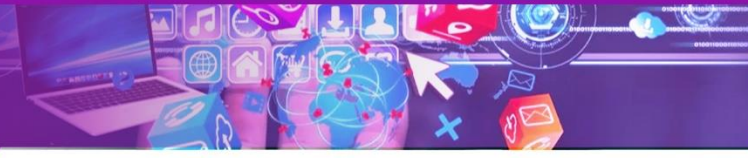

# Bapa budak terjatuh sungai masih harap anak ditemui selamat

Pasukan penyelamat teruskan usaha kesan mangsa dikhuatiri lemas

**Tumpat:** "Sebaik mendapat panggilan anak terjatuh ke dalam sungai, saya sudah bersedia dengan segala kemungkinan, termasuk bakal kehilangannya," kata bapa kepada kanak-kanak lelaki, Amrullah Fitri Afendi.

Dalam kejadian kira-kira jam 6.45 petang kelmarin, Nor Awadah Sulong, 30, ditemukan lemas manakala suaminya, Wan Muhamad Najmi Wan Taib, 30, serta Amrullah Fitri, 10, masih hilang.

Afendi Ismail, 43, berkata dia menerima panggilan telefon jam 7 malam mengenai Amrullah Fitri yang terjatuh ke dalam sungai ketika bersiar menaiki bot bersama bapa saudaranya di Sungai Kelantan di sini.

"Saya kemudian bergegas ke lokasi di Kampung Pasir Pekan Hulu dan ternampak mayat Nor Awadah di tebing sungai, manakala anak saya dan adik ipar

(Wan Muhamad Najmi) masih belum ditemukan.

"Dalam hati saya berasakan sudah tiada harapan untuk ditemui dengan selamat memandangkan anak saya tidak pandai berenang, malah semua mereka juga tidak memakai jaket keselamatan.

"Saya menunggu di lokasi sehingga jam 2 pagi tadi (semalam) dan sempat melaungkan azan di sekitar kawasan itu dengan harapan anak dan adik ipar segera dijumpai," katanya ketika ditemui.

#### Enjin bot mati tiba-tiba

Sebelum ini, Ketua Polis Daerah Tumpat, Asisten Komisioner Amran Dolah, dilaporkan berkata,

hasil maklumat awal mendapati ketiga-tiga mangsa serta seorang bayi perempuan berusia 14 bulan yang juga anak pasangan suami isteri itu bersiar di sungai berkenaan dengan menaiki bot.

Katanya, enjin bot milik Wan Muhamad Najmi dikatakan mati secara mengejut menyebabkan tiga mangsa terbabit terpelanting, sebelum terjatuh ke dalam sungai.

"Ahli keluarga mangsa yang berada di tebing sungai segera ke lokasi dengan menaiki bot dan menyelamatkan mangsa wanita serta bayi perempuan terbabit sebelum dibawa ke tebing.

"Anak perempuan pasangan itu, Wan Nur Ameena Wan Mu-

hammad Najmi berusia 14 bulan selamat," katanya ketika ditemui di lokasi kejadian.

Afendi yang menetap di Kampung Patek, Kadok, Kota Bharu, berkata anak tunggal lelakinya yang dipanggil 'Abang Ngah' itu sudah kerap menaiki bot milik Naimi untuk bersiar-siar di Sungai Kelantan.

Katanya, sebelum kejadian, Amrullah Fitri bersolat Jumaat bersamanya di sebuah masjid di

Kampung Kadok dan sempat membaca surah Yasin seperti kebiasaan.

"Cuma semalam (kelmarin) anak saya membaca surah Yasin dengan lancar, tidak seperti biasa yang kerap juga bertanyakan saya jika tidak pasti mengenai bacaan.

"Ketika ingin menunaikan solat Jumaat juga, Abang Ngah agak teruja berada di barisan hadapan selepas menyedari ada beberapa ruang kosong sebelum memenuhinya.

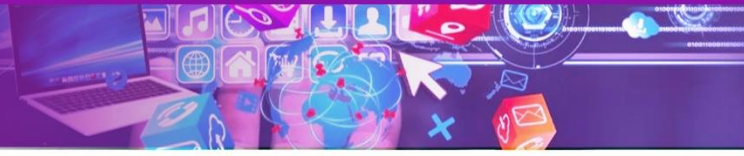
"Abang Ngah anak yang patuh dan sering membantu saya menjaga lembu peliharaan kerana sudah boleh diharap. Saya harap mereka berdua ditemukan segera walau hidup atau sudah tiada," katanya.

Jenazah Nor Awadah dikebumikan di Tanah Perkuburan Islam Kampung Kutan Sungai di sini.

Operasi mencari dan menyelamat diteruskan bermula jam 8 pagi semalam dengan pencarian sekitar 1.2 kilometer radius, termasuk selaman daripada semblan anggota Pasukan Penyelamat Di Air (PPDA).

# Bapa, anak, cucu sanding serentak

Tiga generasi realisasi hari bersejarah pada majlis dihadiri 3,000 tetamu

**Pontian:** Tiga generasi merealisasikan hari bersejarah mereka apabila bersanding secara serentak dalam majlis perkahwinan yang berlangsung di Kampung Melayu Raya, Pekan Nanas, semalam.

Lebih menarik, pasangan itu terdiri bapa, anak dan cucu.

Ahmad Omar, 60, (bapa) bersanding bersama pasangan, Juriah Misubani, 61; Rozita Ahmad, 45 (anak) pula bersanding bersama Mohd Yazid Ali, 44; manakala Nurhazimah Mohd Hussin, 24, (cucu) dengan pasangannya, Mohamad Zulhaire Zakaria, 22.

Majlis bersejarah itu turut dihadiri kira-kira 3,000 tetamu.

Majlis pernikahan Ahmad berlangsung pada 1 Jun, Rozita pula pada 3 Jun, manakala Nurhazimah pada 30 Jun.

Juriah mengenakan pakaian serba kelabu, Nurhazimah bersama Mohamad Zulhaire pula serba merah, manakala Rozita serta Mohd Yazid berpakaian ungu.

Ketiga-tiganya bersanding di rumah Mohd Hussin Jambari selaku tuan rumah yang juga bapa kepada Nurhazimah.

Ahmad yang juga bapa kepada enam anak dan mempunyai 15 cucu serta tiga cicit berkata, majlis pernikahannya berlangsung

di Pejabat Kadi Pontian dengan hantaran RM5,000.

#### Muafakat semua pihak

Katanya, kelangsungan majlis berkenaan, termasuk bersanding secara serentak adalah hasil permuafakatan semua pihak, termasuk ahli keluarga pengantin.

"Kami berterima kasih kepada semua pihak, termasuk penduduk kampung serta saudara-mara, yang membantu mengurus-

kan majlis ini," katanya yang juga petani.

Bagi Rozita yang juga anak bongsu daripada enam beradik, dia bersyukur dengan kelancaran majlis persandingan itu.

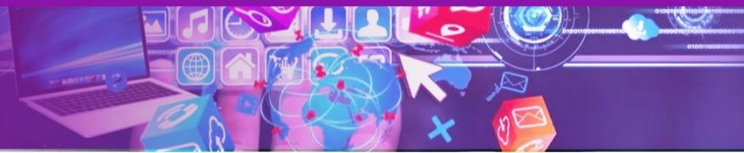
"Siapa sangka, tiga generasi bersanding di pelamin hari yang sama. Ia cukup menunjukkan eratnya silaturahim dalam kalangan keluarga dan masyarakat.

"Saya berdoa supaya perkahwinan kami sentiasa dirahmati

Allah SWT. Terima kasih juga kepada semua yang membantu," katanya yang bekerja di sebuah syarikat swasta di daerah ini.

Sementara itu, tetamu, Robaniah Jamari, 60, berkata, majlis berkenaan bukan sekadar menjadi kenangan buat mempelai, malah tetamu.

"Majlis ini cukup unik serta melambangkan keharmonian dalam keluarga juga masyarakat," katanya.

## Kompaun wanita berseluar pendek dibatal

**Ipoh:** Kes seorang peniaga wanita yang dikompaun Majlis Perbandaran Kota Bharu Bandaraya Islam (MPKB) akibat berseluar pendek di tempat awam baru-baru ini, sudah selesai, kata Menteri Pembangunan Kerajaan Tempatan, Nga Kor Ming.

Kor Ming dalam pada itu menegaskan, tidak timbul isu pihaknya dan Kerajaan Persekutuan campur tangan terhadap undang-undang kerajaan negeri.

Ia rentetan kenyataannya sebelum ini yang meminta MPKB menarik kembali kompaun itu atas sebab bertentangan dengan semangat Perlembagaan Persekutuan yang menjamin hak dan kebebasan rakyat berbilang kaum.

Beliau malah berkata, MPKB bersetuju membatalkan kompaun terhadap wanita berumur 35 tahun itu selepas sesi perbincangan diadakan bersama Ketua Pengarah Jabatan Kerajaan Tempatan (JKT) Datuk Mohd Fadzi Mohd Kenall.

"Isu ini sebenarnya sudah selesai. Ketua Pengarah JKT susah berbincang dengan MPKB dan pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) itu sudah pun setuju untuk membatalkan kompaun terbabit kerana ia tidak munasabah.

"Harus saya tegaskan, ini adalah masyarakat berbilang kaum dan bangsa, jadi tiada isu untuk kata Kerajaan (Persekutuan) campur tangan.

"Lagi pula antara slogan Kementerian Pembangunan Kerajaan Tempatan (KPKT) adalah perpaduan dalam kepelbagaian," katanya kepada media ketika lawatan kerja di Fair Park di sini, semalam.

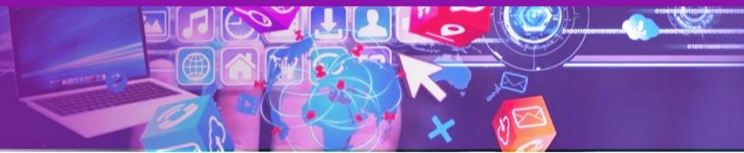
Hadir sama Datuk Bandar Ipoh Datuk Rumaizi Baharin.

Pada lawatan itu, Kor Ming turut mengumumkan penyaluran peruntukan lebih RM22 juta untuk kerja pembinaan prasarana, termasuk pembinaan parkir bertingkat di kawasan Pekan Lama Ipoh.

Peruntukan itu juga untuk membaiki fasiliti dan prasarana sekitar bandar raya ini, khususnya membabitkan kemudahan lif di beberapa pangsupuri yang disifatkan uzur.

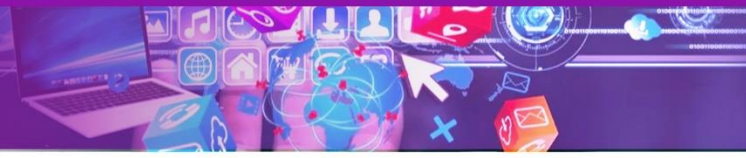

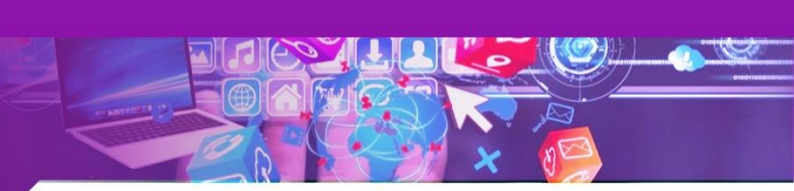
Menurut Safiah, ketiga-tiganya kini menggunakan lampin pakai buang dan meminum susu yang disyorkan doktor.

Sebaik mendapat panggilan memberitahu anak terjatuh dalam sungai, saya sudah bersedia dengan segala kemungkinan termasuk akan kehilangannya," kata bapa kepada kanak-kanak lelaki, Amrullah Fitri Afendi.

Dalam kejadian kira-kira jam 6.45 petang kelmarin, Nor Awadah Sulong, 30, di temui lemas manakala suaminya, Wan Muhamad Najmi Wan Taib, 30, serta anak saudaranya, Amrullah Fitri Afendi, 10, masih hilang.

Afendi Ismail, 43, berkata, dia menerima panggilan jam

7 malam kelmarin mengenai anaknya yang berusia 10 tahun itu terjatuh ke dalam sungai ketika bersiar-siar menaiki bot bersama bapa saudaranya di Sungai Kelantan di sini.

"Saya bergegas ke lokasi di Kampung Pasir Pekan Hulu dan ternampak mayat Nor Awadah di tebing sungai manakala anak saya dan adik ipar (Wan Muhamad Najmi) masih belum ditemukan."

Dalam hati saya merasakan sudah tiada harapan untuk ditemankan dengan selamat memandangkan dia tidak pandai berenang malah kesemua mereka juga tidak memakai jaket keselamatan.

"Saya menunggu di lokasi sehingga jam 2 pagi dan

sempat melaukan azan di sekitar kawasan itu dengan harapan anak dan adik ipar segera dijumpai," katanya ketika ditemui di sini, semalam.

Afendi yang menetap di Kampung Pakok, Kadok, Kota Bharu berkata, anak tunggal lelakinya yang dipanggil Abang Ngah itu sudah kerap kali menaiki bot milik Najmi untuk bersiar-siar di Sungai Kelantan.

Dia berkata, sebelum kejadian, Amrullah Fitri bersolat Jumaat bersama-sama di sebuah masjid di Kampung Kadok, Kota Bharu dan sempat membaca surah Yasin seperti kebiasaan.

"Cuma kelmarin anak saya membaca surah Yasin dengan lancar, tidak seperti

"Ahli keluarga mangsa yang berada di tebing sungai segera ke lokasi menaiki bot dan menyelamatkan mangsa wanita serta bayi perempuan terbatih sebelum dibawa ke tebing.

"Bagaimanapun mangsa wanita itu sudah meninggal dunia manakala bayinya selamat

dan mangsa dibawa ke Hospital Tumpat untuk proses bedah siasat," katanya ketika ditemui di lokasi kejadian.

Anwar berkata, operasi mencari dan menyelamat membabitkan pemantauan di permukaan sungai sahaja dan selaman. Turut hadir di lokasi adalah Menteri Besar Kelantan, Datuk Ahmad Nakhod yang bertanya khabar mengenai kejadian serta menyantuni keluarga mangsa.

Sementara itu, seorang saksi, Riduan Adnan, 30, berkata, dia terdengar bunyi bising di tebing sungai dan segera ke sana untuk melihat apa yang berlaku.

Dia berkata, sebaik tiba di tebing sungai, dia ternampak seorang lelaki yang juga ahli keluarga mangsa menaiki botnya menghampiri bot yang dinaiki semua mangsa yang berada di tengah sungai.

"Lelaki itu mengangkat mangsa wanita dan dibawa ke tebing sungai sebelum berpatah semula ke bot yang semakin dibawa arus untuk mengambil bayi perempuan yang sedang menangis."

"Ada juga penduduk kampung cuba membuat bantuan pernafasan terhadap mangsa wanita itu namun dia sudah pun meninggal dunia," katanya.

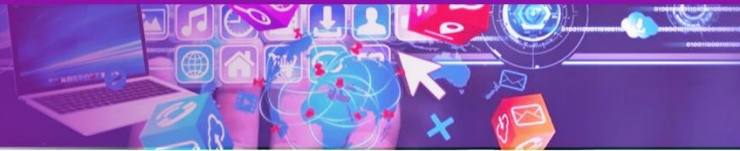

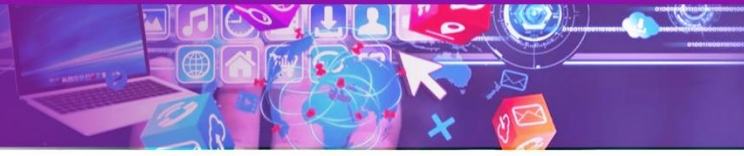
"Siapa sangka, tiga generasi bersanding di pelamin yang hari yang sama. Ia cu-

tama ibu bapa menerima agama saya walaupun pada mulanya saya takut untuk berterus-terang.

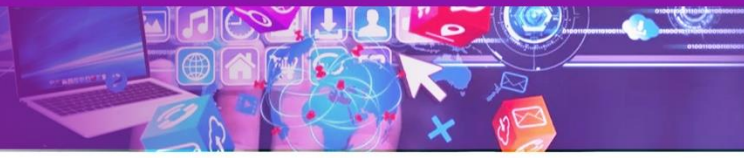

Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek yesterday said the matter had been resolved by the Negri Sembilan Education Department.

"This matter has been settled at the department level and we consider it (matter) resolved."

Social media has been abuzz since Tuesday over claims that a Year One pupil, who was punished by his teacher, was locked up in a room with an iron fence that resembled a cage.

The boy's unnamed father had since apologised to the classmate's parents for his son's joke that went overboard.

Asked if the place the boy was

"Also, the action by the department (as I mentioned earlier) has

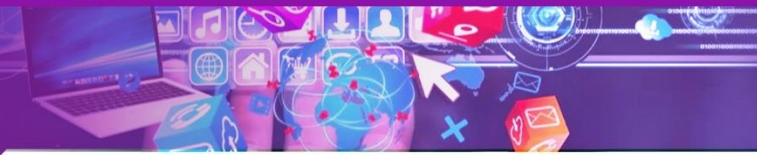
been settled.

# No fine for wearing shorts

## Kota Baru council will not pursue matter, says minister

**IPOH:** The Kota Baru Municipal Council has agreed to cancel the fine on a non-Muslim woman who was penalised for wearing shorts in her store, says Nga Kor Ming.

He said the matter was decided after a discussion with the Local Government Department director-general.

Speaking on the recent case, the Local Government Development Minister said the woman should

not have paid the fine.

"She might have been misled into doing so. She wore shorts in her own shop, which sells shorts.

"If she could not wear shorts, it meant all her stocks would have to be discarded, which does not make sense.

"But the issue is now settled," Nga told a press conference in Fair Park here yesterday.

Last Sunday, the Kota Baru Municipal Council fined a

non-Muslim businesswoman for wearing shorts in public, saying that it was an offence under Section 34(2)(b) of the council's Business and Industrial Trade By-Laws 2019.

The by-laws state that non-Muslims are to be dressed decently while covering their aurat (parts of the body that, in Islam, are not supposed to be exposed in public).

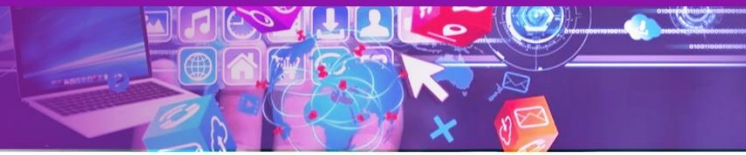
Nga reminded local govern-

ments that they needed to understand the essence of the Federal Constitution when carrying out their duties.

"Malaysia is a multiracial country and we need to respect each other.

"We respect the dress code but do not be too enthusiastic when enforcing the law.

"This should not have happened and we hope it will not recur," he added.

With the theme "Redefining the Future of Rail and Infrastructure", the conference will feature 11 speakers from Malaysia, Europe and Asia Pacific.

The conference will include presentations on transformative rail and infrastructure projects from around the world, including Japan, with a special keynote addressing magnetic levitation (maglev) technology to move superfast trains.

Japan-based JR Central counsel and director Koei Tsuge will speak on that country's superconducting maglev (SCMaglev), which is jointly developed by JR Central and the Railway Technical Research Institute.

On April 21, 2015, a seven-car SCMaglev train hit a speed of 603kph, less than a week after the same train clocked 590kph, breaking the previous land speed record for rail vehicles of 581kph set by a JR Central MLX01 maglev train in December 2003.

Conference participants will

also get a better glimpse of Indonesia's new administrative capital, Nusantara, through a talk by Silvia Halim from the Nusantara Capital Authority.

Meanwhile, Datuk Alice Jawan Empaling, permanent secretary of Sarawak's Transport Ministry, will speak about how that state is transforming its public transport. There will be a presentation on how to improve gender diversity in the rail industry from Hiba Fares, CEO of RATP Dev in France.

With 27,000 employees, RATP Dev has a presence in 16 countries, where it transports 1.5 billion passengers a year.

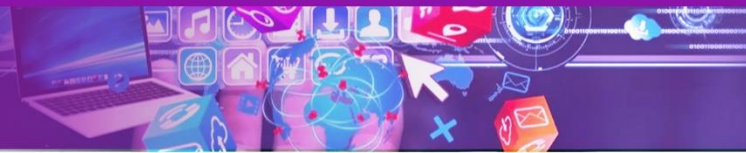
"The conference welcomes professionals, industry leaders and enthusiasts who are passionate about the advancement of rail, construction and infrastructure growth," said Natasha.

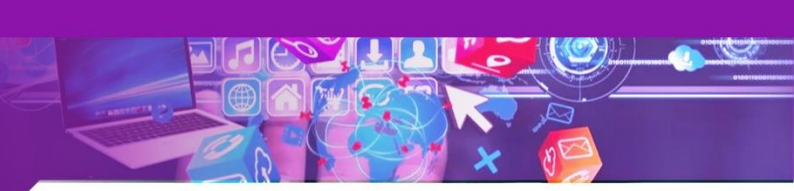
In a statement from its communications and corporate affairs department, Socso said it wished to apologise for the inconvenience caused to the woman, who was accompanied by a colleague.

# 'Together, we must break the silence'

### What meant as a university project ends up raising students' awareness of sexual harassment issues and their rights for justice, protection

THERE must never be any compromise when it comes to defending oneself against any form of sexual harassments and in this regard, the law is there to protect the rights of the victims, regardless of their backgrounds.

In force beginning March 28 this year, the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act 2022 was passed in the Dewan Rakyat on July 20, 2022, and subsequently in the Dewan Negara on Aug 11.

It was gazetted as a new law on Oct 18 last year after receiving the Royal Assent of Yang di-Pertuan Agong Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah.

According to Women, Family and Community Development Ministry, the Act is being implemented in phases, involving Section 1 (Short Title and Commencement); Section 2 (Interpretation); Section 24 (Administrator); Section 25 (Functions and Powers of Administrator); and, Section 26 (Power to Make Regulations).

"The enforcement of the Act involves the definition of sexual harassment, elements of awareness and prevention of sexual harassment in the community.

"It takes into account the importance of educating the people and increasing their understanding and awareness of the seriousness of issues involving sexual harassment, before this Act is fully enforced," said the ministry in a statement issued in March.

It also said the Act reflected the government's concern and serious commitment to addressing and eliminating gender-based discrimination, especially sexual harassment.

"The understanding and awareness of sexual harassment and its effects on victims can be enhanced in the community, and can directly help towards providing a safe environment.

"This is to empower people in the economic, social and political spheres, in addition to ensuring that they are not marginalised in the country's development towards achieving the Malaysia Madani aspirations," the statement read.

All this was encapsulated in the "Women for Women: Breaking the Silence of Women in

Community", a recent exhibition organised and run by the Semester 2-Group 2A diploma students from the Faculty of Hotel and Tourism Management of Universiti Teknologi Mara (UTM) Sarawak in Kota Samarahan.

"More than just an assignment" At first, group leader Bemisha Chindri Basli did not think much about the project assigned to her and fellow course-mates by their senior lecturer, Nuraini Putit. The 20-year-old Miriam, nonetheless, was very serious about putting her best efforts into the assignment.

It was during research work and interviews with those well-versed in this matter that she began to understand the significance of this project.

"It did not mean that I was totally clueless about sexual harassment, but this project showed me the other aspects of this issue that I never realised were there before.

"It was then my course-mates and I understood how severe the impact could be on the victims, and also the channels that they could seek for help and protection," Bemisha told the Sunday Post when met at the exhibition in La Promenade Mall, Kota Samarahan recently.

As part of the assignment, her team conducted interviews with DSP Jennifer Atok, the officer in charge of the Division of Investigation of Sexual Crimes Against Women and Children (D11) under the Criminal

Investigation Department of Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) Sarawak Contingent, and also Sarawak Women for Women Society (SWWS) programme officer Krystal Nantie Thomas.

"These interviews really opened our eyes. From the session with DSP Jennifer, I now understand that sexual harassment is any act of a sexual nature, in any form whether verbal, non-verbal, visual, gestural or physical, that is unwanted by the victim who feels uncomfortable, offended, humiliated or threatened by it.

"From the interview with Miss Krystal, we found out more about the programmes run by the SWWS meant to advocate and empower women and children's rights and equality in the fields of education, welfare, careers and also in society. They also serve to educate and develop supportive services for women and young girls," said Bemisha.

"All of us now realise that there are help and support for those facing abuse, discrimination and other types of mistreatment," she added.

"Afraid to speak out" Fellow team member Janice James also talked about gaining better understanding from doing her part in the class project.

However, she felt that it was highly necessary for the conversation to continue running as there were still many people who viewed the issue of sexual harassment as 'a normalised thing'.

"There are those who are scared to speak out — maybe it's because of the fear of losing one's job, being ostracised by the family,

being condemned by their peers and society, or thinking that the authorities may just ignore their plight, thus feeling that it's a lost cause.

"I think there should be a specific awareness programme being run regularly, especially in schools and IPTs (Institutions of Higher Learning), as well as the workplace. It's important for everyone to know their right to say no, and to seek justice and protection. The law and the assistance are by your side, but it is also very important for you to be aware of it," said the 19-year-old student, who also hails from Miri.

"Affecting all genders" Accompanying Bemisha and Janice during the interview was Muhammad Azling Khayyatul Fitri Erman, one of six male students in the 21-member project group.

"I must admit that during brainstorming, I was quite unsure of how I could contribute to the group — you know, being a boy.

"But later on during research, I realised that sexual harassment could also affect men. I was able to interact with the visitors and explain the exhibits to them, for them to understand the issue more clearly," said the 20-year-old Kuchingite.

Joining the conversation, Nuraini said she was proud to see growth in her charges as they move along handling the exhibition.

"Yes, it started as a prerequisite for the diploma programme, but I did not want it to only be seen that way. I wanted them to be able to relate to what this project was about, and to know that they could seek help should this unfortunate thing befall them," said the 52-year-old senior lecturer who has been with UTM Sarawak since 1999.

Adding her input into the conversation about sexual harassment, Nuraini felt that much more must be done in getting justice for the victims of such cases in Malaysia.

Citing her past years of living in the US and Australia, she observed that these overseas countries really put strict emphasis on the fight against sexual offences and crimes not only through their respective laws, but also in social awareness.

"Over there, 'NO' means 'NO', and their laws back this up. Their mind-sets are also different.

"Here, the subject of sex itself is still taboo, and almost always, it is associated with smearing the family's honour or bringing shame to one's community.

"So you must understand why many are afraid to speak out — in most cases, the damage to the victim is far greater and more destructive than that to the offender," she stressed.

Nuraini also clarified that her view was not meant at belittling the authorities handling these cases.

"There are means to help the victims and for the authorities to solve the cases. I just think that some bureaucratic red tapes should be taken down," she pointed out.

"That being said, I believe that things are moving towards a positive direction, as more and more are willing to speak out. They are now realising: 'Why should I suffer for something that's not my fault, while the one who actually committed it, is allowed to just sit and relax' — right?"

"Awareness is important. This is what I want not only for my students, but also for everyone out there, to know."

She praised the society for giving a positive impact to the people in Dalat. She added that providing a hearse to

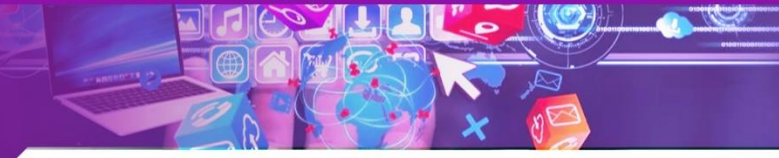

# Family planning: Establishing facts, dispelling myths

For 60 years, SFPA remains steadfast in providing accessible, comprehensive reproductive healthcare services, aiming for lasting change

AT the heart of every society lies the profound belief in the power of choice. It is a belief that empowers individuals and families to shape their own destinies, define their ambitions, and decide the trajectory of their lives.

Amidst this intricate tapestry of choices, the Sarawak Family Planning Association (SFPA) stands tall as a beacon of hope, compassion, and advocacy for reproductive health and family planning rights for all.

The organisation traces its roots back to 1961, when a group of forward-thinking individuals recognised the need to address reproductive health concerns in Sarawak.

They saw a need to serve the many women in Sarawak who had too many children poorly spaced out. The women suffered from pregnancy related illnesses, faced the dilemma of illegal abortions and difficult financial pressure.

In pursuit of social justice, Dr Chong Chun Hian, who was the state obstetrician and gynaecologist, initiated to form SFPA. Together with a few concerned doctors and nurses, their foresight laid the foundation for a movement that would transcend borders and bring about transformative change in the lives of countless individuals and communities.

They strove to ensure that individuals and families would have access to accurate information, counselling and support, as well as to empower them in making informed decisions about their bodies, fostering healthier families and communities.

Making access to information available SFPA's formal registration with the Registrar of Societies (RoS) only happened in 1963 – the delay due to the formation of Malaysia.

Since its inception, the SFPA has been dedicated to providing accessible and comprehensive sexual and reproductive healthcare services.

"Its mission is to ensure that individuals would have access to the resources they need to make informed decisions about their reproductive health, regardless of their age, gender, economic status, or geographical location."

"As we are commemorating our 60th anniversary this year, it

is important to acknowledge the road ahead. While great strides have been made in reproductive rights, significant challenges still persist.

"In many societies, access to information and resources related to family planning is limited, leading to numerous consequences for individuals, families, and communities," SFPA manager Annie Tan told the Sunday Post in Kuching.

Early days in the beginning, the association operated from the polyclinic at Jalan Masjid (now Jalan Masjid Health Clinic Kuching) twice a week, with each session commencing at 4.30pm.

Tan was unable to provide any record on how long a session would run.

However, it was being run mainly with the help from volunteering staff of the Medical Department comprising doctors, nurses and some public-spirited women.

"The operation time was after office hours because volunteers stopped work at 4.15pm in those days. Although there was a demand for even more sessions, it was not possible as the volunteers had already sacrificed a lot of their time to run the two sessions weekly."

SFPA only recruited its own team after the mid-1960s, as its financial situation had

improved after receiving grants from the state government and International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF).

The main services were providing contraceptives such as condoms, diaphragms and tubal ligation, and advice on family health such as nutrition and spacing out of births.

In the later years of the 1960s the SFPA had extended its services throughout Sarawak, opening clinics in Sri Aman, Sibau, Sanyit, Bintangor, Miri, Limbang and Bintulu.

Through frugal management, the SFPA was able to use its internally-generated funds to construct clinics on land leased or gifted by the state government.

Excess capacity was rented out to generate more incomes.

The first building, the current headquarters cum the Kuching branch at Jalan P. Ramlee (then Jalan Jawa) was completed in 1970, followed by Miri and Sri Aman in 1982.

Shophots were purchased for Bintulu in 1989 (own building in 2007), and Sibau in 1998.

The facilities in Limbang, Sanyit and Bintangor were housed in rented premises.

Challenges and obstacles in the early days, the association faced many difficulties, among them reservations from religious groups.

"The Roman Catholics approved only 'rhythm method' – basically scheduling sex by tracking the woman's menstrual cycle as per the calendar to either avoid or have intercourse during her fertile days.

are usually the carriers of this virus and women who have this virus have a high probability of contracting it from men.

Tan stressed: "HPV is a common sexually-transmitted infection."

Other services included emergency contraceptive (morning after pill), counselling on menopause and hormone replacement therapy (HRT), treatment for minor gynaecological problems, breast examination, and abortion (counselling and referral).

The emergency contraception, according to Tan, is a way to prevent pregnancy from sex without contraception.

"The SFPA constantly raises awareness of emergency contraceptive pill to educate the local community about self-protection. It is merely a prevention method, not an abortion drug as it would not end a pregnancy that has already been implanted within the uterus."

"Self-dependency" SFPA is a non-profit government organisation and as such, it does depend on donations.

However, the organisation also generates its own income through sales, from which the profits are utilised to sustain its branches and keep its staff on the payroll.

"The association sells products at affordable prices and makes modest profits," said Tan.

"In recent years, our revenue had derived from the increased provisions of other services especially vaccines, blood tests and pap smear screenings."

Since the mid-1990s, though, there has been a continuous drop in the sales of contraceptive commodities, mainly due to the more aggressive efforts of the Ministry of Health (MoH) in providing free contraceptive services.

In the early days, the SFPA depended primarily on donations.

Since 1964, it has received an annual grant ( gazetted) of RM20,000 from the state government.

The IPPF recognised the good work done by SFPA and in extending 'observer status' to it, the former had also helped with commodity grants – namely, supplies of contraceptive pills and intrauterine contraceptive devices (IUCDs).

SFPA stopped receiving direct commodity grant in 1978 after it became a member of the Federation of Family Planning Association of Malaysia (FRHAM).

Tan said the facilities in the SFPA's Women Clinic had been significantly improved following grants received from the Japanese

Embassy. In March 2010, the Embassy gave a generous amount of RM74,670 to improve the medical ultrasound machine facilities.

Three years later in 2013, it gave SFPA RM101,584 for the same purposes, for it to be implemented in eight other women's clinics in Sarawak.

Projects Throughout the years, SFPA has undertaken various projects, some of which were run in collaboration with several organisations such as the IPPF, FRHAM, United Nations Family Planning Association (UNFPA), and Mercy Malaysia.

Among them were youth camp for poor educators to enhance their skills, self-esteem and leadership potential, empowering them to lead healthy sexual lives that would respond to their needs; the HPV programme; basic contraception course to empower service providers; doctors and nurses in providing quality sexual reproductive health services to the public; the UNFPA projects to provide pap smear screening, blood screening and general check-ups; partnering with Mercy Malaysia for outreach project in the rural areas; the 'Spread A Smile' adoption programme where SFPA Kuching adopted 54 families and SFPA Sibau, seven families, of people living with HIV/AIDS and their orphans.

"The 'Spread A Smile' project was terminated in February 2022 after 16 years, said Annie, partly due to financial limitation.

Looking ahead The SFPA understands the significance of collaborative efforts in achieving lasting change. It continues to be actively engaged with the local communities, healthcare professionals and government agencies towards creating partnerships and building a united front for reproductive health advocacy.

According to Tan, the SFPA recognises that education is not merely a tool, but also a catalyst for change.

"In our unrelenting dedication to comprehensive sexual education, we hope to conduct more youth programme in schools to carry out the 'Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE)."

"The youth programme has been slow as most schools are not ready yet to open for the association to carry out the CSE."

"As SFPA moves forward, it faces unique challenges including limited resources and geographic disparities. We are looking forward to have sponsors to get a van each for our Kuching, Miri, and Sibau branches to conduct services of family planning in the rural areas."

"The van would act like a mobile clinic, from where we could carry out pap smear and general health screenings."

"A van would be more efficient than a bus because some rural places are small and thus, are only accessible by small vehicles," she said.

With each passing year, the SFPA continues to sow the seeds of change, nurturing the aspirations and dreams of countless individuals and families.

It has, with its unwavering commitment to reproductive health, played a vital role in transforming lives, empowering communities and shaping a brighter future for Sarawak.

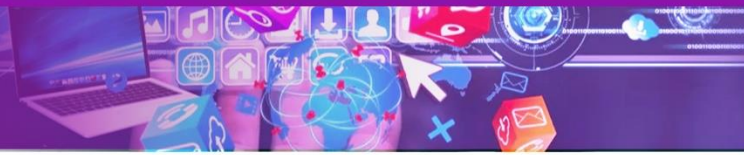

## Rep proposes appointment of more community leaders for Sentosa

**SIBU:** A proposal has been made to Sibu Resident Office to appoint more community leaders in Sentosa area to better serve its residents, said Joseph Chieng.

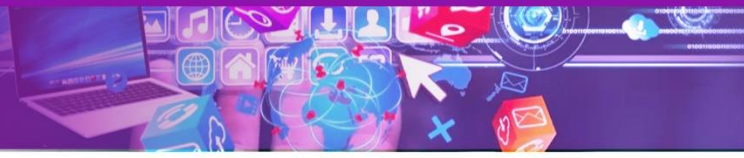

## Viral case of Year One student confined in 'iron cage' resolved — Fadhlina

**NIBONG TEBAL:** The case of a Year One student being locked in an 'iron cage' at a school in Rembau, Negeri Sembilan, that went viral on social media has been resolved, said Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek.

She said the matter had been resolved amicably between the school and the parents of the seven-year-old boy during a meeting at the Negeri Sembilan Education Department.

"The student's family accepted the explanation given by the school...so, we consider the matter settled," she told reporters when met after the Aidiladha Sacrificial programme at Masjid Jamek Al Huda Sungai Bakau here yesterday.

The issue surfaced when a man's tweet and a screenshot of a WhatsApp group conversation, believed to be between a teacher and the student's father, went viral on Twitter.

There was also a media report which stated Rembau District Police Chief Supt Hazri Mohamad as saying that the father of the Year One student who was locked up in the 'iron cage' had accepted the teacher's explanation during a meeting involving the student's family, Rembau district education officers, the school and the police last Wednesday.

Elaborating on the case, Fadhlina who is Nibong Tebal Member of Parliament, said

the Negeri Sembilan Education Department also conducted an investigation into the case.

In another development, Fadhlina said the ministry had established a special committee to ensure the smooth implementation of the Malaysian Education Development Plan (PPPM) 2013-2025, which is now entering its third wave.

"This third wave means that it

(PPPM) has almost reached its end. So, now is a critical period for us to see the effectiveness of the initiatives," she added.

She said this when asked to comment on a suggestion by former Education Minister Dr Maszlee Malik for the country's education system to be overhauled following the Covid-19 epidemic. — Bernama

# Woman dies in head-on collision at Jalan Bakam

**MIRI:** A 33-year-old woman passenger died after the car she was travelling in collided head-on with a lorry at Jalan Bakam on Friday.

Miri police chief ACP Alexson Naga Chabu said a report on the incident was received by police around 2.30pm on Friday.

"Investigation at the scene found that the car that was driven by a 32-year-old man lost control and skidded into the opposite lane before crashing into a lorry," he said in a statement.

The accident had caused major damage to the left side of the car and the front side of the lorry.

Seven personnel from Miri Fire and Rescue Department Central Station were dispatched to the location to remove two of the victims who were stuck in the driver's seat and passenger seat, he added.

"The accident resulted in the death of a woman passenger, whereas the car driver and three



The damaged car and lorry in the accident at Jalan Bakam that resulted in a woman's death.

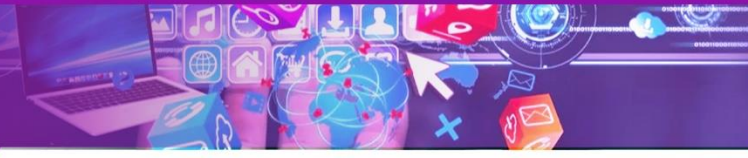
other passengers aged between one and six suffered serious injuries. The injured are now being treated at Miri Hospital,"

he said.

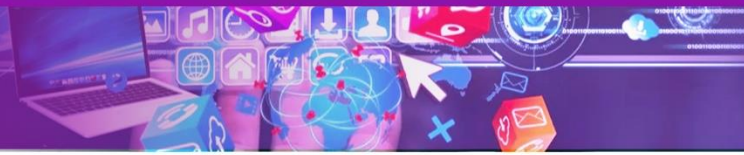

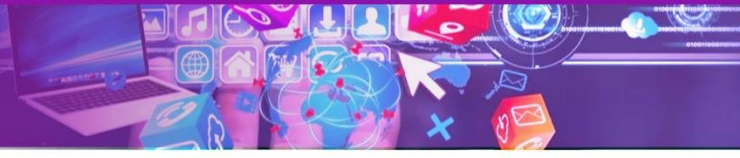
yang terjejas susulan bekalan air terputus ketika PKP.

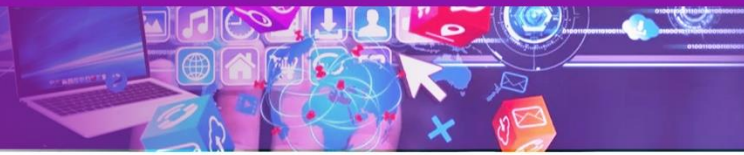

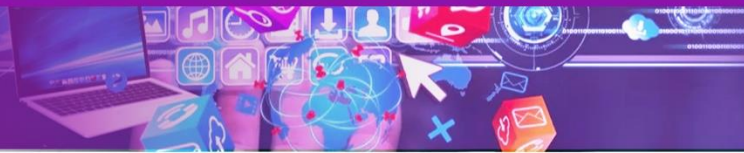
terhadap aktiviti-aktiviti seperti ini.

“Tanpa ilmu pengetahuan, sukarlah hidup anak-anak kita nanti.

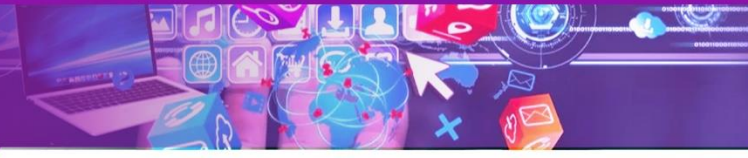

# Wanita maut dalam kemalangan di Miri

**MIRI:** Seorang wanita berusia 33 tahun meninggal dunia selepas kereta yang dinaikinya berlanggar dengan sebuah lori di Jalan Bakam di sini, petang kelmarin.

Ketua Polis Daerah Miri ACP Alexson Naga Chabu berkata, pihak polis menerima laporan mengenai kemalangan maut itu pada jam 2.30 petang.

“Siasatan di tempat kejadian mendapati kereta yang dipandu seorang lelaki berusia 32 tahun dipercayai hilang kawalan lalu terbabas ke laluan bertentangan dan berlanggar dengan sebuah lori yang dipandu seorang lelaki berusia 44 tahun.

Alexson menambah susulan itu, satu kertas siasatan dibuka dan disiasat di bawah Seksyen 41(1) Akta Pengangkutan Jalan 1987.

Terdahulu, sepasukan tujuh anggota dari Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat Miri Sentral bergegas ke lokasi kejadian bagi menjalankan operasi mengeluarkan dua mangsa yang tersesit di tempat duduk pemandu dan penumpang hadapan kereta terbabit.
