Mengaku tendang, tumbuk anak

Gerik: Seorang bapa mengaku bersalah di Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam atas pertuduhan mencederakan anak kandungnya dengan menendang dan menumbuk mangsa yang berusia 12 tahun, minggu lalu.

Mohamad Zairi Mohamad Nawi, 37, didakwa menyebabkan kecederaan ke atas kanak-kanak lelaki itu di sebuah rumah di Jalan Pasir Buaya, Kampung Perah di sini pada 29 Oktober lalu.

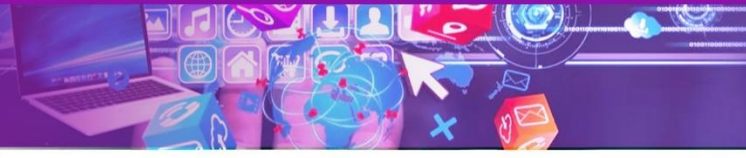
Pertuduhan dikemukakan mengikut Seksyen 323 Kanun Keseksaan dibaca bersama Seksyen 326A kanun sama membawa hukuman penjara maksimum setahun atau dengan denda hingga RM2,000 atau dengan kedua-duanya dan boleh dipenjara dua kali ganda tempoh maksimum jika sabit kesalahan.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Nor Atiyah Shafiee memohon tarikh baharu bagi menunggu laporan perubatan mangsa dan tawarkan jaminan RM5,000 ke atas tertuduh dengan seorang penjamin.

Peguam Yayasan Bantuan Guaman Kebangsaan (YBGK), Nur Murni Che Mood yang mewakili dua anak itu memohon jaminan rendah atas alasan anak guamnya yang berpendapatan tidak tetap, perlu menanggung anak dan ibu bapanya.

Majistret membenarkan jaminan RM2,500 dengan seorang penjamin dan menetapkan 27 November untuk sebutan semula kes.

Kelmarin, tertuduh mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen Kuala Kangsar atas pertuduhan memiliki senjata berbahaya, iaitu sebilah parang di tepi jalan Kampung Perah, Gerik, pada 30 Oktober. BERNAMA

Guna dokumen palsu

Pembantu tadbir MINDEF didenda RM20,000

Kuala Lumpur: Mahkamah Sesyen semalam mengenakan hukuman denda RM20,000 terhadap seorang pembantu tadbir kewangan Kementerian Pertahanan (MINDEF) kerana menggunakan dokumen palsu, tahun lalu.

Hakim, Rozina Ayob, memutuskan hukuman berkenaan terhadap Norshuhada Ismail, 35, selepas ibu tiga anak itu mengaku bersalah atas tuduhan berkenaan.

"Mahkamah bagi peluang terakhir, kamu (tertuduh) sepatutnya menjadi teladan kepada anak," katanya.

Mahkamah juga mengarahkan tertuduh dipenjara 30 hari jika gagal bayar denda berkenaan.

Mengikut pertuduhan, wanita terbabit didakwa bersubhat de-

ngan Pengurus Syarikat Mieza Jaya Global Enterprise, Nordin Yaakop, 59, sebagai ejen Kementerian Pertahanan dengan cagarannya menggunakan dokumen tulen.

ia adalah Kertas Kerja bagi Permohonan Perkhidmatan Sajian bagi Kursus Bijak Urus Wang pada 28 Februari hingga 3 Mac 2022 dan Bengkel Memperkasakan Modal Insan pada 14 hingga 17 Mac 2022 berjumlah RM15,776.

Dengan itu, tertuduh ada sebab untuk percaya menggunakan dokumen palsu dengan niat hendak memperdayakan Kementerian Pertahanan.

Kesalahan dilakukan di pejabat Pusat Tanggungjawab (PTJ) Bahagian Pembangunan Sumber

Manusia, Markas Tentera Laut, Kementerian Pertahanan, antara Februari hingga Mac 2022 mengikut Seksyen 471 Kanun Keseksaan (KK).

Tertuduh boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 465 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa kepada hukuman penjara maksimum dua tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Rayu tidak dipenjarakan

Terdahulu, Norshuhada yang tidak diwakili peguam merayu tidak dipenjarakan, sebaliknya hanya dikenakan hukuman denda atas alasan perlu menanggung keluarga dan tiga anak masih bersekolah.

"Saya insaf, menyesal dan ber-

janji tidak akan melakukan kesalahan sama dan mohon hukuman denda antara RM20,000 hingga RM25,000," katanya.

Bagaimanapun, Pegawai Pendakwa Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM), Afiqah Ab Razak, memohon dikenakan hukuman setimpal terhadap tertuduh.

"Kes membabitkan penjawat awam selaku pembantu tadbir kewangan menguruskan perolehan, ia profesion mulia yang tidak seharusnya dicemari unsur jenayah.

"Penggunaan dokumen palsu menunjukkan sikap tamak tertuduh dan kes ini membabitkan kepentingan awam yang perlu diutamakan berbanding kepentingan peribadi," katanya.

Tertuduh, Norshuhada Ismail, 35, mengaku bersalah atas tuduhan menggunakan dokumen palsu dengan niat memperdayakan Kementerian Pertahanan Malaysia.

Mengikut pertuduhan, ibu tiga anak itu didakwa bersubahat dengan Pengurus syarikat Mieza Jaya Global Enterprise, Nordin Yakop, 59, sebagai ejen kepada Kementerian Pertahanan Malaysia dengan curangnya menggunakan suatu dokumen sebagai tulen iaitu Kertas Kerja bagi Permohonan Perkhidmatan Sajjian bagi Kursus Bijak Urus Wang pada 28 Februari 2022 hingga 3 Mac 2022 dan Bengkel Memperkasakan Modal Insan pada 14 Mac 2022 hingga 17 Mac 2022 berjumlah RM15,776.

nusia, Markas Tentera Laut, Kementerian Pertahanan Malaysia di sini, antara Februari hingga Mac 2022.

Wanita itu dituduh mengikut Seksyen 471 Kanun Keseksaan dan boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 465 kanun sama, jika disabitkan boleh dipenjarakan maksimum dua tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya. Norshuhada yang tidak diwakili peguam merayu dikenakan hukuman denda dan tidak dipenjarakan dengan alasan menanggung keluarga dan tiga anak masih bersekolah.

"Saya insaf dan menyesal

serta berjanji tidak akan melakukan kesalahan sama dan mohon hukuman denda antara RM20,000 hingga RM25,000," katanya.

Pegawai Pendakwa Suruhanjaya Pencegahan Rasuah Malaysia (SPRM), Afiqah Ab Razak memohon hukuman setimpal atas kesalahan dilakukan tertuduh.

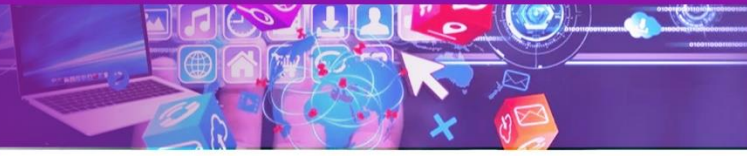
"Kes ini membabitkan penjawat awam selaku pembantu tadbir kewangan menguruskan perolehan, ini profesion mulia yang tidak seharusnya dicemari unsur jenayah.

"Penggunaan dokumen palsu adalah sikap tamak

haloba tertuduh dan kes ini membabitkan kepentingan awam diutamakan melebihi kepentingan peribadi.

"Oleh itu, kami memohon hukuman setimpal, pendakwaan tidak membantah jumlah sekiranya hukuman denda dalam julat RM20,000 hingga RM25,000, tertuduh tiada rekod lampau," katanya.

Mendengar hujah kedua-dua pihak, Rozina menasihatkan tertuduh supaya insaf sebelum menjatuhkan denda RM20,000 atau dipenjarakan 30 hari jika gagal membayar denda berkenaan.

'Sudah tiba masa buli dikategorikan sebagai jenayah berat'

Kuala Lumpur: Kes *raging* atau buli tidak boleh dipandang remeh kerana ia memberikan kesan negatif secara fizikal, psikologi dan emosi terhadap mangsa buli, malah ia adalah satu perbuatan jenayah.

Data Sistem Sahsiah Diri Murid (SSDM) Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) juga merekodkan 4,994 kes buli dari Januari hingga Oktober tahun ini.

Pengerusi Pertubuhan Aspirasi Wanita Malaysia, Wan Azlina Wan Adnan berkata, paling terbaru tular kejadian buli di sebuah sekolah berasrama penuh di Perak yang kini dalam siasatan polis.

Menurutnya, kes buli ini

bukan perkara baru dan budaya ini dalam kalangan pelajar terutama di sekolah berasrama penuh sudah di tahap merisaukan.

"Budaya membuli yang bermula dari konsep *raging* kini sudah mencapai tahap menyebabkan

mangsa-mangsa buli mengalami kecederaan teruk, kecacatan fizikal, trauma dan kematian.

"*Raging* oleh pelajar senior ke atas junior adalah salah satu penyumbang kes buli khususnya di asrama penuh," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

Beliau yang juga Ketua Gerakan Pengubalan Akta Anti Buli berkata, pelajar senior beranggapan mereka mempunyai kuasa untuk mendakwa pelajar junior atas kesalahan yang didakwa dilakukan.

Menurutnya, mereka ini juga menjadi 'hakim' untuk membuat keputusan dan juga menjadi pelaksana hukuman yang ber-

bentuk fizikal, mental dan emosi ke atas 'mangsa' terabit.

"Senior merasakan mereka seolah-olah mempunyai justifikasi untuk mengajar pelajar-pelajar lain melalui kekerasan.

"Tradisi ini diturunkan dan diwarisi daripada satu kemasukan ke kemasukan berikutnya. Itulah kitaran budaya buli di sekolah," katanya.

Katanya, kes buli tidak boleh dipandang remeh kerana ia memberikan kesan negatif terhadap mangsa secara fizikal, psikologi dan emosi.

"Semua pihak harus sedar bahawa kejadian buli adalah suatu jenayah yang

boleh merosakkan mangsa buli sehingga ada yang meragut nyawa.

"Oleh itu, buli tidak lagi seharusnya dilihat hanya sekadar masalah disiplin, tetapi jenayah 'berat' yang semakin berleluasa," katanya.

Katanya, sudah tiba masanya untuk Malaysia menggubal satu undang-undang khusus untuk mencegah dan menangani kes-kes buli terutama di sekolah-sekolah.

"Sehingga kini masih belum ada peruntukan khusus yang boleh memberikan definisi dan tafsiran yang lengkap dan menyeluruh tentang apa yang boleh dianggap sebagai perbuatan buli.

"Walaupun Malaysia mempunyai kanun keseksaan dan pelbagai peraturan, panduan seperti Ordinan Pelajaran, 1957, Peraturan-Peraturan Pelajaran (Disiplin Sekolah) 1959 serta pekeliling yang berkaitan, namun satu undang-undang anti buli yang khusus diperlukan untuk menambah baik dan menguatkan undang-undang sedia ada," katanya.

Katanya, bagi menghapuskan budaya buli di sekolah, ia memerlukan kerjasama semua pihak iaitu pentadbir sekolah, ibu bapa, Persatuan Ibu Bapa dan Guru (PIBG), Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia, polis dan masyarakat.

Redah lumpur demi didik anak bangsa

Guru SK Sungai Tiang depani pelbagai cabaran didik pelajar Orang Asli

Demi anak bangsa, Guru Cemerlang Pendidikan Sains, Ahmad Adnan Mohd Shukri tidak menghiraukan cabaran meredah perjalanan sukar ke sekolah pedalaman sejak mula bertugas di Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Sungai Tiang, Royal Belum, di sini, pada 2015.

Berkongsi cabaran menunaikan tanggungjawab mulia itu, Ahmad Adnan, 32, berkata, satu-satunya laluan ke sekolah adalah merentasi Sungai Perak dan Tasik Banding yang perjalanannya memakan masa kira-kiranya satu jam menaiki bot dari Jeti Awam Pulau Banding.

Bagaimanapun, menurutnya, cabaran sebenar adalah ketika air tasik terpaksa disurutkan beberapa kali dalam setahun sebagai langkah kawalan untuk

mengelakkan Empangan Temenggor pecah dan mampu menampung sejumlah air ketika musim tengkujuh.

Pada ketika itu, sebahagian kawasan tasik yang menjadi laluan bot untuk ke sekolah menjadi cetek dan menghalang bot tiba ke jeti berdekatan sekolah dengan lancar seperti kebiasaan.

"Apabila air tasik kering, guru-guru terpaksa berjalan kaki kira-kira dua kilometer, ada kalanya berjalan di tebing serta dalam lumpur atau air sambil menolak bot.

"Perjalanan dari Jeti Awam Pulau Banding (Jati Amanjaya) ke SK Sungai Tiang dengan bot yang sepatutnya memakan masa kira-kira sejam perjalanan menjadi tiga jam 30 minit ketika air surut.

"Berjalan kaki bukan ha-

nya melenggang dengan membawa diri semata-mata, setiap guru perlu mengangkut bersama barang-barang keperluan harian yang lain terutamanya barang-barang masak seperti ayam (16 ekor), gula (5kg), susu (10 tin), beras (20kg), sotong, udang, dan barang-barang kering yang lain untuk makan selama lima hari bagi 17 orang kakitangan sekolah," katanya memaklumkan guru bergilir-gilir memasak kerana tiada kantin.

Kongsinya lagi, cabaran lain adalah bagi mendapatkan bekalan air bersih di mana setiap hari air dari tasik dipam untuk tujuan memasak, minuman dan membersihkan diri selain

tiada talian telefon menyuarakan mereka mendapatkan khabar berita dari luar terutamanya kes kecemasan.

"Capaian Internet hanya diperoleh dari pencawang internet yang disediakan untuk penduduk kampung.

"Guru cuma memperoleh capaian internet yang sangat lemah ketika berada di pagar sekolah sahaja, manakala tiada capaian internet di dalam kawasan sekolah.

"Akibatnya sebarang bentuk mesyuarat atau bengkel yang dilaksanakan secara atas talian tidak dapat dihadiri," katanya.

Ahmad Adnan berkata, sumber tenaga utama bagi

bekalan elektrik di penempatan guru diperoleh daripada panel solar dan generator sebagai, namun kerosakan yang berlaku sejak beberapa bulan lalu menyebabkan guru terpaksa berpanas pada sesetengah waktu.

"Generator akan dihidupkan setiap hari bermula jam 7 pagi hingga 12 tengah hari. Seterusnya, generator ditutup untuk 'rehat' hingga jam 7 malam.

"Generator dihidupkan sekali lagi jam 7 malam hingga 12 tengah malam. Setelah itu, generator dimatikan semula hingga pagi. Beginilah rutinnya setiap hari," katanya.

Walaupun demikian, kepayahan serta kesulitan terbabit tidak mematahkan semangat apatah lagi keikhlasan guru SK Sungai Tiang itu menggalas tanggungjawab mendidik 150 murid Orang

Asli di pedalaman selain menyahut seruan menjayakan flagship Santuni Orang Asli yang digariskan oleh Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Saarani Mohamad dalam pelan Perak Sejahtera 2030.

Melalui pelan berkenaan, Jabatan Pendidikan Negeri memaikan peranan sebagai antara peneraju yang berminat kepada pembangunan dan kesejahteraan masyarakat Orang Asli di Perak.

Ahmad Adnan, bukan guru biasa-biasa, sumbangannya mendidik murid Orang Asli subetnik Negrito suku Jahai di SK Sungai Tiang, diiktiraf Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) apabila dinobatkan sebagai penerima Anugerah Khas Pendidikan Guru Gigih Pedalaman sempena Hari Guru Peringkat Kebangsaan 2023.

Anugerah itu sememangnya layak diterima anak jati Pengkalan Hulu itu memandangkan pelibatan beliau dalam dunia pendidikan sains yang menyeluruh meliputi aspek kompetensi iaitu pengetahuan dan kemahiran di pelbagai peringkat bermula dari sekolah, zon, daerah, negeri, kebangsaan dan antarabangsa.

kami sendiri tidak tahu sa-

Katanya, keadaan anak-
nyanya beransur pulih dan ma-
hu meneruskan pembela-
jarannya di sekolah berke-
nangan kerana sudah belajar
sejak tingkatan satu selain
turut aktif sukan.

“Cuma, saya agak terki-

lan apabila Persatuan Ibu
Bapa dan Guru (PIBG) se-
kolah itu mengeluarkan ke-
nyataan sehingga mende-
dahkan nama kami, se-
dangkan saya tidak mende-
dahkan nama sekolah
dan sebagainya,” katanya.

Menceritakan semula ke-
jadian menimpa anaknyanya,
wanita terbabit berkata, se-
mula pelajar Tingkatan Em-
pat diarahkan berkumpul
dengan memakai kasut se-
kolah oleh pelajar senior di
satu kawasan kira-kira jam

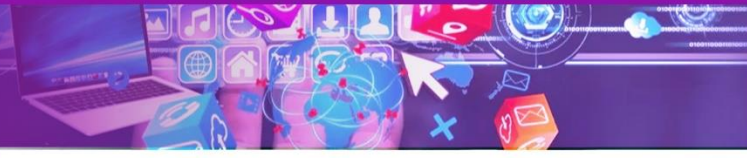

STOP THE STIGMA

CHILDREN'S MENTAL HEALTH IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY

THE 2019 National Health and Morbidity Survey (NHMS) found that 424,000 children struggled with mental health problems. The 2022 NHMS found that one in four teenagers had experienced feelings of depression and one in 10 had tried ending their lives.

Considering the fact that children and teenagers are our future, these findings are worrying.

In-depth studies should be done on this matter. With empirical data, we will be better able to design solutions.

I welcome Health Minister Dr Zaliha Mustafa's announcement on initiatives by the Health Ministry, Education Ministry and other agencies to address the mental health of children and teenagers.

The Covid-19 pandemic was a difficult period for many people. We grappled with isolation and our usual social connections were disrupted. This happened to children and teenagers, too, especially when they were unable to physically play and grow with their peers.

It is a challenge to transition to the post-pandemic period as children and teenagers need to make big adjustments.

Good mental health practices need to be instilled at a young age. It is high time mental health literacy was incorporated into the education system.

Children need to be exposed to the basics of good mental health practices.

Skills such as problem-solving and stress management will enhance a child's mental health. When they are mental-health literate, they will be more open to reaching out for help.

They must be able to get help with ease. Therefore, it is important to ensure that we have enough counsellors in primary and secondary schools. I hope the Education Ministry can collaborate with tertiary institutions so that trainee counsellors can do their practicum and internship in schools.

Teachers should also be equipped with basic mental health knowledge, such as the ability to recognise stu-

dents who are struggling mentally and the skills to provide emotional support.

Peer Supporters, or Pembimbing Rakan Sebaya, should be set up in every school as some children feel more comfortable opening up to their peers. Peer supporters can be a crucial link between struggling students and the help they need.

From the same 2022 NHMS, only 24.2 per cent of teenagers felt their parents could understand their problems and worries. So, where do they turn to for support when they are emotionally troubled?

Children should have a safe space to talk about their feelings without the fear of being judged.

Parents need to have an awareness of mental health as they play an important role in helping to develop their

children's mental wellbeing.

Have frequent conversations about their feelings and validate them instead of reprimanding them. I have encountered situations where a child was not allowed to seek professional help as the parents felt ashamed, or did not believe in mental health.

I hope that the "Mental Health Belongs to All, Stop the Stigma" campaign will include parents as one of its target audiences.

Parents and educators need to promote the responsible use of social media by children. There are numerous studies that found excessive use of social media is correlated with a higher risk of mental disorders. Excessive use can lead to cyberbullying, neglect of responsibilities and feelings of insecurity.

There is also a safety issue.

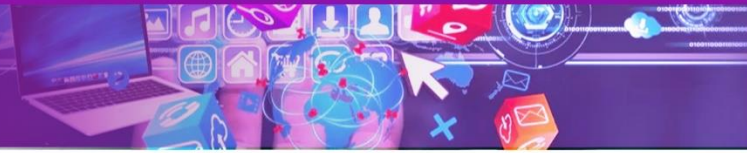
While there has been much negativity attached to social media, we need to also acknowledge the many advantages.

It is imperative that parents find a balance so that they can reap the benefits of using social media. They can spend time exploring social media together with their children, which could also strengthen the family bond.

Using a screen time limiting application can be helpful, too.

Mental health is everyone's responsibility, and it does not only matter in October, but it should be our emphasis on a day-to-day basis. Let's work together for the betterment of our children's mental health.

Student and teenager nabbed after cops find 10kg of cannabis in car

PASIR MAS: Two teenagers, including a student, were detained by police for possessing 10kg of cannabis worth RM31,000 here on Sunday.

Deputy district police chief Superintendent Nik Aminuddin Raja Abdullah said the two were arrested by the roadside in Kampung Banggol Petaling near Rantau Panjang.

Also seized in the operation was a Perodua Kancil.

"A police party went to the area following a tip-off and they saw the car when it passed by at 3.15pm.

"The officers then stopped the car, with two teenagers inside, for inspection.

"After checking the vehicle, they found 10kg of cannabis in the vehicle and detained the two, aged 18 and 16," he said in a statement yesterday.

Nik Aminuddin said one of the two suspects was still studying at a school in Rantau Panjang.

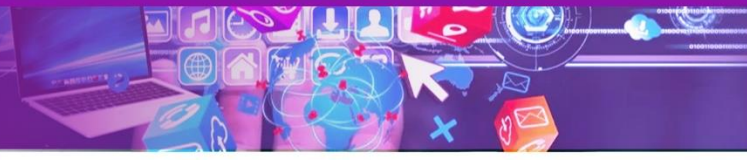


The 10kg of cannabis found inside the vehicle in the police operation in Pasir Mas, Kelantan, on Sunday. PIC COURTESY OF POLICE

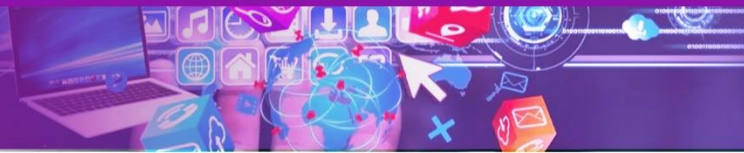

Kota Kinabalu police chief ACP Mohd Zaidi Abdullah said police found a plastic bag behind a space at the back of the toilet tank.

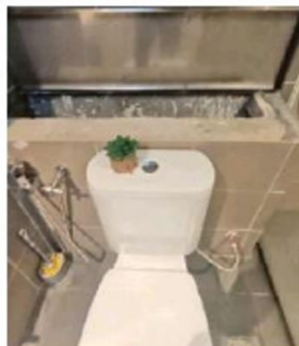
"Upon inspecting the plastic bag, police found the body of a baby boy believed to have just been born.

"The body was taken to Queen Elizabeth Hospital for a post-mortem," he said.

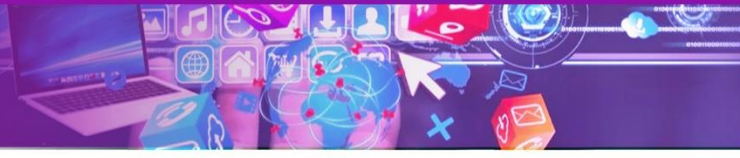
Mohd Zaidi added police are tracking down a 20-year-old woman who checked into the homestay four days ago.

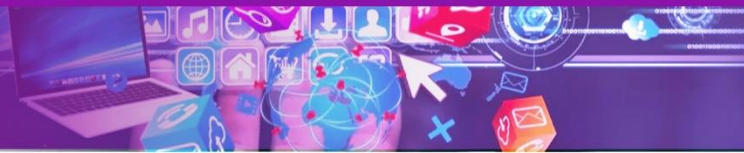

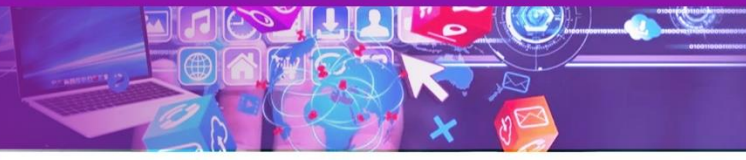

Easily acquired addiction

Teens hooked on vaping due to lack of restrictions and controls

KEPALA BATAS: With vapes and cigarettes becoming easily available online, some teenagers find vaping a "trend", thinking that it is "better" than smoking cigarettes.

According to a Form Three student, who only wanted to be known as Rizal, vaping is viewed as trendier among students due to the variety of flavours it offers.

The 15-year-old said vaping was also getting popular among female students.

Rizal said he first started with smoking before transitioning to vaping.

"I had my first taste of cigarettes when I was 11 years old. I took my father's cigarettes, and from there, it became a habit," he said.

Upon entering secondary school,

Rizal said he got curious after seeing his friends vaping.

"My friends said vaping is better than smoking cigarettes. After giving it a try, I stopped smoking and started vaping until now," he said.

Rizal said he bought his vape online, adding that several grocery shops also sold cheap vaping devices, some lower than RM50.

Another teenager, who wanted to be known as Mamat, said he started vaping to release stress while studying.

The 16-year-old ended up addicted to vaping.

"My first experience with vaping was when my cousin bought me a new vaping set on my 12th birthday," he said.

Mamat said he would only vape after school or at night when out with friends.

"I never brought it to school, unlike some of my seniors, includ-

ing girls.

"Vaping now is a trend among secondary school students," he added.

Vape shop operator Mohamad Nor Hakim Azizan, 23, said he practised the no-sale policy to those aged 18 and below.

"There are times when students would come to my shop.

"As a responsible trader, I always ensure they are not underage. I will ask them for their MyKad," he said.

The Star reported that vapes and cigarettes have become so easily accessible online that even teenagers are able to buy them, which has led to growing concern among parents and teachers.

Based on checks online, *The Star* found that these items were being sold on popular ecommerce sites as well as individual vape sellers' websites.

Transactions are below RM40

on average and there are no restrictions – purchasers are not even asked whether they are aged 18 or above.

Stakeholders said this was why the proposed Control of Smoking Products for Public Health Bill 2023 should be quickly passed as there was a growing trend of smoking and vaping among schoolgoing teenagers.

The Bill, dubbed as the Generational End Game (GEG), was initially slated to be tabled for the second reading in Parliament on Oct 10 but was postponed at the eleventh hour to make way for Budget 2024 and other orders of business.

The Health Ministry now has three days from Nov 28-30 to table and get the Bill passed.

If this fails, the next window to table and pass the law will be when the Dewan Rakyat convenes in 2024.

Parents fume over kids' easy access to vapes, ecigarettes

JOHOR BARU: Parents of primary school kids are worried about the rampant use of vapes and ecigarettes among youngsters, especially with the products still widely sold in the state.

A parent, who only wanted to be known as Liza, was disappointed that vape products were still available despite a statewide ban imposed by the state government in 2016.

The mother of three said she was curious how such shops, some of which are located in Bandar Baru Uda, could be issued business licences when the ban prohibits the sale of vapes.

"My youngest son is in Year Six and will be entering Form One next year, so naturally, I am worried about the peer pressure and bad habits that he might be exposed to.

"I hope that stronger enforcement will be carried out against those who sell vape or ecigarette products in shops before tackling the online sellers," the mother said.

The 46-year-old added there should be no more delay in the tabling of the Generational End Game (GEG) Bill to handle the issue as soon as possible.

On Jan 1, 2016, Johor became the first state in the country to ban vaping, with enforcement against users as well as traders.

The decision followed a decree by Johor Ruler Sultan Ibrahim ibni Almarhum Sultan Iskandar, who had ordered a ban on vaping in the state.

SJK(T) Ladang Mount Austin school board member James Selvanathan said although vaping among pupils was still uncommon, there is a risk they may do so after graduating to secondary school.

"This is why our school holds annual programmes to bring in policemen and doctors to educate them about the dangers of substance abuse, such as drugs and nicotine use.

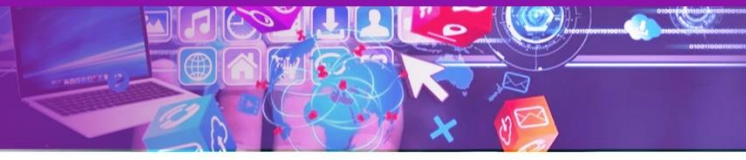
"As parents, we are worried about how easily vape and ecigarette products are available in the market and online.

"At least for the sale of cigarettes, there are stickers that prohibit the sale of the items to those under 18 years old.

"But there is no regulation for vapes and ecigarettes," the school board member said.

James, who is also the former school Parent-Teacher Association chairman, suggested a smoke-free radius be set up around the school to prohibit smoking or vaping.

"That way, not only is the school a smoke-free zone, those who wait outside to pick up the students are also not allowed to smoke, to minimise the students' exposure to such bad habits," he said.

PM: Quality of education must improve too

BANGI: The better learning facilities in the country must be translated into improved quality of education for our schoolchildren, says Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

The Prime Minister added that he has instructed both the Education and Higher Education ministries to focus on improving the quality of national education as early as next year in line with the improvement of the facilities.

"This year, we gave emphasis to a lot of details, focusing on the needs of students. The construction of new schools (replacing the dilapidated ones) has been completed, and the infrastructure facilities are sufficient.

"When they need help, we give," he added.

Anwar said the performance for 2024 cannot be the same as this year's, adding that there needs to be improvement.

He said he has told Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek and Higher Education Minister Datuk Seri Khaled Nordin that the focus after this is on raising and improving the quality of education.

The Prime Minister said that while "schools are good, the toilets are ready, the basic facilities are sufficient", the performance of the school students is the same as the one in previous years.

"We cannot accept this," he said, adding that improving students' academic performance is crucial in light of the changing global landscape marked with challenges.

"We cannot uplift our nation if the quality of education is not developed," he said at the launch of the pilot project on redeveloping dilapidated schools at SK Bandar Baru Bangi yesterday.

Anwar said he wants the Education Ministry to focus on helping schoolchildren to master languages and subjects such as mathematics, science, computer and religion.

He added it should also involve the parent-teacher associations to seek ways to get parents to be more involved in their children's education, including asking parents to spend at least half an hour

revising their children's schoolwork with them every night.

Anwar said the ministries should also draft proposals on improving the academic performance of students a week after school reopens.

The ministries should also submit progress reports to him.

He added that he will bring up the issue on education quality at the Cabinet meeting on Friday.

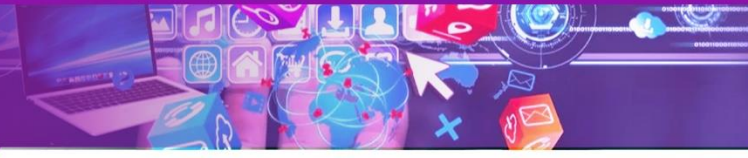

Selangor, Perak record rise in flood evacuees

KUALA LUMPUR: Selangor and Perak recorded an increase in the number of residents evacuated due to floods.

In Selangor, the number of evacuees increased to 673 people from 170 families yesterday morning compared with 547 from 144 families on Monday night.

Another relief centre was opened at Dewan Serbaguna MBSJ Camelia Section 10, Putra Heights, Subang Jaya to house 91 evacuees.

According to the Social Welfare Department's *Info Bencana*, so far, a total of seven relief centres have been opened in Selangor to accommodate evacuees.

They included two in Hulu Langat at SK Bangi and SK Semenyih as well as four in Sepang.

The centres in Sepang are at the Dewan

Orang Ramai Kampung Dato Ahmad Razali, Dewan Orang Ramai Jenderam Hilir, Dewan Orang Ramai Taman Gemilang and Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Dengkil.

In Perak, the number of evacuees increased to 299 people, involving 87 families yesterday morning compared with 257 from 74 families on Monday night.

They are housed at four centres in the Hilir Perak and Kerian districts.

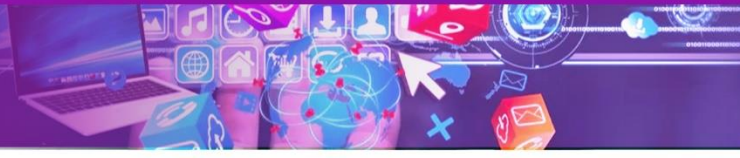
According to the Secretariat of the Perak Disaster Management Committee, 145 evacuees from 44 families are placed at a centre in Dewan Serbaguna Padang Tembak in Hilir Perak, while 97 from 24 families are housed at a centre in SK Changkat Lobak in Kerian and 57 evacuees from 19 families are at a centre in SK Alor Pongsu.

Evacuees at Dewan Majlis Perbandaran Teluk Intan centre were reported to have returned to their homes.

Meanwhile, the Irrigation and Drainage Department reported that the water in Sungai Bidor at Changkat Jong was at a dangerous level, with a reading of 4.10m, while Sungai Kerian in Selama was at a warning level with a reading of 12.21m and Sungai Kinta at the Tanjung Tualang Weir was at an alert level of 13.30m.

Several road stretches in Perak are closed due to floods.

The State Public Works Department said the FT 147 Jalan Selama route in Kerian is closed to all vehicles due to a landslide, and motorists are advised to use the alternative route A111 Jalan Pintasan Alor Pongsu-Bukit Merah. – Bernama

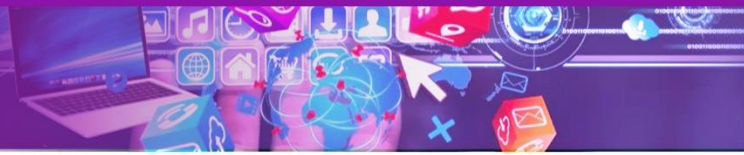
