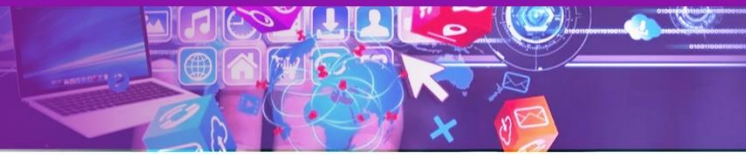

Emosi pemandu terganggu punca nahas

Musim cuti panjang tidak kira sempena sambutan perayaan atau penggal persekolahan sering menjadi masa paling berbahaya. Umumnya dalam tempoh itu kita akan sering membaca mengenai kemalangan jalan raya termasuk membabitkan kes yang meragut nyawa.

Pastinya satu daripada faktor kejadian itu berlaku disebabkan peningkatan kenderaan di jalan raya. Setiap orang ada hala tuju yang sama ada pulang ke kampung, meraikan perkahwinan atau melancong, menjadikan jalan raya padat dan menjejaskan pemanduan. Ramai pengguna akan tersekat di jalan raya gara-gara bilangan kenderaan yang banyak selain perlu berbaris panjang di kaunter tol.

Semua itu sedikit sebanyak mampu menjejaskan tumpuan pemandu kerana masing-masing akan lewat daripada jadual. Hal ini menyumbang kepada kesesakan lalu lintas dan boleh menyebabkan gangguan kelewatan perjalanan. Ia juga mampu menjadi penyumbang kepada ketidakstabilan emosi dan akhirnya boleh menyebabkan peningkatan risiko kemalangan.

Misalnya, kes kemalangan maut membabitkan enam sekeluarga yang berlaku di Jalan Segamat-Kuantan. Tragedi itu dipercayai berpunca daripada lori pasir hilang kawalan dan memasuki laluan bertentangan sebelum bertembung dengan kereta dinaiki keluarga berkenaan.

Keselamatan tanggungjawab semua

Peristiwa tragis sebegini mampu dielakkan sekiranya faktor penyumbang kepada kemalangan ngeri dikaji dan diperhalusi selain keprihatinan pemandu terhadap kebajikannya sendiri serta orang lain diperbaiki.

Misalnya, jika menempuh perjalanan yang panjang, sebagai pemandu tentu sahaja mudah be-



rasa lesu. Apatah lagi jika baru selesai aktiviti bersama keluarga tidak kiralah kenduri kenderaan atau bercuti. Dalam keadaan penat, badan tidak bermaya akan mudah mengurangkan tumpuan dan kewaspadaan terhadap pemanduan.

Seterusnya, penyelenggaraan kenderaan tidak berkala juga boleh menjadi penyumbang kepada kemalangan. Sebagai pemilik kenderaan, kita bertanggungjawab untuk memastikan kenderaan yang dipandu sentiasa dalam keadaan terbaik.

Misalnya memastikan lampu isyarat masih berfungsi. Jika memandu pada waktu malam, lampu kenderaan mesti diperiksa terlebih dahulu, apakah baterinya masih berfungsi atau tidak. Begitu juga dengan cengkaman tayar. Hal begini penting kerana kita tidak tahu kemungkinan berlaku perubahan cuaca. Misalnya, meskipun diramal panas terik hingga ke petang, tetapi tiba-tiba berlaku hujan lebat di tengah hari.

Sebagai pengguna jalan raya yang bijak dan berhemah, adalah menjadi kewajipan untuk membuat perancangan rapi sebelum memulakan per-

jalanan. Ambil kira faktor jarak, keadaan cuaca, pilihan laluan, masa perjalanan dan risiko-risiko lain yang mungkin berlaku.

Jika badan mulai rasa keletihan mahupun mengantuk, dinasihatkan untuk berhenti berehat untuk mengelakkan kepenatan. Tidur yang cukup 'ubat' paling mujarab bagi menghilangkan rasa mengantuk ketika memandu.

Setiap pemandu yang mempunyai lesen memandu sah pasti mengetahui undang-undang jalan raya serta maksud setiap papan tanda yang diletakkan di bahu jalan. Memandu pada kelajuan dibenarkan mampu mengurangkan impak sekiranya berlaku perkara yang tidak diingini. Patuhi had laju yang ditetapkan dan undang-undang jalan raya.

Namun dari aspek yang lain, keadaan jalan raya juga perlu diperhatikan pihak berkuasa. Jalan raya perlu dinaiki taraf dan dilakukan penambahbaikan terutama di kawasan sering berlaku kemalangan. Jalan raya berlubang, risiko tanah mendarat mestilah diatasi selain jalur garisan di jalan raya mestilah dalam keadaan baik.

Penganggur dituduh bunuh bapa

Petaling Jaya: Lelaki yang memukul bapa kandungnya hingga mati dengan menggunakan penyodok pasir, didakwa di Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam, atas tuduhan membunuh.

M Jaisino, 40, didakwa mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 kanun sama yang membawa hukuman gantung sampai mati.

Jaisino yang juga penganggur itu didakwa membunuh E Mangalam, 74, di sebuah rumah di Taman Dato Hormat di sini.

Perbuatan itu dilakukan pada jam 2.15 pagi, pada 26 Ogos lalu.

Bagaimanapun, tiada pengakuan direkodkan daripada tertuduh kerana kes bunuh berada di bawah bidang kuasa Mahkamah Tinggi.

Majistret Shahril Anuar Ahmad Mustapa kemudian menetapkan sebutan semula kes pada 6 Oktober ini.

WAWASANITA mahu teroka pasaran Pakistan, Brunei

Kuala Lumpur: Pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) yang membantu wanita dalam perniagaan, iaitu WAWASANITA menyasarkan untuk membawa golongan itu menembusi pasaran Pakistan dan Brunei menjelang suku ke-empat tahun ini.

Presidennya, Datin Dr Norli Alias berkata sehingga kini, hampir 90 syarikat yang berada di bawah persatuan itu sudah berjaya melebarkan sayap mereka ke lima negara memabatkan Indonesia, Myanmar, Korea, United Kingdom (UK) dan Thailand.

Mengulas lanjut katanya, Pakistan dan Brunei akan menjadi negara seterusnya untuk ditakluki usahawan WAWASANITA, memabatkan lebih 50 syarikat yang bersedia memasarkan produk mereka.

"Sebelum ini, kita sudah berada dalam fasa mencuba pasaran di lima negara apabila kami menjalinkan kerjasama antaranya dengan Persatuan Wanita Korea, Persatuan Peniaga Muslim Myanmar dan Patani Asean Mall.

"Kita berjaya membawa usahawan menembusi pasaran luar memabatkan kluster produk makanan dan minuman (F&B), fesyen, kecantikan, produk pakaian, hasil seni kraf dan perkhidmatan.

"Melalui sasaran penembusan pasaran ke Brunei dengan ker-

jasama daripada syarikat perkhidmatan penghantaran, produk yang bakal kita bawa lebih kepada F&B," katanya, di sini.

Norli ditemui ketika pengantaraan program *Go International Biz Pro, Chapter Selangor*, yang mengumpulkan sebanyak 84 syarikat daripada pelbagai latar belakang peniaga.

WAWASANITA sudah bertapak dalam industri keusahawanan selama 26 tahun, memabatkan penyertaan ahli perniagaan wanita dari seluruh negara.

Pada masa sama, Norli berkata, sehingga kini, sebanyak 89 syarikat di bawah WAWASANITA sudah berjaya menembusi pasaran luar memabatkan 130 produk.

Beri bantuan bimbingan

Beliau berkata, sebelum COVID-19, persatuan itu mempunyai keahlian memabatkan kira-kira 3,400 syarikat, namun kini ia berkurangan kepada 799 sahaja.

"Lebih 50 peratus gulung tikar kesan akibat COVID-19 dan saya mahu membantu mereka untuk kembali dalam bidang keusahawanan, kalau boleh tingkatkan jumlah pembabitkan semula dalam WAWASANITA sebanyak dua kali ganda," katanya.

Beliau berkata, WAWASANITA memberi bantuan dan bimbingan dalam aspek platform, pemasaran, latihan serta strategi

bagi memastikan mereka boleh menembusi pasaran luar.

Katanya, tidak hanya aspek bimbingan namun usahawan di bawah WAWASANITA, dipantau secara ketat bagi memastikan mereka bergerak dengan proaktif selepas enam bulan diberi latihan.

"Melalui WAWASANITA, kita mahu jadikan keusahawanan sebagai satu budaya dengan mewujudkan masyarakat usahawan

saling membantu," katanya.

Usahawan F&B, Norhaidah Samlee, berkata, penyertannya dalam WAWASANITA ternyata memberi hikmah buatnya apabila persatuan itu berjaya membantu beliau mengembangkan produknya sehingga ke UK.

Sebelum ini, pihaknya juga sudah berjaya menembusi pasaran di Jepun dan Amerika Syarikat (AS) melalui nasi lemak dan sambal bilis.

"Saya sudah 20 tahun berkecimpung dalam F&B dan pernah beroperasi di restoran serta catering sebelum membuka kilang di Bandar Bukit Raja, sejak lima tahun lalu.

"Di UK, kita sudah mencuba pasaran di Halal Street dan sudah memasuki Malakat Mall," katanya yang merancang untuk meluaskan pasaran bagi produk nasi lemak bersama sambal cendawan.

The group, led by chairman Kong Sien Hua, visited Fung Hai Chuo at her home at Taman Ixora here where they presented the items as well as a token ang pow.

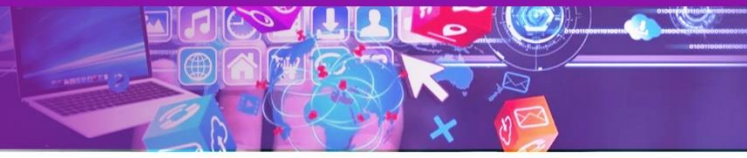
The donated items were also to assist Fung's daughter-in-law Wong Siew Chien, who has been unable to work as she is still suffering the effects of a stroke.

Duo slightly hurt after pickup truck skids off road, lands in ditch

BINTULU: Two women were injured Sunday after the pickup truck they were in skidded off the road and landed in a ditch at the Jepak roundabout, Jalan Kuala Tatau.

The Fire and Rescue Department in a statement said it dispatched a team from the Bintulu fire station to the scene after being informed of the

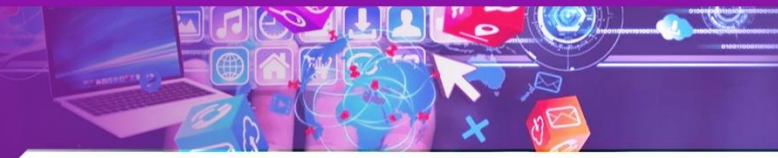

Motorcyclist succumbs to injuries sustained in accident involving lorry

KUCHING: A teenage motorcyclist succumbed to injuries sustained in an accident at the Kuching-Samarahan Expressway yesterday morning.

Acting Kuching police chief Supt Merbin Lisa said the 18-year-old was travelling alone towards Samarahan when the accident occurred around 6am.

"The motorcycle is said to have skidded and crashed before it was hit by a lorry travelling in

the same direction.

"The victim suffered serious injuries and was sent to Sarawak General Hospital for further treatment, but he later succumbed to his injuries," he said in a statement.

Merbin said police are investigating the case under Section 41 of the Road Transport Act 1987.

He also advised road users to stay focused while driving and to always obey traffic laws.

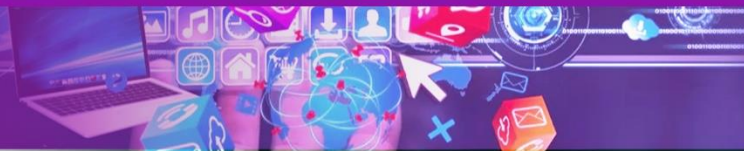

Woman pleads guilty to drug abuse charge, fined RM2,800

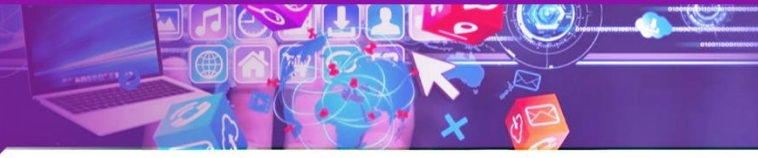
KUCHING: A woman was fined RM2,800 in default five months' jail after she pleaded guilty in a magistrates' court here yesterday to abusing drugs.

Dorothy Hu Xuan, 25, from Bintulu, made the plea before Magistrate Syarifah Fatimah Azura Wan Ali, who also placed her on two years of supervision by the authorities.

Hu was charged under Section 15(1)(a) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952 punishable under Section 15(1) of the same Act.

She tested positive for amphetamine, methamphetamine, ecstasy and methylenedioxyamphetamine, at the state Narcotics Criminal Investigation Department office at around 6.50am on June 25, 2023.

Insp Nur Shafiq Nyaie Ilin prosecuted, while Hu was unrepresented by legal counsel.

Parents want kids' sports tax relief

Proposed aid can help reduce financial burden, make children more active

PETALING JAYA: Parents are looking forward to the implementation of tax relief for sports training next year, as it would help them nurture their children's development through sports while reducing their financial burden.

Housewife Murniyantie Musa said the planned tax relief is a good initiative as it helps parents who want their children to be more active in sports and practice a healthy lifestyle.

The 34-year-old said she has enrolled her six-year-old daughter, Maya Mikayla Azwan, in weekly swimming classes.

"To shape the young to be active in sports, parents must bear the cost of monthly fees, events, competitions, and upgrading classes.

"If this tax relief is implemented, I can get my daughter involved in other sports such as archery and horse-riding, which are quite expensive," said the 35-year-old from Ipoh.

A data analyst who only wanted to be known as Ana said she is looking forward to the sports tax relief as it would reduce her financial burden.

"I have more than two children, so it would be nice to have the government subsidise part of the cost of something worthwhile for

the children, as they are the nation's next generation," she said.

She said she sends her children to weekly badminton lessons and would be more encouraged to expose them to other types of

sports, such as martial arts.

"It will provide a more holistic approach to children's physical and mental development.

"Children need an outlet for their energy, to combat any mental stress faced in school, and to

help build resilience," said the 36-year-old from Petaling Jaya.

She hoped the government would widen the range of activities eligible for the tax relief, including arts and skills-related courses, design, and robotics.



Human resource manager Masrah Marsinda also believed that the tax relief would encourage a healthy lifestyle among children and parents alike.

She said she has enrolled her son in martial arts classes such as boxing and silat, and intends to send him to other outdoor sports activities such as football or archery.

"With the rising number of bullying cases in schools, I make it mandatory for my kids to learn martial arts, and with more outdoor activities, they are more engaged with being physical rather than just playing video games at home," she said.

The 35-year-old from Rawang said she also hoped the government could consider extending tax relief to religious classes such as Quran and Arabic studies.

Sports Minister Hannah Yeoh recently announced that people who send their children for sports training or undergo such activity might qualify for personal tax relief starting next year.

She said this was the ministry's primary focus for the 2024 Budget, which has been presented to the Finance Ministry.

Man charged with murdering father

PETALING JAYA: A jobless man was charged at the Magistrate's Court yesterday with allegedly murdering his father at a house in Taman Dato Hormat last month.

M. Jaisino, 40, was said to have murdered his father E. Mangalam, 74, at about 2am on Aug 26.

He was charged under Section 302 of the Penal Code, which carries the death penalty.

Jaisino, who was unrepresented, nodded after the charge was read to him before Magistrate Shahril Anuar Ahmad Mustapa, but no plea was recorded as the case was under High Court jurisdiction.

DPP Nurul Sofea Jaysal did not propose bail as it was a non-bailable offence. The court fixed Oct 6 for mention.

Police detained Jaisino on Aug 29 for allegedly bludgeoning his father to death with a shovel.

Petaling Jaya police chief ACP Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid said he purportedly committed the crime after being frequently chided by the victim over his unemployment.

Family members later found the body of the victim wrapped in a curtain by a roadside in PJS 10. - Bernama

Wanita lumpuh separuh badan tabah hadapi ujian

Puncak Alam: Nikmat berjalan yang 'diambil' semula akibat kecederaan saraf tulang belakang atau *Spinal Cord Injury* kira-kira empat tahun lalu menjadikan wanita ini tabah menjalani kehidupan sukar yang mencabar mental dan keupayaannya.

Ini kerana Fazrin Abu Bakar, 43, yang juga yatim piatu mengharungi suka duka hidup seorang diri sebagai orang kurang upaya (OKU) yang kini lumpuh separuh badan dan menggunakan bantuan kerusi roda sepenuhnya.

Kisah semangat juang dimiliki Fazrin mendapat perhatian netizen apabila rakan senasibnya berkongsi kisah wanita tabah itu di akaun TikTiknya yang mendapat reaksi positif.

Fazrin berkata, pada mulanya dia terlantar di katil selama setahun kerana mengalami jangkitan kuman di kaki pada 2019 sebelum cedera saraf tulang belakang apabila tulang tengkuknya terkeluar daripada saraf tunjang secara tiba-tiba pada 2021.

Menurutnya, sejak itu dia yang menjalani kehidupan normal seperti wanita lain sebelum ini tidak boleh berjalan dan lumpuh



bermula paras pinggang hingga ke bawah.

Katanya, berbekalkan semangat, dia yang menjalani rawatan rehabilitasi kemudiannya berjaya berjalan semula dengan bantuan tongkat selama tiga bulan namun terjatuh pada Jun tahun lalu menyebabkan dia kembali tidak boleh berjalan.

"Saya kini bermula zero kembali dan masih menjalani terapi, tetapi doktor cakap kalau dapat berjalan semula adalah satu bonus.

"Sekarang saya memakai tiub untuk kencing, lampin pakai buang selain memerlukan bantuan ubat untuk membuang air besar malah saya kerap terjatuh dan akan meminta bantuan rakan atau pemandu e-hailing yang sudah biasa membawa saya ke hospital untuk membantu mengangkat saya.

"Saya menjalani kehidupan sebatang kara, boleh atau tidak saya perlu membolehkan diri menguruskan diri termasuk memasak makanan ringkas,"

katanya ketika ditemui di rumah sewanya di Seksyen 8, Bandar Puncak Alam di sini, kelmarin.

Katanya, sebelum ini dia pernah berkahwin namun reda apabila jodohnya tidak panjang sebelum berpisah dengan bekas suami pada April lalu.

"Ibu bapa saya sudah tiada sejak sekian lama dan saya pula anak tunggal. Kehidupan sekarang hanya ada diri saya saja," katanya.

Katanya, sebelum ini dia hanya suri rumah sambil berniaga pes asam pedas selepas berhenti kerja kilang namun tidak dapat kembali bekerja kerana keadaan dirinya dan menerima bantuan daripada zakat serta Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

"Sewa rumah RM800 dibayar pihak zakat dan bantuan JKJ RM300 diterima setiap bulan. Tiub kencing dan lampin pakai buang dapat bantuan daripada badan bukan kerajaan (NGO) tetapi bukanlah selalu.

"Kadang-kadang saya terpaksa tebakkan muka untuk pinjam wang daripada kawan untuk beli lampin pakai buang, biarpun malu mahu meminta bantuan kerana tidak cukup wang," katanya yang menjalani terapi dua kali seminggu di hospital.
