'EFS: Tedious process why some parents haven't applied'

KUCHING: Only 64 per cent of 19,375 Sarawakian births, or those with 'K' status, recorded from Jan 1-July 31 this year have been submitted for Endowment Fund Sarawak (EFS) application, said Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

The Minister of Women, Children and Community Wellbeing Development said among the reasons for this was that some parents found the application process to be very tedious.

"I have come across parents who applied for 'Bantuan Ibu Bersalin' (post-natal assistance) but are not interested in applying for the Endowment Fund Sarawak.

"Because of that, we will do more intervention such as outreach programmes where we go to the ground together with other agencies or during big government events," she told reporters after chairing the second EFS Committee meeting for 2023 here yesterday.

Fatimah said that EFS is one of the Sarawak government's initiatives, with a grant of RM1,000 in the form of trust savings for every birth of a Sarawakian child.

According to her, this initiative started in 2019 and is given regardless of race, religion and socioeconomic status as long as

the child has 'K' status.

She pointed out that the trust saving, which could grow to more than RM2,000 once the child reaches 18 years old, aims to help Sarawak's children to prepare for further studies, start a career or used as capital to start a small business.

To enable more Anak Sarawak

to be registered for EFS, she said her ministry is preparing a five-year review of the EFS to be presented to the Cabinet.

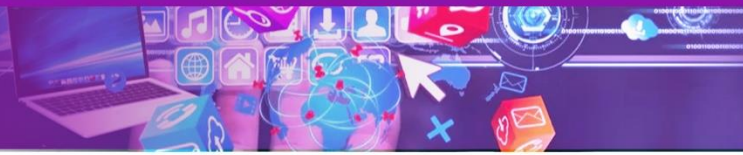
"The review will include suggestions to ensure the aim to provide EFS for all Anak Sarawak is achieved," she said.

Fatimah also touched on the dropping birth rates in Sarawak, saying that among the reasons found were due to decisions made by a couple following the rise in cost of living.

"Another reason for lower birth rates is the later age of marriages, as well as those who have decided not to have many children," she said.

Meanwhile, a press kit distributed by her ministry revealed a total 100,202 EFS accounts have been opened since 2019 to July 31 this year, involving an allocation of RM100.2 million.

It also stated automatic application of EFS is being mullied as a way forward by the ministry, of which further announcements will be made after approval is obtained by the Cabinet.

500 join walk to raise awareness of sexual harassment in Putrajaya

PUTRAJAYA: About 500 participants, including individuals with disabilities (PwD), joined a three-kilometre 'fun walk' in Putrajaya yesterday to raise awareness against sexual harassment.

The 'Langkah Kasih Merdeka KPWKM@Advokasi Anti Gangguan Seksual' programme saw participants walk from the Ministry of Women, Family, and Community Development (KPWKM) to the Palace of Justice, carrying anti-sexual harassment notices and handing them out to the various ministries and premises along the route.

Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said the notices were presented to the Ministry of Communications and Digital, the Ministry of Local Government Development, and the Attorney General's Department, among others.

"The notices should be prominently displayed within the buildings of the relevant ministries and agencies, serving as a symbol of solidarity and unity in addressing matters of sexual harassment," she told reporters after officiating the programme.

Nancy hoped that the 'fun walk' programme held in conjunction with National Month 2023 would help create a safe environment, in line with the principles of well-being, one of the pillars of Malaysia Madani.

The Malaysia Madani concept launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim on

Jan 19 is based on six core values, namely Sustainability, Prosperity, Innovation, Respect, Trust, and Compassion.

Nancy said with regard to sexual harassment reports lodged, there were still victims, especially men, who opted not to report the incidents to authorities and remain silent, noting that there were 506 recorded cases of sexual harassment so far.

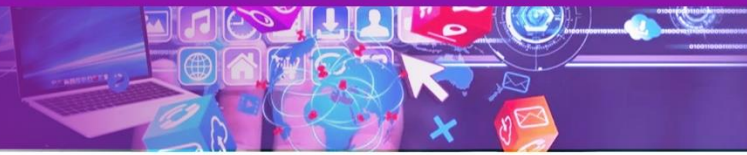
"If it occurs, please report it (if you are a victim). That's the reason we're organising awareness-raising advocacy programmes, so that our society can get to know what is meant by sexual harassment," she added.

Meanwhile, Taska Anak Istimewa Sindrom Down (Taska ANISD) supervisor Siti Nurul Aina Mohd Naim said the 'fun walk' event organised by KPWKM offered a chance to her and the special needs children to engage with ministry personnel and other participants involved in the activity.

"This is my first time participating. Another fellow educator and I brought four special needs pupils, aged four, from Taska ANISD to participate. Alhamdulillah, they are happy to join, even though it's their first time being part of a programme with so many people," she said.

KPWKM legal advisor Sharifah Nur Amirah Syed Ahmad Yunus said such activities not only strengthened the relationships among KPWKM members but also provided them with an opportunity to interact and be friendly with the target group.

"Activities like this should be held regularly, because they not only instill patriotic spirit but also raise awareness among the community about sexual harassment, especially at the workplace," she said, adding that a workplace free from sexual harassment allowed employees to work comfortably and safely. — Bernama

Lumpur; PPR Taman Putra Damai in Lembah Subang, Selangor; as well as PPR Taman Cendana in Pasir Gudang, Johor.

Additionally, it will extend support to the residents by organising community clean-ups or gotong-royong activities aimed

at eliminating mosquito breeding sites in the neighbourhood.

Commenting on this collaboration, JKM acknowledges

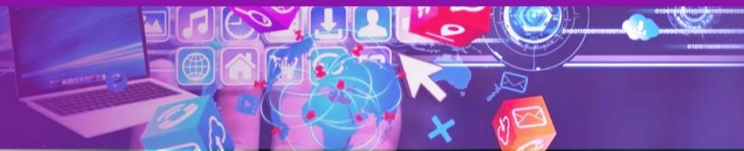

KUANTAN: A woman lost RM118,767 after being duped by a scam syndicate that offered high-paying part-time jobs online.

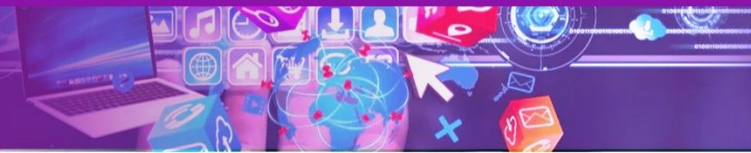

KAJANG: A businessman has been charged in the Magistrate's Court here with the murder of his 38-year-old wife last month.

Mohamed Imran Mohamed Yunos, 32, only nodded when the charge was read to him in front of Magistrate Syahrul Sazly Md Sain. However, no plea was recorded as murder cases are under the purview of the High Court.

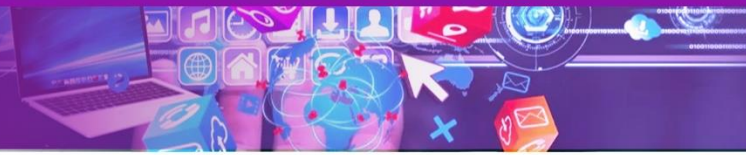
According to the charge sheet, the accused had allegedly murdered Azween Noor Alias, in a unit of Sutera Pines Apartments, Jalan Sutera Pines here, between 8pm and 10.30pm, on July 22.

Syahrul Sazly fixed Sept 13 for the submission of documents related to the case.

Bernama previously reported that a woman, believed to have been beaten, died while seeking treatment at a private hospital in Kajang.

Police received a report regarding the victim's death from a nurse at the hospital after seeing that the woman was unconscious with bruises and injuries all over her body.

Charged with raping a 13-year-old girl

IPOH: A jobless man has claimed trial at the Sessions Court here to raping a 13-year-old girl.

Fazaikal Hakimi Mustafa, 21, pleaded not guilty before judge Ainul Shahrin Mohamad to raping the teenager at a house in

Taman Impiana Adril in Menglembu between midnight and 4am in July.

He is charged under Section 376(1) of the Penal Code and faces up to 20 years' imprisonment and a whipping, if convicted.

Deputy public prosecutor Evangelin Simon Silvaraj requested for no bail to be set due to

the seriousness of the case.

Lawyer Mohamad Salihen Mastor, who represented the accused, requested a lower bail as his client is not working.

"He is currently staying with his mother and two other siblings.

"Although he is not working, Faizaikal is helping his mother

take care of his elderly grandfather.

"His mother is working as a teacher at a religious centre and she has offered to ensure her son's attendance throughout the trial," he added.

Ainul Shahrin set bail at RM4,000 with one surety. She also fixed Sept 7 for mention.

Cop's unity message to pupils wins praise

Clip of officer's meaningful talk goes viral

PETALING JAYA: A policeman's act of spreading a message on multiracial unity to primary school pupils has received the thumbs up of Malaysians.

Netizens who saw a viral video of the policeman giving a talk at the SK Kangkar Pulai 2 in Johor were full of praise for his delivery, which was meaningful yet presented in a humorous way so that the children could enjoy themselves.

The policeman had the kids in stitches as he moved around in an exaggerated manner and spoke

animatedly to inject humour and heighten his overall message, which was that they should never refer to each other using racial terms or fight with each other.

"Uncle doesn't want to hear nonsensical words being used. For example, don't call out 'Woi India, woi India'. Can you understand?" he said to the pupils, who answered in the affirmative.

He also made them promise to love each other.

"Uncle doesn't want to hear of fights among races. Can you all promise, uncle, that all of you will learn to love?" he said during the talk which took place on Aug 2.

The policeman then asked the children to reach out and touch their friends' shoulders while proclaiming, "Saya sayang awak" (I love you).

A 55-second video put up on TikTok by user azmilcombat capturing the policeman's short but sweet message has since garnered over 84,000 likes and over 2,000 comments as of Tuesday.

TikTok user Banu commented, "This is the right time to teach them. Then they will follow. Thank you very much. We are one Malaysia."

FIZA commented, "Well, we don't need politicians to cultivate the feeling of love amongst Malay-

Rare 'stroke' disease risk to teens, adults

○ Melas disorder has prevalence of one in 4,000 individuals worldwide, says Kuala Lumpur Hospital neurologist

KUALA LUMPUR: Alia, 15, (not her real name) was rushed to the Kuala Lumpur Hospital emergency unit after suffering stroke-like episodes with sudden muscle weakness on the right side of her body.

A computed tomography scan showed evidence of a stroke in her left brain. Subsequently, a special test confirmed that she had developed mitochondrial encephalomyopathy, lactic acidosis and stroke-like episodes (Melas).

Kuala Lumpur Hospital

neurologist Dr Ahmad Shahir Mawardi said Alia was then referred to a rehabilitation physician for additional treatment, including physiotherapy and physical therapy.

"Several months later, she showed positive development, regained muscle strength and could walk again."

Ahmad said Melas is a rare disease that affects the nervous system and muscles, adding that less than 20 cases were related to the genetic condition, Bernama reported.

He also said patients range from teenagers to adults in their early 40s and the disorder has an estimated prevalence of one in 4,000 individuals worldwide, with an equal probability of affecting males and females.

"A patient could develop it as early as 10 years old and the onset typically presents as recurrent attacks of epileptic seizures, stroke episodes or stroke involving sudden neurological symptoms.

"The episodes could weaken half of the body and affect their vision, intellectual function and ability to speak.

"Disturbance to mental health and cognitive functions could occur. Patients may also experience heart problems, diabetes and chronic fatigue."

Meanwhile, Malaysian Rare

Disorders Society president Nadiah Hanim Abdul Latif said user generated content and the internet have provided a venue for quick and broad dissemination of information, not all of which were accurate or reliable.

"Sensationalism is still prevalent in false and misleading content to gain public sympathy without providing real facts or being supported by strong evidence.

"We often hear of very costly rare disease treatments that could run up to thousands of ringgit. This negative perception must be corrected."

She said the majority of rare diseases do not require costly treatment as no "orphan drugs" were available or approved to treat certain conditions.

An "orphan drug" is classified as

a medication that is not developed or marketed because of its extremely limited use.

Nadiah Hanim expressed hope that the government would continue to support the rare disorder community, adding that public empathy could go a long way.

"This includes policy formulation, increasing annual aid for patients, law amendments to make the Persons with Disabilities Act 2008 more comprehensive, strengthening the empowerment network, providing equitable job opportunities and access to support, including for health and social care.

"We hope to (raise public awareness) that Melas is not a communicable disease. It would not have any effect on the physical health of others."

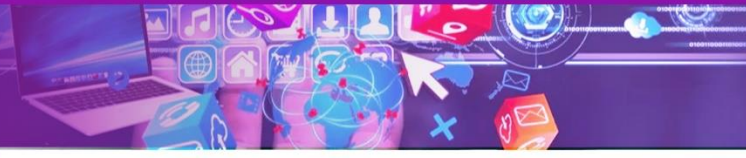

Sebab itu kita adakan program advokasi untuk memberi kesedaran supaya masyarakat kita mula mengenali apa yang dimaksudkan dengan gangguan seksual," katanya.

Sementara itu, Penyelia Taska Anak Istimewa Sindrom Down Siti Nurul Aina Mohd Naim berkata aktiviti fun walk anjuran KPWKM itu memberi peluang kepadanya dan kanak-kanak OKU untuk bergaul dengan warga kementerian dan peserta aktiviti terbabit.

"Ini kali pertama saya

terlibat, saya bersama seorang lagi rakan tenaga pengajar bawa empat pelajar OKU dari taska yang berusia empat tahun untuk turut serta. Alhamdulillah, anak-anak ini gembira dapat sertai walaupun kali pertama menyertai bersama ramai orang," katanya.

Penasihat Undang-undang KPWKM Sharifah Nur Amirah Syed Ahmad Yunus, 30, berkata aktiviti seumpama itu bukan sahaja dapat mengeratkan hubungan antara warga KPWKM malah

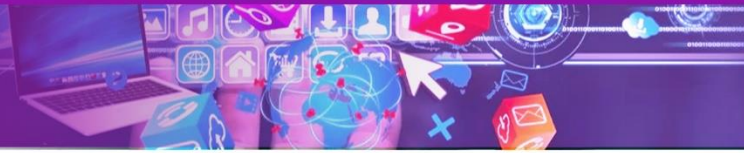
Kes dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nurul Husna Amran manakala peguam P. Gunalan mewakili tertuduh.

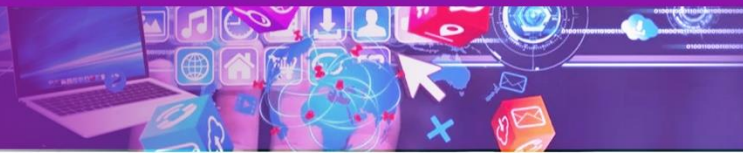

Kelvin berkata Uthayakumar juga mengalami masalah sakit urat, selain mempunyai tiga anak dan dalam proses perceraian sementara penjamin iaitu ibunya hanya mempunyai RM3,000.

Bagaimanapun, Hakim Ainul Shahrin Mohamad membenarkan masing-masing diikat jamin RM6,000 dengan seorang penjamin dan menetapkan 2 Okt untuk sebutan kes.

Pada 3 Ogos, media melaporkan rayuan sayu seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia empat tahun di sebuah jeriji berkunci rumahnya untuk meminta makanan daripada orang ramai, membongkar kisahnya menjadi mangsa dera ibu dan teman lelaki wanita itu.

Kanak-kanak yang ditinggalkan bersendirian dan dipenuhi kesan luka seluruh badan itu, kemudian diselamatkan polis, selepas menerima laporan daripada orang awam. — Bernama

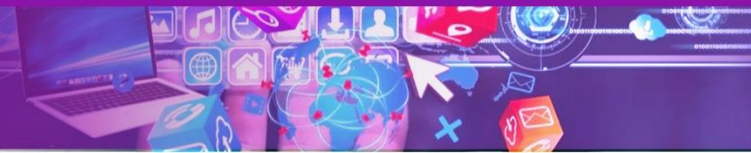

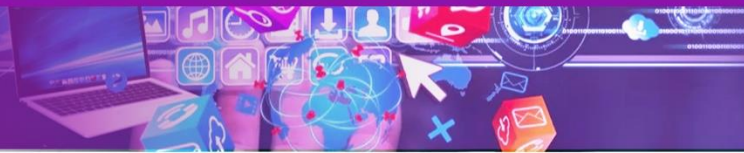

“Mangsa yang menghubungi suspek kemudian ditawarkan pula tugas melakukan tangkap layar barangan di pautan diberikan dengan dijanjikan keuntungan bagi setiap tangkap layar dibuat,” katanya menerusi kenyataan di sini semalam.

Yahaya berkata mangsa yang bekerja di sebuah institusi pendidikan di sini, tertarik dengan “kerja” itu kerana telah menerima upah RM47 selepas menyelesaikan dua tugas, menyebabkan dia

terus menghubungi suspek untuk mendapatkan tugas selanjutnya.

Suspek didakwa mengarahkan mangsa untuk membuat bayaran terlebih dahulu, dengan dia akhirnya membuat 20 transaksi pemindahan wang ke 11 akaun yang diberikan.

“Mangsa yang menggunakan wang simpanan bagi membuat bayaran itu turut meminjam daripada bank dan rakan sebelum menyedari dirinya telah ditipu apabila menyedari jumlah wang yang telah dikeluarkannya,” katanya.

Yahaya berkata mangsa

membuat laporan di Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Kuantan petang kelmarin.

Beliau juga menasihati orang ramai agar tidak mudah terperdaya dengan tawaran kerja melalui media sosial terutamanya yang menawarkan gaji lumayan bagi kerja mudah serta membuat semakan latar belakang syarikat terlibat.

Orang awam juga dinasihatkan membuat semakan nombor akaun diterima menerusi <https://semakmule.rmp.gov.my/> sebelum membuat transaksi pemindahan wang bagi mengelakkan ditipu. — Bernama
