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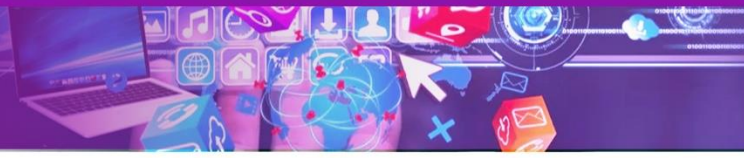

# Individu pertama didakwa kes hendap diarah jalani rawatan psikiatri

**Shah Alam:** Mahkamah Majistret semalam mengarahkan seorang bekas pereka sambilan yang menjadi individu pertama didakwa atas kesalahan menghendap menjalani rawatan psikiatri di Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta, Perak, selama sebulan.

Majistret Sasha Diana Sabtu membuat keputusan berkenaan selepas Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Zilfinaz Abbas, memohon supaya Mohamad Safiq Rosli, 37, yang mengaku tidak bersalah atas tuduhan berkenaan dihantar ke hospital itu mengikut Seksyen 342 Kanun Tatacara Jenayah (CPC).

Mengikut pertuduhan, Mohamad Safiq menggunakan akaun Twitter '@sopert99' secara berulang mengganggu Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31, yang juga jurugambar dengan menghantar komunikasi kepada akaun Twitter '@ShaFoShizzle' yang dibaca di sebuah rumah di Shah Alam.

Kesalahan dilakukan jam 1.40 pagi pada 15 Julai lalu hingga 5.58 petang, 21 Julai lalu dan tertuduh sepatutnya tahu bahawa gangguan itu boleh mendatangkan ketautan kepada mangsa.

Tertuduh melakukan kesala-

han menghendap di bawah Seksyen 507A (1) Kanun Keseksaan (KK) yang boleh dihukum di mengikut Seksyen 507A (3) KK yang membawa kepada hukuman penjara maksimum tiga tahun atau denda atau kedua-keduanya jika sabit kesalahan.

Terdahulu, Zilfinaz berkata, permohonan terbabit dibuat mengikut arahan, selain mengesahkan tertuduh menjalani rawa-

tan psikiatri di Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL), sejak 17 Julai lalu.

## HKL ada laporan perubatan

Katanya, HKL ada menyediakan laporan perubatan tertuduh untuk dikemukakan ke mahkamah.

"Pendakwaan juga tidak menawarkan jaminan atas alasan tertuduh ada sejarah melanggar jaminan selepas ditangkap polis di United Kingdom (UK) pada 4

April lalu.

"Tertuduh diberi jaminan dan melanggarnya, tertuduh sepatutnya hadir ke mahkamah (UK) memberi penjelasan mengenai pelanggaran jamin pada 2 Jun lalu.

"Malangnya tertuduh melarikan diri ke Malaysia dan polis UK menyenarai hitam tertuduh di negara itu," katanya.

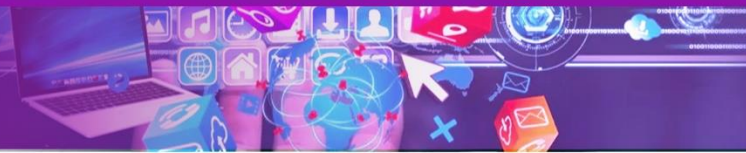
Sementara itu, peguam bela tertuduh, Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil, ketika ditemui media memaklumkan tidak membantah supaya anak guam dihantar ke hospital berkenaan untuk pemeriksaan psikiatri.

"Atas permintaan pendakwaan, kami serah kepada pakar untuk rawatan psikiatri," katanya.

Peguam pemerhati mewakili mangsa, Jason Wee, pula mengesahkan memohon perintah perlindungan supaya anak guam tidak diganggu tertuduh.

"Kami percaya ini permulaan kes, di mana kami bertungkus-lum dan bekerja keras untuk mendapatkan keadilan," katanya.

Mahkamah menetapkan 7 September ini untuk sebutan semula kes dan perkembangan laporan psikiatri.

## Pengasuh taska disyaki dera budak 4 tahun direman seminggu

**Kota Kinabalu:** Seorang wanita yang juga pengasuh di sebuah taska di Luyang, dekat sini, direman selama seminggu susulan kes dera membabitkan kanak-kanak lelaki berusia empat tahun di pusat asuhan itu.

Perintah reman bermula semalam ke atas suspek, 27, dikeluarkan Majistret Stephanie Sherron Abbie di Mahkamah Majistret Kota Kinabalu susulan kes yang turut tular di media sosial itu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Kota Kinabalu, Asisten Komisioner Mohd Zaidi Abdullah, ketika dihubungi memaklumkan suspek ditahan awal pagi semalam untuk membantu siasatan mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001.

"Setakat ini, polis menerima tiga laporan daripada ibu mangsa, pengusaha dan pengasuh taska yang juga suspek dalam kes ini yang mendakwa dikasari bapa kanak-kanak terbabit," katanya.

Terdahulu, tular video berdurasi dua minit 12 saat memaparkan seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia empat tahun ditendang, ditampar dan rambut ditarik oleh pengasuh di sebuah taska di Luyang sejak petang kelmarin.

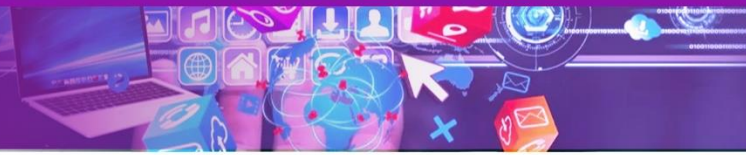
Rakaman kamera litar tertutup menunjukkan kanak-kanak lelaki itu ditampar dan dipukul menggunakan pembaris pada muka dan kepala berkali-kali ketika hendak makan.

Sementara itu, Menteri Pembangunan Masyarakat dan Kesejahteraan Rakyat (KP-MKR) Sabah, Datuk James Ratib, memandang serius kes dera yang berlaku itu dan pihaknya akan memanggil pengusaha taska terbabit untuk memberi penjelasan lanjut.

"Kita sudah buat penelitian, syarikat (yang mengendalikan taska) itu mempunyai dua lesen iaitu lesen taska dan tadika. Tadika adalah di bawah Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM).

"Di pihak kami, saya akan melihat perkara ini secara serius kerana tidak mahu ibu bapa yang menghantar anak ke taska dan tadika hilang kepercayaan.

"Saya juga minta Pengarah Jabatan Perkhidmatan Kebajikan Am (JPKA) negeri supaya membuat satu garis panduan terutama kepada pengendali taska di bawah kementerian saya," katanya.

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## KES MANGSA HENDAP DIBICARA

# 'Moga tiada lagi mangsa sama'

Kuala Lumpur

"Alhamdulillah, syukur dan lega kerana kes ini akhirnya diberi perhatian serius serta diambil tindakan mengikut undang-undang. Perbicaraan mahkamah mungkin mengambil masa panjang namun saya sudah bersedia untuk menghadapinya," kata jurugambar profesional, Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31.

Dia sebelum ini menjadi mangsa hendap dan gangguan seksual dalam talian sejak lebih lapan tahun lalu oleh seorang lelaki berusia 37 tahun.

Lelaki terbabit bukan sahaja menghantar gambar dan video lucah, malah mengikuti setiap perkembangan Acacia Mardiana serta mengekori wanita itu sehingga ke United Kingdom.

Penderitaan mangsa turut didedahkan secara eksklusif Harian Metro pada 15 Julai lalu selepas mangsa mendakwa laporan polis dibuat sebelum ini tidak diambil tindakan.

Namun pendedahan melalui media sosial dilaku-

kannya itu akhirnya diambil perhatian serius sebelum suspek ditahan polis.

Menurut Acacia Mardiana, pendakwaan mahkamah terhadap lelaki itu semalam memberikannya harapan dan kelegaan.

"Diharapkan isu ini menjadi pengajaran pada masa hadapan. Moga tiada lagi

mangsa lain mengalami penderitaan sama seperti saya alami selepas Seksyen 507A Kanun Keseksaan atas kesalahan menghendap dilaksanakan.

"Sejak kes didedahkan kepada umum (Julai lalu), saya menerima banyak sokongan termasuk daripada individu tidak dikenali.

"Ia sedikit sebanyak memberi kekuatan untuk terus kekal kuat menghadapi ujian berkenaan. Saya ingin ucapkan terima kasih kepada pihak Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK), Kementerian Komunikasi dan Digital serta peguam atas usaha mereka untuk memastikan kes ini dapat diheret ke mahkamah," katanya.

Menurutnya, usaha mendakwa penjenayah terbabit memerlukan kerjasama banyak pihak.

"Saya berharap keputusan (hukuman) kelak menjadi keputusan wajar, selain dapat menghalang penghendap daripada melakukan jenayah ini kepada mangsa lain pada masa hadapan.

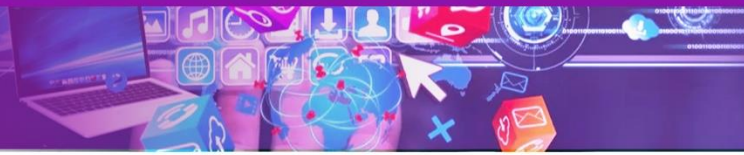
"Saya akui perasaan takut masih ada dalam diri namun di sebaliknya, ada sinar baharu untuk masa depan yang lebih baik untuk negara ini," katanya.

Difahamkan suspek yang mengganggunya itu bakal menjadi individu pertama yang akan didakwa di mahkamah mengikut Seksyen 507A Kanun Keseksaan atas kesalahan menghendap.

Jika didapati bersalah, lelaki terbabit berdepan hukuman penjara maksimum sehingga tiga tahun, denda, atau kedua-duanya sekali.

## Empat *cedera* MPV bertembung kereta perisai ATM

**Johor Bahru:** Seorang wanita dan tiga kanak-kanak lelaki cedera selepas kenderaan dinaiki terbabit kemalangan dengan sebuah kereta perisai milik Angkatan Tentera Malaysia (ATM) di jalan menghala Taman Damai sebelum Punggai di Kota Tinggi, kelmarin.

Komander Operasi Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat (BBP) Punggai Pegawai Bomba Deddy Borhan Umaali berkata, seramai 15 anggota termasuk dari BBP Sungai Rengit dikejarkan ke lokasi kejadian selepas panggilan kecemasan diterima pada 8.28 malam.

Beliau berkata, wanita yang berusia 54 tahun bersama tiga kanak-kanak lelaki berusia tujuh, lima dan empat tahun menaiki kenderaan pelbagai guna

(MPV) jenis Honda Odyssey.

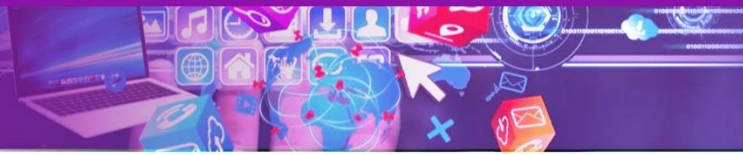
Kereta perisai milik ATM yang dalam perjalanan balik ke kem Teluk Sepang dipercayai berlanggar dengan kenderaan MPV itu, katanya.

"Bagaimanapun, wanita dan tiga kanak-kanak terbabit tidak tersepit di dalam kenderaan mereka,"

katanya dalam kenyataan. Beliau berkata pihaknya bertindak memberikan rawatan awal kepada kesemua mangsa yang mengalami kecederaan sebelum dihantar ke Hospital Kota Tinggi.

Beliau bagaimanapun menjelaskan dua anggota yang berada di dalam kereta perisai itu selamat dan tidak mengalami sebarang kecederaan.

Kisah dua beranak itu tular selepas video mereka dikongsi di Facebook (FB) dan TikTok Perkim Kebangsaan serta turut menerima ribuan komen positif serta sokongan orang ramai.

Berdasarkan kenyataan

di FB Perkim Kebangsaan, dua beranak itu sanggup berjalan dua kilometer (km) dari rumah mereka di Titiwangsa ke Ibu Pejabat Perkim demi Nur Shazrin Aisyah memeluk Islam.

Gadis itu melafazkan syahadah di hadapan Pegawai Unit Pembangunan Insan dan Operasi Perkim, Ustaz Sulaiman Ding Yu Zhong dan disaksikan ibu

kandungnya.

"Ketika Shazrin atau nama asalnya Sugasini melengkapkan butir pengislaman, lima minit kemudian, ibunya menyatakan hasrat mengikuti jejak anaknya memeluk Islam.

"Selepas mengikrarkan dua kalimah syahadah dalam bahasa Arab diikuti dalam bahasa Inggeris, ibu Shazrin memilih nama Nu-

rul Hidayah Kerashnan kerana Allah SWT sudah memberi hidayah menjadi seorang Islam," katanya.

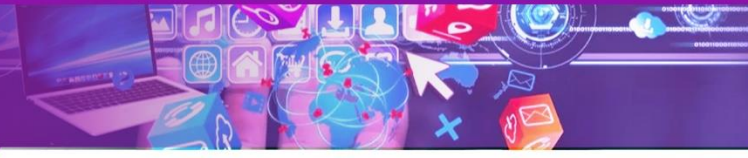
Berdasarkan perkongsian itu, Nurul Hidayah memaklumkan sudah biasa menyesuaikan diri dalam kehidupan seorang Muslim kerana tiga anaknya sudah memeluk Islam sebelum ini, sekali gus keluarga mereka mempraktikkan aspek halal haram dalam Islam.

"Saya mula kenal Islam ketika berusia 12 tahun selepas berpindah ke sebuah sekolah yang mana ketika itu hanya saya pelajar bukan Islam," katanya.

Dia juga pernah mengikuti ceramah di surau sekolah tanpa paksaan dan mengakui menerima hidayah ketika berusia 18 tahun selepas bermimpi seorang wanita memberi salam.

Seolah-olah 'naik hantu' apabila seorang pengasuh sebuah taman asuhan kanak-kanak (taska) bertindak kejam menendang, menampar, menarik rambut serta memukul menggunakan pembaris di bahagian muka dan kepala seorang kanak-kanak dijajanya.

Video pengasuh wanita terbabit tular di media sosial susulan tindakannya mendera seorang kanak-kanak lelaki berusia empat tahun di taska terletak di Jalan Kampung Seronok Nosoob, Penampang di sini.

Difahamkan video rakaman litar tertutup (CCTV) mengenai kejadian itu tular di media sosial sejak petang kelmarin.

Bapa mangsa yang enggan dikenali berkata, dia sendiri tidak sanggup melihat rakaman video memaparkan anaknya ditendang, ditampar dan dipukul dengan pembaris berulang-kali.

"Saya sendiri tidak sanggup lihat rakaman video anak ditendang dan ditampar di bahagian muka dan kepala. Ibu bapa mana tidak sedih anak diperlakukan sedemikian.

"Malah, lebih memilukan ketika hendak makan, anak saya turut ditampar dan dipukul dengan pembaris berulang-kali," katanya sebak.

Menceritakan kejadian itu, beliau berkata, sudah dua kali anaknya menjadi mangsa dera sejak bersekolah di taska berkenaan yang bermula pada Mac lalu.

Katanya, kejadian pertama dua minggu lalu selepas isterinya perasan terdapat kesan lebam di bahagian tangan anaknya sebaik diambil daripada taska itu.

"Pada mulanya anak saya mengatakan dia dipukul oleh guru (pengasuh) namun mengubah dengan mengatakan kawan-kawannya yang pukul.

"Tetapi, seminggu kemudian isteri melihat kesan lebam lain di bahagian dada

anak sebelum bertanya kepada pihak taska. Mereka hanya memberikan jawapan bahawa itu adalah perkara biasa kerana kemungkinan anak kami didakwa bergaduh dengan rakan-rakan," katanya semalam.

Beliau berkata, mereka menerima jawapan itu dan menghantar anak seperti biasa ke taska terbabit sehinggalah anak mereka mengadu sakit di bahagian kepala.

"Semalam (kelmarin), sebaik menjemput anak kami di taska itu isteri saya mengusap ubun-ubun sebelum anak mengadu sakit di bahagian kepala.

"Isteri saya memeriksa

bahagian itu dan terkejut kerana terdapat kesan luka di kepala, saya terus bertanya kepada pihak taska namun mereka tiada jawapan mengenai kesan luka itu," katanya.

Bagaimanapun, katanya, dia yang tidak dapat bersabar terus meminta untuk memeriksa CCTV di taska terbabit sebelum melihat rakaman anaknya didera dengan ditampar dan ditenang.

"Saya kemudian membuat laporan di Balai Polis Tanjung Aru untuk tindakan selanjutnya kerana perkara ini tidak boleh dibiarkan berlaku bagi mengelakkan lebih ramai kanak-ka-

nak yang dihantar di taska itu menerima nasib sama.

"Saya berharap pihak berkuasa dapat menjalankan siasatan dan mengambil tindakan terhadap pihak taska ini.

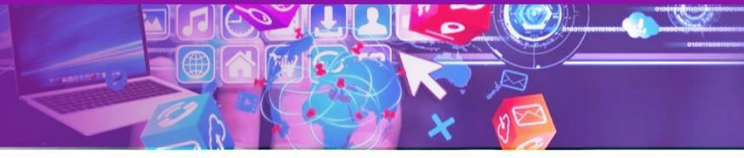
"Anak saya kini mendapatkan rawatan lanjut di Hospital Queen Elizabeth (HQE) bagi mengenal pasti kecederaan dialami kesan daripada perbuatan kejam pengasuh itu," katanya.

"Setakat ini, dua kertas siasatan dibuka iaitu mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 dan Seksyen 323 Kanun Keseksaan," katanya semalam.

## Safiq diarah dihantar ke hospital bahagia

**Shah Alam:** Mahkamah Majistret, semalam memerintahkan seorang bekas peraka sambilan yang berdepan tuduhan menghendap dan melakukan gangguan berulang terhadap jurugambar wanita bagi perhatian psikiatri di Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta, Perak selama sebulan.

Majistret Sasha Diana Sabtu membuat keputusan itu selepas Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Zilfinaz Abbas memohon Mohamad Safiq Rosli, 37, dihantar ke hospital itu.

Mohamad Safiq menjadi individu pertama di negara ini didakwa atas pertuduhan menghendap mengikut Seksyen 507A Kanun Keseksaan yang baharu dikuatkuasakan.

Terdahulu, dalam prosiding semalam, Mohamad Safiq memakai kemeja hijau mengaku tidak bersalah selepas pertuduhan ke atasnya dibaca di hadapan Sasha Diana.

"Tidak mengaku (bersalah), mohon bicara," katanya.

Mengikut pertuduhan, lelaki itu yang kini pengangguar melalui aplikasi Twitter atas nama akaun '@so-pert99' secara berulang mengganggu Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31, dengan menghantar tiga komunikasi berbentuk luahan perasaannya seperti dalam lampiran kepada akaun Twitter milik mangsa '@ShaFoShizzle' yang dibaca di sebuah rumah di daerah ini.

Kesalahan didakwa dilakukan antara jam 1.40 petang, 15 Julai dan 5.58 petang, 21 Julai lalu yang mana tertuduh sepatutnya tahu ia boleh mendatangkan ketakutan kepada mangsa.

Berikutan itu, tertuduh didakwa melakukan kesalahan menghendap di bawah Seksyen 507A(1) Kanun Keseksaan yang boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen 507A(3) akta sama yang membawa hukuman penjara maksimum tiga tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Terdahulu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Zilfinaz Abbas tidak menawarkan jaminan terhadap tertuduh selepas mengambil kira faktor tertuduh sebelum ini melanggar syarat jaminan polis bagi kes di United Kingdom (UK).

"Tertuduh sepatutnya hadir ke mahkamah di negara itu untuk memberi penjelasan atas pelanggaran jaminannya 2 Jun lalu, tetapi dia melarikan diri ke Malaysia dan namanya disenarai hitam di UK.

"Saya diarah menghantar tertuduh ke Unit Forensik Psikiatri di Hospital Ulu Kinta untuk pemerhatian. Sebelum ini, tertuduh dihantar keluarganya ke Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) untuk mendapatkan rawatan dan pihak hospital turut memberi laporan perubatan tertuduh pada hari ini (semalam)," katanya.

Zilfinaz berkata, tertuduh ditempatkan di wad psikiatri di HKL sejak 17 Julai sehingga kini dan polis mengambil tertuduh di hospital itu untuk dititah di mahkamah.

Sementara itu, peguam bela tertuduh, Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil ketika ditemui media memaklumkan tidak membantah anak guam dihantar ke hospital berkenaan untuk pemeriksaan psikiatri.

"Atas permintaan pendakwaan, kami serahkan kepada pakar untuk rawatan psikiatri.

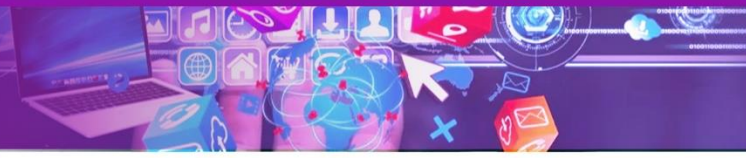
"Keluarga hantar anak guam ke HKL sebelum ini untuk rawatan selama sebulan. Kami percaya rawatan di hospital bahagia diperlukan," katanya.

Peguam pemerhati mewakili mangsa, Jason Wee pula mengesahkan memohon perintah perlindungan supaya anak guam tidak diganggu tertuduh.

"Kami percaya ini permulaan kes, di mana kami bertungkus-lumus dan bekerja keras untuk mendapatkan keadilan.

"Kami berterima kasih kepada polis, Suruhanjaya Komunikasi Multimedia Malaysia (SKMM) dan Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK) yang membantu mangsa penghendap," katanya.

Pada 29 Mac lalu, Dewan Rakyat meluluskan pindaan Kanun Keseksaan menjadikan menghendap oleh penghendap (*stalker*) secara fizikal dan dalam talian sebagai satu jenayah.

# Man charged with stalking photographer

**SHAH ALAM:** A former freelance designer, 37, yesterday became the first person to be charged under the new anti-stalking law.

Mohd Safiq Rosli allegedly stalked and sexually harassed a

female photographer for years, sending her lewd photographs of himself, and even followed her to the United Kingdom.

He pleaded not guilty before magistrate Sasha Diana Sabtu to

repeatedly harassing photographer Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31.

The offence under Section 507A of the Penal Code carries a maximum penalty of three years in jail and a fine.

Sasha ordered the accused to be sent to Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta in Perak for a mental evaluation upon the request of deputy public prosecutor Zilfinaz Abbas.

The court has fixed Sept 7 for mention.

The court granted Acacia a protection order until the conclusion of the trial through the request of her watching brief, lawyer Jason Wee.

According to the charge sheet, Safiq allegedly repeatedly harassed Acacia by sending messages on her Twitter/X account when he should've known that it would incite fear in her, hence

making it a stalking offence.

Zilfinaz has proposed no bail for the accused as he had evaded the authorities when he was being investigated for harassment in the UK.

The accused had also failed to make a court appearance in the UK on June 2 as he had fled to Malaysia.

She said Safiq was also blacklisted from entering the UK.

Safiq's lawyer Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil did not dispute the bail and the observation request at Hospital Bahagia.

Sasha said the bail amount would be decided after the observation period at Hospital Bahagia.

Wee said Acacia had requested a protection order to avoid further harassment from the accused and safety concerns.

It was reported that the ac-

cused allegedly stalked and sexually harassed Acacia for years.

Acacia had, in social media postings, revealed her ordeal began in 2016 when she received strange comments on her blog, where she documented her travels and projects.

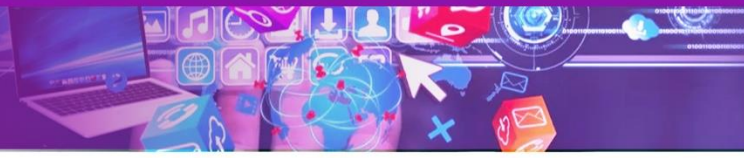
She said the stalker had created several social media accounts over the years to harass her, including sending lewd photos to her via direct message on Instagram.

She said he was arrested in the UK but released on bail while police investigated the case.

She claimed that the police there had intended to charge him with sexual harassment and stalking, but he left for Malaysia and did not turn up in court.

Safiq has been held at the neurology ward of Hospital Kuala Lumpur since last month.

## Caretaker in KK remanded over child abuse probe

**KOTA KINABALU:** A caretaker at a childcare centre here who allegedly abused a four-year-old boy under her care has been remanded until Aug 17.

Magistrate Stephanie Sherron Abbie issued the remand order yesterday.

Kota Kinabalu police chief ACP Mohd Zaidi Abdullah said the 27-year-old woman was arrested Wednesday evening to assist police investigation into an alleged child abuse case which took place at a childcare centre in Luyang.

The case is currently being investigated under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001.

Under this Section, any person who has in his or her care a child that is being neglected, abandoned or exposed the child in a manner likely to cause him/her physical or emotional injury can be fined not exceeding RM20,000 or jailed for a term not exceeding 10 years, or both.

Mohd Zaidi said the four-year-old boy told his parents that he was assaulted by the caretaker, resulting in injuries on various parts of his body.

The parents then visited the childcare centre and reviewed

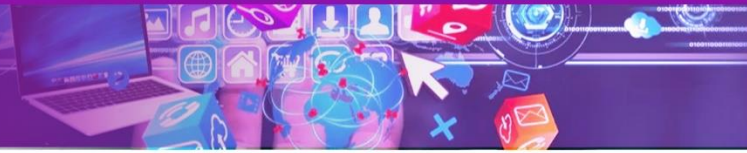
the CCTV footage which confirmed the assault. A police report was then lodged by the boy's parents," he said.

He added that so far, police have received three police reports relating to the incident.

"One (report) was from the victim's mother, one from the childcare centre's owner, and another from the caretaker (suspect) who claimed that she was assaulted by the boy's 36-year-old father," he said, adding that the victim and suspect were referred to Queen Elizabeth Hospital II for medical examination.

Meanwhile, Luyang assemblyman Phoong Jin Zhe, Kota Kinabalu deputy police chief Supt Kalsom Idris, and officials and representatives from the Kota Kinabalu Social Welfare Department made a visit to the daycare centre yesterday.

A two-minute and 12-second video clip from the centre's CCTV, which went viral on social media on Wednesday evening, showed a child being kicked, slapped and hit on his head with a ruler by the caretaker during meal time.

## CBT: Cashier claims trial to 16 counts of misappropriating department store's funds

**KUCHING:** A department store cashier claimed trial in the Sessions Court here yesterday to 16 counts of criminal breach of trust involving a total of RM21,700.

Ivy Estivia Lita, 32, pleaded not guilty before four separate Sessions Court judges to charges framed under Section 408 of the Penal Code.

The Section provides for between one year and 14 years in prison along with caning and a fine, if convicted.

Judges Musli Ab Hamid, Saiful Bahari Adzmi, and Maris Agan set case management for Sept 11, 2023 and granted cash bail of RM1,000 along with a local surety for each of the four charges faced

by Ivy in their courtrooms.

Judge Afidah Abdul Rahman set bail at RM15,000 (undeposited) along with two local sureties with fixed addresses for the other four charges.

Ivy was also ordered to report to the nearest police station once a month and surrender her passport.

She was also advised to seek legal advice before or on the next mention date of the case.

According to the charges, Ivy allegedly misappropriated a total of RM21,700 during her employment at a department store in a mall located along Jalan Tun Ahmad Zaidi Adruce here from Jan 5, 2023 to Feb 20, 2023.

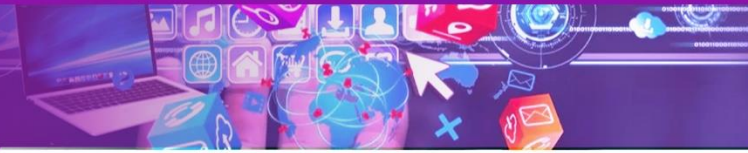
It is alleged that the store's management found funds had been misused through top-up transactions for a member card under Ivy's name.

After a review of the company's system, it was discovered that Ivy had allegedly made 21 top-up transactions for personal use without making payments to the company.

A police report was lodged leading to Ivy's arrest.

Prosecution was conducted separately by DPPs Iezzah Iburdanisha Ibrahim, Ruvinasini Pandian, Mohammad Fauzan Zamri, and Norshafatihah Nor Azmi.

Ivy was unrepresented by legal counsel.

## CCTVs now mandatory in Sabah childcare centres

**KOTA KINABALU:** After the case of physical abuse in a childcare centre here, the state government will require all its kindergarten and day care operators under its jurisdiction of the state government to install closed-circuit television (CCTVs) in the premises before renewing their licences.

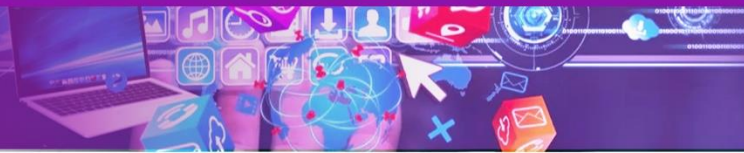
State Community Development and People's Wellbeing Minister Datuk James Ratib said that the state government will summon all kindergartens and childcare centres under the department by today (Aug 11) to convey its concerns and action to be taken.

Speaking to reporters at the State Legislative Assembly building yesterday, he said that the welfare department under his ministry has formulated relevant guidelines to ensure that teachers or caretakers employed by childcare operators are qualified to work with children.

"There are more than 300 kindergartens under my ministry. We will make it mandatory for them to install CCTVs in the premises before renewing their licences. They should also ensure caretakers be given training and make sure they love working with children," he said, when asked to comment on the case of a four-year-old boy abused by one of the caretakers at a daycare centre which was caught on CCTV.

The federal social welfare department had earlier this year made the installation of CCTVs mandatory, but it was unclear whether Sabah had adopted similar measures.

"The teacher is said to have entered the job in 2020. Maybe there have been other children that have been abused since then. We will be investigating this," James said, adding that he feared the incident would affect other parents' faith in such centres. — Malay Mail

## Implementation of anti-stalking law an eye-opener for offenders — Nancy

**SEREMBAN:** The implementation of the Anti-Stalking Law against a man who was charged with the offence yesterday is an eye opener and a lesson to the community and any person who indulges in the act of stalking.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said this is because such obsession will no longer be tolerated and stern action can be taken against offenders.

"We are relieved that the Anti-Stalking Law has finally been enforced, even though it had been approved earlier, the standard operating procedure (SOP) was not completely developed, so action could not be taken (against stalkers). But Alhamdulillah, we saw the first individual charged in court for stalking.

"Most of such cases involve women, so it is also an encouragement for women being stalked to report. This may also happen to men, we don't know, so

if you feel harassed by someone's unwanted attention, you have the right to take action."

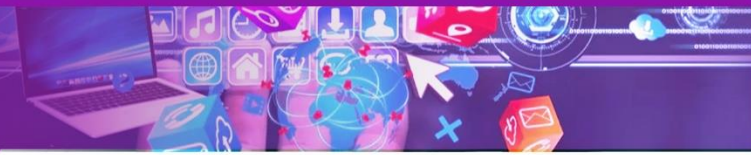
She said this after officiating at the KPWKM@Anti-Sexual Harassment Advocacy Programme which was also attended by deputy minister Aiman Athirah Sabu here yesterday.

Earlier yesterday, 37-year-old Mohamad Safiq Rosli was charged in the Magistrates' Court in Shah Alam for stalking a female photographer for eight years, making him the first person to be charged under the new Section 507A(1) of the Penal Code.

Meanwhile, Nancy said some victims do not report cases of stalking or sexual harassment because they are afraid as the perpetrator may be a powerful person or an employer, resulting in the victim's loss of self-confidence, prolonged trauma and even lead them to take drastic actions. — Bernama

## Jelita programme to give women access to male-dominated TVET fields

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Job Empowerment by Learning and Inclusive Technical Advancement (Jelita) programme is expected to empower women and give them access to the male dominated fields under Technical and Vocational Education Training (TVET).

Universiti Teknikal Malaysia vice-chancellor Prof Dr Massila Kamalrudin said women should discard the mindset of associating TVET with the 3D sector of Dirty, Difficult and Dangerous jobs.

"When it comes to advanced TVET, there is great income potential and big opportunities to become technical entrepreneurs online. There are also technical fields such as computer software in TVET where women need not get their hands dirty, which require intellectual skills instead," she told Bernama.

Meanwhile, a Universiti Tun Hussein Onn Malaysia (UTHM) student N. Vethashri, 27, welcomed the Jelita programme, saying it would give women more opportunities to get into TVET.

Vethashri, who was exposed to TVET during school, said TVET job openings for women are still low.

"I completed a catering course. When I started working, I found the majority of staff at my workplace were men.

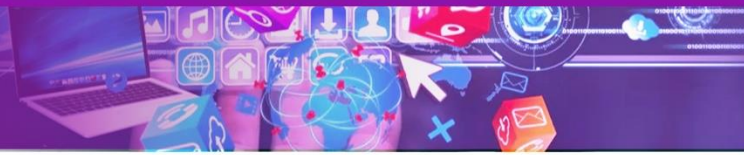
Another UTHM student Nurul Athirah Firdaus, 24, said women who take up the Jelita programme can secure their careers in whichever field they choose, just as she did in the aviation management industry.

"I want to prove that I can also succeed in this field, which is usually dominated by men.

"I am not worried about job opportunities because with a programme like Jelita, I am one step closer to securing my career in this field," she said.

Previously, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Ahmad Zahid Hamidi said the Jelita programme is aimed at empowering women economically through the development of talents, skills, abilities and knowledge.

He said the programme which will be implemented for three years is targeting to attract the participation of 150,000 women. — Bernama

# Phone scam leaves woman RM39k poorer

**KUCHING:** A woman here has claimed that she lost RM39,000 to a recent phone scam.

Democratic Action Party (DAP) member Michael Kong said the victim, known as 'Amanda', claimed she was hoodwinked by a scam syndicate into providing her banking details.

"Her mistake was that she believed what the impersonator had said over the phone and divulged her banking account details," he said in a statement.

The special assistant to Stampin MP Chong Chieng Jen said efforts to save any remaining money in the victim's bank account with the help of a bank were futile.

"The scammer's actions proved too quick and there were no monies left in the account.

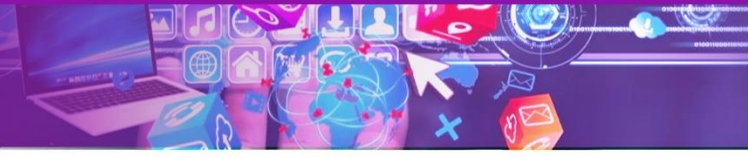
"The bank has already blacklisted the account and an investigation will be carried out by the bank and the police," said Kong.

He added that the bank account used by the scammer was likely to be another mule account under the syndicate.

Kong reminded the public

that the authorities, such as the police or the Inland Revenue Board, would never conduct dealings or interviews over the telephone.

"Do not ever believe the stories given over the phone and never reveal any personal information to these people," he added.

## Sabah woman claims VVIP husband abused, assaulted her

**KOTA KINABALU:** A pregnant woman here has lodged three reports against her husband, who holds a 'Datuk' title and believed to be a senior politician, for allegedly abusing and assaulting her.

The 31-year-old, who only wanted to be identified as Wong, sought assistance from Parti Warisan on Wednesday after claiming the police did not give her appropriate advice when she lodged the reports.

According to Warisan Kota Kinabalu Division deputy chairman Melanie Chia, the police officers who took the victim's first police report failed to help her to apply for an interim protective order (IPO).

"The victim lodged three police reports after she was abused by her husband but the police officer who took her report failed to give the victim proper advice and help her to apply for IPO.

"The police also did not refer the victim to any social worker who could help her after she suffered mental breakdown due to the abuse she sustained from the hands of her husband.

"The police are supposed to assist victims of domestic

violence to file an application for IPO regarding domestic violence.

"This case somehow shows a lack of understanding of domestic violence on the part of the police," said Chia, adding that IPO is to be granted by the court.

Meanwhile, Wong when met at the Warisan Kota Kinabalu division office said her reason for approaching Warisan was not to embarrass her 57-year-old husband but to seek justice for her and her family.

"I have been going up and down the police station to seek justice for me and my family after I had been beaten up and assaulted by my husband, with all injuries proven in all medical reports.

"This incident has put me into a total mental breakdown," said Wong, who is two months pregnant with the couple's first child.

She said the first incident happened at their family home in Likas on April 19 when her husband attacked her, resulting in injuries to her head.

"The second incident happened at my husband's office on July 4, while the third incident

happened on July 18 when my husband beat me up knowing very well that I am pregnant.

"At the police station when lodging the police reports, I was told by the police officers that my case will take a long time to process while the investigation is still ongoing.

"I was also told by an officer that an investigation paper has been opened against me under Section 427 of the Penal Code, Section 323/506 of the Penal Code, and under the Minor Offences Ordinance, and that a

charge will be preferred against me in court.

"If I am wrong, I will accept any charges against me, but I am not wrong," said Wong who is currently on police bail.

She added that she had spoken with a senior investigation officer about her case but was told that it would be a long process.

"When I asked the investigating officer, the officer told me that my case will take a long time to process and might also refer to Bukit Aman

and even up to Putrajaya. The reason is because it involves a VVIP," she said.

"I have been beaten and assaulted. I am not only injured but I am also traumatised. My life and my baby's life in my womb are being threatened.

"Just because he (husband) is a VVIP and holding the highest post in the ministry, he is special? All I want is the truth and justice," said Wong.

Meanwhile, Warisan vice president Datuk Junz Wong said Wong's case is a high-profile case and highlights the importance for society to be brave to fight against domestic violence.

"The purpose of the victim to come forward today is because she feels that the authorities, which are supposed to act against domestic violence, have somehow prolonged or maybe have not proceeded with the investigation because of a VVIP status.

"We want the relevant authorities and all parties involved to be aware of this case and people should take such incidents seriously and put in the effort to help or assist in this investigation.

"Just because a certain person

is a VIP, they have special treatment and the case can be prolonged or delayed? We also hope the public will not make any assumption or speculation in regards to this case and to respect the victim and her family's privacy," he said.

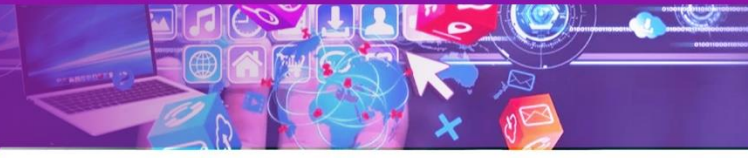
Chia meanwhile said victims of domestic violence must not be afraid to come forward and seek help for their own protection.

She said victims must not be afraid or ashamed but be brave and come forward and report such incidents to the authorities for justice.

"There is a Domestic Violence Act in Malaysia but somehow many people are not aware of this.

"When you have been a victim of domestic violence, you must come forward and lodge a police report for your own protection, and the police must do their job to protect these victims.

"The police must carry out a thorough and fair investigation to protect victims of domestic violence from the perpetrators regardless if these perpetrators are important figures or hold a high ranking post in the government," she said.

# Designer sent to mental hospital

## First man charged under anti-stalking law ordered to undergo psychiatric observation

**SHAH ALAM:** A 37-year-old freelance designer, who became the first person to be charged under the new anti-stalking law, will undergo a month's observation at the forensics psychiatric unit in Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta, Perak.

The court order came after Mohamad Safiq Rosli pleaded not guilty in the Magistrate's Court here to a charge of stalking a female photographer.

Mohamad Safiq, who was brought into the courtroom in handcuffs, is accused of repeatedly harassing Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31 – better known as Acacia Diana – by sending communication to her Twitter account when he should know that the harassment could incite fear in the victim.

The communication, which contained his expressions of love to the victim, was then read at a place in Shah Alam.

He allegedly committed the offence using his Twitter – now known as X – account between 1.40am on July 15 and 5.58pm on July 21.

Mohamad Safiq is charged under Section 507A(1) of the Penal Code, punishable under Section 507A(3) of the Code, and faces imprisonment of up to three years, a fine or both if convicted.

Wearing a green long-sleeved shirt and a black face mask, he pleaded not guilty before magis-

trate Sasha Diana Sabtu yesterday.

Deputy public prosecutor Zilfinaz Abbas did not offer bail although the accused was charged with a bailable offence.

"I've been instructed not to offer bail as the accused has a history of jumping bail in the United Kingdom.

"He was arrested by the British police in April and released on bail pending a court appearance

on June 2, but he skipped the court date by returning to Malaysia," the prosecutor said, adding that Mohamad Safiq has since been blacklisted in the UK.

Lawyer Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil, who represented Mohamad Safiq, did not object to the prosecution's refusal to offer bail.

DPP Zilfinaz then made the application for the accused to be sent to Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta in Tanjung Rambutan to be

observed by the forensics psychiatric unit.

She said prior to the court proceedings, the accused was picked up by the investigating officer at the psychiatric ward at Hospital Kuala Lumpur, where he was admitted by his family since July.

Meanwhile, lawyer Jason Wee, who held a watching brief for the victim, made an *ex parte* application under Section 98A of the Criminal Procedure Code for a

protection order for his client.

"We pray for this order to be given on the basis of preventing further harassment and also due to safety concerns, whereby the accused had flown all the way to the UK to continue such an act against the victim.

"We humbly pray to restrain the accused from going anywhere near the victim and also not to communicate in any means with the victim until the conclusion of this case," Wee said.

Sasha Diana allowed the prosecution's application to admit the accused for observation in Hospital Bahagia Ulu Kinta and said bail would be decided after the observation is completed.

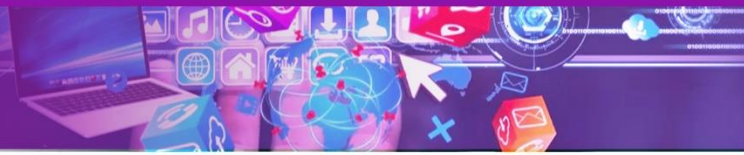
"The court also allows the protection order for the victim," she said.

The court fixed Sept 7 for mention.

On March 29, the Dewan Rakyat passed amendments to the Penal Code making stalking – both physically and online – a crime.

A new Section 507A has been included under the Penal Code (Act 574) to make stalking an offence and any individual found guilty faces a maximum jail sentence of three years, a fine or both, upon conviction.

## Disabled still have little access to amenities, study finds

**PETALING JAYA:** Close to three quarters of public premises are rated three stars and below, with some requirements not up to Malaysian standards, an audit of accessibility for people with disabilities (OKU) conducted over 11 years has found.

The wide-ranging Accessibility Audit Study, gathered from 2011 to 2022, covered public, commercial, institutional and religious premises, recreational parks as well as outdoor, transportation and health facilities.

It was carried out by the International Islamic University Malaysia's KAED Universal Design

Unit (Kudu) under its Architecture and Environmental Design Faculty to gauge accessibility for OKU.

Announcing the study results in a statement yesterday, the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry said 195 premises were audited with the involvement of two or three local authorities.

Of this total, only 13 premises were accorded a five-star rating while 40 premises got four stars.

"The remaining 73% of the audited premises received a rating of three stars or below. Of these, 89 premises were rated three stars, 48 premises two stars and five premises one star," it said.

The findings of the study were presented to the council committee of the National Association for the Disabled in a meeting chaired by minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri on Aug 1.

The ministry said that based on the audit, there was a lack of signage and directions that made it difficult to locate facilities such as toilets and parking for the disabled.

Ramps for wheelchairs were also unavailable, which hindered OKU's access to the main route and facilities. In addition, there were steep ramps that did not comply with Malaysian standards (MS1184).

"The findings also showed dam-

aged footpaths, disabled parking spaces that did not meet MS1184 specifications, and disabled parking without a stand sign.

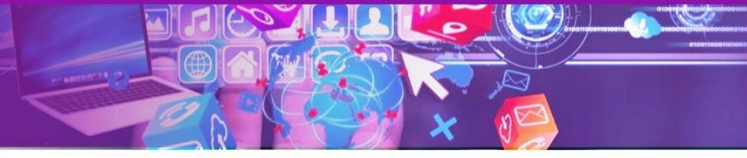
"Apart from that, toilets for the disabled were quite small, with the mirror too high and not meeting specifications," the study found. It also noted that a "refuge area" was not provided in the emergency stairwell area.

Other shortcomings highlighted included elevators not fitted with braille or a voice transmission system, hampering accessibility for the visually-impaired.

The ministry said recommendations for improvement includ-

ed standardising the universal design policies and guidelines and built environment for the whole country; and establishing a team or universal design unit in the technical department of the local authority which is related to pro-consultation purposes.

Others were reviewing plans for the universal design development; monitoring of new development areas; drawing up an accessibility master plan for each local authority; and organising an accessibility awareness programme and accessibility audit workshop to collaborate with government agencies or NGOs twice a year.

## Consultant first person charged under new anti-stalking law

**SHAH ALAM:** A freelance event management consultant was charged in the Magistrate's Court here yesterday with stalking a female photographer, making him the first person to be charged under the new Section 507A (1) of the Penal Code.

Mohamad Safiq Rosli, 37, pleaded not guilty to the charge, which was read out before Magistrate Sasha Diana Sabtu.

He is alleged to have stalked the woman by repeatedly harassing her through three communications on his X (formerly Twitter) account last month.

Mohamad Safiq was charged with repeatedly harassing Acacia Mardiana Daud, 31, through the X app while using the account name "@sopert99" by sending three communications, in which he expressed his feelings for the woman on her X account "@ShaFoShizzle", which was read at a house in Shah Alam.

He is alleged to have committed the offence between 1.40am on July 15 and 5.58pm on July 21 despite knowing that the act was likely to cause distress, fear or alarm to Acacia Mardiana.

He faces imprisonment of up to three years or a fine, or both.

DPP Zilfinaz Abbas did not propose bail, taking into account that Mohamad Safiq had previously violated bail conditions for a case involving the same victim in the United Kingdom (UK).

Lawyer Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil, representing Mohamad Safiq, did not object.

According to Zilfinaz, the accused was supposed to appear in a court in the UK to explain breaching his bail last June 2 but he

fled to Malaysia, resulting in his name being blacklisted in the UK, Bernama reported.

"I was also instructed to send the accused for observation at the Forensic Psychiatry Unit of the Ulu Kinta Hospital.

"His family had also sent him to Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) for treatment and the hospital has issued a medical report on him," she said, adding that Mohamad Safiq has been warded at the psychiatric ward at HKL since July 17.

## Court allows protection order application

Meanwhile, lawyer Jason Wee, who is holding a watching brief for Acacia Mardiana, applied for a protection order for the woman to avoid further harassment by Mohamad Safiq.

"This order ought to be given to my client to avoid further harassment due to safety concerns. The accused flew to the UK to

continue such acts against the same victim.

"We humbly pray to restrain the accused from going anywhere near the victim and not to communicate by any means with the victim until the conclusion of this case," he said.

Sasha Diana allowed the

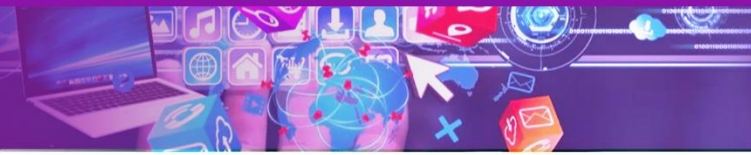
prosecution's request to refer the accused to Ulu Kinta Hospital and will set the bail amount on the accused after the hospital completes its observation of him.

The court also allowed Wee's application for a protection order and fixed Sept 7 for mention.

Through a recent post on Instagram, Acacia Mardiana said she

had been living in fear for eight years because of sexual harassment by a man on social media.

Her plight caught the attention of Communications and Digital Minister Fahmi Fadzil, who advised her to submit evidence, including police reports and screenshots, to the government's official email for further action.

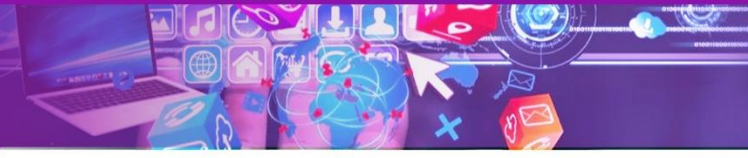
## Cops probe kindergarten abuse case

**KOTA KINABALU:** Two investigation papers have been opened under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001 to look into the abuse of a four-year-old boy by a kindergarten worker, 27, after a video of the incident was uploaded on social media recently.

Kota Kinabalu district police chief ACP Mohd Zaidi Abdullah said in a statement yesterday that police discovered a video of the incident and preliminary investigations revealed it occurred at a kindergarten in Luyang.

"Police have also received three reports - from the parents, kindergarten operator and the worker who claimed she was hit by the victim's parents. Both the victim and the suspect have been referred to the Queen Elizabeth II Hospital for checkups by doctors," he said.

## Juruwang mengaku tidak bersalah ke atas 16 pertuduhan pecah amanah

**KUCHING:** Seorang juruwang kanan pasar raya di sebuah pusat beli-belah di sini mengaku tidak bersalah apabila didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen semalam atas 16 pertuduhan pecah amanah membabitkan wang berjumlah RM21,700.

Tertuduh, Ivy Estivia Lita, 32, yang hadir ke mahkamah ditemani suaminya membuat pengakuan tersebut selepas kesemua 16 pertuduhan dibacakan terhadapnya di hadapan empat Hakim Mahkamah Sesyen berbeza.

Kesemua pertuduhan dibuat mengikut Seksyen 408 Kanun Keseksaan yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara minimum setahun dan maksimum 14 tahun serta denda jika sabit kesalahan.

Hakim Musli Ab Hamid, Hakim Saiful Bahari Adzmi dan Hakim Maris Agan masing-masing menetapkan pengurusan kes pada 11 September 2023 dan memberikan ikat jamin tunai RM1,000 berserta seorang penjamin

tempatan bagi setiap satu pertuduhan dihadapi tertuduh.

Sementara Hakim Afidah Abdul Rahman menetapkan tertuduh diberikan ikat jamin RM15,000 (tidak didepositkan) berserta dua penjamin tempatan beralamat tetap bagi empat pertuduhan dihadapinya.

Mahkamah juga memerintahkan tertuduh untuk melaporkan diri ke balai polis berdekatan sekali sebulan dan menyerahkan pasport kepada mahkamah.

Selain itu, tertuduh juga dinasihatkan oleh mahkamah untuk mendapatkan khidmat nasihat peguam sebelum atau pada tarikh sebutan kes berikutnya.

Mengikut kesemua pertuduhan, tertuduh dari tempoh 5 Januari 2023 sehingga 20 Februari 2023 telah membuat sejumlah 21 transaksi penambahan nilai yang membawa kepada jumlah RM21,700.

Kesalahan itu didakwa dilakukannya semasa bekerja di pasar raya di sebuah pusat

beli-belah tersebut yang terletak di Jalan Tun Ahmad Zaidi Adruce di sini.

Difahamkan, pegawai sumber manusia di pusat beli-belah tersebut mendapati terdapat penyalahgunaan duit syarikat dengan cara melakukan transaksi penambahan nilai ke dalam satu kad keahlian yang dikatakan di bawah nama Ivy.

Setelah semakan melalui sistem syarikat dibuat, pihak syarikat dikatakan mendapati tertuduh melakukan transaksi penambahan nilai ke dalam kad keahliannya untuk kegunaan sendiri, tanpa membuat bayaran kepada pihak syarikat.

Susulan itu, laporan polis dibuat yang seterusnya membawa kepada penangkapan tertuduh.
