# 'Henti pertikai pakaian jururawat'

**KKM utamakan penyampaian khidmat terbaik berbanding isu seragam kakitangan**

**Johor Bahru:** Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) mempunyai etika pemakaian yang jelas dan sudah ditetapkan, kata Menteri, Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

Berikutan itu, katanya, isu pakaian jururawat hospital awam

di negara ini yang dikatakan ketat dan tidak mematuhi syariah, tidak perlu diperbesarkan.

Katanya, apa yang lebih diberikan keutamaan KKM adalah soal penyampaian perkhidmatan terbaik kepada rakyat.

"Saya sebenarnya sudah menjawab hal ini dan pada saya jika lihat pada pakaian jururawat ini ada etika yang jelas.

"Pada saya, ia tiada masalah, kerana yang paling penting ialah kita memberi keutamaan kepada penyampaian perkhidmatan kepada rakyat," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika sidang media pada Majlis Penyerahan Projek Bangunan Baharu Makmal Patologi, HSA; Klinik Kesihatan Taman Ungku Tun Aminah dan Klinik Kesihatan Palong Timur, Segamat di HSA, di sini, semalam.

Turut hadir, Timbalan Menteri Pelaburan, Perdagangan dan Industri, Liew Chin Tong; Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Kesihatan dan Perpaduan negeri, Ling Tian Soon; Ketua Pengarah Kesihatan, Datuk Dr Muhammad Radzi Abu Hassan dan Pengarah Kesihatan Johor, Dr Mohtar Pungut @ Ahmad.

## Perhalusi cadangan

Terdahulu, Dr Zalina diminta mengulas kenyataan seorang Ahli Parlimen Perikatan Nasional (PN), Wan Razali Wan Nor (PN-Kuantan) yang mempersoalkan etika pemakaian jururawat wanita yang didakwa ketat dan tidak patuh syariah.

Dalam perkembangan lain, Dr Zalina berkata, KKM akan memperhalusi cadangan Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri

dan Kos Sara Hidup (KPDN) yang mahu pesakit kanser dibenar beli susu formula khas di hospital dengan harga lebih murah berbanding pasaran.

Katanya, pihaknya perlu meneliti keperluan cadangan berkenaan dan melihat kesesuaian susu formula yang dikhaskan untuk pesakit kanser itu.

"Kita perlu melihat perincian perkara ini, mengenai susu, apa kandungannya, sesuai atau tidak untuk pesakit kanser dan sebagainya.

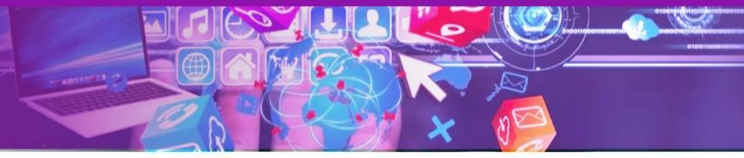
"Kalau perlu dan ada kepentingan kepada pesakit, kita boleh perhalusi perkara ini," katanya.

Kelmarin, media melaporkan, KPDN akan berbincang dengan Menteri Kesihatan supaya pesakit kanser boleh beli susu formula khas di hospital lebih murah berbanding pasaran.

## Hilang 3 insan tersayang sekelip mata

Ibu Zahidah yang enggan namanya disiarkan berkata, seorang lagi cucunya, Muhammad Uwais Wafiuddin Mohd Riduan, 8, yang turut terbabit dalam kemalangan itu kini menerima rawatan di HTAA.

"Sedih bila teringatkan nasib Muhammad Uwais yang kini tinggal bersendirian selepas kedua ibu bapa dan adik perempuannya pergi menghadap Ilahi.

"Saya tidak putus berdoa agar Muhammad Uwais segera sembuh. Saya dan ahli keluarga lain akan menjaga dia sebaik mungkin.

"Saya nak dia belajar dengan cemerlang dan menjadi anak yang berjaya dalam pelajaran," katanya ketika dihubungi.

Beliau berkata, kedua-dua cucu sangat rapat dengannya dan ahli keluarga lain kerana beliau yang menjaga dua kanak-kanak itu ketika ibu bapa mereka bekerja.

Katanya, ketika kejadian, kedua-dua pasangan itu membawa anak mereka ke Kuantan kerana menantunya, Mohd Riduan hendak melakukan rawatan kaki.

"Dalam perjalanan pulang ke rumah di Kampung Raja Teluk Pasu, Kuala Terengganu, mereka

terbabit dalam kemalangan itu.

"Saya terkejut dan sedih bila mendapat berita anak dan menantu meninggal di tempat kejadian," katanya.

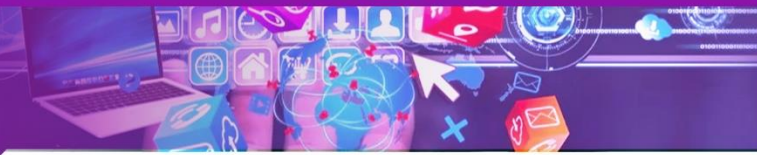
Beliau berkata, Zahidah anak yang baik serta selalu menuruti apa sahaja kehendaknya dan kali terakhir arwah itu sempat membawa sate yang dipesannya.

"Saya tidak sangka keinginan menikmati sate yang dibawa arwah serta makan bersamanya

adalah saat terakhir kami bersama.

"Apapun saya tetap reda dengan apa yang berlaku dan berharap supaya roh semua anak, menantu dan cucu saya itu ditempatkan dalam kalangan orang yang soleh," katanya.

Beliau berkata, jenazah tiga beraanak itu akan dikuburkan dalam satu liang lahad di Tanah Perkuburan Islam Kampung Sekati, Kuala Terengganu, sebaik proses bedah siasat selesai.

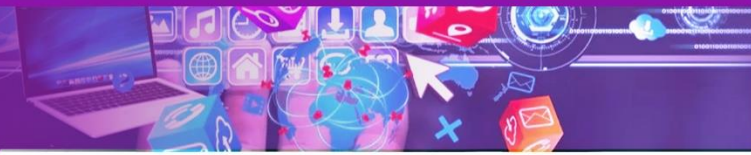

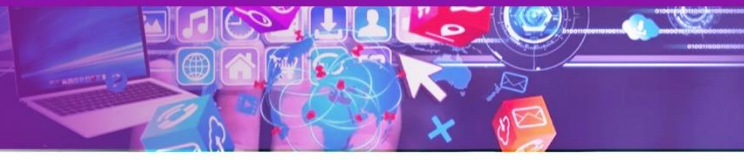

Nurul Syazwani Sajari, 32, dan adiknya, Nurul Farhanah, 29, yang kini berada di Tanah Suci untuk menunaikan ibadat haji, dibawa petugas Tabung Haji (TH) ke kawasan perkuburan itu, kira-kira 15 kilometer dari maktab penginapan mereka di Abraj Janadriyah di sini.

Ketika memandang deretan kubur tidak bertanda di kawasan tanah perkuburan itu, air mata kedua-dua mereka dilihat berjuraian sambil doa turut dibaca buat Allahyarham Sajari Sawi.

Menurut Nurul Syazwani, emosinya sebelum ini sudah tersentuh selepas melihat petugas TH yang mengenakan pakaian seragam seperti pernah dipakai ayahnya ketika tiba di Lapangan Ter-

bang Antarabangsa Prince Mohammad bin Abdulaziz, 30 Mei lepas.

"Kami ada rancangan untuk ziarah kubur ayah bersama mak, tetapi mak sakit dan meninggal dunia dua tahun selepas ayah pergi disebabkan kanser," katanya ketika ditemui di sini.

Allahyarham Sajari, petugas TH pada musim haji 1437 Hijrah meninggal dunia di khemah di Mina, Arab Saudi jam 6.10 pagi waktu tem-

patan pada 14 September 2016 akibat serangan jantung ketika berusia 56 tahun.

Sajari yang berkhidmat dengan TH sejak 1985 dan bertugas sebagai Penolong Pengurus Zon 1 (Madinah) ketika itu, dikuburkan di perkuburan berkenaan selepas solat Zuhur pada hari sama.

Mengimbau kembali kenangan terakhir sebelum Allahyarham berangkat ke Tanah Suci di Kompleks TH Kelana Jaya, Nurul Syazwani berkata, ayahnya berpesan supaya dia menjaga solat dan dua adiknya, Nurul Farhanah dan Muhammad Syamil, 28.

Menurutnya, ayahnya begitu gembira kerana dapat bertugas pada tahun itu berbanding tahun-tahun sebelumnya, selain berkongsi resipi dan mengajarnya memasak nasi arab yang sebelum itu tidak dikongsikan kepada ahli keluarga, walaupun diminta berbuat demikian.

Dia mengenali Muhammad Hawari Hashim sejak 18 tahun lalu dan sepanjang tempoh itu hubungan persahabatan mereka baik kerana rakanranya itu seorang yang peramah serta mudah bergaul dalam komuniti termasuk dirinya.

"Muhammad Hawari adalah pelajar kesayangan dan disenangi ramai kerana seorang yang baik, kelakar dan ringan tulang.

"Dia juga banyak berkongsi ilmu, tip dan pengalaman tentang pendakian dan alam semula jadi.

"Saya bersyukur mendapat bimbingan dan latihan daripada Muhammad Hawari. Dia pernah cuba mendaki Gunung Everest pada 2022, malangnya tidak dapat sampai puncak Everest sebab cuaca buruk sebelum ia ditangguhkan pada tahun ini.

"Muhammad Hawari juga pernah cakap pada saya akan menjalani latihan dengannya dan jika saya yakin dengan kemampuan diri itu yang akan membantu menayakan ekspedisi pendakian," katanya ketika dihubungi melalui aplikasi WhatsApp hari ini.

Muhammad Hawari yang juga pendaki OKU dalam misi Malaysia Everest 2023 (ME2023) dilaporkan hilang selepas dilaporkan berjaya menawan Gunung Everest pada 19 Mei lalu.

Menurut Hui, kehilangan Muhammad Hawari itu me-

nejutkannya dan turut menyedihkan komuniti pekak termasuk dirinya selain sentiasa berharap supaya bapa kepada dua anak itu segera ditemui dan pulang ke tanah air.

"Muhammad Hawari menjadi inspirasi saya dalam komuniti pekak, malah kejayaannya juga menggalakkan saya untuk menghadapi cabaran peribadi akan datang," katanya yang berkerja dalam bidang perakaunan dan berasal dari Johor.

Difahamkan, Hui adalah wanita pekak pertama negara yang mendaki dan menawan Annapurna Base Camp (ABC) setinggi 4,310 meter (m) dari aras laut dengan misi itu dilakukan bersama pasukan Kelab Ohana Adventure Sport pada 2019.

Kejayaan Hui itu diinspirasikan daripada kecekalan dan semangat Muhammad Hawari yang aktif melakukan aktiviti lasak walaupun berstatus OKU.

Mengimbas memori ketika berjaya menawan puncak ABC, Hui Xin berkata, Muhammad Hawari ketika itu baru mendarat di Kathmandu, Nepal untuk misi sama

dan mereka hampir berjumpa, namun tidak jadi sebelum saling mengucapkan tahniah atas kejayaan itu.

Menurutnya, melihat kemampuan rakan OKU lain termasuk Muhammad Hawari melakukan aktiviti lasak hingga ada yang berdaya menempa nama, menaikkan semangatnya untuk melakukan perkara sama.

"Meskipun secara fizikal pendaki mempunyai stamina, namun ia masih berisiko diserang akut gunung atau *altitude mountain sickness* (AMS) yang menyebabkan simptom pening, mual dan kehilangan koordinasi badan ketika di ketinggian 3,000m.

"Justeru, perjalanan ke ABC adalah sangat mencabar, bukan saja kerana kecuramannya, malah AMS juga boleh menjadi serius walaupun seseorang pendaki itu sudah membuat persiapan terbaik," katanya.

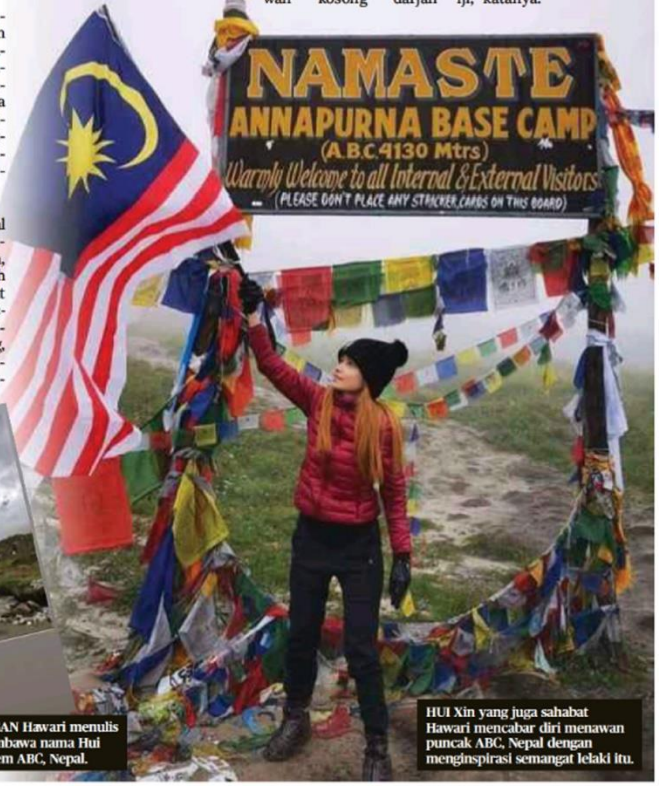
Menurutnya, puncak ABC menjadi pengalaman uniknya dan bersyukur

dia dapat menayakan misi itu biarpun menghadapi cabaran getir dalam perjalanan selama 11 hari.

"Ia pengalaman peribadi saya untuk pertama kali cuba membiasakan diri dengan kawasan beraltitud tinggi atau berdepan keadaan cuaca sejuk sehingga jatuh ke paras bawah kosong darjah

Celsius dan itu sudah pasti menjadi cabaran dalam pendakian berkenaan.

"Selain itu, pendakian ke ABC yang sukar untuk dijangka perubahan iklim juga menjadi cabaran kepada kumpulan pendaki terutama apabila tiba di kem MBC (*Machapuchare Base Camp*) yang kadang-kadang bersalji," katanya.

Dua sahabat, Hadi Rahim dan Norhazim Izzat Md Azman tidak hanya berkongsi minat sama berlari serta berbasikal namun kedua-duanya turut dikurniakan 'anak syurga'.

Meskipun begitu, Hadi, 33, dan Norhazim Izzat, 36, tidak pernah malu memiliki anak istimewa sebaliknya gemar membawa cahaya mata mereka beriadah bersama terutama pada hujung minggu.

Bagi Hadi, anak sulungnya, Hanaa Sofea, enam tahun, yang menghidap penyakit jarang jumpa, Prader-Willi Syndrome (PWS) (satu gangguan genetik akibat ketiadaan bagan genetik aktif pada kromosom 15 salinan paternal) berhak merasai nikmat kebebasan seperti insan normal.

Berikutan itu, Hadi tidak meninggalkan Hanaa Sofea, tetapi mengajaknya bersama dalam acara larian dan berbasikal sejak umur dua tahun.

"Sebelum kahwin saya aktif bersukan cuma selepas kelahiran Sofea dunia berasa gelap, ibarat tiada makna.

"Ia kerana ketika itu, saya

dan isteri (Ainaa Rosli, 32) sedih seolah-olah menafikan keadaan anak kami.

"Mengenangkan Sofea perlu perhatian dan kasih sayang, kami cuba bangkit dan beranikan diri membawa Sofea beriadah," katanya ketika ditemui di Dataran Putrajaya di sini, kelmarin.

Pada awalnya, Hadi yang bekerja sebagai pegawai eksekutif di sebuah syarikat sekadar membawa Sofea beriadah di sekitar taman perumahan sebelum menyertai acara berbasikal dan larian *fun run*.

Katanya, tindakannya membawa hasil positif apabila Hanaa Sofea lebih gembira menunjukkan perubahan positif.

Berkongsi ringkas mengenai Hanaa Sofea, Hadi berkata, anaknya itu meragam

pada waktu tertentu namun disifatkan penyayang, ceria dan aktif terutama apabila diajak beriadah.

"Saya harap semua sahabat di luar sana yang senasib (memiliki anak istimewa) lebih terbuka untuk terbahit dalam aktiviti sebegini bersama anak masing-masing," katanya.

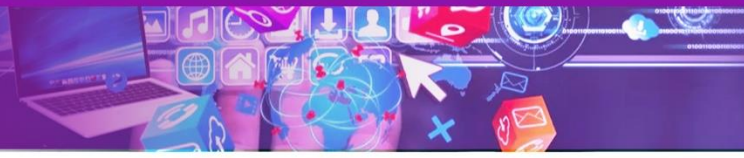
Sementara itu, Norhazim Izzat menyifatkan dua anaknya Muhammad Adam Huzair, empat tahun dan Nur Alisyah Humaira, tujuh tahun yang dikategorikan autisme ringan sebagai anugerah terindah daripada Allah SWT.

Norhazim Izzat tidak janggal atau malu membawa dua anaknya beriadah kerana ia menjadi rutin dan terapi buat mereka sekeluarga pada setiap hujung minggu.

"Anak saya sebelum ini meragam dan nampak ketara waktu Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP) kerana tidak dapat keluar rumah.

"Apabila sering bawa mereka beriadah, saya nampak ada perubahan baik apabila lebih mudah tidur dan kurang meragam seperti sebelumnya.

"Memang ada yang pandang semacam apabila bawa anak keluar. Namun saya tidak ambil pusing kerana mereka (anak) juga berhak merasai hidup gembira seperti orang lain," katanya yang mengalukan penyertaan ibu bapa anak istimewa lain dalam aktiviti riadah dan sukan.

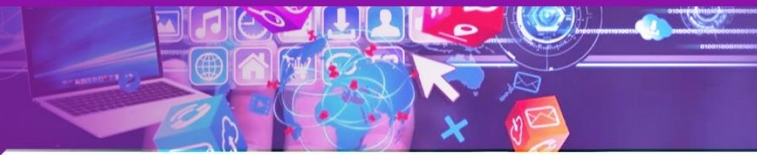

“Tengkorak dan serpihan tulang dihantar ke Jabatan Forensik Hospital Daerah Segamat (HDS) untuk pemeriksaan lanjut oleh pakar patologi.

“Sampel DNA waris sudah diambil dan polis menunggu laporan penuh daripada forensik dan patologi,” katanya kepada Harian Metro semalam.

Dalam pada itu, Ahmad Zamry menasihati orang ramai tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi.

“Usah buat sebarang spekulasi sehingga laporan penuh dan melengkapkan siasatan.

“Setakat ini, kes diklasifikasikan sebagai mati mengejut,” katanya.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan dalam kejadian jam 7.15 malam pada 20 September lalu, Ithnin Warsan, 80, dikatakan berada di halaman kediamannya di Kampung Tungku Tiga di sini, sebelum menghilang tanpa jejak.

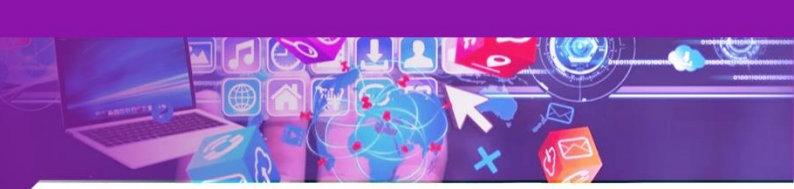

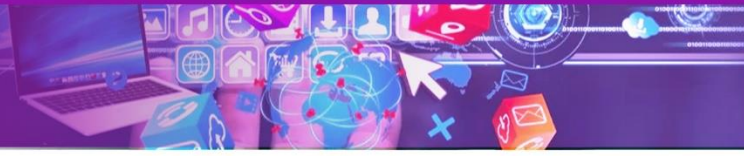

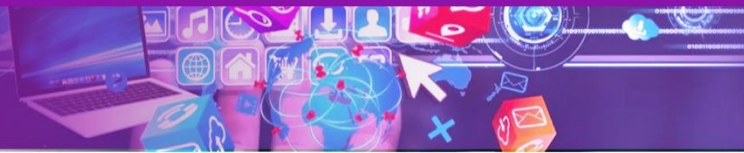

"Badan bukan kerajaan, pemimpin tempatan, syarikat swasta atau sesiapa sahaja ingin membuat program tanggungjawab sosial korporat (CSR), inilah tempatnya (SKSSR).

"Carum untuk suri rumah

yang boleh dapat faedah jika belaku apa-apa kepada mereka walaupun mereka tidak kerja," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika ditemui media sejourus menyampaikan faedah kepada pencarum R Chandran, 40, yang mendapat Faedah Hilang Upaya Kekal di kediaman lelaki itu di Taman Desa Temiang di sini, semalam.

Chandran yang kini bekerja sebagai penghantar makanan mengalami kemalangan pada 2012 ketika da-

lam perjalanan pulang dari tempat kerja.

Mengulas lanjut mengenai SKSSR, Sivakumar berkata, ibu tunggal atau wanita yang belum berkahwin juga layak untuk mencarum menerusi SKSSR.

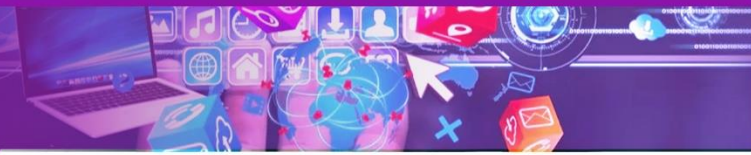
"Sebelum ini saya bekerja di sebuah syarikat di Bahau sebelum terbabit kemalangan pada 2012.

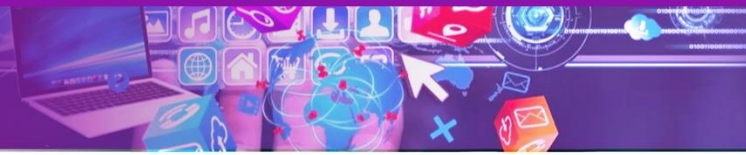

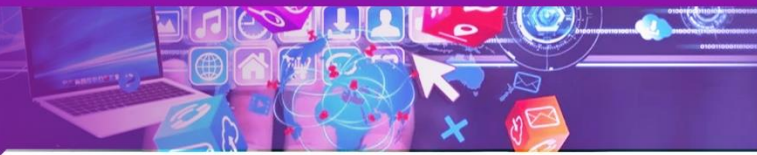

## Pregnant woman held for insulting king over Kit Siang award

**GEORGE TOWN:** Police have arrested a woman for allegedly insulting the Yang di-Pertuan Agong on social media.

The woman was detained by Bukit Aman's Classified Crime Investigation Unit at the Seberang Prai Utara police headquarters on June 13.

State police chief Datuk Khaw Kok Chin said police received a report from the public on June 7 concerning social media content that could affect public orderliness.

"Following that, Bukit Aman's investigation unit detained a 32-year-old woman at the Seberang Prai Utara police headquarters on June 13.

"She was arrested for allegedly uploading insulting content onto

social media against the Yang di-Pertuan Agong in connection to the recent awarding of the Tan Sri award to Lim Kit Siang.

"She had linked him to triggering the May 13, 1969 riot.

"Evidence, such as a laptop, handphone and SIM card, were taken from her to assist in the investigation."

Khaw said the woman was released on bail on the same day, as she was six months pregnant.

The case is being probed under Section 4(1) of the Sedition Act 1948 and Section 233 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998.

Khaw said the case had been taken over by Bukit Aman's investigation unit.

ALARMING TREND

MALE KIDS TARGETED IN SEXUAL CRIMES

AS the digital world becomes more accessible, a growing number of children, including boys, are falling prey to sexual crimes. Faced with such a horrific trend, the police force has set up a new unit to put a stop to things, write KALBANA PERIMBANAYAGAM and NUR ZARINA OTHMAN in the first of a two-part series

KUALA LUMPUR

POLICE in Malaysia have recorded a significant rise in sexual crimes against children, including rape, grooming and sexual extortion. This has been brought on by the rapid growth of the Internet and the easy accessibility we now enjoy, with practically every child having a smartphone or device at hand.

What is more, the rise in sexual crimes against children is not gender-specific, with a growing trend of boys being targeted as well.

With such crimes on the rise, the police force set up a new, specially trained unit in February.

Federal Sexual, Women and Children Crime Investigation Division (DII) principal assistant director Assistant Commissioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan said the Malaysia Internet Crimes Against Children (Micac) would probe into sexual crimes and offences committed against children using the Internet as a medium.

"What are internet crimes against children? The definition can vary, but in the department's context, it is when a child is made to be a sexual victim via the Internet, whether it involves a sexual act, grooming, or being coaxed to provide explicit materials," she told the New Straits Times.

She said things normally started when a stranger communicated with a minor online, and once he or she had gained the victim's trust, the perpetrator would go on to ask for nude pictures or engage in video calls.

This, said Siti Kamsiah, might shift into the grooming phase before they actually arrange to meet. "All this is already an offence." The abuser does not have to meet the child or commit any sexual act with him or her to be arrested.

"Communicating in a sexual manner online and requesting photos in a compromising position alone are sufficient for him or her to be charged," she said.

Although child sexual exploitation mostly involved young female children, Siti Kamsiah said there was a new, growing trend involving young boys as well.

"Recently, online sexual crimes against young boys seem to be on the rise, with the suspects also mostly being male. Sexual crimes against children are no longer limited to female children like in those days."

She said another tactic used by online predators was to instil a sense of belonging to make the child feel special and to find a common interest to make a topic of discussion between the two.

"For instance, K-pop. The perpetrators will use this to slowly gain the child's trust through a series of interactions before he goes on to ask for explicit personal materials on the Internet.

"It will normally start with a photograph, then video calls (where he asks the child to undress), which he will secretly record to be used against them (as a threat) when the child no longer wants to engage in such acts with the perpetrator."

Siti Kamsiah said materials gathered via online chats, recorded sexual materials and video calls were known among investigators as child sexual abuse materials (CSAM).

She said those who were most vulnerable were mostly under the age of 10.

"This is because children under 10 have the minimum ability to understand or comprehend any action in a mature manner. They are also unable to understand their actions and the repercussions."

Siti Kamsiah said paedophilia was not prevalent in Malaysia, but the rise in such cases had set off alarm bells and worried the authorities.

With children as young as 5 having access to the Internet via smart gadgets and such crimes being transborder, it would take a lot to put an end to the scourge.

"For us to eradicate such crimes individually is not possible due to the constraints of technology, training and manpower."

"Micac is a very new unit, and we have only about 10 members at present," said Siti Kamsiah.

She said as "newbies", they were still very much dependent on information and knowledge-sharing with counterparts from more advanced countries in curbing internet crimes against children.

Countries like those in the West, she said, were more familiar with online sexual crimes involving children because they began dealing with them much earlier.

'Victims need support in the long recovery process'

Over the years, these countries have mastered and advanced in the latest technology to identify sexual crimes against children quickly.

"Malaysian police have good collaboration with our counterparts in the United States, Australia, Canada and others, especially in terms of sharing information and raising red flags on child sexual materials."

"Any time someone using a Malaysian IP (Internet protocol) address accesses child pornography on the Internet, enforcement agencies abroad will be alerted."

"Even if the person uses encryption to upload or access such CSAM materials on the Internet, police are still able to track them."

"We have done it before. There was this case where a man uploaded photos and videos of him touching a child's private parts and doing things that he was not supposed to on a website."

"This had been going on for some time, and the enforcement agency in the US was flagged about his regular posts."

"They immediately alerted Micac and provided us with the IP address. We did our own investigations with the help of the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission and traced the IP to a house in Johor."

During interrogation, the suspect admitted that he recorded himself performing the sexual acts on his 7-year-old niece.

"The girl was 13 years old by then, but we still managed to charge him for his offences."

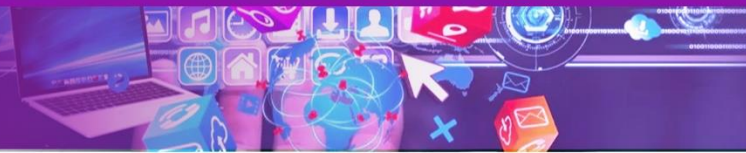
"In these sorts of cases, the real challenge is when we need to interview the victims about what happened and get them to recollect what the suspects had done to them."

She said this was because getting a victim to recall such a traumatising experience was not easy and could have long-lasting effects on their mental health.

"Children who have been victims of child sexual exploitation must be given proper counselling and medical treatment by professionals."

The recovery process is long, and victims must receive the necessary support and encouragement from those around them. Otherwise, there is a high chance that the victims themselves would become addicted to sexual activities."

## More than RM250,000 in SKSSR benefits paid to housewives, families — Sivakumar

He said a total of RM254,617 in benefits had also been paid to insured housewives and families under the social safety net programme for the period starting from Dec 1.

"Housewives are encouraged to register and contribute to SKSSR for protection against domestic disasters, disability or death while managing the household.

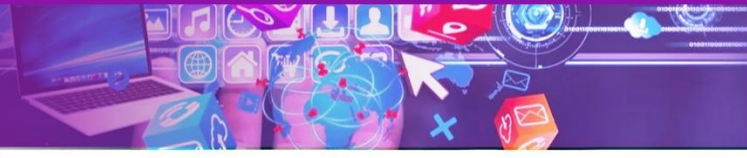
"I encourage husbands to pay the SKSSR contribution of RM120 a year for their respective wives in appreciation of their role and sacrifices towards the family," he told reporters here yesterday.

Sivakumar also called on non-governmental organisations and private companies to sponsor SKSSR contributions for the welfare of their employees, as a corporate social responsibility.

Earlier, Sivakumar had presented Social Security Organisation (Socso) benefits to contributor R. Chandran in Taman Desa Temiang here.

Chandran, 40, while working as a salesman at a tobacco company near here, suffered an accident in 2012 and he received RM14,291.62 after being referred to a panel of doctors to determine permanent disability benefits.

# Over 30 have heads shaved at Kuching's GoBald 2023 event

**KUCHING:** Over 30 participants, including three family members of a childhood cancer patient, had their heads shaved during the GoBald 2023 event at Vivacity Megamall here yesterday.

According to organiser Sarawak Children's Cancer Society (SCCS), there were also 13 participants who had gone bald, but they did it either at an appointed salon or at home under an alternative option made available in the campaign, which was run in connection with the ongoing 'Cancer Survivor Month'.

"One of the main challenges that can be distressing for some children is losing hair as a side effect of cancer treatments such as chemotherapy. When participants choose to go bald voluntarily, it is an empowering act of support, to show children that they are willing to fight this battle and walk the journey with them.

"The shared understanding and camaraderie can uplift their spirit and foster a sense of hope for these little cancer-fighters," said SCCS president Rodney Wong.

He also highlighted the spreading of hope and delivering optimism to childhood cancer patients and survivors as among the key messages of GoBald 2023, anchored on the theme of 'Dare to Dream'.

"It was a carefully planned decision to ensure that we would carry out both Miri and Kuching physical GoBald events in June, as we observe 'Cancer Survivor Month'.

"This is part of our initiatives in sending out a strong message of hope and strength to about 40 children who are currently under active treatment, and about 150 children who are still in remission and continuing follow-up care across Sarawak," he added.

GoBald has been one of the major fundraising channels for SCCS since the annual campaign was introduced in 2009, having garnered support from over

10,000 participants across Malaysia over the last 14 years.

To date, the drive has raised more than RM753,000 from over 1,900 donors. This month-to-date, 130 people in Malaysia have signed up for GoBald, with at least 108 pledging to shave their heads. They include 28 students and teachers from Lodge Group of Schools who have committed to going bald at a satellite event this July 11.

"Our gratitude goes to all the fundraisers and donors for their unwavering support and advocacy for GoBald and the cause of childhood cancer.

"We acknowledge that their contributions play a vital role in ensuring that children in Sarawak with cancer would receive comprehensive treatment, care and support," said Wong.

Meanwhile, the three family members who went bald yesterday did it as a show of support for 14-year-old Daniel Kueh.

The boy was diagnosed with T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukaemia (T-ALL) in May and currently, he is undergoing active

treatment at Sarawak General Hospital (SGH) here.

Daniel's three supporters are his parents Kueh Joo Leong and Karen Kueh, and his aunt Michelle Kueh.

"We are inspired by Daniel's optimism through the many challenges in his cancer-fighting journey. We hope to show Daniel that everyone here is rooting for him to get better.

"No matter how tough this journey can be, we want him to know that we are with him every step of the way and he is not fighting this battle alone.

"So let us have hope and be strong because this is just another obstacle to overcome in life," said Karen.

GoBald, being the flagship awareness and fundraising campaign for SCCS, significantly contributes to the society's annual expenditure of nearly RM2 million. Every year, the proceeds from the GoBald event account for between 20 per cent and 30 per cent of SCCS's total expenses.

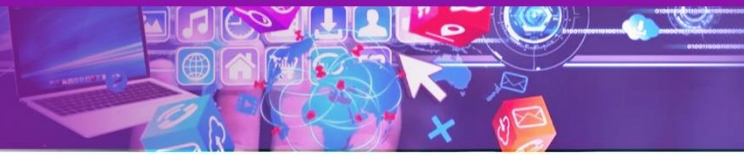
Since its inception in 2001, SCCS has supported over 1,600 families fighting childhood

cancer in Sarawak, and the non-profit organisation is primarily relying on public donations to run its programmes.

"Unlike the many cancers that

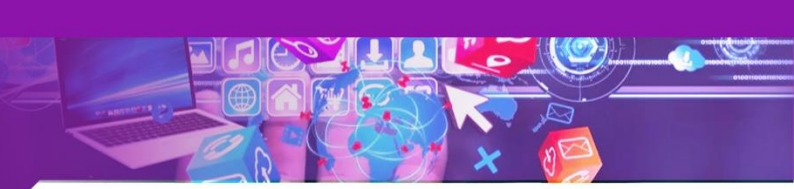

## Two women lose over RM200,000 each to separate online scams

**KUCHING:** A woman has lodged a police report after losing nearly RM240,000 to an online investment scheme she joined last year.

Sarawak Police Commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri in a statement yesterday said the 44-year-old victim had on Nov 27 last year received a WhatsApp message from an individual named 'Royman' who claimed to be a Singaporean.

"Royman managed to convince the victim to join an investment scheme. She was also told to download an app called 'App Trust' from the Google Playstore and submit her personal details, and to contact a person via

Telegram.

"The victim then texted then person on Telegram and was told to invest money to receive her earnings," he said.

According to Mohd Azman, the woman made a total of 17 online transactions between Nov 27, 2022 and Feb 15, 2023 to nine different bank accounts totalling RM238,481.

However, he said the woman has to date only received a return of RM500 from her investment and decided to file a police report for investigation.

In a separate case, Mohd Azman informed that a 47-year-old female IT officer from Kota Samarahan lost over RM200,000

after responding to a 'job advertisement' on Facebook.

He said the woman came across the ad on June 11 and submitted her phone number.

"She was then contacted via WhatsApp and Telegram by a person who claimed to be from an online recruitment company.

"The company claimed to offer part-time jobs to help YouTubers and online selling platforms reach and direct more users to their websites.

"The victim was told to register an application via <http://pgmallbuy.com>, where she would be given payments and bonuses for every completed task given to her," said Mohd

Azman.

He said on June 12, the woman was told that in order to gain more returns, she had to make a 'pre-order payment'.

"From June 12 to June 16, the victim made a total of 14 transactions to seven bank accounts totalling RM201,186. She only realised she had been scammed after she did not receive any returns," he added.

He reminded the public to not entertain unknown phone calls and to immediately notify their partners, friends or family members of such phone calls, and to check with the police station, banks or related agencies for confirmation.

# 'No problem with uniforms'

## Health Minister clarifies nurses adhere to dress code

**JOHOR BARU:** There is no problem with the uniform of nurses in the country and the focus should instead be on providing good services to the people, says Health Minister Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

"There (is a dress code) that nurses adhere to when it comes to uniforms, and it is clear to me that there is no problem.

"We have just tabled the Health White Paper and we should be focusing on what is important, which is providing the best health services.

"For now, I do not see the uniform as an issue," she told reporters when met after the handing over ceremony of three projects from the Public Works Departments to the Health Ministry here yesterday.

She said this when asked to comment on Kuantan MP Wan Razali Wan Nor's remarks on the attire of nurses.

While debating the White Paper of Public Health Reforms in the Dewan Rakyat recently, he had said the government should consider changing the uniforms for nurses as they were "too tight and not syariah-compliant."

The PAS MP has since come under fire from many Malaysians and organisations over his remarks.

On another matter, Dr Zaliha said her ministry will be having more awareness initiatives to ensure that the public is aware of the Health White Paper.

"I know that the people may not be fully aware of the Health White

Paper, and we will reach out to them to ensure that they know and understand the importance of health," she said.

She also said that negotiations over a piece of land that is expected to be the location of Hospital Sultanah Aminah 2 (HSA2) is still ongoing between her ministry and the Defence Ministry.

"The Defence Ministry is aware of the importance of health, and they will look into the suitability of using the land they own for the construction of the hospital," she said when asked about the progress of HSA2.

On Thursday, state health and unity committee chairman Ling Tian Soon said that discussions

were ongoing between the Health and Defence ministries with regard to a piece of land in Skudai for the proposed HSA2.

He said this was because the land that has been identified as a suitable location for the hospital is owned by the Defence Ministry.

"We faced some difficulties with regards to the land matter previously and asked the Health Ministry to carry out discussions with the land's owner.

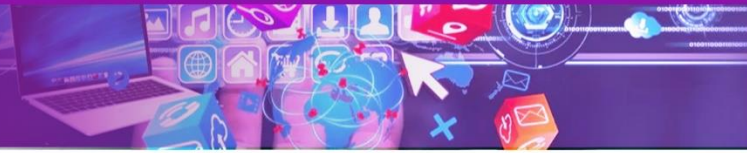
"Once the land matter has been resolved, we can proceed to apply for an allocation for the construction of the hospital," he told a press conference after the state assembly sitting recently.

Earlier, Dr Zaliha witnessed the

handing over ceremony of three projects, namely, a new Pathology Lab at HSA, a health clinic at Taman Ungku Tun Aminah, and a health clinic at Palang Timur, Segamat.

Meanwhile, in a Facebook post, Johor Menteri Besar Datuk Onn Hafiz Ghazi expressed his gratitude to the Health Ministry and Dr Zaliha for having a discussion with the state government on several health matters, among which, he said, were the lack of staff, improvements to infrastructure, and the construction of HSA2.

Onn Hafiz also thanked the ministry for the projects amounting to RM73.5mil that would be completed soon.

The policewoman went viral online last week after she was captured in video shouting at a rank-and-file policeman.

Another clip surfaced online

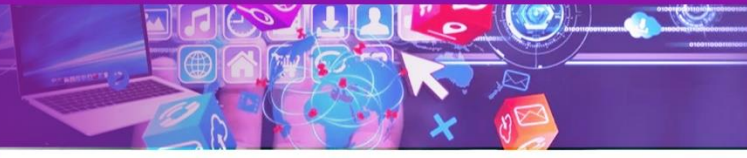
soon after showing a woman, believed to be the suspect, fighting with another woman over a parking lot in Brickfields, Kuala Lumpur.

On June 16, Comm Datuk Hussein said the cop in question had berated two policemen in Taman Sri Gombak and that she was also investigated for threatening to hit a civilian.

"We have two investigation papers (open).

The first is being investigated under Section 506 of the Penal Code for criminal intimidation, based on a police report made by a civilian.

"The second is based on a report lodged by two policemen under Section 186 of the Penal Code and Section 14 of the Minor Offences Act 1955 for preventing a public official from carrying out his duty and using foul language (respectively)," he added.

# 170 Benut families get free houses

## Residents from three villages look forward to leaving flood-prone area

**PONTIAN:** A total of 170 families from three villages in Benut here were all smiles as they finally received the keys to their new homes for free from state and federal governments.

The Taman Dato' Hajjah Fatimah Salim housing project was built on 12ha of land in Kampung Parit Makuaseng as a solution for the three villages that have been hit by flooding for years.

House recipient Sin Lang Hua, 67, said he is happy to get a dream home for his family and move out of Kampung Sungai Sanglang.

"The village is often flooded,

during monsoon season. With this new home, my family can live more comfortably.

"The old house belonged to my late father who passed away 20 years ago," said the second-generation fishball maker.

Daim Kamdar, 60, from Kampung Sri Tanjung, is excited to move to their new house to prepare for the coming Hari Raya Aidiladha celebration.

"I have been living there since I was little, and I am a bit sad to leave the house as I have many unforgettable memories there," said Daim, a bus driver.

Johor Mentri Besar Datuk Onn Hafiz Ghazi said the state government has agreed to provide an

80% discount for land premium payment, while the remaining 20% was paid by the Rural and Regional Development Ministry.

Villagers from Kampung Nelayan, Kampung Sri Tanjung, and Kampung Sungai Sanglang, can now enjoy a 100% discount on land premiums for their new house in Kampung Parit Makuaseng.

"The total development cost for this project is RM38mil and is borne by the Rural and Regional Development Ministry, where each house is worth RM150,000.

"This means villagers would not have to pay for land premiums, they will also get a new house for free," he said in a speech at the key handing over ceremony

at Dewan Serbaguna Benut here yesterday.

The project involved the construction of semi-detached houses with dimensions measuring 35x70 sq ft, and basic facilities such as roads, besides infrastructure including halls, suraus, kindergartens, and four shops, he said.

The project began in 2014 and was completed in August last year. Maintenance of the hall, surau, kindergarten and shops will also be handled by the Johor state government, Onn Hafiz added.

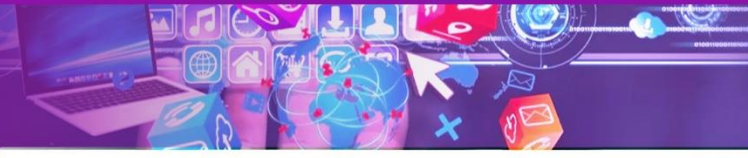
"I hope the villagers will quickly relocate to their new home after this, as they are given three months to vacate their old house

before they are demolished.

"Do not rent your old houses to outsiders or family members.

"I would also like to thank Deputy Finance Minister and Pontian MP Datuk Seri Ahmad Maslan, and former Johor Mentri Besar and Benut assemblyman Datuk Seri Hasni Mohammad, who have been fighting for this project," he added.

On April 28, Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, who is Rural and Regional Development Minister, had said that the Johor state government has agreed to provide an 80% discount on land premiums totalling RM1.6mil from the total of RM2mil.

He showed his devotion in other ways, says adopted daughter Nur Zahirah

**IPOH:** As a child, Nur Zahirah Zain saw a letter with her and her father's names written on it. There were also the words "pendaftaran anak angkat" (registration of adopted child).

For years, she tried asking her parents about it.

"They had trouble explaining it, especially my father, the quietest in the family," she said.

It was just three years ago that her parents finally revealed the whole truth to Nur Zahirah, who is now 26.

"I told them that I wanted to get married. That was when they told me my adoption story, which is fine by me because I love them no matter what."

But Nur Zahirah had always known that she was not their biological child in view of the letter about the adoption.

She is quick to point out that her family

has shown her much love.

"Even though they are not my biological parents, they love me and provide me with a lot of support so that I graduated with a Master's degree," she said.

Although her father is a man of few words, he showed his devotion in other ways, she said.

"We don't talk to each other much. The way we show our love is through our actions. My father would drive me to school until I studied in Kuala Pilah in Negri Sembilan.

"He was already in his 60s at the time. Yet, he would still drive all the way from Ipoh to Kuala Pilah just to pick me up.

"I was worried about him driving long hours and told him I could take the bus, but he insisted," she said.

She said her father was in his late 40s when they adopted her.

"I was told that they adopted me as a newborn at the hospital.

"My parents already had two sons before

adopting me."

Prior to adopting her, Nur Zahirah said her father was an engineer in Brunei. He retired early, but later decided to become a lorry driver.

"He kept on working to pay for my brothers' and my education. He wanted to provide the best for us," she said.

Her mother is a full-time homemaker.

"Although I am adopted, my parents never treated me differently from my brothers.

"We celebrated birthdays and, of course, Fathers Day as well. I always get him cake on Fathers Day as he likes dessert. When I

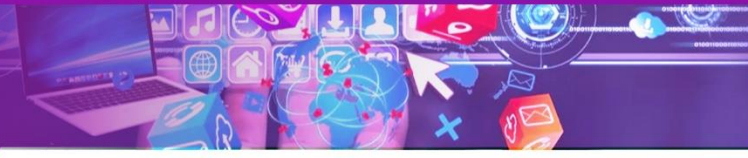
started working, I also got him gifts."

Unfortunately, she said her father had a minor stroke attack in late 2021 and was bedridden for a while.

"He has recovered a bit now, but he is in a wheelchair and has difficulties talking. Since I am still staying in Ipoh, I try to visit him every now and then," she added.

# Give dads more for sake of kids and mums

**PETALING JAYA:** More flexibility should be given to working fathers, including the option of longer paternity leave based on any underlying condition of the newborn or mother, say experts.

Prof Dr Rumaya Juhari of the Universiti Putra Malaysia's (UPM) Department of Human Development and Family Studies said it is important to consider the health and other aspects of the mother and child when considering how long the father needs to be present after childbirth.

"The demand for post-partum care will be different based on many factors such as the type of delivery, and health status of the mother and infant.

"Some newborns will also face complications, which require extra days of hospitalisation," she said, adding that the presence of other children as well as other support systems in the household also need to be considered.

"The more complicated the contextual factors are, the higher the demand for the fathers to be present to ensure the well-being of both mother and child," she said.

"Most likely, longer paternity leave will be very helpful."

Malaysia extended paternity leave from three to seven days earlier this year.

Among Asean countries, Myanmar and Thailand have the longest paternity leave at 15 days, while Singapore allocates 14 days, according to the International Labour Organisation (ILO).

However, Thailand's paternity leave only extends to fathers in the public sector.

Vietnam offers five to 14 days of paternity leave, depending on the type of birth and number of children.

The Philippines, like Malaysia,

Assoc Prof Dr Jamaluddin Aziz

offers a week-long paternity leave.

Malaysia's current seven-day paternity leave, however, has yet to be enforced in Sabah and Sarawak, though the Sabah government has agreed to amend an article under the Sabah Labour Ordinance in order to implement the policy.

This was done following an incident where a woman reportedly died four days after giving birth, with her husband claiming he was not granted seven days' paternity leave to take care of her.

Meanwhile, fathers in Indonesia have the shortest paternity leave of three days, while Cambodian fathers are not entitled to any paid statutory paternity leave, but can use their annual leave entitlement of up to seven days.

Prof Rumaya suggested that on top of the country's existing seven days' paternity leave, employees should be given an option of an additional seven days that can be used sporadically throughout the remaining days of the wife's confinement and the months after.

"This can be for hospital visits or other relevant needs. In the period of three to four months, adjustments are really needed so with time off work for the father, couples can plan for the transitioning phase where the mother has to return to work," she said.

She added that fathers should also learn more about newborns and infancy, their developmental milestones, observe the schedule for hospital trips and vaccina-

tions, as well as do things to ensure the spouse is comfortable and motivated to do her part in the parenting process.

Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia's Critical Media Studies Assoc Prof Dr Jamaluddin Aziz said most countries that offer paternity leave longer than three weeks and up to 14 weeks are high-income nations.

Countries such as South Korea, Japan, France, Portugal and many other European nations stand out for providing father-specific parental and homecare leave with a duration of between five and 52 weeks.

He said the length of paternity leave should depend on an individual's situation, such as the type of birth, any complications, and the condition of the newborn.

"If the wife is suffering from postpartum depression, longer paternity leave, either paid or unpaid, should be made accessible," said Jamaluddin.

"In some countries, parental leave granted for mothers can also be transferred to the father. This will help women transition back into their work."

He added that one of the father's roles after childbirth is to do all household chores, which will allow the mother to get enough rest to recuperate.

Chai Sen Tyng, a senior research officer at UPM's Malaysian Research Institute on Ageing, said while paternity leave in Malaysia must be utilised in one consecu-

utive stretch, several countries are more flexible.

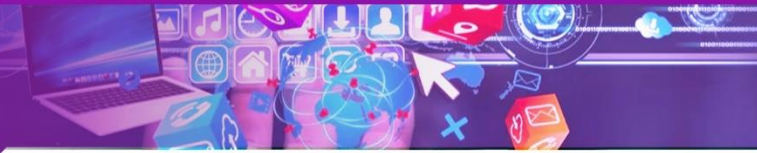
They allow parental leave to be taken in several stretches of time periods to support working couples to adjust to early childhood rearing responsibilities.

He said countries such as Sweden offer much longer parental leave which can be utilised by either parent.

"The household dynamics are pretty varied, and when you consider the challenges of breastfeeding and early childcare, we should put the discussion up for stronger parental leave rather than just arguing which parent should have more leave.

"I think there is no debate the priority here are the mothers and newborns.

"Men need to do a lot more than just bring home the pay cheque. In dual-income families, there are many new roles to fill and to share," Chai said.

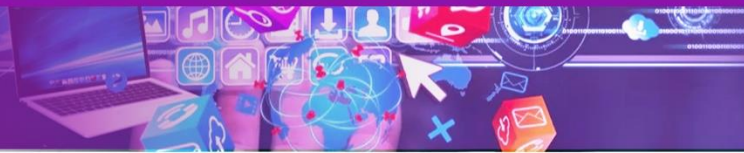
"He has this balance of being easy going and strict," he said.

## 175,000 covered by social security scheme for housewives

SEREMBAN: A total of 177,858 housewives are covered by the Housewives' Social Security Scheme as of June 15, said Human Resources Minister V. Sivakumar.

He said RM254,617 in benefits had been paid to insured housewives and families under the social safety net programme for the period starting from Dec 1.

"Housewives are encouraged to register and contribute to the scheme for protection against domestic disasters, disability or death while

managing their households.

"I encourage husbands to pay the contribution of RM120 each a year under the scheme for their respective wives in appreciation of their role and sacrifices for the family."

Sivakumar also called on non-governmental organisations and private companies to sponsor the contribution under the scheme for the welfare of their employees as a corporate social responsibility.

Earlier, Sivakumar presented Social Security Organisation (Socso)

benefits to contributor R. Chandran in Taman Desa Temiang, here.

Chandran, 40, while working as a salesman at a tobacco company near here, suffered an accident in 2012 and he received RM14,291.62 after being referred to a panel of doctors to determine permanent disability benefits.

The father of one suffered a right knee problem which made him unable to stand for long periods or do heavy work.

Sivakumar said Socso is looking

for a new job for Chandran that suits his condition.

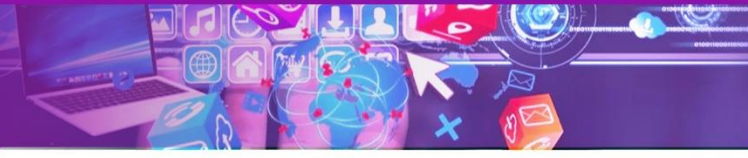
Private sector worker Leong Tai Hee, 49, who suffered a stroke, was given a Socso pension of RM2,757.08 per month after being referred to a medical panel.

Sivakumar added that the government would also look into the payment of allowances for students who undergo industrial training, following a report on a public university student who expressed concern about living expenses during

the training period.

"For me, this matter (payment of allowances) needs to be given serious attention by the government. This has also been raised in International Labour Organisation conferences so that it is given due consideration around the world.

"These interns (students undergoing industrial training) cannot be considered as free labour. We will look into this matter and I will give feedback soon." - Bernama

# Go easy on children

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A clinical psychologist has urged parents not to put too much pressure on their children to perform academically, and instead encourage them to pursue their interests and passions for a more balanced upbringing.

Dr Cassandra Aasmundsen-Fry, who runs a clinical practice, said children have difficulty handling stress.

She was giving her views on recent comments by Untuk Malaysia, a movement to rejuvenate the education system, which said 70,445 Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia 2022 candidates did not get certificates because they failed their Bahasa Melayu or History papers, or did not sit for the exams.

A total of 403,637 candidates sat for the written exams from Feb 20 to March 15, involving 3,355 examination centres nationwide. Education Director-General Datuk Pkharuddin Ghazali said a total of 75,322 candidates (20.1%) obtained average results, with at least a Grade C for all subjects.

Aasmundsen-Fry said: "Children who face too much stress and pressure have unrealistic expectations for their grades and will react disproportionately if they do poorly.

"Poor grades could also cause difficulties in the parent-child relationship as well as their academic and future success. But most importantly, they could develop chronic stress-related problems such as high blood pressure, heart disease and increased susceptibility to illnesses.

"Psychologically, they can develop anxiety, depressive disorders, or trauma-based issues.

Teaching children to communicate and regulate their emotions as well as how to handle stress is just as important as nurturing them academically. A well-balanced child can thrive in all areas of his life," she said.

Mother of three, Thayalini Gunasegaran, said in the past, it was common for children to perform well in school as academic success was highly expected.

But today, when children think about exams, it is often associated with the stress and pressure to achieve a high grade.

"In the 80s, academic achievement was highly valued and exams were seen as an important milestone. Success in them would show our measure of intelligence and competence. They played a big role in solidifying our foundation for a better future.

"We were expected to study for long hours, which included school and homework. Furthermore, the focus on studying was not understanding but 'rote learning' and memorisation, which further tired us."

Thayalini, who is a pre-school teacher in Kota Kemuning, Shah Alam, said she has noticed a change in the way modern parents raise their children.

"There is an understanding of the importance of balance and the need to give children time to explore their interests and

discover their passion. Every child is unique and cannot be put into a box and expected to perform.

"As a modern parent, instead of aiming purely for academic excellence, I try to instill a love for learning in them so that they can pursue their interests and passions."

Ravindran Annamalai, who is a manager at a telecommunications company and a father of two, said the expectations placed on children during the 70s and 80s might have caused negative effects.

He said the shift in parental attitude could be due to social media and how it educates newer parents about how to view their children's academics as well as focus more on the socio-emotional well-being of their children.

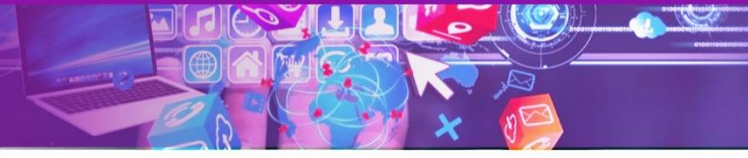
"A balanced approach that instills a love for learning and encourages the pursuit of passions may be more effective in helping children reach their full potential."

A biology teacher from the Klang Valley, who gave her name as Clara Edmund, said: "The shifting parental attitudes towards children could be due to worries of negatively impacting their mental health and self-esteem."



She said a societal shift in values and parenting styles plays a heavy role in promoting children's self-esteem and emotional well-being.

"While it is difficult to generalise parenting, I believe it is moving towards a positive direction. With the growing understanding of child development and mental health, parenting approaches have shifted towards promoting positive values," she said.

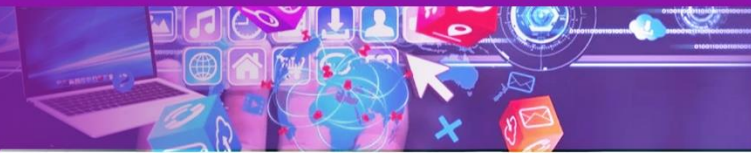

**IPOH:** A total of 257 children aged six to 12 participated in the Bazaar Junior Perak event aimed at helping to build and develop young entrepreneurs.

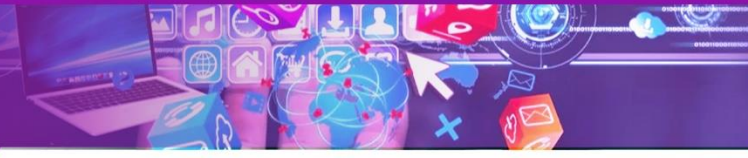

Criminal Investigation Department arrested the woman to assist in the investigations," he said.

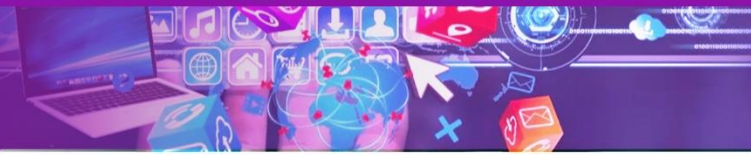
Khaw added that based on preliminary investigations, the woman is also believed to have implicated Lim as an instigator of the May 13 riots.

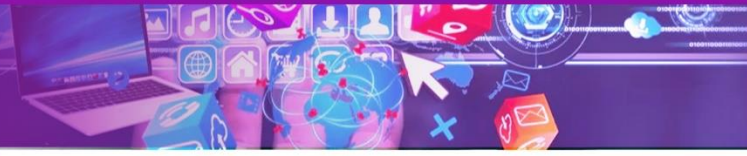

berkongsi maklumat perbankan tersebut kononnya bagi mengeluarkan diri daripada senarai itu," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

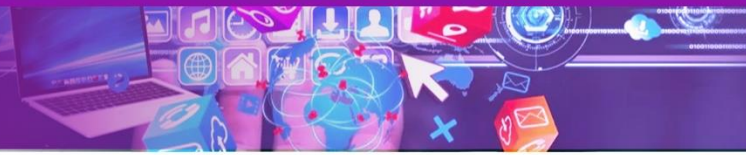

Ahli Parlimen Sekijang itu ditanya mengenai kenyat-

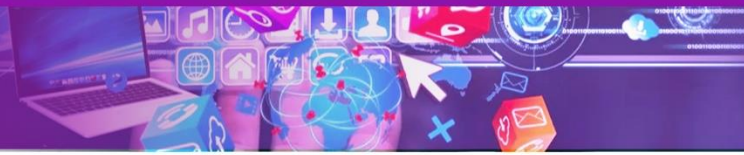

## Kes penipuan dalam talian, dua wanita rugi lebih RM400,000

**KUCHING:** Dua wanita mengalami kerugian lebih RM400,000 setelah menjadi mangsa penipuan dalam dua kejadian berasingan melibatkan penipuan pelaburan dan tawaran kerja tidak wujud.

Pesuruhjaya Polis Sarawak Dato Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri berkata, dua kejadian itu berlaku di daerah Padawan dan Kota Samarahan.

Menurutnya, kejadian pertama membabitkan seorang wanita berusia 44 tahun yang merupakan peniaga dalam talian.

"Pada 27 November 2022, ketika berada di rumahnya mangsa menerima WhatsApp daripada kawannya bernama 'Royman' iaitu warga Singapura yang mengajak mangsa mengikutnya dalam pelaburan melalui Telegram.

"Mangsa yang berminat diarahkan untuk memuat turun aplikasi daripada play-store iaitu 'App Trust' di mana mangsa telah mendaftar dan mengisi maklumat peribadi selain berurusan dengan individu terbabit melalui Telegram," katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Azman berkata, individu itu menawarkan pelaburan kepada mangsa dan wanita itu juga diminta memasukkan wang untuk mendapatkan keuntungan.

"Bermula 27 November 2022 hingga 15 Februari 2023, mangsa telah membuat 17 transaksi pembayaran kepada sembilan akaun bank berbeza berjumlah RM238,481.

"Mangsa menyedari dirinya ditipu apabila hanya menerima RM500 sahaja pulangan daripada wang pelaburan terbabit," katanya.

Sementara itu, kejadian kedua pula berlaku di Kota Samarahan melibatkan wanita berusia 47 tahun yang bekerja sebagai pegawai teknologi maklumat.

Menurutnya, pada 11 Jun 2023 ketika mangsa berada di rumah, mangsa melihat iklan pekerjaan dalam talian di Facebook dan mangsa meninggalkan nombor telefon di

iklan berkenaan.

"Mangsa kemudian menerima mesej WhatsApp dan Telegram daripada nombor yang tidak dikenali memperkenalkan diri daripada sebuah syarikat Sky9 Capital iaitu syarikat yang kononnya menawarkan pekerjaan dalam talian bagi membantu pengguna Youtube dan platform perdagangan dalam talian seperti Lazada untuk menaik taraf capaian.

"Mangsa yang berminat dikehendaki mendaftar di laman web yang diberikan iaitu <http://pgmallbuy.com> di mana mangsa akan mendapat bayaran dan bonus untuk setiap penugasan yang diberikan," jelasnya.

Katanya lagi, tugasan yang diberikan ialah menaik taraf trafik pengguna Youtube yang dibekalkan oleh suspek.

"Pada 12 Jun 2023, suspek memaklumkan kepada mangsa sekiranya ingin mendapat bayaran lebih, mangsa perlu membuat bayaran untuk 'pre-order' dengan jumlah bayaran tertentu.

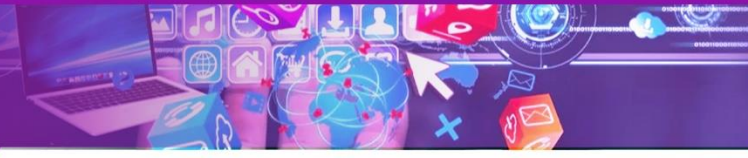
"Bermula 13 hingga 16 Jun 2023, mangsa telah membuat 14 transaksi bayaran kepada tujuh akaun bank yang berbeza membabitkan jumlah RM201,186," katanya.

Jelas Azman, mangsa menyedari dirinya ditipu apabila tidak menerima sebarang pulangan dan telah dinasihati oleh kawannya untuk membuat laporan polis.

Sehubungan itu, orang ramai sentiasa diingatkan agar tidak terperdaya dengan pelaburan yang tidak sah melalui media sosial selain tidak mudah tertarik dengan gaji lumayan.

"Orang ramai juga boleh menghubungi National Scam Response Centre di talian 997 jika menjadi mangsa penipuan siber sekiranya baru sahaja membuat transaksi pemindahan ke akaun dan e-wallet suspek.

"Selain itu, disarankan untuk memuat turun aplikasi Whoscall melalui Google Play atau Apple Store untuk membantu anda membuat keputusan mahu menjawab panggilan," jelas Azman.

Sekiranya pendidikan diabaikan, pelbagai peluang untuk memperbaiki kehidupan dalam seisi keluarga akan terlepas,” katanya ketika merasmikan Mesyuarat Persatuan Ibu Bapa dan Guru (PIBG) sesi 2023/2024 di Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Terusan Tengah di sini, semalam.

Bagaimanapun katanya, kerajaan hari ini perlu sedar

dan peka terhadap kekurangan kemudahan yang dihadapi oleh para murid-murid serta guru di kawasan pedalaman dan pulau.

Katanya, Pulau Bum Bum khususnya memerlukan usaha pemerkasaan kemudahan persekolahan bukan sahaja dari segi bangunan, jalan raya, bekalan air, elektrik tetapi juga jeti.

“Jeti perlu dibina khas untuk kegunaan para guru dan murid,” katanya.

Beliau berkata, pihaknya juga sudah mengenal pasti sebanyak lapan buah sekolah di Semporna untuk disalurkan peruntukan untuk memperkasakan kemudahan sedia ada.

Katanya, sumbangan itu adalah dari peruntukan wakil rakyat. Walaupun kerajaan ada menyalurkan peruntukan seumpamanya, tetapi adalah wajar bantuan seumpamanya juga diberikan.

Sementara itu, Jaujan memberikan jaminan bahawa isu pendidikan rakyat di

Sulabayan akan menjadi keutamaan selagi beliau menjadi ADUN kawasan berkenaan.

“Saya sangat tekankan pendidikan kerana tanpanya pengangguran akan tinggi, bina banyak kilang di sini pun tiada gunanya sekiranya tiada tenaga mahir dan sebagainya,” katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Jaujan juga akan membekalkan kitab al-Quran di sekolah-sekolah rendah kawasan Sulabayan.

Beliau juga mencadangkan ibu bapa murid yang tidak mahir dalam mengkaji ayat al-Quran dijemput hadir ke perpustakaan sekolah untuk bersama-sama guru-guru agama di sekolah terbabit belajar.

“Mungkin kelepasan boleh diberikan pada hujung minggu untuk perkara ini. Kita akan memberikan kerjasama kepada PIBG berkaitan perkara ini.

“Kita juga berharap perpustakaan di sekolah-sekolah di sini dapat diluaskan lagi,” katanya.
