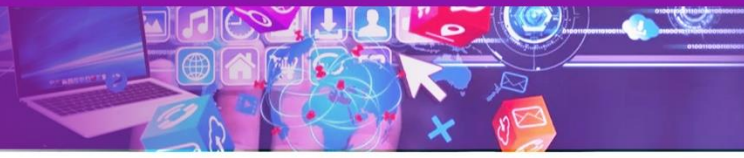

## Ibu tegur anak buat bising maut ditetak

**Muar:** Berang ditegur kerana membuat bising, seorang lelaki tergamak bertindak kejam menetak leher dan kepala ibunya beberapa kali dengan senjata tajam hingga maut, dalam kejadian di sebuah rumah dekat Taman Temiang Utama di sini, malam kelmarin.

Dalam kejadian jam 8 malam itu, mangsa berusia 73 tahun ditemui berlumuran darah di ruang tamu rumahnya.

Ketua Polis Daerah Muar, Asisten Komisioner Raiz Mukhliz Azman Aziz, berkata sebelum kejadian, ibunya dikatakan menegur suspek kerana membuat bising.

Beliau berkata, dalam kejadian pada 8.20 malam itu, wanita itu cedera parah di kepala serta leher kerana dipercayai dipukul anaknya berusia 47 tahun dengan menggunakan senjata tajam.

"Mangsa maut di tempat kejadian, iaitu di rumah mereka selepas cedera parah di bahagian

kepala serta leher.

"Kejadian berlaku dipercayai akibat tindakan mangsa menegur anaknya itu kerana membuat bising yang menyebabkannya mengamuk dan memukul kepala mangsa dengan menggunakan senjata tajam," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Raiz Mukhliz berkata, lelaki terbabit didapati mempunyai rekod psikiatri lampau, ditahan sejurus polis seurus tiba di lokasi kejadian.

Katanya, polis turut merampas sebilah pisau dapur dan kapak yang disyaki digunakan lelaki terbabit dalam kejadian itu.

"Kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan kerana membunuh dan mayat mangsa dibawa ke Hospital Pakar Sultanah Fatimah (HPSF) Muar untuk bedah siasat," katanya.

Suspek kini berada dalam tahanan reman selama tujuh hari selepas perintah itu dikeluarkan

Majistret Muar, Nurfarah Syahidah Mohd Noh, semalam.

### Pernah rosakkan kenderaan

Sementara itu, penduduk sekitar perumahan keluarga suspek, mendakwa lelaki itu sebelum ini pernah merosakkan beberapa kenderaan penduduk sekitar.

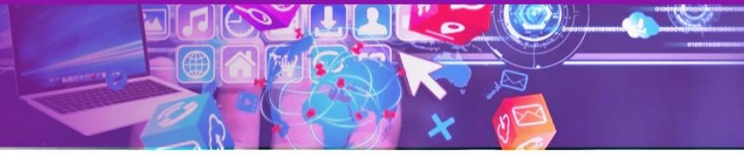
Penduduk memaklumkan, mereka yang tinggal di situ mengetahui suspek menghidap masalah mental, namun jarang melihatnya di luar kawasan rumah.

"Kejadian beberapa tahun lalu menyebabkan kereta milik penduduk taman ini rosak, cermin pecah. Suspek melarikan diri ke rumah abangnya di Sungai Abong, namun polis ke sana dan menahannya selepas penduduk membuat laporan.

## KKM siasat punca kes doktor hamil mati mengejut

and Physician Associates (GACOPA) di sebuah hotel, di sini, semalam.

*BH* pada 17 Jun lalu, melaporkan seorang doktor hamil empat bulan berusia 32 tahun, ditemui mati mengejut dalam sebuah bilik di rumahnya di Shah Alam.

Ketua Polis Daerah Shah Alam, Asisten Komisioner Mohd Iqbal Ibrahim, berkata siasatan awal mendapati doktor berkenaan bertugas di sebuah klinik kesihatan kerajaan.

Katanya, laporan dibuat jam 8.55 malam pada 5 Jun lalu, susulan makluman daripada Hospital Sungai Buloh sebaik menerima panggilan kecemasan dari seorang lelaki berusia 32 tahun yang memaklumkan isterinya mati mengejut di rumah.

Dalam pada itu, Dr Zaliha

berkata, kementeriannya sedia mempertimbangkan cadangan untuk menambah baik pengurusan kesihatan mental dalam kalangan pegawai kesihatan.

Katanya, masalah berkenaan adalah sebahagian daripada tonggak yang disenaraikan dalam Kertas Putih Kesihatan bagi memastikan perkara seperti ini menjadi keutamaan.

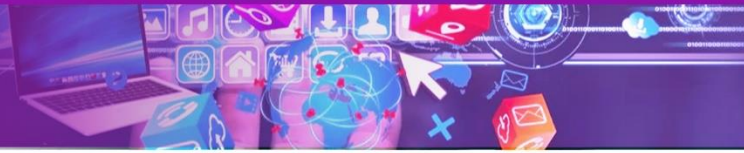
“Langkah sedia ada sudah mencukupi, namun sekiranya perlu ditambah baik kita akan lakukan.”

**Petaling Jaya:** Seorang pemain Sabah FC didakwa di Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam, atas tuduhan memukul teman wanitanya dan merosakkan telefon miliknya di sebuah bilik hotel, dua minggu lalu.

Bagaimanapun Mohd Rizal Mohd Ghazali, 31, yang beraksi dalam saingan Liga Super mengaku tidak bersalah selepas pertuduhan dibacakan jurubahasa di hadapan Majistret, Zhafran Rahim Hamzah.

Mengikut pertuduhan, Mohd Rizal yang juga bekas pemain bola sepak kebangsaan didapati sengaja mendatangkan kecederaan dengan memukul Hani Farhana Hasrul Sani, 37, dan melakukan khianat merosakkan telefon bimbit milik mangsa dengan nilai kerugian RM4,500 di sebuah bilik hotel di sini, pada 7 Jun lalu.

Pendakwaan mengikut Seksyen 323 dan 427 Kanun Keseksaan masing-masing memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum setahun, denda hingga RM2,000 atau kedua-duanya dan penjara maksimum tiga

bulan atau denda atau kedua-duanya jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Susulan pengakuan tidak bersalah itu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Siti Maryam Jamilah Md Kamal, memohon Mohd Rizal diikat jamin RM7,000.

"Syarat tambahan tertuduh tidak boleh mengganggu mangsa dan saksi pendakwaan," katanya.

### Sebutan semula kes 24 Ogos

Sementara itu, peguam bela Mohd Rizal, Datuk Suraj Singh, memohon jaminan paling rendah atas alasan anak guam perlu menanggung ibu bapa, tiada risiko melarikan diri dan tiada pertuduhan kes lain.

"Kenalan rapat anak guam akan menjadi penjaminnya. Anak guam memberi kerjasama penuh kepada polis dan apabila dapat panggilan pegawai penyiasat, anak guam hadir ke mahkamah tepat pada waktunya (pagi tadi).

"Jaminan hanya untuk pastikan kehadiran pada perbicaraan dan bukan untuk menghukum," katanya.

Majistret kemudian membe-

narkan jaminan RM3,500 dan syarat tambahan seperti dimohon pihak pendakwaan, manakala sebutan semula kes ditetapkan 24 Ogos ini.

Pada 7 Jun lalu, polis menahan pemain berkenaan dalam satu serbuan di sebuah hotel di sini untuk membantu siasatan hasil maklumat dan risikan.

Ketua Polis Daerah, Asisten Komisioner Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid dilaporkan berkata, dalam perselisihan faham antara mangsa dan teman lelaki mangsa itu menyebabkan kecederaan di bahagian badan mangsa, selain suspek didapati merosakkan telefon bimbit mangsa.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan, seorang bekas pemain kebangsaan dipercayai membela-sah kekasihnya sehingga cedera selepas berlaku pergaduhan antara mereka baru-baru ini.

Menurut sumber, pemain itu dikatakan sering melakukan perbuatan terbabit sehingga menyebabkan kekasihnya yang juga seorang doktor mendedahkan perkara itu kepada umum.

pacuan empat roda patah kaki kiri dan kanan," katanya, di sini, semalam.

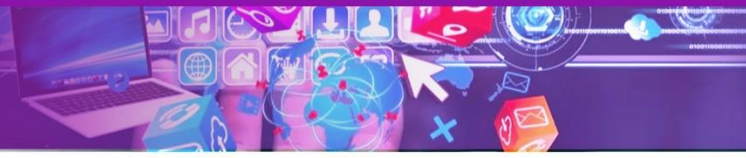

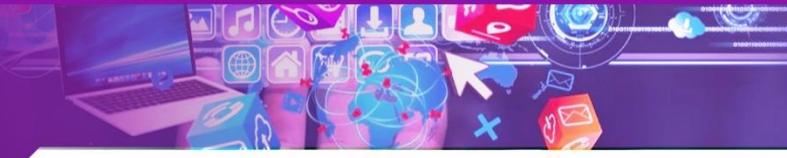

"Itu cara saya mencari nikmat sihat dan pengetahuan yang ada itu juga saya gunakan untuk 'berdakwah' mengenai kesihatan.

"Lagipun, banyak cara untuk berdakwah, bukan hanya dalam soal agama tetapi juga kesihatan kerana sebagai manusia, menjadi tanggungjawab kita menjaga tubuh pemberian Allah," katanya ketika dihubungi Harian Metro.

Bercerita lanjut, Mohd Iqbal berkata, rutin hariannya adalah berlari sejauh 10 hingga 15 kilometer (km) selepas menunaikan solat Subuh.

Selesai larian, Mohd Iqbal

terus ke pusat gimnasium untuk melakukan kerja haki.

"Pada waktu terluang, saya buat senaman kecergasan dalam pusat gimnasium.

"Begitu rutin harian setiap hari dan saya turut terapkan gaya hidup sihat dalam kalangan ahli keluarga

termasuk isteri.

"Ia kerana saya nak mereka (isteri) juga kuat dan bertenaga macam saya. Lagipun, tak bermakna wanita tak boleh aktif dalam kecergasan.

"Nampak mereka suka malah anak sulung pun sudah mula ikut jejak langkah saya," katanya.



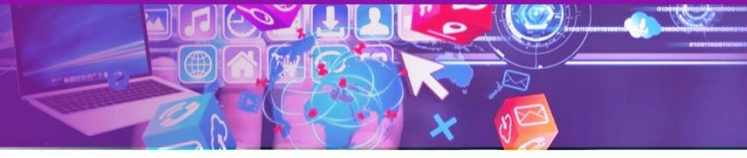
**IQBAL** suka bersukan sejak usia muda.

## Bunuh ibu tegur buat bising

Lelaki miliki rekod psikiatri tetak ibu guna kapak sehingga mati direman polis tujuh hari

Marah ditegur membuat bising, seorang lelaki yang mempunyai rekod psikiatri menetak leher dan kepala ibunya beberapa kali dengan kapak hingga maut di sebuah rumah di Taman Temiang Utama di sini, kelmarin.

Dalam kejadian jam 8 malam, mangsa berusia 73 tahun ditemukan dalam keadaan berhemran darah di ruang tamu rumahnya.

Ketua Polis Daerah Muar, Asisten Komisioner Raiz Mukhliz Azman Aziz berkata, sebelum kejadian, ibunya dikatakan menegur suspek berusia 47 tahun itu kerana membuat bising.

Katanya, mangsa meninggal dunia di tempat kejadian akibat kecederaan parah di bahagian kepala serta leher.

"Kejadian berlaku dipercayai akibat tindakan mangsa menegur anaknya itu kerana membuat bising yang menyebabkannya menagumuk dan menetak kepala mangsa dengan menggunakan senjata tajam," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

Menurutnya, suspek yang mempunyai rekod psikiatri lampau itu ditahan sejurus polis tiba di lokasi kejadian dan turut merampas sebilah pisau dapur dan kapak yang disyaki digunakan dalam kejadian itu.

Suspek direman tujuh hari bagi membantu siasatan yang dijalankan mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksamaan manakala mayat mangsa dibawa ke Hospital Pakar Sultanah Fatiimah (HPSF) Muar untuk bedah siasat.

Dalam pada itu Raiz Mukhliz menasihati orang ramai peka serta memantau rapi mana-mana individu yang mengalami masalah psikiatri supaya tidak mendatangkan bahaya kepada nyawa, harta, individu lain, ahli keluarga serta keselamatan awam.

Sementara itu, penduduk mendakwa suspek sebelum ini pernah merasakan beberapa kenderaan penduduk taman perumahan itu tahun

lalu. Penduduk yang enggan dikenali berkata, mereka yang tinggal di situ mengetahui suspek mempunyai masalah

mental namun jarang melihatnya di luar kawasan rumah. "Kejadian ini berlaku beberapa tahun lalu menye-

babkan kereta milik penduduk taman ini rosak dan cermin pecah. Selepas melakukan perbuatan itu, suspek melarikan diri ke rumah abangnya di Sungai Abong namun polis menahannya selepas penduduk membuat laporan.

"Dia (suspek) cukup dikenali penduduk di sini. Ahli keluarganya pula tidak bergaul dengan orang lain mungkin kerana malu dengan perbuatan suspek.

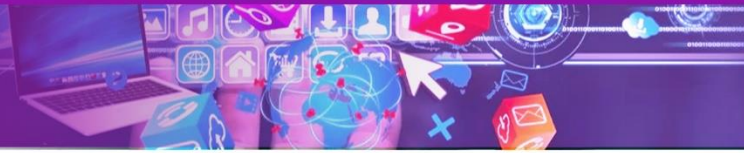
"Saya tidak menyangka tindakan suspek hingga ke tahap ini (membunuh ibunya). Itupun selepas dimaklumkan jiran lain mengenai kejadian ini malam tadi," katanya ketika ditemui semalam.

Menurutnya lagi, ketika kejadian dia mendapat tahu salah seorang cucu mangsa berusia belasan tahun berada di rumah namun berjaya keluar menyelamatkan diri. "Tidak ramai ahli keluarganya dalam rumah ketika itu dan cucu mangsa kemudian memberitahu jiran sebelum menghubungi polis," katanya.

Seorang lagi penduduk yang enggan dikenali berusia 56 tahun memberitahu, mereka tidak beberapa mengenali ahli keluarga suspek kerana mereka jarang keluar rumah bercampur dengan penduduk.

Katanya, dia terkejut apabila mendapati beberapa kereta polis berada di rumah mangsa malam kelmarin ketika pulang dari kedai makan.

"Terkejut juga apabila diberitahu wanita itu mati dibunuh anaknya," katanya.

**Kuala Lumpur:** Seorang pembantu tadbir gred N19 di Kementerian Pembangunan dan Kerajaan Tempatan (KPKT) didenda RM5,500 oleh Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam selepas menerima wang tunai lebih RM4,000 daripada seorang pekerja sebuah syarikat pembekalan makanan, enam tahun lalu.

Hakim Suzana Hussin menjatuhkan hukuman itu terhadap Nurul Azirah Kamaruddin, 37, selepas tertuduh mengaku bersalah dan memerintahkan wanita itu menjalani hukuman penjara sebulan sekiranya denda gagal dibayar.

Mengikut pertuduhan, ibu lima anak yang juga penjawat awam iaitu pembantu tadbir perkeranian dan operasi didakwa menerima

wang tunai RM4,797.50 daripada seorang individu yang mempunyai hubungan dengan tugas rasminya.

Kesalahan itu didakwa dilakukan di Maybank Desa Jaya, Kepong di sini, pada 21 April 2018 mengikut Seksyen 165 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman penjara maksimum dua tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya.

Mengikut fakta kes, tertuduh menerima pertolongan daripada seorang pekerja sebuah syarikat pembekalan makanan bagi menaikkan jumlah peserta Bengkel Akta Pengurusan Strata anjuran KPKT di Langkawi, Kedah daripada 34 orang kepada 85 peserta di dalam invoice syarikat terbabit.

Pada 12 April 2018, syarikat itu kemudian mene-

rima bayaran daripada KPKT untuk perkhidmatan pembekalan makanan bagi bengkel itu dan tertuduh mengaku menerima RM4,797.50 daripada jumlah bayaran terbabit.

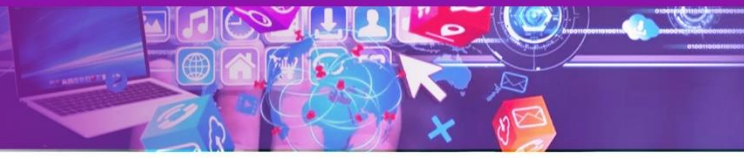
Terdahulu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Natrah Fareha Rahmat memohon supaya mahkamah menjatuhkan hukuman setimpal mengambil kira faktor tertuduh adalah penjawat awam yang seharusnya menjaga nama baik sektor kerajaan.

# HANDLING CHILD CRIME VICTIMS WITH CARE

The rising number of crimes against children sparked an urgent need for a safe space for them to be interviewed. Now, with Internet crimes also on the rise, this is even more important. **NUR ZARINA OTHMAN and KALBANA PERIMBANAYAGAM** find out more

KUALA LUMPUR

**M**ORE than two decades ago, Malaysian police recognised the need for specialised centres, where child victims of crimes could be put more at ease when being interviewed by investigators.

They also recognised that it would take policemen and women who were specially trained to handle such cases and to persuade the children to talk without subjecting them to more trauma.

In 2002, this came to fruition with the setting up of child interview centres (CIC), run by the Sexual, Women, and Children Crime Investigation Division (D11).

Now, with the rapid growth of the digital world, these centres have become even more important as there are more opportunities for criminals to exploit and victimise children.

Malaysia has seen a troubling increase in Internet crimes against minors in recent years. With an increasing number of

children engaged in Internet activities, criminals have devised new methods of targeting and manipulating them.

According to police, incidents of cybercrimes against children have increased by 40 per cent in the last two years alone. These offences range from child pornography, grooming, and on-line sexual exploitation to cyberbullying and sextortion.

**AN ACT OF JUSTICE**

The Malaysia Internet Crime Against Children investigation unit examines cyber-paedophilia (the use of the Internet to exploit children sexually) crimes in Malaysia.

While the country has the best laws in place for crimes against children, D11 principal assistant director Assistant Commissioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan believes it takes more to ensure that these criminals are apprehended and brought to justice, such as having cutting-edge technology, interview techniques and facilities.

The main CIC is located near the federal police headquarters in Bukit Aman but away from

uniform-clad officers to "ensure that the children feel comfortable, and not intimidated by it so that they can talk without feeling anxious".

"After all, they are children," says Siti Kamsiah as she gives the *New Straits Times* a tour of the facility.

**THE FACILITY**

It first opened in 2002 and has designated rooms, one of which is the "rapport room", which is furnished brightly to make youngsters feel at ease before their interview, according to Siti Kamsiah.

She said combating crimes against minors called for a multifaceted approach that included strong legal measures, effective law enforcement, public awareness efforts and educational activities.

"Specially trained law enforcement officers will conduct child victim interviews in a sensitive, child-friendly, and non-threatening manner.

"They are given specialised training to provide a safe environment in which victims may

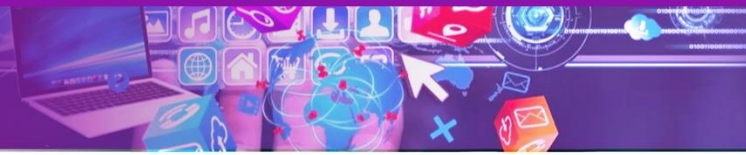
share their experiences and the officers acquire relevant evidence while minimising the risk of 're-traumatisation'."

"The officers must adhere to guidelines for digital evidence collection and handling, ensuring that all procedures are carried out by international standards and best practices.

"This would help to preserve the integrity of evidence and increase the chances of successful prosecution of offenders," she added, noting that the ordeal they went through not only caused immediate harm but also had long-lasting psychological effects on the victims, potentially leading to serious emotional distress and trauma.

The centre is critical in bringing perpetrators to justice while also protecting the wellbeing and rights of victims, Siti Kamsiah said.

"By putting child victims' mental and emotional wellbeing first during the investigation process, we provide them with a sense of security and support, allowing them to share their experiences without fear of further harm."

# MAN ALLEGEDLY STABS MUM, 73, TO DEATH

47-year-old became upset when he was reprimanded for being too noisy

**A** 73-year-old woman was allegedly stabbed to death by her son at their house in Taman Temiang, near here, on Sunday.

The 47-year-old suspect is believed to have stabbed his mother repeatedly in her neck and head with a kitchen knife when she confronted him for causing a ruckus.

District police chief Assistant Commissioner Mukhliz Azman Aziz said the incident occurred at about 8.20pm.

He said the son was said to have been making a lot of noise, which prompted the woman to tell him to lower his voice so as not to disturb the neighbours.

The man, said Mukhliz, got upset and the situation soon escalated.

The man went to the kitchen where he grabbed a knife stab-

bing his mother multiple times in the neck and head.

Mukhliz said an emergency call was placed and police were despatched to the scene immediately.

Upon their arrival, the victim had succumbed to her injuries, and the suspect was apprehended.

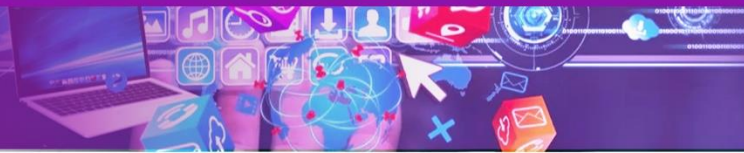
Police also seized a kitchen knife and an axe.

The case is being investigated under Section 302 of the Penal Code for murder.

Mukhliz urged the public to be cautious when dealing with individuals believed to have psychiatric issues.

"Please seek police's help if you are feeling threatened when dealing with individuals who are believed to be troubled with psychiatric issues.

"Family members should always monitor them and get the relevant treatment to ensure these individuals do not pose a threat to others," he said.

# Missing activist's wife, daughter to take the stand

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The wife and daughter of missing activist Amri Che Mat will testify in a suit filed against the government and 20 others.

Lawyer Larissa Ann Louis, who is representing Amri's wife Norhayati Ariffin in the suit, confirmed this yesterday.

The hearing was supposed to start yesterday in the High Court before judge Su Tiang Joo.

However, it was postponed to tomorrow due to a glitch in the court's online database system.

Both Norhayati and her daughter, Amirah, were in court, as well as Susanna Liew — the wife of abducted Christian pastor Raymond Koh.

Norhayati filed the suit on Nov 18, 2019 against the police, the government and then-home minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, as well as the former head of the Special Branch's social extremism division, Awaludin Jadid.

The activist's wife sought aggravated and exemplary damages.

In 2019, the government had set up a task force chaired by former High Court judge Datuk Abd Rahim Uda to investigate the Human Rights Commission of

Malaysia's (Suhakam) claim of police involvement in the disappearances of Amri and Koh.

On May 9 this year, High Court judge Datuk Wan Ahmad Farid Wan Salleh ruled that the task force's report should be given to Norhayati and her lawyer.

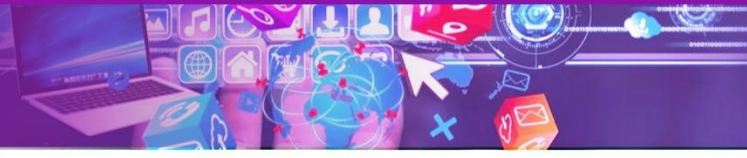
However, the government filed an appeal on June 7.

Amri, — the founder of a non-governmental organisation — went missing after leaving his home in Kangar at 11.30pm on Nov 24, 2016.

His vehicle was found abandoned

at a construction site at Bukit Chabang in Kangar.

Suhakam conducted public inquiries into both disappearances, and found that it was likely he and Koh fell victim to "enforced disappearances" perpetrated by Special Branch policemen.

## Parents play big role against cyber-paedophilia threat

**KUALA LUMPUR:** All parents need to be aware of their important role in protecting children from cyber-paedophiles.

This is as child victims of sexual predators come from all walks of life, with the only similarities being that they have access to smartphones and the Internet, and are introverts.

Federal police Sexual, Women, and Children Crime Investigation Division (D11) principal assistant director Assistant Commissioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan said there was no one particular background when it came to victims.

"From the cases we have investigated, we learnt that children who were manipulated or sexually exploited online were not from any particular background. There are victims from well-to-do families as well as lower-income families.

"The obvious similarities we

notice is that the victims all have access to handphones and the Internet. They are also mostly introverted and are lonely, with a small number of friends.

"In this kind of situation, the child becomes more vulnerable to being exposed to paedophiles or abusers online," she told the *New Straits Times*.

Siti Kamsiah said the lack of family values was more likely to be among the reasons a child might trust someone he or she met online.

"Parents play an important role in keeping an eye on their children's activities. Those days, danger was only when children went out of the house but now with technological advancements, the Internet and smartphones at hand, children are exposed to all sorts of threats.

"Parents need to be creative in their approach towards educating their children on what's good

and what's not. They should teach them that there are limitations. When a person asks you to send a photo of yourself, what you can reveal and what not to reveal must be taught from young."

She said D11 and the units under it worked closely with the Multimedia and Communications Ministry, their counterparts in other countries, the Health Ministry, as well as non-governmental organisations involved in child protection to create awareness and stop Internet sexual crimes against children.

On whether laws in Malaysia are sufficient to tackle the growing threat, Siti Kamsiah said crimes against children, especially online sexual crimes, were among those with the heaviest penalties.

Child abusers can be jailed up to 30 years with caning, depending on the severity of the cri-

me committed.

Siti Kamsiah said Malaysia had laws which were among the most stringent in the world in safeguarding children against exploitation and crimes, and were sufficient at present.

"Internet crimes against children, among others, are offences under the provisions of the Child Act 2001 and for now it is sufficient to keep our children safe."

She said besides technological advancements, criminals might adopt new ways to prey on their victims.

She said enforcement agencies must be prepared to match such changes.

"It is undeniable that we have strong laws. For instance, anyone found to have even one video recording of child pornography on their mobile phones (or in any other place) can be imprisoned for five years.

"Anyone found recording

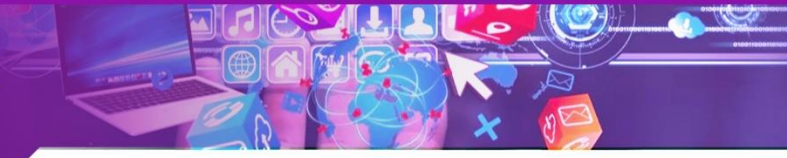
pornographic material can be jailed up to 30 years, if found guilty."

Siti Kamsiah said the Child Act 2001 provides children the most protection against predators, abuse, neglect, and sexual exploitation and crimes.

"Our law is not limited to only physical interaction, but also online and Internet-based interaction that can lead to grooming, exploitation and child sexual crimes. This gives us a very wide scope to protect our children from online predators."

Siti Kamsiah said one distinct difference between Malaysia and other countries was that Malaysian laws also provide for caning on top of jail sentences.

"We are known to be one of the few nations that still mete out caning on top of jail sentences for anyone who sexually exploits or causes harm to a child, whether online or physical."

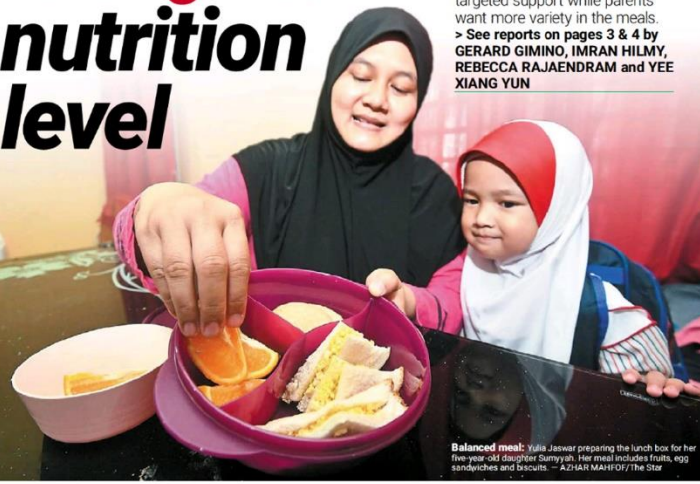

## Attending preschool a way for poor kids to get nutritional meal

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Attending preschool is not all about getting a child ready for their schooling years where they will learn and interact with others.

For poor families, it is possibly the only place where their kids can get a nutritional meal.

World Bank Senior Education Specialist Dr Aija Maurt-Rinkinen said preschools receive free meals that are heavily subsidised by the government.

These dishes — which are clean, nutritious and balanced — are prepared based on the guidelines from the Health Ministry to meet the appropriate caloric and macronutrient requirements for a growing child.

In this year's national budget, the preschool food aid was increased from RM89mil to RM108mil, a 21% increase.

This is expected to increase the food aid from RM2 to RM2.50 per child in the peninsula and RM2.25 to RM2.75 in Sabah and Sarawak.

According to the World Bank "Shaping First Steps: A Comprehensive Review of Preschool Education in Malaysia" report, 14.1% of Malaysian children under five are underweight, 21.8% are suffering from stunting, 9.7% from wasting, and 5.6%

are overweight and obese, with the trend worsening.

The report suggests that the food assistance rate for preschools be reviewed to evaluate if the allowance is sufficient to meet the nutritional and developmental needs of children.

## Healthy food to fuel growth

### Importance of nutritional meals cannot be ignored

**PETALING JAYA:** Addressing growing children's nutritional needs is crucial to effectively tackle malnutrition and stunting among children, say nutritionists and health experts.

They welcomed the increased allocation for food aid programmes at public kindergartens and primary schools.

Currently, there are two food aid programmes — the Preschool Food Aid (BMP) for all children and the Supplementary Food Aid (RMT) for pupils from underprivileged families.

The current rate for BMP and RMT meals are fixed at RM2 and RM2.50 respectively per child in Peninsular Malaysia, and RM2.25 and RM3 per child in Sabah and Sarawak.

The rate for BMP is expected to increase by 50 sen per child while RMT's rate will increase by RM1 per child.

Consultant paediatrician Datin Dr Amar Singh HS said a universal preschool and school breakfast programme should be introduced to ensure the meals served

meet the nutritional demands of children, as practised in many countries.

"Good data on social determinants of health are required to identify those with inequities and target support for them," he added.

While the allocations for BMP and RMT have increased, he said the hike was small, at 1% and 24% respectively, and the sum could be inadequate.

Under Budget 2023, the Education Ministry received a total of RM55.26b.

Of the amount, RM108mil was set aside for BMP, up from the previous RM89mil and set to benefit some 240,000 students while RMT got RM77mil, an increase from RM62.5mil and set to benefit some 700,000 students.

According to statistics from the Health Ministry's Adolescent Nutrition Survey, as part of the National Health and Morbidity Survey (NHMS) 2017, more than 8% of school children were stunted.

"Serial NHMS surveys also showed an increasing stunting rate from 6.9% (2011) to 17.7% (2015) and shot up further to

21.8% in 2019.

"These suggest that we are regressing to become like poorer developing nations, which have 25% stunting rates," said Dr Amar, an Honorary Senior Fellow at the Galen Centre for Health and Social Policy.

Stunting also brought significant implications as it implied poorer cognitive development that could mean a lifetime poverty trap, he said.

"We must remember that stunting starts in the womb, so we must identify mothers with malnutrition in pregnancy, support them financially and only through good nutrition can we end stunting in children," he added.

Nutrition Society of Malaysia president Dr Tee T. Sheng said BMP and RMT could also be leveraged to ingrain values of healthy eating among children.

"The long-term measure should be promoting nutritional education and advocating healthier eating habits from a young age."

"We're not talking about conducting an entire syllabus, but rather having some three to five-minute lessons whenever the food is distributed," he suggested.

Dr Tee said engagements should be held between canteen operators and the Health and Education ministries, to ensure healthier food options.

"It would be futile if we make the effort to educate our children on healthy eating, but less nutritious food is still being served in schools," he said.

Malnutrition in the short term could induce negative effects such as being underweight and possibly resulting in children having a weaker immune system, he added.

"The weaker immune system could result in them having a higher tendency to fall sick, resulting in absenteeism."

"Falling sick also causes a further lack of appetite, potentially leading to under-eating and children being even more underweight," he said, adding that long-term malnutrition could also lead to stunting.

He said if a stunted child begins to build an appetite, it might cause the kid to eat more and possibly be overweight or obese.

"This potentially brings a higher prevalence of non-communicable diseases in their later years," he added.

## Preschoolers food aid increase not a lot but will help

**GEORGE TOWN:** Real, natural food is best for preschool kids aged four to six.

"That means potatoes instead of fries, brown instead of white rice and actual fruits instead of juices, said nutritionist Annie Yee.

And while the government's effort to increase aid for preschool meals is commendable, Yee was concerned that a budget of RM2.50 to RM2.75 per meal would not be enough.

"Kids may miss out on important nutrients from dairy products or rice, which would be more expensive," she said.

Yee, who is the senior nutrition-

ist at Pemang Adventist Hospital, said parents and preschools should give children real food instead of fast or highly processed food.

She urged parents to top up on the government's efforts and collaborate with their children's preschools to ensure sufficient budget for quality nutrition in their children's meals.

As an aid for nutritious food on a tight budget, family medicine specialist Dr Mastura Mohd Sopian said fresh sardines are inexpensive, and the fish could be filleted and deboned, then fried with rice for a good serving of protein and Omega-3 fatty acids.

She added that the leftover heads and bones could be boiled into a soup stock.

Dr Mastura, who is from Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), said good nutritional intake is a high priority for kids because of their rapid growth.

Aside from macro nutrients such as proteins and fats, she said attention must be paid to micro nutrients for tooth and bone development and cognitive activity.

She said iron-rich food like vegetables, meats, instead of preschoolers feel full is crucial.

"Children should be encouraged to eat a high fibre diet and stay away from highly processed food," she said.

Kindergarten operators interviewed applauded the move to increase the budget for food aid.

In this year's national budget, the preschool food aid was increased from RM89mil to RM108mil, a 21% increase.

Tadika Pavitra principal V. Santhi said the increased aid is significant to parents in the B40 group.

"This is a good long-term help for kids in lower income groups because it will increase their nutrient intake," she said.

Santhi, who has been running her kindergarten in Simpang Empat on mainland Penang for the past 25 years, said the typical morning meals for preschoolers were fried noodles, nasi lemak or roti canai.

With the increased aid, she said fruits and milk could be included in their breakfasts.

Tadika Hijah Fajar operator Christine Tan, expressed similar enthusiasm and asked for clarification on how the aid would be channelled.

"Will it be channelled through subsidies or other mechanisms?" she asked.

Malaysia Preschool Teachers Association president Sally Ng praised the government's focus on preschoolers' nutritional needs.

"Although the amount is not much, it adds up over the months and with the increased cost of living, it means a lot for the kids and their parents," she said.

## Have more food variety for kids under RMT, urge parents

**JOHOR BAHRU:** Parents are calling for more variety of food for their children under the Supplementary Food Programme (RMT).

Yushaneylah Md Yusof said her daughter, a Year Two pupil, has been eating similar meals at her school in Pasir Gudang near here.

"My daughter, who is hearing- and speech-impaired, said she had fried noodles or fried rice almost every other day."

"Sometimes, she receives bread and a packet of milk.

"I hope the school canteen operator can prepare other dishes like fried chicken or porridge occasionally so that the children would get more nutrition," she added.

However, the 44-year-old mother of three, who also has hearing and speech difficulties, was thankful for the RMT, saying the programme has helped to ease her family's financial burden.

My husband is a food delivery rider and I help out by selling homemade curry puffs. Our incomes are not stable," said Yushaneylah, who lives at a

people's housing flat.

"I have to take care of all the children myself. The youngest is only in preschool."

"We cannot afford to send them to a daycare centre due to the high charges," she said.

wished to be known only as Mani, is happy that her son's school had started serving more vegetables to the children a few months ago.

"I am happy and I hope they keep it up. This helps children to develop a healthier eating habit," said the 39-year-old sales assistant.

Meanwhile, Jackson Chong, 53, hoped that the RMT could be extended to secondary school to assist more families in coping

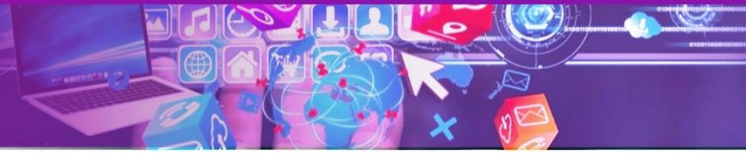
with the rising cost of living.

The father of two said he gave his son, who is in Form Two, between RM5 and RM10 daily for food.

"I also hope the programme can cover the middle-income group as well because people like us are often left out from any form of government aid," said the businessman, whose shops selling daily necessities are closed down amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

He is now operating a Bristol from home to cut down the operational costs.

## Sabah FC footballer denies injuring his lover at PJ hotel

**PETALING JAYA:** A 31-year-old footballer has claimed trial at a Magistrates' Court here for allegedly hitting his girlfriend in an incident at a hotel earlier this month.

Mohd Rizal Mohd Ghazali was accused of causing injury to Hani Farhana Hasrul Sani, 37, by hitting her at a hotel room in Petaling Jaya at about 6am on June 7.

The charge under Section 323 of the Penal Code carries a maximum two-year imprisonment or a fine of up to RM2,000 or both, upon conviction.

Mohd Rizal, a defender with the Sabah Football Club, was also slapped with a second charge of allegedly committing mischief by destroying Hani Farhana's handphone in the same incident.

The estimated cost of damage is RM4,500.

The charge was framed under Section 427 of the Penal Code and Mohd Rizal faces imprisonment of up to three months, or a fine, or both, if convicted.

The footballer appeared calm after the charges were read out here yesterday and pleaded not guilty to both charges.

Deputy public prosecutor Siti Maryam Jamilah Md Kamal offered bail at RM7,000 for both charges with the additional condition that the accused must not harass the victim and prosecution witnesses.

Lawyer Datuk Suraj Singh, who represented Mohd Rizal, told the court that the bail amount was too high and asked for a lower amount.

He said his client was released on police bail without any sureties and came to court on his own as soon as he was told to do so.

"He is a football player who supports his parents. There is no risk of him absconding."

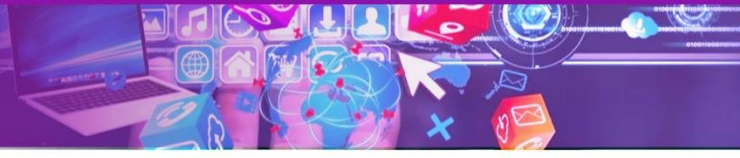
"The bail amount is meant to ensure presence in court and not punitive," Suraj said.

Magistrate Zhafran Rahim Hamzah fixed bail at RM3,500 in one surety and ordered the accused not to harass the victim and witnesses.

The case is fixed for mention on Aug 24.

# Seven-year-old dies in car-lorry crash

**KOTA KINABALU:** A seven-year-old girl died after the car she was travelling in with two relatives was involved in an accident with a lorry.

She was declared dead on the spot while the 59-year-old woman driver of the car and a 15-year-old boy suffered minor injuries in the accident at about 5.30am yesterday at Jalan Lintas near Taman Khidmat here.

The three victims were stuck inside after the crash and had to be extracted, said a Fire and Rescue Department spokesman.

"Two of them were given treatment by a medical officer and health personnel at the scene."

The 39-year-old lorry driver was not injured.

In KUALA BERANG, Hulu Terengganu, an elderly couple were killed after the four-wheel-drive vehicle they were travelling in crashed into a trailer lorry at KM392.9 of the East Coast Expressway 2 (LPT2).

Hulu Terengganu district police chief Deputy Supt Hasmeera Hassan said Mohd Ghani, 68, and his wife Minah Abdullah, 69, from Kampung Tok Rimau in Kuala Terengganu, died on the spot from severe body injuries in the 9pm accident on Sunday.

He said from preliminary investigations, the victims were believed to have been travelling from Kuantan to Kuala Terengganu when the vehicle, driven by

their son, rear-ended a trailer carrying oil palm dregs, which was heading to Kota Baru, on the left lane.

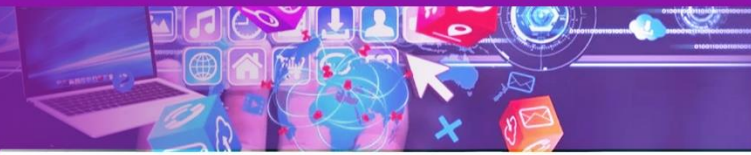
"The impact of the crash caused severe damage to the front part of the vehicle.

## Elderly couple killed in crash

**P**ETALING JAYA: A lawyer has called for the establishment of "specialised adolescent courts" to deal with teenage drug and substance abuse.

Kokila Vaani Vadiveloo was commenting on the number of teenagers falling into the trap of drug and substance abuse as highlighted in the Adolescent Health Survey (AHS) conducted last year by the Institute for Public Health.

AHS revealed that about 60,000 adolescents were on narcotics, and 75% of teenagers between the age of 13 and 17 used drugs before their 14th birthday.

Of the 60,000 adolescents, 2.8% admitted to using inhalants such as glue and paint, 2.3% reported using kratom or ketum, 1.1% indicated marijuana use at least once, and 1% disclosed using amphetamines or methamphetamines.

Kokila Vaani, who is also chair of the Selangor Bar Child Rights committee, said the specialised adolescent courts should emphasise rehabilitation, treatment and support rather than punishment.

"To better support adolescents who are struggling with drugs and substance use, the legal system should consider having these specialised adolescent courts to deal with them."

She said to effectively evaluate prevention programmes, collaboration among government agencies, NGOs, academic institutions and communities is also crucial, adding that schools and parents should work together to prevent and address drug and substance abuse among adolescents.

She said this could be achieved through a comprehensive anti-drug education, creating a drug-free environment, and working together to provide resources to help children stay drug-free.

"There are also options available for adolescents caught in possession of drugs or substances. These include counselling, treatment services and family therapy."

"NGOs such as Rumah Pengasih Warga Pribatin Malaysia offer tailored rehabilitation

programmes for adolescents struggling with drug addiction," Kokila Vaani said.

She added that the programmes facilitate monitoring and evaluation processes, leading to improved prevention strategies.

She also said support services for teenagers dealing with drug addiction encompass prevention and treatment aspects through rehabilitation centres, counselling services, helplines and support groups for them and their families throughout the recovery process.

"There are various laws and regulations in place to address drug and substance abuse among youths, including the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952 and the Child Act 2001. In cases where parents or guardians expose children to drug use, legal action will be taken against them."

She said in a case in 2021, a father was found guilty of causing a three-year-old child

to be tested positive for drugs such as amphetamines and methamphetamines.

"Such cases fall under Section 31(1)(A) of the Child Act 2001, which carries a maximum sentence of 20 years imprisonment or a fine of RM50,000, or both, upon conviction of an offence of neglecting, abusing or abandoning a child in a manner likely to cause him physical or emotional injury."

"It will also fall under Section 14(1) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952, which states that any person who administers any dangerous drug specified in Parts III and IV of the First Schedule to any other person

shall be guilty of an offence under the Act and shall be liable, upon conviction, to a fine not exceeding RM10,000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years, or to both,"

Kokila Vaani said. Meanwhile, former YouthCare Malaysia secretary-general Norol Ariff A'toullah Norolazali said it is shocking that adolescents are exposed to drug use.

He said the prevalence of drug and substance abuse among Malaysian adolescents over the past decade has been steadily increasing due to accessibility and demographic influences.

Norol Ariff said from his experience, some adolescents were more vulnerable to drug use due to factors such as their socioeconomic status, residential location, education level and family dynamics.

"This vulnerability may be higher among low-income families, and others who experienced trauma or abuse, have mental health issues and are involved in gangs or criminal activity."

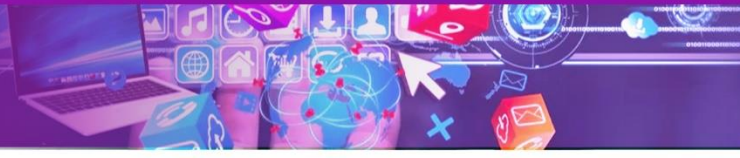
"Peer pressure, stress, family problems, and exposure to a drug-using environment are some of the reasons teenagers get initiated into drug use."

Norol Ariff said the risk factors associated with drug use among adolescents include a family history of substance abuse, mental health issues, early exposure to drugs, low socioeconomic status, limited access to education and lack of parental guidance.

He said addressing the issue of drug use among adolescents requires advocacy campaigns and collaboration with educational institutions.

"Engagement with policymakers is crucial to effect systemic changes and promote sustainable solutions. By considering such measures, we can strive towards reducing the alarming prevalence of drug use among youths."

Jaafar Along, 58, said he decided to stop his 11-year-old daughter from attending school as he is worried for her safety, adding that

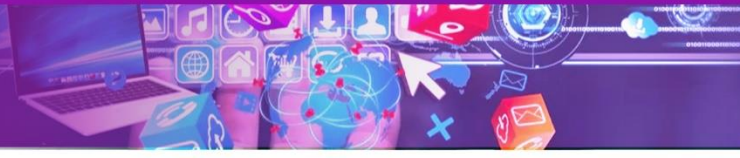
other students were also reluctant to go to school and their parents were not forcing them to attend classes.
