## Selangor mula seragam peraturan kecil taska

**Shah Alam:** Kerajaan negeri bersetuju memulakan program rintis pada peringkat pihak berkuasa tempatan (PBT) bagi menggerakkan usaha penyeragaman Undang-Undang Kecil berkaitan taman asuhan kanak-kanak (taska), terutama yang beroperasi di rumah.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Wanita dan Kebajikan Masyarakat negeri, Anfaal Saari, berkata perkara itu diputuskan melalui dua siri pertemuan dan perbincangan bersama Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) serta agensi Persekutuan.

"Bagi menyelesaikan isu taska tidak berdaftar, khususnya yang beroperasi di rumah, kerajaan negeri mengadakan dua siri sesi libat urus pada 6 Mac dan 2 Mei lalu bersama PBT, selain Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Selangor, Persatuan Taska Negeri Selangor dan wakil badan bukan kerajaan (NGO) dalam bidang pengasuhan dan penjagaan kanak-kanak.

"Ia bertujuan membincangkan isu dan cara penyelesaian wajar diambil pada peringkat kerajaan negeri ke peringkat KPWKM baru-baru ini," katanya ketika sesi penggulungan perbahasan pada Sidang Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) Selangor semalam.

Anfaal menegaskan, keselamatan kanak-kanak yang berada di tempat pengasuhan dan pusat penjagaan sememangnya tidak boleh dikompromi.

Justeru, usaha penyeragaman Undang-Undang Kecil itu diambil bertujuan memudahkan urusan permohonan dan menggalakkan pendaftaran pengusaha taska di rumah.

"Langkah seterusnya bagi meningkatkan kualiti perkhidmatan, pengasuhan dan penjagaan kanak-kanak, agenda ini akan dimuatkan di dalam Dasar Ekonomi Penjagaan yang sedang dirangka dan dijangka dilancarkan pada suku kedua 2024," katanya.

# 160,000 WARGA EMAS HIDAP MASALAH MATA

Seramai 160,000 penduduk negara ini yang berusia 50 tahun ke atas mengalami masalah kurang penglihatan manakala lapan peratus daripada jumlah berkenaan mengalami kebutaan.

Timbalan Menteri Kesihatan Datuk Lukanisman Awang Sauni berkata, jumlah itu berdasarkan hasil Tinjauan Mata Kebangsaan III menunjukkan prevalens kebutaan di kedua-dua zon menurun secara signifikan berbanding data daripada Tinjauan Mata Kebangsaan II.

Menurutnya, tinjauan pada 2014 merekodkan enam daripada 1,000 penduduk Sarawak mengalami kebutaan, berbanding 16 orang daripada 1,000 pada 2014 dan lapan daripada 1,000 penduduk Zon Timur mengalami kebutaan, berbanding 14 orang daripada

1,000 pada tahun yang sama.

Katanya, antara penyebab utama masalah kebutaan di kedua-dua zon itu disebabkan oleh Katarak, Retinopati Diabetes, Glaucoma dan penyakit bahagian belakang mata.

"Tinjauan Mata Kebangsaan III itu dijalankan pada Julai hingga Oktober lalu di

dua zon iaitu Zon Sarawak dan Zon Timur," katanya ketika berucap ketika merasmikan Majlis Pelancaran Dapatan NES3 dan Program Saringan Mata Kakitangan KKM sempena Hari Penglihatan Se Dunia di sini semalam.

Tinjauan di Zon Timur memabitkan Terengganu, Kelantan dan Pahang ma-

nakala di Sarawak bertujuan mengkaji prevalens kebutaan dan masalah penglihatan dalam kalangan rakyat Malaysia berusia 50 tahun dan ke atas.

Ia juga bertujuan menilai keberkesanan program intervensi kebutaan yang dilaksanakan seperti Klinik Katarak KKM dan Program Pencari Katarak.

## Dijel lima bulan rakam jiran mandi

**Melaka:** Seorang penjaga stor kedai serbaneka dituduh hukuman penjara lima bulan oleh Mahkamah Majistret Ayer Keroh di sini, semalam, selepas mengaku bersalah merakam jirannya mandi minggu lalu.

Majistret Nabilah Nizam menjatuhkan hukuman itu terhadap tertuduh, Muhammad Fakrul Najmi Rohaizan, 26, selepas menerima pengakuan tertuduh.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan, tertuduh didapati merakamkan gambar mangsa wanita berusia 44 tahun sedang mandi menggunakan telefon bimbit di sebuah rumah di Padang Temu, di sini, pada jam 10.50 malam, 10 November lalu.

Kesalahan itu didakwa mengikut Seksyen 509 Kanun Keseksaan, sabit kesalahan tertuduh boleh dihukum penjara maksimum lima tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya sekali.

Berdasarkan laporan po-

lis dibuat mangsa, dia menyedari dirinya dirakam selepas terlihat ada tangan memegang telefon bimbit di celah lubang angin tandas sebelum merampas telefon bimbit itu.

Mangsa bergegas mendapatkan suaminya dan menceritakan kejadian sebelum tertuduh yang juga anak jirannya datang untuk meminta maaf.

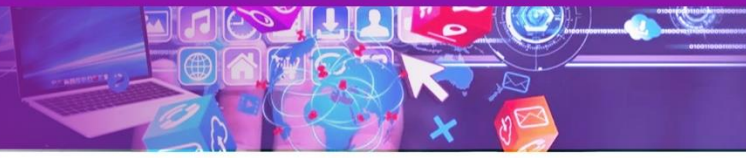
Terdahulu, tertuduh yang tidak diwakili peguam merayu hukumannya diringkaskan kerana menanggung keluarga dan hanya bekerja sebagai penjaga stor.

Bagaimanapun, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Wardah Ishhar memohon hukuman setimpal dikenakan sebagai pengajaran terhadap tertuduh.

Mahkamah kemudian menjatuhkan hukuman penjara lima bulan dari tarikh ditangkap iaitu pada 14 November lalu.

## 67 kids rescued from traffickers in past 5 years

**KUALA LUMPUR:** While some children enjoy the safety and stability of their homes, others are being trafficked into Malaysia, where they are exploited and coerced into begging or working as roadside vendors, leveraging their ability to evoke sympathy from passers-by.

Malaysian children are also not spared from being trafficked, as some were forced to be sex workers by their own fathers.

Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Anti-Smuggling of Migrants Council (MAPO) division secretary Syuhaida Abdul Wahab Zen said they had rescued 67 children under the age of 18 trafficked to Malaysia in the past five years.

While some of those under the age of 18 were being trafficked to work as beggars and sellers, there were also babies trafficked to be sold to new parents.

"Children are supposed to be

studying and learning. They are not to be exploited for begging. We have had cases of institutions trafficking children for begging for selling items like keychains.

"We want the public to know that whenever they have any information on children involved in trafficking, please report it to the authorities so that action can be taken," she said.

In terms of internal trafficking of children in Malaysia, Syuhaida said there were also instances of children being sexually trafficked by their fathers as a means to earn money and resolve debts.

Internal trafficking also affected married women, as there have been cases where husbands were found to have trafficked their wives for money, she added.

She cited the example of a former bank officer who was sentenced to 10 years in prison for sexually exploiting his wife by

charging clients RM1,000 per hour for sex with her. He reportedly did so to pay off his debts.

Persons with disabilities were also not spared, said Syuhaida, adding that they had handled a case of a woman who was deceived into becoming a sex worker by her neighbour.

In the case of sex trafficking, Syuhaida said MAPO had saved

22 Malaysians last year alone.

Syuhaida said managing sex trafficking was no easy feat, as some victims developed Stockholm syndrome, where they believed that their perpetrators were their saviours.

"They feel that the perpetrator was the only person that could help them. But, actually, they were the one who benefited from

acts they coerced the victims to do under the guise of love.

"So that's why sometimes they hesitate to lodge a report, as they feel that these people were their guardians.

"Stockholm syndrome affects victims across different types of trafficking, but it is especially prevalent in sex trafficking." **By Ilyia Marsya Iskandar**

# Man charged with rape, sex assault

**KUALA KANGSAR:** A 52-year-old man was charged in the Sessions Court here yesterday with three counts of raping and sexually assaulting a 14-year-old girl.

The accused, however, pleaded not guilty to the charges read before Judge Rohaida Ishak.

The man is accused of raping the girl in a village in Grik at 1pm on March 27.

For the offence, he faces a jail term of up to 20 years and whipping, upon conviction.

The man, an odd-job worker, was also charged with two counts of sexual assault against the victim at the same time and location.

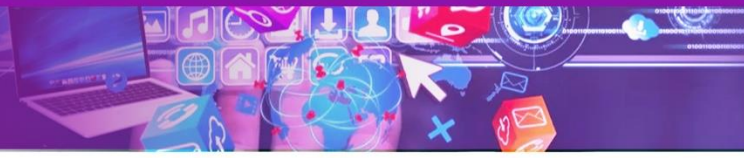
For this offence, he also faces up to 20 years' jail and whipping.

Deputy public prosecutor Muhammad Firdaus Nor Azlan did not offer bail as the accused was the victim's neighbour.

However, the court set bail at RM10,000 with two sureties.

It also imposed additional conditions prohibiting the accused and his family from approaching and disturbing the victim.

Rohaida set Dec 18 for mention.

## Curtin M'sia reaches out to Miri Methodist Children's Home

**MIRI:** Curtin University Malaysia (Curtin Malaysia)'s final-year construction management students and staff members recently held a community engagement and knowledge transfer programme especially for the orphans at Miri Methodist Children's Home.

Supported by academic staff from its Department of Built Environment, Faculty of Humanities and Health Sciences, the students took the opportunity to impart basic knowledge about building materials and construction to the children.

"The event aimed to cultivate a sense of social responsibility in Curtin students, while providing them with an opportunity to develop leadership skills and apply the knowledge acquired in their academic journey," said the university in a statement.

Students from other disciplines such as accounting, marketing, and civil and construction engineering also took part in the outreach.

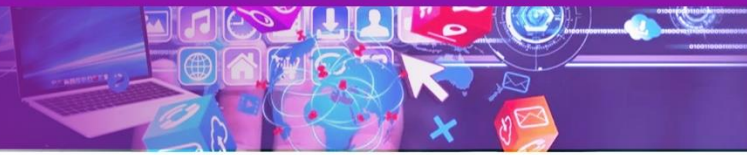
A total of 15 children from the orphanage, aged from five to 15 years old, learned about the various building materials and got actively involved 'mix-

## By-laws on childcare centres in Selangor to be standardised

**SHAH ALAM:** The Selangor government has agreed to start a pilot programme at the local authority level (PBT) to mobilise efforts to standardise by-laws related to home daycare operators.

State women's development and social welfare committee

chairman Anfaal Saari said this followed two series of meetings and discussions involving the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry and the relevant federal agencies to resolve the problem of unregistered nurseries operating at home.

She said the pilot programme aimed to simplify application matters and encourage the registration of home daycare operators.

"The next step is to improve the quality of services and childcare. This agenda will be included in the Care Economy Policy which

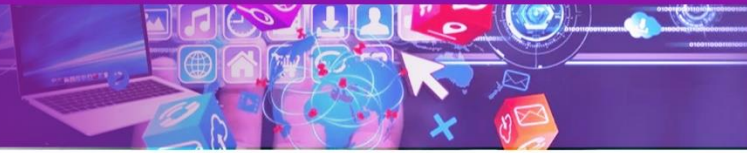
is being drafted and is expected to be launched in the second quarter of 2024," she said.

She said this when winding up the Supply Enactment Bill 2024 at the state assembly yesterday, Bernama reported.

Anfaal said the state government would not compromise on

the safety of children in childcare centres.

She said the issue needed to be dealt with more carefully because it involved the enforcement of the Child Care Centre Act and the Child Care Centre Regulations as well as by-laws at the PBT level.

If you use a rear-facing baby seat, another thing to do is to buy a baby car seat mirror. This will enable the driver to monitor the

baby in the seat. This nifty gadget is easily available at online retail platforms.

We can rely on gadgets, habits and even technology to remind us, but the responsibility for the safety of our children falls on our shoulders. There are no two ways about it. Ensure you are always alert to the whereabouts of your child.

I do realise parenting can be dif-

icult – you are deprived of sleep, stressed, and that's even before we consider work demands. However, we owe it to our children to do our best to keep them safe, so use everything, including cooperation with your spouse, work out a schedule, come up with a roster, whatever, to ensure your own well-being and, consequently, that of your child's.

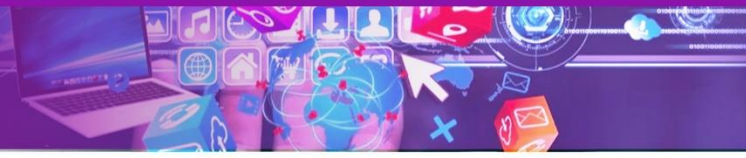
