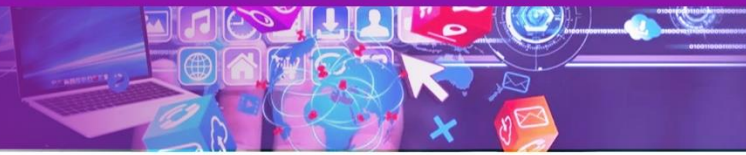

"Reman mereka sudah tamat dan kita sudah melengkapkan siasatan, namun suspek termasuk seorang warga Indonesia dan seorang pemastautin tetap belum lagi dapat dituduh di mahkamah sebab mereka dikehendaki di beberapa negeri lain atas jenayah sama.

"Polis percaya kumpulan ini aktif melakukan jenayah penipuan sejak dari awal tahun ini. Di Perlis sahaja, terdapat dua laporan polis dibuat berhubung penipuan yang dilakukan.

"Suspek menggunakan modus operandi memujuk sebelum memperdaya mangsa dengan menawarkan khidmat pemulihan kesihatan kepada mangsa. Kerugian bagi kedua-dua kes berkenaan dianggarkan sekitar RM24,000," katanya ketika dihubungi semalam.

Katanya, berdasarkan semakan pihaknya juga mendapati dua suspek, termasuk seorang pemastautin tetap negara ini mempunyai rekod jenayah lampau.

"Suspek warga tempatan berusia 56 tahun didapati mempunyai rekod jenayah membabitkan pecah rumah, samun dan cabul. 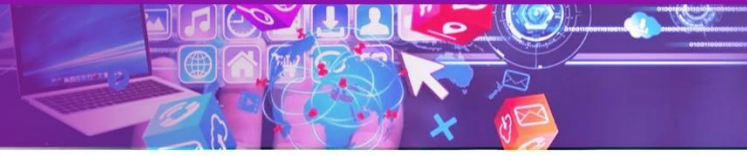

## 20 pelajar minum 'air campur' keracunan metanol

Beliau berkata, daripada kumpulan yang bergejala itu, kesihatan dua pelajar semakin merosot dan masing-masing telah dihantar ke Unit

Rawatan Rapi (ICU) Hospital Queen Elizabeth (HQE) dan ICU Hospital Queen Elizabeth 2 (HQE 2) untuk rawatan lanjut, semalam.

"Daripada kes bergelaja, sebanyak lima kes lagi telah dihantar ke HQE untuk rawatan lanjut dan satu kes masih dirawat di Hospital Pitas. Siasatan awal mendapati mangsa mengambil minuman itu pada pukul 2.30 petang, Selasa lalu," katanya menerusi satu kenyataan di sini, kelmarin.

Katanya, semua kes telah mendapat rawatan awal di Hospital Pitas.

Pitas, sebuah daerah di uta-

ra Sabah, terletak kira-kira 175 kilometer dari sini.

Dr Asits berkata, 12 pelajar yang tidak bergejala itu telah dimasukkan ke wad di Hospital Pitas untuk pemantauan dan rawatan seterusnya.

Beliau berkata, sampel berkaitan telah diambil untuk pengesahan kehadiran metanol termasuk darah, urin, serta sampel 'spirit', dan siasatan lanjut sedang dijalankan bagi mengetahui punca sebenar kejadian.

"Jabatan Kesihatan Negeri Sabah sentiasa memantau keadaan mangsa dan bekerjasama dengan sekolah serta Jabatan Pendidikan Ne-

geri Sabah juga Pejabat Pendidikan Daerah Pitas bagi menjalankan siasatan lanjut, selain mengambil langkah mengelakkan kejadian ini berulang," katanya.

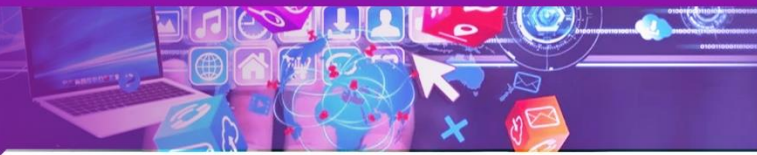
Katanya, seseorang yang keracunan metanol mungkin tidak menunjukkan apa-apa gejala untuk tempoh satu hingga 72 jam selepas pengambilan.

"Gejala akan wujud dengan lebih cepat jika metanol diminum dalam kuantiti banyak dan adalah lebih lambat jika diminum dalam kuantiti yang sedikit atau diminum bersama etanol. Keracunan metanol juga boleh disebabkan oleh penyalahgunaan metanol sebagai bahan pembuat minuman keras," katanya.

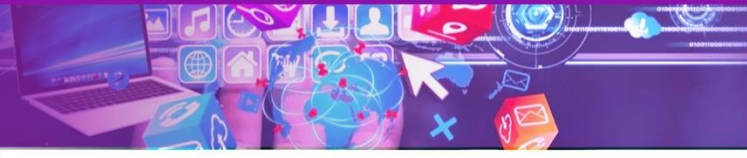

## Malaysian 'Mother Teresa' passes away at 97

**PETALING JAYA:** Malaysia's "Mother Teresa", Datin Paduka A. Mangalam S. Iyaswasmy (*pic*), has passed away. She was 97.

Mangalam, who was a well-known figure in the humanitarian field, was the life president of the Pure Life Society (PLS), which was founded in 1949.

She had an illustrious career in the field; Mangalam was a recipient of the Merdeka Award in 2010 for education and community,

Malaysia Inter-Religious Organisation vice president, and a member of the National Advisory Council for the Integration of Women in Development.

Pure Life Society vice-president Datuk VL Kandan said in a statement that Mangalam had fallen ill after celebrating her 97th birthday on May 20.

"It was a very happy occasion for her, after which she fell ill with pneumonia and received the best

medical attention possible in Assunta Hospital.

"However, complications set in. We have lost someone who personified the Pure Life Society throughout its 72 years of existence. She passed away peacefully at 3.52pm on Saturday," he said.

Kandan said the funeral would be held tomorrow.

"Those who wish to pay their last respects can do so today, from 10am at the PLS Multipurpose

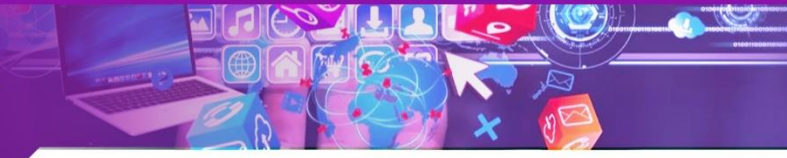
Hall," he said.

# Mum anxious over daughter's whereabouts

**KULAI:** The mother of a 22-year-old Malaysian woman who was reported missing in Mae Sai district in Chiang Rai province, Thailand, believes that despite her assurances, her daughter had been duped into going there.

Chee Choy Won, 50, said she was still concerned for Chong Sum Yee, the younger of two siblings, who travelled to Thailand on May 29 without informing anyone.

"My daughter contacted me on Friday night through a WhatsApp call. She told me to take back the police report I had lodged after she went missing, telling me that she is fine over there.

"It was only a few minutes' call, but when I asked why she went to Thailand and who she is with, she kept telling me she is safe before hanging up.

"As a mother, I know she is not in a good place and I am worried about her safety," she told a press conference organised by Johor DAP education politics director Alan Tee Boon Tsong here yesterday.

Chee added that she and her son went to Thailand on June 6 to follow up on the Thai police's search for Sum Yee.

"They told me that they were not ruling out the possibility of her having crossed the border into Myanmar," she said, adding that her daughter was supposed to return to Malaysia on June 7.

Sum Yee's older brother Jeng Wei, 23, questioned several videos of his sister that have been uploaded on social media saying she was safe and healthy.

"I know my sister very well. That does not sound like her and she looks very stressed," he said, adding that as far as the family knows, Sum Yee has no working issues, financial problems or issues with the family.

Jeng Wei said until now, the family has no clue as to why Sum Yee, who has been working as a beautician for the past five years in Kuala Lumpur, decided to go to Thailand.

"Please come back home, our mother is worried about you. She hardly sleeps or eats since you went missing," he added.

It was reported that Sum Yee flew to Chiang Mai on May 29

and travelled about 250km to the northernmost district of Mae Sai in Chiang Rai province in northern Thailand.

The place is close to the neighbouring town of Tachilek in Myanmar, where human trafficking incidents have been reported.

The videos of Sum Yee were posted by a Facebook user named 'Moe Aye' in the comment section of a post made by Chee.

In two of the videos, the young woman repeatedly says she is safe and healthy.

She also pleads with the police to stop bothering the driver who sent her there as he supposedly knew nothing about her situation.

In a 23-second video, the woman clad in dark-coloured shirt says: "Hello. I am currently working here and I am safe. Do not worry about me."

In another 33-second video, the young woman repeats she is fine, healthy and had not been beaten.

Earlier, Thai police said initial investigations found Sum Yee had crossed the border into Tachilek, Myanmar, on May 30.

## Retiree falls prey to phone scam, loses RM1.2mil

**KUCHING:** A private sector retiree has lodged a police report claiming that he suffered losses of RM1.2mil in a phone scam in April.

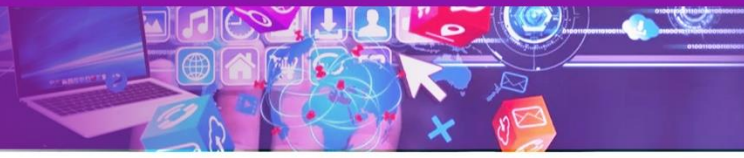
Sarawak police commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri said the 66-year-old man from Miri district claimed to have received a phone call from the suspect on April 18, saying the victim was involved in a money laundering case.

He said the suspect then asked the victim to open two new bank accounts to facilitate the investigation, Bernama reported.

"The victim opened a new bank account at two local financial institutions on April 19 and 20 before giving the banking information and password to the suspect.

"The suspect then instructed the victim to transfer money amounting to RM1.2mil through four transactions, from his AmBank and Employee Provident Fund (EPF) accounts, to the two newly-opened bank accounts," he said in a statement yesterday.

Mohd Azman said the victim only realised he had been cheated after checking the balance in his two new bank accounts and found that the money had been transferred to an unknown account in stages from April 19 to May 3.

# Threats intensify to kidnapping

## Moneylenders warn businessman they may abduct his children, niece

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A businessman is worried about his family's safety after loan sharks threatened to kidnap his children.

The man who only wished to be identified as Choong, 42, from Cheras, said his younger brother had taken about 13 loans amounting to RM83,000 from illegal moneylenders.

"He took the loans in May but this month they began harassing

him and me to start paying off the debt.

"They even threatened to kidnap my two children aged nine and 12 as well as his two-year-old daughter," he told the MCA Public Services and Complaints Department on Friday.

He said the moneylenders also edited pictures of his younger brother and wife and placed it on a hearse as a threat.

"This is the first time that he has borrowed money from a loan shark and now we are all worried

for our safety.

"My brother also reported the case to the police at Hulu Selangor on June 6," he said, asking for help on the matter.

Meanwhile, an accountant who only wanted to be known as Huang, from Petaling Jaya, said her estranged husband had left her and her family members facing harassment from moneylenders.

"My husband is 45 years old and works as an air-conditioning service technician.

"He moved out of the house in January this year as we are in the midst of a divorce," she said, adding that she had no idea why her husband needed to seek out a moneylender to take out loans in the first place.

She said they managed to settle her husband's loans two years ago, but her cousin and father-in-law have been receiving threatening calls from the moneylender since last month.

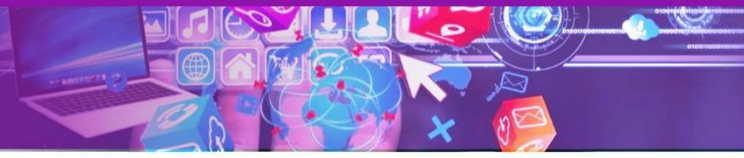
"My cousin was told that he is the guarantor for the borrower,

but he never stood as guarantor before.

"I also have received calls from the moneylender demanding that I pay another RM4,300 in order to settle the matter," she said.

When contacted, department head Datuk Seri Michael Chong said these illegal moneylenders were a menace to society.

"They should seek out the borrower instead of harassing and threatening their family members who have nothing to do with the issue," he said.

The rest of the victims only received outpatient treatment,



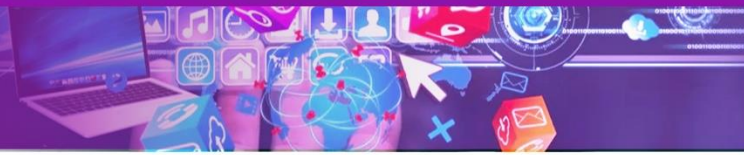
**Deadly damage:** A vehicle lying pinned under a motorcycle and a fallen tree in George Town after the night storm.

# Miri retiree loses RM1.2 million in phone scam

**KUCHING:** A 66-year-old retiree from Miri suffered a loss of RM1.2 million to a phone scam recently.

Sarawak Police Commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri said the victim received a phone call from an unknown man who introduced himself as someone from the Health Ministry on April 18.

The phone call was then connected to two individuals claiming to be police officers, 'Sgt Wong' and 'Insp Khoo' from Kota Kinabalu, Sabah, he added.

"The suspects then told the victim he was involved in an illegal money changing case and arrests will be made. The victim denied the allegation and requested he remain in Miri while the investigation was being conducted, as he is suffering from bowel cancer.

"The suspects then asked the victim to provide details on his banking information and finances before being ordered to open two new bank accounts to facilitate the purported investigation," he said in a statement yesterday.

Mohd Azman said the victim opened the bank accounts in two banks in Miri on April 19 and April 20 before providing the information, as well as the online banking IDs and passwords to the suspects.

After that, the victim was instructed to transfer a sum of RM1.2 million through four transactions to the new accounts.

"The victim only realised he had been deceived after checking the balance in both of the new bank accounts on June 8 and found that the RM1.2 million had been transferred to an unknown account between April 19 and May 3.

"He then lodged a police

report for further investigation by the police," he said. Mohd Azman advised the public not to entertain unknown phone calls and to immediately notify their partners, friends or family members of the phone calls received and to check with the police station, banks or related agencies for confirmation.

report for further investigation by the police," he said.

Mohd Azman advised the public not to entertain unknown phone calls and to immediately notify their partners, friends or family members of the phone calls received and to check with the police station, banks or related agencies for confirmation.

The public is also advised not to provide their banking information to any unknown individuals or parties and to refrain from registering the suspects' given phone numbers in their online banking.

He said members of the public should not be afraid or panic about any allegations made against them by the suspects.

"Contact the National Scam Response Centre at 997 if you are a victim of cyberscams (phone scam, love scam, e-

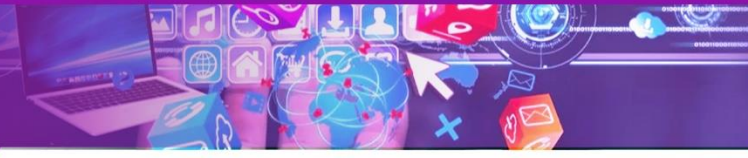
commerce, non-existent loans) and if you've just made a money transfer to any of the suspects' bank accounts or e-wallets.

"It is also recommended to download the Whoscall app via the Google Play Store or Apple Store to enable you to make a decision on whether to answer the phone calls. The collaboration between the police and app developers enables the numbers listed in the Semak Mule System database to be marked as scammers by the app.

"In addition, the public can also scan the Scan Me QR Code on the Commercial Crime Investigation Department's (CCID) social media accounts and commercial crime e-books to get the latest information on commercial crime modus operandi," he said.

The public can contact the CCID Infoline at 013-211 1222 via WhatsApp or SMS to receive advice or provide information on online criminal cases, or check suspected phone numbers and bank accounts through the Check Scammers CCID app or via <http://semakmule.rmp.gov.my> before making any transactions.

# Mother of missing Malaysian in Thailand doesn't believe FB videos saying she's safe

**KULAI:** The mother of Chong Sum Yee, 22, who was reported missing in Chiang Mai, Thailand, does not believe the viral videos of her daughter claiming she is 'safe and healthy'.

Chee Choy Won said this was because the videos were uploaded by a new Facebook account named 'Moe Aye'.

The 50-year-old woman said Sum Yee was also difficult to get in touch with and had been avoiding questions about her whereabouts.

Chee said she managed to contact Sum Yee at 8pm last night via WhatsApp, and her daughter wanted her to withdraw the police report.

"We talked for a few minutes last night, Sum Yee said she was safe and asked us not to look for her and to withdraw the police report but she was talking quite fast, like in a hurry.

"Every time I asked her where she was, she didn't answer and repeatedly said she was safe. I'm not sure what happened, but (I believe) there is a possibility

that she has become a victim of human trafficking or a scam," she told a press conference at the Johor DAP headquarters here yesterday.

The mother of two said she flew to Thailand with her son Chong Jeng Wei, 23, and Johor DAP Political Education director Alan Tee Boon Tsong on June 6 for four days.

However, Chee said the Thai police informed them that there was a possibility that her daughter was in Myanmar, therefore, the Thai and Myanmar police are working together to trace Sum Yee who was supposed to return to Malaysia on June 7.

Meanwhile, Jeng Wei said he was worried when his younger sister, who works as a beautician in Kuala Lumpur, told him that she wanted to go to Thailand alone because she had never travelled abroad alone.

He said they were getting more worried when Sum Yee said it was for work, which had been denied by the employer.

The three videos were posted by an unknown Facebook user named 'Moe Aye' in the comment section of a post made by her mother.

In two of the videos, the long-haired woman repeatedly says she is safe and healthy. She also pleads the police to stop bothering the driver who sent her there as he supposedly knew nothing about her situation.

It was reported that Sum Yee flew to Chiang Mai on May 29 and travelled about 250 km to the northernmost district of Mae Sai in Chiang Rai province in northern Thailand.

The place is close to the neighbouring town of Tachilek in Myanmar, where incidences of human trafficking have been reported.

The Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) is also reported to be working with the Thai police to track down the missing woman and based on preliminary investigations, she had crossed the border into Tachilek on May 30. — Bernama

## Rosey: Registration for endowment fund, postnatal aid still low

**MIRI:** Registration for the one-off RM1,000 Endowment Fund Sarawak (EFS) and RM450 Postnatal Assistance (BIB) is still relatively low when compared to the number of child births recorded in the state this year, says Datuk Rosey Yunus.

The Deputy Minister for Women, Childhood and Community Development said this could be due to ignorance regarding EFS and BIB, as well as some parents' decision not to register for the aid.

"As of May 2023, there are a total of 11,430 registrations of babies with the 'K' status throughout Sarawak. However, out of this figure, only 7,245 or 65 per cent have registered their babies for EFS.

"Meanwhile, out of 7,245 registrations, a total of 5,068 had their applications approved, including those who had registered the previous year," she said during a symbolic EFS and BIB presentation at Miri Hospital Friday.

Rosey said in Miri for example, 1,535 births with the 'K' status were recorded as of May 15, but only 1,113 EFS applications had been received.

As for BIB applications, Rosey said as of May 15 this year, 9,765 mothers with the 'K' status had given birth in Sarawak.

"Out of this figure, a total of 6,853 mothers or 70 per cent had registered for the BIB both through online and

manual applications.

"And out of these 6,853 registrations, a total of 5,520 applications had been approved and payment has also been made," she revealed.

She urged all eligible parents to register for the EFS as well as the BIB as these are part of the state government's efforts to assist them.

"Although there are some parents who does not want to register for this aid, I do hope that in the future, every mother will register their babies for the EFS as well as to apply for themselves the BIB.

"This is for everyone irrespective of race, religion, and political affiliation.

As long as one parent is Sarawakian, the baby and mother are both eligible for the EFS and BIB," she said.

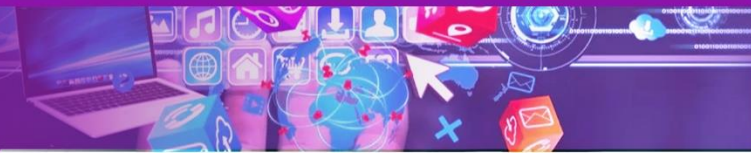
Rosey added that from 2019 when EFS was first introduced until May 15 this year, a total of 91,163 EFS accounts had been opened involving an allocation amounting RM91.16 million.

As for BIB, a total of 47,928 mothers had benefited from the assistance from January 2020 until May 15 this year involving an allocation of RM21.5 million.

Among those present at the function were the ministry's permanent secretary Noriah Ahmad and Miri Hospital director Dr Jack Wong.

## 'Phone scam': Warga emas rugi RM1.2 juta

**KUCHING:** Seorang warga emas rugi RM1.2 juta selepas menjadi mangsa penipuan melalui 'phone scam' yang menyamar menjadi kakitangan Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) dan Polis Diraja Malaysia, kelmarin.

Pesuruhjaya Polis Sarawak Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri berkata, mangsa berumur 66 tahun itu merupakan seorang pesara sebuah syarikat swasta di daerah Miri.

Menurutnya, mangsa telah menerima panggilan telefon daripada seorang lelaki tidak dikenali yang mendakwa dari KKM pada 18 April sebelum panggilan disambung kepada suspek yang mengaku sebagai 'Sarjan Wong' dan 'Inspektor Khoo' dari Kota Kinabalu, Sabah.

"Suspek kemudian mengatakan mangsa terlibat dengan kes pengubahan wang haram dan tangkapan akan dibuat ke atas mangsa.

"Mangsa menafikan dakwaan tersebut dan memohon agar dirinya tetap berada di bandar raya Miri, Sarawak semasa siasatan dijalankan kerana menghidap kanser usus," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Susulan itu, Azman berkata, suspek meminta mangsa memberikan maklumat perbankan dan butiran kewangan milik mangsa sebelum suspek mengarahkan mangsa membuka dua akaun bank baharu bagi memudahkan siasatan.

"Mangsa bagaimanapun telah membuka dua akaun bank baharu di dua institusi kewangan tempatan di Miri pada 19 dan 20 April.

"Selepas itu, mangsa telah memberikan maklumat baharu serta ID dan kata laluan perbankan atas talian kepada suspek," jelasnya.

Tambahnya, mangsa seterusnya diarahkan oleh suspek untuk memindahkan wang keseluruhan berjumlah RM1.2 juta melalui empat transaksi dari akaun Ambank dan Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) ke dua bank yang baru dibuka.

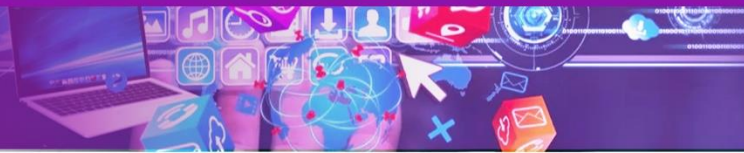

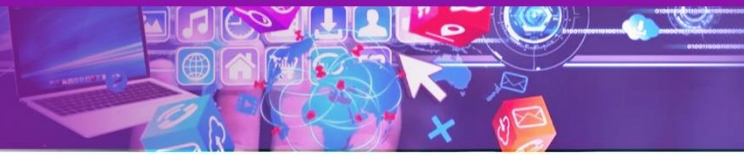

Sehubungan itu, Nancy memaklumkan terdapat banyak lagi saranan lain yang dikemukakan ketika perjumpaan tersebut termasuk menggantikan perkataan OKU kepada perkataan lain.

“Ini adalah saranan mereka, kita tidak menghalang mereka menyuarakan perkara tersebut. Bagi saya sekiranya saranan itu baik kita akan pertimbangkan untuk ke peringkat atasan.

“Malah, saya turut menyarankan agar golongan OKU menyuarakan pendapat secara berkumpulan supaya kita boleh bawa suara itu dengan rasmi di peringkat seterusnya,” kata beliau.

Dalam pada itu, Nancy memberitahu akan mewakili

Malaysia bagi Konvensyen Mengenai Hak OKU anjuran Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (PBB) di New York, Amerika Syarikat pada 13 hingga 15 Jun ini.

“Kita akan berbincang, bermesyuarat mengenai OKU ini sekali gus melihat dan mendengar bagaimana amalan-amalan yang dilakukan di luar negara termasuk dasar mereka.

“Selain itu, (kita) melihat sama ada dasar mereka bersesuaian dengan apa yang kita boleh terima dan perubahan, kerana di sana nanti kita juga akan berkongsi dasar dari segi kategori OKU - mengikut ‘cita rasa’ Malaysia begitu juga dengan negara lain,” ujar Ahli Parlimen Santubong itu.

Mengenai frasa Iban Segulai Sejalai, Nancy berkata ia

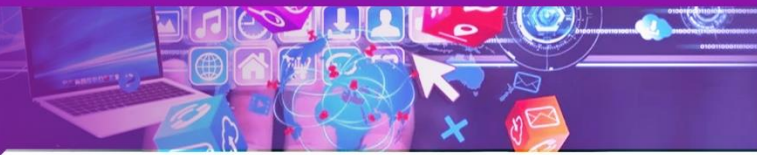

# Ibu wanita hilang di Thailand tak percaya video 'anak selamat'

Anaknya sukar dihubungi dan mengelak setiap kali ditanya keberadaannya

**KULAI:** Ibu kepada Chong Sum Yee, 22, wanita Malaysia yang dipercayai hilang di Chiang Mai, Thailand, tidak mempercayai video anaknya mendakwa dirinya selamat dan sihat, yang tular beberapa hari kebelakangan ini.

Chee Choy Won, 50, berkata hal ini kerana akaun Facebook yang menggunakan nama 'Moe Aye' yang memuat naik rakaman video anaknya itu, tidak dikenali dan percaya ia adalah akaun baharu dibuat.

Beliau berkata, anaknya juga sukar untuk dihubungi dan mengelak setiap kali ditanya mengenai keberadaannya.

Menurut Chee, ia ditambah pula dengan gesaan anaknya yang mahu laporan polis ditarik balik ketika dia berjaya menghubungi anaknya itu pada jam 8 malam kelmarin menerusi aplikasi WhatsApp.

"Menerusi panggilan WhatsApp selama beberapa minit malam tadi (kelmarin), Sum Yee mengatakan dia selamat dan meminta agar kami tidak mencarinya serta menarik laporan polis tetapi suaranya agak laju dan kelam

katut.

Ibu dua anak itu berkata, dia turut berlepas ke Thailand bersama anak lelakinya Chong Jeng Wei, 23, dan Pengarah Pendidikan Politik DAP Johor Alan Tee Boon Tsong selama empat hari pada 6 Jun lepas bagi mengikuti perkembangan kes kehilangan anaknya.

Bagaimanapun, Chee berkata pihak polis Thailand memaklumkan terdapat kemungkinan anaknya berada di Myanmar, justeru, Polis Thailand dan Myanmar sedang bekerjasama bagi mengesan Sum Yee yang sepatutnya pulang ke Malaysia pada 7 Jun lepas.

Sementara itu, Jeng Wei berkata dia musykil apabila adik perempuannya yang bekerja sebagai jurusolek

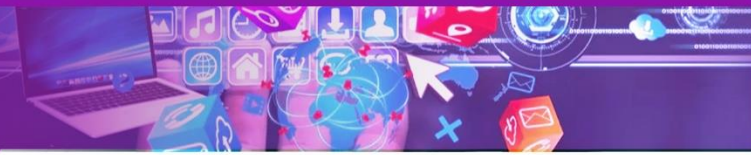
Jeng Wei berkata, mereka semakin risau apabila Sum Yee memberi alasan ke sana atas urusan kerja yang telah dinafikan oleh majikan dan berharap agar dia segera ditemui.

Sebelum ini, laporan berita dipetik terdapat tiga video yang telah dimuat naik oleh seorang pengguna Facebook yang tidak dikenali bernama 'Moe Aye' di ruangan komen catatan Chee, memaparkan Sum Yee tersenyum serta berulang kali menyatakan

"dia selamat dan sihat".

Sum Yee dipercayai berlepas ke Chiang Mai, Thailand pada 29 Mei dan melakukan perjalanan sejauh 250 kilometer ke daerah utara Mae Sai di wilayah Chiang Rai, yang berdekatan dengan bandar Tachilek di Myanmar, iaitu lokasi kes-kes pemerdagangan manusia pernah dilaporkan.

Polis Diraja Malaysia juga dilaporkan sedang bekerjasama dengan Polis Thailand bagi mengesan Sum Yee dan berdasarkan situasi awal, jurusolek itu telah menyeberang sempadan ke Tachilek, sejak 30 Mei lepas. — Bernama

## Polis tahan lelaki pukul pemandu wanita dengan topi keledar

**BALIK PULAU:** Polis menahan seorang lelaki yang memukul pemandu wanita menggunakan topi keledar dalam kejadian di Jalan Permatang Damar Laut, di sini pada Khamis yang video insiden itu turut tular di media sosial.

Ketua Polis Daerah Barat Daya Supt Kamarul Rizal Jenal berkata, suspek berusia 32 tahun yang merupakan penunggang motosikal itu ditahan semalam bagi membantu siasatan kes tersebut.

“Siasatan awal mendapati lelaki itu tidak berpuas hati dengan wanita tersebut yang memandu kereta sehingga menyebabkan kemalangan dan telah mendorong suspek mencederakan wanita itu dengan topi keledar.

“Lelaki itu direman untuk siasatan lanjut dan kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 324 Kanun Keseksaan,” katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Beliau turut meminta kerjasama orang ramai yang melihat atau mempunyai maklumat berhubung kejadian itu agar menghubungi Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah

(IPD) Barat Daya menerusi talian 04-8662222.

Terdahulu tular video berdurasi 14 saat memaparkan seorang penunggang motosikal bertindak kasar sebelum memukul pemandu wanita dengan topi keledar.

Sementara itu, dalam perkembangan lain Kamarul Rizal berkata pihaknya menyita enam motosikal dalam Ops Samseng Jalan yang dijalankan bermula 1 pagi di Bayan Lepas, di sini.

“Kesemua motosikal itu disita menurut Seksyen 64 (1) Akta Pengangkutan Jalan 1987 dan polis turut mengeluarkan 133 saman kerana pelbagai kesalahan lalu lintas,” katanya menambah selain membendung samseng jalan melibatkan mat rempit, operasi juga bertujuan memastikan penunggang motosikal sentiasa mematuhi peraturan lalu lintas dan mengikut spesifikasi yang ditetapkan.

“Operasi akan diteruskan setiap minggu bagi mencegah gejala mat rempit yang sering mengganggu ketenteraman awam,” katanya. — Bernama
