The Centre encompasses a range of specialised services tailored to women and children:

FERTILITY CENTRE

Notably, success rates are compelling, with achievements such as 25% success rate for women above 40 years, 54.9% for those aged 35-39, and 48.5% for those under 35 years.

The Obstetrics & Gynaecology ("O&G") team offers a comprehensive array of services, ranging from general and complex O&G cases to maternal and foetal medicine. The Centre prioritises holistic care for mothers and infants, offering Parentcraft classes and lactation counselling to support parents on their parenting journey. The Centre's tailored rehabilitation programmes address musculoskeletal issues, incontinence, and other postnatal concerns.



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PAEDIATRIC CARE

The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (“NICU”) stands as a sanctuary for the tiniest lives, providing expert care to small and sick newborns. A Level 3B facility, the NICU boasts a team of specialists, offering a full range of rehabilitation care to support children’s developmental growth and disorders. Demonstrating its prowess, the NICU at KPJ Damansara has effectively managed a broad spectrum of neonatal conditions, even caring for infants born as early as 23 weeks gestation and weighing as little as 450 grams. This advanced unit stands as a symbol of hope, offering specialised care for premature infants and newborns, fortified by cutting-edge technology and a team of highly skilled medical professionals.
