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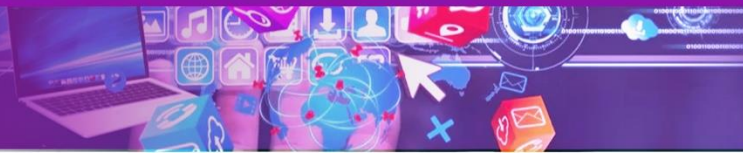

Anak maut, ibu parah dalam perjalanan daftar universiti

Kampar: Perjalanan lima beranak untuk menghantar dua daripada mereka mendaftar ke universiti berakhir tragedi apabila seorang daripada mereka maut, manakala seorang lagi parah selepas kereta dinaiki terbabit kemalangan dengan sebuah treler di Kilometer 301.5, Lebuhraya Utara Selatan (PLUS) arah selatan, dekat Gopeng, pagi semalam.

Mangsa, Muhammad Zweill Haikal Ghazali, 18, meninggal dunia akibat parah pada kepala, manakala ibunya, Asnoni Othman, 49, berasal dari Teluk Kumbar, Bayan Lepas, Pulau Pinang, parah.

Nahas kira-kira jam 7 pagi itu turut menyebabkan tiga lagi anak lelaki Asnoni, iaitu yang berusia 24, 20 dan 10 tahun yang menaiki kereta sama, cedera termasuk dua daripadanya cedera ringan.

Ketua Polis Daerah Kampar, Superintendan Mohamad Nazri Daud, berkata mangsa dalam perjalanan untuk mendaftarkan Muhammad Zweill dan abangnya yang berusia 20 tahun ke Universiti Malaya (UM) kampus Cyberjaya, Selangor.

Katanya, siasatan awal mendapati kereta dinaiki lima beranak itu dari arah Ipoh menghala Kuala Lumpur.

“Setiba di tempat kejadian, kereta dipandu lelaki berusia 24 tahun dipercayai gagal mengawal kenderaannya lalu melanggar bahagian belakang sebelah kanan treler yang dipandu seorang lelaki berumur 50 tahun yang sedang bergerak di lorong kiri jalan.

“Susulan nahas itu, Muhammad Zweill disahkan maut di tempat kejadian, manakala semua mangsa lain yang cedera termasuk pemandu kereta yang ketika ini tidak sedarkan diri berikutan pendarahan di perut, dihantar ke Hospital Tapah untuk rawatan lanjut,” katanya.

Peningkatan kesihatan mental

Anak perlu cukup belaian emosi

Ibu bapa patut peka cabaran berbeza dihadapi antara remaja, kanak-kanak

Kuala Lumpur: Ibu bapa tidak boleh hanya menyempurnakan keperluan fizikal anak mereka dengan wang ringgit atau gajet, sebaliknya perlu memastikan mereka mendapat belaian emosi dan kasih sayang secukupnya.

Pakar Psikologi, Prof Datin Dr Mariani Md Nor, berkata kitaran persekitaran boleh menyumbang terjejasnya kesihatan mental kanak-kanak dan remaja, namun perlu ada perlindungan daripada ibu bapa.

"Hak mereka perlu dijaga dengan tidak membiarkan anak itu tanpa belaian emosi dan kasih

sayang kerana pergi (kerja) pagi dan balik malam.

"Ibu bapa bukan setakat bagi cukup makan, minum dan pakaian buat anak, namun keperluan asas kedua iaitu kasih sayang, pengiktirafan dan keselamatan mereka juga penting," katanya kepada *BH*, di sini.

Beliau berkata demikian mengulas kenyataan Menteri Kesihatan, Dr Zaliha Mustafa bahawa kes kesihatan mental dalam kalangan penduduk berusia 16 tahun ke atas merekodkan peningkatan hampir tiga kali ganda.

Dr Zaliha dilaporkan berkata, peningkatan daripada 11 peratus pada 1996 kepada 29 peratus pada 2015 itu, menunjukkan masalah kesihatan mental bagi penduduk berusia 16 tahun ke atas semakin melarat.

Selain itu, 12 peratus kanak-kanak berumur lima hingga 15 tahun didapati mengalami masa-

lah kesihatan mental pada 2015.

Pada masa sama, Dr Mariani berkata, kanak-kanak dan remaja berdepan cabaran berbeza yang boleh menyebabkan mereka berdepan tekanan antaranya aspek akademik, desakan daripada ibu bapa yang mahu terbaik dalam pendidikan.

Cara berbeza

Beliau berkata, ibu bapa perlu mengetahui setiap anak mempunyai tahap perkembangan, kebijaksanaan dan kecerdasan berbeza dengan saudara kandung lain.

"Jika anak dipaksa untuk dapat pencapaian tertentu yang tidak dapat diikuti mereka, pastinya emosi akan tercalar dan rasa dibandingkan dengan adik beradik yang lain.

"Ibu bapa perlu pahat dalam minda tidak semua anak ada kecerdasan tinggi dan perlu fikir apa kekuatannya, mungkin bukan pada akademik tetapi pada vokasional," katanya.

KPM sasar tingkatan enrolmen murid prasekolah

Langkah awal tangani keciciran pada peringkat sekolah rendah, menengah

Alor Setar: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) menyasarkan untuk meningkatkan enrolmen murid di prasekolah kepada 90 peratus berbanding 80 peratus ketika ini sebagai langkah awal mengekang keciciran pada peringkat sekolah rendah dan menengah.

Menterinya, Fadhlina Sidek, berkata bagi mencapai sasaran itu KPM akan membuka lebih banyak prasekolah selain melancarkan kempen advokasi kepada ibu bapa untuk menggalakkan mereka menghantar anak-anak ke prasekolah bagi mendapatkan pendidikan awal.

"Enrolmen prasekolah (ketika ini) adalah sekitar 80 peratus, sekolah menengah lebih kurang 78 peratus jadi agak rendah berbanding sekolah rendah yang kita wajibkan itu iaitu pada ka-

dar 98 peratus.

"Jadi kita ada dua segmen pelajar yang perlu kita beri tumpuan enrolmennya iaitu prasekolah dan juga sekolah menengah," katanya kepada pemberita selepas menghadiri program Sesi Motivasi bersama Cikgu Menteri di sini, malam kelmarin.

Ibu bapa tak mampu

Beliau berkata, antara faktor kadar enrolmen prasekolah rendah adalah disebabkan kemiskinan iaitu ibu bapa tidak mampu menghantar anak mereka ke prasekolah, selain kekurangan kelas prasekolah yang sedang ditangani di peringkat kementerian.

Ditanya sama ada KPM berhasrat mewajibkan pendidikan prasekolah seperti sekolah rendah, Fadhlina berkata, pihaknya akan menyelesaikan dahulu isu berkaitan prasekolah sebelum meneliti perkara itu.

Mengulas mengenai keciciran pada peringkat sekolah menengah, beliau berkata, Rang Undang-Undang (RUU) mewajibkan pendidikan di peringkat sekolah menengah yang akan dibentangkan di Parlimen dijangka dapat memastikan pelajar kekal bersekolah sehingga tamat tingkatan lima.

"Sekolah menengah ini drop

out (tercicir), orang tak sambung belajar ini disebabkan oleh macam-macam, kemiskinan, bekerja, kahwin, hamil dan memang mahu berhenti atau terabit dengan pelbagai isu sosial.

"Jadi untuk kekang isu ini kita perlu juga ada dasar pendidikan wajib untuk sekolah menengah supaya mereka boleh kekal di sekolah sehingga Tingkatan Lima," katanya. BERNAMA

Majlis Tilawah dan Hafazan Al-Quran Peringkat Kebangsaan

Qari pertama OKU cipta sejarah

Muhammad Qayyim akan terus berlatih sebagai persediaan ke peringkat antarabangsa

Butterworth: "Saya hanya menyasarkan untuk menduduki tempat ketiga pada tilawah kali ini kerana berasakan bacaannya tidak sehabat qari yang lain," kata Muhammad Qayyim Nizar Sarimi.

Muhammad Qayyim, 25, yang juga orang kurang upaya (OKU) penglihatan berasal dari Kelantan muncul qari pertama OKU bergelar juara sepanjang sejarah pertandingan yang berlangsung sejak 1947.

Pelajar Kolej Universiti Islam Antarabangsa Sultan Ismail Petra (KIAS) dalam bidang Ijazah Sarjana Muda Tahfiz membaca al-Quran dalam versi tulisan braille berkata, mengakui persaingan sengit yang diberikan semua peserta dan tidak menyangka nama mereka diumumkan sebagai pemenang.

"Banyak qari yang hebat dalam pertandingan kali ini hingga sukar nak tentukan siapa pemenang tetapi siapa sangka rezeki

saya untuk bergelar juara.

"Untuk persediaan ke peringkat antarabangsa, saya akan membuat latihan yang lebih baik," kata anak sulung daripada enam beradik itu selepas Majlis Penutup dan Penyampaian Hadiah program berkenaan di Pusat Konvensyen, Kebudayaan dan Kesenian Antarabangsa (PICCA), Arena Butterworth, di sini, malam kelmarin.

Johan qariah, Nor Hidayah Abdul Rahman, 32, yang berkhidmat sebagai penolong pegawai tadbir dari Terengganu berkata, dia tidak menyangka muncul juara qariah buat kali pertama selepas tujuh tahun berturut-turut menyertai pertandingan itu.

"Saya sudah mewakili Terengganu tujuh kali dan ini kali pertama saya diumumkan sebagai juara yang ia hadiah amat bermakna buat saya.

"Tambah pula, peserta kali ini bukan biasa-biasa kerana pemarkahan yang diperolehi sangat sengit, tetapi rezeki berpihak kepada saya," katanya yang memiliki dua anak lelaki berusia satu dan empat tahun.

Wang tunai RM20,000

Dengan kemenangan itu, Muhammad Qayyim dan Nor Hidayah layak membawa pulang masing-masing hadiah wang tunai RM20,000, selain piala iringan dan tambahan wang tunai RM10,000 bagi menunaikan haji.

(Johan Menunggu) dan qariah dari Selangor, Nor Ruzana Natiah Jafar; manakala tempat ketiga dimenangi qari dari Negeri Sembilan, Mohamad Husaini dan qariah dari Johor, Nurul Nadiyah Hashim.

Bagi kategori hafazan, peserta Johor, Ahmad Ikmal Mohd Ridhuan diumumkan johan hafiz bagi kategori 1 hingga 30 juzuk beserta tafsir, manakala peserta Sabah, Dian Karisma Mohd Japar dinobatkan johan hafizah.

Mereka masing-masing membawa pulang wang tunai RM20,000, selain tambahan wang

tunai RM10,000 untuk menunaikan haji dan piala iringan.

Untuk kategori 1 hingga 20 juzuk, hafiz dari Terengganu, Muhammad Fakhurazi Yahaya dan hafizah dari Melaka, Dina Hafidina Mohd Umarul Hisyam dinobatkan johan.

Kategori 1 hingga 10 juzuk beserta taranum pula diungguli hafiz dari Wilayah Persekutuan, Muhammad Fahmi Shari dan hafizah dari Melaka, Siti Nabilah Zamri.

Terdahulu Yang Dipertua Negeri Pulau Pinang, Tun Ahmad Fuzi Abdul Razak menyampaikan

hadiah kepada pemenang yang turut menyaksikan Negeri Sembilan muncul juara keseluruhan.

Turut hadir Timbalan Ketua Menteri I Pulau Pinang, Datuk Ir Ahmad Zakiyuddin Abdul Rahman dan Menteri di Jabatan Perdana Menteri (Hal Ehwal Agama), Datuk Dr Mohd Na'im Mokhtar.

MTHQK berlangsung enam hari di PICCA, Arena Butterworth, di sini, dirasmikan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim pada 11 Jun lalu dengan penyeretaan 108 peserta tilawah dan hafazan mewakili 14 negeri.

Penunggang Ducati maut jatuh jejambat SUKE

Suspek bawa motosikal lawan arus serah diri



Peniaga makanan dakwa sesat ketika mahu balik rumah

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Kuala Lumpur: Penunggang motosikal yang dipercayai menjadi punca kemalangan maut seorang penunggang motosikal berkuasa tinggi di Kilometer 22.2 Lebuhraya Sungai Besi Ulu Kelang (Suke) su-

sur keluar Ulu Kelang di sini, Rabu lalu, menyerahkan diri kepada polis, kelmarin.

Lelaki warga tempatan berusia 41 tahun dari Kajang, Selangor itu tampil membantu siasatan polis dengan membuat satu laporan polis berkaitan kemalangan itu di Balai Trafik Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Kajang.

Ketua Polis Daerah Ampang Jaya, Asisten Komisioner Mohd Azam Ismail, berkata melalui keterangan, suspek memaklumkan pada hari kejadian dia tersesat ketika dalam perjalanan dari Ampang pulang ke rumahnya di Kajang.

Berikutan itu, katanya, suspek

yang juga seorang peniaga makanan itu membuat keputusan memasuki jejambat Lebuhraya SUKE secara melawan arus sehingga menyebabkan berlaku kemalangan.

"Akibat pergeseran dengan motosikal mangsa, suspek juga terjatuh daripada motosikalnya.

"Selepas kemalangan, suspek terus pulang ke rumah dan hanya mengetahui mengenai insiden menimpa mangsa setelah menonton berita di televisyen dan hebahan di media sosial," katanya semalam.

Mohd Azam berkata, akibat kemalangan itu, suspek turut mengalami pelbagai kecederaan antaranya patah bahu kanan, patah jari

kelingking, selain luka pada bahu kiri dan kaki kanan.

"Polis turut merampas motosikal milik suspek dan beberapa barang kes lain untuk siasatan.

"Buat masa ini suspek tidak ditahan kerana keadaan kecederaan yang dialaminya agak parah," katanya.

Dalam kejadian jam 1.05 tengah hari itu, mangsa, Ahmad Fadzil Omar Azzadin, 62, dari arah Ampang dalam perjalanan memasuki susur keluar Lebuhraya Lingkar Tengah 2 (MRR2) Ulu Kelang.

Tuntut penjelasan

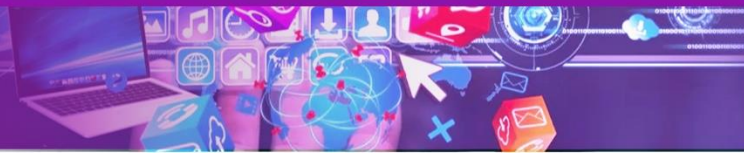
Sementara itu, anak kepada lelaki yang maut dalam nahas di SUKE,

mahu penunggang motosikal yang menjadi punca kemalangan itu tampil memohon maaf kepada ibunya.

Muhammad Hafidz Ahmad Fadzil, 36, kecewa kerana penunggang motosikal itu melarikan diri tanpa membantu bapanya.

Beliau turut menuntut penjelasan daripada penunggang motosikal terbabit tidak menghubungi ambulans, sebaliknya terus meninggalkan tempat kejadian.

"Semua orang lakukan kesilapan, tetapi sekurang-kurangnya bertanggungjawab dan memohon maaf kepada kami, terutama ibu saya," katanya memetik laporan portal FMT, semalam.

Tiga beranak melecur kereta meletup masih dirawat

Alor Setar: Tiga beranak yang melecur selepas Proton Wira yang dinaiki mereka meletup dan terbakar di hadapan sebuah premis di Taman Industri Ringan Sri Mergong, Lorong Perak 22, Selasa lalu, masih dirawat di Hospital Sultanah Bahiyah (HSB).

Ketua Polis Daerah Kota Setar, Asisten Komisioner Ahmad Shukri Mat Akhir, berkata setakat ini dua mangsa, Tuah Omar, 54, yang melecur 70 peratus dan anaknya, Muhammad Firdaus Syawal Abdullah, 5, yang melecur 60 peratus dalam keadaan stabil dan sedang ditidurkan.

Beliau berkata, Tuah dan isterinya yang juga ibu kanak-kanak itu, Noor Azlina Abu Bakar, 34, yang melecur 30 peratus dirawat di Unit Kebakaran HSB.

“Anak pasangan itu, Muhammad Firdaus Syawal pula dirawat di Wad Rawatan Rapi Pediatrik HSB,” katanya semalam.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan, tiga beranak melecur selepas Proton Wira yang dinaiki mereka meletup di hadapan sebuah premis Taman Industri Ringan Mergong, Selasa lalu.

Dalam kejadian kira-kira jam 12.30 tengah hari itu, tiga beranak terbabit datang ke premis itu untuk mengisi dua tong gas oksigen untuk kegunaan bantuan pernafasan bagi kegunaan sendiri.

Bagaimanapun, tong gas terbabit dipercayai meletup ketika mangsa baru meletakkannya dalam kereta berkenaan menyebabkan ketiga-tiga mangsa cedera akibat melecur.

"Ramai qari yang hebat dalam pertandingan kali ini hingga sukar nak tentukan siapa pemenang. Saya pula hanya menyasarkan tempat ketiga, tetapi siapa sangka rezeki saya untuk bergelar johan," katanya yang membaca al-Quran versi tulisan braille.

Katanya, dia menyertai pertandingan tilawah al-Quran sejak berusia sembilan tahun namun mengakui banyak yang perlu dipelajari.

Majlis penutupan itu disempurnakan Yang Dipertua Negeri Pulau Pinang, Tun Ahmad Fuzi Abdul Razak.

Selepas 48 tahun terpisah, Mohd Sopian Mohamed Sapihi kini mengecap nikmat kasih sayang ibu kandungnya, Fatimah Kuny Alive yang ditemui dalam pertemuan tidak dirancang pada 22 Mei lalu.

Kisah itu mendapat perhatian netizen selepas isterinya, Nor Faridah Badri, 46, memuat naik video sewaktu detik pertemuan itu di TikTok.

Berkongsi kisah sebenar, Mohd Sopian, 48, berkata, video itu dirakam dan dimuat naik pada hari pertemuan dengan ibunya yang kini berusia 72 tahun.

di sini.

Berkongsi perihal dirinya, Mohd Sopian berkata, dia terpisah dengan ibunya sejak berusia lapan bulan.

Sejak itu, dia dibesarkan bapa, nenek dan ibu saudara di Simpang Chenderiang, Batu 3, Temoh, Perak.

"Saya anak tunggal dan menurut apa diceritakan, ayah bawa saya bertemu keluarganya di Perak dan membawa surat beranak saya bersama.

"Awalnya emak dapat menghubungi ayah...tetapi mereka terputus hubungan jadi sejak itu ayah dan keluarganya membesarkan saya.

"Nenek sangat manjakan saya manakala kesemua ibu saudara layan dengan baik hingga saya sudah ang-

gap mereka seperti emak kandung.

"Jadi, saya tak terfikir dan berasa pun kehilangan ibu waktu kecil dan di bangku sekolah memandangkan ayah pun masih ada ketika itu sebelum meninggal dunia 16 tahun lalu," katanya.

Menurut Mohd Sopian, individu sekeliling pernah memintanya mencari ibu kandungnya namun dia belum terbuka hati dulu kerana tiada petunjuk dan nampak kepentingannya.

"Dulu, memang ramai minta saya cari emak namun saya saja enggan kerana anggap tiada dosa atau kesalahan dengan emak jadi fikir tak guna mencarinya.

"Isteri pun ada minta saya cari emak namun tidak sampai mendesak. Lagipun, sebagai manusia saya ada ego saya dan logiknya siapa tak nak ibu?"

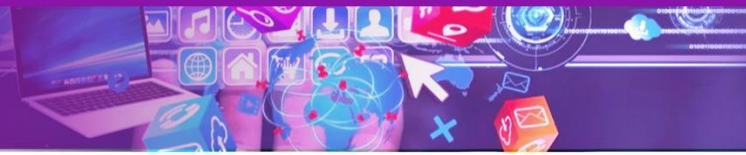

mandangkan kesihatan lelaki itu tidak mengizinkan.

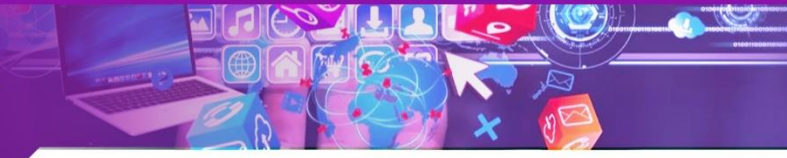

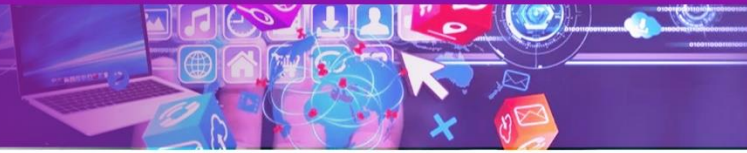
"Kami mahu penuhi im-

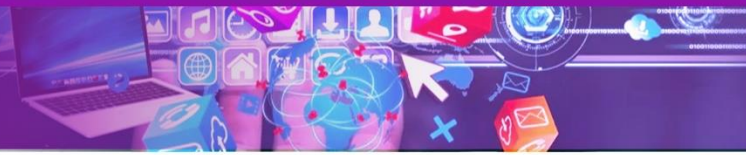

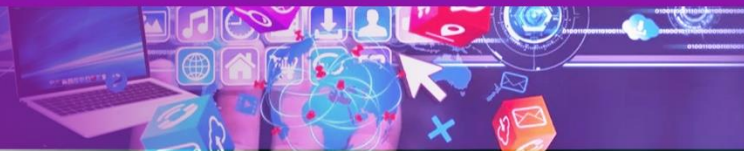

Sasar tingkat enrolmen murid prasekolah

Alor Setar: Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia (KPM) menyasarkan meningkatkan enrolmen murid di prasekolah kepada 90 peratus berbanding 80 peratus ketika ini sebagai langkah awal mengekang keciciran di peringkat sekolah rendah dan menengah.

Menterinya, Fadhlina Sidek berkata, bagi mencapai sasaran itu KPM akan membuka lebih banyak prasekolah selain melakukan kempen advokasi kepada ibu bapa untuk menggalakkan menghantar anak-anak ke prasekolah bagi mendapatkan pendidikan awal.

“Enrolmen prasekolah (ketika ini) adalah sekitar 80 peratus, sekolah me-

nengah lebih kurang 78 peratus jadi agak rendah berbanding sekolah rendah yang kita wajibkan itu iaitu pada kadar 98 peratus.

“Jadi kita ada dua segmen pelajar yang perlu beri tumpuan enrolmennya iaitu prasekolah dan juga sekolah menengah,” katanya selepas program Sesi Motivasi bersama Cikgu Menteri di sini, malam kelmarin.

Beliau berkata, antara faktor kadar enrolmen prasekolah rendah adalah disebabkan kemiskinan iaitu ibu bapa tidak mampu menghantar anak ke prasekolah, selain kekurangan kelas prasekolah yang sedang ditangani di peringkat kementerian.

Education Ministry to open more preschools in order to reduce dropout rate

THE Education Ministry aims to boost preschool enrolment to 90 per cent from 80 per cent as a preliminary measure to prevent school dropouts.

Minister Fadhlina Sidek said to achieve the target, the ministry would open more preschools and run an advocacy campaign to encourage parents to send their children to preschools.

"Preschool enrolment is at 80 per cent, while secondary school enrolment is around 78

per cent, which is low compared with primary school enrolment, which is made compulsory, at 98 per cent.

"We have two segments of students whose enrolment we need to focus on, namely preschool and secondary school."

She said this after attending the Sesi Motivasi bersama Cikgu Menterl programme here on Friday.

Fadhlina also cited poverty as a contributing factor to the low preschool enrolment rate.

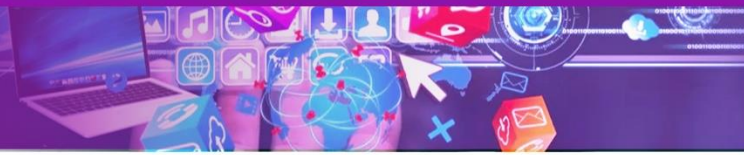
On whether the ministry intended to make preschool education compulsory, she said the ministry must first resolve preschool-related issues.

On secondary school dropouts, she said a bill to make secondary education compulsory for students that would be tabled in Parliament would ensure that students completed their schooling up to Form Five.

ing equipment.

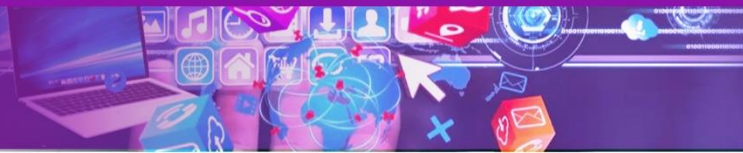
Students who had the card could receive discounts when buying at participating vendors. Students were given book vouchers prior to KADS1M.

her school programmes.

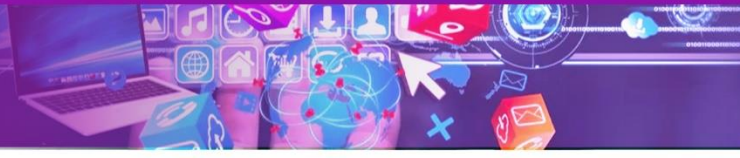
"I am also Echa's photographer, but other photographers take her pictures too."

SUKE CRASH SUSPECT SAYS HE GOT LOST

Victim's son wants food vendor to apologise to mum and explain why he failed to call for help

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THE motorcyclist who rode against traffic flow and allegedly caused the death of a high-powered motorcycle rider lodged a police report yesterday.

Ampang Jaya district police

chief Superintendent Mohd Azam Ismail said the 41-year-old food vendor from Kajang, Selangor, gave his statement at the Kajang police station.

On June 14, Ducati Panigale rider Ahmad Fadzil Omar Az-zadin, 62, was thrown off an elevated highway while attempting to avoid a motorcyclist, who was riding against the flow of traffic at 1.05pm at Km22.2 of the Sungai Besi Ulu Kelang Highway (Suke) near Ulu Kelang.

It was reported that Fadzil was negotiating a bend when he swerved to avoid the oncoming motorcyclist.

He crashed into a divider before being flung 30m down the elevated flyover. Fadzil was pronounced dead at the scene.

Azam said police had recorded statements from six people, including a suspect related to the crash.

He said the suspect told him that he got lost on his way from Ampang to his home in Kajang.

Azam said the suspect then decided to access the Suke flyover against the flow, which led to the fatal accident.

"During the collision, the suspect also fell off his motorcycle.

"After the accident, the suspect said he went home and only found out about the incident after watching the news on television and social media," Azam said yesterday.

The suspect sustained a broken right shoulder and finger, as well

as injuries to his left shoulder and right leg.

"We have confiscated the suspect's motorcycle and some items for investigation," Azam said, adding that the suspect had not been arrested as he was recovering from his injuries.

Both motorcycles belonging to the victim and the suspect would be sent to the Computerised Vehicle Inspection Centre (Puspakom) and the Chemistry Department for inspection.

Fadzil's son, Hafidz, 36, urged the suspect in the fatal crash to come forward and apologise.

He expressed his disappointment over the motorcyclist's alleged decision to flee the scene without providing assistance to

his father.

Hafidz also wants the rider to explain why he failed to contact emergency services or call for an ambulance.

"I am disappointed that the motorcyclist simply fled the scene. Everyone makes mistakes, but at least be responsible and apologise to us, especially to my mother.

"If the rider is reading this, please come forward and apologise to my mother," he told a news portal.

While expressing gratitude for the prayers and condolences received from the public, Hafidz appealed to social media users to refrain from sharing graphic photos or footage of the crash.

Video of female cop in temple fracas causes a stir

KUALA LUMPUR: Social media is again abuzz over a viral video featuring a policewoman in a heated argument at a temple.

The 18-second TikTok video, uploaded by the handle @ismet_66 and viewed over 941,000 times, appeared to show a policewoman who looked similar to the one who berated two policemen in a previous incident.

The cause of the altercation at the temple was unclear. However, people at the premises were seen telling the policewoman to leave.

The video captured snippets of the argument, with one person shouting: "Ask her to get out!" while another commenting: "I think she belongs in the mental ward."

The accompanying caption highlighted the alleged officer's disciplinary problems and accusations of causing disturbances even at a temple.

This recent video followed an earlier viral video on June 16, in which a woman, believed to be the same policewoman, was seen insulting policemen in Gombak.

The video sparked widespread outrage and raised questions about her behaviour towards lower ranking personnel.

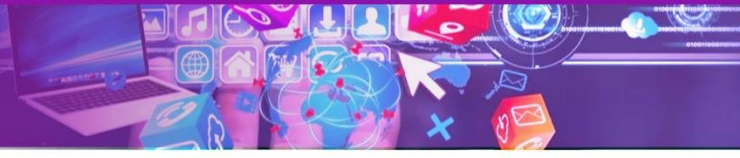
Netizens took to the comments section expressing frustration with the policewoman's attitude, while others voiced concern about her mental wellbeing.

User @ajinamoto suggested that counselling and medical treatment might be more appropriate than termination, since she might be in a stressful or depressed state.

Others expressed surprise that a person with disciplinary issues could become a high-ranking officer, thereby questioning the standards within the police force.

User @LensaBayu raised concern about public trust and safety, asking whether the police would retain officers like her.

The incidents had ignited a larger discussion on the behaviour and accountability of law enforcement officers, with many demanding action and transparency from the authorities.

Woman loses son in highway crash

KAMPAR: A mother's wish to send her two sons to a university in Cyberjaya was dashed when they were involved in an accident that killed one of the boys.

The mother was travelling in a car with her four children when they crashed into a lorry trailer in the southbound carriageway at Km301.5 of the North-South Expressway at 6.15am yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Muhammad Zweill Haikal Ghazali, 18. His mother, Asnoni Othman, 49, from Taman Kumbar Permai in Teluk Kumbar, Penang, suffered leg injuries.

The accident also injured Asnoni's three other children.

Muhammad Danial Haikal, 24, suffered bleeding in his stomach. Muhammad Darweiss Haikal, 20 and Muhammad Uwaiss Ryeqal, 10, both had minor injuries.

District police chief Superintendent Mohamad Nazri Daud said the car driven by Danial Haikal was heading to the Universiti Malaya (UM) Campus in Cyberjaya, Selangor, where Zweill and Darweiss were to register as students.

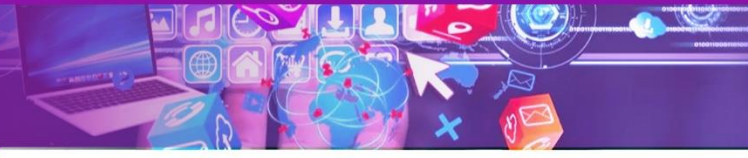
"Initial investigations found that the car had gone out of control before hitting the back of a lorry trailer driven by a 50-year-old man on the left lane.

"They were on their way to register the deceased and his brother at the UM Campus in Cyberjaya today (yesterday)," he said.

Nazri said Zweill was killed instantly due to severe head injuries.

"The injured victims were taken to the Tapah Hospital for treatment while the deceased was taken to the same hospital for a post-mortem.

"The driver of the trailer escaped unhurt. The case is being investigated under Section 41(1) of the Road Transport Act 1987 (for causing death by reckless or dangerous driving)," he said.

'Be clear on human trafficking'

Nazri: Malaysia must be decisive when dealing with the issue

KUALA LUMPUR: The improved standing in the US State Department's Trafficking in Persons (TIP) report serves as a catalyst for the country to be more strategic and decisive when dealing with the issue, says Datuk Seri Mohamed Nazri Abdul Aziz.

The Malaysian ambassador to the United States said the "promotion" of Malaysia to Tier 2 Watch List was a move by the US government to improve bilateral ties between the two nations.

"This reflects the openness of both countries to discuss, understand and cooperate in adding value to the Malaysia-United States 'comprehensive partnership'. I believe this is a constructive step by the US government in improving cooperation with

Malaysia," he said in a statement reported by Bernama.

Nazri said the embassy was prepared to support the government's initiatives through the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Migrant Anti-Smuggling Council (MAPO).

The US State Department's annual TIP Report 2023 showed that Malaysia is now back on the Tier 2 Watch List, where it had been placed from 2018 to 2020.

The Tier 2 Watch List refers to countries whose governments have not fully adhered to the minimum standards but are making significant efforts to comply with these standards.

Malaysia was in Tier 3 – the lowest tier – in 2021 and 2022, which refers to governments that

do not fully comply with the minimum standards.

Countries placed in Tier 3 can be penalised with sanctions and limited access to the United States.

Commenting on the same issue, MCA said the government should continue to work closely with stakeholders to strengthen efforts in tackling human trafficking, including overseas job scams.

The party's International Communication and Diplomacy Bureau deputy chairman Neo Choo Seong said Malaysia has shown significant effort in dealing with crime including greater enforcement and implementation of the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Anti-Smuggling of Migrants Act.

"MCA congratulates the Home Ministry, the police, the Immig-

ration Department and other agencies on this development," he said in a statement.

Neo said there were still many Malaysians who fell victim to and remain trapped in overseas job scams despite repeated warnings and awareness programmes.

Malaysians Against Rape, Assault and Snatch Thief founder Dave Avran said despite an increase in human trafficking cases each year, there was still a lack of awareness among the public on the gravity of human trafficking.

"Anyone can be a victim of forced labour or sex trafficking. It can happen to both men and women regardless of age, race, ethnicity, nationality, immigration status or socioeconomic class."

A special bond with his special one

Dad takes up tai chi to keep fit, spend time with daughter

JOHOR BARU: A father's love knows no bounds, as shown by 82-year-old Ng Chong Hah who is devoted to his daughter with special needs.

The retired engineer insists on bringing his 47-year-old daughter Kye Chi, a slow learner, along wherever he goes, including to his regular tai chi sessions.

"My wife and I started learning tai chi weekly with a group of residents at Taman Sri Tebrau in May as we wanted to stay active

and fit.

"It's not a chore to bring Kye Chi with us as we want to include her in all our activities and experiences.

"Taking care of her may come with many challenges, but this child of ours has also taught us to be more appreciative of our surroundings and the people around us," he said in an interview.

His wife, Cheong Fong Eng, 73, said Chong Hah has always been a patient and dedicated dad even when he was working in Brunei to raise their three children.

The couple's two sons now live

in Australia.

Chong Hah remains a committed father to Kye Chi.

"He insists on taking her everywhere as it is also good for her to get some fresh air and mingle with others," said Cheong.

She said that Chong Hah suffered from a mild stroke and heart issues in 2017, which led them to pursue a healthier lifestyle and their subsequent decision to take up tai chi.

"That was his reason for keeping up with an active lifestyle,

including participating in gotong-royong activities.

"We recently started incorporating a long blade into our tai chi routine, which is quite challenging due to our age, but it is good for stimulating our mind and body.

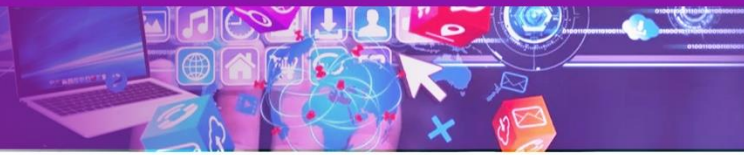
"It improves our motor skills as we need to hop, spin and move our limbs in our routine," she said, adding that by doing so, they are also encouraging Kye Chi to continue being active.

Cheong, who obtained a certifi-

cate in traditional Chinese massage from Southern University College at the age of 63 to help Kye Chi, said being active helps her daughter to improve her movements as well.

"As parents, we want to do our best for our children.

"What we learned from caring for Kye Chi is that having a positive outlook in life is vital and that people with disabilities should be treated equally in order to nurture a more loving and caring society," she added.

JOHOR BARU: When his wife left home six years ago, Ooi Teik Kwoi was forced to take on the responsibilities of both a father and a mother for his two children overnight.

The 60-year-old recalled that one day in December 2017, his wife packed her bags and said she wanted to visit her family back in Myanmar.

"She said she had some family issues to deal with and would be back in a month's time. She promised our sons that she would be back soon with gifts for them.

"We waited for a call from her after she left, but the phone never rang. On the third day, I called my mother-in-law and heard that my

wife had not made it back to her village.

"I was worried sick, thinking that something bad had happened to her. Later that day, she called to tell me that she was never coming back but did not give any reasons," he said when met at his house in Taman Plentong Utama here.

Ooi said he was devastated to hear that his wife of nine years had left him and their two children, who were only seven and eight years old at that time, for good.

"What really broke my heart was the fact that my children would have to live without a mother suddenly.

"I know they were too young to understand what had happened, but I decided to be frank with

them as it hurt me to see them waiting for her," he said.

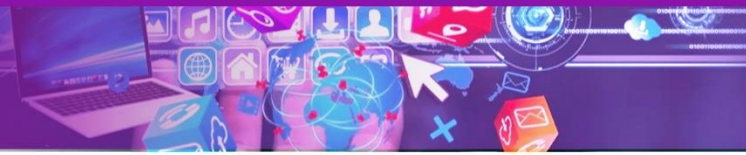
Ooi quit his job as a welder in Singapore, where he was earning almost S\$2,000, to take care of his children.

"My kids were young and had just lost their mother, the person whom they spent most of their time with since they were babies.

"I did not want them to ever feel abandoned, so I made it a point to spend as much time as I could with them. I wanted them to know that they have a father who loves them dearly," he said.

After quitting his full-time job, he has been taking up odd jobs, including food delivery and being a part-time contractor.

This Fathers Day, his only wish is that his two sons will be happy and healthy, Ooi said.

Dads are heroes without capes amid tough times

PETALING JAYA: Adam (not his real name) has been working day and night to make ends meet.

His wife is six months' pregnant with their first child and Adam has been taking side jobs over the weekends.

"I go to work early and often return home late. I am worried that I don't have enough for my child and wife. Everything is so expensive nowadays. The price of diapers and formula milk scares me," said the expectant father who is in a bittersweet mood on Fathers Day today.

Adam is among many fathers suffering from mental stress as they grind it out to make ends meet, experts said.

This dilemma is also prevalent in twin-income households as

husbands and wives work hard to put food on the table amid the rising cost of living.

Mental health counsellor and family dispute resolution practitioner Dr Arman Rashid (pic) said many fathers are increasingly anxious about their ability to provide for their families.

"The global economy is yet to recover from the Covid-19 pandemic and the Ukraine war, leading to increasing poverty across the world," he said.

"This has affected the mental health of everyone in society, more so for fathers who are the primary breadwinners.

"Many fathers are feeling increasingly stressed, anxious and perhaps even inadequate in confronting the question 'Will I be



able to provide for my family?'"

Their worry mostly stemmed from financial insecurity due to rising expenses and depleting savings.

"Such financial stress often causes psychological distress for fathers, increasing their risks of long-term mental health conditions, substance abuse and self-harm, and suicide.

"In patriarchal cultures, men often have self-loathing tendencies with shame and hopelessness for not being able to fend for their families," he added.

Arman said ultimately, mental stress caused by financial stress often ended in family conflicts and the need for fathers with deteriorating mental health to seek help.

"There is an alarming spike in family violence in Malaysia and globally in the aftermath of the pandemic. This is not to make excuses for violence against women and children but to recognise the need for fathers with deteriorating mental health to seek professional help.

"As a counsellor and family dispute resolution practitioner, I have seen how family conflicts after the pandemic affected the entire family unit, particularly children," he said.

Better Dads Malaysia (BDM), an NGO that supports the development of fatherhood, said mental health issues remain a growing concern in the country.

Its president Joshua Hong said it must be acknowledged that it is not easy for men to open up and share their emotions.

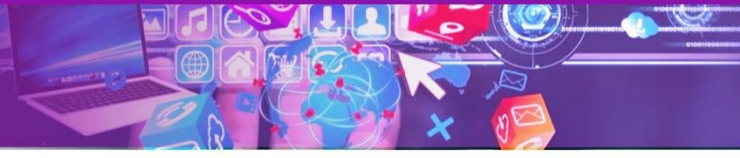
He said there is also a need to

dispel the misconception surrounding mental health.

"Mental health is just as important as physical health. I encourage men to open up and speak to their spouse or someone they trust if they are unable to cope with stress or if they are feeling emotionally unwell.

"If there are doubts about whether mental health issues are present, it's important to know that the government and many NGOs can help verify one's situation.

"Better Dads Malaysia is also making efforts to develop initiatives to address and support men and fathers in this regard," Hong said.

It is not an easy road to traverse but fathers are working their fingers to the bone when it comes to raising families. The increasing costs of living and the ever-expanding need to cater to lifestyle and education requirements, for example, are leading them to play a more significant role as breadwinners.

Eking out more than just a living for their families, especially the children, is proving to be stressful. Nevertheless, it is a responsibility that must be seen through. Everything from the grind for better positions at work and creating opportunities to supplement incomes to moonlighting for other companies seems to have become the norm in the current difficult economic climate.

But these fathers are also thankful for the support they receive at home. Some of their wives, for example, have been taking up part-time jobs to bolster household income to alleviate financial burdens. Today, it is not just about putting food on the table for fathers. It is about securing a better future for their children as well as educating them, by example, on dealing with responsibilities and working hard.

Getting by to get better

Assoc Prof Dr Hasan Ahmad is a father of eight, with the eldest being 27 years old and the youngest, nine.

The 57-year-old has never strictly subscribed to family planning as he believes his children are gifts from God – a mindset in line with his main job as a philosophical lecturer at Universiti Malaysia Pahang.

Hasan says his wife does not object to having many children although it means having to put in extra effort to raise them. "Raising many children is no easy task. There are many things you have to look into, especially their needs. And it is not necessarily about mental but material needs as well.

"I have to make more for the family. For instance, I regularly hold tuition classes for the additional income."

His wife, school teacher Norshihan Mohd Sood, 50, manages the family's finances. "Whatever I earn that month, I will give to her. She knows better when it comes to handling money. I am glad for that," Hasan says.

Of course, the challenge in raising children does not only lie in the numbers. Further away in Shah Alam, content manager Muhammad Afiq Mohd Hanif, 40, strives at work to ensure that his children's needs are met.

Fathers going the extra mile

On Fathers Day today, *Sunday Star* celebrates all the dads who are doing their best to make sure their children have everything they need.

He is a father of two: daughter Ayra Rayyan is 14 and son Aydan Qalif is nine and is on the autism spectrum.

"As the family's breadwinner, I do everything I can to provide for them. For instance, I have enrolled Aydan in a special school for autistic children," Muhammad Afiq says.

Muhammad Afiq has made plans to secure his children's future and has been working hard to make progress in his career with that in mind.

"Parents have to realise that today, you have to do things to upgrade yourselves. Not for anyone else, but your family. "I'm an executive now and the older your children get, your abilities need to be consistent with their growing needs.

"You need to plan for the future. You need to think more about finances, set aside extra savings, especially for their education, or if you have enough, make some investments to grow your money."

Braving the toil

Adam (not his real name), 35, is working diligently as an IT technician to make ends meet.

His wife is six months pregnant and Adam is racing against time to make enough savings for when the baby arrives.

"I have to moonlight for other companies. I am afraid that I may not have enough to buy everything for my baby. My wife is not working.

"I carry out my side jobs during the weekends. I am rarely at home during the day. Thankfully the other jobs do help supplement my savings. I hope I make enough."

But Adam says the stress of working is getting to him.

"There are many times when I can't sleep despite being tired. My mind is always about work, my wife, and our baby.

"My body aches from time to time. Sometimes, my heart beats fast whenever I

think about my worries. Maybe it is anxiety. I'm not sure. I don't have time to see the doctor."

Adam's wife has been supportive of him, he's glad to say.

"My wife understands me. She is worried about my health but knows that as the current breadwinner, I have to pull out all the stops."

Side jobs, responsibility and fulfilment

Hasan says it is a norm for fathers to moonlight or look for additional work to increase their incomes nowadays.

"Yes, there are many fathers who take side jobs. For example, I am the same. I am busy with my main job and I do not make much from the tuition classes.

"But I can tell you that it does help. It is OK. I am doing this for my children."

NGO Better Dads Malaysia (BDM), which advocates the development of father figures and parenting skills, says the concept of fathers spending time at work to provide for their families has been prevalent throughout the history of human civilisation across various cultures and societies.

BDM president Joshua Hong, however, points out that it is plausible for fathers today to spend more time at work due to the current economic circumstances.

"While I don't have specific figures or statistics at hand, it is plausible that this may be true, appearing as a trend due to the circumstances arising in the post-Covid-19 economy, with inflation resulting from recent conflicts and other factors.

"It is worth considering that some fathers' incomes may have been affected by the pandemic, compelling them to work harder or longer hours to make ends meet.

But at the same time, Hong says men derive fulfilment from their achievements in their profession.

"I have observed that many men derive fulfilment and contentment from their work or chosen profession.

"Men often find confidence in their achievements, regardless of whether their work or craft generates substantial income, as the value people place on different aspects varies."

Of course, contributions by their wives are not to be overlooked.

"It is important to acknowledge that since women have entered the workforce, we have witnessed a significant shift, with many cases of both parents working and men no longer being the sole breadwinners in families."

Taking a breather

How does Adam cope with his stressful situation?

"I try my best to get enough sleep and remember that I am doing this for my family. I pray for things to get better."

For Muhammad Afiq, spending time talking to his children after work and watching football does the trick.

"It is better if they like football too. But my daughter is into anime nowadays and the boy is still learning his way around. But as long as we talk, things are going well."

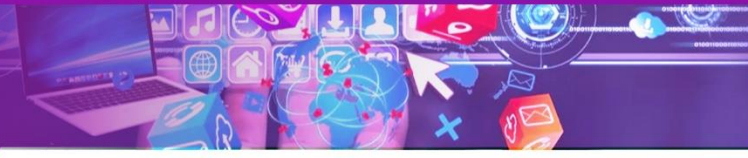
Hasan goes the extra mile by gathering all of his children for a weekly "mini-lecture" at home. Understandably, seeing all of his children together during such sessions brings joy to Hasan.

"If some of them could not make it, then we will have an online session. I have a son studying in Russia and another in the United States."

Hong says there is a growing trend among many men to get more involved in their children's lives.

"They want to take on more active roles in parenting. This indicates a desire for greater balance and shared responsibilities within the family dynamic."

Four families get houses under pilot Ihsan project

KEPALA BATAS: A gift of a new house for a poor family has made all the difference for Md Nasir Md Shariff who can now fully focus on his job as a kitchen helper, other than developing himself and his family in Kampung Tok Bedu, Tasek Gelugor, here.

Md Nasir, who was born and raised in the village, has been living in an old wooden house inherited from his grandparents.

The roof of the old house was not only leaking, but the wooden floor was also broken.

Md Nasir, 42, was among four people who received a new house under the Penang Rumah Kasih Ihsan project.

"The old house has been in a dilapidated state for a long time, and it was difficult to maintain it.

"My wife and three daughters,

aged five to 13, live in it and it was becoming unsafe.

"Now with proper shelter, we can put our worries aside and focus on improving ourselves.

"My children will grow up in a better condition and I hope they will benefit from it," said Md Nasir after receiving the key, together with three other recipients, from Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim during a ceremony yesterday.

The new house was built just behind his old house in the village.

Costing RM75,000 and measuring 660 sq ft, the house has a living room, three bedrooms and a bathroom.

The programme is an initiative of the Federal Government and coordinated by the Prime Minister's Office through its Penang Bumiputra Participation Department.

Recipients of the houses are

those earning below RM580 monthly, single mothers or people with chronic illnesses.

As a pilot project, four houses under the programme were built in Kampung Tok Bedu, Padang Menora, Penaga and Machang Bubok.

The houses are built on land

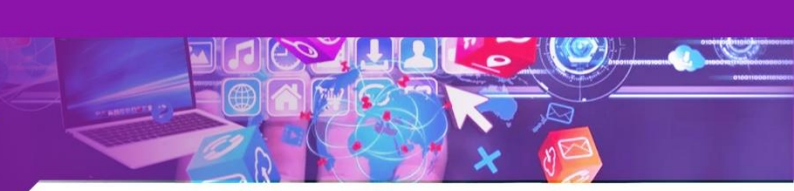
with temporary occupation licences (TOL) or privately owned land with permission.

Children of late Lina Samuel finally granted citizenship

MIRI: The children of the late Lina Samuel, a cancer patient from Lawas who made headlines in April this year after she was stripped of her MyKad, were finally granted citizenship.

Lina's youngest daughter Ruran Lukas, 42, and her three older siblings received their birth certificates, stating their Malaysian citizenship, at an event in Lawas yesterday.

"Yes, it is true that my siblings and I have been given citizenship. We have just received our birth certificates that clearly state that we are now citizens of Malaysia," she said in a telephone interview.

The birth certificates were presented to them by Lawas MP Datuk Henry Sum Agong.

Ruran said she and her siblings, Paul, Henry and Ramina, were overjoyed now that their dream and their mum's last wish had finally come true.

"Even though we are heartbroken that my mother

is no longer here with us to celebrate this day, but knowing that her last wish and prayer had been answered, we could not ask for more. We are very blessed and happy even though it has been a very long journey for us in getting our citizenship," she said.

She added that they would be going to the National Registration Department (JPN) office in Lawas this Monday to apply for their MyKad.

As for her mother's MyKad, which was seized by JPN Lawas last November, Ruran said she was told that they would not be getting the MyKad back as her mother had passed away.

"However, the detail on her death certificate stated that she was a Malaysian, and that is alright," she said.

Ruran thanked the Home Ministry for putting an end to their long struggle to obtain citizenship. She also thanked activist Agnes Padan and the

media who had helped highlight their plight in the news.

"With the MyKad, our children would be able to change their status from non-citizens to citizens and so too will our future grandchildren," Ruran said.

The late Lina, 65, made headlines in April after news reported her concern about getting follow-up cancer treatment in Miri because her MyKad had been seized by the JPN Lawas in November.

Her story quickly made the rounds on social media, which drew criticisms from many parties including several non-governmental organisations (NGOs).

In response, Home Minister Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail claimed that Lina was stripped of her MyKad because JPN discovered that she was an Indonesian citizen.

Lawyers for Liberty (LFL) also responded and called upon the government to return Lina's

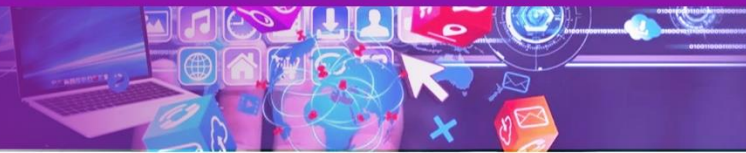
MyKad as the seizure was unlawful and unconstitutional.

On April 13, JPN Kuching sent officers to Lawas to meet

with Lina. Following the meeting, Lina was issued a temporary document to ease her travel to Miri for cancer

treatment.

Lina, who was diagnosed with Stage 4 colon cancer, however passed away on April 25.

Job scam on Facebook leaves woman RM133,432 poorer

KUCHING: A 60-year-old woman from Padawan has lost RM133,432 in a scam involving a non-existent part-time job.

In a statement yesterday, Sarawak police commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri said the victim came across the job offer on Facebook and immediately gave her phone number.

"She was then contacted via WhatsApp and given a link where she was required to make online purchases. The victim was also told that she would get a 35 per cent commission," said Mohd Azman.

The retired accounts assistant made 24 transactions from three of her bank accounts between April 12 and May 11 totalling RM133,432.

The money was transferred into seven bank accounts provided by the scammer.

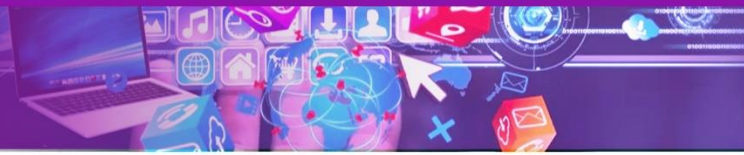
"She only realised that she was scammed after she only received RM43 from the scammer," said Mohd Azman.

He advised the public not to entertain calls or messages from strangers and to inform their family members should they receive such calls or messages.

"The public are also advised to contact the nearest police station or banks to confirm anything that was mentioned by the scammers," he said.

He added the public should never share their personal banking details with strangers and must immediately call the National Scam Response Centre on 997 if they feel that they have been scammed.

Ministry of Education aims to increase pre-school enrolment to 90 pct

ALOR SETAR: The Ministry of Education (MOE) aims to increase pre-school enrolment to 90 per cent from the current 80 per cent as a preliminary measure to prevent school dropouts.

Its Minister Fadhlina Sidek said that in order to achieve that target, MOE would open more pre-schools and run an advocacy campaign to encourage parents to send their children to pre-schools.

“Pre-school enrolment is currently at 80 per cent, while secondary school enrolment is

around 78 per cent, which is quite low compared to enrolment in primary schools, which is made compulsory, at 98 per cent.

“So we have two segments of students whose enrolment we need to focus on, namely pre-school and secondary school,” she told reporters after attending the Sesi Motivasi bersama Cikgu Menteri programme here Friday night.

In addition to the lack of pre-school classes, which was being addressed at the ministry level, Fadhlina cited poverty as a contributing factor to the low

primary pre-school enrollment rate.

Asked if the MOE intends to make pre-school education compulsory like primary education, Fadhlina said that the ministry must first resolve pre-school-related issues.

On secondary school dropout, she said a bill to make secondary education compulsory for students that would be tabled in Parliament would ensure that students completed their schooling up to Form Five.

MUKAH: Minister of Women, Children and Community Well-Being Development Sarawak Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah said July 22 should be given greater recognition in Malaysian history as Sarawak Independence Day.

“There is not much exposure in our history textbooks regarding July 22, our Sarawak’s independence date,” she said at the launch of Sarawak Merdeka Expedition in Mukah Division at the Mukah Civic Centre yesterday.

July 22, according to her, is equally important as other significant dates such as Aug 31 (National Day) and Sept 16 (Malaysia Day).

“It is appropriate for the date of July 22 to also have a special place in our history,” she stressed.

Fatimah, who is Dalat assemblywoman, also talked about the significance of Sarawak’s development over the past 60 years, especially in education.

She said 60 years ago, there were not many primary or secondary schools compared to the present time.

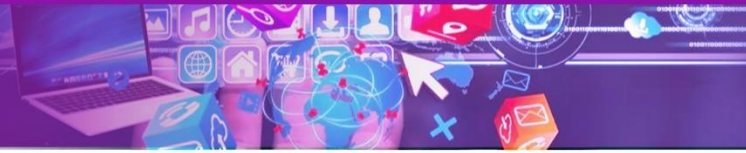
She pointed out that today, Mukah has higher education institutions and the healthcare facilities have also improved

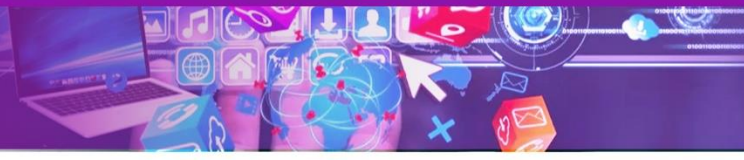
ditetapkan.

MUKAH: Silibus mata pelajaran Sejarah perlu dikaji semula, kata Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Kanak-Kanak dan Kesejahteraan Komuniti Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

Menurutnya, tarikh penting 22 Julai sebagai tarikh kemerdekaan Sarawak perlu dicatat.

“Sangat kurang pendedahan dalam mana-mana buku teks sejarah tentang tarikh 22 Julai ini yang merupakan tarikh Sarawak merdeka,” katanya ketika Majlis Pelancaran Kembara Sarawak Merdeka Bahagian Mukah di pekarangan Dewan Suarah Mesra Mukah semalam.

Fatimah berkata, tarikh itu juga sama dengan tarikh-tarikh penting lain seperti tarikh kemerdekaan 31 Ogos dan 16 September iaitu Hari Malaysia.

Sewajarnya tarikh 22 Julai turut mendapat tempat khusus dalam pahatan sejarah, katanya.

Sementara itu, bercakap mengenai 60 Tahun Sarawak Merdeka, Fatimah yang juga Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (ADUN) Dalat memberitahu ia sangat bertepatan dengan pengalaman serta usia beliau sendiri.

Katanya, dari segi beberapa aspek, Sarawak telah banyak berubah berbanding 60 tahun lalu terutamanya dari segi pendidikan.

“Jika memandang 60 tahun ke belakang, tidak banyak sekolah rendah atau sekolah menengah didirikan berbanding ketika ini.

“Apatah lagi di Mukah, kini sudah dilengkapi dengan kemudahan institusi pengajian tinggi yang suatu ketika dahulu hanya menjadi impian anak-anak luar bandar.

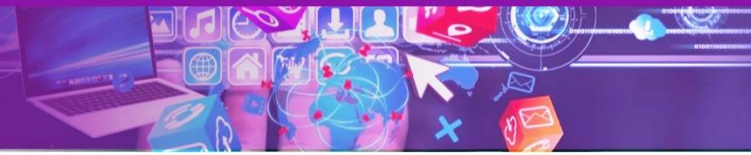

KUCHING: Seorang wanita warga emas mengalami kerugian sebanyak RM133,432 gara-gara terperdaya dengan iklan kerja sambilan di Facebook.

Pesuruhjaya Polis Sarawak Datuk Mohd Azman Mohd Sapri berkata

mangsa, 63, yang merupakan bekas pembantu akauntan, mula tertarik dengan iklan tersebut pada 26 Mac.

Menurutnya, mangsa meninggalkan nombor telefonnya dan telah dihubungi oleh seseorang yang memperkenalkan dirinya pekerja khidmat pelanggan.

"Mangsa telah diberikan laman web awan di mana mangsa dikehendaki menempah barang dan dibayar oleh mangsa sendiri.

"Mangsa tertarik dengan tawaran tersebut kerana akan diberi komisen sebanyak 35 peratus," katanya menerusi satu kenyataan semalam.

Azman berkata, mangsa yang telah terperdaya seterusnya membuat bayaran secara dalam talian.

"Sebanyak 24 transaksi pembayaran dibuat oleh mangsa dari tiga akaun banknya ke tujuh akaun bank berbeza berjumlah RM133,432.

"Pembayaran dibuat antara 12 April hingga 11 Mei tahun ini," katanya.

Menurutnya, mangsa hanya menyedari dirinya ditipu apabila hanya menerima RM43.

"Suspek selepas itu tidak dapat dihubungi lagi," katanya sambil menambah, siasatan lanjut pihak polis masih giat dijalankan.
