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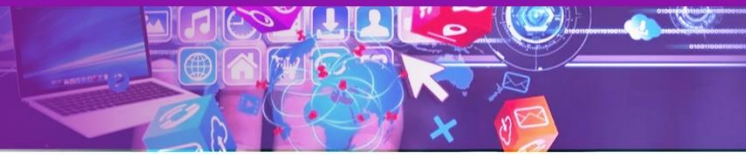

'Educate children early on importance of healthy habits'

KUCHING: The Malaysian Medical Association (MMA) is urging the government to prioritise early education on the importance of healthy habits as part of a national strategy.

Its president Dr Muruga Raj Rajathurai said this is to encourage a healthy lifestyle among Malaysians and prevent further increases in cases of non-communicable diseases (NCDs).

"More drastic preventative measures are needed as a high number of NCD cases can have an impact on the country's productivity, put a strain on the healthcare system and not to mention increase healthcare costs. We need to start thinking of the health of our younger generation and stop NCDs early, before it happens," he said in a statement.

He said child obesity, which was almost unheard of four to five decades ago, has now become a national health issue.

Citing the National Health and Morbidity Survey (NHMS) 2019, he said 14.8 per cent of children aged between five and 17 were found to be obese, a significant increase from 6.1 per cent reported in 2011.

"More alarmingly, based on the NHMS 2015, a total of 1.65 million Malaysian school children are expected to be overweight or obese by 2025," said Dr Muruga.

Dr Muruga stressed that it is crucial that healthy habits be cultivated in children during their formative years.

"This is to ensure that they carry these habits into adulthood, where a health-conscious lifestyle becomes ingrained.

"As children spend a fair

amount of time at school, schools would be the ideal platform to pick up healthy habits," he said.

As part of a national strategy to prevent NCDs, he said MMA proposed that the Ministry of Health together with the Ministry of Education work towards a comprehensive policy to educate children from kindergarten to secondary school on the importance of a healthy and active lifestyle to remain healthy and prevent disease.

"Health should not be just a test or examination subject but embraced as part of a school lifestyle," he said.

He said the comprehensive policy to educate children on health should include education on healthy lifestyle habits and promoting healthy eating habits such as basic nutrition education; weight management with

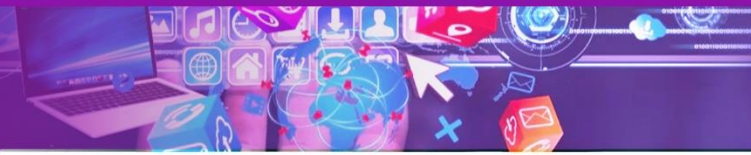
monitoring of Body Mass Index (BMI); educating and training of school canteen operators/cooks on the preparation of healthy and nutritious meals; include calorie and nutrition information on food sold at school canteens; and a total ban on junk food/processed food at schools.

He also said that children must be educated on practising an active lifestyle such as encouraging them to take up at least one physical sport or join a sports club, excluding e-sports; daily full body workout or physical exercises as part of the school timetable; and to provide a school environment that encourages students to be physically active.

"A whole-of-school policy which encourages students, headmasters and principals, teachers and all staff to be physically active should also be developed," he suggested.

Dr Muruga said for a successful outcome, parents of school children will have the most important role to play in supporting their child's healthy development.

"We urge the government to also consider including programmes or activities that can involve parents," he added.

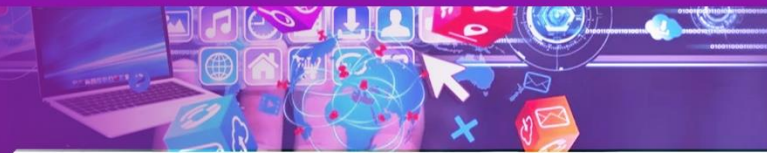

Goass calls for stern action against bullies in schools, varsities

MIRI: Cases of aggression and violence among students within and outside schools and colleges should be checked and curbed by the authorities as failure to act on bullying will result in dire consequences for victims, said Gabungan Orang Asal Sarawak/Sabah (Goass) founder Peter John Jaban.

He suggested severe punishment should be meted out to students who slap, hit, punch or kick another student for whatever reason, even if they have been provoked.

He was responding to a recent video which went viral where a Sarawakian university student stood up to a bully and decided to put on boxing gloves and turn the table on the latter, a foreign student, in Petaling Jaya.

The foreigner was given a painful lesson in the boxing match, trying to escape and eventually sent crashing to the floor by a left hook on the chin by the smaller-sized Sarawakian, who told him to learn his lesson and not to be a bully.

According to the post on X by Funnyworld1313, the foreign student allegedly has a history of being a bully and extorting money when drunk.

The angry Sarawakian lectured the floored university mate to learn his lesson as he was lucky to face him instead of others in the street where the later could end up dead in a confrontation.

Peter said students who bullied and beat up other

students should be hauled up and expelled, otherwise it is a good thing to organise an open fight to teach the bullies a lesson.

"I am happy that the Sarawak boy taught the foreign student a good lesson as a warning," he added.

Peter said victims who are assaulted and beaten up are physically and emotionally scarred and many are traumatised and psychologically affected.

He pointed out that bullies have caused fundamental threats to students' daily lives in institutions of higher learning, schools, clubs, after-school activities, neighbourhoods, and many public places in Malaysia.

This could force victims to drop out of school and take up arms for self defence due to continuous harassment, name-calling, violence, and other forms of bullying, he added.

He also said many students, especially young girls, have a fear of bullying by college mates and do not know how to stand up for themselves.

Hope Place seeks kind donations for bedridden girl with cerebral palsy

KUCHING: Hope Place has come to the aid of Nur Rabiatul Adawiyah Darus, a 12-year-old girl who was born with cerebral palsy.

The non-governmental organisation in a statement yesterday said Rabiatul's plight was brought to their attention by social workers at Sarawak General Hospital (SGH).

Rabiatul lives at Kampung Gita Lama, Petra Jaya here with her parents and four siblings.

Her father Darus is a daily paid construction worker, while her mother Hazlinda is a housewife. Three of her siblings are still studying.

With a heavy heart, Darus shared to Hope Place his plight of not being able to provide sufficiently for his family.

"With price increase in food, children's school expenses and my little girl's illness, we never seem to have enough to make ends meet," he said.

When meeting the family for the first time, Hope Place learnt that Rabiatul is not only bedridden, but also deaf and mute as well.

"Her feeding tube is connected straight to her stomach. Unable to move much, Rabiatul also has frequent seizures.

"The saddest thing was Rabiatul never shows any response whenever her mother hugs her or smiles at her," said the statement.

Rabiatul had also been admitted to SGH's intensive care unit last year after having contracted lung infection, which

almost claimed her life.

While being grateful for the monthly aid of RM300 from state Welfare Department and a one-off assistance from Tabung Baitumal, Hazlinda also takes up babysitting to earn a little extra income.

Rabiatul's grandmother also helps by contributing diapers and support to the family.

Hope Place, meanwhile, is supporting Rabiatul with special milk supplements which she consumes once every three hours

daily.

Kuching High Court to hear woman's application to determine religion, upbringing of teen son

KUCHING: The High Court here will on Monday hear an application by a woman seeking a declaration that she has the right to determine the religion and upbringing of her teenage son, who at present has a Muslim name on his MyKad.

The plaintiff is seeking a court order to compel the National Registration Department (JPN), among others, to record changes in her son's MyKad in relation to religion.

One of the plaintiff's lawyers, Clarice Chan of Baru Bian Advocates Company, confirmed this yesterday.

Last month, the 52-year-old mother filed the originating summons in the High Court here against the Malaysian Births, Deaths and Adoptions director; the Sarawak regional registrar of Births and Deaths; the Identity Card Division director; the JPN director-general; JPN; and the federal government, as the first to sixth defendants.

Her 17-year-old son, who was born in Sabah and is now residing in Sarawak, has professed the Buddhist faith all his life. The divorcee contends that her son's Muslim father has no objections to him being a Buddhist.

The boy, who turns 18 next month, declared support in his affidavit for his Buddhist mother's legal challenge against JPN's alleged delay in changing his religious status on his MyKad.

It is understood that the teenager has just completed his schooling at a Chinese-medium school in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah and his friends know him by his Chinese name.

Born on Oct 18 2005, the teenager during his schooling years did not take any Islamic religious classes and has neither practised Islam in his life nor wanted to be identified as a

Muslim.

The plaintiff (mother) and the boy's father married in Sabah on Aug 3, 1999 but she personally practises Buddhism. The couple divorced on Jan 27, 2010

The woman was granted sole care and custody of their son who was raised as a Buddhist since birth. Her former husband, who is a Muslim, has since remarried and now has a separate family of his own.

The mother claimed on July 5 this year she and her lawyers faced problems when applying to JPN Sarawak to change the details in her son's identity card registers.

She claimed that a woman JPN Sarawak counter staff member refused to accept the application and instead gave her a separate set of forms to fill.

The mother claimed she resubmitted the application on July 18 with supporting documents from her former husband as well as their son, which JPN accepted.

She alleged that following her lawyers' letter to the state JPN, the department replied via a letter dated July 31 that it neither granted nor rejected the application and that she was asked to fill even more forms.

The mother said the forms were repetitive as they were, in essence, identical – especially the second and third forms – save for the provisions of the relevant ordinance.

She contended that as a Malaysian citizen, she is entitled to correct the details on her son's identity card in the relevant register in any part of the country. The mother also claimed that her son is known to friends, family, teachers, and the community by his Chinese name and that they both attend a Buddhist society here.

Man who threatened brother, parents over money jailed six months

KUCHING: A man was sentenced yesterday to six months in jail for threatening his younger brother and parents over their refusal to give him money.

Mohamad Fadli Taib, 28, from Daro, Mukah pleaded guilty after the charge framed under Section 506 of the Penal Code was read to

him before Magistrate Zubaidah Sharkawi.

The court ordered the jail sentence to take effect from yesterday.

According to the case facts, Mohamad Fadli ran amok at the family home in Taman Matang Jaya at around 9.08pm on Sept 2 and threatened his 20-year-old

brother for refusing to give him money.

He similarly threatened his parents after they both also refused his demand for money.

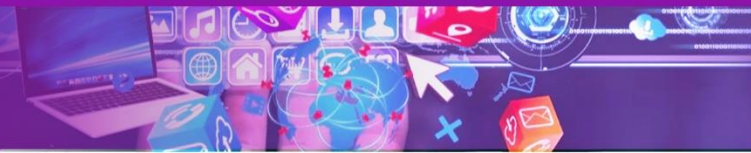
A police report lodged by the family led to his arrest on Sept 3.

Investigations found that the

family refused to give money to Mohamad Fadli as they believed he would use it to buy drugs.

It was also not the first time the accused had behaved in such manner against his family.

Insp Nur Shafiq Nyaie Ilin prosecuted, while the accused was not represented by legal counsel.

Nancy: Report sexual harassment cases

KOTA BHARU: Parents of children who are victims of sexual harassment should not hesitate or be afraid to report such incidents, said Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

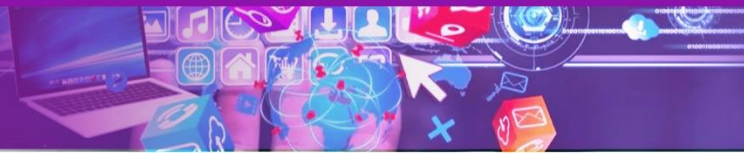
She said according to police statistics, there were 378 cases of sexual harassment in 2020, and the number increased to 506 cases in 2021. There was however a slight drop in 2022, which amounted to 477 cases, involving both men and women, she added.

"While we acknowledge the decrease in reported cases, I remain concerned that victims might hesitate due to fear or the embarrassment for their families. They should immediately report any instances of sexual harassment," she said at a press conference after officiating the ministry's Anti-Sexual Harassment Advocacy Programme in Kelantan, yesterday.

Commenting further, Nancy said children who become victims of sexual harassment depend on their parents to protect them.

"Parents should educate their children, not hesitate to report incidents, and be cautious if anyone who engages in improper conduct or touching. They should pay attention to their children's movements and understand their body language.

"The fear and embarrassment of reporting can be part of the challenges in addressing sexual harassment, especially when the perpetrators view their actions as harmless jokes or misunderstandings," she said.

Teen with stolen motorcycle gets three years in Sekolah Tunas Bakti

KUCHING: A 14-year-old boy has been ordered by the Magistrates' Court here to be sent to Sekolah Tunas Bakti for three years after he pleaded guilty to retaining a stolen motorcycle.

Magistrate Zubaidah Sharkawi imposed the sentence on the teenager after reviewing the Welfare Department's (JKM) probation report.

The court also ordered for him to be placed under the supervision of JKM personnel for two years after he is released from the school.

The teenager was charged under Section 411 of the Penal Code for having in his possession a stolen motorcycle at a house in Sungai Maong

Tengah around 2pm on July 28.

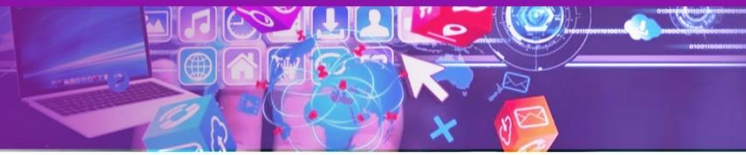
The motorcycle was reported stolen on July 11 by a 24-year-old man, who had parked it in front of a premises at Jalan Satok.

Cleaner mum abandons son at bosses' home

A MOTHER, who worked as a house cleaner, abandoned her two-year-old son at her customer's house in Subang Jaya, Selangor, *Harian Metro* reported.

The Welfare Department is now looking for the mother, only known as Thevegi, to resolve issues regarding the boy's custody and documentation.

"However, since January, the woman stopped going to the couple's house and she could not be contacted," she said.

The boy has no valid documentation with him.

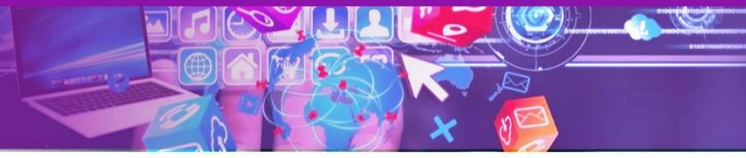
"This has happened to me before and I urge the government to step in. What I'm raising today involves television stations and event organisers. Some organisers take months to pay us, sometimes even longer.

Teen claims sexual abuse at centre

Childcare centre ordered shut after chairman accused of misconduct

GEORGE TOWN: A childcare centre here has been ordered to shut down following an incident of sexual abuse involving one of its residents.

A 17-year-old girl had claimed that she was kissed on the lips and hugged by a man, believed to be the chairman of the home on the Penang island, on Feb 19.

Penang Welfare Department director Zakaria Taib said the centre would need to be closed down within the next few days.

"The home is not registered and

we will place the remaining five children in another home.

"We have moved the alleged victim and her siblings to another home after the incident came to light.

"The victim is currently living with her mother in Johor Baru.

"Our priority is the children's safety. The case is now being handled by the police," he added.

Prior to the incident, there were 10 children staying at the centre.

The incident, believed to have



been captured on CCTV, came to light after a social worker with a non-governmental organisation lodged a police report on May 1.

Police picked up the man, in his 40s, for questioning a day later. He was released on police bail.

In the police report, the social worker said the girl alleged that the man had hugged and kissed her on the lips at 8.30pm on Feb 19.

The report claimed that the

man had been "harassing" the girl since December 2022.

Balik Pulau OCPD Supt Kamarul Rizal Jenal (*pic*) said investigation papers on the case had been submitted to the deputy public prosecutor's office on Aug 30, with a request to charge the man under Section 14 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017.

He added initial investigation showed that the centre has been operating since June 2022.

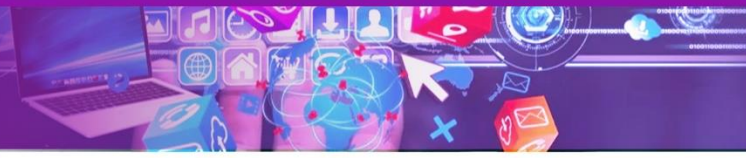
It was listed as an NGO with its application to the state Welfare Department still pending approval, he said.

"The girl is now staying with her mother in Taman Tampoi Utama, Johor Baru.

"Her elder brother and younger sister, who were also staying at the home previously, were transferred to the Children Protection Centre in Johor after the incident," said Supt Kamarul.

Child Protection Society Penang social service head G. Suria Kumari said the home should not have been allowed to operate.

She added rules must be adhered to if there is a request to register a childcare centre with the authorities.

Woman falls victim to mooncake scam

A WOMAN realised she was scammed after being told to download a suspicious mobile app just to apply for a refund, reported *Sin Chew Daily*.

The woman from Seri Kembangan, Selangor, said she bought four boxes of mooncakes for RM440 after seeing an advertisement on Facebook, but did not receive the goods after paying.

When she complained to the "seller", they asked her to download an app which would help her apply for a refund.

She realised she had been scammed after finding out that the app required her to divulge her personal details.

"They wanted me to download an app. Seeing this, I realised I

had been scammed!" she said.

She lodged a police report on Sept 5.

It is believed that the app was used in what is known as "recovery fraud".

After being scammed the first time, the fraudster would then claim to be able to help the victim recover some or all of their initial loss.

They would often ask for the victim's sensitive personal information or an upfront fee and would disappear before the victim realised they had been scammed a second time.

The daily had earlier reported that Facebook was the top platform for scammers to con unsuspecting victims.

Malaysians had lost a total of RM80mil and RM92mil to scams on Facebook in 2021 and 2022 respectively, according to the Communications and Digital Ministry.

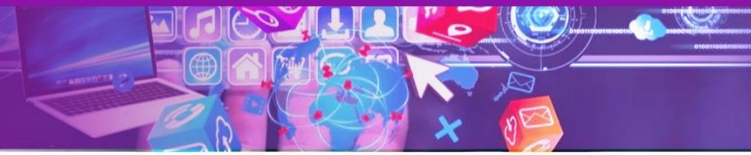

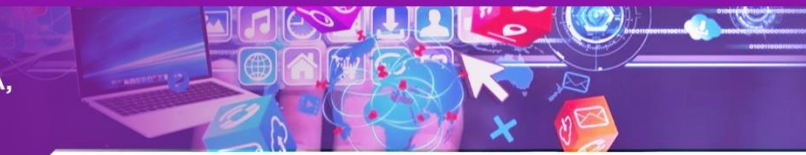

Jangan malu, takut lapor kes gangguan seksual: Nancy

KOTA BHARU: Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK M) menggesa ibu bapa kepada kanak-kanak yang terlibat dengan gangguan seksual supaya tampil atau membuat laporan.

Menterinya Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri berkata, ibu bapa tidak perlu rasa malu atau takut membuat laporan kerana ia merupakan tanggungjawab penting dalam melindungi anak-anak mereka.

Beliau berkata menurut statistik polis sejumlah 378 kes gangguan seksual dilaporkan pada 2020, dan

jumlah itu meningkat kepada 506 kes pada 2021.

“Bagaimanapun, terdapat sedikit penurunan pada tahun 2022 iaitu kepada 477 kes. Jumlah kes yang dilaporkan ini adalah melibatkan kedua-dua jantina, lelaki dan wanita.

“Kita akui laporan yang dibuat menunjukkan penurunan, tetapi saya masih sangsi mangsa tidak mahu berbuat demikian kerana takut dan mungkin memalukan keluarga, malah sepatutnya berani tampil dengan segera apabila berlaku gangguan seksual,” katanya.

lepas merasmikan Program Jerayawara KPWK M@Advokasi Antigangguan Seksual Negeri Kelantan, di sini semalam.

“Usaha itu berjaya dilakukan untuk mengeluarkan mangsa dan seterusnya mangsa ditempatkan di atas pengusung.

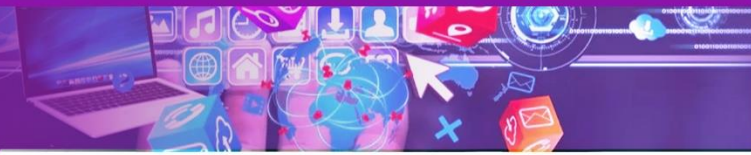
“Namun mangsa disahkan meninggal dunia semasa pemeriksaan oleh petugas KKM Tatau.

Tertuduh didakwa melakukan ugutan jenayah dengan mengugut hendak menyebabkan kematian terhadap adik lelakinya yang berusia 20 tahun pada 2 September 2023, sekitar jam 9.08 malam di sebuah rumah di Taman Matang Jaya, Jalan Matang di sini.

Berdasarkan fakta kes, semasa mangsa (pengadu) berada di rumah sewa keluarganya di alamat tersebut,

pengadu mendapati tertuduh tiba-tiba mengamuk, selain mengugut hendak memecahkan kepala pengadu, bapa dan emak mereka sekiranya tidak diberikan duit.

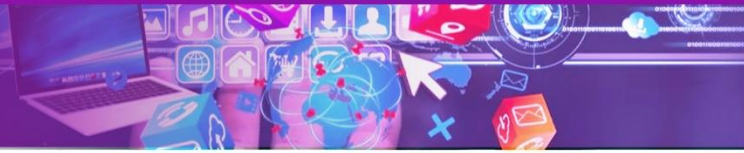

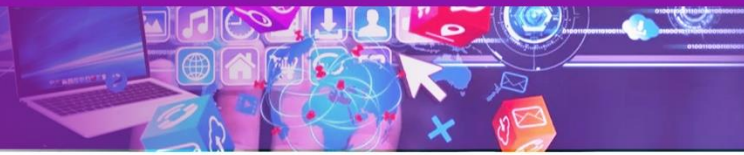

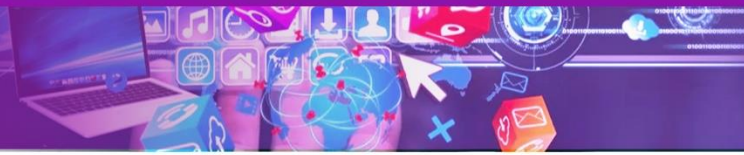

Menurut keterangan kes, tertuduh didapati telah menggunakan dadah berbahaya jenis Amphetamine, Methamphetamine, Methylenedioxy-methamphetamine (MDA) dan 3,4-methylenedioxy-methamphetamine (MDMA) yang terkandung di dalam Jadual Pertama ADB 1952 (Akta 234), dengan cara memasukkan dadah tersebut ke dalam tubuh badan sendiri tanpa kebenaran pihak berkuasa.

Difahamkan ketika kejadian mangsa dalam perjalanan pulang ke Pangkalan Nelayan Sungai Timun dan sedang menimba air di dalam perahunya selepas menangkap udang galah bersama beberapa nelayan lain menggunakan serkap.

Mengimbau detik cemas itu, Nurkaisa berkata, perahunya berada di hadapan perahu lain.

“Sebaik mula menimba air dari dalam perahu, kaki kanan saya yang terjuntai di dalam air disambar sesuatu dan ditarik ke dalam sungai.

“Mujur saya sempat memegang tali bot dengan kuat hingga buaya itu tidak dapat mengheret saya ke tengah sungai.

“Dalam kesakitan itu mak cik mengendurkan sedikit tali perayu dan menyelam sebelum terpegang bahagian hidung buaya itu.

“Mak cik pegang sekuat hati bahagian hidung buaya itu dan meronta-ronta hingga ia melepaskan gigitan,” katanya kepada Harian Metro semalam.

Nurkaisa berkata, dia kemudian menendang buaya itu bersaiz besar itu sebelum berenang naik ke perahu dan menjerit meminta tolong.

“Akibat gigitan buaya itu, mak cik cedera dari bahagian tumit hingga keting. Malah pembedahan terpaksa dilakukan kelmarin susulan kecederaan dialami.

Mangsa diserang buaya tembaga

Melaka: Buaya tembaga (*Crocodylus Porosus*) dikenali pasti sebagai spesies haiwan yang menyerang dan menggigit kaki wanita warga emas ketika mangsa menangkap udang galah di Sungai Timun, Lubok China di sini, Jumaat lalu.

Pengarah Jabatan Perlindungan Hidupan Liar dan Taman Negara (Perhilitan) negeri, Petra Sulai berkata, ia berikutan sungai berkenaan adalah habitat spesies buaya tembaga.

“Dianggarkan terdapat ratusan ekor buaya tembaga mendiami sungai berkenaan dan hal ini sedia diketahui oleh penduduk di sekitar kawasan itu dan juga nelayan.

“Justeru, kami menasihatkan penduduk dan nelayan supaya sentiasa ber-

hati-hati ketika melakukan sebarang aktiviti termasuk menangkap udang galah menggunakan alat serkap. Kegiatan ini amat berisiko dan langkah berwaspada perlu diambil bagi mengelak sebarang kejadian tidak diingini,” katanya dihubungi di sini.

Menurut Petra, berdasarkan rekod jabatan, kejadian serangan buaya itu kali pertama dilaporkan berlaku di perairan sungai berkenaan dan kes kini disiasat Perhilitan Negeri Sembilan kerana ia berlaku di kawasan negeri itu.

“Untuk menangkap buaya ini agak mustahil kerana terdapat ratusan buaya di sungai itu. Kita tidak tahu yang mana satu (buaya) yang menggigit mangsa,” katanya.

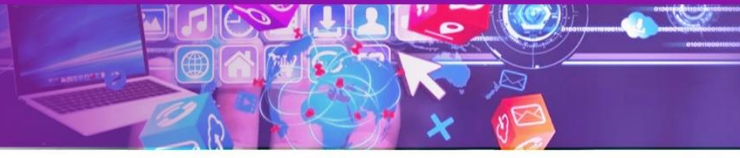

Dalam pada itu, insiden menimpa Nurkaisa turut mendapat perhatian Ahli Dewan Negeri (Adun) Duyong, Datuk Mohd Noor Helmy Abdul Halem yang memuat naik video sewaktu menziarahi mangsa di HTJ, Seremban.

"Malah along turut mengganggu ibu saya yang menghidap penyakit par-

kinson serta *anxiety*. Akibatnya ibu saya tidak lena tidur malam," katanya.

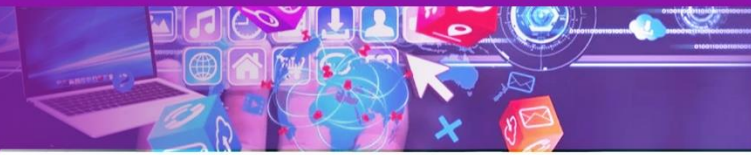

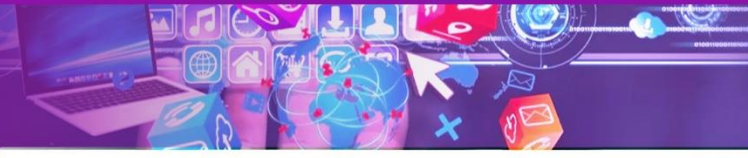

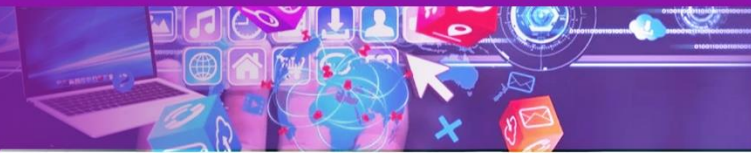

Petaling Jaya: Terperdaya dengan dakwaan dia memiliki rekod saman trafik, menyebabkan wanita kerugian RM31,638.85 akibat ditipu sindiket penipuan dalam talian.

Ketua Polis Selangor, Datuk Hussein Omar Khan berkata, polis menerima laporan daripada mangsa berusia 37 tahun, baru-baru ini berkaitan penipuan menggunakan e-mel palsu dalam urusan pembayaran saman trafik Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM).

Menurutnya, wanita terbabit menerima satu e-mel daripada no-reply@rmp.gov.my yang menyatakan dia mempunyai satu saman trafik PDRM.

"E-mel terbabit menyertakan portal rasmi MyBayar PDRM di pautan <https://mybayar.rmp.gov.my> untuk mangsa membuat semakan.

"Mangsa membuat semakan melalui pautan terbabit dan mendapati terdapat satu saman PDRM atas kenderaannya," kata-

nya dalam kenyataan, kelmarin.

Hussein berkata, e-mel palsu terbabit kemudian memberi amaran kepada mangsa untuk segera membayar saman itu jika tidak mahu tindakan lanjut dikenakan.

"Ia turut menyertakan satu laman My Bayar PDRM bragi@noxmedical.com untuk mangsa membuat bayaran secara dalam talian.

"Mangsa kemudian menekan pautan go to page payment dan dibawa masuk ke laman MyBayar PDRM iaitu My Bayar PDRM yang sebenarnya adalah palsu untuk membuat bayaran saman RM50 di mana mangsa mengisi butir-butir perbankan iaitu kata nama, kata kunci dan nombor OTP ke dalam borang yang disediakan dalam pautan itu.

"Setelah butiran perbankan dimasukkan transaksi bayaran terbabit gagal dengan skrin laman sesawang palsu itu menyata-

kan nombor kod SMS yang diterima tidak sah," katanya.

Beliau berkata, mangsa tidak menyedari sebenarnya *scammer* memperoleh butir rahsia perbankan mangsa melalui pautan palsu itu membolehkan pihak *scammer* memindahkan wang mangsa secara dalam talian ke dalam akaun bank lain.

"Mangsa kemudian menerima panggilan daripada pihak bank menyatakan wang dari akaun mangsa dipindahkan sebanyak tiga kali dalam masa singkat ke dalam akaun bank lain berjumlah RM31,638.85.

"Mangsa baru menyedari ditipu dalam urusan bayaran saman PDRM terbabit," katanya.

Beliau menasihati orang ramai supaya tidak melayan sebarang e-mel didakwa daripada PDRM untuk membayar saman, kerana jabatan itu tidak berhubung menerusi e-mel untuk urusan berkenaan.
