19 langkah ringan beban rakyat sudah dilaksanakan

Kuala Lumpur: Kerajaan Perpaduan sudah melaksanakan sekurang-kurangnya 19 inisiatif untuk membantu mengurangkan beban ekonomi rakyat, hanya dalam tempoh tujuh bulan pentadbirannya.

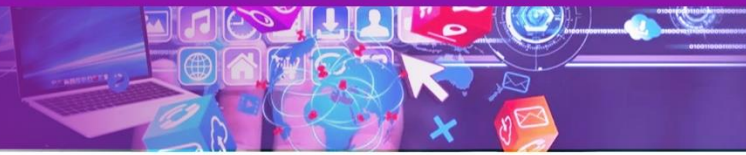
Menerusi satu video khas siri pertama laporan pencapaian Kerajaan Perpaduan, Menteri Komunikasi dan Digital, Fahmi Fadzil, merangkumkan inisiatif berkenaan, membabitkan pengenalan beberapa inisiatif dan bantuan baharu serta menaikkan kadar bantuan sedia ada.

Daripada 19 inisiatif yang sudah dilaksanakan, sembilan daripadanya membabitkan peningkatan kadar bantuan sedia ada yang memanfaatkan pelajar, anak muda, golongan berpendapatan rendah, guru Kelas Agama dan Fardu Ain, penjawat awam, pesara kerajaan dan pekebun.

Menurut Fahmi, ia merangkumi kenaikan elaun sara hidup pelajar tajaan Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA) kepada RM1,100 sebulan; Bantuan Awal Persekolahan menjadi RM150; e-dompet (RM200) serta Sumbangan Tunai Rahmah yang diberi sehingga RM2,500, berbanding RM1,800 bagi Bantuan Prihatin Rakyat sebelum ini.

Selain itu, katanya, elaun 35,000 guru Kelas Al-Quran & Fardu Ain (KAFA) dinaikkan kepada RM1,100 sebulan, manakala sumbangan imam, bilal, tok siak, noja, marbut, guru KAFA dan guru takmir naik kepada RM600.

Bantuan Aidilfitri kepada penjawat awam dan pesara kerajaan turut dinaikkan, masing-masing kepada RM700 dan RM250, manakala bantuan musim tengkujuh kepada pekebun meningkat kepada RM800 berbanding RM600 sebelum ini.

79,668 lepasan SPM ditawarkan ke universiti awam

Putrajaya: Sejumlah 79,668 lepasan Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) ditawarkan tempat ke universiti awam (UA) untuk pengajian asasi, diploma dan ijazah sarjana muda bagi sesi akademik 2023/2024.

Kementerian Pengajian Tinggi (KPT) melalui kenyataan berkata, mereka sebahagian daripada 144,911 calon lepasan SPM yang membuat permohonan bagi melanjutkan pengajian melalui UPUOnline.

Kenyataan sama memaklumkan 65,243 calon SPM ditawarkan melanjutkan pengajian di

politeknik, kolej komuniti (KK) dan institusi latihan kemahiran awam (ILKA) yang menawarkan program pengajian peringkat sijil dalam bidang Pendidikan Teknikal dan Latihan Vokasional (TVET).

"Sebanyak 500 program pengajian ditawarkan bagi sesi 2023/2024, iaitu 47 pengajian asasi, 309 (diploma), satu (ijazah sarjana muda) dan 143 (sijil).

"Kemasukan pelajar ke institusi berkenaan dibuat berasaskan prinsip meritokrasi, dengan menyusun semua calon yang layak tanpa mengira kaum, aga-

ma, jantina, negeri, taraf hidup dan tempat tinggal mengikut markah merit tertinggi hingga terendah," katanya.

Prinsip meritokrasi adalah berasaskan 90 peratus pencapaian akademik dan 10 peratus pencapaian kokurikulum.

"Seramai 61,286 calon lelaki dan 83,625 calon perempuan berjaya mendapat tawaran kemasukan ke UA, politeknik, KK dan ILKA bagi program lepasan SPM," kata kenyataan itu lagi.

KPT juga memaklumkan secara keseluruhan, tawaran laluan

husus ialah sebanyak 14,619 iaitu 13,649 diberikan kepada calon dari keluarga B40, 346 kepada orang kurang upaya (OKU), 335 (atlet), 289 (Orang Asli) dan 26 calon lepasan institusi di bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

Mengenai calon tidak mendapat tawaran, KPT memaklumkan antara faktor kegagalan ialah tidak memenuhi syarat am atau syarat khas program pengajian, tiada kekosongan tempat terutama bagi program kompetitif dan kedudukan merit rendah.

KPT mempelawa mereka untuk membuat rayuan melalui UPUOnline dalam tempoh 10 hari mulai semalam sehingga jam 5 petang pada 16 Julai ini.

Selain itu, KPT mengesahkan 164,028 daripada 403,637 calon yang menduduki SPM tidak membuat permohonan melalui UPUOnline atas beberapa faktor, antaranya kerana sudah mendapat tawaran menyambung pengajian di kolej matrikulasi Kementerian Pendidikan, institut pendidikan guru, institusi pengajian tinggi swasta dan Majlis Amanah Rakyat. Budak 3 tahun maut didera kekasih ibu

Suspek mengaku tendang mangsa hingga tengkorak retak, organ dalam perut pecah

Melaka: Seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia tiga tahun maut didera teman lelaki ibunya yang dipercayai menekan perut dan menendang mangsa hingga menyebabkan tengkorak retak dan organ dalam perut pecah.

Ketua Polis Daerah Melaka Tengah, Asisten Komisioner, Christopher Patit, berkata siasatan awal polis mendapati suspek mengaku menendang mangsa secara agresif kerana muntah di atas sofa kesayangannya kelmarin.

Beliau berkata suspek juga mengaku menekan perut kanak-kanak itu secara agresif berkali-kali, selain menendang sehingga kepala mangsa terhantuk ke lantai.

Katanya, akibat perbuatan kejam itu, tengkorak mangsa retak selain organ dalam perut turut pecah.

"Sebaik tiba di Hospital Melaka pada 6.50 pagi, kanak-kanak yang dalam keadaan tidak sedarkan diri dirawat di Zon Merah dan diberikan bantuan pernafasan lebih sejam.

"Namun doktor mendapati mangsa tidak memberikan sebarang reaksi sebelum disahkan meninggal dunia pada jam 9.15 pagi," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Christopher berkata, mangsa

dihantar ke rumah suspek berusia 25 tahun di Cheng oleh ibu mangsa berusia 24 tahun untuk berubat jam 5.30 pagi kelmarin selepas dikatakan kerap muntah.

Bagaimanapun, katanya 40 minit kemudian, suspek menghubungi ibu mangsa memaklumkan anaknya terjatuh dan tidak sedarkan diri sebelum kedua-dua mereka membawa mangsa ke Hospital Melaka.

Katanya, mangsa dibawa ke Jabatan Perubatan Forensik HM jam 10.30 pagi untuk tindakan selanjutnya dan pemeriksaan awal doktor mendapati terdapat kesan kecederaan di kepala dan badannya.

Beliau berkata, ibu kandung mangsa dan teman lakinya ke-

mudian ditahan polis di hospital untuk siasatan lanjut.

Suspek direman 7 hari

Katanya satu kertas siasatan dibuka mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan dan Seksyen 31 (1) (a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 bagi mengetahui motif kejadian dan siasatan lanjut.

Kedua-dua suspek direman tujuh hari bermula semalam bagi membantu siasatan kes.

Perintah reman dikeluarkan Majistret Sharda Shienha Mohd Suleiman.

Christopher menasihati orang ramai tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi atau menyebarkan berita yang tidak benar kerana dikhuatiri akan menimbulkan kegusaran kepada masyarakat.

Inisiatif tambahan untuk peneroka FELDA diumumkan

Kerajaan salur RM10 bilion dalam tempoh 10 tahun bantu pelan pemulihan

Serdang: Kerajaan akan menyalurkan sehingga RM1 bilion setahun untuk tempoh 10 tahun kepada FELDA melalui terbitan sukuk bagi memastikan kelangsungan agensi rancangan tanah berkenaan.

Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim berkata, peruntukan itu diluluskan bulan lalu oleh Kementerian Kewangan (MoF) bagi meneruskan dana pembiayaan sukuk FELDA yang tertangguh sebelum ini.

Kabinet sebelum ini meluluskan cadangan terbitan sukuk bernilai RM9.9 bilion oleh FELDA dengan jaminan kerajaan bagi membolehkan agensi itu melaksanakan pelan pemulihan, seperti dibentangkan Pasukan Petugas Khas melalui laporan pada Oktober 2020.

Dalam pada itu, Perdana Menteri ketika berucap di hadapan 10,000 warga FELDA sempena sambutan Hari Peneroka FELDA 2023 di Taman Ekspo Pertanian Malaysia (MAEPS) di Serdang, dekat sini, turut mengumumkan beberapa inisiatif tambahan khusus untuk FELDA dan warga penerokanya.

Antaranya kelulusan peruntukan RM7.7 juta setahun untuk

menanggung perbelanjaan kos operasi 37,012 lampu jalan melalui projek pencerahan lampu jalan seluruh kawasan FELDA.

Kerajaan juga akan menjadikan FELDA peneraju transformasi digital menerusi program Digital MADANI bagi memperkasa ekonomi gig.

12 Pusat Hemodialisis

Perdana Menteri turut mengumumkan penyediaan 12 Pusat Hemodialisis dengan peruntukan RM21 juta di semua FELDA dan sebuah lagi di premis Yayasan FELDA di Kelana Jaya yang dijangka dapat memberi manfaat kepada hampir 2,000 pesakit di kawasan tanah rancangan.

Kerajaan juga akan memperkenalkan insentif khas Sumbangan Kesihatan Rahmah (SKR) sebanyak RM300 dengan peruntukan keseluruhan RM21.21 juta yang bakal memberi manfaat ke-

pada 70,715 peneroka.

Perdana Menteri turut mengumumkan subsidi diesel RM36 juta setahun akan ditampung kerajaan bagi operasi penjanaan tenaga dan rawatan air yang akan memberi manfaat kepada hampir 43,000 penduduk di kawasan Kompleks Sahabat, Umas dan Kalabakan di Sabah.

Bagi membantu menyelesaikan isu Perumahan Generasi Baharu FELDA (PGBF) yang terbengkalai, beliau berkata kerajaan akan menyiapkan baki 283 unit perumahan berkenaan dengan segera.

Kerajaan juga mempertimbangkan usaha drastik untuk membantu peneroka getah beralih kepada tanaman komoditi lain seperti sawit, kelapa atau yang bersesuaian tertakluk kelulusan kerajaan negeri masing-masing.

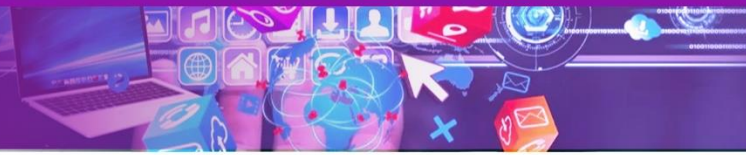
"Seperti diumumkan minggu lalu, kerajaan menandatangani

Ujian Imbasan Pengimejan Resonans Magnetik (MRI) mendapati terdapat jangkitan kuman menye-

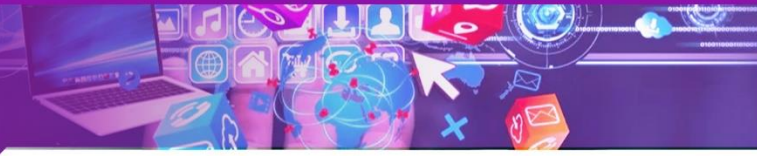
rang otak menyebabkannya Angah separuh koma.

"Mak saya layan semua orang dengan baik, dia lurus orangnya...orang buat macam mana pun dia akan layan dengan baik.

"Sebelum ini saya selalu pesan pada dia untuk berhati-hati sebab dia selalu balik berniaga awal pagi kan...tak sangka jadi macam ini.

"Bila jadi macam ini dia dah trauma sampai kami sekeluarga nak tidur malam

pun dah tak lena sebab takut," katanya kepada Harian Metro ketika ditemui di sini, semalam.

Nora berkata, ibunya yang dibenarkan keluar dari hospital malam semalam mengalami pedih berterusan di bahagian mata kiri dan cedera mecur di lengan akibat simbahan asid.

Katanya, bapa tirinya warga Pakistan mecur di bahu kanan sehingga ke belakang badan dan muka.

Menurutnya, sebelum serangan asid itu kedai mereka berniaga hampir musnah dalam kebakaran yang didakwa akibat perbuatan khianat pada 9 Jun lalu.

"Selepas terbakar hari itu ibu dah habis ribuan ringgit untuk baiki segala kerosakan dan sempat berniaga seminggu sahaja sebelum diserang.

"Saya harap pihak polis tangkap orang yang lakukan perkara ini untuk keselamatan kami.

"Perancangan masa hada-

Lumpur dan Selangor.

Katanya, kebanyakan golongan ini mengalami kesihatan mental akibat masalah ekonomi dihadapi selepas penularan Covid-19 dan disebabkan ruang tempat tinggal kurang selesa.

"Kita turut melihat kepada kemungkinan saiz PPR dengan ruang disediakan

terhad dan ditambah jumlah keluarga besar tidak dapat menampung mereka yang

ada dalam rumah itu.

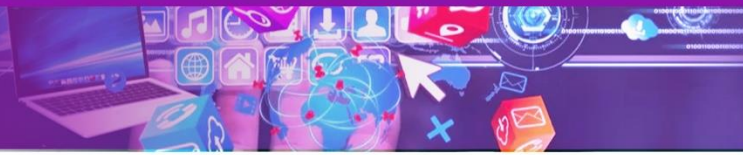
"Akhirnya ia menyebabkan remaja ini keluar rumah untuk melepaskan tekanan, seterusnya mengambil barang terlarang.

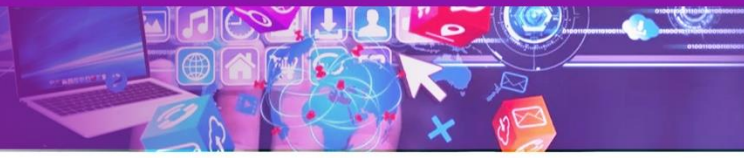

Ketika ditemui di rumahnya, semalam, keadaan tubuhnya kurus dan pertuturannya juga lemah dan tersekat-sekat.

Wan Noor Hayati lebih dikenali Wanti memenangi Hadiah Kajai Hadiah Ke-wartawanan Malaysia MPI-Petronas 2013 ketika berkhidmat dengan BH.

Beliau yang tinggal berseendirian di rumah sewanya berkata, pada April lalu dia dimasukkan ke wad Hospital Putrajaya sebab batuk dan muntah berterusan sebelum disahkan menghidap Covid-19.

"Pada masa itu doktor juga mendapati saya menghidap asma kronik. Kemudian, saya dibantu rakan terpaksa berulang-alik ke Hospital Serdang dan Hospital Kajang untuk rawatan susulan sebelum disahkan menghidap radang paru-paru pada Jun lalu.

"Selepas bacaan oksigen kembali normal saya dibenarkan keluar wad Hospital Kajang. Namun ketika di rumah, kesihatan saya semakin merosot dan lemah sebab tidak mampu untuk menjamah makanan atau minuman.

"Mungkin sekarang berat badan saya di bawah 40 kilogram berbanding ketika

sihat 60 kilogram," katanya yang mengharapkan orang ramai dapat melakukan solat hajat mendoakan kesembuhan dirinya.

Selain itu, dia juga sudah terputus pendapatan apabila pada 24 Jun lalu terpaksa berhenti kerja sebab masalah kesihatan dialaminya.

Katanya, pihak Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) ada datang melawatnya di rumah dan meminta laporan penuh perubatan untuk tindakan selanjutnya.

"Namun buat masa ini saya memang tidak berupaya ulang-alik melakukan urusan itu. Banyak masa hanya baring di sofa ini (di ruang tamu rumah).

"Perbelanjaan harian, serah kepada Tuhan. Ada orang bagi duit syukur. Tak ada (wang), saya reda.

"Saya pernah dirawat secara rawatan Islam, belum ada perubahan lagi setakat ini. Jika ada ikhtiar lain untuk bantu, saya nak cuba semua ikhtiar, Tuhan suruh (berikhtiar)," katanya.

Perbualan bersamanya turut dibantu sahabat baiknya yang juga wartawan Selangorkini, Fatimah Zakinan atau Yuyu yang setiap hari datang membantu menjaga Wanti.

Penderitaan Muhammad Anaqi Fayyadh mesra disapa adik mendapat perhatian di TikTok apabila bapa saudaranya yang juga adik ipar Nur Fitri berkongsi video bayi lelaki itu memerlukan bantuan kos perubatan.

Nur Fitri berkata, Muhammad Anaqi Fayyadh turut diuji apabila diserang angin ahmar di sebelah kiri badan kesan penyakitnya dan kini mendapatkan rawatan di Hospital Pakar Kanak-Kanak (HPKK) Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM), di sini, sejak seminggu lalu.

Menurutnya, anaknya menjalani prosedur memasukkan kamera di paha sehingga ke otak untuk pemeriksaan di bahagian berkenaan.

"Ketumbuhan di otak kanan adik sebesar 10 sentimeter (cm) dan saya dimaklumkan kedudukannya berhampiran salur darah serta

itu menanggung kesakitan," katanya, semalam.

Nur Fitri yang tinggal di Kempas, Johor Bahru berkata, mereka kini berkampung di HPKK UKM untuk rawatan anak yang sebelum ini dijalankan di Johor Bahru.

Menurutnya, anggaran kos perubatan Muhammad Anaqi Fayyadh dianggarkan RM100,000 sekaligus merealisasikan mereka kerana tidak berkemampuan.

Katanya, bil rawatan anak termasuk ujian Imbasan Pengimejan Resonans Magnetik (MRI) di hospital swasta sebelum ini juga ditanggung sendiri atas beberapa faktor.

"Saya tidak bekerja dan suami (Abu Zar Zainal) hanya pemandu lori yang kini berhenti buat sementara. Pihak hospital (HPKK UKM) beritahu mereka sedia membantu kami untuk mendapatkan bantuan pihak berkaitan.

"Saya tersentak apabila mendengar kos perubatan adik, tetapi sebagai ibu saya mahu dia mendapatkan rawatan terbaik supaya dapat membesar dengan sihat," katanya yang mempunyai seorang lagi anak perempuan.

Katanya, dalam keadaan hamil ketika ini dia tetap mengutamakan anak biarpun pinggangnya selalu sakit terutama ketika mendukung Muhammad Anaqi Fayyadh.

"Kami berusaha membawa adik melakukan rawatan alternatif seperti berurut dan bahagian kiri badan adik dan kini boleh digerakkan sedikit," katanya memberitahu anak turut mendapat bantuan dana perubatan daripada Majlis Agama Islam Negeri Johor.

"Hasil siasatan awal, lelaki berkenaan mengaku ada menendang mangsa secara agresif kerana muntah di atas sofa kesayangannya.

"Lelaki itu juga mengaku menekan perut kanak-kanak itu secara agresif berkali-kali selain menendang sehingga kepala mangsa terhantuk ke lantai.

"Akibat perbuatan kejamnya itu tengkorak kanak-kanak itu pecah selain organ dalam perutnya turut pecah," katanya.

Beliau berkata, ibu kandung mangsa dan teman lelakinya berusia 24 dan 25 tahun kemudian ditahan polis di hospital untuk siasatan lanjut.

Katanya satu kertas siasatan dibuka mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksan dan Seksyen 31 (1) (a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 bagi

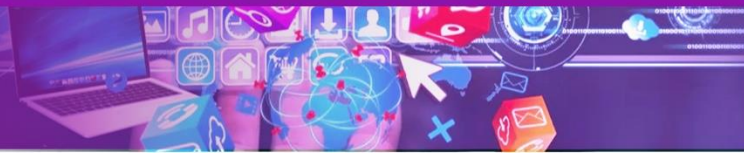
mengetahui motif kejadian dan siasatan lanjut.

KUALA LUMPUR: A couple were injured after they were splashed with a liquid, believed to be acid, while entering the lift at a flat in Batu Caves, Gombak, here.

DAD SAVES SONS FROM BLAZING SHOPHOUSE

In a desperate move, he throws his 2 kids trapped on upper floor

A MAN threw his sons from the upper floor of a shophouse in Pekan Lenga, Bukit Kepong, near here, in a desperate attempt to save them when they were trapped in a fire.

In the 4.30am incident on Thursday, Zamirul Suahimi, 30, threw Muhammad Firas Syahmi, 10, and Muhammad Harith, 4, from the upper floor of the shophouse. The two boys were caught by factory workers, who were downstairs.

However, Zamirul, who jumped off the top floor after throwing his sons down, injured his hand when it hit a zink structure.

He also suffered burns on the ear, eyelid and mouth, as well as swelling around his neck.

Zamirul's wife, S'biha Bahari, 39, said prior to the incident, she had been trying to contact her husband.

"Not long after, the two factory workers answered my husband's phone and informed me that the

restaurant that we owned had caught fire.

"It has become the norm for my husband and our children to sleep at the shop because he will get up early in the morning to prepare breakfast.

"I, meanwhile, slept at my mother's house, which is not far from our restaurant.

"My husband got up when he

heard screams. He decided to throw our children from the top floor of the shophouse to keep them from harm's way."

S'biha said Zamirul was being treated at Sultanah Fatimah Specialist Hospital in Muar.

Ten shophouses, including a sundry shop, two motorcycle shops, a home appliance shop and a house, were razed.

RM10 billion in sukuk to spur Felda's recovery

KUALA LUMPUR: The government will channel RM10 billion in sukuk for Felda's recovery plans for 10 years.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim said the allocation had been approved last month by the Finance Ministry to ensure the federal agency's survival.

"We previously had the sukuk, but it was suspended by the previous government. However, I have signed the approval (for the allocation) last month.

"This is to ensure Felda's survival and recovery in the industry as a huge institution (that can help its settlers)," he said during the national-level Felda Settlers' Day celebration at the Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang near here yesterday.

Last week, the government announced that it would restructure Felda's debts through sukuk issuance and revolving credit.

Anwar, who is also the finance minister, said a large part of the restructuring plans involved reducing Felda's debts.

He also said the restructuring would help reduce Felda's costs against rising interest rates and allow it to abolish 80 per cent of settlers' loans worth RM8.3 billion.

Following this, Anwar pledged that the government would restructure Felda's financial position to ensure that it could abolish 80 per cent of its settlers' debts.

"As what was announced last week, the government has also agreed to restructure Felda's financial position through sukuk issuance and revolving credit in our effort to recover its finances and allow the abolishment of 80 per cent of settlers' loans worth RM8.3 billion."

The prime minister also said Putrajaya had pledged to prioritise Felda's recovery in the 2024 Budget, which would be tabled in October.

Anwar said the move to prioritise the institution was to look after the people of Felda and their livelihood.

"I vow to review (the move to help the settlers) through the 12th Malaysia Plan. And through this, we will include Felda under the second Madani Budget in October in efforts to lift the people's livelihood."

Anwar also announced that the government would provide special health incentives worth RM21.2 million for settlers aged 65 years and above.

"To ensure their health is taken care of, individuals aged 65 and above will be given RM300 each and this incentive will benefit a total of 70,715 settlers.

"The government will also establish a dialysis centre with an allocation of RM21 million for all Felda districts. The centre is expected to benefit almost 2,000 patients from Felda who have to travel up to two hours to get treatment."

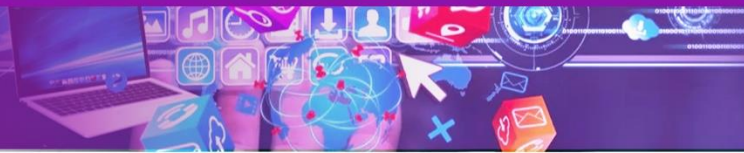
Anwar also announced that the government had agreed to bear the operating costs of 37,012 streetlights in Felda districts nationwide, which amounted to RM7.7 million, as well as diesel subsidies worth RM36 million to ensure smooth operations and alleviate the energy and water ra-

tions in Sabah.

Anwar also vowed to resolve abandoned housing projects faced by second-generation Felda farmers.

"Give me some time to discuss with the (plantation industries and commodities) minister, as we need to check the cost. However, I have agreed to consider (to resolve the issue)."

Search for missing boy expanded to 10km radius

HULU SELANGOR: The search-and-rescue (SAR) area for the 7-year-old boy who slipped and fell into a river while trying to retrieve a pair of slippers has been expanded on its third day.

Selangor Fire and Rescue Department assistant director of operations Mohamadul Ehsan Mohd Zain said the search was expanded to cover a 10km radius from where Ahmad Ammar Akhtar Tajul Azwa was said to have gone missing on Wednesday.

He said the SAR operation was carried out until 11pm on Thursday night and resumed at 7am yesterday.

"Earlier, the operation was carried out using the water surface searching technique until the Batang Kali bridge. This covered a 3km distance."

"At 2pm yesterday (Friday), the search was expanded with the personnel divided into two teams. Five boats and a K9 tracker dog unit were deployed to cover Sungai Selangor.

"Monitoring is also being done at rubbish traps by personnel from the Bukit Sentosa and Bestari Jaya fire stations," he said on Thursday night.

Mohamadul said 15 officers and personnel from the Fire and Rescue Department, including the department's Water Rescue Team, were involved in the SAR

operation. Others comprise four firemen and two dogs from the K9 tracker dog unit.

It was reported that the boy was trying to retrieve a pair of slippers near the riverbank when he slipped and was swept away by strong currents in Desa Alam Ria near Batang Kali.

The Fire and Rescue Department said a team was deployed to the site at 7.30pm on Wednesday.

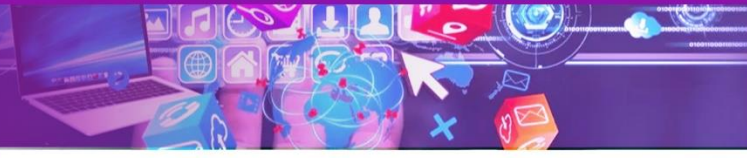
On Thursday, World Bank's Malaysia lead economist Apurva Sanghi tweeted about Sarawak qualifying for a high-income status, as it had Gross National Income (GNI) per capita of more than US\$13,205.

"While Malaysia's quest to join the high-income club continues, there is one nice surprise: Sarawak is now a high income state," he said on Twitter.

Based on the figures also shared by Apurva on his tweet, Sarawak now joins the ranks of Penang and the federal territories, Labuan and Kuala Lumpur.

Apurva noted that the state-level GDP data had been obtained from the Department of Statistics Malaysia and converted to US dollar applying the World Bank Atlas method, divided by the mid-year population.

On its website, the World Bank says it assigns economies to four income groups: low, lower-middle, upper-middle, and high income. The classifications are updated each year on July 1, and are based on the GNI per capita, measured in US dollar, of the previous year.

BINTULU: Home fire prevention is the responsibility of all family members, says Sarawak Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) director Datu Khirudin Drahman.

He stressed homes should have fire extinguishers and use electrical equipment responsibly, as well as avoid the 3Ls of 'Lupa, Leka, and Lalai' (forgetfulness, carelessness, negligence).

"The safety issue at home starts from us, which requires a change of mindset on fire prevention, surveillance, and protection," he said when officiating at the Children's Fire Safety Programme at SJKC Chung Hua Bintulu Thursday.

Khirudin stressed the importance of providing fire extinguishers at home and preventing any actions that could cause fires.

He said there are misconceptions that having fire extinguishers at home is a bad omen, too expensive, or complicated to maintain.

Safety and costs are two different things that need to be understood, he said and stressed that safety should be of higher value.

He added 99 per cent of fires could be avoided, except for fires due to lightning strikes or the

presence of flammable items.

"Forgetfulness, carelessness, and negligence mistakes must always be avoided among children and family members for fire prevention," he said.

He pointed out fire prevention education needs to be inculcated among early children by taking them to visit fire stations as well as supporting fire safety

activities.

He thanked Yayasan Farley for organising and donating 25 fire extinguishers for SJK Chung Hua Bintulu, SJK Kai Min, SJK Siang Boon, SJK Sebiaw Chinese, and SJK Chung Hua Bintulu 2.

Yayasan Farley president Eijing Lau said the foundation is proud to be able to give back to the community through the

programme.

"Here (Bintulu) Farley started 35 years ago and then established this foundation in 2021 with the aim of supporting education in Sarawak," he said.

Lau said Yayasan Farley and Bomba Sarawak started its collaboration in June last year by holding several similar projects in Kuching.

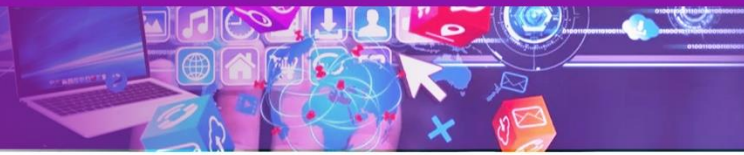
According to Lions Club of Batu Niah president, Andy Jong Wan Joon, the donation was handed over to the pupils on June 25,

"It is our collective responsibility to support their holistic development," she said.

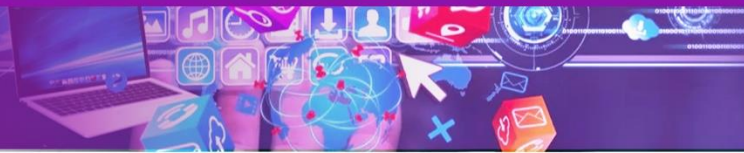
She added that the fundraising campaign also received an overwhelming response from various donors who came forward to support the worthy cause. The funds will go towards supporting the home's daily operational expenses.

Internet service providers urged to comply with CMA 1998

KUALA LUMPUR: Internet Service Providers (ISP) are required to make every effort to prevent criminal conduct on their platforms and promptly remove any online harm in view of the growing number of public complaints related to abuse of network facilities and services.

The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission

(MCMC), in a statement yesterday, said it is taking the matter seriously and wants ISPs to provide a report with action plans addressing the issue of content infringement and outlining their future plans to enhance their capabilities in combatting online harms, ensuring information security and maintaining network

integrity.

The main areas of concern regarding online harms include the dissemination of child sexual abuse material, online gambling, content inciting racial or religious discontent, scams and phishing, the sale and promotion of illegal drugs and prohibited substances, impersonation, the spread of disinformation and

fake news, and the unlicensed sale of health products, read the statement.

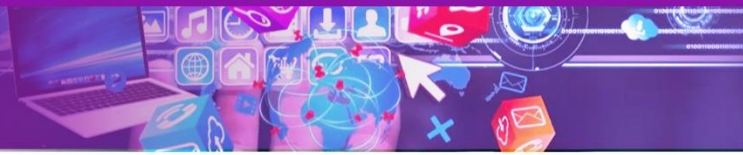
In urging ISPs to fulfil their obligations and duties as required under the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 (CMA 1998), it said section 263 of the CMA 1998 requires them to use their best endeavours to prevent the services that they provide from

being used to commit any offence, and to prevent the commission or attempted commission of an offence under Malaysian laws.

Henceforth, it would require the commitment of ISPs in allocating sufficient resources, and expertise to promptly ensure that the requirements of this Section are met, said MCMC.

The law also requires ISPs

to carry out any request or instructions from the MCMC in preventing the commission or attempted commission of an offence under any written law of Malaysia or otherwise in enforcing the laws of Malaysia, including but not limited, to the protection of the public revenue and preservation of national security. — Bernama

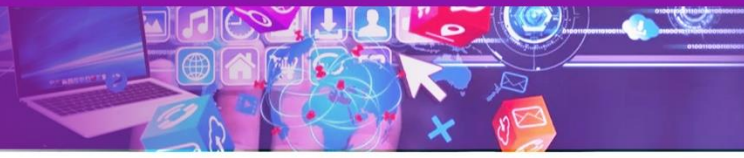
"In addition, the anti-sexual harassment advocacy roadshow programme is also in line with

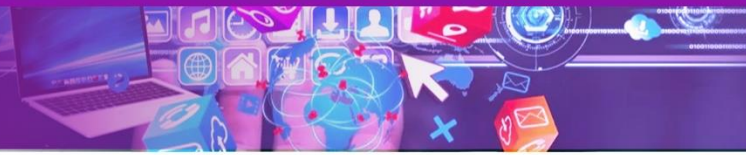

Malaysia hosts first international kebaya design competition

KUALA LUMPUR: Women of all races were dressed in their kebaya best at the launch of the Kebaya Heritage Design Competition as it got off to a glamorous start at the Kuala Lumpur Craft Complex on Thursday.

Hosted by the International Conference on World Cultures, the event was officiated by Tourism, Arts and Culture Deputy Minister Khairul Firdaus Akbar Khan with designers, diplomats, celebrities and government officials in attendance.

"Being the host country of Kebaya Heritage Design Competition, I am honoured to have us all under one roof united to achieve the goal of recognising the significance of our culture and protecting it," said Khairul in his speech.

"I appreciate everyone coming together to participate in the KHDC as it casts a wider net for the Malaysian market on tourism, arts and culture."

Highlights of the launch included a traditional Malay dance by students from the Sekolah Seni Malaysia and a kebaya fashion show by reigning beauty queens Miss Globe Malaysia Manvin Khera, Miss Global Malaysia Taanusiya Chetty, Miss Star Malaysia Kash Bhullar, Miss Eco Malaysia Tisyaa Ong and Carolyn Wee, finalist of Ratu Wanita Malaysia 2023.

Competition which began its run on June 15 has so far seen about 100 participants from Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Brunei and the Philippines submit their sketches and drawings.

The last day of submission is July 30, after which judges will narrow it down to 50 semi-finalists who have to produce a prototype kebaya before the deadline on August 30.

The 50 semi-finalists will also have to do a presentation on the details and cultural significance of their design.

A gala dinner will be held on September 9, where judges from all the five countries will select

25 finalists who get to showcase their designs in a fashion show on the same night.

Only three of the finalists will be declared winners and have their designs auctioned off for charity to support local designers.

The first prize winner will receive US\$5,000 while the second and third prize winners will receive US\$3,000 and US\$2,000 respectively.

"As you know, we are doing this to support the listing of the kebaya as a tangible cultural heritage in Unesco," said ICWC president Azmi Mustapha at the press conference.

"We want to show the world

the kebaya is here to stay, it's not something that will go away."

He also added that they hope to send the winner of the competition to Cannes, France for a fashion show.

Kebaya ambassador of ICWC 2023, Wanna Ali, head judge Juita Jalil and competition coordinator Asfarena Samion Mon were also at the press conference.

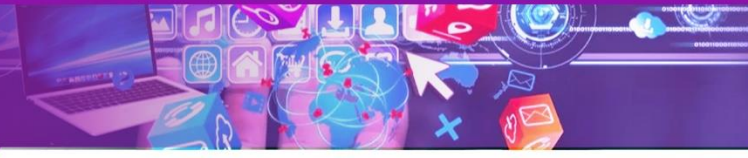
"We hope to reach our maximum target of 500 entries before the end of the month," said Asafarena. "The kebaya is worn by people from all the five participating countries. So, it's a symbol of tradition and heritage of not just Malaysia but a big part of Asean."

"As ambassador, I will promote kebaya heritage by of course, donning it and by being the face of the competition and getting as many participants as possible," said Wanna who looked radiant in an elegant white kebaya.

On what she wants to see from competitors, Juita said: "Show us something we've not seen before but still has culture and tradition steeped in it."

She added that with all the women looking beautiful in their kebayas at the event, there's no way kebaya is not trendy and not stylish or sophisticated.

"Give us something that will excite us enough for us to say to the world 'hey, the kebaya is here to stay'." — Malay Mail

Stateless Sarawakian in viral videos appeals for citizenship

Fatimah recommends that Liana apply for 'temporary resident card' first

SIBU: Stateless Sarawakian Liana Sari Santud, 20, who recently went viral on social media for sharing her plight, has appealed to the government to grant her and her family members citizenship.

Liana, who is from Rumah Sika, Pasai Siong here, said besides her, her parents Santud Danong and Gading Gandut Ngerantar, and two of her three siblings are all stateless despite being born in Sarawak.

"My family has applied several times for a valid identity card from the authorities, but until now there has been no news from them," Liana, who was born at Sibu Hospital, told The Borneo Post yesterday.

She shared that her elder brother Asan somehow managed to get citizenship status on his birth certificate, despite her parents being stateless.

She called on the Sarawak government to assist her family so that they have equal rights like other Sarawakians.

Liana, who studied at SMK Rosli Dhoby, scored A's for Bahasa Melayu, Moral

Education, History, and Mathematics; B+ for English; C+ for Chemistry and Biology; C for Physics; and passed Iban Language for her Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM).

She will be continuing her studies at University of Technology Sarawak (UTS) and said her uncle would be the guarantor for her UTS scholarship.

"I am going to study there (UTS) because of the help of my uncle, who became my guarantor under the scholarship, because he is the only member of my family who has a valid identity card," she said.

UTS chairman Datuk Dr Annuar Rapae recently said the university would let Liana continue her studies although she does not have citizenship.

"There is no issue for her to study in UTS, with or without IC (identification card). We treat her equally as other Sarawakians and that is why she is also eligible for free foundation, which is funded by the state government," said Dr Annuar, who is also Deputy Minister for Education, Innovation and Talent Development.

KUCHING: Liana Sari Santud, who has appealed to have her citizenship granted, has been recommended to submit an application for a green identity card called 'temporary resident card'.

Minister of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah in a statement said the status of Liana's birth certificate was still listed as 'Undetermined'.

She said it was due to the fact that her biological mother is also listed as 'Undetermined' on the birth certificate while her father does not have any identification documents.

"We recommend that Liana's parents come to any National Registration Department (JPN) office to submit a citizenship claims if there is proof of the identification document of their mother or father or siblings or grandparents."

"Another suggestion is for Liana to go to the nearest JPN office to submit an application for a green identification card, which is a temporary resident card," she said.

Fatimah hoped that the Special Task Force (STF) programme could address similar issue in the near future.

The STF was set up on

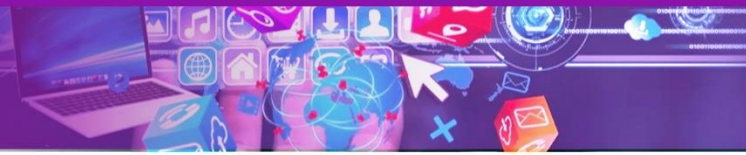
April 11 last year to help Sarawakians who do not have any identification documents or citizenship status.

According to an Utusan Borneo report on Thursday (June 8), Liana, 20, a stateless Sarawakian who recently went viral on social media for sharing her plight, begged the government to grant her and her family members citizenship.

Liana who comes from Rumah Sika, Pasai Siong here, said apart from her, her parents Santud Danong and Gading Gandut Ngerantar and her two younger siblings also did not have citizenship even though they were born in Sarawak.

According to Liana, her brother (Asan), however managed to get citizenship status on his birth certificate, even though both of their parents did not have citizenship.

She thus called on the Sarawak government to help her family so they have the same rights as other Sarawakians.

Found after two weeks in forest

KOTA KINABALU: All hope looked to be lost for 11-year-old Al Fajri Anto and his uncle Iwan Musakir who had been lost in a rough terrain forest in the Tawau east coast district for two weeks.

Their friends had tried searching for them for five days. They then reported the incident to the authorities on June 29, triggering a search mission involving firemen, police and villagers.

Just when they were ready to give up, a miracle of sorts happened yesterday.

The two were found alive and well, albeit in a weakened state, by a plantation worker at 9am.

The worker first spotted the

boy walking aimlessly in the area and the uncle was found not far from the location soon after that.

"They were weak but in good condition. The area had plenty of wild fruits and there was also a river there where they could catch fish (for survival)," said Sabah Fire and Rescue Department assistant director of operations Hamsa Isnurdini yesterday.

Iwan, 33, and Al Fajri had gone missing after separating from a bigger group of hunters at the Usahawan Borneo Burmas oil palm plantation on June 24.

They were supposed to regroup with six others later that evening, but never showed up.

"The boy was found in

Plantation 8, about 8km from our control post in Plantation 7," said Hamsa.

He said they could not learn more from the two, including on how they lost their way in the jungle, as they were given medical attention and taken to the district hospital.

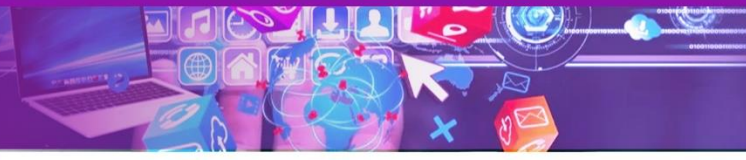
The fire department, he said, has handed the case to the police for further investigation.

"But I wish to thank the firemen, rescuers from other agencies and villagers who were unrelenting in their efforts to look for the victims for nine days," he said.

The uncle-nephew duo was united with family members at the control post before being taken to hospital.

ISPs need to be proactive

Combating harmful online content an obligation, says expert

PETALING JAYA: The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission's (MCMC) reminder to Internet service providers (ISPs) that they are obligated under law to prevent the abuse of their network facilities and services will push them to be proactive rather than reactive, says an expert.

Cybersecurity law expert and lawyer Derek Fernandez said: "Simply put, Section 263 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 (CMA 1998) was designed to adopt a proactive approach to cybersecurity in relation to online harms and information security rather than a reactive approach, which has been practised for so many years."

He said that currently ISPs take action to resolve a threat only

when the public complains to the ISP or the regulator, adding that Section 263 requires ISPs and any licence holder to use their best efforts to eliminate criminal threats on their network.

This reactive approach, he continued, is inadequate to combat today's cybercrime and online harms, adding that technologies such as threat intelligence, web filtering, anti-scam, and reporting systems are available to assist compliance.

According to MCMC, the main areas of concern regarding online harms are child sexual abuse material, online gambling, content inciting racial or religious discontent, scams and phishing attacks, content with illegal drugs and prohibited substances, impersonation, disinformation and fake news, and unlicensed health products.

The MCMC notice comes after

both Facebook-owner Meta (July 4) and messaging service Telegram (June 20) agreed to cooperate with the MCMC in clamping down on online crime.

Both companies had received warnings of legal action due to the significant amount of harmful content on their platforms.

In a statement, Maxis said it has always worked closely with MCMC and the relevant authorities on managing harmful or unlawful content.

"In fact, Maxis is part of the Content Forum and adheres to MCMC's Content Code, with resources in place to comply with the regulator's directives and information requests from authorities, where needed," it said.

Maxis added that it has internal SOPs in place for website blocking, which is undertaken based on instructions by MCMC, the police, and the Domestic Trade

and Cost of Living Ministry within the stipulated timelines given.

CelcomDigi also said it strictly follows operating procedures based on the obligations prescribed under the CMA 1998 in a statement.

"We take pride in protecting our customers' safety and ensuring that all Malaysians can safely derive the full benefit of the digital society," said a CelcomDigi spokesperson.

When contacted, Telekom Malaysia said it adheres to high standards of governance and policy and works closely with relevant authorities to mitigate any issues.

The co-chair of the Bar Council's intellectual property committee, Foong Cheng Leong, said there are concerns that Section 263 could be used to infringe users' rights to freedom of speech online.

"As we have seen in the past, ISPs generally comply with such requests, and we have seen it being used to protect the rights of individuals," he said.

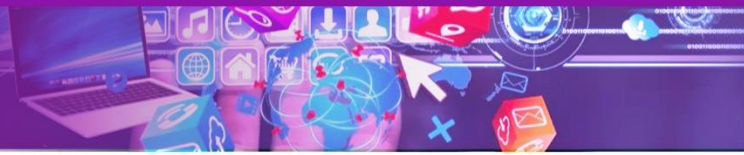
As written requests under Section 263 to the ISP are not made public, Foong said there is no way to gauge the level of compliance by ISPs.

"We know that MCMC does issue press releases on fines or compounds issued against ISPs for non-compliance with other guidelines," he added.

Foong also added that this can be addressed by creating better regulations, rules and guidelines in relation to any blocking order.

"It must be exercised sparingly, and there must be a predefined outline of what can be blocked," he said.

He also said there must be an avenue for appeal for those affected, whether directly or indirectly.

Sick boy beaten to death for vomiting on sofa

MELAKA: A man has been arrested in connection with the death of his girlfriend's son, who was reportedly sick at the time.

The 31-year-old was said to have kicked and beaten up the three-year-old child for staining a sofa at his home in Cheng here.

Also detained to assist investigation was the boy's mother, 24.

Melaka Tengah OCPD Asst

Comm Christopher Patit said the suspects were detained yesterday and a one-week remand order had been issued by the Magistrate's Court in Ayer Keroh.

ACP Christopher said the mother had sent her child to the boyfriend's house at 5.30am on Thursday.

"The child was unwell and the male suspect was supposed to take him for treatment," he added.

He said about 40min later, the

male suspect called his girlfriend to inform that the child was unconscious after falling from the staircase.

The couple then rushed the boy to the hospital.

"Medical officers at Melaka Hospital found the child in a serious condition and attempted to resuscitate him.

"The child succumbed to his injuries at 9.15am on Thursday," said ACP Christopher. The post-mortem report showed that

the child had severe injuries on his head and body.

ACP Christopher said during the preliminary investigation, the male suspect had admitted to beating the victim after the boy vomited on his favourite sofa.

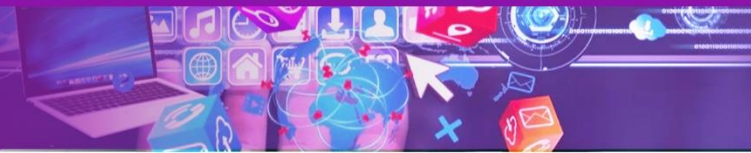

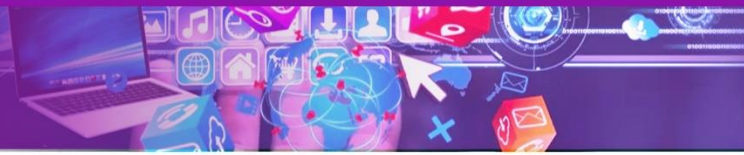

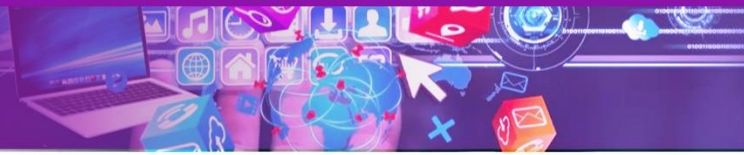

BINTULU: Isu keselamatan dan pencegahan kebakaran di rumah adalah tanggungjawab seluruh ahli keluarga, kata Pengarah Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Sarawak Datu Khirudin Drahman.

Menurutnya, ini melibatkan penyediaan alat pemadam api, penggunaan peralatan elektrik dengan selamat dan mengingatkan ahli keluarga mengenai sindrom 3L iaitu Lupa, Lalai dan Leka.

Khirudin berkata, adalah penting untuk rumah menyediakan alat pemadam api dan mencegah tindakan yang boleh menjadi punca kepada kebakaran.

Katanya, persepsi sesetengah orang bahawa penyediaan alat pemadam api di rumah sebagai petanda buruk, kos pembelian terlalu mahal dan penyelenggaraan rumit merupakan antara alasan yang tidak dapat diterima.

Khirudin berkata, aspek keselamatan tidak dapat dinilai dengan wang ringgit dan kos yang dianggap tinggi adalah berbaloi sekiranya

nyawa ahli keluarga dan harta benda terpelihara daripada kebakaran.

Katanya, 99 peratus kebakaran boleh dielak melainkan berlaku kebakaran akibat panahan petir atau akibat barang-barang mudah terbakar.

"Kesilapan Lupa, Lalai dan Leka (3L) membabitkan anak-anak dan ahli keluarga juga perlu sentiasa diperingatkan sebagai pencegahan," tegasnya.

Pada masa sama katanya, pendidikan awal pencegahan kebakaran perlu diterapkan dalam diri anak-anak dengan membawa mereka melawat balai bomba serta menyokong mereka dalam aktiviti pencegahan kebakaran.

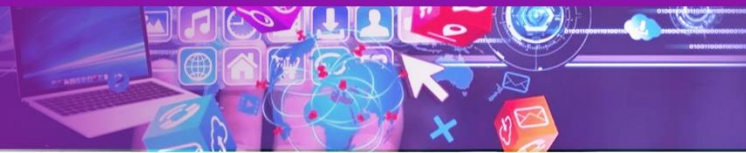
menyokong pendidikan di Sarawak," ujarnya.

Kelmarin, dilaporkan Sarawak kini sebuah negeri berpendapatan tinggi, menurut Ahli Ekonomi Bank Dunia Apurva Sanghi.

Dalam ciapannya di Twitter, Apurva berkata, pendapatan negara kasar (PNK) Sarawak telah melebihi ambang pendapatan tinggi AS\$13,205 (RM61,500).

“Sementara Malaysia meneruskan usaha untuk menjadi negara berpendapatan tinggi, terdapat satu kejutan yang menarik – Sarawak kini sebuah negeri berpenda-

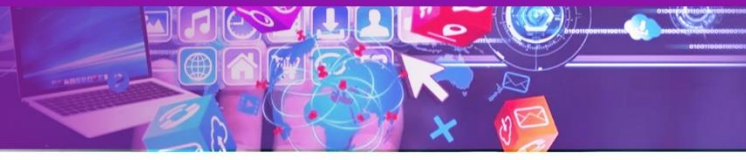
patan tinggi,” katanya.

Beliau berkata, ini berdasarkan penerbitan data Bank Dunia yang diperoleh daripada Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM).

Pulau Pinang, Kuala Lumpur dan Labuan juga telah melebihi ambang pendapatan tinggi, menurut data Apurva.

Blog rasmi Bank Dunia membahagikan ekonomi dunia kepada empat kumpulan pendapatan untuk setiap tahun – rendah, pertengahan bawah, pertengahan atas dan tinggi berdasarkan PNK per kapita.

Menurut Bank Dunia lagi, ambang itu dikemas kini setiap tahun pada awal tahun kewangannya (bermula 1 Julai) dan diselaraskan untuk inflasi.

“Selalunya kanak-kanak enggan mendedahkan insiden tersebut kepada guru dan ahli keluarga menyebabkan perbuatan buli berterusan dan menjadi lebih serius.

“Oleh itu, MTPN dapat memainkan peranan sebagai pihak ketiga dengan menganjurkan ceramah dan aktiviti di sekolah bagi memastikan kanak-kanak mempunyai saluran aduan yang boleh diakses apabila menghadapi situasi buli seterusnya mencegah berlakunya tragedi lebih banyak,” katanya.

didikan Khas Dr. Qusayla Abd Razak menyokong serta menekankan keperluan pelaksanaan segera berkenaan usaha ini.

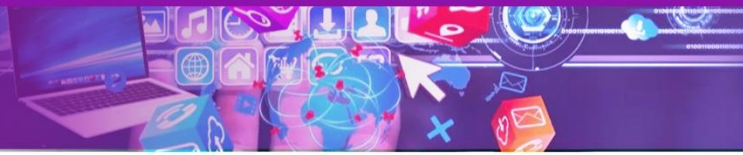

SKSSR: Kakitangan awam disaran carum untuk isteri

KUALA TERENGGANU: Kakitangan awam disarankan supaya membuat caruman Skim Keselamatan Sosial Suri Rumah (SKSSR) untuk isteri masing-masing sebagai perlindungan khas sewaktu menguruskan rumah tangga.

Menteri Sumber Manusia V. Sivakumar berkata setakat ini kesedaran orang ramai terhadap skim itu masih rendah, justeru kaedah caruman melalui suami untuk isteri merupakan antara inisiatif yang boleh dibuat bagi meningkatkan jumlah mereka yang dilindungi skim itu.

“Sasaran kita untuk capai 500,000 pencarum tahun ini dan saya ada lebih kurang enam bulan lagi untuk capai sasaran itu.

“Saya bersama Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) sedang ambil segala inisiatif untuk beri kesedaran kepada suri rumah dan suami, penjawat awam (untuk men-carum),” katanya kepada pemberita selepas meras-

mikan Karnival Kerjaya Myfuturejobs dan SKSSR 2023 di sini semalam.

Menurutnya sejak dilancarkan pada 1 Dis 2022 hingga 2 Julai lepas, seramai 178,710 suri rumah di seluruh negara telah dilindungi SKSSR.

Sivakumar berkata jumlah itu bagaimanapun masih rendah, sedangkan faedah perlindungan yang akan dipeoleh suri rumah menerusi skim itu sangat bermanfaat walaupun dengan bayaran caruman lebih kecil berbanding skim insurans lain.

Beliau berkata pihaknya akan berbincang dengan Kongres Kesatuan Pekerja Dalam Perkhidmatan Awam (CUEPACS) untuk mencari mekanisme terbaik bagi melaksanakan bayaran caruman membabitkan penjawat awam.

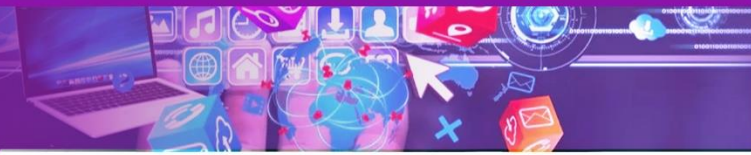
Menurutnya sejak program itu bermula, sejumlah RM350,000 faedah telah dibayar kepada suri rumah yang men-carum membabit-

kan 145 kes di seluruh negara.

Sivakumar turut menyeru semua pihak termasuk pemimpin masyarakat agar sama-sama memberi kesedaran kepada orang ramai untuk menyertai skim itu, selain menyarankan badan bukan kerajaan serta syarikat swasta menaja caruman SKSSR demi kebajikan pekerja mereka sebagai tanggungjawab sosial korporat.

SKSSR memberi perlindungan kepada suri rumah menerusi faedah hilang upaya kekal, perubatan dan pemuliharaan, elauun keuzuran, bantuan dialisis, pencen penakat dan pengurusan mayat.

Semua suri rumah berusia bawah 55 tahun dan menguruskan rumah tangga sepenuh masa atau separuh masa, serta berkahwin atau bujang, layak menyertai skim itu dengan caruman RM120 bagi tempoh 12 bulan, yang dibayar secara lebih awal. — Bernama

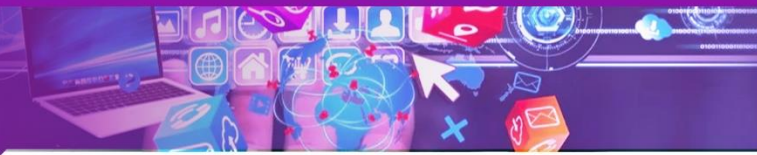
Dia didakwa melakukan kesalahan itu pada jam 4.30 petang, 4 Julai lalu di sebuah premis di Jalan Maigold, Senadin di sini.

Bagi kesalahan itu, tertuduh

telah didakwa mengikut Seksyen 4 (1) (c) Akta Rumah Judi Terbuka 1953 dan dihukum di bawah Seksyen 4 (1) akta yang sama.

Jika sabit kesalahan, boleh didenda tidak kurang dari RM5,000 serta tidak melebihi RM50,000 dan penjara tidak melebihi tiga tahun dan sebagai tambahan denda tidak kurang dari RM5,000 dan tidak melebihi RM50,000 bagi setiap mesin perkakas perjudian yang dirampas.

Terdahulu, pegawai pendakwa Inspektor Mudzilawati Abdul Rahman memohon ditetapkan satu tarikh baharu untuk pengurusan kes memandangkan tertuduh telah mengaku tidak bersalah.

Wanita, teman lelaki direman bantu siasatan kematian kanak-kanak lelaki

MELAKA: Seorang wanita dan teman lelakinya direman tujuh hari bermula semalam bagi membantu siasatan berkaitan kematian anak lelakinya yang berusia tiga tahun, kelmarin.

Ketua Polis Daerah Melaka Tengah ACP Christopher Patit berkata, wanita berusia 24 tahun dan lelaki berusia 25 tahun itu, ditahan pada 8 malam kelmarin di Hospital Melaka.

Beliau berkata, kanak-kanak itu dibawa oleh wanita berkenaan dan teman lelakinya ke hospital tersebut kira-kira 6.50 pagi kelmarin

dalam keadaan tidak sedarkan diri.

“Sebaik tiba di hospital, kanak-kanak itu diberikan bantuan pernafasan selama satu jam 10 minit, namun mangsa tidak memberi sebarang respons sebelum disahkan meninggal dunia pada 9.15 pagi semalam (kelmarin).

“Mayat mangsa kemudian dibawa ke Unit Perubatan Forensik Hospital Melaka kira-kira 10.30 pagi dan pemeriksaan awal doktor mendapati terdapat kesan cedera di bahagian kepala serta badan mangsa. Punca

kematian disebabkan kecederaan di kepala dan bahagian perut,” katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Beliau berkata, hasil siasatan awal mendapati sebelum kejadian itu, ibu mangsa telah membawa kanak-kanak berkenaan yang mengalami muntah-muntah untuk berubat di rumah teman lelakinya di Cheng, di sini kira-kira 5.30 pagi kelmarin.

Katanya, bagaimanapun tidak sampai satu jam kemudian, ibu mangsa telah dihubungi teman lelakinya memaklumkan kanak-kanak tersebut telah terjatuh dan

tidak sedarkan diri sebelum pasangan itu membawa mangsa ke Hospital Melaka.

Menurutnya, kes disiasat di bawah Seksyen 31(1)(A) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 kerana pengabaian kanak-kanak dan Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksamaan kerana bunuh.

Christopher turut menasihatkan orang ramai tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi atau menyebarkan berita tidak benar supaya tidak mengganggu siasatan selain dikhuatiri menimbulkan kegusaran kepada masyarakat. — Bernama
