KKM pastikan pelajar terima vaksin HPV

Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) komited dalam memastikan semua murid perempuan kohort 2021, 2022 dan 2023 menerima vaksin papilomavirus manusia (HPV) sebelum menamatkan persekolahan.

Menteri Kesihatan, Dr Zaliha Mustafa, berkata giliran suntikan bergantung kepada jumlah vaksin yang dapat diperolehi tahun ini.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, keutamaan pemberian vaksin HPV kepada murid perempuan kohort 2021 yang kini di Tingkatan Tiga.

“Apabila keseluruhan kohort ini selesai, vaksin akan mula diberi kepada murid kohort 2022 dan seterusnya kohort 2023,” katanya pada sesi soal jawab lisan di Dewan Rakyat, semalam.

Beliau menjawab soalan Yeo Bee Yin (PH-Puchong) berkaitan status terkini pelajar perempuan yang terlepas suntikan vaksin HPV pada 2020 hingga 2022.

Dr Zaliha berkata, seramai 336,592 pelajar perempuan Tingkatan Satu kohort 2020 hingga 2022 belum menerima dos vaksin HPV.

Katanya, isu berkenaan timbul selepas KKM tidak dapat membuat perolehan bekalan vaksin HPV pada 2021 disebabkan gangguan bekalan di peringkat global.

Suami isteri didakwa semula cuai jaga anak

Johor Bahru: Suami isteri yang dilepas tanpa dibebaskan oleh Mahkamah Sesyen, di sini kelmarin, mengekalkan pengakuan tidak bersalah dalam pendakwaan semula atas pertuduhan baharu di Mahkamah Sesyen Johor Bahru, semalam.

Pasangan terbabit membuat pengakuan itu di hadapan Hakim VM Mabel Sheela atas pertuduhan bertindak cuai terhadap anak lelaki mereka berusia empat tahun yang didakwa dilakukan dua bulan lalu.

Mengikut kertas pertuduhan, S Nagendran, 23, yang juga bapa tiri kanak-kanak itu dan ibu mangsa, A Sangeetha, 23, yang sedang hamil tiga bulan didakwa mencapai niat bersama bertindak secara cuai terhadap mangsa yang dijaga mereka dengan cara mungkin menyebabkannya mengalami kecederaan fizikal.

Perbuatan itu didakwa dilakukan di rumah mereka dekat Skudai Villa Apartmen, Jalan Aman, Taman Skudai Baru, di sini kira-kira jam 12.30 tengah malam

pada 28 April lalu.

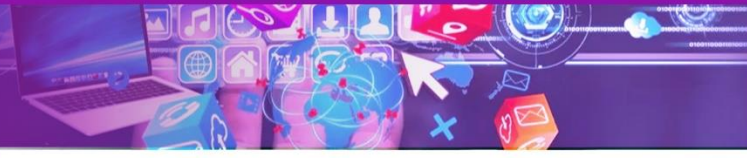
Mereka didakwa mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang sabit kesalahan boleh didenda sehingga RM50,000 atau penjara maksimum 20 tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Kes dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya S Thiviya, manakala pasangan suami isteri itu tidak diwakili peguam.

Mahkamah menetapkan kedua tertuduh dijamin RM7,000 setiap seorang, selain perlu melapor diri sebulan sekali di balai polis berhampiran, tidak mengganggu saksi dan menyerahkan passport kepada pihak mahkamah.

Tarikh sebutan semula kes ditetapkan 9 Julai depan.

Kelmarin, suami isteri itu dilepaskan tanpa dibebaskan apabila pihak pendakwaan gagal mempertahankan pertuduhan pindaan selepas pasangan itu menukar pengakuan kepada tidak bersalah.

Wanita perlu diberi tanggungjawab lebih besar

Wanita perlu diberikan peranan yang lebih besar termasuk untuk menerajui kementerian lebih kanan atau jawatan penting dalam agensi serta badan bukan kerajaan (GLC).

Ketua Wanita UMNO, Datuk Seri Dr Noraini Ahmad, berkata dengan pengorbanan dan perjuangan selama ini, wanita perlu dilihat seiring dengan peredaran politik semasa dan tidak mahu hanya diberikan portfolio tradisi, yang sifatnya 'sekadar ada' untuk mereka.

"Kita tidak mahu wanita seka-

dar memanas kerusi di agensi dan GLC saja dan dijanjikan dengan sejumlah bilangan kerusi (pada pilihan raya).

"Sudah tiba masanya wanita diberikan peranan lebih besar. Kuota 30 peratus, jangan dilupa dan bukan sekadar janji kosong saja.

"Wanita tidak akan pernah jemu dengan tuntutan ini sehingga ia tercapai. Memang kita faham, tuntutan ini hadir bersama dengan cabaran. Adakah kita sudah bersedia?"

"Kita mempunyai barisan yang cukup dan memenuhi kriteria

yang boleh ditonjolkan sebagai calon. Saya percaya kita boleh jika diberi peluang," katanya ketika menyampaikan Ucapan Dasar pada Perhimpunan Agung Wanita UMNO (PAU) 2023 di Pusat Dagangan Dunia (WTC) di sini, semalam.

Noraini berkata, sudah tiba masanya Wanita UMNO mempunyai sebuah institusi yang mencungkil potensi dan melahirkan calon wanita yang boleh diketengahkan.

"Wanita UMNO mesti bergerak ke hadapan. Evolusi politik Wa-

nita perlu diberi lebih banyak perhatian supaya lebih dipercayai, moden dan berkeseluruhan," katanya.

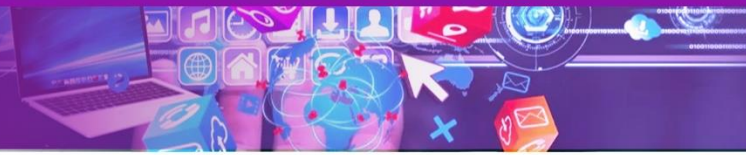
Fokus agenda lebih penting

Beliau berkata, sejak Perhimpunan Agung UMNO pada Mac lalu, Wanita sudah mula menggerakkan beberapa agenda pembaharuan penting dalam gerak kerja, terutama untuk berdepan Pilihan Raya Negeri (PRN).

Antaranya, memodenkan gerak kerja Jalanan Rakyat (JR), pengupayaan Skwad Sayang, me-

nambah baik Sekretariat Wanita Profesional dan menguasai media digital, selain akan menerapkan penggunaan teknologi analisis data raya, dengan penubuhan pusat data, rangkaian dan analisis atau Pusat DNA.

"Dengan pengalaman yang cukup luas, kita perlu sama-sama bangkit berjuang dan membuktikan peranan Wanita UMNO dalam menggerakkan jentera pilihan raya, bakal memberikan impak, sekali gus memberikan kemenangan dalam PRN nanti," katanya.

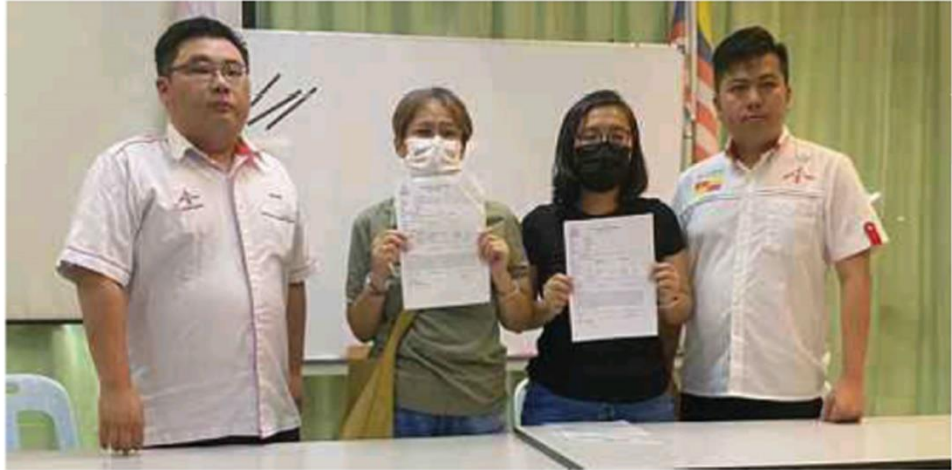

pada bahagian otak sebelum ini," katanya ketika ditemui di Pusat Biro Aduan Awam DAPSY di sini, semalam.

Turut hadir, Pengarah Biro Aduan DAPSY Selangor Lee Wen Bin dan Timbalan Pengarah Biro Aduan DAPSY Selangor Aw wai Kit.

Sim berkata, dia sudah mengeluarkan wang sehingga RM15,000 bagi membayar hutang anaknya

itu, namun masih diganggu along yang mendakwa anaknya masih mempunyai baki hutang pinjaman.

"Saya pun tidak tahu berapa ramai along dia pinjam dan jumlah pinjaman. Sekarang kami sudah tidak mempunyai wang lagi untuk membayar baki hutang itu.

"Saya merayu kepada along atau mana-mana pihak yang memberi pinja-

man kepada dia supaya tidak lagi mengganggu kami memandangkan saya dan suami tidak lagi menganggapnya sebagai anak," katanya.

Sementara itu, turut menerima tempas adalah bekas isteri lelaki berkenaan yang dikenali sebagai Tee, 37, yang menerima gangguan daripada along meskipun mereka sudah bercerai sejak 2019.

Katanya, susulan kejadian itu laporan dibuat di Balai Polis Arau semalam oleh pe-

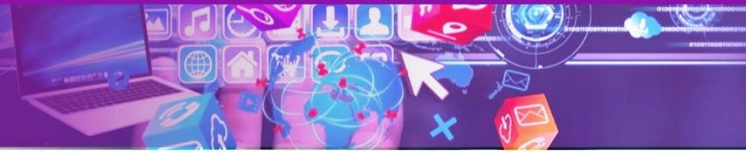
milik kedai emas dengan kerugian dianggarkan bernilai RM45,000.

Katanya, tahap kekerapan jenayah seksual termasuk kes rogol membabitkan kanak-kanak dan remaja bawah umur juga didapati se-

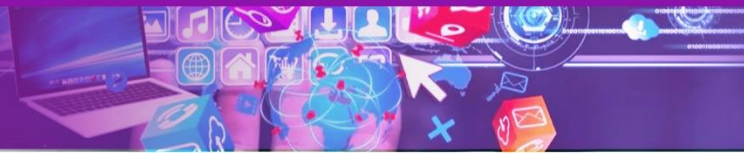

Noraini berkata, hab itu akan menjadi platform penting yang menyediakan peluang dan sokongan kepada pekebun kecil wanita,

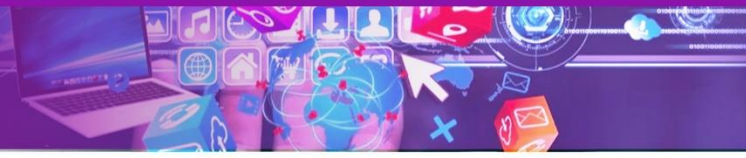

ngan menggunakan baki stok vaksin pada tahun 2020, seramai 34,933 orang (15.7 peratus) pelajar perempuan tingkatan satu kohort 2021 menerima dos satu vaksin HPV serta terdapat 187,151 orang atau 84.3 peratus belum menerima vaksin HPV pada tahun 2021.

"Kemudian pada tahun 2022, harga vaksin HPV di peringkat global meningkat sebanyak enam kali ganda

mengakibatkan KKM hanya boleh membuat perolehan sebanyak 100,000 dos vaksin HPV pada Disember 2022 lalu.

"Semua vaksin itu sudah diagihkan ke negeri-negeri seluruh negara untuk diberikan kepada pelajar perempuan tingkatan satu kohort 2021 yang belum menerima vaksin.

'We can no longer contest all seats'

KUALA LUMPUR: Umno leaders and members have been reminded to accept the fact that the grand old party is no longer a dominant political organisation in the country.

Wanita Umno chief Datuk Seri Dr Noraini Ahmad said following the party's poor showing in the last two general elections, Umno must come to terms that it would no longer be able to contest all seats in the state polls.

The present development in the country's political landscape, she said, demanded Umno to learn to work in consensus and compromise with its allies in the unity government.

"In the upcoming (state) elections, we should ensure the victory of Barisan Nasional (BN).

"At the same time, we must also lend our assistance to our political partners in the coalition (unity) government to help them win their respective seats just as how we are hoping for similar assistance from them," Noraini said in her policy speech during the Wanita Umno delegates' conference at Dewan Merdeka in World Trade Centre Kuala Lumpur.

Noraini, nevertheless, said she realised that such move was a tall order for Umno, since the party was formerly a long-time political rival to some parties in the unity government.

However, she envisioned that it was not impossible for Umno to forge strong cooperation with its new allies for the betterment of the country.

"Therefore, the conference today (yesterday) is extremely important. Let us come together and identify the best formula in our efforts not only to inject new spirit into the (Wanita Umno) movement, but also position Um-

no to its former glory.

"Let us put aside our disappointment and frustration (following Umno's dismal performance in the last two general elections). There is a big task ahead of us and we need to move forward," she said.

Noraini also reiterated the movement's stance that it would not budge from its demand for the party leadership to set aside 30 per cent of seats in the upcoming state elections for women candidates.

"We want such quotas for women candidates to become a reality and not merely empty promises. We will continue to demand such quota.

"Wanita Umno has a line-up of leaders who are capable of being put forward as election candidates. I certainly believe that we can," she said.

Puteri Umno chief Datuk Nurul Amal Mohd Fauzi, at the wing's own conference, asked members

to widen their perspective on the formation of the unity government to ensure political stability in the country.

She said the political assimilation of two top coalitions — Barisan Nasional and Pakatan Harapan — may be difficult and feels foreign to Umno members, but the fundamental thing was to ensure that the government could be retained.

"I admit that we might need some time to adapt, comprehend and fully understand the wisdom behind our role in the unity government.

"Some of us might feel like we are caught between the devil and the deep blue sea. Is this the best choice for us to defend the party's struggle and protect the people's interests?

"However, unity is core and fundamental towards the government formation, (and) because of this, we became a part of the government."

He said the victim agreed to meet the girl at the specified location.

However, upon the victim's arrival at the location, he was set on by four men aged 22 to 29.

The suspects robbed the victim of RM550, a silver bracelet, a silver necklace, and a smartphone.

The victim lodged a police report on the day of the robbery, which led personnel from the district's Criminal Investigation Division (CID) to arrest the

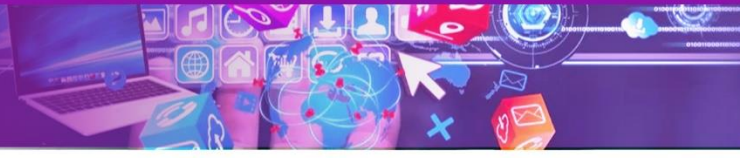
suspects at different locations.

"Police also seized a car which was used during the robbery. Also recovered was the victim's smartphone," said Aswandy.

He further revealed that all the suspects have previous criminal records for robbery and drug-related offences.

"Drug tests on all of them also showed that they tested positive," he added.

Police are investigating the case under Section 395 and Section 397 of the Penal Code.

KUCHING: A concerned doctor at the Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) has recently referred a malnourished 12-year-old girl to Hope Place Kuching for assistance.

The girl, Bettria Phuyuu Jeferson, has cerebral palsy since birth and is bedridden, as well as unable to move or speak, said the non-governmental organisation in a press release.

Bettria lives in Demak Laut with her mother and elder brother.

Her mother Priscilla, 40, is unable to work as her hands are full, taking care of all her daughter's needs as well as household chores.

"Every morning, I will send my son to school and I also have to bring Bettria with me in the car. I have no choice because there's no one else at home," said Priscilla.

Bettria is on tube-feeding, taking special milk formula once every three hours. Though she is 12 years old, Bettria looks tiny and malnourished.

According to Priscilla, Bettria needs constant care all the time and it is very dangerous if she is left on her own. She also has to bring Bettria to SGH for physiotherapy once a month.

Despite her many worries, Priscilla is thankful especially to her family for helping her in many ways.

According to the press release, her family has given her a car to use and would at times help out with food and monetary assistance.

Bettria has also received

a reclining wheelchair from Tabung Baitulmal Sarawak and a gravity chair (specialised car seat) from the Welfare Department.

Hope Place said it is supporting

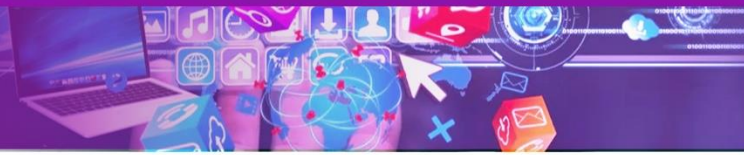
Bettria with supplies of the needed special milk formula.

Police tracking down man who allegedly abused baby girl

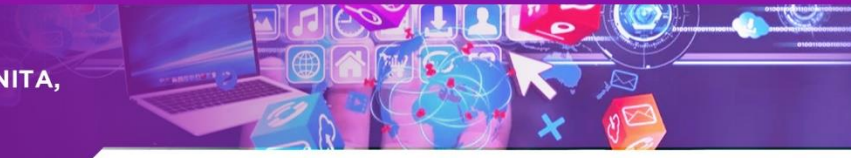
KUALA LUMPUR: The police are tracking down a 31-year-old man who allegedly abused an 11-month-old baby at an apartment unit at Setapak here.

scene after a call from a member of the public was received at 1.28am, the Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) said in a statement.

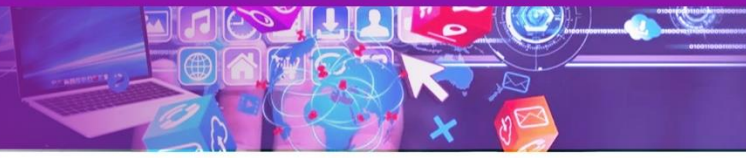
"The car is said to have skidded off the road before crashing

Prime Minister and Pakatan Harapan chairman Datuk Seri

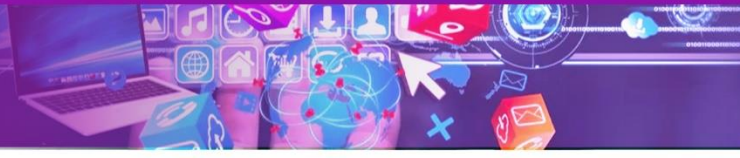
Anwar Ibrahim is expected to attend the opening of the annual general assembly today.

Chia's 'joke' no laughing matter

Comedian gets roundly criticised after distasteful joke about MH370

PETALING JAYA: Singapore-born stand-up comedian Jocelyn Chia (*pic*) has landed herself in hot water with top diplomats, artistes and the public slamming her for her "distasteful" joke about MH370 at a club in New York.

Singapore High Commissioner to Malaysia Vanu Gopala Menon described Chia's remarks as "gratuitously offensive comments" and said his government did not condone words or actions that cause harm or hurt to others.

"Chia, who is no longer Singaporean, does not in any way reflect our views. I sincerely apologise to all Malaysians for her hurtful remarks," he said in a state-

ment yesterday.

Chia is now a US citizen. The republic's Foreign Minister Vivian Balakrishnan also tweeted in response to Muar MP Syed Saddiq Syed Abdul Rahman's tweet referencing Chia's joke.

"She certainly does not speak for Singaporeans. We treasure our ties with family and friends in Malaysia, and are sorry for the offence and hurt caused to all Malaysians," he said.

Condemning Chia's distasteful joke, Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Dr Zambry Abdul Kadir said the comedian showed a total lack of sensitivity and empathy towards the victims' families.

"I believe this is not a stance or action



accepted by any country," he said.

Intan Maizura Othaman, the wife of a flight attendant on MH370, said her son Muhammad is still crying over the loss of his father. "...and here you are making fun of the tragedy.

"Do you know how many mothers are still crying over the tragedy until today?" she said in a video posted on her TikTok page.

Malaysian comedian Harith Iskander was also dismayed by Chia's actions.

While freedom of expression is necessary for comedians, he said it was also equally important to exercise sensitivity and empathy.

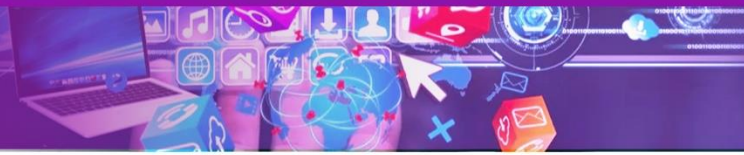
"The loss of the plane is a deeply traumatic event for all Malaysians," Harith said on his Instagram account.

"Comedians, as artists, need to be aware of the potential impact our words can have," he said.

"Malaysia, we may still be a developing nation. But when it comes to kindness and thoughtfulness, we are definitely first world," he said, alluding to Chia's snide remark that Malaysia was still a developing nation.

Comedian-screenwriter Datuk Afdlin Shauki said comedians should steer clear of sensitive topics such as tragedies and urged them to "use their heads".

He told *Berita Harian* it was all right to poke fun at Malaysians but "we generally avoid sensitive topics such as tragedies".

Couple charged again with neglecting son

JOHOR BARU: A married couple, who were given a discharge not amounting to an acquittal (DNAA) over negligence of their four-year-old son who died, have been charged again.

The boy's stepfather S. Nagendran and mother A. Sangeetha, both 23, pleaded not guilty when they were charged under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child

Act 2001 before Sessions Court judge VM Mabel Sheela yesterday.

According to the charge sheet, to achieve a common end, Nagendran and Sangeetha acted negligently towards the boy in their care, which might have caused physical injury to him.

They were accused of committing the offence at Skudai Villa Apartment, Jalan Aman, Taman Skudai Baru, here, on April 28.

The charge was read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code.

If convicted, they could be slapped with a maximum fine of RM50,000 or a jail term of up to 20 years or both.

The case was prosecuted by deputy public prosecutor S. Thiviya while the couple were not represented.

Mabel Sheela set bail at RM7,000 with one surety each and set July 11 for next mention.

Both accused are also required to report to the police station once a month, not to disturb witnesses

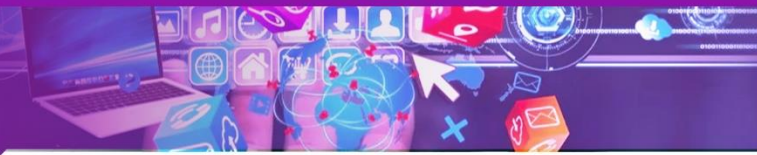
and to surrender their passports.

The couple did not post bail.

On Wednesday, the couple were given a discharge not amounting to an acquittal by the Sessions Court here.

In his decision, judge Ahmad Kamal Arifin Ismail said the prosecution had included two distinct offences in one charge, which is a duplicity.

The court then ordered the couple to be discharged but not acquitted.

The woman had posted a clip on Instagram showing bruises on her arms and finger as well as a caption saying that she was now dealing with trauma and phobia.

Meanwhile, in KUALA LUMPUR, two robbers were killed after police opened fire in self-defence.

City police chief Comm Datuk Mohd Shuhaily Mohd Zain, when met at the scene in Lorong Jintan 2, said police were

patrolling at 3.30am yesterday when they received information about some suspicious activities in the area.

"The team on duty went to investigate and found tools used to break into houses such as a machete.

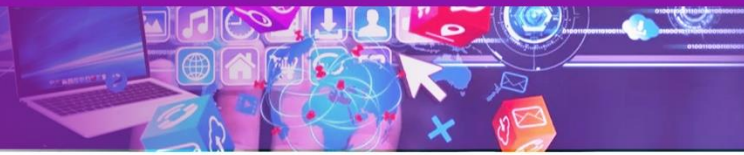
"In self-defence, they were forced to open fire at the robbers," he said.

School principal Ande Noor Munawara Bachok said Zee Hwe was the school's best SPM 2022 candidate.

She added that Zee Hwe, who was the school's former head prefect, is a good example of a student who can find a balance between her studies and co-curriculum activities.

"Besides achieving success in her studies, Zee Hwe is very active in school through our choir group.

She can play guitar and has a good singing voice," she added.

Ande Noor said 180 candidates sat for the 2022 SPM examination.

The school achieved 100% passing marks with 32 of them getting straight As.

"Their good results are a perfect parting gift for me as I will be retiring in August this year after 39 years in the education field," she added.

Johor Education Department said that a total of 1,129 SPM can-

didates in the state obtained A+, A and A- in all subjects taken.

The department's (school management sector) deputy director Anuar Sukiran said the results were the best in five years.

He said 20 SPM candidates obtained A+ for all subjects.

"The number of school candidates who registered in the state to sit for the SPM examination in 2022 was 42,795 candidates compared to 50,330 candidates in 2021.

"The national average grade

(GPN) of Johor in 2022 is 4.59, which is an increase of 0.16 points compared to 4.75 in 2021," he said.

He said the state's SPM GPN index also surpassed the national GPN achievement for nine consecutive years.

330,000 female students yet to receive HPV shots

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 336,592 Form 1 female students from the 2020 to 2022 cohort have not received any human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine shots, said Health Minister Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

She said the ministry is committed to ensuring that all students from the 2021, 2022 and 2023 groups receive the vaccine before they finish school.

“HPV vaccination for students had to be postponed in 2021 due to a global supply disruption of vaccines.

“By using the remaining stock of vaccines available in 2020, a total of 34,933 students have received the first dose.

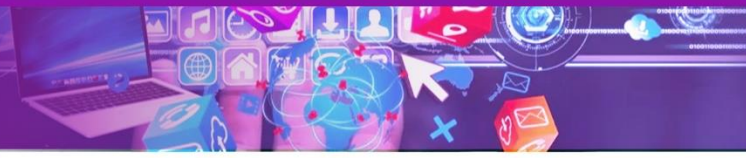
“This means that there are a total of 187,151 students who have not received the vaccine,” she said when replying to a question from Yeo Bee Yin (PH-Puchong) in the Dewan Rakyat yesterday.

Yeo had asked about the status of the vaccination for more than 500,000 girls who missed the injection as well as the procurement allocation of RM120 million this year.

Meanwhile, Zaliha said in 2022, the price of the vaccine increased six-fold and only 100,000 doses were procured in December last year, Bernama reported.

“We have distributed all the vaccines to the states to be given to the students who have yet to receive it and the ministry expects this new procurement will be finalised in the third quarter,” she added.

Zaliha said female students from 2021 who are currently in Form 3 would be given priority for the vaccination before being dispensed to those from 2022 and 2023, depending on the number of vaccines received.

NGO keen to promote 30% women directors quota

○ Organisation offers training programmes, MBA courses for gender group in rural areas to become business savvy

PETALING JAYA: Ensuring a composition of 30% women on the boards of publicly listed companies is very difficult as the boards are akin to a boys club, said Women's Institute of Management (WIM) chairman Datuk Dr Nellie S.L Tan-Wong, adding that there are a huge number of capable women who can be directors.

"A major issue is once a group of directors are comfortable with one woman, she is appointed to numerous other boards, thus denying other women a chance."

Tan said there have been announcements of retired senior military officers being appointed directors, and questioned what kind of knowledge they have on company and tax laws.

"It is important for those who are directors to understand their role and have the ability and knowledge to make snap decisions when issues crop up.

"Directors need to undergo training, which was once conducted by WIM. Several directors were unwilling to attend training sessions and some even sent their drivers to sit in for them but they were caught out."

Tan also said some even complained to the government, causing the training programme to be cancelled halfway.

On its history, she said WIM was set up in 1993 and is an NGO that does not receive any funding or grants from the government, except once in the 1990s, when it received some funds to help organise training programmes for women in rural areas.

When WIM was first set up, Tan said it organised a basic two-day entrepreneurship programme.

"We had an average of over 40 women turning up each time. Many of them were interested in doing business, so in the first part of the programme, we explained all the pitfalls involved and the commitment required.

"This served to help them understand that setting up a business requires a lot of hard work," she said.

Tan added that once they understood the fundamentals of doing business, those who remained then thought about how to set up a business.

"WIM is a voluntary organisation and those involved do not get any financial remuneration. WIM relies on fundraising to run the organisation. We have over 20 staff

and funds to pay them come from its activities.

"We took our time to construct a six-storey, RM10 million building on NGO-allocated land in Taman Tun Dr Ismail. WIM also built a hostel, which can accommodate over 80 people."

She said some of the rooms are used for those attending WIM courses while the others are rented out to single adults. The car park is another source of income, but the charges are low, at only RM4 per day.

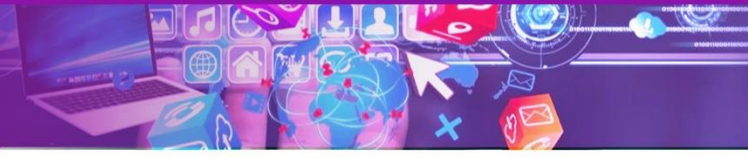
Tan also said WIM is the only NGO that runs a Masters in Business Administration (MBA) programme in collaboration with the University of East London in Barking, UK.

"The course started in 2000 when there was hardly anyone offering MBA courses. We took the risk although none of us in WIM had any background in running an educational institution. We believed it could be successful, but were heartbroken when only four students registered," she said.

Tan added that WIM persevered on its MBA course and now there are two graduations a year.

"WIM is also organising a two-day Millennials Summit in October with the keynote speaker being Tan Sri Andrew Sheng, who will talk about 'Re-thinking the NEP for the Knowledge-Based Economy'."

She said WIM has carried out 771 courses, which benefited 36,363 participants. The majority of the courses are free training in small businesses and basic ICT.

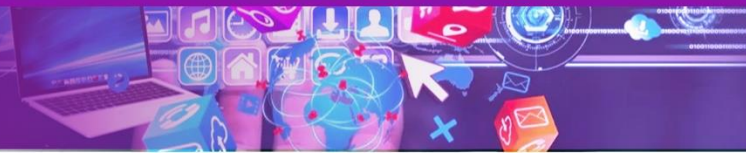

IPOH: A woman suffered losses amounting to RM132,860 when she tried to purchase a used car via an advertisement on Facebook on June 1.

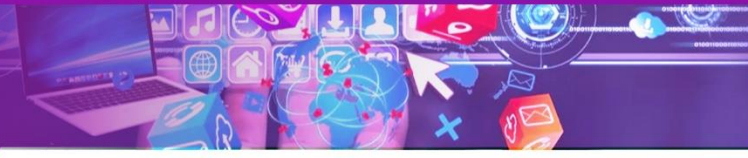

336,592 pelajar perempuan belum terima suntikan HPV: Dr Zaliha



KUALA LUMPUR: Seramai 336,592 pelajar perempuan Tingkatan 1 kohort 2020 hingga 2022 belum menerima sebarang suntikan vaksin HPV setakat ini, kata Menteri Kesihatan Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

Beliau berkata, Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) komited untuk memastikan kesemua murid perempuan bagi kohort 2021, 2022 dan 2023 ini menerima vaksin HPV sebelum mereka menamatkan persekolahan.

“Pada 2021, KKM tidak dapat membuat perolehan bekalan vaksin HPV ekoran gangguan bekalan vaksin di peringkat global yang telah

mengganggu pelaksanaan pemberian vaksin ini kepada pelajar Tingkatan 1 atau remaja yang berusia 13 tahun bermula 2021.

“Jadi dengan menggunakan baki stok vaksin yang ada pada 2020, seramai 34,933 orang iaitu hanya 15.7 peratus murid perempuan Tingkatan 1 kohort 2021 telah menerima dos vaksin pertama sahaja.

“Ini bermakna terdapat seramai 187,151 pelajar atau baki 84.3 peratus yang belum terima vaksin HPV untuk tahun kohort 2021,” katanya pada sesi Waktu Pertanyaan-Pertanyaan Menteri di Dewan Rakyat semalam.

Beliau menjawab pertanyaan Yeo Bee Yin (PH-Puchong) yang ingin mengetahui status terkini suntikan HPV untuk lebih daripada 500,000 kanak-kanak perempuan yang terlepas suntikan dari tahun 2020 hingga 2022 serta perolehan vaksin HPV

yang telah diperuntukkan RM120 juta untuk tahun 2023.

Sementara itu, Dr Zaliha berkata pada 2022, harga vaksin HPV telah meningkat sebanyak enam kali ganda dan hanya 100,000 dos vaksin HPV berjaya diperoleh pada Disember tahun lepas.

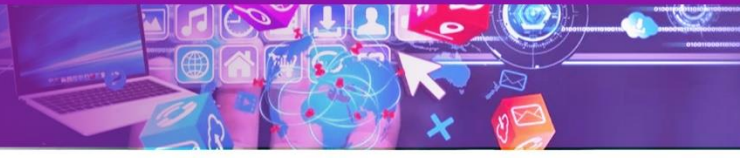

Dr Zaliha berkata, murid perempuan bagi kohort 2021 yang kini berada di Tingkatan 3 diberi keutamaan untuk pemberian vaksin HPV itu

sebelum diberikan kepada kohort 2022 dan 2023 bergantung kepada jumlah vaksin yang diterima tahun ini.

Mengenai keciciran pemberian vaksin rutin mengikut Program Imunisasi Kebangsaan kepada kanak-kanak semasa negara dilanda COVID-19 pada 2020 hingga 2022, Dr Zaliha berkata antara langkah yang diambil termasuk dengan menghubungi ibu bapa berdasarkan rekod yang ada di Klinik Kesihatan dan mengadakan lawatan ke rumah menerusi program ‘outreach’.

“Selain itu, kita juga mengadakan advokasi seperti pada Hari Imunisasi Kebangsaan yang diadakan setiap tahun untuk mengingatkan ibu bapa supaya anak-anak mereka mendapat imunisasi selain ‘engagement’ dengan beberapa pihak termasuk taska untuk memberi kesedaran,” katanya. — Bernama

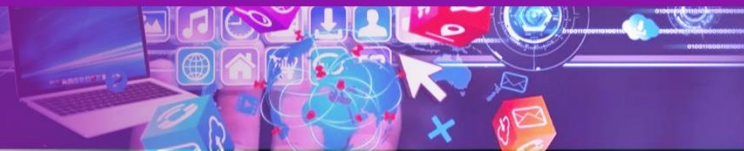
"Aspek pembangunan diri dan kemahiran interpersonal

KUCHING: Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Sarawak (JKNS) menyangkal dakwaan kekurangan pegawai perubatan untuk memberi suntikan vaksin rabies kepada seorang pesakit wanita warga emas semasa mendapatkan rawatan pada 3 Jun lepas.

Pengarah JKNS Dr Ooi Choo Huck berkata, pesakit tersebut mengadu tidak diberikan suntikan rabies ketika mendapatkan rawatan di Hospital Umum Sarawak (HUS) pada tarikh tersebut.

Menurut Dr Ooi, hasil siasatan mendapati wanita tersebut hadir ke Jabatan Kecemasan dan Trauma HUS pada tarikh tersebut, jam 10 pagi atas kecederaan gigitan anjing peliharaan sendiri.

Pesakit itu katanya, telah dirawat di Zon Hijau Jabatan Kecemasan dan Trauma oleh pegawai perubatan yang bertugas.

“Penilaian risiko ke atas beliau telah dijalankan dan mengesahkan ia sebagai berisiko rendah berdasarkan maklumat bahawa anjing tersebut adalah anjing

peliharaan beliau yang hanya berada di dalam kawasan rumah beliau yang berpagar serta tidak mempunyai gejala rabies.

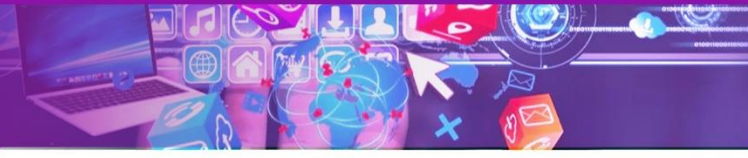
“Pengurusan kes gigitan anjing ini adalah selari dengan Sarawak Health Department, Dog/Animal Bite Management Guideline, GAJKNS-4/2023.

“Beliau juga telah diberikan janji temu ke perkhidmatan Klinik Gigitan Anjing pada 6 Jun 2023 untuk penilaian selanjutnya,” katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Dr Ooi turut menegaskan pesakit tersebut telah diberi perhatian dan rawatan sewajarnya sepanjang beliau berada di Jabatan Kecemasan dan Trauma HUS.

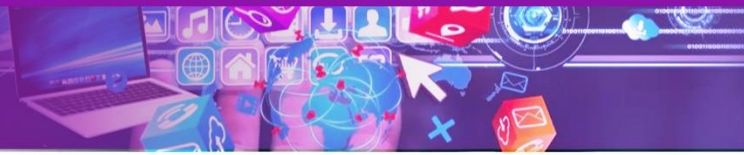

FRT dan EMRS ke lokasi kejadian,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

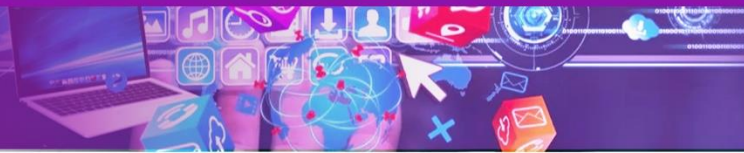
Menurutnya, kemalangan itu melibatkan sebuah kereta sedan yang terbabas ke dalam parit.

MIRI: Seorang wanita berusia 56 tahun maut manakala tiga lagi cedera dalam kemalangan melibatkan dua kenderaan di Jalan Lapangan Terbang Miri, awal pagi semalam.

Menurut jurucakap Pusat Gerakan Operasi (PGO) Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Sarawak, lapan anggota dari Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat Miri Sentral dikerahkan ke lokasi selepas menerima panggilan pada jam 2 pagi.

Dalam nahas melibatkan sebuah kereta dan sebuah kenderaan jenis pikap itu katanya, mangsa dikenali sebagai Lua Ukam disahkan meninggal dunia di tempat kejadian oleh petugas kesihatan dari Hospital Miri.

"Sebuah kereta itu dinaiki tiga mangsa dan terdapat seorang mangsa tersepit di bahagian tempat duduk belakang, manakala dua orang lagi masing-masing lelaki berusia 23 tahun dan wanita berusia 20 tahun cedera,"katanya dalam satu kenyataan.

Susulan itu, pasukan bomba menjalankan operasi dan berjaya mengeluarkan mangsa yang tersepit.

"Mangsa kemudian diserahkan kepada pihak polis untuk tindakan selanjutnya,"ujarnya.
