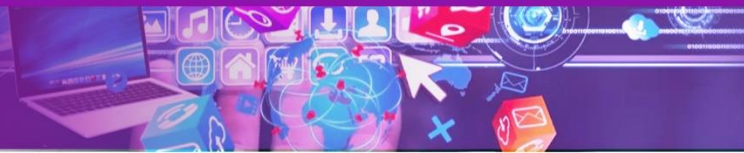

## 2 pelajar cemerlang SPM antara 3 didakwa kes rogol

**Muar:** Dua pelajar cemerlang Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) adalah antara tiga orang yang didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen semalam atas pertuduhan merogol seorang kenalan bawah umur pada Julai dan minggu lalu.

Muhammad Ammar Zikry Mohd Izrak, Muhammad Anaqi Lukmanulhakim masing-masing berusia 18 tahun dan Muhammad Daniel Haikal Helmi Effero, 20, mengaku tidak bersalah sebaik pertuduhan dibaca di hadapan Hakim Abu Bakar Manat.

Muhammad Ammar Zikry dan Muhammad Anaqi yang juga tertuduh pertama dan kedua, manakala Muhammad Daniel Haikal, sebagai tertuduh ketiga masing-masing berdepan

satu tuduhan merogol.

Mengikut kertas pertuduhan, Muhammad Ammar Zikry dan Muhammad Anaqi didakwa merogol kenalan perempuan berusia 12 tahun dalam kebun sawit dekat Sri Gading, Batu Pahat pada jam 11.30 malam, 14 Ogos lalu.

Mereka didakwa melakukan kesalahan mengikut Seksyen 375B Kanun Keseksaan iaitu merogol secara berkumpulan yang membawa hukuman penjara sehingga 30 tahun.

Muhammad Daniel Haikal didakwa merogol mangsa sama di sebuah rumah di Batu Pahat pada jam 8.30 malam, pertengahan bulan lalu.

Lepasan sijil kemahiran itu didakwa melakukan kesalahan mengikut Seksyen 376 (1) Kanun Ke-

seksaan yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Daniel Munir manakala Muhammad Ammar Zikry diwakili peguam Aqmarul Aqil Ismail.

Aqmarul Aqil turut mewakili Muhammad Anaqi dan Muhammad Daniel, tetapi atas dasar pro bono untuk jaminan.

Terdahulu, pihak pendakwaan memohon mahkamah mengenakan ikat jamin RM25,000 terhadap Muhammad Ammar Zikry dan Muhammad Anaqi serta RM20,000 ke atas Muhammad Daniel Haikal.

Mahkamah membenarkan ikat jamin RM8,000 setiap seorang dengan seorang penjamin.

Tertuduh, Muhammad Ammar Zikry Mohd Izrak dan Muhammad Anaqi Lukmanulhakim masing-masing berusia 18 tahun serta Muhammad Daniel Haikal Helmi Effero, 20, bagaimanapun mengaku tidak bersalah sebaik pertuduhan dibaca di hadapan Hakim Abu Bakar Manat.

Mengikut kertas pertuduhan, Muhammad Ammar Zikry dan Muhammad Anaqi

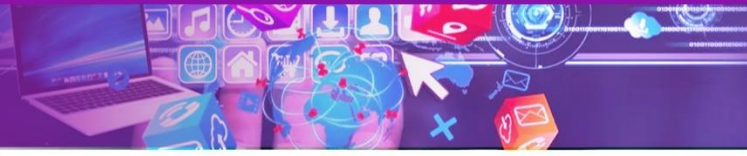
Terdahulu, pihak pendakwaan memohon mahkamah mengenakan ikat jamin sebanyak RM25,000 terhadap Muhammad Ammar Zikry dan Muhammad Anaqi manakala Muhammad Daniel Haikal pula sebanyak RM20,000.

Aqmarul Aqil kemudian memohon mahkamah supaya meringankan jaminan terhadap ketiga-tiga tertuduh dengan mengambil kira rekod pencapaian akademik dan kokurikulum.

Selepas mempertimbangkan hujahan kedua-dua belah pihak, mahkamah membenarkan ikat jamin sebanyak RM8,000 setiap seorang dengan seorang penjamin.

Di samping itu, mahkamah juga menetapkan syarat supaya semua tertuduh melapor diri di balai polis berdekatan serta tidak boleh mengganggu atau berhubung dengan mangsa serta keluarganya.

Jika gagal mematuhi syarat ditetapkan itu, mahkamah memutuskan bahawa jaminan dikenakan terhadap ketiga-tiga tertuduh akan ditarik balik.

## 'CCTVs at childcare centres effective tool for children's safety'

**BINTULU:** Bintulu Childcare and Early Childhood Educators Association chairperson Maraini Jaafar welcomes the move by the federal government to enforce laws regarding the installation of closed circuit television cameras (CCTVs) at childcare centres.

Maraini said this in response to the recent proposal by Minister of Women, Family and Community Development (KPWK) Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri in making the installation of CCTVs as a mandatory condition for renewing childcare centre licences.

Although the government had stipulated that the installation of CCTVs were required under the Child Care Centre Act 1984 and the Child Care Centre Regulations 2012, the Minister

said that there were still cases of non-compliant operators.

This measure, Nancy said as quoted by Bernama, had to be taken to curb cases of children being abused at childcare centres.

Maraini opined that CCTVs are an effective tool to monitor daily activities that take place in the childcare centres and to ensure the safety and well-being of the children within the setting.

"It is important to have the CCTVs as evidence of any serious incidents concerning children and staff," she said, adding that parents would have more confidence in sending their children to a registered childcare centres with CCTVs.

"With CCTVs, the staff will be more proactive and productive in doing their tasks because

they know that they are being monitored.

"Some might think it may create stressful situations and disrupt the childcare centres' routines, but I believe that this would not pose a problem for those who have integrity in their workplace," said the operator of Taska Permata Kasih and Taska Penyayang Mama.

Child abuse cases have seen an alarming increase recently, she added, to which they have not only happened at the children's nurseries, kindergartens or daycare centres, but also at home.

Adding on, Maraini said the CCTVs must also be regularly checked to ensure they are in proper working order, and also be installed in strategic locations within the premises.

"CCTV installation cost should

not be an issue because there are many options available in the market with cheaper price and functions," she said.

When asked if parents ought to be given the access to childcare centre's CCTV, Maraini pointed out that the CCTV footage is meant for specific purposes such as for safety and in providing evidence in the event of injury or misconduct.

"Parents, therefore, must be wise and choose only registered childcare centres for their children," she stressed.

"Sometimes, abuse or injury cases may happen in the kindergarten, but often the nursery gets highlighted in such cases," she said.

With stricter enforcement and the mandatory installation of CCTVs in childcare centres, she expressed hope that this would

give positive impact in terms of safety and security of children, and also in making sure that the premise operators comply to the regulations and requirements.

"What matters the most is the integrity in the profession, as well as the empathy and responsibility towards the young children.

"Each and every child, whether they are attending private or public daycare or preschools, deserves to be cared and nurtured," she stressed.

"The state government's efforts and initiatives in early childhood and childcare industry are timely as young parents now have to spend more to raise a child due to the rising cost of living," she said, adding that private daycares also deserve to be assisted in grants and subsidies.

# Amanita expands collab with Permyjaya housewives

**MIRI:** The state's Women Peace Police Squad (Amanita) yesterday launched its adoption programme involving a residential area, the RPR Link Quadruplex in Permyjaya new township here.

Sarawak Police Commissioner Dato Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri said the housing estate adoption initiative would engage more housewives to be involved in helping eradicate crimes.

"Amanita was started in 2013 by the Royal Malaysia Police (PDRM) to combat crime in residential areas, whereby female officers in each police station will deal directly with the housewives," he said when launching the programme at the new township here yesterday.

The programme, he added, also aimed at obtaining information related to crimes that were not reported among the community.

"Having the housewives involved in this programme is the right choice because they are always at home and are aware of the developments around the residential area.

"They (housewives) deserve to be given a mandate to report any crimes to the designated police officers," he said, adding that the implementation of the programme has by far yielded good results in reducing crime rates.

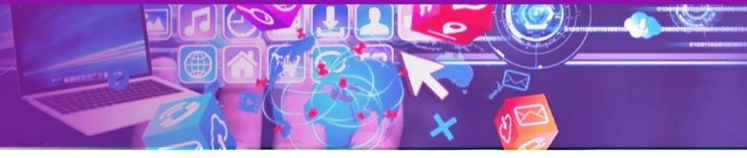
Mohd Azman said the programme has also forged good

# For the homeless, dealing with mental illness an everyday struggle

A WOMAN smiles as she peers out the wide corridor of Desa Bina Diri Kuching (DBD), a special home for the destitute run by Sarawak Social Welfare Department (JKMS).

"Come in! Come in!" Kim (not her real name) calls out from her room while cheerfully waving her hands in the air.

Kim looks just like any other women one might pass by on the street without giving a second look. A chatty and cheerful person, she is full of smiles and quick to crack a joke.

But her cheeriness can disappear in a blink of an eye when she is in a foul mood and not on her medication, transforming her into a different person – aggressive, agitated and even violent.

For almost seven years, this 43-year-old woman has been diagnosed with psychosis. She relies on her prescribed medication to deal with her hallucinations.

For seven years now, she has been following the same routine – swallowing six types of pills in the morning, and again at night.

Kim's mental illness only began to show symptoms during her first six months at Desa Bina Diri, and began deteriorating in the years that followed.

She now no longer remembers her full name and has trouble speaking.

Prior to her admission in Desa Bina Diri seven years ago, Kim's boyfriend abandoned her after discovering she was pregnant. At 26, she became homeless and had nothing to her name except her personal documents and the child in her belly.

For many years, she faced the mental pressures of living on the streets. Faced with poverty and

with little access to healthcare, she ended up giving birth to her son at a bus station.

All this, she believes, affected her son's brain development, leaving him mentally handicapped.

Kim's unstable physical and mental health condition is also shared by other residents of Desa

Bina Diri Kuching

According to Sarawak Welfare Department chief assistant director (Enforcement) Harry Silas Tirau, the residents often develop mental illnesses during their first three to six months of admission at the facility.

He said this is because they have often never been formally

diagnosed – that is until there are rescued by welfare officers.

"You have to deal with office work and looking after their needs. We have 39 residents, meaning we have to deal with 39 different 'characters'," he said.

Taking care of 39 destitute persons who previously slept on the streets means Desa Bina Diri staff like Sulaiman Morni has to learn all of their different behaviours.

"Most of the time, the residents wander the streets while talking to themselves. Sometimes they are half-naked, sometimes fully naked.

"They might also behave aggressively towards the people around them, so we must keep them occupied. For instance, when they get agitated, we must ensure they have taken their medication to control their behaviour.

"But there are times when they cannot control their hallucination. They speak to someone that's invisible. And then, they will cry, sometimes scream.

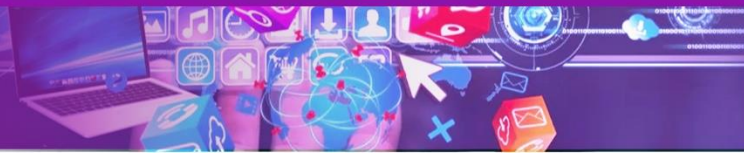
"It's like they are quarrelling with someone, but that person is invisible," he told The Borneo Post when met at Desa Bina Diri Kuching in Kota Samarahan.

He said the common trait shared by all of the residents is their homeless 'character' which they have a hard time shedding.

The staff, he said would also need to help wash the residents on a daily basis, and also clean them when they relieve themselves.

"Because of their homeless 'character', some of them would urinate and defecate anywhere they like and we need to clean it up," he said.

## Woman injures head, hands in fall from city centre premises

**MIRI:** A woman suffered injuries to her head and hands after falling from a premises in the city centre here Saturday night.

The Civil Defence Force (APM) in a statement said they were notified of the incident at 8.33pm and rushed a team to the scene.

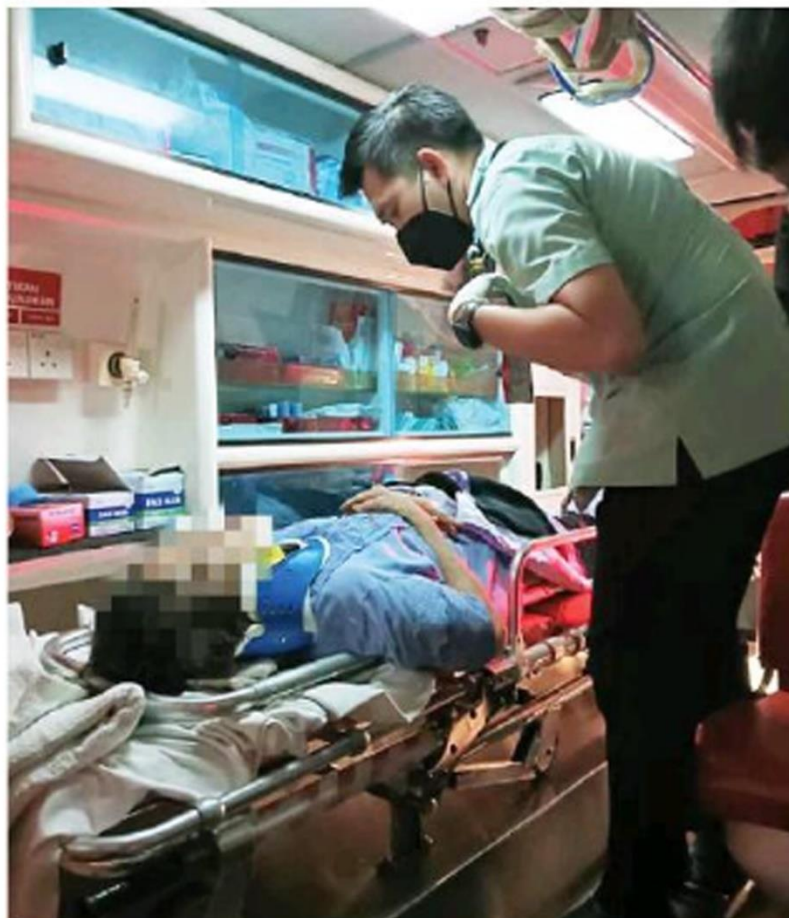
"Upon arrival, the team was met by the male caller who reported that he found the victim

lying on the road," it said.

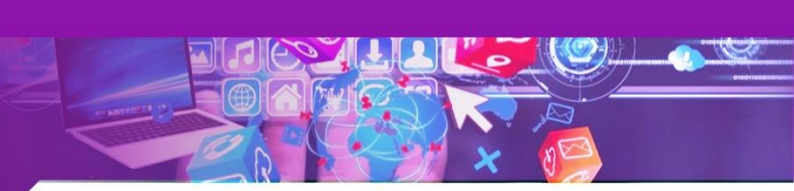
APM said the woman was given first aid before being taken to Miri Hospital for further treatment.

The operation ended at 8.50pm.

A WAVE of cheer and applause broke the evening silence in Kampung Semayan, in the northern part of Banggi Island off Sabah's Kudat district, as the village community finally got to switch on the lights at their homes after living without electricity for decades.

Most of us take lighting for granted, but these villagers have dwelled in the dark all this while. Now, they do not have to be left behind, as PETRONAS

through its subsidiary PETRONAS Floating LNG (PFLNG) has come forward with solar energy to power their homes under the second phase of its Uplifting Lives - Rays of Hope programme.

"We have been living without any electricity power source for decades. Our family uses oil lamps and torchlights as well as alternative energy sources such as batteries to operate our electrical appliances," said 74-year-old Hadiah Daud.

She said that at her age, she almost gave up hope of ever enjoying electricity supply like other Malaysians and was more than elated when informed that hers would be among the homes in Kampung Semayan to be hooked to solar energy.

Kampung Semayan is nestled several hours away from Banggi's main town, and one would have to travel on gravel and dirt road past oil palm estates to reach the village.

There is a school here powered by generators, which are also the main source of electricity for villagers to charge their hand-phones.

Hadiah said the villagers would have to be very careful and economical with their usage of oil lamps because the fuel to light up the lamps can only be purchased from a petrol station in Kota Kinabalu.

"So, if we run out of the oil, we have to travel for a few hours from here to Banggi town, take a 45-minute to an hour's boat ride to Kudat, then take a bus to Kota Kinabalu," she said, adding that five litres of the fuel cost about RM20 and would last up to two months if used wisely.

Local caterer Sufiana Johari, 25, said her house was installed with solar panels, light bulbs and a fan on Aug 9, and her whole family was so overjoyed they could hardly sleep that night.

"Can you imagine having to go to bed early every day and doing

our chores using just a flashlight or oil lamps in the evening for years? So, of course when we

finally have light, we celebrate," said the mother of three. She said they were so happy

that they could not stop talking, singing with neighbours, or just hanging out on the balcony.

"It feels like we've achieved true independence with this gift of light that we received from PETRONAS during this National Day month," Sufiana added.

Year Three pupil Shakira Abdul Saleh was clearly delighted when the lights were turned on at her house, smiling non-stop. The shy nine-year-old loved to draw and she was already on the floor drawing away immediately after that.

Her mother Majidah Masuah, 48, said that when dusk descended, they usually used a flashlight or oil lamps as Shakira needed to do her homework or drawing.

"I normally hold the flashlight for her but now, there is no need to go through all that hassle because we have power supply," she said.

### Solar-power energy systems

These villagers are among the 140 households who got the solar panels as part of PETRONAS' social impact programme which

started installation earlier this year. The PETRONAS Uplifting Lives - Rays of Hope programme is expected to conclude by September, when all the 140 targeted houses get their solar panels and items such as light bulbs and fans installed.

PFLNG has collaborated with the Ministry of Rural Development Sabah to establish clean energy access for three villages on Banggi Island.

This collaboration resulted in the installation of solar-power energy systems which benefit over 700 residents.

The objective is to empower underprivileged communities by facilitating access to sustainable energy solutions for them, with the aim of enhancing their quality of life and promoting inclusive development. In February this year, PETRONAS successfully marked the start of this clean energy initiative by installing solar-powered systems at prayer halls (*surau*) in the three villages - Kampung Rahmat, Kampung Semayan and Kampung Dogoton.

The initiative's subsequent phase is currently underway, involving the installation of solar-powered systems at 140 homes in these three villages. With a targeted completion date set for September 2023, this effort is expected to improve living conditions and enhance economic opportunities for the residents.

According to PFLNG chief executive officer Azrul Roshazi, PETRONAS as a progressive energy and solutions provider not only has the responsibility to provide lower-carbon energy for businesses but also to help improve the livelihoods of the communities where they operate.

“Majlis Taman Angkat AMANITA Kontinjen Sarawak yang dilancarkan ini diharap akan menghasilkan seorang suri rumah

yang berkemampuan untuk menjadikan keselamatan diri, keluarga dan harta benda; mengenali dan melaporkan aktiviti-aktiviti yang mencurigakan serta kejadian jenayah yang berlaku; menjaga keselamatan harta jiran sekitar kediaman dan bekerjasama dengan pihak polis bagi mengenal pasti kegiatan jenayah yang sering berlaku di kawasan mereka.

“Saya berharap program ini memberi keyakinan kepada orang awam dan masyarakat setempat terhadap PDRM dalam memberantas kegiatan jenayah melalui inisiatif AMANITA dan Taman Angkat AMANITA.

“Dengan kewujudan AMANITA PDRM di kawasan taman perumahan ini

# Pusat jagaan kanak-kanak wajib pasang CCTV

Untuk pantau aktiviti harian agar pengusaha, penyelia dan agensi terlibat patuhi peraturan

**BINTULU:** Pemasangan kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) merupakan peralatan yang perlu disediakan di setiap pusat jagaan kanak-kanak untuk memantau aktiviti harian yang berlaku di pusat tersebut agar pengusaha, penyelia dan agensi terlibat mematuhi peraturan.

Pengerusi Persatuan Pengasah dan Pendidik Awal Kanak-Kanak Bintulu (PAKB) Maraini Jaafar berkata, pemasangan CCTV diwajibkan di setiap taska dan surat pekeliling berhubung kewajipan memasang CCTV bagi setiap proses pendaftaran di taska telah dikuatkuasakan Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) sejak sekian lama.

Katanya, cadangan Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK) untuk menjadikan pemasangan CCTV sebagai syarat wajib memperbaharui lesen taman asuhan

kanak-kanak amat disokong kerana bagi taska berdaftar, semua syarat dan syarat yang ditetapkan perlu dipatuhi.

Baru-baru ini Menteri KPWK Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri seperti dipetik BERNAMA berkata, langkah itu perlu diambil bagi membanding kes penderaan kanak-kanak di premis berkecemasan walaupun sebelum ini kerajaan telah menetapkan CCTV diperlukan di bawah Akta Taman Asuhan Kanak-Kanak 1984 dan Peraturan-Peraturan Taman Asuhan

Menteri berkata, ada yang tidak memasang CCTV walaupun diminta mematuhi.

Maraini berkata, CCTV adalah alat berkesan untuk memudahkan atau memantau aktiviti harian yang berlaku di taman asuhan kanak-kanak kerana mereka tahu mereka sedang dipantau.

Begitupun katanya, mungkin ada kesan negatif kerana ini sebenarnya memberi tekanan apabila pergerakan mereka diperhatikan dengan teliti dan tiada perasaan selamat.

ke pusat asuhan kanak-kanak berdaftar yang mempunyai CCTV,” katanya.

Beliau berkata, dengan adanya CCTV, kakitangan akan lebih proaktif dan produktif dalam melaksanakan tanggungjawab mereka kerana mereka tahu mereka sedang dipantau.

Begitupun katanya, mungkin ada kesan negatif kerana ini sebenarnya memberi tekanan apabila pergerakan mereka diperhatikan dengan teliti dan tiada perasaan selamat.

“Bagi yang tidak kuat, mereka akan tertekan tetapi mereka yang mempunyai integriti dalam kerja tiada masalah,” kata Maraini yang merupakan pengendali Taska Permata Kasih dan Taska Penyayang Mama Bintulu ketika ditanya mengenai cadangan pemasangan CCTV yang diwajibkan itu.

Katanya, kes penderaan dalam kalangan kanak-kanak semakin meningkat dan sangat serius bukan sahaja berlaku di taska tetapi juga di tadika, pusat asuhan dan jumlah kes yang tinggi berlaku di rumah juga amat membimbangkan.

Beliau berkata, meskipun terdapat CCTV, kes penderaan dalam kalangan kanak-kanak masih berlaku dan terdapat banyak faktor yang menyebabkan kes tersebut memerlukan perhatian lebih lanjut.

Justeru katanya, CCTV mesti diperiksa secara berkala agar ia berfungsi dengan baik dan mesti dipasang di lokasi strategik.

“Kos pemasangan CCTV tidak menjadi isu kerana kini terdapat banyak pilihan di pasaran, CCTV yang didaftarkan dengan harga lebih murah dan pelbagai fungsi turut disediakan.

“Ibu bapa perlu faham bahawa rakaman CCTV hanya boleh digunakan untuk tujuan tertentu.

“Ibu bapa mesti bijak, pilih sahaja pusat jagaan kanak-kanak yang berdaftar,” katanya.

Maraini berkata, orang ramai perlu faham dan jelas bahawa taska, tadika, pusat asuhan dan pusat tuisyen adalah entiti yang berbeza.

Jelasnya, pengusaha premis perlu mempunyai integriti tinggi dengan mengambil kanak-kanak mengikut umur mereka serta syarat dan keperluan lain.

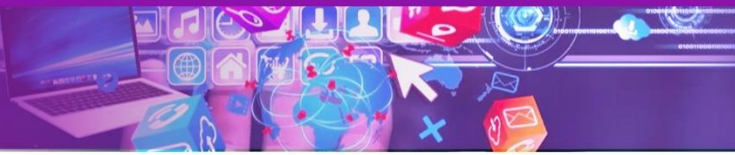
“Ibu bapa juga tidak perlu terkeliru dengan taska dan tadika, kadangkala penderaan, kes kecederaan mungkin berlaku di tempat lain sebaliknya taska diketengahkan,” katanya.

Beliau berharap dengan penguatkuasaan pemasangan mandatori CCTV di pusat jagaan kanak-kanak, tahap keselamatan dalam kalangan kanak-kanak dapat dipertingkatkan.

“Apa yang penting, semua yang terlibat dalam bidang ini sama ada, ia ada atau tanpa CCTV adalah integriti dalam kerjaya dan sikap empati terhadap kanak-kanak perlu tinggi,” katanya.

Beliau berharap kerajaan akan terus menyokong industri pendidikan awal kanak-kanak dan penjagaan kanak-kanak serta menyokong ibu bapa muda yang menanggung kos tinggi untuk kanak-kanak kecil, termasuk kakitangan di taska, terutama taska swasta yang perlu dibantu seperti di Singapura.

“Setiap kanak-kanak tidak kira di mana mereka dihantar berhak mendapat asuhan dan penjagaan yang sama seperti di taska lain yang diberi geran, subsidi dan peruntukan oleh kerajaan,” tambahnya.

"Mangsa kemudiannya telah diarahkan untuk memuat naik satu lagi aplikasi eBay bagi tujuan memulakan penugasan dengan membuat tempahan barangan dan membuat bayaran dalam tempoh yang ditetapkan oleh suspek," ujarnya.

Zulkipli berkata, bermula dari tempoh 13 hingga 14 Ogos, mangsa telah membuat pembayaran sebanyak 15 kali transaksi berjumlah RM26,780.08 ke dalam tujuh akaun yang berlainan dan dijanjikan akan menerima komisen 10 peratus bagi setiap pembayaran.

"Namun sehingga laporan dibuat, mangsa tidak menerima komisen yang dijanjikan dan menyedari telah tertipu," ujarnya.

Katanya, pihak polis menasihati orang ramai agar tidak mudah terperdaya dan terpengaruh dengan tawaran pekerjaan melalui media sosial yang menjanjikan pulangan lumayan.
