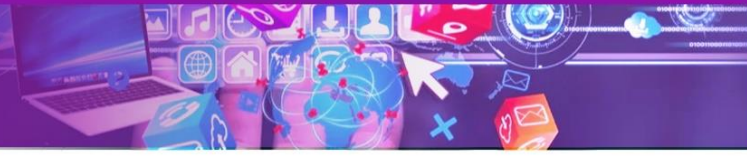

Lebih 20 peratus wanita jadi lembaga pengarah PLC

Bursa Malaysia memuji usaha syarikat senaraian awam (PLC) yang menunjukkan tindakan positif terhadap kepelbagaian jantina dalam komposisi lembaga p mereka.

Bursa Malaysia berkata, bagi keseluruhan PLC yang disenaraikan di Bursa Malaysia, peratusan purata pengarah wanita kini kira-kira 22 peratus pada 1 Mei 2023.

Malah, mengikut *Kesaksamaan Jantina dalam Kepimpinan Korporat: Laporan Analisis Serantau* oleh Inisiatif Bursa Saham Lestari Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (SSE PBB) dengan kerjasama Perbadanan Kewangan Antarabangsa (IFC) pada Disember 2022, Malaysia antara empat pasaran baharu muncul dengan lebih 20 peratus daripada 100 kerusi lembaga

teratas dipegang wanita.

IFC adalah ahli Kumpulan Bank Dunia dan Wanita PBB.

Laporan itu juga meliputi 3,246 PLC di 35 bursa saham merentasi tujuh wilayah di seluruh dunia.

Bursa Malaysia bagaimanapun berkata, antara cabaran dalam perjalanan ke arah mencapai sasaran 30 peratus ialah mengkaji amalan beberapa PLC yang mempunyai semua lelaki dalam lembaga pengarah.

Ia berkata, pada Januari 2022, pihaknya mengumumkan bahawa PLC dengan permodalan pasaran RM2 bilion sehingga 31 Disember 2021 akan melantik sekurang-kurangnya seorang ahli lembaga pengarah wanita menjelang 1 September 2022, sementara PLC lain, keperluan itu perlu dipatuhi menjelang 1 Jun 2023.

"Setakat 1 Jun 2023, terdapat 24 PLC yang belum melantik sekurang-kurangnya seorang pengarah wanita, justeru gagal mematuhi keperluan yang ditetapkan Bursa Malaysia," katanya.

Pengendali pasaran saham itu berkata, syarikat tersenarai dalam Pasaran Utama dikehendaki mengurus kepelbagaian secara berkesan dalam organisasi masing-masing bermula tahun kewangan berakhir 31 Disember 2023, demikian kata Bursa Malaysia.

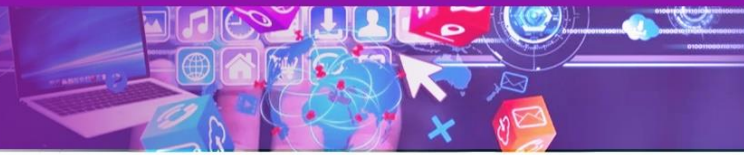
Ia berkata, PLC Pasaran Utama dikehendaki berbuat demikian dengan melaksanakan dasar, proses dan inisiatif berkaitan untuk menggalakkan kepelbagaian serta membuat pendanaan yang sepadan dalam penyata atau laporan kelestarian mereka.

Manakala, PLC Pasaran ACE pula, jelasnya, akan tertakluk kepada keperluan itu mulai tahun kewangan berakhir 31 Disember 2025.

"Bagi meningkatkan ketelusan dan akauntabiliti, bursa mewajibkan semua PLC melaporkan petunjuk berikut untuk menunjukkan peningkatan dari semasa ke semasa iaitu peratusan pengarah mengikut jantina dan kumpulan umur dan peratusan pekerja mengikut jantina dan kumpulan umur, bagi setiap kategori pekerja," katanya.

Berjaya Corporation Bhd (BCorp), tahun ini antara lain mengumumkan barisan lembaga pengarah yang terdiri daripada semua wanita, diketuai Tunku Tun Aminah Sultan Ibrahim Ismail sebagai Pengerusi Bukan Bebas Bukan Eksekutif.

3 wanita pecah tabung surau, masjid ditahan

Seremban: Kegiatan tiga wanita yang dikesan melakukan jenayah pecah tabung surau dan masjid di sekitar daerah ini terbongkar selepas mereka ditahan polis.

Dalam kejadian terbaharu 26 Mei lalu, suspek dikatakan mencuri wang dari tabung sebuah surau di Taman Dato Wan, Paroi di sini.

Ketua Polis Daerah Seremban, Asisten Komisioner Arifai Tarawe berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan daripada seorang lelaki mendakwa tabung surau dipecahkan dan semua wang dilarikan.

“Rabu lalu, kami menerima laporan daripada ahli jawatankuasa surau di Taman Dato Wan yang menyatakan tabung dipecahkan. Laporan hanya dibuat

selepas lima hari kejadian berlaku.

“Hasil siasatan mendapati suspek memotong mangga pada tabung dan mengambil semua wang di dalamnya,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Menurutnya, polis menjalankan siasatan dan menahan tiga wanita berusia 26 hingga 28 tahun dari 1 Jun hingga kelmarin.

“Dengan tertangkapnya suspek, polis menyelesaikan tiga kes pecah tabung masjid dan surau di sekitar Seremban.

“Kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 380 Kanun Keseksaan kerana kesalahan mencuri dalam bangunan,” katanya menambah suspek direman sehingga hari ini bagi membantu siasatan.

Iskandar Puteri: Seramai 26 wanita warga asing dan 10 lelaki berusia 20-an hingga 40-an ditahan pada serbuan Op Noda di sebuah kelab malam dekat Taman Bukit Indah di sini, semalam.

Ketua Polis Daerah Iskandar Puteri Asisten Komisiner Rahmat Ariffin berkata, pada operasi penguatkuasaan bermula jam 2 pagi hingga jam 5 pagi membabitkan aktiviti pelacuran dan pusat hiburan itu, individu yang ditahan turut didapati melakukan pelbagai kesalahan.

"Mereka ditahan mengikut Seksyen 372B Kanun Keseksaan, Seksyen 39B, Seksyen 55B dan Seksyen 15(1)(c) Akta Imigresen 1956/53 serta Seksyen 11(2) Enakmen Negeri Johor.

"Lima individu juga didapati positif dadah ketika serbuan. Dua lelaki tempatan yang juga pelanggan kelab malam berusia 30-an dan 50-an turut didapati berada dalam senarai dikhendaki atas kesalahan dadah serta jenayah," katanya

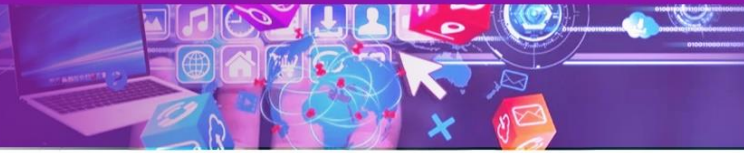

Berdebar jantung terima berita anak dipercayai lemas

Kuala Berang: "Saya amat terkejut dan tidak percaya ketika beberapa anggota polis datang ke rumah memberitahu anak saya dipercayai lemas," kata Mokhtar Mohamad, 63.

Mokhtar adalah bapa Muhammad Adam Shazwan, 15, yang dikhuatiri lemas selepas dibawa arus Sungai Terengganu, dekat Kampung Dusun di sini, Jumaat lalu.

Katanya, dia tidak tahu jam berapa anak bongsunya keluar dari rumah dan menyedari ketiadaannya selepas dipanggil untuk makan tengah hari selepas pulang dari solat Jumaat.

"Anak memang selalu ke sungai bersantai bersama rakan-rakannya atau memancing ikan.

"Namun, sejak empat hari lalu anak kerap mandi sehingga dimaklumkan hi-

lang dipercayai lemas," katanya di lokasi kejadian.

Katanya, dia dimaklumkan sebelum kejadian Adam turut menahan pukut kerana ketika itu paras sungai tidak begitu dalam.

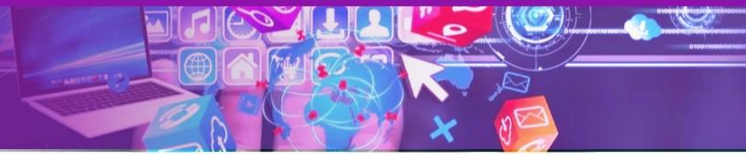
Bagaimanapun, katanya, arus sungai bertukar deras dan laju menyebabkan anaknya tidak dapat diselamatkan rakan yang bersamanya ketika itu.

"Adam tidak mahir berenang dan saya sangat berharap anak ditemui segera," katanya.

Sementara itu, mayat Muhammad Adam ditemui pada 1.05 tengah hari semalam di Kampung Temir, dekat sini, kira-kira tiga kilometer daripada lokasi terakhir mangsa dipercayai lemas. Mayat ditemui oleh orang awam dalam keadaan terapung.

Housewife loses RM110,000 in job scam

KUANTAN: A housewife claims she lost RM110,556 after falling victim to a scam syndicate that offered part-time jobs on social media.

Pahang police chief Datuk Yahaya Othman yesterday said the 36-year-old victim claimed that she had responded to an advertisement on Telegram on May 30, which required her to like and share YouTube videos.

"The victim said she was offered a commission of between 15 and 20 per cent for doing eight tasks, but she had to make a payment first to get a link to the

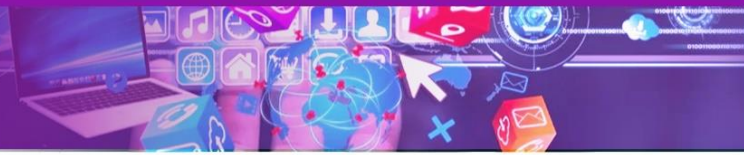
videos," he said.

"She withdrew her savings and borrowed money from her friends to pay the suspect,"

Yahaya said the victim made 21 online money transfers to five accounts provided by the suspect before realising she had been cheated.

The victim lodged a report at the Kuantan district police headquarters on Saturday.

Yahaya urged the public not to be deceived by advertisements on social media, especially those that offered high profits for doing simple jobs. **Bernama**

Tracker dogs used to find boy feared drowned

IPOH: Tracker dogs are being used to find a boy, 8, who is feared to have drowned while bathing at Teratak River View Lubuk Hantu in Simpang Empat, Tanjung Malim, on Saturday.

State Fire and Rescue Department Operations Division assistant director Sabarodzi Nor Ahmad said the two dogs took part in the search-and-rescue operation to find the victim.

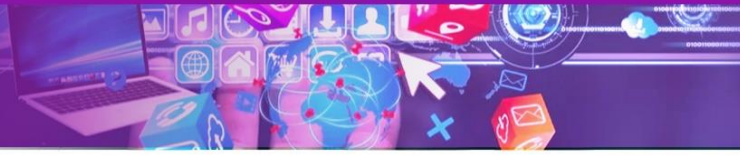
"The team resumed operations this (yesterday) morning with surface searching covering a distance of 2km from where the vic-

tim was last seen."

He said the rescue efforts, which entered the second day, involved 24 firemen from the Tanjung Malim fire station, and the Water Rescue Team personnel from Ipoh, Kuala Kangsar and Teluk Intan.

The operation was assisted by police, the People's Volunteer Corps and the Malaysian Civil Defence Force, as well as the Kampung Slim Volunteer Fire Brigade.

SHAH ALAM: A 57-year-old woman faced anxious moments when she was trapped in her vehicle during a flash flood near Klang Sentral in Jalan Meru yesterday morning.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department assistant director (operations) Mohamadul Ehsan Mohd Zain said in the 5.44am incident, the woman was passing through a heavily flooded road when her vehicle got stuck.

He said the victim was on her way home and was believed to have been caught in the flash flood about five minutes before her vehicle was submerged in the water.

"The woman managed to get out her car with the help of

Bomba conducts medevac to help Orang Asli woman get treatment

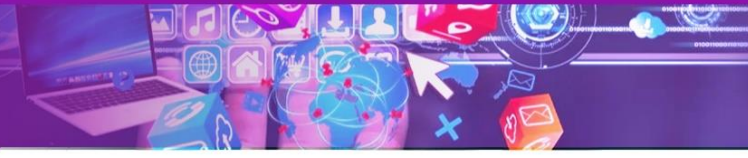

Childhood cancer patient's mum emphasises importance of having and giving hope

THE lives of Marylene Placid and her family changed forever the day her daughter, Adela Ivy, was diagnosed with Pre-T-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (ALL). It was December 2013 when Adela received the diagnosis, days after she was down with fever and high chills, abdominal distension with pain and constipations – among other symptoms.

Worrying about her daughter's continuous sickness, Marylene rushed her girl to Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) for a check-up.

Her initial admission was on Dec 18, 2013. The doctor's diagnosis came quite quickly after Adela was examined. On Dec 20, she was put under T-cell ALL protocol.

"Everything happened too fast for us to process it properly. My husband and I were very vulnerable at that time because never would I ever think that my family, in particular Adela, would be diagnosed with cancer.

I was devastated upon receiving the news, feeling that my whole world had collapsed. Being in a state of disbelief, I found myself googling while sobbing, searching and learning about all types of leukaemia and the causes.

"We were in dire need of support; the despair and insanity crept in to fail my whole being," she told her story.

Amid the helplessness, Marylene had paediatric oncology specialist Dr Ong Gek Bee to thank for, though initially she was ready to confront her for what she thought was a misdiagnosis of cancer.

It was Dr Ong who reassured her that she and her family were not alone in this fight.

"She encouraged me to go around, and have a talk with Sarawak Children's Cancer Society (SCCS) support services officer, Puan Dayang Juliana at the time, telling me that I could get help dealing with this.

"I was able to light up a bit when other caretakers were smiling and their kind gestures were able to envelope my sanity to care for Adela."

As her daughter's chemotherapy treatment began, Marylene knew that the only way she could properly take care of her daughter was by putting her full trust on the doctors.

The idea of seeking other alternatives like faith and spiritual treatment was tempting as it was suggested by her spiritual priest based on trustworthy testimonies, but Marylene rejected it after thorough discussion with her husband.

Living in Kuching provided convenience for them to go back and forth between home and hospital, so travelling was not much of a challenge for them. The commutes were exhaustive, but her focus was to ensure that Adela could complete her cycle of chemotherapy and radiotherapy treatments.

"Though our daily routine changed and diligent time management were pivotal in order to ensure our work, family routine, Adela treatments and

hospital appointments would not be disrupted.

"We were even more thankful to doctors-in-charge and nurses who were very helpful in explaining the medicines, the treatments and the protocols. The nurses trained me and my husband on the proper way to care for Adela such as on the medication procedures, central venous line (CVL) dressings, the recording of food and beverage consumptions, as well as procedures to attend chemotherapy and radiotherapy," said Marylene.

Over the next eight months, Marylene had to struggle watching her daughter in pain while receiving treatment – she always had that urge to pull her out from the procedure.

Yet, she endured as much mental pain as her daughter's physical pain, because they were counting the chances of surviving each treatment as pivotal.

On Aug 12, 2014, Adela finally completed the ALL Protocol II cranial irradiation. However, six days later, she was readmitted into hospital due to fever. She was discharged the next day on

Dec 19.

Marylene said all symptoms were showing signs of relapse and Adela was put under Relapsed Pre-T-cell Lymphoblastic Leukaemia protocol. The girl was admitted again to hospital on Nov 19, 2015, and was pronounced to be in palliative care after all effective treatments had been exhausted.

Adela passed away in December that year.

The pain of losing Adela brought changes in Marylene, her husband and the rest of the family.

"Before all this, I always felt that relationship could be broken easily and would not be mended by patching, as patching meant putting or giving an empty assurance that would not guarantee a lasting effect on the patch itself.

"Because I know that eventually, it would leak and break, and the aftermaths would often be unbearable.

Yet, somehow the loss changed my perspective. I'm weaving my relationship – as the movement of weaving clearly states going up and down crafting a masterpiece artwork,

which I would be proud of it. It is evidently a long process that requires patience, determination and perseverance," said Marylene, now a SCCS volunteer.

Grieving the loss, she felt, was a pivotal development for her and her children.

"It wasn't easy dealing with grief and bereft, but I assured them (her children) that it was OK to cry and feel the loss. As parents, I observed them, and went out to ensure that they're able to reflect their pain and journey forward, instead of leaving them in darkness.

"All in all, acceptance of the loss is important, as not to fall into depression. In my situation, I was able to manoeuvre my pain and struggle into hope; I was rest assured that my children and my husband were on the same board."

To her, losing Adela left her countless sweet memories and also chunks of bitter one. The memories, she said, had played a key role in helping them move forward by embracing hope to people around them.

"As the idiom goes: 'Every cloud has a silver lining', despite the despair."

As a parent of childhood cancer patient, Marylene could not stress enough the importance

of giving hope. The fight against childhood cancer must go on, with every support being crucial towards continuing that fight.

Marylene, also a committee member of SCCS, called upon the support from members of the public from near and far to come together and help children fight cancer.

To date, the online donation channelled via <https://gobald.my/event-detail-page/4/main/gobald-2023> has surpassed one-third of the RM1-million target.

The first in-person event will be held in Miri this June 11, followed by Kuching on June 18, which will take place on the ground floor of the East Atrium, Vivacity Megamall.

Those in Miri, Kuching, Bintulu and Sibul wishing to raise funds and go bald at their own time, can do so between now until June 30 at these designated salons – Paul & Jennifer Salon (Miri); Ray's Salon (Kuching); T2H Academy (Bintulu); and Danny Hair Academy (Sibu).

"SCCS' Go Bald 2023 campaign is back, taking place at Permaisuri Imperial City Mall in Miri this June 11, running from 1:30pm to 7:20pm.

Find more creative ways to get children to read — Minister

KUALA LUMPUR: More creative efforts are needed to encourage children to read, said Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

She said it was important to encourage children to choose reading materials over social media as their main source of information in order for them to learn how to think.

"My personal view is that we need to be more creative to find ways to get children interested in reading and to show interest when they have found something that they like.

"At times comic books do promote creative and critical thinking as the reader, be it a child or anyone, will be required to think," she told reporters.

She was met at the launch of the book 'Puisi Ganjil: SaTUI' written by Dewan Bahasa dan Pustaka (DBP) board of governors member Tan Sri Hamad Kama Piah Che Othman at the 2023 Kuala Lumpur International Book Fair, here yesterday.

Earlier in her speech, Nancy said the local book industry had not reached the target set by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (Unesco) on book publishing for developed countries, which is one per cent of the total population.

"This means that the country should publish 30,000 book titles considering that the population of Malaysia has reached over 30 million.

"In 2020, a total of 15,080

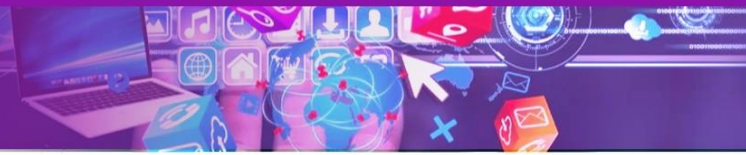
book titles were published, the following year, 13,655 book titles were released. This shows we are still far from the actual target for a developed country," she said.

As such, Nancy said the role of writing books should not be limited to academics or professional writers alone, but the public including corporate figures should also be involved in the production of books and literary works.

"This is not impossible because Tan Sri Hamad Kama Piah, who is a corporate figure, has accomplished this despite his busy schedule.

"Literature should continue to be relevant in shaping civilisation and developing a society," she said adding that it is also a reflection of humanity.

KUANTAN: A housewife here claimed to have lost RM110,556 after being duped by a scam syndicate offering part-time jobs on social media.

Pahang police chief Datuk Yahaya Othman said the 36-year-old victim claimed that based on the advertisement on Telegram on May 30, she was only required to like and share YouTube videos.

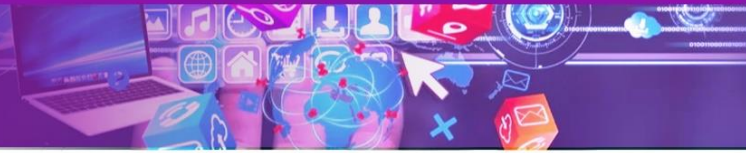
"The victim said she was offered a commission of between 15 and 20 per cent for doing eight tasks, but she had to make a payment first to get a link to the videos.

"She then withdrew her savings and borrowed money from her friends to pay the suspect," he said in a statement yesterday.

Yahaya said the victim had made 21 online money transfers to five accounts provided by the suspect before realising she had been cheated.

The victim lodged a report at the Kuantan District Police Headquarters on Saturday.

He advised the public not to be easily deceived by advertisements on social media, especially those that offer high profits for doing simple jobs. — Bernama

Two girls drown, man missing while swimming at Bagan Lalang Beach

PUTRAJAYA: Two girls drowned, while a man in his 30s is still missing while bathing at Bagan Lalang Beach, Selangor yesterday afternoon.

The Selangor Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) said it received a distress call about the incident at 2.34pm and six members from the Sepang station arrived at the scene about 23 minutes later.

"The female victims, aged seven and nine, were found 50 metres from where they were suspected

to have drowned, and their deaths were confirmed by Health Ministry personnel.

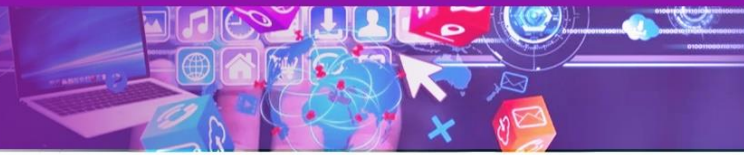
"The male victim has yet to be found. Search operations are being carried out by the fire department," he said in a statement, adding that they had opened an operational control post at the scene to search for the victim.

Meanwhile in Terengganu, the body of a teenage boy who was swept away by currents while bathing in Sungai Terengganu, near Kampung Dusun here last

Friday, was found at 1.05pm yesterday.

Hulu Terengganu police chief DSP Hasmeera Hassan said the body of the victim, Muhammad Adam Shazwan Mokhtar, 15, was found in the river near Kampung Temir by an individual who happened to be passing by the river, about 3km from the location of the incident.

"The body has been taken to Hulu Terengganu Hospital for further action," Hasmeera told reporters. — Bernama
