Kes kanak-kanak mati di hospital

Bapa dakwa anak kena ikat ambil darah

Kuala Lumpur: Bapa kanak-kanak perempuan berusia 10 tahun, Dea Maisarah, mendakwa kecuai-an pihak hospital punca kematian anaknya ketika mendapatkan rawatan di Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR) di Klang pada Ahad lalu.

Melalui rakaman video di TikTok, Bada Hussein, menjelaskan kronologi hari kejadian bermula saat dia menerima panggilan isteri yang memaklumkan keadaan Dea sehingga detik anaknya itu diisytiharkan meninggal dunia di HTAR.

"Sebaik sampai di Hospital Tengku Ampuan Rahimah (HTAR) saya ambil nombor (giliran) dan bayar, lalu menunggu lebih kurang 40 hingga 45 minit.

"Selepas itu, dia (pihak hospital) suruh saya ke zon kanak-kanak di sebelah kecemasan. Sampai di sana (zon kanak-kanak), saya menunggu lagi dalam 20 minit macam tu, lama juga.

"Apabila tiba giliran anak saya, pihak hospital mula periksa degupan jantung, mereka tengok tahap oksigen dalam darah.

"Di situ mereka mula kelam-

kabut sebab oksigen dalam darah memang tak cukup. Mula-mula saya tengok tahap oksigen Dea jadi 90, 80, 70 macam tu," jelasnya melalui rakaman video itu.

Bada berkata, melihat tahap kesihatan Dea yang semakin merosot, pihak hospital kelam-kabut dan terus meletakkan anaknya di atas katil untuk rawatan susulan.

"Masa itu mereka ada juga berikan alat bantuan pernafasan, selepas itu mereka cuba ambil darah. Anak saya fobia sikit dengan jarum akibat selalu kena cucuk waktu kecil sebab penyakit kuning.

"Akibatnya dia meronta-ronta dan Dea diikat. Sudahlah diikat, Dea diserkap lagi, dipegang lagi semata-mata untuk mendapatkan darah. Anak saya meronta-ronta terus dan meminta tolong daripada saya.

"Sehingga seorang doktor menyampuk berkata, kalau kamu

bekerjasama, kami tak akan buat macam tu," katanya sambil mempersoalkan kewajaran seorang doktor berkata demikian dalam keadaan anaknya diikat.

Selepas beberapa kali dipaksa pihak hospital untuk mengambil darah, Bada mendakwa degupan jantung anaknya terhenti dan tidak lama selepas itu, dia diarahkan keluar daripada bilik rawatan, namun berkeras untuk masuk semula.

ra-pura buat itu dan buat ini, kononnya bekerja. Sebenarnya anak saya dah lama meninggal," katanya.

Kematian Dea tular di media sosial selepas kanak-kanak itu didakwa lewat diberikan rawatan minit sebelum mengalami sesak nafas, selain terpaksa diikat kerana meronta.

Dakwa buat laporan palsu

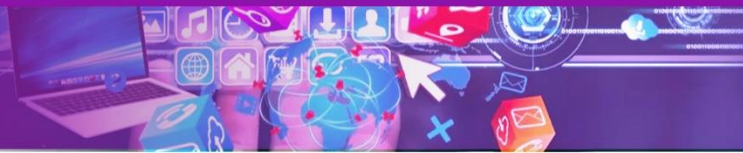
Pihak hospital juga didakwa membuat laporan palsu berhubung kematian kanak-kanak itu dengan mengatakan mangsa sudah meninggal ketika dihantar untuk mendapatkan rawatan.

HTAR dalam kenyataan balas memaklumkan pihaknya akan menjalankan siasatan berhubung kematian kanak-kanak itu.

Pengarahnya, Dr Zulkarnain Mohd Rawi, dilapor berkata ketika mendapatkan rawatan kanak-kanak itu dalam keadaan lemah dan diberikan rawatan sewajarnya oleh Pakar Perubatan Kecemasan, namun tidak dapat diselamatkan.

Dalam pada itu, Menteri Kesihatan, Dr Zaliha Mustafa, mengesahkan kes kematian Dea ketika mendapatkan rawatan di HTAR Ahad lalu kini disiasat pihak berkuasa dan memohon kerjasama semua pihak untuk menghormati privasi keluarga kanak-kanak terbabit.

Beliau berkata, kementerian bersimpati dan menyampaikan ucapan takziah kepada keluarga Allahyarhamah Dea Maisarah.

Polis selamatkan 5 remaja asing jadi buruh paksa

Klang: Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah (JSJ) Bukit Aman menyelamatkan lima remaja bawah umur warga asing yang dipercayai dieksploitasi sebagai buruh paksa dalam serbuan di sebuah kilang barangan lusuh dan terpakai di Kampung Jawa di sini, petang kelmarin.

Serbuan jam 4 petang itu dilakukan hasil risikan Bahagian Antipemerdagangan Orang dan Penyeludupan Migran (ATIPSOM), D3, JSJ Bukit Aman, bersama Pasukan Khas Majlis Anti Pemerdagangan Orang (MAPO) Kementerian Dalam Negeri dan Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Klang Selatan.

Ketua Penolong Pengarah D3 ATIPSOM, JSJ Bukit Aman, Senior Asisten Komisioner Fadil Marsus, berkata lima remaja yang diselamatkan membabit-

kan tiga perempuan dan dua remaja lelaki warga asing berusia 14 hingga 17 tahun.

"Siasatan awal mendapati, mereka bekerja di kilang berkenaan sejak enam bulan lalu dan dibayar RM50 sehari.

"Seramai 72 warga asing ditahan atas pelbagai kesalahan Imigresen seperti tidak memiliki dokumen perjalanan sah serta menyalahgunakan pas permit kerja," katanya kepada *BH*, semalam.

Fadil berkata, warga asing yang ditahan merangkumi 28 lelaki warga Myanmar, 12 lelaki warga Bangladesh, empat lelaki warga China dan seorang lelaki warga India serta dua wanita warga Myanmar dan seorang wanita warga China

"Fokus operasi ialah menge-

nal pasti mangsa pemerdagangan orang berpandukan Garis Panduan Nasional Mengenai Indikator Pemerdagangan. Orang (NGHTI) yang dibangunkan untuk membantu agensi penguat kuasa," katanya.

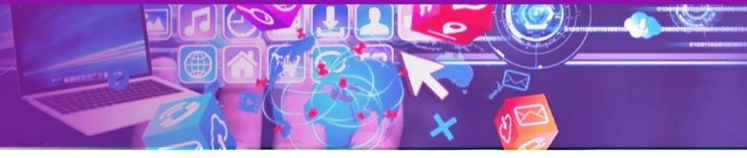
Beliau berkata, tiga lelaki warga China berusia 36 hingga 37 tahun turut ditangkap disyaki berperanan sebagai pengurus dan pembantu pengurus kilang.

"Kilang yang diserbu dipercayai beroperasi secara haram kira-kira setahun manakala mangsa dan semua tangkapan warga asing adalah pekerja kilang itu.

"Kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 14 ATIPSOM 2007, Seksyen 6(1)(c) dan Seksyen 55B Akta Imigresen 1959/63 serta Peraturan 39(b) Peraturan-peraturan Imigresen 1963," katanya.

Kementerian Belia dan Sukan (KBS) melancarkan Sekolah Rukun Negara iaitu inisiatif terkini kementerian itu menerusi Rakan Muda (Rakan Demokrasi) bertujuan menyemarakkan kefahaman dan pengetahuan demokrasi politik dalam kalangan belia.

Timbalan Menteri Belia dan Sukan, Adam Adli Abd Halim berkata, 16,759 peserta percubaan daripada pelbagai latar belakang menyertai program bermula 6 Mei hingga Jun bagi percubaan modul yang diselenggarakan Institut Pembangunan dan Kecemerlangan Kepimpinan (i-LEAD).

Menurutnya, tahun ini kementerian menyoalakan 60,000 peserta program secara bersempena dan dalam masa sama sasaran secara pendigitalan menerusi media sosial ialah sembilan juta belia seluruh negara menerusi pelbagai platform kendalian i-LEAD KBS seperti TikTok, Facebook (FB) dan Youtube.

Katanya, setakat ini sasaran secara pendigitalan menerusi 2.1 juta capaian di

media sosial.

"Program Sekolah Rukun Negara ini percuma, terbuka kepada semua. Ia terbahagi kepada tiga tahap, iaitu asas setengah hari, pertengahan tiga hari dua malam manakala bagi program tahap lanjutan adalah empat hari tiga malam.

"Program secara bersempena dilaksana di 18 Kem Wawasan Negara di seluruh Malaysia. Sasaran penyertaan belia berumur 15 hingga 30 tahun khususnya bagi mereka yang mencapai umur 18 berikutan pindaan had umur

mengundi pada 2019.

Sebanyak 12 perkara ditekankan ialah falsafah kenegaraan, pilihan raya, media dan akses maklumat, seni dan budaya, pentadbiran am, kerajaan tempatan, kesaksamaan gender, parti politik, institusi kehakiman, masyarakat sivil dan institusi parlimen.

Tahap asas hanya lebih kepada meningkatkan pengetahuan tentang 12 perkara, tahap pertengahan peserta didedahkan secara mendalam tentang 12 perkara dan tahap lanjutan peserta tidak

hanya berada di dalam kelas, tetapi terlibat secara fizikal seperti hadir ke dewan parlimen serta menyumbang kepada masyarakat berdasarkan 12 perkara tersebut.

Beliau berkata demikian selepas merasmikan pelancaran Sekolah Rukun Negara, di Dewan Panggung Seni, Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) di sini yang turut mendapat kerjasama daripada mahasiswa Persatuan Sejarah, Sains Politik dan Strategik (PESEPSI).

Pelajar dan Alumni) UKM Prof Madya Dr Mohd Suzeren Md Jamil dan Ketua Pengarah i-LEAD Mohd Haswandi Ahmad.

Adam Adli berkata, Program Sekolah Rukun Negara dibangunkan seawal Januari lalu dan mendapat pandangan pihak berkepentingan termasuk sesi libat urus semua parti politik dan beberapa pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO).

"Sesi libat urus yang sangat banyak dan pembangunan modul pada waktu itu kita harapkan dapat diteliti dengan baik.

"Kini akhirnya Program Sekolah Rukun Negara dilancarkan ke seluruh negara secara program tetap. Ertinya akan jadi satu daripada program *flagship* di bawah program Rakan Muda Rakan Demokrasi.

"Ia menjadi program na-

sional untuk menjawab terutama persoalan mengenai bagaimana kita nak lakukan perihwal literasi politik dalam kalangan belia negara. Kita harap banyak pihak lain beri kerjasama daripada semasa ke semasa," katanya.

Beliau berkata, program itu tidak membabitkan elemen doktrinasi oleh mana-mana parti politik.

the department received a distress call at 7.13am.

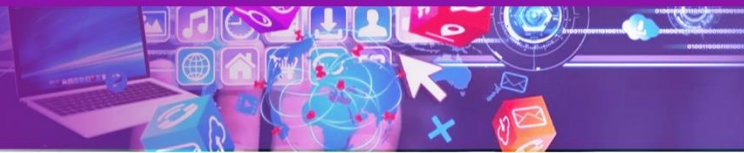

MINISTRY INVESTIGATES GIRL'S DEATH AT HOSPITAL

Hospital director says 10-year-old was weak, treated at emergency unit

THE Health Ministry said it is investigating the death of a 10-year-old girl at Tengku Ampuan Rahimah Hospital (HTAR) in Klang.

Its minister, Dr Zaliha Mustafa confirmed this in a Facebook post and extended her condolences to the family of Dea Maisarah Bada.

"The incident is being investigated by the authorities.

"I would like to appeal to all parties to respect the privacy of the family (of Dea Maisarah).

"Let us pray for her soul to receive the blessings and be under the protection of Allah.

"May the family of Allahyarhamah remain strong in facing such a difficult time."

A video clip that went viral showed Dea Maisarah's father claiming that the girl died at the hospital as she was struggling when her blood was being drawn by medical staff.

The girl was taken to the hospital on July 9 for fever and flu.

HTAR confirmed in a statement that it had initiated an investigation into the death of Dea Maisarah.

Its director, Dr Zulkarnain Mohd Rawi, said the girl was weak when she arrived at the hospital's emergency department and was treated by specialists.

He added that the hospital's forensic department was investigating the cause of the girl's death.

From a wild child to a golden heart

Former rebel Chew now helps others reform

JOHOR BARU: As a teenager, Chew Kuan Yuan wanted to be popular in school so he started to get involved in gangsterism and dabbled in drugs.

Living a carefree life as a 14-year-old back then, he did not see anything wrong getting involved in numerous gang fights and other illegal activities.

He almost died and was badly injured during several bloody fights. However, his days of being wild came to an abrupt end when he was arrested at the age of 16 and sent for rehabilitation for two years.

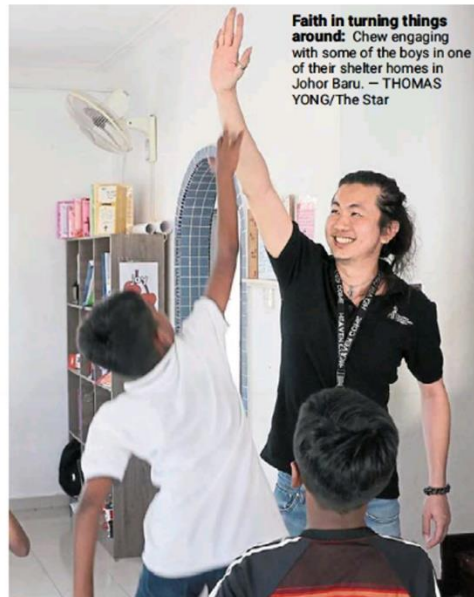
Now 37, the father of four has turned over a new leaf and is overseeing the Pusat Kobajikan Kalvari (PKK), a shelter home that looks after more than 450 destitute residents, comprising drug addicts, homeless people, abandoned children, old folks, mentally challenged and abused victims statewide.

"I never expected that one day, I would be serving and leading the very same place that gave me a new beginning when I was a young and restless teenager," he said in an interview.

Recalling his troubled past, Chew, who is affectionately known as Athens among his peers, said it all started when he joined a gang while in Form 2, hoping to be popular with the girls.

"In the process, I was led astray, dabbling in drugs such as Ecstasy, ice, ketamine and cannabis," he said, adding that he would party almost every night and doze off while in school.

Chew added that he only managed to continue his studies until Form 3.

"I remember my parents were very worried and had advised me to leave the bad company, but to no avail. All this went on for about two years before I was caught and sent for rehabilitation at a care centre," he said, adding that initially, it did not work out as he attempted to escape twice.

Chew said the rehab programmes were not easy for him since he was addicted to drugs and that he was among the youngest residents at the PKK home in Labis.

"Going through rehab is very difficult and a painful journey.

"Because of my mischief, I was often kept in solitary confinement and also got caned.

"Eventually, I persevered and no longer had the urge to run away and started adapting to life in the centre," he said.

Along the way, Chew picked up new skills, including learning to play the guitar and art.

"Slowly, I put in more effort to change for the better and over time, the centre's supervisors started to give me bigger responsibilities," he said.

Chew said when he turned 18, he was released from the rehab centre and rejoined society.

Going back to his family, he tried to further his studies via private tutors but did not do well.

He then found a job in an IT company, earning about RM1,700 per month.

"During my free time, I played guitar at the Calvary Community Church. Later, I quit my job and took up the position of a full-time clerk with the church which included taking charge of the

media unit," he said.

In 2018, Chew said, the PKK senior management appointed him vice-president and then chief operating officer in April last year.

"At present, I oversee 19 homes with a workforce of 52 workers," he said, adding that 99% of their workers were those who have been rehabilitated and are now using their skills to rehabilitate and help others.

He said PKK has grown over the past 34 years and needed about RM300,000 monthly to run its operations.

"We are blessed to receive continuous assistance from the public," he said, adding that during the recent floods, their residents and volunteers reached out to help those affected in Chaah.

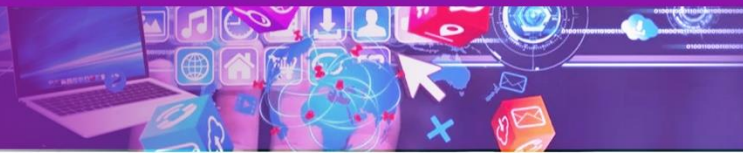
Chew also said one of the biggest challenges they faced was after the Covid-19 pandemic when more people, especially the elderly, were abandoned and also young people getting involved in drugs.

"We have had cases of people being left by the roadside or youths facing depression. We try our best to help as many as we can."

He added that their rehab programme was usually two years to help addicts to kick the habit.

Despite the tedious work, which requires a lot of attention, patience and perseverance, Chew said he and his team were satisfied with the impact and end results.

"Some of these abandoned children have now become successful including one studying medicine, another working as a pilot while a few others managed to reconcile with their families after kicking their addiction," he said.

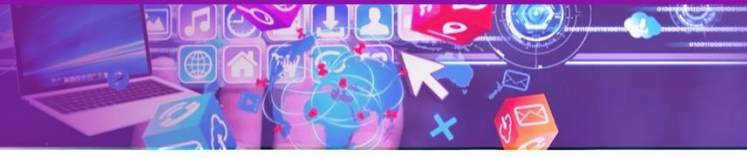

Woman fakes extortion to hide payment to scammers

AMPANG: Instead of coming clean, a woman created a fake story of extortion and corrupt cops to hide a payment to suspected scammers.

On June 22, the woman lodged a police report with Ampang Jaya police, claiming that she had been extorted by two policemen.

In her report, she told the police that the so-called extortion occurred on June 20 in Bandar Baru Ampang, where she was told by the "policemen" that she had

been involved in a criminal case and had to pay RM25,000 if she wanted to be released. However, discrepancies were found, and on July 12, the police arrested the woman at the Ampang Jaya police headquarters on suspicion of filing a fake police report.

"The police also seized the original report lodged and three bank receipts, dated June 20.

"Questioning conducted led to the discovery that the suspect had filed the fake report because she chose not to be honest with her husband regarding the pawning of gold on June 20.

"It is believed that the money gained was then paid to a party that we believed to be scammers," Ampang Jaya OCPD Asst Comm Mohd Azam Ismail said. He added that she had been granted police bail following two days of police remand.

In an unrelated case, three suspected home burglars were arrested after CCTV footage caught them in the act.

On June 14, the complainant was told by his relative that his house in Taman Cheras Indah had been robbed.

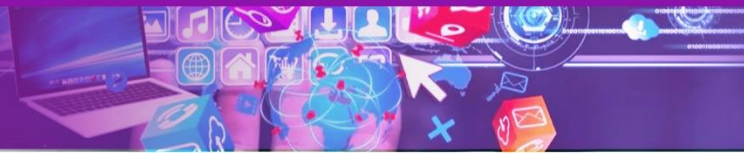
CCTV footage obtained by a

neighbour showed three men leaving the suspect's home via the back door. They were spotted carrying a red package.

When the complainant returned home, he found that several pieces of jewellery were missing and losses were estimated to be around RM5,000.

Following investigations into the case, three Myanmar nationals were arrested on July 13.

The three men, aged 29 to 31 years old, confessed to committing around 15 home burglaries within the Ampang area and have been remanded until July 19.

She said Rakan Demokrasi would not only inform them of their right to vote but also educate them on the election process.

“The right to cast their ballot has been given but it can be difficult without education as we are concerned that they may not know what to do regarding the polling process and the like.

“We have done a lot on this, especially via online content, to improve the understanding and awareness of youths on the system of democracy,” she said.

She was crowned by outgoing Miss Petite Global Borneo 2022, Alya Abdul.

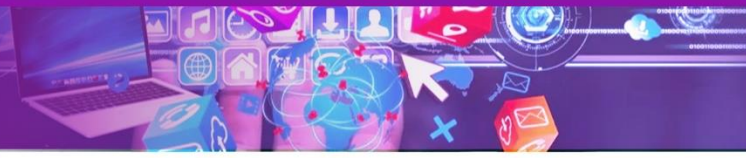
Lee received RM2,500 and also picked up the Miss Beautiful Body and Best Catwalk subsidiary awards.

Woman Kayan paramount chief strives to bring about changes in community

THE roles of Orang Ulu women in today's society have changed tremendously over the years, with several of them having taken the non-traditional roles through active participation in politics, economy as well as in non-governmental organisations (NGOs).

One of them is Temengong Elizabeth Deng, who has brought pride not only to her family but also the whole community through her active participation in many areas, mostly in championing the rights of women through her social work with local NGO, Doh Kayan Telang Usan (DKTU).

Elizabeth, now 63, created history when she became the first woman Orang Ulu Pemana in 2012; thus, breaking the old tradition in her community where such a position would only be accorded to men.

"When I first received my appointment letter as Pemana, I did not reject it – truly believing that I could do the job.

"After about a year and a half, I received an offer – this time to become the next Temengong for the Kayan community.

"I declined the offer at first because I thought I had just started out my term as a Pemana," she said in an interview conducted in Miri recently.

Several months had gone by when she later received a call, still regarding the proposed appointment for her to be next Kayan Temengong.

It was then when Elizabeth felt that she could no longer decline such offer.

"I took up the position as the paramount chief for the Kayans on July 20, 2014, with my community's best interest in my heart.

"I just wanted to bring about changes in my community in particular, and the society at large," she said.

Despite being the first Orang Ulu woman to be appointed as Temengong and thus, breaking the man-dominated tradition in her society, Elizabeth said she did not face any backlash or criticism from her community.

She said 'surprisingly', she had been receiving support from them, which had enabled her to continue her second

term as Temengong.

"Prior to my appointment as Pemana and subsequently, as Temengong, there were not many Orang Ulu women being actively involved in politics, economy and in NGOs.

"But today, we can see many Orang Ulu women taking up the non-traditional roles, either as leaders in society, heads of government departments, and also a number of them becoming successful entrepreneurs.

"All these have been made possible because of the Sarawak government's all-inclusive policy that includes women, including our Orang Ulu women, in politics, economy as well as other social sectors," she said.

However, Elizabeth said she would still want to see better recognition being given to women.

"Although there are already some Orang Ulu women holding high positions in society and across various agencies and departments, I do hope that better recognition would be accorded to deserving women."

According to the DKTU chairperson, there are many strong, intelligent and eloquent Orang Ulu women who are still not getting the equal opportunities in either serving at grassroots and community leadership levels, or holding high positions in both the government and the private sectors.

"While we see more and more Orang Ulu women getting actively involved in politics, economy and social sectors nowadays, actually we are still underrepresented.

"Therefore, we hope to see more Orang Ulu women coming out of their comfort zone and being ready to contribute towards the development of not just their community, but the state as well," she said.

Elizabeth was confident that under the leadership of Premier of Sarawak Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg, women, especially those from the Orang Ulu group, would continue to gain recognition and be given equal opportunities in politics, economy as well as in other fields.

Wong yang berkunjung ke pejabat syarikat utiliti itu di Bintangor, agak terkejut apabila melihat kaunter pembayaran ditutup walaupun mempunyai kakitangan yang bertugas.

“Kakitangan ada di sana tetapi pengunjung diberitahu untuk membuat pembayaran menggunakan kios yang disediakan. Ini agak membingungkan,” katanya.

Walaupun tidak menolak penggunaan kios itu, Wong berpendapat adalah perlu untuk memberi pertimbangan terhadap keperluan warga emas.

Sehubungan itu beliau menyeru pihak terbabit membenarkan pelanggan terutama warga emas untuk membuat bayaran di kaunter yang ada.

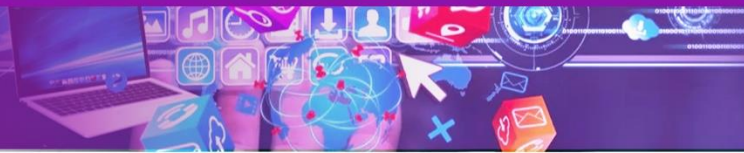
dan persekitaran baharu, serta rakan-rakannya di sini kelmarin.

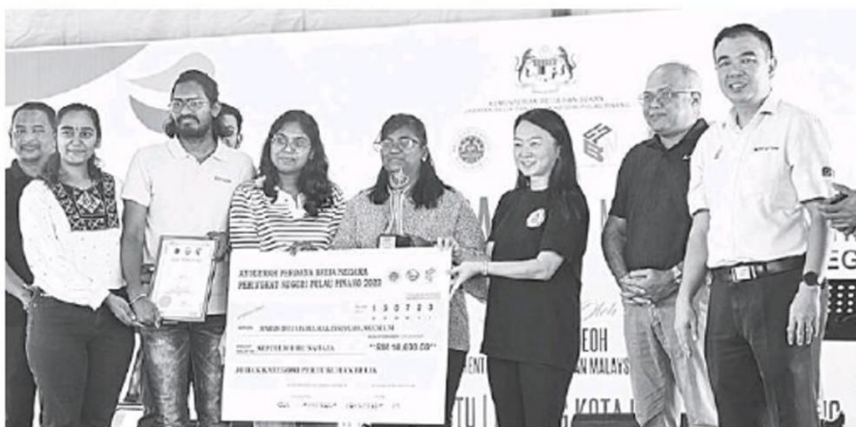
Laporan polis kes gangguan seksual jurulatih dodgeball telah dibuat: Hannah

sekolah rendah.

Presiden Persatuan Dodgeball Malaysia (MAD) Datuk V. Radhakrishnan dilaporkan berkata pihaknya menerima aduan daripada Biro Kokurikulum Persatuan Ibu Bapa dan Guru (PIBG) sekolah berkenaan dan akan membuat pertemuan dengan Hannah bagi membincangkan pelaksanaan kod sukan selamat dengan lebih terperinci.

Radhakrishnan dilapor-

kan berkata tindakan tidak bormal itu jelas memberi impak negatif kepada sukan dodgeball, malah secara tidak langsung akan memberi kesan kepada ibu bapa untuk membabitkan anak-anak mereka dengan aktiviti sukan di sekolah.

Sementara itu, Hannah berkata menerusi inisiatif Rakan Muda iaitu gaya hidup Rakan Demokrasi, pihaknya sedang menjalankan beberapa

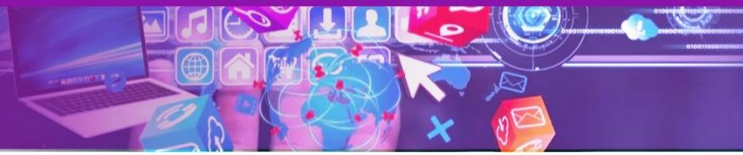
projek bagi menyemarakkan kefahaman dan pengetahuan demokrasi terutama menjelang Pilihan Raya Negeri (PRN) terhadap golongan muda.

Katanya menerusi Rakan Demokrasi itu, mereka bukan sahaja diberi maklumat tentang hak keluar mengundi tetapi juga pendidikan tentang pilihan raya dan proses mengundi supaya golongan berkenaan tahu apa yang perlu dilakukan.

“Hak untuk mereka keluar mengundi telah diberikan, namun kalau hak itu tanpa pendidikan agak susah juga, sebab kita bimbang mereka tidak tahu apa nak buat dengan proses pengundian dan sebagainya ... ini yang kita banyak jalankan terutama kandungan dalam talian supaya mereka mendapat maklumat yang betul berikutan objektif utama program ini adalah untuk meningkatkan kesedaran dan kefahaman golongan belia tentang sistem demokrasi,” katanya.

Terdahulu dalam ucapannya, Hannah turut mengumumkan peruntukan sebanyak RM500,000 dana sukan komuniti untuk disalurkan kepada kumpulan belia di negeri ini menerusi Jabatan Belia dan Sukan Negeri (JBSN) Pulau Pinang pada tahun ini.

“Sempena Sambutan Hari Belia Negeri Pulau Pinang, saya telah mengumumkan dana sukan komuniti sebanyak RM500,000 dan mana-mana kumpulan belia yang perlukan dana untuk aktiviti dan program sukan, mereka boleh mohon dengan JBSN Pulau Pinang,” katanya. — Bernama

Pembinaan pusat hemodialisis pemangkin penjagaan kesihatan warga FELDA

KUALA NERANG: Inisiatif kerajaan untuk membina pusat hemodialisis di semua wilayah FELDA, disifatkan mampu menjadi pemangkin kepada penjagaan kesihatan warga peneroka.

Ketua Peneroka FELDA Lubuk Merbau Mat bin Awang Saad berkata pembinaan pusat tersebut, dilihat sebagai salah satu infrastruktur penting kepada warga FELDA untuk mendapatkan penjagaan kesihatan dengan mudah.

“Kami warga peneroka memerlukan sebuah pusat hemodialisis, pada masa ini ada pesakit buah pinggang di FELDA ini yang tinggal dengan anak-anak mereka di pekan untuk dekat dengan klinik atau hospital, malah ada yang terpaksa menyewa rumah supaya senang berulang-alik ke klinik atau pusat hemodialisis swasta.

“Dengan adanya pusat itu nanti, ia akan memudahkan urusan warga FELDA untuk mendapatkan rawatan dan tentunya akan dapat mengurangkan perbelanjaan mereka berbanding sebelum ini,” katanya kepada Bernama di sini.

Bagi peneroka FELDA Osman Awang, 81, berkata inisiatif itu menunjukkan kerajaan benar-benar prihatin terhadap tahap kesihatan warga FELDA dan mengambil berat nasib mereka.

Beliau turut mengalu-alukan pengumuman kerajaan, untuk menanggung perbelanjaan kos operasi bagi 37,012 lampu jalan di tanah rancangan FELDA seluruh negara.

“Kita juga minta tambahan 40 lampu jalan lagi, terutama dari Kampung Berjaya dan Kampung Kura ke tempat kami, serta di lima simpang jalan kampung yang tentunya

akan dapat meningkatkan tahap keselamatan penduduk,” katanya yang turut memberitahu sehingga kini terdapat lebih 100 lampu jalan di FELDA Lubuk Merbau.

Sementara itu, peneroka di FELDA yang sama Anuar Rahim, 58, yang merupakan generasi kedua FELDA, meminta kerajaan turut menangani isu perparitan di kawasan FELDA itu, yang menurut beliau masih belum lengkap.

“Longkang juga menjadi masalah, kerana ada di sesetengah tempat tidak dibuat menyeluruh dan apabila hujan lebat air rumah ditenggelami air. Selain itu kami juga minta dinaik taraf pekan Lubuk Merbau agar lebih tersusun dan lengkap, dengan kemudahan lain yang akan mencantikkan kawasan,” katanya.

Pada 7 Julai, Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim mengumumkan beberapa inisiatif dan insentif, bagi meningkatkan kualiti hidup dan memelihara kebajikan warga FELDA, termasuk dalam aspek penyediaan infrastruktur, penjagaan kesihatan, pendigitalan dan perumahan.

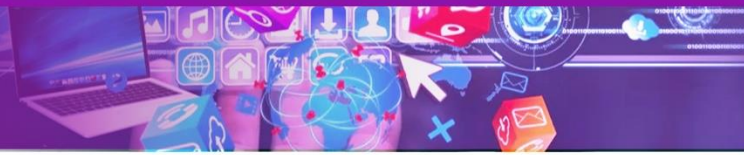

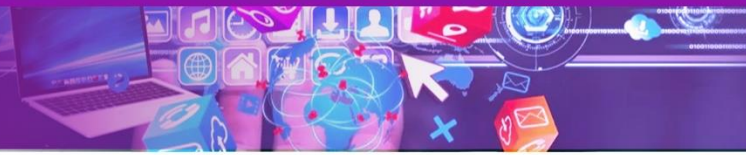

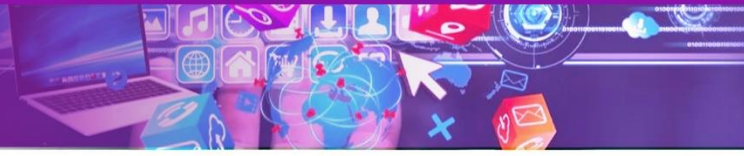
