Hasil jualan barangan kitar semula biayai pengajian

Tanjung Malim: Seorang ibu tunggal menggunakan hasil pendapatan daripada jualan minyak masak terpakai yang dibeli daripada suri rumah, peniaga dan restoran serta jualan barangan kitar semula untuk membiayai pengajiannya di peringkat sarjana.

Ternyata usaha itu tidak sia-sia, malah lebih menarik. Habibah Yaacob turut membuktikan walaupun sudah mencecah usia 60 tahun beliau berjaya menggenggam Ijazah Sarjana Pengurusan sempena Majlis Konvokesyen Open University Malaysia (OUM) Ke-27 di Dewan Merdeka Pusat Dagangan Dunia Kuala Lumpur (WTCKL), baru-baru ini.

Habibah berkata, dia mengikuti pengajian di Fakulti Pengurusan dan Perniagaan selama dua tahun secara pengajian jarak jauh (PJJ) dan memperoleh purata nilai gred kumulatif (CGPA) 3.69 di OUM cawangan Tanjung Malim.

Beliau berkata, tiada yang mustahil dan mampu dicapai jika ada kemahuan dan berharap ia juga boleh menjadi motivasi kepada golongan muda yang belum atau ingin menyambung pengajian pada peringkat berkenaan, turut melakukannya.

Katanya, setiap kejayaan sudah tentu memerlukan pengor-

banan terutama memabatkan masa dan wang ringgit, namun tidak menjadi halangan untuk mencipta kejayaan.

"Saya bersyukur dan berterima kasih kepada tenaga pengajar termasuk pensyarah yang banyak memberi motivasi serta bimbingan.

"Kejayaan ini juga membuk-

akan usia atau status ibu tunggal bukan halangan untuk mencipta kejayaan dalam kehidupan," katanya.

Beliau berkata, hasil kepayahan mengumpul wang usaha tulang empat kerat dapat membiayai yuran pengajian RM24,000.

Nenek lima cucu ini berkata, sepanjang pengajian beliau ter-

paksa membahagikan masa kerja rutin harian termasuk jual beli minyak masak terpakai, selain barangan kitar semula serta aktiviti sukarelawan.

"Hasil jual beli berkenaan disimpan secara jimat cermat kemudian digunakan untuk membiayai sepanjang pengajian di universiti terbabit.

"Memang kadangkala agak sukar mengharungi kehidupan sebagai pelajar pada usia sebegini apatah lagi ibu tunggal, tetapi berkat kegigihan saya dan sokongan anak, akhirnya berjaya.

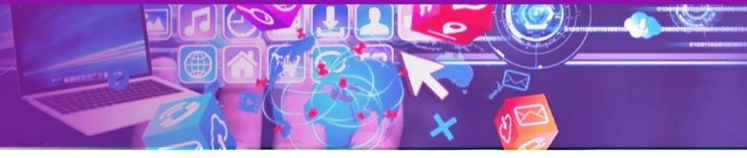
"Kejayaan ini sekali gus memberi motivasi pada diri saya dan berhasrat menyambung pengajian pada peringkat Ijazah Doktor Falsafah (PhD) pada masa akan datang," katanya.

Pandang sinis

Beliau berkata, walaupun ada segelintir individu yang pandang sinis dengan usaha berkenaan, namun sesekali tidak akan luntur semangat meneruskan pengajian pada peringkat yang lebih tinggi.

Setiap orang mempunyai pilihan atau hak untuk membahagikan diri masing-masing dengan cara tersendiri dan dia memilih cara demikian untuk mencipta kejayaan dalam kehidupan.

Di samping itu, dalam kesibukan rutin seharian, beliau juga aktif dalam aktiviti sukarelawan dan kemasyarakatan sebagai Ketua Biro Aktiviti Pasukan Komunitasi untuk Perubahan Tingkah Laku (COMBI) Perak dan Pengerusi COMBI Daerah Muallim termasuk mengurus Pusat Pembelajaran dan Pengisian Barang Kitar Semula (3R) di Taman Bandar dekat Tanjung Malim.

Ujian personaliti bantu kanak-kanak pilih kerjaya

Elak ibu bapa paksa, tentukan bidang diceburi bimbang anak alami kemurungan

Kuala Lumpur: Kanak-kanak seawal usia muda digalakkan mengambil ujian psikometrik bagi menentukan personaliti kerjaya mereka supaya mereka tahu hala tuju masa hadapan.

Ujian itu juga dapat membantu mengelakkan ibu bapa menentukan atau memaksa jenis kerjaya yang mereka mahukan berbanding anak mereka minat.

Ini kerana, jika ibu bapa me-

netapkan apa mereka inginkan, bimbang anak akur dalam keadaan terpaksa, sekali gus boleh menyebabkan mereka kemurungan kerana memendam perasaan.

Pakar Psikologi dan Kaunseling Universiti Pendidikan Sultan Idris (UPSI), Prof Madya Dr Fauziah Mohd Saad, berkata tidak dapat dinafikan, kebanyakan ibu bapa di Malaysia suka menentukan kerjaya anak.

Malah katanya, ada ibu bapa didakwa memaksa anak sejak dari kecil untuk 'bekerja' seperti menjadi penyanyi, berlakon menjadi model kerana berasakan ia kerjaya yang menguntungkan.

"Bagi anak yang sudah dipatenkan kerjaya mereka oleh ibu bapa sejak kecil, jika mereka memang minat dalam bidang itu ia tidak akan menjadi satu masalah, malah ramai dilihat sudah berjaya dalam bidang masing-masing.

"Namun, jika sebenarnya tidak

minat, mereka sudah pasti akan merasa tertekan dan akan menjadi masalah kerana jika dipendam, ia boleh menyebabkan kemurungan," katanya.

Beliau berkata, anak yang tidak suka dengan tindakan ibu bapa yang memaksa mereka akan bermula dengan masalah kerisauan terlebih dahulu.

Namun katanya, akibat terlalu memendam perasaan, ia akan bertukar kepada kemurungan, malah ada yang sehingga mempunyai keinginan untuk membunuh diri kerana tidak tahan dengan kehidupan.

"Oleh itu, anak ini perlu mendapatkan bantuan yang bersesuaian dan jika mereka ada masalah kerisauan boleh berjumpa dengan rakan, ahli keluarga atau mereka yang boleh dipercayai untuk berkongsi perasaan.

"Jika mereka terus memendam perasaan bimbang akan berakhir dengan kemurungan, sekali gus boleh merosakkan masa

hadapan mereka.

"Selain itu, mereka perlu juga mendapat bimbingan sewajarnya dengan mendapatkan bantuan daripada pakar atau kaunselor bagi mengurangkan tekanan yang dialami," katanya.

Buat ujian psikometrik

Justeru Fauziah berkata, anak digalakkan mengambil ujian psikometrik bersesuaian sejak dari usia muda yang dapat menentukan personaliti kerjaya yang bersesuaian dengan mereka.

Katanya, ibu bapa juga perlu akur dengan kerjaya pilihan anak kerana ia adalah untuk masa depan mereka.

"Kesedaran kerjaya anak perlu bermula seawal usia tujuh tahun lagi supaya mereka tahu apa jenis kerjaya yang ada dan apa yang mereka mahu.

"Ketika usia awal apabila ditanya kepada mereka cita-cita, mereka hanya mampu menjawab mahu menjadi ahli bomba, polis

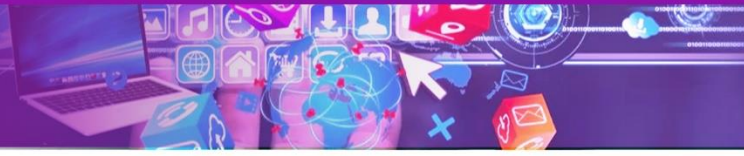

dan guru sahaja kerana pendedahan kerjaya yang masih kurang," katanya.

Oleh itu beliau mencadangkan supaya murid di sekolah dibawa melawat tempat yang dapat memberikan pendedahan kerjaya selain diberikan lebih maklumat mengenai peluang kerjaya yang ada.

Selain itu katanya, mereka juga digalakkan mengambil ujian minat kerjaya yang dapat membantu hala tuju yang tepat untuk kerjaya mereka di masa hadapan.

Kuala Lumpur: Perumahan khusus bagi warga emas perlu dibangunkan di Kuala Lumpur memandangkan bandar raya ini dijangka menjadi bandar menua menjelang 2040, demikian menurut Pelan Struktur Kuala Lumpur 2040 (PSKL2040).

PSKL2040 menjangkakan jumlah penduduk warga emas adalah lebih tinggi iaitu 17.3 peratus pada 2040 berbanding 9.2 peratus pada 2025.

Menurut PSKL2040, pembinaan rumah khusus bagi warga emas yang digalakkan termasuk rumah persaraan bagi kehidupan berdikari, rumah persaraan lengkap bantuan perubatan serta rumah penjagaan warga emas.

"Ini membolehkan war-

ga emas hidup berdikari dengan penyediaan kemudahan khusus untuk membantu mereka hidup sendiri. Bagaimanapun, kesesuaian rumah persaraan dengan bantuan perubatan di kawasan kediaman perlu dikaji dengan terperinci," menurut dokumen itu.

Pembangunan rumah khusus bagi warga emas digalakkan untuk dijual, dipajak atau disewa kepada golongan ini dan pembangunannya boleh sama ada di dalam zon kediaman atau perdagangan dengan mengambil kira kesesuaian semasa.

Kawasan perumahan yang mempunyai komuniti persaraan yang ramai juga digalakkan untuk menyediakan ruang sosial dan kemudahan awam yang bersesuaian.

Selain itu, rumah persaraan perlu dilengkapi kemudahan mengambil

kira prinsip asas reka bentuk sejagat seperti kelengkapan mesra warga emas termasuk alat amaran kecemasan dan keselamatan bagi membolehkan warga emas hidup selesa berdasarkan kemampuan fizikal tanpa bantuan.

Bagi rumah penjagaan

"Ini membolehkan warga emas hidup berdikari dengan penyediaan kemudahan khusus untuk membantu mereka hidup sendiri. Bagaimanapun, kesesuaian rumah persaraan dengan bantuan perubatan di kawasan kediaman perlu dikaji dengan terperinci"

warga emas, Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL) perlu menyediakan garis panduan terperinci bagi perancangan dan reka bentuknya dan ia perlu selari garis panduan daripada agensi berkaitan bagi memartabatkan kesejahteraan warga emas.

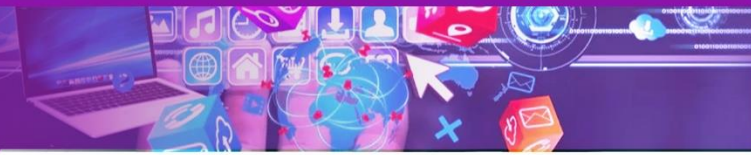

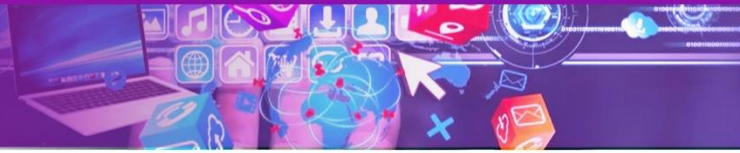

Seorang wanita yang bekerja sebagai pembuat roti canai tidak hanya disamun dan dirogol, malah mangsa turut dibunuh sebelum mayatnya ditemui di dalam kawasan semak berhampiran kebun pisang di Kampung Pisang, di sini.

Lebih menyedihkan apabila wanita warga asing berusia 36 tahun itu ditemui dalam keadaan separuh bogel oleh ahli keluarganya jam 8.15 pagi kelmarin.

Ketua Polis Daerah Lahad Datu, Asisten Komisioner Rohan Shah Ahmad berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan berhubung penemuan mayat itu pada jam 8.26 pagi.

Katanya, siasatan awal di lokasi kejadian mendapati mayat mangsa ditemui ahli keluarganya pada jarak kira-kira 600 meter dari kediaman dihuni.

"Mayat mangsa ditemukan dalam keadaan separuh bogel dengan kesan kelar di leher selain luka di bahagian kepala akibat hentakan objek tumpul.

"Polis juga tidak menolak kemungkinan mangsa turut dirogol berdasarkan kesan air mani suspek yang ditemui," katanya.

Selain itu, katanya, polis mendapati telefon bimbit dan wang tunai di dalam dompet mangsa turut hilang dalam kejadian itu.

"Menurut saksi, mangsa adalah ibu kepada lima

anak. Mangsa keluar bekerja di sebuah restoran pada jam 6.15 pagi kelmarin.

"Suami mangsa bekerja di Semenanjung Malaysia. Mangsa biasanya menggunakan laluan pejalan kaki di sebuah kawasan semak kebun pisang untuk pergi dan pulang bekerja.

"Bagaimanapun pemilik

restoran yang juga majikan mangsa menghubungi keluarga mangsa selepas mendapati wanita tidak hadir berkerja seperti kebiasaannya.

"Sangsi dengan maklumat itu, ahli keluarga mangsa berusaha mencarinya, sebelum menemui mayatnya di kawasan semak berkenaan," katanya.

Beliau berkata, mayat mangsa kemudian dibawa ke Jabatan Forensik Hospital Lahad Datu bagi tujuan bedah siasat dan siasatan lanjut.

Rohan berkata, polis sedang berusaha mengesan suspek dalam kejadian ini dan kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan.

"Polis memohon kerjasama daripada orang awam yang mempunyai maklumat mengenai kejadian ini supaya menghubungi balai polis berhampiran.

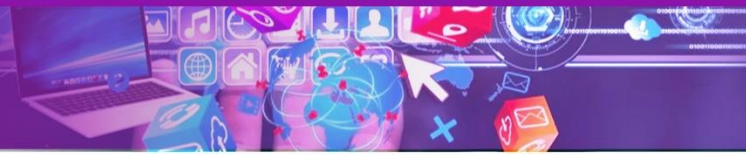

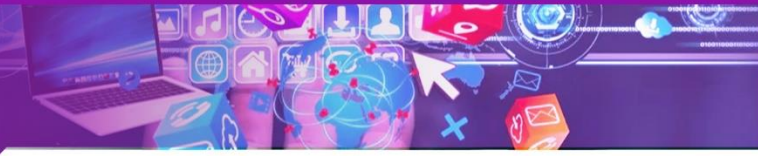

'Start sex education early'

Child activists: Children need proper sexual, reproductive info

PETALING JAYA: There are no shortcuts to addressing the occurrence of sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) among teens except to educate them about sexual and reproductive health from a young age, say children's activists.

Juliana Ooi of X Ed Malaysia, a social enterprise, said with most Asian parents finding it awkward to discuss the birds and the bees with their children, it will be best to first equip the parents with knowledge for the task.

She pointed out that the number of STD cases among teens as announced by Education Minister Fadhilna Sidek in Parliament on Oct 30 could just be the tip of the iceberg.

"That number probably did not include data from private and NGO healthcare providers, and untreated or self-treated cases as well.

"Nonetheless, this is an opportunity for the Education, Health as well as the Women, Family and Community Development Ministries to work together.

"They should enhance delivery of youth-centred sexual and reproductive health services including testing, treatment and follow-ups," she said.

Ooi, who conducts workshops on sexuality education for children and teenagers, said it's important to evaluate the teenagers' level of understanding of the subject to add information on prevention and skills for them to protect themselves.

"This includes strategies like identifying a trusted adult to share, knowing where to go to, such as a one-stop crisis centre, healthcare services and the importance of getting early screening or treatment, etc, if they show symptoms (of STDs).

"When they know about STDs, they are not only aware of how to prevent these but if they or their friends encounter such a situation, they will know the channels to reach out to for help.

"Therefore it's important for health services to also be youth-centred so that they will come forward," she added.

Ooi called for a safe space for parents and guardians to kickstart the conversation with their children.

"It's helpful to upskill parents and guardians in sexuality education and related issues in a safe space. Without a safe space, many may turn to and be misinformed by non-scientific, non-educational sources," she said.

X Ed is currently developing a toolkit to help reduce the barriers and difficulty in discussing sexuality education at home.

"The toolkit contains age-appropriate materials and is designed to be culturally sensitive while also taking into consideration religious perspectives.

"It helps parents to get ready to have the discussions with their children based on their comfort level," she said, adding that the toolkit is designed based on the international technical guidance on sexuality education.

Child activist Datuk Dr Hartini Zainuddin said the education system must strengthen sexual health education in schools at an early age.

"The authorities must develop youth-friendly healthcare services such as peer-to-peer talks on platforms normally frequented by

youth like TikTok, Instagram and other social media chat groups.

"Identify focal student youth leaders. Establish accessible and affordable healthcare services tailored to the needs of young people, where they can seek confidential advice, guidance and medical assistance regarding sexual health," she said.

Hartini also said government agencies, religious leaders and communities must collaborate to foster partnerships in addressing the issue.

"All of this must be done in a friendly way, not with a threatening approach," she added.

Fadhilna has revealed that 913 teenagers (13- to 17-year-olds) tested positive for STDs – syphilis, gonorrhoea, chancroid and HIV – from 2018 to 2022.

Quoting figures from the Health Ministry, she said there were 255 cases in 2018, 225 in 2019, 191 in 2020, 96 in 2021, and 146 last year.

According to the ministry's MyHEALTH portal, the highest increase in sexually transmitted infections has been among the 16 to 24 years age group.

'Social media tools can have positive effects on sex education'

PETALING JAYA: While she supports the call for parents to be open about discussing sex education with their children, an activist says using social media tools can bring positive effects to the sensitive issue.

Parent Action Group for Education Malaysia (PAGE) honorary secretary Tunku Munawirah Putra said in line with current trends, it will be useful to have short TikTok videos of public service announcements on sexuality education.

"In this digital day and age, more can be done by both the Education as well as the Women, Family and Community Development ministries to guide and support students and parents in teaching and talking about this subject matter," she said.

She was commenting on the answer given by Education Minister Fadhilna Sidek at the Dewan Rakyat on Oct 29 that over 900 teenagers, with some as young as 13, having tested positive for sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) between 2018 and 2022.

Tunku Munawirah, however, said "having the talk" remains the best method when addressing the elephant in the room or when children start asking questions.

"No doubt parents play a big role in educating their children but they too will find it challenging to discuss such a complex subject and may shy away from talking about it.

"It is indeed worrying that children as young as 13 are sexually active but do not know what they are getting themselves into.

"It is even more worrying that these young teens could be victims of sexual violence or sexual grooming that they have no knowledge of," she said.

National Union of the Teaching Profession (NUTP) secretary-general Fouzi Singon said the minister's revelation would not surprise disciplinary and guidance or counselling teachers.

Schools can only provide input and information but parents are the ones who should ensure their children are educated about such matters, he said.

Fouzi cited family issues, abuse, peer pressure and social ills as among the main reasons contributing to teenage sex.

A teacher, who wishes to be known only as Rumie, 43, said she was not surprised by the data.

"As a teacher, I take it upon myself to warn my students; with girls I focus on trust, with the boys I'll have to practise a bit of reverse psychology on them," she said.

Even though topics on safe sex and sex education are covered under Islamic studies and morals, at the end of the day there is no control over what teenagers will do because most are influenced by friends and peer pressure coupled with their raging hormones, she added.

Expert: Cases of teens with STDs may be higher

PETALING JAYA: There may be under-reporting in cases of teenagers with sexual transmitted diseases (STDs), says a public health expert.

Prof Dr Sharifa Ezat Wan Puteh, a health economics and public health specialist with Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, said the actual number is likely to be higher than what was revealed in Parliament recently.

On Oct 30, Education Minister Fadhilna Sidek said in Dewan Rakyat that based on data from the Health Ministry, 913 teenagers, with some as young as 13, had

tested positive for syphilis, gonorrhoea, chancroid and HIV from 2018 to 2022.

Dr Sharifa Ezat said such cases happened due to many factors including more socialisation and sexual encounters, experimenting with new things and risk-seeking behaviours common among young people.

"These things have also become an accepted culture among youngsters, who have more liberty in choosing partners," she said.

She added that young people may experience symptoms of

STDs but delay seeking treatments and continue to have unprotected sex.

According to the MyHEALTH portal, a person should go to a doctor if the individual experiences itching, swelling or redness around the vagina or penis, unusual discharge, or pain in the lower abdomen.

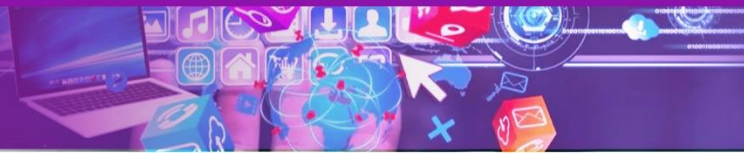
In the National Health and Morbidity Survey: Adolescent Health Survey 2022 released by the Health Ministry recently, it was revealed that 154,646 adolescents in Malaysia had engaged in sexual activities.

It noted that 33% of that number had engaged in sexual activities before the age of 14. The age of consent for sex in Malaysia is 16.

The survey was conducted from June 12 to July 8, 2022, involving secondary school students aged between 13 and 17.

It also revealed that 75% of them reported having sex recently, and 88% of those who had sex did not use any condoms or birth control.

The survey reported that 11% of the teenagers had more than one sexual partner.

arrest which was Feb 20, 2020.

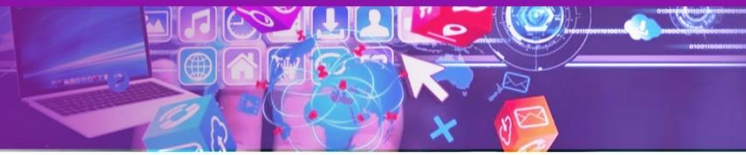
"After hearing the mitigation by the accused and objection by the prosecution, there is no compromise in an incest case. The accused was supposed to protect his stepdaughter who was 13

KUALA LUMPUR: Special housing for the elderly needs to be developed in Kuala Lumpur as the federal capital is expected to become an ageing city by 2040, according to the Kuala Lumpur Structure Plan 2040 (KLSP2040).

It projects that the elderly population will be higher in 2040, at 17.3% compared with 9.2% in 2025, adding that the construction of homes specifically for the elderly should include retirement homes for independent living, those with medical assistance and nursing homes.

"The provision of facilities specifically for the elderly allows them to live independently.

"However, the viability of retirement residences with medical assistance in residential areas requires an in-depth study."

The plan advocates the special homes be sold, leased or rented and the units constructed either in residential or commercial zones, depending on suitability.

Retirement homes also need to be equipped with facilities that take into account the fundamental principles of

universal design, such as elderly-friendly equipment that include emergency and safety warning devices.

"Kuala Lumpur City Hall must offer comprehensive guidelines for the planning and construction of elderly nursing homes that are in line with directives issued by relevant agencies.

"Cooperation from higher education institutions, professional bodies and NGOs is

also encouraged to aid in the development of these facilities."

KLSP2040 also projects that Kuala Lumpur will experience a population profile shift in the future, with the number of household members decreasing from 3.2 in 2025 to 3.0 in 2040.

"As such, future planning and management of housing provision in Kuala Lumpur must account for anticipated shifts in the population profile

and households."

Meanwhile, the document stated that the provision of housing for persons with disabilities (PwD) is critical, and the collaborative efforts of various agencies need to be given attention to ensure that this group is not marginalised.

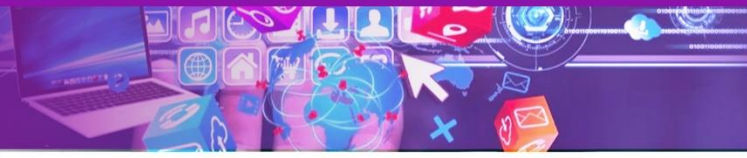
"The cumulative number of PwD registered in Kuala Lumpur in 2020 increased by 12.2%, from 34,299 in 2019 to 38,590."

KLSP2040 also stated the National Social Policy mandates that the government fulfil the needs of communities, families and individuals, which include providing special housing for the PwD community, Bernama reported.

Among the initiatives that need to be implemented are allowing the disabled to rent low-cost houses or City Hall flats, in addition to providing suitable and easily accessible facilities such as ramps and parking spaces for the group.

Other initiatives include allocating a 2% quota for PwD in each suitable residential area, as well as designing home spaces that fulfil a barrier-free design and universal design standards, rules and guidelines.

Gazetted on Oct 19, KLSP2040 replaces KLSP2020 as the future planning document for Kuala Lumpur in driving the strategic development of the Malaysian capital indicatively until 2040.

Bangladeshi gets 22 years, 15 strokes for raping stepdaughter

SEREMBAN: A Bangladeshi man was sentenced to 22 years in prison and given 15 strokes of the cane by the Sessions Court here yesterday for raping his stepdaughter, resulting in her giving birth.

Judge Datin Surita Budin handed down the sentence on Md Babul Hossain, 44, after finding him guilty of raping the then 13-year-old girl, and ordered the imprisonment to commence from the date of his arrest on Feb 20, 2020.

"After hearing the mitigation by the accused and objection by the prosecution, there is no compromise in an incest case. The accused was supposed to protect his stepdaughter who

was 13 years old," said the judge.

Md Babul, a cloth merchant, was charged with committing incest by raping his stepdaughter at the Tekir Orang Asli Village, Mentera, Labu Batu 10, here at about 10.30pm on Feb 15, 2020.

The charge, framed under Section 376B of the Penal Code, provides imprisonment of between 10 years and 30 years and whipping, upon conviction.

The prosecution was conducted by Deputy Public Prosecutor Goh Hsiao Tung, while the accused was unrepresented.

In requesting a proportionate punishment, the DPP said the deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) test conducted on the accused and the child born to the victim

found they were the same, and there was no strong evidence to show that the cloth merchant was not at the scene.

The accused's stepdaughter lost her biological mother due to brain cancer. Therefore, the victim was completely dependent on the accused to protect and take care of her. Instead, the accused took advantage of the victim.

"The victim was abused four times until she reached the age of 13. For a child, her life should be focused on studies and happiness. However, her life has been affected because she is now a single mother while having to continue her studies," she said. — Bernama

Body of suspected rape victim found in Lahad Datu

LAHAD DATU: The body of foreign woman suspected to be a rape victim was found in a bush area in Kampung Pisang, here Tuesday.

Lahad Datu police chief ACP Dr Rohan Shah Ahmad said family members of the 36-year-old victim discovered her body

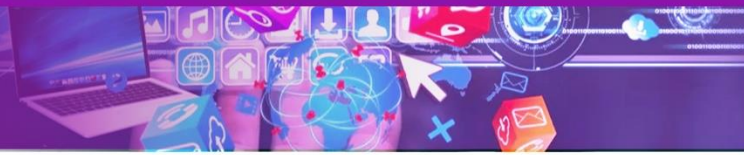
about 600 metres from her house at 6.20am.

"The body was found in a semi-nude condition with slash wounds on the head and neck.

"We do not rule out the possibility that the victim was also raped, based on traces of semen found on her genitals," he

said in a statement, adding the victim's mobile phone and money were missing.

The body was taken to Lahad Datu Hospital for post-mortem, with police classifying the case as murder, under Section 302 of the Penal Code.

Miri mayor Adam Yil is slated to officiate the carnival's opening ceremony at 2pm.

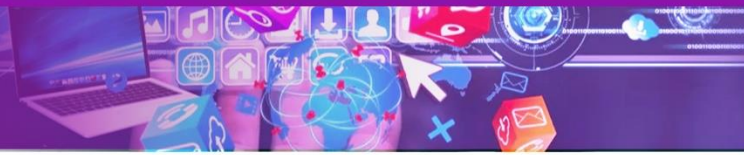
The family-oriented event will begin with a puppetry performance today, followed by

S'wak to have special needs centre in Samarahan — Fatimah

KUCHING: A Sarawak Special Needs Centre (SSNC) is set to be constructed in Muara Tuang Land District in Samarahan with a budget allocation of RM50 million, said Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

The Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Minister said the centre, also known as the first 'Enabling Village' in Sarawak, is expected to be completed by 2026.

"We have observed successful models, such as the one in Singapore, and we are determined to create our own tailored approach.

"The SSNC, also known as the Enabling Village, will offer a range of services, including diagnosis and pre-diagnosis, educational

therapy and vocational facilities," she said.

Fatimah announced this in her speech at the 'Hari Kesejahteraan Bersama (Hari Bersama Warga Emas, Orang Kurang Upaya, Keluarga dan Kanak-Kanak)' held at Waterfront Hotel here yesterday.

Acknowledging the importance of filling educational gaps, Fatimah said the focus of SSNC is also to provide services for those unable to attend mainstream schools due to the severity of their disabilities.

"We want to emphasise their abilities rather than solely focusing on physical limitations," she explained.

Elaborating, Fatimah said that one of the significant aspects of SSNC is the provision of vocational training and

workshops tailored to each individual's capabilities.

"We believe in nurturing their unique abilities and providing vocational training opportunities that align with their skills and interests."

In response to the pressing need for residential facilities, Fatimah said the SSNC also aims to bridge the current gap.

"For those without family support, intense care is essential. Currently, such facilities are scarce, and individuals are often sent to the peninsula for care.

"We are committed to changing this by establishing our own residential facility under SSNC," she said.

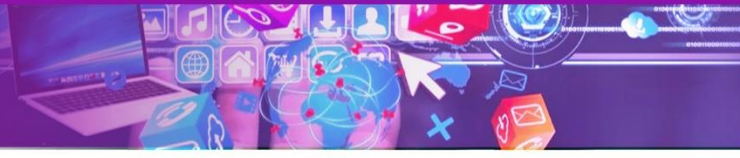
Fatimah pointed out that the SSNC is another initiative by the state government towards inclusivity and comprehensive

support for Persons with Disabilities (PWD).

The initiative aims to address the diverse needs of the special needs community in Sarawak.

"The SSNC, which will provide comprehensive services, including diagnosis, therapy, education, vocational training, workshop programmes and residential facilities for Sarawak's special needs community, stands as a testament to Sarawak's dedication to fostering an inclusive and supportive environment for all," she added.

She was charged with murdering Norzihan Abd Karim, 65, in front of the Telekom

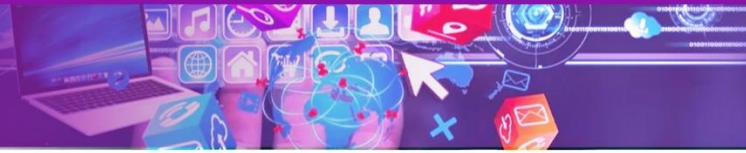
Malaysia guard post at Batu 23 in Kuala Berang, near Hulu Terengganu, between 3.20am and 4am on Nov 1.

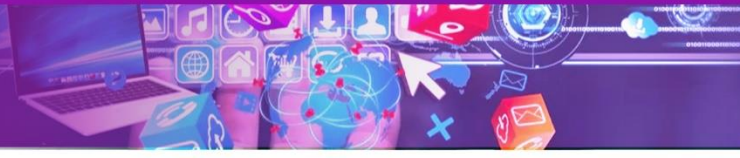

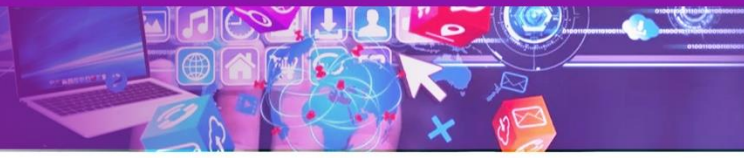

SEREMBAN: Seorang warga Bangladesh dihukum penjara 22 tahun dan 15 sebatan oleh Mahkamah Sesyen di sini semalam selepas didapati bersalah atas pertuduhan melakukan sumbang mahram terhadap anak tirinya sehingga melahirkan anak, tiga tahun lepas.

Hakim Datin Surita Budin menjatuhkan hukuman itu selepas mendapati tertuduh yang berusia 44 tahun bersalah di akhir kes pembelaan dan memerintahkan dia menjalani hukuman penjara bermula dari tarikh tangkap pada 20 Februari 2020.

"Setelah mendengar mitigasi tertuduh dan pembelaan oleh pihak pendakwaan, tiada kompromi terhadap kes sumbang mahram. Tertuduh sepatutnya melindungi anak tirinya yang berusia 13 tahun (ketika kejadian).

"Tindakan tersebut umpama haruan makan anak dan

meninggalkan trauma kepada mangsa," katanya.
