Bot hanyut hingga ke perairan Filipina

Pasangan warga emas hilang sejak Ahad lalu ditemui selamat

Sandakan: Suami isteri warga emas yang dalam perjalanan dari Terusan Sugut ke Batu Putih, di sini berdepan detik cemas selepas bot dinaiki mereka hanyut hingga ke perairan Filipina akibat kehabisan minyak, Ahad lalu.

Md Asibih Tamang, 73, dan isteri Fatima Ulo, 65, dilaporkan hilang ketika dalam perjalanan ke rumah anaknya di Kampung Batu Putih dengan menaiki bot gentian kaca kira-kira jam 8 pagi.

Pengarah Agensi Penguatkuasaan Maritim Malaysia (Maritim Malaysia) Zon Maritim Sandakan, Kepten Maritim Zaimudin Mohd Zuki, berkata pasangan itu sepatutnya tiba di rumah anak mereka dua jam kemudian.

Katanya, apabila mendapati pasangan itu tidak tiba pada waktu sepatutnya, menantu mereka membuat laporan kepada Maritim Malaysia berhubung kehilangan berkenaan.

"Selepas menerima laporan dari Pusat Operasi (PUSOP) Zon Maritim Sandakan, Maritime Rescue Sub Centre (MRSC) Kota Kinabalu mengaktifkan operasi mencari dan menyelamat (CARILAMAT) pada jam 6.30 petang hari yang sama.

"Bagaimanapun, pencarian pasangan itu ditamatkan selepas mereka dapat dihubungi dan dilaporkan berada dalam keadaan selamat di Pulau Mapun, Filipina, Isnin lalu.

"Mangsa diberikan bantuan

oleh nelayan tempatan yang kemudiannya menghantar mereka pulang dengan menggunakan kapal nelayan dan diserahkan kepada Maritim Malaysia berhampiran Tanjung Pamaguan," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Beliau berkata, pasangan itu kemudian dibawa ke Jeti Zon Maritim Sandakan untuk diserahkan kepada keluarga mereka kelmarin.

Bot habis minyak

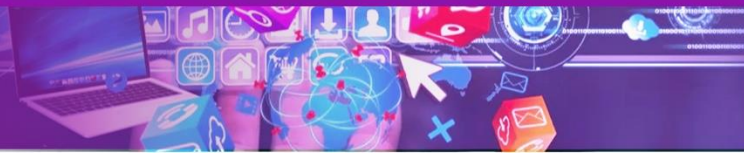
Mengulas lanjut, Zaimudin berkata, mangsa memaklumkan mereka menuju ke Batu Putih dengan menjadikan Pulau Tikus sebagai panduan, namun tersesat sehingga bot kehabisan minyak berhampiran Pulau Lankayan.

"Mereka kemudiannya mendapatkan bantuan petugas yang berada di Pulau Lankayan untuk mengisi minyak.

"Bagi mengelakkan daripada tersesat untuk ke destinasi yang dituju, petugas berkenaan menasihati mereka supaya mengikuti sebuah kapal yang akan menuju ke Sandakan sebagai pandu arah.

"Bagaimanapun, selepas beberapa ketika mengikuti kapal berkenaan, Md Asibih memintas kapal terbabit dengan alasan ia bergerak terlalu perlahan dan khuatir berlakunya ribut.

"Malangnya, tindakan itu membuatkan mereka tersesat dan bot kehabisan minyak semula sehingga hanyut ke Pulau Mapun, Filipina," katanya.

Budak bawah usia 5 tahun kekurangan nutrisi naik 0.3 peratus

Kuala Lumpur: Jumlah kanak-kanak bawah usia lima tahun mengalami kekurangan nutrisi yang teruk meningkat sedikit kepada 0.3 peratus pada tahun lalu berbanding 0.2 peratus pada tahun sebelumnya.

Ketua Perangkawan, Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin, berkata melihat kepada aspek kesihatan, indikator kekurangan nutrisi yang dilaporkan dalam perangkaan berkenaan adalah berdasarkan kanak-kanak berusia bawah lima tahun yang hadir ke fasiliti kesihatan negara ini.

"Kanak-kanak negara ini yang berusia di bawah lima tahun yang mengalami kekurangan nutrisi yang sederhana turut meningkat daripada 0.1 peratus kepada 1.4 peratus tahun lalu, berbanding 1.3 peratus pada 2021.

Komposisi kanak-kanak di bawah usia lima tahun adalah berjumlah 2.35 juta dengan 1.21 juta kanak-kanak lelaki dan 1.14 juta kanak-kanak perempuan.

"Kumpulan umur ini membabitkan 25.7 peratus daripada jumlah kanak-kanak di Malaysia," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Dalam pada itu, statistik juga menunjukkan jumlah kanak-kanak yang terbabit dengan jenayah tahun lalu pula menunjukkan penurunan sebanyak 12.8 peratus tahun lalu dengan 1,621 kes berbanding 1,481 kes pada 2021," katanya.

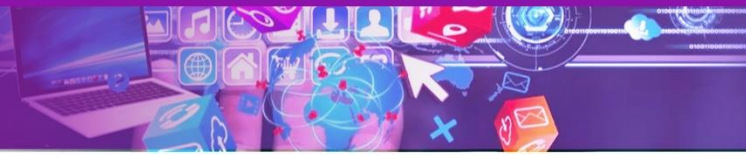
Beliau berkata berdasarkan anggaran penduduk negara tahun ini, jumlah kanak-kanak bawah usia 18 tahun ialah 9.13 juta membabitkan 27.4 peratus daripada jumlah penduduk Malaysia, 33.38 juta.

Katanya, bilangan kanak-kanak lelaki dan perempuan di bawah usia 18 tahun masing-masing adalah 4.72 juta dan 4.42 juta.

Beliau berkata, Putrajaya merekodkan peratusan tertinggi kanak-kanak bawah 18 tahun tahun ini iaitu 41.1 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan penduduk Putrajaya, yang berjumlah 120,000.

"Ia diikuti oleh Kelantan (34.4 peratus) dan Terengganu (33.5 peratus)," katanya.

"Kuala Lumpur mencatatkan peratusan terendah iaitu 22.6 peratus. Selangor merekodkan bilangan kanak-kanak di bawah usia 18 tahun tertinggi iaitu 1.81 juta, diikuti Johor (1.11 juta) dan Sabah (1.10 juta)," katanya.

Didakwa serah dokumen palsu tipu PERKESO

Alor Setar: Seorang pemilik syarikat mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini semalam atas tujuh pertuduhan mengemukakan dokumen mengandungi butiran palsu bagi menuntut insentif berjumlah RM24,500 di bawah Program Penjana Kerjaya 2.0, dua tahun lalu.

Nur Kesuma Kartini Mohamad Zahir, 41, pemilik syarikat Aisy Maju Abadi Trading didakwa memberikan tujuh borang Pengesahan Pekerja Program Insentif Pengambilan Pekerja atas nama syarikat itu kepada seorang ejen Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO), bagi menuntut insentif berkenaan.

Tertuduh didakwa memperdaya PERKESO dengan mengemukakan semua dokumen yang mengandungi butiran palsu, iaitu tujuh individu yang dinamakan

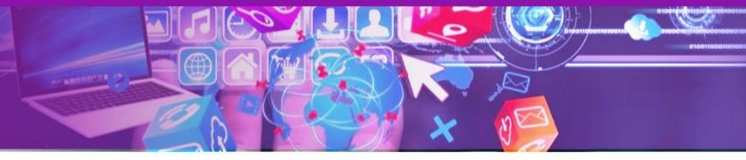
dalam dokumen itu bukan pekerja Aisy Maju Abadi Trading.

Dia dituduh melakukan semua perbuatan itu di Pejabat PERKESO, Jalan Teluk Wanjah di sini pada 22 Jun 2021, mengikut Seksyen 18 Akta Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM) 2009 dan boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 24 akta sama.

Seksyen itu membawa hukuman penjara maksimum 20 tahun dan denda tidak kurang lima kali nilai butir palsu itu atau RM10,000 mengikut mana lebih tinggi, jika sabit kesalahan.

Hakim Rohatul Akmar Abdullah membenarkan tertuduh yang kini berniaga kecil-kecilan, diikat jamin RM10,000 bagi semua pertuduhan dan menetapkan sebutan semula kes pada 5 Disember.

Hakim sebak baca hukuman

Ibu tunggal
aniaya, abaikan

Johor Bahru: Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam, menjatuhkan hukuman penjara 14 tahun ke atas seorang ibu tunggal dan rakan serumah atas dua pertuduhan menganiaya serta mengabaikan anak kandungnya pada Ogos lalu.

Hakim VM Mabel Sheela menjatuhkan hukuman itu terhadap ibu tunggal, Nurul Asyiqin Mohamad Zahid, 27, dan rakan serumahnya, Awiin Chua, 30, selepas ditangguhkan pada 10 Oktober lalu kerana beliau cuti sakit.

Nurul Asyiqin dan Awiin masing-masing dihukum penjara tujuh tahun bagi setiap pertuduhan berkenaan. Bagaimanapun, mahkamah memerintahkan hukuman bagi kedua-dua pertuduhan itu berjalan serentak bermula dari tarikh tangkapan pada 12 Ogos lalu.

Mabel Sheela dalam penghakimannya, sebak ketika membayangkan penderitaan kanak-kanak lelaki berusia tujuh tahun itu yang didera dalam tempoh sebulan.

"Pertalian ibu dan anak adalah sangat istimewa. Kalau awak (merujuk kepada ibu mangsa) tanya anak, adakah dia mahu mengikut awak, pasti dia akan mahu ikut, walaupun tahu akan merasa sakit.

"Mahkamah tidak boleh membayangkan keadaan mangsa jika

keadaan berlarutan lebih lama dan tidak dibantu orang awam, pastinya mangsa akan meninggal dunia," katanya sebak.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Nur Diyana Zubir, manakala kedua-dua tertuduh diwakili peguam, Nurhazneena Zureen Jaesleen Mohamad Hanafiah.

20 kecederaan fizikal

Dalam penghujahannya, Nur Diyana memaklumkan terdapat lebih 20 kecederaan fizikal pada tubuh mangsa berdasarkan hasil pemeriksaan pakar perubatan.

Tempoh penderaan terhadap mangsa selama sebulan yang mana kedua-dua tertuduh mempunyai penjagaan terhadapnya

kerana kanak-kanak itu tinggal bersama mereka.

"Kekerapan setiap hari sejak 1 Julai hingga 9 Ogos lalu berdasarkan pengesahan luka lama dan baru serta parut tubuh badan mangsa dalam laporan perubatan.

"Mangsa bukan saja dipukul tetapi turut diabaikan dengan mangsa ditinggalkan keseorangan, dikunci di rumah tanpa makanan, serta tidak menghalang atau menyelamatkan mangsa apabila dipukul," katanya.

Mengikut kertas pertuduhan pertama, kedua-dua tertuduh didakwa mencapai niat bersama menganiaya seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia tujuh tahun bawah pemeliharaan mereka

sehingga menyebabkan mangsa mengalami kecederaan fizikal.

Bagi pertuduhan kedua, mereka didakwa mencapai niat bersama mengabaikan kanak-kanak yang juga anak kedua ibu tunggal itu ketika mangsa bawah pemeliharaan mereka.

Kedua-dua perbuatan itu didakwa dilakukan di sebuah rumah dekat Jalan Wau Kikik 7, Bandar Layangkasa, Pasir Gudang, di sini, antara 1 Julai hingga 9 Ogos lalu.

Pendakwaan kedua-dua pertuduhan itu dibuat mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman denda hingga RM50,000 atau penjara maksimum 20 tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Terdahulu, kedua-dua tertuduh yang tiba di pekarangan mahkamah pada jam 9 pagi semalam dilihat tenang dan bersedia menerima hukuman yang bakal dijatuhkan hakim terhadap mereka.

Pada 16 Ogos lalu, ibu tunggal itu dan Awiin yang juga wanita berperwatakan lelaki, mengaku tidak bersalah selepas pertuduhan dibacakan jurubahasa mahkamah di hadapan Hakim Fatimah Zahari.

Bagaimanapun, pada 27 September lalu, kedua-dua mereka memukar pengakuan kepada bersalah, selepas pertuduhan terhadap mereka dibacakan semula oleh jurubahasa mahkamah di hadapan Mabel Sheela.

Awal Ogos lalu, media melaporkan seorang kanak-kanak lelaki disyaki menjadi mangsa dera kepada dua wanita yang mana seorang daripadanya adalah ibu kandungnya.

Kejadian menimpa kanak-kanak itu terbongkar selepas jiran menyerbu rumah diduduki dua beranak itu bersama kenalan ibu mangsa.

Kenaikan kos sara hidup jejas kesihatan ibu, bayi

Kuala Lumpur: Peningkatan kos sara hidup terutama akibat kenaikan harga barang keperluan asas, menyebabkan sebilangan ibu bapa terpaksa mendapatkan makanan murah yang kurang atau tiada nutrisi, sekali gus dikhuatiri memberi kesan terhadap tahap kesihatan wanita hamil dan kemungkinan bayi dilahirkan mengalami masalah bantut.

Timbalan Menteri Kesihatan, Datuk Lukanisman Awang Sauni, berkata beliau bimbang dengan perubahan gaya hidup ibu bapa sekarang yang terkesan dengan kenaikan kos sara hidup.

“Saya juga bimbang dengan keadaan harga, kos kehidupan semakin meningkat, seperti barang keperluan yang mempunyai nutrisi apabila harganya meningkat.

“Ini menyebabkan ibu bapa memilih mendapatkan makanan

murah dan ibu hamil juga tidak mengambil nutrisi terbaik bagi memastikan anak dilahirkan sihat serta tidak berbantut.

“Bantut ini memberikan kesan agak besar kerana anak yang bantut lebih terdedah dengan penyakit seperti obesiti. Ini juga menyebabkan produktiviti tumbesaran anak terjejas.

“Jika kumpulan kanak-kanak ramai terbantut, produktiviti negara pada masa depan juga terjejas untuk mengeluarkan hasil terbaik kepada negara,” katanya pada sesi soal jawab di Dewan Rakyat, semalam.

Beliau menjawab soalan tambahan dikemukakan Datuk Seri Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad (PH-Kuala Selangor) mengenai sejauh mana ukuran kumpulan yang agak terpinggir supaya kerajaan dapat menangani masalah bantut dengan baik.

Lukanisman turut mendedah-

kan ada pengusaha kantin di sekolah tertentu menyediakan menu sosej dan nasi melalui program Rancangan Makanan Tambahan (RMT) sedangkan murid terbabit sepatutnya disajikan makanan sihat dan berkhasiat.

Beliau berkata, isu nutrisi bukan saja dihadapi keluarga B40, malah turut berlaku dalam kalangan keluarga T20 sehingga terdapat anak daripada golongan isi rumah berkenaan mengalami masalah bantut.

“Saya setuju masalah bantut bukan saja tertumpu kepada golongan B40. Dalam rekod kami pada lima tahun lalu, masalah bantut berlaku di tiga negeri tertinggi seperti Kelantan dan Putrajaya termasuk dalam senarai tiga teratas.

“Populasi Putrajaya kebanyakan golongan berpendidikan tetapi mereka ini juga mengambil langkah mudah kerana kesibu-

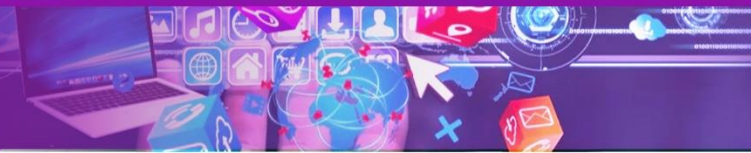

kan dan pembinaan kerjaya lebih meluas. Jadi dari segi pemilihan, makanan segera sering diberi kepada anak mereka,” katanya.

Susulan itu, beliau menyarankan ibu bapa meluangkan masa memasak bersama-sama dan anak lebih tertarik kepada makanan mengandungi nutrisi.

Kes buli di sekolah semakin meningkat

KPM sedia pelbagai platform salur aduan, kerjasama atasi isu

Kuala Lumpur: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) mendedahkan jumlah kes buli di sekolah terus melonjak tahun ini berbanding dua tahun lalu dengan 4,994 kes direkodkan setakat bulan lalu.

Timbalan Menteri Pendidikan, Lim Hui Ying, berkata kes buli bagi 2021 lebih rendah disebabkan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) bagi menangani gelombang COVID-19.

"Berdasarkan data Sistem Sahsiah Diri Murid (SSDM) KPM bagi tempoh tiga tahun, sejumlah 326 kes direkodkan pada 2021, manakala 3,887 kes pada 2022.

"Bagaimanapun, bagi 2023 sehingga bulan lalu, sebanyak 4,994 kes direkodkan dan siasatan sudah dijalankan bagi semua kes itu dan tindakan susulan diambil terutama dari segi bimbingan serta kaunseling," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian keti-

ka menjawab soalan tambahan Datuk Muhammad Bakhtiar Wan Chik (PH-Balik Pulau) yang ingin tahu jumlah keseluruhan kes buli direkodkan sepanjang tahun dan apakah langkah diambil KPM bagi menanganinya.

Mengulas lanjut, Hui Ying berkata, bagi menangani gejala buli di sekolah, ia memerlukan pembabitian menyeluruh pelbagai pihak termasuk ibu bapa, pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) dan komuniti setempat.

Jawatankuasa Anti Buli

Pada masa sama, katanya, kementerian mewujudkan Jawatankuasa Anti Buli di setiap jabatan pendidikan negeri bagi menangani gejala berkenaan.

"Antara inisiatif KPM termasuk mengeratkan hubungan murid dan guru melalui amalan guru penyayang di sekolah. Ia bertujuan menerapkan budaya penyayang dalam kalangan guru dan murid di sekolah, sekali gus meningkatkan hubungan

antara keduanya.

"Selain itu, KPM turut mengadakan kerjasama erat dengan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) melalui pegawai perhubungan sekolah (PPS).

"Ada seorang PPS di setiap sekolah yang mendampingi dan bekerjasama dengan pihak sekolah termasuk mengadakan program berkaitan buli, malah PPS juga akan melaporkan kes buli kepada KPM," katanya.

Hui Ying berkata, KPM turut mempelbagaikan platform aduan buli bagi membolehkan murid, ibu bapa dan orang awam membuat aduan terus kepada KPM dengan maklumat disalurkan itu adalah dilindungi.

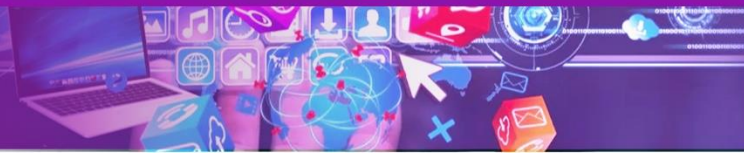
"Ada empat saluran utama untuk aduan buli iaitu menerusi Sistem Pengurusan Aduan Awam (SISPA), e-mel, talian telefon dan aplikasi WhatsApp.

"KPM juga tidak menolak untuk menambah guru kaunseling jika kes buli di sekolah terus meningkat," katanya.

Mengaku tak bersalah buat hantaran ugut bunuh bekas PM

Ampang: Seorang pembantu klinik di Singapura didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen semalam kerana membuat kenyataan jelik membabitkan pembunuhan bekas Perdana Menteri, Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, menerusi Facebook.

Bagaimanapun, Tai Zee Zing, 31, mengaku tidak bersalah sejurus pertuduhan dikemuka di hadapan Hakim, Wan Mohd Norisham Wan Yaakob.

Mengikut pertuduhan, wanita itu didapati menggunakan Facebook melalui profil 'Penny Tai' secara sedar membuat dan memulakan penghantaran komunikasi jelik, iaitu *Can hired killer to kill new Prime Minister?* (Boleh mengupah pembunuh untuk bunuh Perdana Menteri baharu?) dengan niat menyakitkan hati orang lain.

Kesalahan di Balai Polis Ampang, Ampang, jam 12.35 tengah hari, 1 Mac 2020, mengikut Seksyen 233(1)(a)(i) Akta Komunikasi dan Multimedia 1998 yang boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 233(3) akta sama.

Seksyen terbabit memperuntukkan denda tidak lebih RM50,000 atau penjara maksimum setahun atau kedua-duanya dan boleh didenda selanjutnya RM1,000 bagi setiap hari kesalahan diteruskan selepas sabitan, jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Susulan pengakuan tidak bersalah itu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Hakim Amir Abdul Hamid, mencadangkan jaminan RM20,000 terhadap tertuduh yang disifatkan sebagai munasabah dengan seorang penjamin.

"Syarat tambahan melaporkan diri di balai polis berdekatan setiap bulan dan pasport diserahkan kepada mahkamah," katanya.

Bagaimanapun, peguam bela Zee Zing, Rajsurlan Pillai, berkata cadangan jaminan terlalu tinggi.

"Anak guam bujang dan kerja di klinik dengan gaji RM3,000 sebulan, selain perlu menyara ibu bapa.

"Adik tertuduh yang juga peguam hadir untuk menjadi penjamin. Saya turut membantah syarat tambahan kerana anak guam sedang melanjutkan pelajaran di Singapura dalam Diploma Pengurusan Perniagaan," katanya.

Hakim membenarkan jaminan RM10,000 dengan seorang penjamin, namun tidak menetapkan sebarang syarat tambahan memandangkan tertuduh sedang melanjutkan pelajaran di Singapura.

Sebutan semula kes ditetapkan pada 20 Disember.

Wanita maut disyaki dilanggar, ditikam rakan kongsi

Ketua Polis Terengganu, Datuk Mazli Mazlan, berkata siasatan awal mendapati mangsa dipercayai dilanggar suspek wanita

yang juga rakan kongsinya berusia 35 tahun.

Beliau berkata, mangsa dan suspek sebelum itu menaiki kenderaan jenis Honda Jazz dan berlaku pertengkaran antara mereka.

Katanya, mangsa dikatakan turun daripada kereta itu sebelum dilanggar suspek dan tercampak ke dalam longkang.

"Suspek kemudian keluar dari kenderaan itu dan bertindak menikam mangsa sebelum meninggalkan lokasi dengan menumpang sebuah van.

"Suspek kemudian berjaya ditahan di rumahnya di Wakaf Tapai, Marang kira-kira jam 11 pagi," katanya pada sidang media, di Ibu Pejabat Polis Kontinjen Terengganu, di sini semalam.

Mazli berkata, berdasarkan siasatan awal, polis percaya kejadian berpunca daripada rasa tidak puas hati berhubung agihan keuntungan perniagaan pakaian dan tudung yang diusahakan mereka sejak lima tahun lalu.

Beliau berkata, pihaknya turut merampas sebilah pisau pemotong

daging yang dibuang suspek berhampiran rumahnya.

"Kereta Honda Jazz yang ditinggalkan di lokasi kejadian adalah milik suami suspek dan selepas kejadian itu, suspek dikatakan menahan kenderaan yang melalui kawasan berkenaan untuk pulang ke rumahnya.

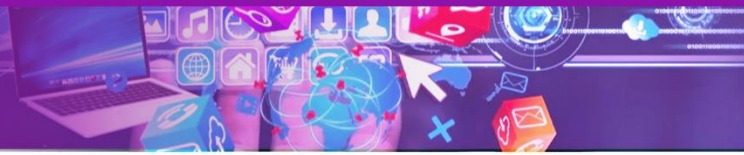
"Mayat mangsa dibawa ke Hospital Hulu Terengganu sebelum dipindahkan ke Hospital Sultanah Nur Zahirah Kuala Terengganu untuk bedah siasat.

"Suspek akan dibawa ke

mahkamah bagi mendapatkan perintah reman dan kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan," katanya.

4,994 kes buli di sekolah setakat Oktober

Kuala Lumpur: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) mendedahkan jumlah kes buli di sekolah terus melonjak dengan 4,994 kes direkodkan setakat Oktober tahun ini.

Angka itu menunjukkan peningkatan kes salah laku buli di sekolah berbanding 2021 dan tahun lalu.

Timbalan Menteri Pendidikan Lim Hui Ying berkata, kes buli bagi 2021 lebih rendah disebabkan pelaksanaan Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) bagi menangani gelombang Covid-19.

"Berdasarkan data Sistem Sahsia Diri Murid (SSDM) KPM bagi tempoh tiga tahun, 326 kes direkodkan pada 2021.

"Bagi tahun lalu, sebanyak 3,887 kes direkodkan dan untuk tahun ini, sehingga Oktober lalu, 4,994 kes direkodkan.

"Siasatan sudah dijalankan bagi semua kes ini dan tindakan susulan turut sudah diambil, terutama daripada segi bimbingan dan kaunseling," katanya.

Beliau menjawab soalan tambahan **Datuk Muhammad Bakhtiar Wan Chik (PH-Balik Pulau)** yang in-

gin tahu jumlah keseluruhan kes buli yang direkodkan sepanjang tahun dan apa langkah diambil KPM bagi menanganinya.

Mengulas lanjut, Hui Ying berkata, bagi menangani gejala buli di sekolah, ia memerlukan pembabitatan menyeluruh pelbagai pihak termasuk ibu bapa, pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) dan komuniti setempat.

Pada masa sama, katanya, kementerian sudah mewujudkan Jawatankuasa Anti Buli di setiap Jabatan Pendidikan Negeri bagi menangani gejala berkenaan.

"Antara inisiatif KPM termasuk mengeratkan hubungan murid dan guru melalui amalan guru penyayang di sekolah. Ia bertujuan menerapkan budaya penyayang dalam kalangan

guru dan murid di sekolah, sekali gus meningkatkan hubungan antara keduanya.

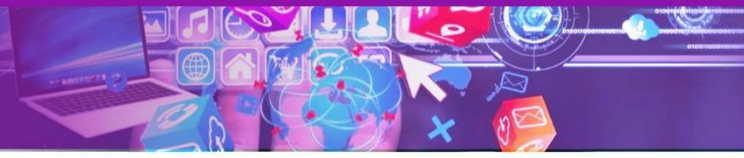
"Selain itu, KPM turut mengadakan kerjasama erat dengan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) melalui pegawai perhubungan sekolah (PPS)

"Ada seorang PPS di setiap sekolah yang mendampingi dan bekerjasama dengan pihak sekolah termasuk mengadakan program berkaitan buli, malah PPS juga akan melaporkan kes buli kepada KPM," katanya.

Tambahnya, KPM turut mempelbagaikan platform bagi aduan buli bagi membolehkan murid, ibu bapa dan orang awam membuat aduan terus kepada kementerian itu dengan maklumat disalurkan itu adalah dilindungi.

"Ada empat saluran utama untuk aduan buli iaitu menerusi Sistem Pengurusan Aduan Awam (Sispa), e-mel, talian telefon dan aplikasi WhatsApp.

"KPM juga tidak menolak untuk menambah guru kaunseling sekiranya kes buli di sekolah terus meningkat," katanya.

Johor Bahru: Remaja bawah umur antara lapan lelaki yang ditahan polis kerana melakukan khianat dengan api, menyimbah cat dan ugut mangsa ceti haram di negeri ini.

Ketua Polis Johor, Datuk Kamarul Zaman Mamat berkata, suspek berusia 16 hingga 43 tahun itu ditahan menerusi beberapa siri serbuan di Kota Tinggi, Seri Alam dan Segamat antara 22 hingga 25 Oktober lalu.

Beliau berkata, siasatan mendapati kumpulan samseng upahan itu aktif sejak Ogos lalu dan mendapat upah RM600 untuk melakukan khianat simbah cat manakala RM1,000 sebagai upahan melakukan khianat

dengan api.

"Mereka melakukan gangguan berkenaan terhadap mangsa yang gagal melangsaikan pinjaman dengan ceti haram.

"Hasil serbuan polis berjaya merampas barangan termasuk 15 telefon bimbit, tong cat warna merah, tin semburan cat warna hitam, nota ugutan, sarung tangan dan topeng plastik.

"Turut dirampas sebuah kereta Perodua Bezza, sebuah Proton Saga," katanya dalam sidang media di Ibu Pejabat Polis Kontinjen (IPK) Johor di sini, semalam.

Terdahulu beliau menyaksikan Majlis Pemaka-

Kamarul Zaman berkata, menerusi tangkapan berkenaan, polis berjaya menyelesaikan 45 kes berkaitan di Johor Bahru, Iskandar Puteri, Kulai, Kluang, Seri Alam, Kota Tinggi, Muar, Pontian, Batu Pahat dan Segamat manakala empat kes di Melaka dan satu kes di Negeri Sembilan.

Beliau berkata, modus operandi sindiket berkenaan adalah mengiklankan tawaran pinjaman di laman sosial Facebook (FB) dengan menggunakan ayat pinjaman wang berlesen Singapura bagi memperdaya mangsa.

Menurutnya, apabila pe-

minjam memberi maklumat peribadi berkaitan akaun bank dan alamat tempat tinggal, sindiket akan memasukkan wang ke dalam akaun peminjam tanpa memperoleh persetujuan peminjam.

"Kemudian sindiket akan memaksa peminjam untuk membuat bayaran dengan mengenakan kadar faedah yang dan sekiranya tidak akur, mereka akan menggunakan orang suruhan bagi melakukan perbuatan khianat.

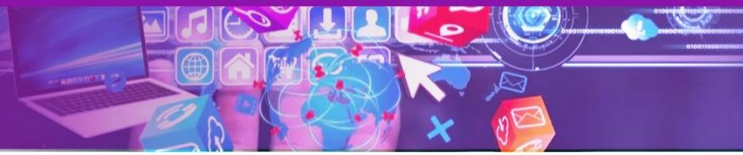
"Hasil siasatan kebanyakannya mangsa adalah dalam kalangan warga tempatan yang bekerja di Singapura.

"Apabila mereka gagal membayar pinjaman, ru-

mah keluarga di negara ini menjadi mangsa simbah cat dan khianat," katanya.

Kamarul Zaman berkata, bagi kes khianat simbah cat kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 427 Kanun Keseksamaan dan jika disabit kesalahan boleh dikenakan hukuman penjara selama tempoh tidak kurang daripada setahun dan tidak melebihi lima tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya.

"Manakala bagi khianat dengan api, kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 435 Kanun Keseksamaan dan jika disabit kesalahan boleh dikenakan hukuman penjara sehingga 14 tahun dan denda," katanya.

Hakim VM Mabel Sheela menjatuhkan hukuman terhadap ibu tunggal berusia 27 tahun itu dan rakan serumahnya, Awiin Chua, 30, semalam selepas ditangguhkan pada 10 Oktober lalu kerana beliau cuti sakit.

Mabel Sheela menjatuhkan hukuman penjara tujuh tahun bagi setiap pertuduhan dan memerintahkan kedua-dua wanita itu menjalani hukuman penjara serentak bermula dari tarikh tangkap pada 12 Ogos lalu.

Mengikut pertuduhan pertama, kedua-dua tertuduh didakwa menganiaya seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia tujuh tahun yang di bawah pemeliharaan mereka sehingga menyebabkan mangsa menghadapi kecederaan fizikal.

Bagi pertuduhan kedua, mereka didakwa secara bersama mengabaikan kanak-kanak berkenaan. Kedua-dua perbuatan itu didakwa dilakukan di sebuah rumah di Jalan Wau Kikik 7, Bandar Layangkasa, Pasir Gudang di sini, antara 1 Julai hingga 9 Ogos lalu.

Pertuduhan dibuat mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman denda sehingga RM50,000 atau penjara maksimum 20 tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Terdahulu, dalam penghakimannya, Mabel Sheela

"Mahkamah tidak boleh membayangkan keadaan mangsa jika keadaan berlarutan lebih lama dan tidak dibantu orang awam, pastinya mangsa akan meninggal dunia," katanya.

Pendakwa dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Nur Diyana Zubir. Kedua-dua tertuduh diwakili Peguam, Nurhazneena

Zureen Jaesleen Mohamad Hanafiah.

Sementara itu, dalam pengujahan Nur Diyana memaklumkan terdapat lebih 20 kecederaan fizikal di tubuh mangsa berdasarkan pemeriksaan dilakukan pakar perubatan.

Katanya, berdasarkan kepada pengesahan luka lama

dan baru serta parut tubuh dalam laporan perubatan, mangsa didera setiap hari sejak 1 Julai hingga 9 Ogos lalu.

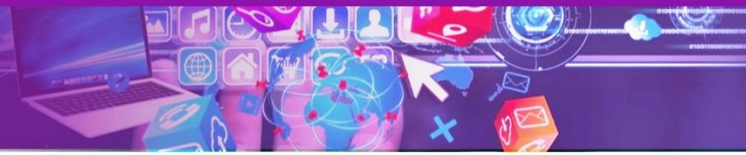
"Mangsa bukan sahaja dipukul tetapi turut diabaikan dengan ditinggalkan keseorangan, kunci di rumah tanpa makanan serta tidak menghalang atau menyelamatkan mangsa apabila dipukul," katanya.

Kejadian menimpa kanak-kanak itu terbongkar selepas jiran menyerbu rumah diduduki dua beranak itu bersama kenalan ibu mangsa yang juga wanita berperwatakan lelaki.

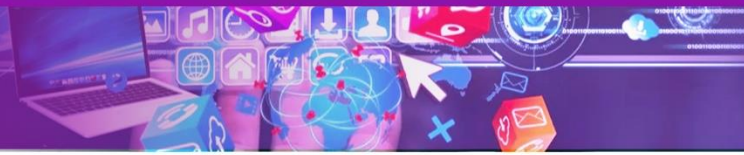

Hanya mata berkelip tanda masih bernafas

Tumpat: Keadaan isteri yang jatuh sakit dan terlanjar secara tiba-tiba menimbulkan tanda tanya buat Wan Anuar Wan Ibrahim.

Ketika ini, Maimon Othman, 44, kaku tidak bergerak sejak tiga bulan lalu, sebaliknya hanya mata berkelip menandakan ibu kepada empat cahaya mata itu masih bernafas.

Wan Anuar, 47, dari Kampung Baru Nelayan, di sini, berkata sebelum ini isterinya hanya mengalami sempit dan dibawa ke Hospital Kelaboran, di sini, bagi rawatan, tetapi gagal meredakan sesak nafasnya.

"Isteri kemudian diberi suntikan ubat dan tidak lama kemudian dia akan-akan kejang dan saya dimaklumkan degupan jantungnya berhenti seketika sebelum segera dirujuk ke Hospital Raja Perempuan Zainab II (HRPZ II), Kota Bharu menaiki ambulans.

"Di dalam kenderaan itu, jantung isteri sekali lagi terhenti dan sebaik tiba di HRPZ II, dia terus dimasukkan ke Unit Rawatan Rapi (ICU) dan dirawat selama lebih sebulan," katanya ketika ditemui di rumahnya, semalam.

Terdahulu, mereka menerima kunjungan Kelab Kebajikan Cakna Kelantan (KKCK) yang turut memberikan kati wakaf untuk kegunaan Maimon.

Wan Anuar berkata, ketika menerima rawatan di ICU, jantung isterinya sekali lagi kritikal sebelum kembali normal dan se-

hingga kini dia tidak pasti apa punca yang menimpa Maimon.

Dia sebelum ini bekerja sebagai pemandu lori terpaksa berhenti kerja bagi menguruskan isterinya kerana dua anaknya baru sahaja memulakan kerja, manakala dua lagi berusia tujuh serta 15 tahun masih bersekolah.

"Saya tidak boleh meninggalkan isteri bersendirian kerana selain kerap kejang otot, Maimon juga perlu disedut kahak dan jika lambat berbuat demikian, dibimbangi akan memudaratkannya.

"Sebab itu saya terpaksa meninggalkan kerja yang selama ini menjadi sumber pendapatan kerana perlu memberi perhatian penuh kepada isteri," katanya sambil memberitahu doktor tidak dapat memberi jaminan bahawa isterinya akan kembali pulih.

Wan Anuar berkata, wang simpanan sudah habis digunakan untuk perbelanjaan harian, persekolahan anak, kos ubat dan susu serta lampin pakai buang isterinya, termasuk membayar sewa rumah sebanyak RM150 sebulan.

Menurutnya, dia masih "berhutang" dengan pihak hospital kira-kira RM7,000 untuk kos rawatan isteri dan buntu memikirkan bagaimana caranya untuk melunaskan bayaran itu.

Sementara itu, seorang saksi yang enggan dikenali berkata, dia yang berada di kawasan berhampiran ada mendengar suara wanita menjerit meminta tolong.

"Tidak berapa lama kemudian, saya ternampak kelibat seorang wanita di tepi jalan dan dilanggar sebuah kereta sehingga terjatuh ke dalam longkang.

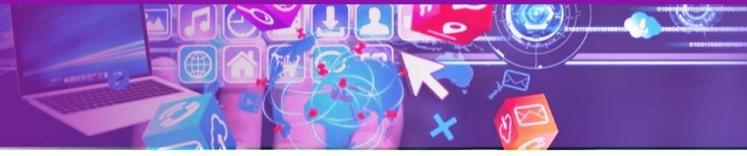

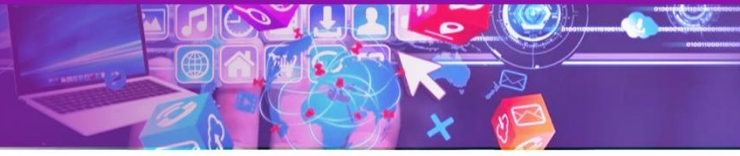

9,207 school bullying cases recorded since 2021

A TOTAL of 9,207 bullying cases were recorded in schools from 2021 to last month, the Dewan Rakyat was told yesterday.

Deputy Education Minister Lim Hui Ying said of the total, 326 cases were reported in 2021, followed by 3,887 cases in 2022, and 4,994 cases from January to last month.

All the cases, she said, had been investigated, with follow-up action given, especially in terms of guidance and counselling.

“Bullying cases, or social issues, involve various parties, not just parents. The involvement of non-governmental organisations and the community is also necessary. The ministry’s goal is to ensure that bullying cases can be reduced, especially by providing guidance to bullies and those being bullied.”

She said this in a response to Datuk Muhammad Bakhtiar Wan Chik (Pakatan Harapan-Balik Pulau).

In his supplementary question, Bakhtiar asked about the number of bullying cases in schools.

In reply to another supplementary question from Dr Ahmad Fakhruddin Fakhruddin (Perikatan Nasional-Kuala Kedah), Lim said the ministry would increase the number of guidance and counselling teachers, should there be an increase in bullying cases.

“This is because those involved (the bullies and those being bul-

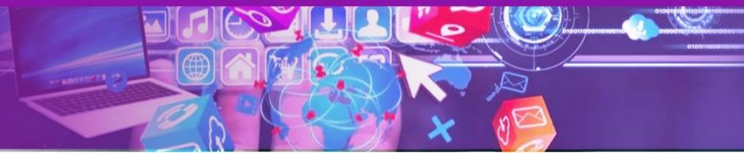
lied) need guidance. So counselling is essential.”

Earlier, in a reply to the initial question from Bakhtiar, Lim said the ministry had launched the seven core pillars of Nadi Keunggulan KPM.

“Through the second core, the ministry emphasises human dignity by instilling good manners, morals and integrity in students, while creating a harmonious environment that avoids negative phenomena, such as sexual harassment, bullying, extremism, gangsterism, and vandalism.”

Bakhtiar had asked about efforts taken by the ministry to fight rampant bullying.

Lim said complaint boxes had been set up in schools and hostels, along with strengthening school and hostel discipline committees. Others include taking action against and punishing students who engage in bullying in schools and hostels.”

PENJANA KERJAYA PROGRAMME

Company owner claims trial to submitting false claims

KUALA LUMPUR: A company owner was charged in the Sessions Court in Kedah with submitting false documents to the Social Security Organisation (Socso) to claim incentives under the Penjana Kerjaya 2.0 (Penjana) programme amounting to RM337,400 two years ago.

Nur Kesuma Kartini Mohamad Zahir, 41, however, pleaded not guilty when the charges were read to her before judge Rohatul Akmar Abdullah yesterday.

She was charged with seven counts under Section 18 of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009 for submitting the Employee Verification Form under the programme containing false details to a Socso agent.

She faces a maximum of 20

years' imprisonment and a fine of not less than five times the value of the false information, or RM10,000, whichever is higher.



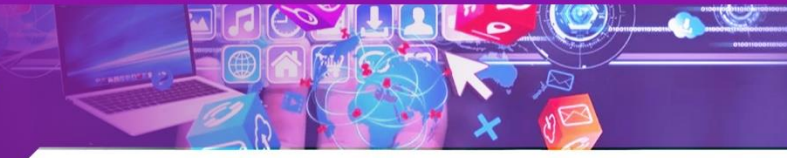

The accused also pleaded not guilty to an alternative charge under Section 471 of the Penal Code of using false documents as genuine and faced imprisonment for up to two years, or a fine or both, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor S. Sujatha appeared for the prosecution while the accused was unrepresented.

The court also ordered the accused to surrender her passport and report to the nearest MACC office monthly.

The court then set RM10,000 bail with one surety and fixed Dec 5 for mention.

ONE MONTH OF TERROR

Judge cries when sentencing mum, housemate for child abuse

JOHOR BARU: A visibly upset Sessions Court judge handed down a 14-year prison sentence on a single mother and her housemate after they were convicted of two counts of abusing and neglecting her child in August.

Judge V.M. Mabel Sheela sentenced the mother, 27, and her housemate, Awiin Chua, 30, after the hearing was postponed from Oct 10 as she was on sick leave.

When the judge was giving her judgment, she became emotional and teared up as she recounted the suffering the abused 7-year-old boy endured for a month.

"The relationship between mother and child is very special. If you (the victim's mother) ask your child if he wants to follow you, he will definitely want to follow, even if he knows it will hurt.

"The court cannot imagine the condition the victim would have been in if the situation had lasted longer, had the public not intervened. The victim would have died," she said.

In her submission prior to sentencing, deputy public prosecutor Nur Diyana Zubir said there were more than 20 physical injuries on the victim's body, a medical examination showed.

She said the two accused abused the victim for a month when they lived together.

"The frequency (of abuse) was every day, from July 1 to Aug 9, based on the confirmation of old and new wounds and scars on the victim's body in the medical report.

"The victim was not only beaten, but also neglected. He was left

alone, locked in the house without food. There were efforts to save the victim when he was beaten."

The accused were represented by lawyer Nurhazneena Zureen Jaesleen Mohamad Hanafiah.

After taking into account the prosecution's submissions, Mabel Sheela sentenced the accused to seven years' jail for the first and second charges.

The court ordered the two accused to serve their jail terms concurrently from the date of their arrest on Aug 12.

For the first charge, the two were accused of achieving the common intention of persecuting a 7-year-old boy under their care, causing the victim to suffer physical injury.

For the second charge, they were alleged to have achieved the

common intention of neglecting the child, who is the second child of the single mother, when the victim was under their care.

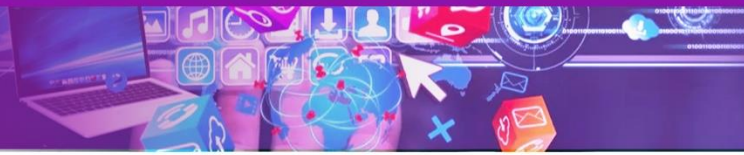
The offences were allegedly committed in a house near Jalan Wau Kikik 7, Bandar Layangkasa, Pasir Gudang here, between July 1 and Aug 9.

The charges were framed under Section 31(1)(a) of the Children Act 2001, read with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which carries a fine of up to RM50,000 or up to 20 years' jail, or both, if convicted.

On Aug 16, the single mother and her housemate pleaded not guilty to the charges.

On Sept 27, the two changed their pleas to guilty.

The boy's abuse came to light after some neighbours "raided" the house they were living in.

Clinic assistant charged with making offensive statement against Muhyiddin

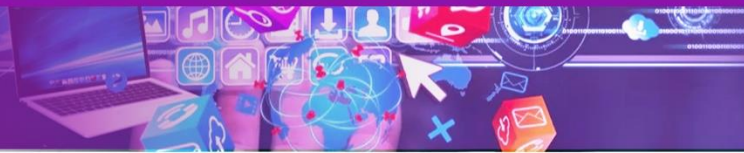
The accused, currently pursuing a diploma in Singapore, is alleged to have committed the offence on March 1, 2020.

She was charged under

Section 223(1)(a)(ii) of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998, punishable under Section 233(3) of the same Act, and faces a maximum fine of RM50,000 or imprisonment for up to a year, or both, for each charge, and can also be fined a further RM1,000 for each day the offence has continued, if found guilty.

Judge Wan Norisham Wan Yaakob set bail at RM10,000 in one surety and fixed Dec 20 for mention.

Deputy Public Prosecutor Hakim Amir Abdul Hamid prosecuted, while lawyer Rajsurian Pillai represented the accused. — Bernama

DoSM: Children under 18 make up 27.4 pct of Malaysia's population

KUALA LUMPUR: The number of children in Malaysia under the age of 18 in 2023 is estimated to be 9.13 million, which accounts for 27.4 per cent of the country's total population of 33.38 million.

Chief Statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin said based on the Children Statistics, Malaysia 2023 published by the Department of Statistics (DoSM) yesterday, the number of boys and girls under 18 is 4.72 million and 4.42 million, respectively.

"The composition of children under five years old in 2023 is 2.35 million, with 1.21 million boys and 1.14 million girls.

"This group covers 25.7 per cent of the total number of children in Malaysia," he said in a statement.

According to Mohd Uzir, the Putrajaya recorded the highest percentage of children under 18 in 2023 with 41.1 per cent of the population, followed by Kelantan (34.4 per cent) and Terengganu (33.5 per cent).

Kuala Lumpur recorded the lowest percentage at 22.6 per cent.

"However, Selangor recorded

the highest number of children under 18 at 1.81 million, followed by Johor (1.11 million) and Sabah (1.1 million).

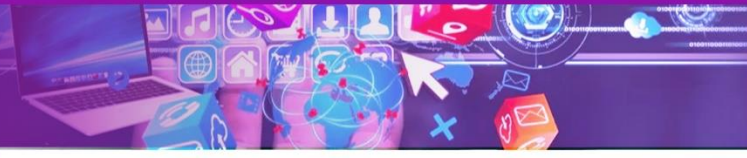
"The lowest number of children under 18 was recorded in Labuan at 0.03 million," he said.

The statistics also indicate that children under the age of five experiencing severe malnutrition increased slightly to 0.3 per cent in 2022 compared to 0.2 per cent in 2021.

In terms of education, the number of pupils in government and government-aided schools in 2022 was 4.96 million, an increase of 0.6 per cent from 4.93 million in the previous year.

During the same period, the number of pupils in private schools dropped by 1.2 per cent to 0.42 million from 0.43 million, he added.

From the child protection perspective, the number of children needing care and protection in 2022 increased by 10.2 per cent to 6,770 persons (4,303 girls, 2,467 boys) compared to 6,144 persons in 2021. — Bernama

managed to raise some funds from generous members of the public.

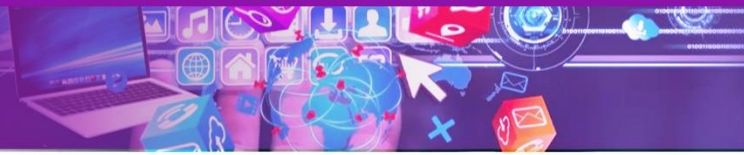

screening procedures provided by several of its healthcare facilities.

"Individuals should be cautious about any lump in the breast or underarm (armpit), thickening or swelling on any part of the breast, skin irritation or dimpling, redness or flakiness around the nipple area or the breast, nipple inversion, pain in the nipple area, unusual nipple discharge that may include blood.

"Changes in breast size or shape and unexplained breast pain should also be regarded as warning signs," said KPJ Perdana Specialist Hospital Consultant Radiologist, Dr Nik Munirah Nik Mahdi.

Meanwhile, Sunway Medical

Centre in Sunway City Consultant Breast and Endocrine Surgeon, Dr Normayah Kitan said doing regular breast self-examination is crucial to detect symptoms such as lumps, pain, or abnormal changes in size.

"In addition to this, a clinical breast examination and screening every year should be done even if you do not detect any abnormalities, as breast cancer often does not present any symptoms at its earliest, which is the most treatable stage," she said.

Penjana Kerjaya: Company owner claims trial to submitting false documents to Socso

ALOR SETAR: A company owner pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court here yesterday to seven charges of submitting false documents to the Social Security Organisation (Socso) to claim for incentives amounting to RM24,500 under the Penjana Kerjaya 2.0 programme two years ago.

Nur Kesuma Kartini Mohamad Zahir, 41, was charged with submitting seven Employee Verification Forms containing false details of seven individuals, who were not employees of Aisy Maju Abadi Trading, to Socso in an attempt to claim the incentives under the programme.

She allegedly committed the offence at the Socso office in Jalan Teluk Wanjah here on June 22, 2021.

Each of the charges under Section 18 of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009 carries an imprisonment of up to 20 years and a fine of not less than five times the value of the false information or RM10,000 whichever is higher, if convicted.

Judge Rohatul Akmar Abdullah allowed the accused bail of RM10,000 for all charges and set Dec 5 for remention. — Bernama

SIBU: Roland Jimbai, 49, could not hold back his tears when he learnt that Raja Permaisuri Agong Tunku Azizah Aminah Maimunah Iskandariah would 'adopt' his daughter Missclyen. The two-year-old was born with congenital generalised hypertrichosis, an extremely

rare condition that causes excessive facial and upper body hair, which is more commonly known as 'werewolf syndrome'.

When contacted by Utusan Borneo yesterday, Roland said a letter dated Oct 10, 2023 from Istana Negara was delivered by Minister of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah in Bintulu on Tuesday

night.

"When I opened the letter last night, I was so happy that I cried," he revealed.

"I did not expect that our brief meeting during the Kembara Kenali Borneo programme that day had attracted the attention of Her Majesty to the extent of taking Missclyen as her 'adopted' child."

The letter from Istana Negara pledged to pay for Missclyen's school expenses as well as medical treatment for her condition.

It also stated that the Queen hoped the assistance would help relieve Roland's financial burdens in raising and taking care of Missclyen.

Roland revealed that he does various jobs to make ends meet.

Hailing from Sangan, Tatau in Bintulu, he and his wife Theresa Guntin have one son and three girls, with Missclyen being their youngest.

The family are renting a house in Kampung Penan Muslim Batu 10, Bintulu.

Missclyen is receiving treatment at Bintulu Hospital.

Apart from having hair all over her face, she was also born

without nostrils.

Roland had waited to meet Tunku Azizah and Yang di-Pertuan Agong Al-Sultan Abdullah Ri'ayatuddin Al-Mustafa Billah Shah during their stop at Masjid Al-Falah, which is located near Kampung Penan Muslim on Sept 10.

During the meeting, the royal couple had called her 'anak syurga' (child from heaven).

Single mother, female friend get seven years each for child abuse

JOHOR BAHRU: A single mother and her female friend were yesterday jailed seven years each for ill-treating and neglecting the former's seven-year-old son and causing him to suffer injuries.

Sessions Court Judge VM Mabel Sheela meted out the sentence on the mother, 27, and her housemate Awiin Chua, 30, after they pleaded guilty to two charges of child abuse on Aug 16.

The court sentenced them to seven years' jail on each charge and ordered them to serve the sentences concurrently from the date of their arrest on Aug 12.

In her decision, the judge emphasised that such an incident should not have occurred, as the bond between a mother and her child is extraordinarily special.

"If you (victim's mother) ask your child to follow you, he will definitely do it even if it means enduring pain.

"The court cannot imagine the condition the victim would be in if this situation had continued, and we're fortunate that the public intervened. Otherwise, the victim could have died," she said.

Deputy public prosecutor

Nur Diyana Zubir asked for a deterrent sentence, saying the victim had suffered more than 20 physical injuries and had been frequently abused.

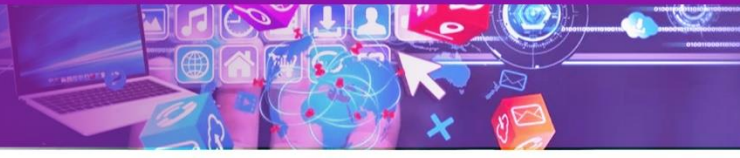
"In this case, we must commend the victim's neighbours for their vigilance, which ultimately saved the victim.

"It is a case of public interest which has also attracted the attention of the consort of Johor Crown Prince, Che' Puan Besar Khaleeda Bustamam," she said.

In mitigation, lawyer Nur Hazneena Zureen Jaesleen Mohd Hanafiah, representing the two accused, appealed for a lighter sentence, saying it was their first offence and that they deeply regretted their actions.

The two women committed the offences at a house in Pasir Gudang between July 1 and Aug 9 this year.

They were charged under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001, read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which provides for a maximum fine of RM50,000 or imprisonment of not more than 20 years, or both, on conviction. — Bernama

Woman found dead with 15 stab wounds, business partner arrested

KUALA TERENGGANU: A senior citizen was found dead with 15 stab wounds inside a drain by the main road in front of the Hulu Terengganu Religious Office in Kuala Berang near Hulu Terengganu yesterday.

Terengganu police chief Datuk Mazli Mazlan said the body of the 65-year-old woman was found by a security guard from the Hulu Terengganu Religious Office, who then called police at 4.35am.

He said the victim, a government pensioner from Kuala Berang, was run over before being stabbed by a woman believed to be her business partner, who works as a seamstress.

"Preliminary investigations found that the victim and the 35-year-old suspect drove somewhere to discuss business matters.

"However, there was an argument that caused the victim to get out of the car before being

run over by the female suspect, who was driving a Honda Jazz car," he said at the Terengganu police contingent headquarters.

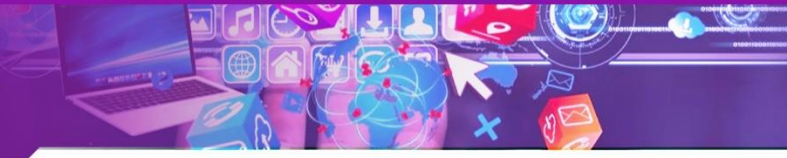
Mazli said the incident stemmed from a dispute over profit sharing between the two.

He said police arrested the suspect at her residence in Wakaf Tapai, near Marang at about 11am, and also recovered a

meat cleaver believed to be the murder weapon near the victim's house.

"Police also arrested a couple to help in the investigation under Section 302 of the Penal Code," he added.

He said the suspects will be remanded today (Nov 2) at the Kuala Terengganu court. — Bernama

1,365 kids neglected and need aid

Deputy minister: Welfare Dept looking into plight of the children

A TOTAL of 1,365 “neglected” children are seeking shelter, protection or rehabilitation with welfare institutions, says Datuk Aiman Athirah Sabu.

The Women, Family and Community deputy minister said these neglected children were being housed in 39 institutions under the Welfare Department.

“Of the number, 51 have no identification documents. In 2022, the number was 158 children,” she told Datuk Siti Zailah Mohd Yusoff (PN-Rantau Panjang).

The Welfare Department, she said, was working with the National Registration Department (NRD) to ensure the children are issued birth certificates before the end of their wardship.

Aiman Athirah said the ministry had carried out a pilot project to help children who have turned 18 to further their education or seek employment.

“There are 43 children who represent the first batch under the Anjung Sinar pilot project.

“I call on the private and public sectors, zakat centres and

non-governmental organisations to sign up as the project’s strategic partners,” she said.

Meanwhile, almost 30% of young children in Malaysia suffer from stunted growth caused by “unhealthy diets”, with Putrajaya having the highest ratio, says the Health Ministry.

Its deputy minister, Lukanisman Awang Sauni, said 29.7% of children within daycare-going ages (zero to four years old) had or are suffering from stunted growth, according to data from the last five years. He said the issue affects more than just one particular income group.

“Those with lower income tend to go for cheaper and less nutritious food due to limited financial resources, which has been made worse by the rising cost of living in the past few years.

“Those with higher income tend to focus more on careers, which leaves them with little time to cook at home and go for less nutritional meal options, like fast food, to feed their families,” he said during Ministers Question Time.

Lukanisman said tackling the issue of stunted growth in children was among the ministry’s priorities because of its possible negative effects on the lives of the next generation.

“Kids suffering from stunted growth are more at risk of developing non-communicable diseases like obesity, which will affect their ability to be productive once they become adults,” he added.

He was responding to Datuk Seri Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad (PH-Kuala Selangor) and Datuk Dr Alias Razak (PN-Kuala Nerus), who asked about the ministry’s efforts in tackling stunted growth among children.

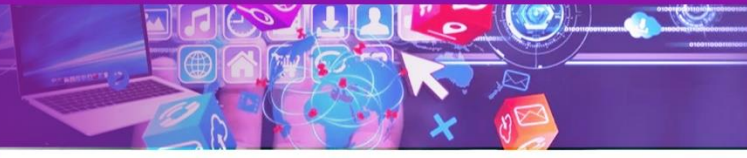
Lukanisman said his ministry would tackle the issue holistically, which would include further

cooperation among ministries and key stakeholders.

This will include further discussions within ministries through the Special Committee to Combat the Double Burden of Malnutrition Among Children, which is chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi.

“We want to work with many local institutions, experts, associations and international bodies like the United Nations Children’s Fund (Unicef) to address the issue before it worsens,” he said.

Call to boost anti-bullying efforts

Stakeholders must tackle surge in cases at schools, say educationists

PETALING JAYA: The near 30% increase in bullying cases this year is a concerning figure that requires urgent intervention from not just parents but also schools, teachers and the Education Ministry, say educationists.

Parent Action Group for Education (PAGE) chairman Datin Noor Azimah Abdul Rahim said it is appalling that bullying cases saw a significant rise of over 1,100 cases this year compared to last year.

She called on the ministry to invest more effort in instilling an interest in learning among students.

She also said there should be a more intensive attempt to diagnose students for autism, dyslexia, attention deficit disorder (ADD), or attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), among others.

"This is to find a more targeted treatment for these disorders.

"Incidentally, half of the inmates in prisons are autistic and untreated," said Noor Azimah.

Children's rights advocate Dr James Nagayam said schools should treat bullies as students with mental health issues.

"Many teenagers from Forms One to Five go through some form of mental health issue like neglect, deprivation of family love, or parents who are going through a divorce.

"Some bullies are also victims of domestic violence," he said.

According to Nagayam, the present ratio of one counsellor to 1,000 students isn't adequate to address possible mental health issues involving students.

"One kid alone takes up a lot of time for one counsellor. Can you imagine one counsellor for 1,000 students? They clearly don't have enough time for all students," he added.

The ministry, he said, is too rigid in its approach to dealing with bullies and should seek a fresh way to deal with bullies by outsourcing counsellors to non-governmental organisations.

"They (NGOs) could work with the police, the Social Welfare Department, or even neighbourhood groups," he said.

A former child commissioner with Suhakam (Human Rights Commission of Malaysia), Nagayam recalled the recognition given to a school in Temerloh, Pahang, for its anti-bullying efforts.

"In this school, parents took turns standing at the front gate of the school to check on bullying.

"There was a remarkable reduction in bullying cases in this school, and it received an award from Suhakam in 2014," he said.

Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia Centre of Education and Diversity senior lecturer Dr Anuar Ahmad, too, said bullies themselves are often victims of

domestic abuse.

"They would tend to replicate the act in schools and bully other children. Bullies see bullying as a form of escapism," he said.

The educationist said the best approach to address bullying is to get schools and parents to establish good relations.

"Schools and parents should always be in communication. This is one of the best mechanisms to prevent bullying among students," he said.

Anuar hopes that the latest figures on bullying will pressure stakeholders into taking prompt action on the menace so that it won't be normalised.

Yesterday, Deputy Education Minister Lim Hui Ying told the Dewan Rakyat that as of last month, 4,994 reports of bullying instances had been received, representing an almost 30% rise from the 3,887 cases received last year.

She said the ministry has launched guidelines on managing

misconduct, including bullying, in educational institutions.

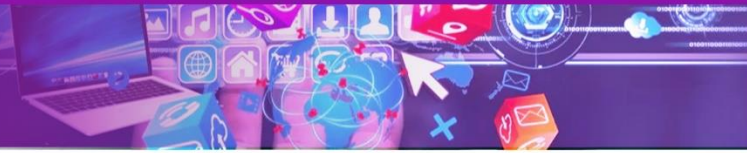
She said schools are collaborating with the police through school liaison officers and anti-bullying programmes in schools.

The ministry has also set up a bullying complaints portal that allows students, parents and the public to file reports directly and discreetly with the authorities, she said.

Complaints could also be filed via the Public Complaints Management Systems (Sispaa), email, telephone and WhatsApp.

"In addition, the ministry provides counselling for children who have the tendency to commit misconduct against other children," she said, adding that the ministry is also committed to increasing counsellors in schools.

Lim was responding to a question by Datuk Muhammad Bakhtiar Wan Chik (PH-Balik Pulau), who asked the ministry about steps to curb rampant school bullying cases.

Car thief ends up facing kidnapping probe

KOTA KINABALU: A man who attempted to drive off with a car in Ranau, some 100km from here, has landed in more trouble as he will also be investigated for kidnapping. This is because the vehicle he tried to make off with on Tuesday had six school-children in it.

The incident occurred near a roadside sundry shop at Kampung Pinousuk in the Kundasang highlands at about 5pm.

A short video clip said to be of the suspect being apprehended

by policemen had gone viral on social media since Tuesday evening.

Ranau OCPD Deputy Supt Simiun Lomudin said the suspect, who is in his early 40s, was being investigated both under Sections 379A and 365 of the Penal Code for theft of a motor vehicle and kidnapping, respectively.

"The district police has received information over a video of the suspect being arrested, which has gone viral over social media.

"Hence, we are carrying out further investigations to ensure appropriate actions are taken under the law," he said in a state-

ment yesterday.

However, there was no mention of the suspect's motive.

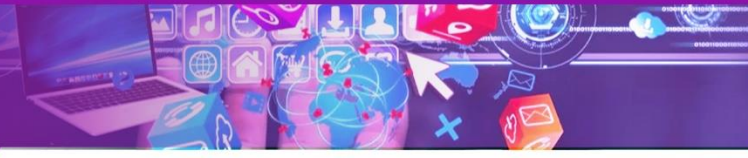
DSP Simiun urged those with information on the incident to contact the district police immediately to help in the probe.

Couple rescued after boat runs out of fuel

KOTA KINABALU: What was supposed to be a two-hour boat ride became a two-day journey for an elderly couple after they got lost and ran out of fuel while travelling off Sandakan.

Md Asibih Tamang, 73, and his wife Fatima Ulo, 65, were travelling from Kampung Batu Putih to their daughter's house in Kampung Terusan Sugut, some 41 nautical miles away, when they got lost.

The couple had headed out to sea at about 8am on Sunday and was supposed to reach their destination some two hours later, but they never showed up.

Sensing something amiss, their son-in-law immediately contacted the district coast guards.

Sandakan MMEA director Capt Zainuddin Mohd Zuki said a search and rescue operation was activated the same day.

"On Monday, communications were established with the couple, who was reported to be safe on Mapun Island in the Philippines.

"Local fishermen there had

come to their rescue and sent them home. The couple was handed over to the MMEA near Tanjung Pamaguan (in Malaysia) on Tuesday," he said.

Zainuddin said the couple had intended on using Pulau Tikus in Malaysian waters as a guide to the village where their daughter was living but lost their way until they ran out of fuel near

Pulau Lankayan.

The couple then sought help from people on the island for fuel before continuing their journey.

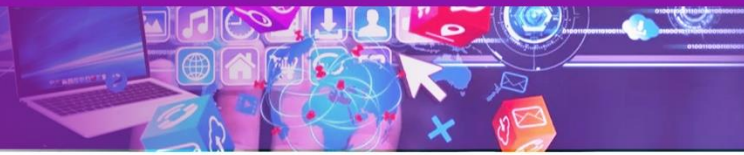
"Islanders had advised them that to avoid getting lost, they should trail a vessel that was heading to Sandakan," Zainuddin said.

"However, after trailing for a short while, the husband decided

to intercept the vessel, saying it was moving too slowly. He was also worried a storm might hit.

"As a result, they got lost and drifted to Mapun Island."

Judge cries for abused child

He could have died, she says, as mum and friend get seven years' jail

JOHOR BARU: A Sessions Court judge here could not contain her tears before sentencing a single mother and her female companion to seven years' jail yesterday for child abuse and neglect.

Nurul Asyiqin Mohamad Zahir, 27, and Singaporean Awiin Chua, 30, pleaded guilty to abusing and neglecting Nurul Asyiqin's seven-year-old son.

When delivering her judgment, Sessions Court judge VM Mabel Sheela teared up when she thought about how the child suffered a whole month of abuse.

"The bond between a mother and a child is very special. If you (Nurul Asyiqin) asked him whether he wants to follow you, he will surely want to be with you even though he knows he would be in pain.

"The court cannot imagine the victim's condition if the public did not intervene. He would have surely died," she said.

In a video that has since gone viral, the boy had been reportedly rescued from the mother's house by neighbours.

Earlier in her submission, deputy public prosecutor Nur Diyana

Zubir said a medical exam found more than 20 physical injuries on the victim's body.

"The frequency of the abuse

every day from July 1 to Aug 9 is based on the presence of old and new wounds as well as scars on the victim's body.

"The victim was not only beaten but also neglected by being locked in the house alone without food, and the accused did not stop

or save the victim when he was beaten," she added.

Nurul Asyiqin and her housemate, Chua, were first brought to court on Aug 16 and charged with physically injuring her son at a house in Bandar Layangkasa, Pasir Gudang from July 1 until Aug 9.

For the second charge, both Nurul Asyiqin and Chua were accused of having a common intention to neglect the child under their care.

Both accused were charged under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001, which was read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, and which carried a fine of up to RM50,000 or a maximum 20 years' imprisonment or both upon conviction.

They initially claimed trial to the charges but later pleaded guilty after the charges were read again in front of Mabel Sheela on Sept 27.

She then sentenced Nurul Asyiqin and Chua to seven years each for the two charges but ordered their imprisonment to run concurrently starting from the date of their arrest.

Lawyer Nurhazneena Zureen Jaesleen Mohamad Hanafiah represented the two accused.

Woman charged for post about ex-PM

KUALA LUMPUR: A clinic assistant in Singapore pleaded not guilty in the Ampang Sessions Court here to a charge of making offensive postings against the eighth Prime Minister, Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin, through Facebook three years ago.

Tai Zee Sing, 31, was charged with knowingly making and initiating the transmission of offensive communication, namely, "Can hired killer kill new prime minister", with the intention to hurt the feelings of others.

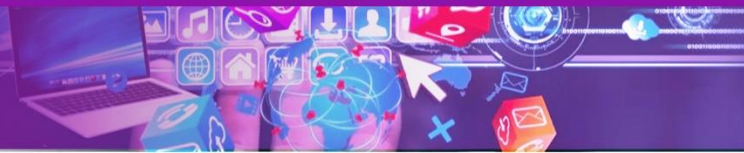
The woman, who is currently pursuing a diploma in Singapore, is alleged to have committed the offence on March 1, 2020.

She was charged under Section 223 (1) (a) (ii) of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 and can be punished under Section 233 (3) of the same Act and face a maximum fine of RM50,000 or imprisonment for up to a year, or both, for each charge, and can also be fined a further RM1,000 for each day the offence has continued, if found guilty.

Judge Wan Norisham Wan Yaakob set bail at RM10,000 in one surety and fixed Dec 20 for mention.

The court did not impose additional conditions, such as reporting to the nearest police station and surrendering her passport, because the accused was pursuing her studies in Singapore.

27% population aged under 18: Statistics Dept

KUALA LUMPUR: The number of children under 18 in Malaysia in 2023 is estimated to be 9.13 million, which accounts for 27.4% of the country's total population of 33.38 million.

Chief Statistician Datuk Seri Dr Mohd Uzir Mahidin said based on the Children Statistics Malaysia 2023 data published by the Statistics Department yesterday, the number of boys and

girls under the age of 18 is 4.72 million and 4.42 million respectively.

"The composition of children under five years old in 2023 is 2.35 million, with 1.21 million boys and 1.14 million girls. This group covers 25.7% of the total number of children in Malaysia," he said in a statement yesterday.

According to Mohd Uzir, the Federal Territory of Putrajaya recorded the highest percentage of children under 18 in 2023 with 41.1% of the population, followed by Kelantan with 34.4% and Terengganu at 33.5%.

The Federal Territory of Kuala Lumpur recorded the lowest percentage at 22.6%.

"However, Selangor recorded the highest number of children under 18 at 1.81 million, followed by Johor with 1.11 million and Sabah with 1.1 million. The lowest number of children under 18 was recorded in the Federal Territory of Labuan at 0.03 million."

The statistics also indicate that children under the age of five experiencing severe malnutrition increased slightly to 0.3% in 2022 compared with 0.2% in 2021.

In terms of education, the number of pupils in government and government-aided schools in 2022 was 4.96 million, an increase of 0.6% from 4.93 million the previous year.

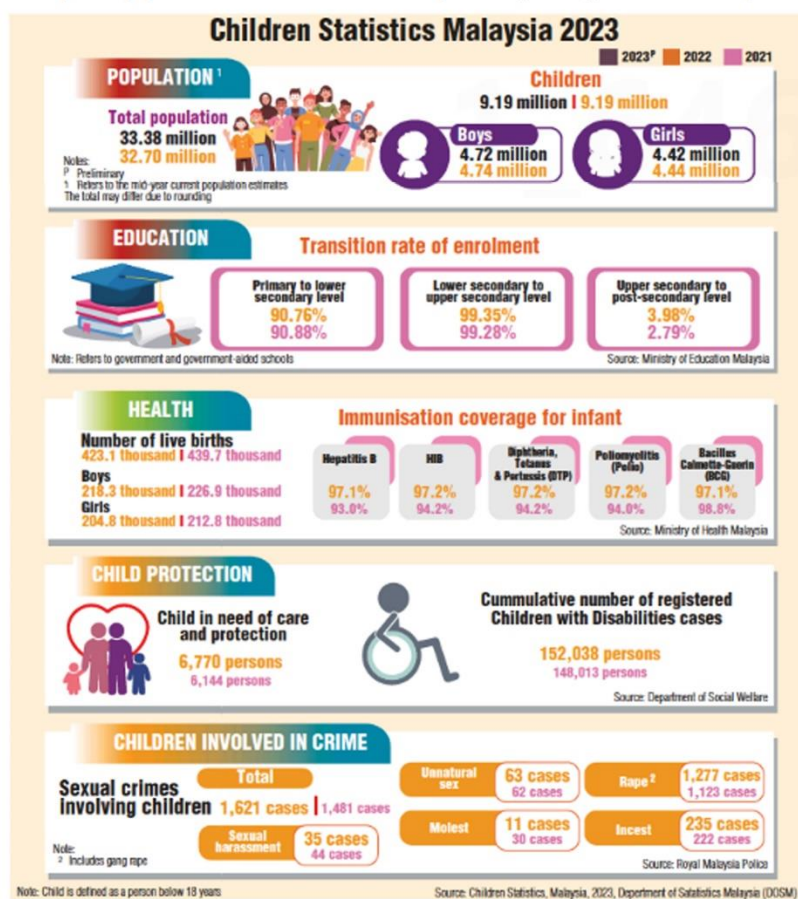
During the same period, the number of pupils in private schools dropped 1.2% to 0.42 million from 0.43 million, he added.

From the child protection perspective, the number of children needing care and protection in 2022 increased by 10.2% to 6,770 (4,303 girls and 2,467 boys) compared with 6,144 individuals in 2021.

The majority of children in need of care and protection are Bumiputera (73.5%), followed by Indians (9%), Chinese (7.5%) and others (10.1%).

According to the statistics, the number of children involved in crime in 2022 dropped by 12.8% to record 3,013 cases compared with 3,457 cases in 2021, while the number of sexual crime cases involving children increased by 9.5% in 2022 with 1,621 cases compared with 1,481 cases in 2021.

Cops act on triad recruitment of secondary school students

JOHOR BAHRU: Police here have detected infiltration of secret societies actively recruiting secondary school students.

State police chief Datuk Kamarul Zaman Mamat said students are believed to be recruited to engage in criminal activities, including drug trafficking.

He said the suspicion was recently confirmed when they received two reports of students being beaten and forced to join two secret societies known as "Hong Hong San

Gang" and "Ngo Sek Kee Gang".

"The secret society recruitment of schoolboys seems to have just happened recently. Two reports were received and there may be more unreported cases.

"The underworld is believed to be targeting students in urban as opposed to rural areas. We hope victims, teachers and parents will report to police immediately if such incidents happen," he said after a handover of duties ceremony for the Johor Criminal Investigation

Department head yesterday. Also present was state deputy police chief DCP M. Kumar.

Kamarul Zaman said police have their ears to the ground to actively monitor activities of secret societies in the state, and urged schools to pass on information to the school liaison officer to deal with such cases.

"We see now that secret societies have dared to rear their ugly heads again by boldly encroaching schools to recruit students.

"My advice to teachers in particular is

to report to police because there are liaison officers in schools. So, please pass on the information."

Commenting on "Hong Hong San Gang" and "Ngo Sek Kee Gang", he said six men involved in the case were charged under Section 323 of the Penal Code and Section 45 of the Societies Act 1966 in the Muar Magistrate's Court on Oct 17.

He added that two of them pleaded guilty and were fined RM3,000 each. - Bernama

Measures to address bullying

KUALA LUMPUR: The Education Ministry plans to increase the number of guidance and counselling teachers if cases of bullying at schools continue to persist and show a rising trend, the Dewan Rakyat was told yesterday.

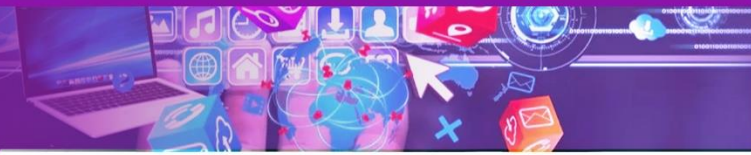
Its deputy minister Lim Hui Ying said guidance and counselling are among the immediate measures that could be taken to address this social issue in schools.

"The bullies must be given proper guidance to understand why they should not engage in bullying. So, counselling is very important," she said in reply to Dr Ahmad Fakhrudin Fakhrurazi (PN-Kuala Kedah) during Question Time.

Lim added that based on the ministry's *Sistem Sahsiah Diri Murid* statistics, bullying incidents at schools had shown an increase, with 4,994 cases recorded as of last month, compared with 3,887 cases last year.

She said all the cases had been investigated and follow-up action had been taken, with focus on providing guidance and counselling to those involved.

"Our objective is to ensure that bullying cases can be reduced." – Bernama

Single mother, housemate jailed for child abuse

JOHOR BAHRU: A single mother and her female friend were jailed seven years each for ill-treating and neglecting her seven-year-old son and causing him to suffer injuries.

Sessions Court Judge V.M. Mabel Sheela meted out the sentence on Nurul Asyiqin Mohamad Zahid, 27, and her housemate Awiin Chua, 30, after they pleaded guilty to two charges of child abuse on Aug 16.

The court sentenced them to seven years' jail on each charge and ordered them to serve the sentences concurrently from the date of their arrest on Aug 12.

Mabel Sheela said such an incident should not have occurred as the bond between a mother and her child is extraordinarily special.

"If you ask your child to follow you, he will definitely do it even if it means enduring pain.

"The court could not imagine the condition the victim would be in if this situation had continued, and we are fortunate that the public intervened. Otherwise, the victim could have died."

DPP Nur Diyana Zubir asked for a deterrent sentence, saying the victim had suffered more than 20 physical injuries and had been frequently abused.

"In this case, we must commend the victim's neighbours for their vigilance, which ultimately saved him. It is a case of public interest, which has also attracted the attention of the consort of the Johor Crown Prince, Che' Puan Besar Khaleeda Bustamam."

Nur Hazneena Zureen Jaesleen Mohd Hanafiah, representing the duo, appealed for a lighter sentence, considering that it was their first offence and they deeply regretted their actions.

The two women committed the offences in a house on Jalan Wau Kikik 7, Bandar Layang Kasa in Pasir Gudang between July 1 and Aug 9.

They were charged under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001, read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which provides a maximum fine of RM50,000, imprisonment of not more than 20 years, or both. - Bernama

Woman charged over false Socso claims

ALOR SETAR: A company owner pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court yesterday to seven charges of submitting false documents to the Social Security Organisation (Socso) to claim incentives totalling RM24,500 under the Penjana Kerjaya 2.0 programme two years ago.

Aisy Maju Abadi Trading owner Nur Kesuma Kartini Mohamad Zahir, 41, was charged over submitting employee verification forms containing false details of seven individuals who were not employees of the company to a Socso agent with the intention to deceive and mislead Socso in an attempt to claim incentives.

She allegedly committed the offence at the Socso office in Jalan Teluk Wanjah on June 22, 2021.

Each of the charges under Section 18 of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) Act 2009 carries imprisonment of up to 20 years and a fine of not less than five times the value of the incentives or RM10,000, whichever is higher.

Judge Rohatul Akmar Abdullah allowed the accused bail of RM10,000 for all charges and set Dec 5 for remention.

MACC prosecuting officer S. Sujatha prosecuted, while Ummi Kalthum Zakaria represented Nur Kesuma. – Bernama



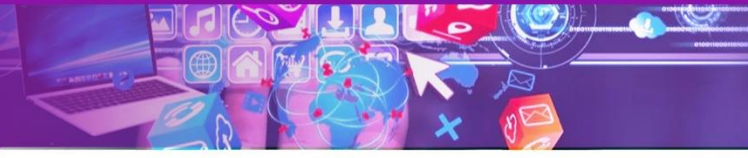

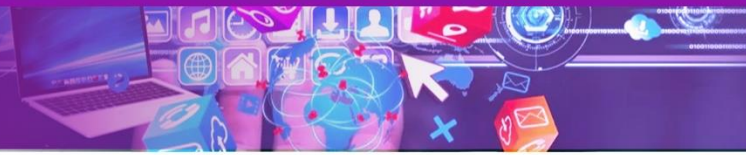
