Lelaki kasari pemandu wanita direman

Tapah: Mahkamah Majistret semalam membenarkan seorang suspek lelaki yang didakwa menunjukkan isyarat lucu dan memukul kepala seorang wanita berdekatan pusat peranginan Lata Iskandar di sini Isnin lalu, direman tiga hari.

Majistret Siti Hanum Mohamad Sah membenarkan permohonan polis menahan reman lelaki berusia 29 tahun itu yang juga penyelia kilang di Serdang, Selangor bermula Rabu hingga Jumaat ini untuk membantu siasatan.

Kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 323 Kanun Keseksaan bagi kesalahan mendatangkan cedera serta Seksyen 506 dan 509 kanun sama kerana melakukan ugutan jenayah dan perbuatan mengaibkan kehormatan.

Terdahulu tular satu video berdurasi 59 saat yang memaparkan seorang lelaki berbaju merah keluar daripada kereta PROTON Persona dipandunya dan mengetuk cermin kenderaan sebelum memarahi pemandu wanita serta memukul kepala mangsa.

Dalam kejadian kira-kira 5.33 petang, pemandu wanita berusia 24 tahun berkenaan dilemparkan kata-kata kesat oleh lelaki itu sebelum kepalanya dipukul.

Kelmarin, Ketua Polis Perak, Datuk Seri Mohd Yusri Hassan Basri, berkata suspek ditahan polis di sekitar Serdang, Selangor selepas mangsa membuat laporan di Balai Polis Saujana Utama, Sungai Buloh, Selangor.

Siasatan lanjut dijalankan polis mendapati kejadian berlaku pada jam 5.33 petang, Isnin lalu, ketika mangsa berusia 24 tahun bersama adik lelakinya yang berusia 17 tahun dalam perjalanan dari Cameron Highlands ke Tapah.

"Mangsa dikatakan cuba memotong kereta suspek tetapi gagal, sebelum lelaki itu menunjukkan isyarat lucu dan memperlakukan kenderaan sehingga jalan menjadi sesak," katanya.

PEDi bantu usahawan kecil perkasa ilmu digital

Kursus asas komputer dan ICT disedia tingkat taraf sosiekonomi peniaga desa, bandar

Kuala Lumpur: Kewujudan Pusat Ekonomi Digital Keluarga Malaysia (PEDi) dapat melahirkan dan memperkasakan usahawan kecil ke arah pendigitalan yang inovatif dan berdaya saing bagi meningkatkan taraf sosioekonomi rakyat.

PEDi juga membantu meningkatkan jualan, malah turut membantu usahawan sama ada di bandar atau luar bandar memperkenalkan produk ke seluruh negara menerusi kaedah digital.

Pengurus PEDi Kampung Batu 1 Kuala Ketil di Baling, Kedah Zieadatul Zulkifli, berkata sebelum mendapat pendedahan di PEDi usahawan hanya dapat menembusi pasaran yang ada di sekitar Baling dengan berdagang secara fizikal.

Bagaimanapun, apabila diberi latihan dan bimbingan di PEDi, usahawan terbahagi dapat meluaskan pasaran mereka.

"Sebelum ini ada usahawan menghasilkan bahu tradisional yang kerap dijadikan sebagai hantaran perkahwinan. Beliau lebih gemar berjumpa pelanggan secara berdepan untuk melakukan jualan.

"Walaupun sudah ada aplikasi Shopee, usahawan terbabit tidak menggunakannya untuk menjual produk. Mungkin dia kurang faham atau tidak mahir menggunakan kaedah perniagaan dalam talian.

"Namun, selepas mengikuti latihan di PEDi dan diberikan bimbingan untuk memasarkan produk serta cara untuk kongsi pautan kepada orang ramai, akhirnya dia berjaya juga melariskan produk bahunya secara digital," katanya.

Bengkel asas fotografi

Zieadatul berkata, selain itu PEDi juga berperanan membantu usahawan dengan kursus asas komputer, multimedia serta teknologi maklumat dan komunikasi (ICT), termasuk membimbing mereka cara mengambil gambar produk untuk dipasarkan di media sosial.

Katanya, bagi mencapai tujuan itu program bengkel asas fotografi diadakan bagi mendedahkan usahawan cara mengambil gambar dengan pencahayaan yang tepat dan mempelajari mengenai suntingan gambar; ia sekali gus mendekatkan usahawan ilmu pengetahuan media digital dan pendekatan mengenai ICT.

"Selain itu, kita juga ajarkan cara bagaimana untuk menghasilkan risalah, logo perniagaan dan juga pelekat untuk ditampal pada produk mereka. Pada masa sama, kita juga membimbing usahawan bagaimana untuk mendaftarkan perniagaan di Suruhanjaya Syarikat Malaysia (SSM)," katanya.

Beliau berkata, PEDi juga memberi impak penting bagi membantu usahawan menjana pendapatan melalui ekonomi digital khususnya suri rumah.

"Ada suri rumah mempunyai

kemahiran untuk menghasilkan kek tetapi selalunya kek yang dibuat dimakan oleh anak dan juga ahli keluarga terdekat.

"Sekarang ini kita bantu dia bagaimana untuk mendapatkan lebih banyak pelanggan. Mungkin di luar lingkungan keluarga atau jiran dalam kawasan yang sama ataupun di tempat lain. Inilah impak yang PEDi boleh bantu supaya komuniti dapat menjana pendapatan," katanya.

Beliau berharap, komuniti dapat memanfaatkan PEDi ini sebaiknya supaya pusat berkenaan dapat berkekalan.

Tumpu kemahiran internet

Pengurus PEDi Projek Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) Hiliran Ampang, Mohd Fikri Yahya pula berkata, PEDi di kawasan bandar lebih menumpukan untuk memberikan bimbingan kepada komuniti bagaimana untuk menggunakan internet.

"Di bandar ini walaupun di PPR, kita lebih mudah mendapatkan akses. Bagaimanapun, tidak ramai yang mahir untuk menggunakannya. Banyak program yang kita adakan bertujuan untuk mendidik komuniti.

"Contohnya seperti pendedahan kepada scam. Kita mengajar mereka teknik yang digunakan oleh scammer supaya mereka tidak terpedaya. Scam ini bahaya kerana mereka boleh menggunakan maklumat peribadi untuk pelbagai tujuan.

"Kita juga ada menyediakan kelas untuk kanak-kanak supaya berhati-hati dalam menggunakan komputer dan tidak menjadi mangsa seksual di media sosial," katanya.

Selain itu, beliau berkata, impak PEDi ini, ramai usahawan yang mendapat manfaat terutama peniaga gerai makan.

"Usahawan gerai makan di sekitar PPR ini kami bantu mereka untuk kembangkan perniagaan. Kita juga membantu mereka untuk mereka cipta menu baharu sekiranya mereka memerlukan.

"Ramai juga usahawan yang kami bantu untuk kembangkan perniagaan dengan kerjasama agensi, contohnya seperti Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO), Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) dan Perbadanan Ekonomi Digital Malaysia (MDEC). Malah, jurulatih daripada MDEC juga kerap datang ke sini bagi mengadakan kelas," katanya.

Katanya, sebelum pandemik COVID-19, ramai yang datang ke PEDi untuk melakukan pelbagai kegiatan tetapi kini ramai yang menumpukan kepada industri ekonomi digital.

Beliau turut berharap lebih ramai komuniti boleh memanfaatkan usaha kerajaan ini. Tambahan pula, komputer yang ada di PEDi ini sudah ditambah baik dengan peralatan baharu dan menggunakan lebih banyak perisian.

Usahawan wanita perlu rebut peluang perniagaan IP

Cabaran usahawan wanita mendepani dunia perniagaan sering terlindung di sebalik 'bayang-bayang lelaki' walaupun pencapaian dan sumbangan golongan hawa dalam pelbagai bidang termasuk politik, ekonomi serta sosial amat penting bagi membentuk kesejahteraan, kemajuan dan kemakmuran sesebuah negara.

Dalam perniagaan membabitkan harta intelek (IP) khususnya, bilangan usahawan wanita menceburi bidang itu masih kurang berbanding lelaki. Dalam hal ini, Pertubuhan Harta Intelek Dunia (WIPO), menyediakan sokongan dan

sumber diperlukan untuk membantu wanita melindungi serta meningkatkan nilai perusahaannya mereka melalui penggunaan IP.

IP adalah perniagaan permulaan dipacu inovasi, sama ada dalam bentuk paten, hak cipta, reka bentuk perindustrian dan rahsia dagangan. Ia penting dalam memastikan keunikan produk dan menangani isu cetak rompak atau pelanggaran hak daripada pesaing.

Pada masa ini, beberapa pejabat IP tempatan di seluruh dunia sedang melancarkan inisiatif bertujuan menyokong wanita dalam perniagaan IP. Pejabat Ketua Pengawal Paten, Reka Bentuk

dan Tanda Dagangan (CGPDTM) India contohnya menawarkan pengurangan yuran 80 peratus kepada syarikat baharu dan usahawan wanita.

Latihan membina kemahiran

Di Amerika Syarikat (AS), Pejabat Paten dan Tanda Dagangan (USPTO) turut mengurangkan yuran untuk entiti kecil dan mikro sebanyak 60 dan 80 peratus. Institut Harta Perindustrian Mexico (IMPI) pula menawarkan pelbagai sumber, termasuk latihan membina kemahiran, bimbingan membantu wanita menambah nilai dan mengkomersialkan teknologi inovatif.

Di Malaysia, usahawan wanita berjaya di dalam perniagaan berteraskan IP dilihat tidak jauh ketinggalan. Contohnya penyelidik Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), Prof Emeritus Datuk Dr Asma Ismail mempelopori pengkomersialan diagnostik pantas penyakit demam kepialu, dipatenkan di lebih 20 negara.

Penyelidik Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM), Prof Dr Lai Oi Ming, pengasas syarikat pemula Lipidware berjaya mengkomersialkan paten krim pelembap penghidap ekzema turut digunakan di China ketika pandemik COVID-19 melanda.

Malaysia harus berbangga dengan usahawan wanita seperti Tan Hooi Ling, pengasas bersama aplikasi Grab menyediakan perkhidmatan e-panggilan merentas Asia Tenggara dan Pazdilah Enda Sulaiman, usahawan telekung inovasi Siti Khadijah.

Secara keseluruhannya kesedaran usahawan tempatan di Malaysia tanpa mengira jantina termasuk perusahaan-perusahaan kecil dan sederhana (PMKS) berhubung kepentingan IP dilihat semakin meningkat apabila 46,812 pendaftaran IP direkodkan pada 2021.

Peruntukan bernilai RM2 juta Dana Pemfanaan IP disediakan Perbadanan Harta Intelek Malaysia (MyIPO) pada 2023 harus diambil peluang usahawan wanita untuk mengembangkan idea perniagaan mereka.

Inisiatif lain seperti Yayasan Inovasi Malaysia (YIM) di bawah Kementerian Tenaga, Sains, Teknologi dan Inovasi (MOSTI) melalui dana Inovasi Sosial Malaysia bagi membangunkan inovasi tempatan dan usahawan B40 juga langkah penting membantu usahawan wanita memulakan langkah perniagaan mereka.

Malaysia harus mencontohi WIPO, berterusan menjalankan pelbagai program bimbingan IP di seluruh dunia untuk membantu perniagaan diterajui usahawan wanita melindungi dan memanfaatkan aset IP. Perniagaan berpacu IP kini menjadi agenda utama supaya manfaat inovasi dapat dinikmati masyarakat dan negara.

Pembentukan ekosistem inovasi mapan ditunjangi kerajaan, universiti atau agensi penyelidikan serta pemain industri perlu menjadi obligasi utama kerajaan bagi memacu IP sebagai asas perniagaan mampu memberi impak tinggi kepada usahawan dan Malaysia.

Dua nafi rompak warga emas 3 kali

Ipoh: Dua individu dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam atas pertuduhan memecah masuk kediaman dan merompak pasangan warga emas sama sebanyak tiga kali dalam tempoh tiga minggu.

M Hari Chandra, 41, dan Lawrence Anthony Das, 39, bagaimanapun mengaku tidak bersalah ketika pertuduhan dibacakan secara bersama ke atas mereka di hadapan Hakim Ainon Shahrin Mohamad.

Berdasarkan kertas pertuduhan, mereka didakwa melakukan rompak berkumpulan dengan bersenjata pisau terhadap Chan Liew Chan, 72, di sebuah rumah di Regat Tasek Timur 20, Taman Ria di sini, jam 3 pagi 24 Mei lalu.

Kesalahan itu boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 395 Kanun Keseksaan dan dibaca bersama Seksyen 397 Kanun yang sama, sabit kesalahan memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan.

Pendakwa dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Mohd Nazreen Zabarudin manakala kedua-dua tertuduh tidak diwakili peguam.

Mohd Nazreen tidak menawarkan jaminan terhadap tertuduh dengan mengambil kira keterangan mangsa bahawa kedua-dua tertuduh melakukan jenayah itu sebanyak tiga kali di rumah yang sama iaitu rumah mangsa.

Mohd Nazreen bagaima-

napun memohon pertimbangan mahkamah bahawa sekiranya tertuduh dibenarkan untuk dijamin, ia mesti disertakan dengan syarat tambahan iaitu tertuduh tidak boleh mengganggu mangsa selain perlu melapor diri ke balai polis dua kali sebulan sehingga kes selesai.

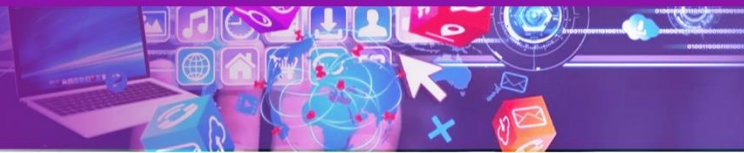
Mahkamah membenarkan kedua-dua tertuduh diikat jamin RM15,000 dengan seorang penjamin setiap seorang selain bersetuju dengan syarat tambahan yang dipohon oleh pihak pendakwaan sebelumnya.

Hakim turut menetapkan tarikh 7 Julai ini untuk sebutan semula kes.

Sementara itu, dalam kamar mahkamah berasingan, rakan kepada kedua-dua tertuduh itu iaitu M Shashipal Singh, 33, turut didakwa dengan pertuduhan secara curang menyimpan harta curi berupa sebuah telefon bimbit kepunyaan Liew Chan dengan pengetahuan bahawa barangan terbabit adalah hasil rompakan berkumpulan.

Shashipal Singh bagaimanapun turut mengaku tidak bersalah ketika pertuduhan dibaca di hadapan Hakim Azizah Ahmad.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan, lelaki itu didakwa menyimpan harta curi berupa sebuah telefon bimbit jenama Huawei 3i kepunyaan Liew Chan dengan pengetahuan bahawa barangan terbabit adalah hasil rompakan berkumpulan.

Isteri tak balik sejak keluar rumah 26 Mei

Puchong: Seorang jurutera bimbang dengan keselamatan isteri selepas usaha mengesan wanita itu yang hilang selepas keluar rumah sejak 26 Mei lalu, menemui jalan buntu.

Lelaki yang mahu dikenali Liew, 57, berkata isterinya Ng Saw Hoon, 56, keluar rumah di Bandar Puchong di sini dan dia hanya mengetahui kehilangan wanita itu sebaik pulang ke rumah pada jam 1.30 tengah hari dan mencari isteri tiada di rumah.

Katanya, dia membuat semakan rakaman kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) mendapati isterinya keluar membawa beg pakaian sebelum menaiki sebuah kenderaan pelbagai guna (MPV) Proton Exora.

"Saya cuba menghubunginya tetapi gagal. Saya kemudian keluar mencarinya di kawasan sekitar dan menghubungi anak serta saudara lain meminta bantuan tetapi mereka juga ti-

dak tahu di mana isteri saya berada.

"Selepas 24 jam kehilangan isteri dan usaha mencarinya tidak berhasil, saya membuat laporan di Balai Polis Puchong," katanya dalam sidang media di Pejabat Parti Gerakan Rakyat Malaysia (Gerakan) Bahagian Puchong di sini, semalam.

Turut hadir Pengerusi Gerakan Bahagian Puchong Jimmy Chew Jyh Gang.

Ber cerita lanjut, Liew berkata, sebelum kehilangan isterinya yang juga suri rumah, wanita itu tidak menunjukkan sebarang perubahan dan hanya mengadu sakit badan serta pening.

Malah, katanya, mereka juga tidak bertengkar atau berselisih faham yang boleh menyebabkan wanita itu melarikan diri.

Beliau meminta orang ramai yang mempunyai maklumat mengenai Saw Hoon supaya menghubunginya di talian 012-2781399 atau Liew di talian 011-69545856.

Johor Bahru: Suami isteri dilepas tanpa dibebaskan oleh Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam atas pertuduhan pindaan bertindak cuai terhadap seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia empat tahun, dua bulan lalu.

Hakim Datuk Ahmad Kamal Arifin Ismail membuat keputusan itu selepas mendapati pertuduhan pindaan yang dikemukakan pihak pendakwaan terdapat elemen penduaan.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan pindaan, tertuduh, S Nagen-dran dan A Sangeetha, kedua-duanya berusia 23 tahun, didakwa mencapai niat bersama bertindak secara cuai terhadap kanak-kanak yang berada di bawah pemeliharaan mereka itu dengan cara yang mungkin akan menyebabkannya mengalami kecederaan fizikal.

Perbuatan itu didakwa dilakukan di rumah mereka dekat Skudai Villa Apartment, Jalan Aman, Taman Skudai Baru di sini, jam 12.30 tengah malam, 28 April lalu.

Mereka didakwa mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 dibaca

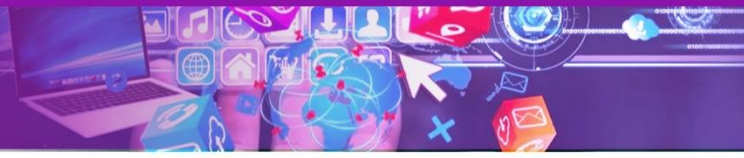

bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang memperuntukkan hukuman denda sehingga RM50,000 atau penjara maksimum 20 tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Pada 3 Mei lalu, suami isteri itu mengaku bersalah bagi pertuduhan mencapai niat bersama menganiayai kanak-kanak yang berada di bawah pemeliharaan mereka itu dengan cara yang mungkin akan menyebabkannya mengalami kecederaan fizikal.

Mahkamah menetapkan semalam, untuk menjatuhkan hukuman. Bagaimanapun, pendakwaan yang dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Umar Faiz Abdul Kohar mengemukakan pertuduhan pindaan itu semalam.

Kedua-dua tertuduh kemudian mengaku tidak bersalah dan mohon dibicarakan bagi pertuduhan pindaan selepas dibacakan jurubahasa mahkamah.

Siti Nurhaliza kongsi pentas dengan Foster

Kuala Lumpur: Impian Datuk Seri Siti Nurhaliza (**gambar**) untuk berkongsi pentas dengan maestro muzik, David Foster akhirnya menjadi nyata apabila diundang membuat persembahan pada Konsert David Foster & Friends Asia 2023 pada 7 Ogos ini di Mega Star Arena, di sini.

Lebih bermakna, kata Siti, 44, pihak pengurusan komposer terkenal dari Kanada itu bukan saja mengundangnya untuk menjayakan konsert di sini, tetapi juga konsert di Singapura yang berlangsung kesokannya.

"Kali pertama saya beraksi bersama Foster ialah di persembahan eksklusif pada 2014. Saya juga berdoaa bukan persembahan per-

tama dan terakhir. Selepas itu, saya diundang pihak pengurusan mereka beberapa kali membuat persembahan bersama di Indonesia tapi rezeki tidak menyebelahi saya ketika itu.

"Justeru, saya tidak akan sia-siakan peluang ini ketika ramai penyanyi muda yang bagus di luar tetapi pasukan pengurusan Foster tetap memanggil saya," katanya ketika ditemui di sidang media Konsert David Foster & Friends di sebuah hotel terkemuka di sini, semalam.

Hadir sama, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif Prihatin, Datuk Mohd Aizuddin Ghazali. Konsert berkenaan dianjurkan Yayasan Prihatin Nasional.

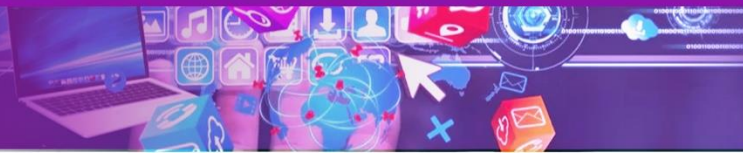

ATTACKED FEMALE DRIVER

3-day remand for alleged road bully

TAPAH: A man who allegedly hurled abusive words and hit a female driver's head has been remanded for three days.

Magistrate Siti Hanum Mohamad Sah granted the order, which will last until Friday, for police to carry out investigations against the 29-year-old man.

The case is being investigated under Sections 323, 506 and 509 of the Penal Code for causing hurt, criminal intimidation and intent to insult a woman's modesty, respectively.

In a 59-second video posted by Facebook user Aizacd Zack, a man clad in a red T-shirt was seen getting out of his car, knocking on the female driver's window and berating her over her driving.

"Drive your car properly. Your (driving) is endangering other people's lives.

"Don't mess around! Don't make me hit you!"

The woman was seen trying to explain her situation to the angry man, but he continued hurling abusive words at her.

He was then seen hitting her head more than once.

On Tuesday, Perak police chief Datuk Seri Mohd Yusri Hassan Basri said the 24-year-old female driver had lodged a report at the Saujana Utama police station in Sungai Buloh, Selangor, about 10am.

"Initial investigations found that the incident happened yesterday (Monday) at 5.33pm when

the woman was driving to Tapah from Cameron Highlands.

"The female driver, who was with her 17-year-old brother, wanted to overtake the man's car, but she could not do so, and the man made obscene gestures."

When the road became congested near Lata Iskandar Resort here, said Yusri, the man confronted the woman and began scolding and threatening her.

Yusri said further checks on the man's vehicle registration number showed that the car belonged to a woman, who lives in Tanjung Karang, Selangor.

"Police located the man in Serdang, Selangor," he said, adding that the man worked as a factory supervisor.

Duo charged with armed gang robbery

IPOH: Two friends who had allegedly broken into a house belonging to a senior citizen couple three times in a month were charged with armed gang robbery at the Sessions Court, here.

M. Hari Chandra, 41, and Lawrence Anthony Das, 39, pleaded not guilty when the charge was jointly read before judge Aion Shahrin Mohamad.

According to the charge sheet, the two were accused of committing gang robbery armed with knives at a house in Regat Tasek Timur at 3am on May 24.

The offence under Section 395 of the Penal Code provides a maximum of 20 years' jail and whipping upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Mohd Nazreen Zabarudin requested that no bail be granted to the accused, but if the court were to grant bail, it must be accompanied by additional conditions that they must not disturb the victim and for them to report to

the nearest police station twice a month until the case is settled.

During mitigation, Hari Chandra pleaded for bail as he was taking care of his sick sister and mother and would be getting married soon.

Meanwhile, Lawrence also pleaded for bail to be granted to him as he is a sole breadwinner and has a school-going child.

Both accused were unrepresented.

Aion granted bail of RM15,000 with one surety each and agreed to the additional conditions as proposed by the DPP and set July 7 for mention.

In a separate courtroom, the duo's friend, M. Shashipal Singh, was charged with dishonestly receiving property stolen in the commission of a gang robbery.

The 33-year-old accused pleaded not guilty to the charge when it was read before judge Azizah Ahmad.

According to the charge sheet, the man was accused of possessing a stolen item, a Huawei 3i mobile phone belonging to the victims of the duo.

The offence was allegedly committed at Rumah Pangsa Bercham, Lengkok Bercham Timur 2 here at 3.45pm on June 4.

The accused was charged under Section 412 of the Penal Code, which carries a jail sentence of up to 20 years, and is liable to a fine.

DPP Mohammad Haiqal Asyraf Suhaimi prosecuted while the accused was unrepresented.

The court set bail at RM4,000 and fixed July 7 for mention.

BINTULU: A family of five was unscathed after their house at KM16 Tatau-Sangan Road was completely destroyed by fire Tuesday night.

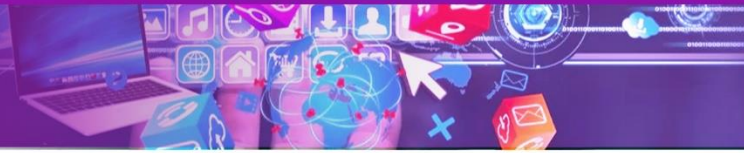
Tatau fire station chief Jankey Jikat said nine firefighters were dispatched to the scene after being notified about the outbreak at 8.29pm.

Sharing how she landed in prison, Abby said she was arrested with two kg of methamphetamine after being instructed by her aunt to sell it.

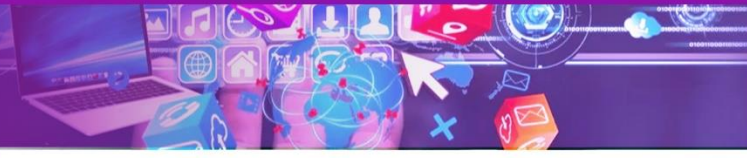
"After my mother passed away and my father left, I lived with my aunt and as we did not have

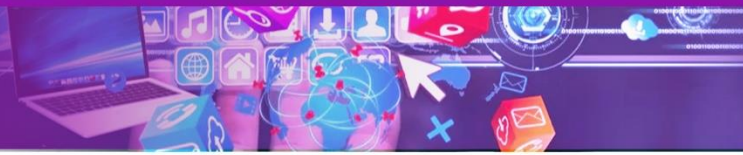

Mum, step-dad DNAA over mistreatment of boy

JOHOR BAHRU: The Sessions Court here yesterday gave a discharge not amounting to an acquittal (DNAA) to a married couple on a charge of negligence that likely caused physical injury to the woman's four-year-old son.

According to charge sheet, both accused were charged with the common intent of acting negligently towards the child in their care in a manner likely to cause him physical injury.



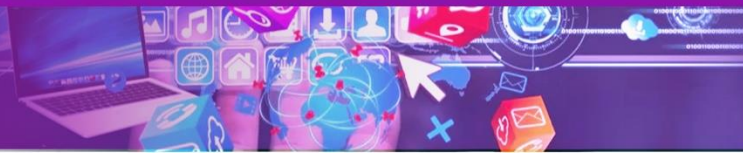

The couple was accused of carrying out the offence at an apartment at 12.30am on April 28.

The charge was made in accordance with Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001 read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which provides for a fine of up

to RM50,000 or a maximum of 20 years in prison, or both.

Both the accused had changed their plea to not guilty after the amended charge was read out to them. The prosecution is expected to re-charge the two accused. — Bernama

RSK Cheras was established to provide protection, rehabilitation, development and

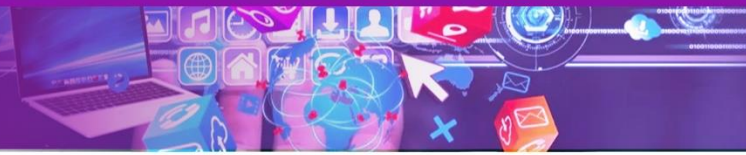
integration to senior citizens to improve their quality of life. At present, there are 211 occupants of the RSK Cheras, 126 of whom are men.

Couple charged with abusing boy let off on a technicality

JOHOR BARU: A couple charged with abusing their four-year-old boy who later died have been given a discharge not amounting to an acquittal by the Sessions Court here over a technicality.

The boy's stepfather S. Nagendran and his mother A. Sangeetha, both 23, had been charged on May 3 with acting negligently towards a child in their care to the extent that it caused him physical injury.

The two had allegedly committed the offence at the Skudai Villa Apartment, Jalan Aman, Taman Skudai Baru, here at 12.30am on

April 29.

According to the charge sheet, the act is an offence under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2011 that was read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which provides for a fine not exceeding RM50,000 or a maximum jail term of 20 years, or both, if convicted.

The accused claimed trial to these charges yesterday in front of judge Datuk Ahmad Kamal Arifin Ismail after earlier pleading guilty on May 3.

During yesterday's proceedings, Ahmad Kamal said the prosecution had included two distinct offences in one charge, which is duplicity.

The court then ordered the accused to be discharged but not acquitted.

It was reported that a four-year-old boy died on April 29 after he was believed to have been physically abused by his mother and stepfather.

Dad dies while trying to save daughter

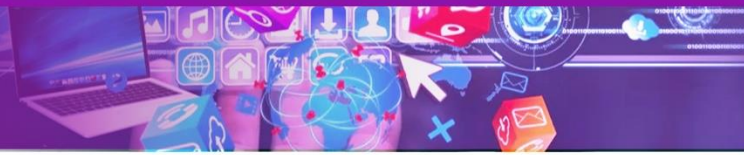
KUALA LUMPUR: A father's courageous attempt to save his daughter struggling in the water in Tasik Metropolitan Kepong ended tragically after both drowned.

Family claims trial to rioting after fatal road accident

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GEORGE TOWN: A couple and their son have pleaded not guilty at the Magistrate's Court here to rioting in a public place following a road accident that killed a woman motorcyclist in Tanjung Bungah.

The three accused – Oo Teck Yeon, 55, his wife Chuah Chew Ting, 54, and their son Oo Cheng Sing, 28 – claimed trial after their charges were read before Magistrate Mohamad Azlan Basri yesterday.

They were accused of rioting in Jalan Loh Poh Heng, Tanjung Bungah, at 11.20am on May 8, and charged under Section 160 of the Penal Code, which carries a jail term of six months or a RM1,000 fine, or both, if convicted.

Mohamad Azlan then set RM5,000 bail in one surety for each accused.

However, lawyer Zainal Akram Zainal Azahar, who represented the three accused, requested that

the bail be reduced as his clients had been given police bail on May 9 and had been cooperating well with the authorities.

He said his male clients were currently employed while his

female client is a housewife.

Mohamad Azlan then reduced the bail amount to RM2,500 in one surety for each accused.

He also set July 11 for case mention and submission of documents.

On May 12, police arrested six individuals allegedly involved in a scuffle following a road accident that killed a woman motorcyclist on the spot.

A viral video showed a car crashing into a motorcyclist, with both the victim and the car then crashing into the pavement along a housing area.

A fight occurred at the same location, possibly minutes after the accident, with several people seen scuffling while others tried to break up the fight.

Police said those involved in the fight were family members of the motorcyclist and the car driver.

Second woman state fire chief

It does not matter if you are male or female, says new Johor head Rohani

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JOHOR BARU: Siti Rohani Nadir became only the second woman in the country to become the head of a state Fire and Rescue Department when she was appointed Johor's chief fire officer.

The new state director said she was prepared to take on the challenge and would give her fullest commitment to the job, just like her male colleagues.

"We know that there are not many women officers in the department. There are only about 4% of women officers compared with men in the department," said the 52-year-old mother of five from Parit Sulong in Batu Pahat.

"However, I do not see this as an issue.

"At the end of the day, the job is the same whether you are a male or a female."

She said that as state director her top priority would be addressing the lack of firefighters and assets.

There are some 144 vacancies for firemen in the state, which also needs 54 fire engines for its 33 stations.

"The issue has yet to reach a critical point, but it could affect operations, especially since Johor is a state that has been attending to the second highest number of operations after Selangor.

"We understand that it will take time and proper planning for the issue to be tackled at the headquarters level, but I hope that it can be addressed in stages," she added.

Siti Rohani was speaking after a welcoming ceremony when she

clocked in for the first time at the state Fire and Rescue Department headquarters yesterday.

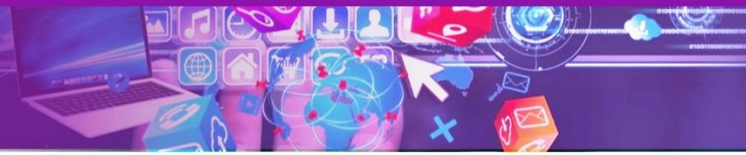
She added that a new batch of firemen would complete their training by the end of this year.

"We are unsure how many of them will be posted to Johor but I hope that this would at least reduce some of our manpower issues," she said.

Siti Rohani, who started her career in Negri Sembilan in 1997, said she would continue carrying on programmes and policies that were progressing well in Johor.

"Johor is a large state and there will be some challenges that we would need to face, including in terms of manpower and preparation for the ongoing monsoon," she said.

The first woman to head a state department is current Perak fire chief Sayani Saidon.

Two men plead not guilty to robbing elderly couple

IPOH: Two men pleaded not guilty to robbing an elderly couple at their house in Bercham.

M. Hari Chandran, 41, and AD Lawrence, 39, who were charged together, claimed trial after the charges were read to them in Tamil before Judge Ainul Shahrin Mohamad at the Sessions Court here yesterday.

According to the charge sheet, the duo allegedly committed the offence at Chan Liew Chan's house at Regat Tasek Timur 20, Taman Ria, at around 3am on May 24.

Deputy Public Prosecutor Mohamad Nazreen Zabardin requested that bail be denied due to the seriousness of the case.

wife's mother," he said.

Lawrence, who was also unrepresented, said he is the sole breadwinner with a child who is still in school.

Judge Ainul set the bail at RM15,000 with one surety for each accused, who must also

report themselves twice a month at the nearest police station.

"Both accused are not allowed to disturb the victims and must report themselves every 1st and 15th of every month at the nearest police station, failing which they can be remanded," she said.

She also fixed the case mention on July 7.

Separately, a 33-year-old man pleaded not guilty to keeping a stolen cellphone.

M. Shashipal Singh claimed trial after the charges were read to him before Judge Azizah Ahmad.

According to the charge sheet, Shashipal was found with a blue-coloured phone belonging to Chan at a flat in Lengkok Bercham Timur on June 4.

Judge Azizah set bail at RM4,000 with one surety, while Shashipal must report himself at the nearest police station once a month.

She fixed July 7 for mention of the case, which is prosecuted by DPP Haigal Asyraf Suhaimi.

Man filmed assaulting woman motorist remanded

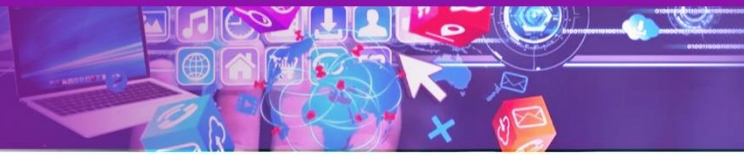
IPOH: A man seen in a video posted on social media assaulting a woman driver while travelling from Cameron Highlands to Tapah has been remanded for three days.

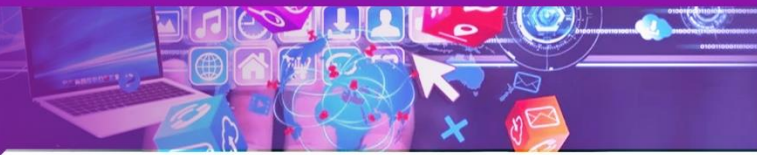

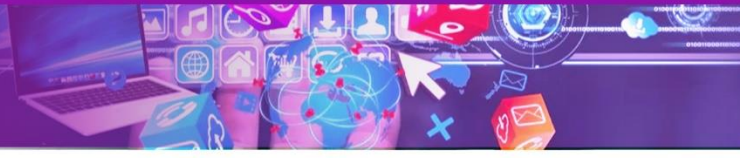
