'Kematian pelajar sekolah di Manjung tiada kaitan buli'

Laporan hospital sahkan mangsa alami darah beku tersumbat pada paru-paru

Manjung: Polis menafikan kemungkinan buli dalam kematian pelajar berusia 15 tahun di Hospital Seri Manjung di sini, Sabtu lalu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Manjung, Asisten Komisioner Mohamed Nordin Abdullah, berkata sebaliknya laporan oleh pegawai perubatan hospital mengesahkan

punca kematian pelajar itu adalah 'acute massive pulmonary embolism' atau darah beku tersumbat pada paru-paru.

"Kita menolak kemungkinan kematian pelajar berkenaan mempunyai kaitan dengan kes buli.

"Susulan kejadian ini, polis membuka satu kertas siasatan mati mengejut untuk siasatan lanjut dan orang awam dinasihat tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi," katanya ketika dihubungi.

Pengsan di sekolah

Berdasarkan maklumat, pelajar Tingkatan Tiga itu dikatakan pengsan ketika kelas subjek Pendidikan Jasmani dan Kesihatan di sekolahnya pada pagi Jumaat lalu, sebelum dihantar ke hospital untuk menerima rawatan.

Mohamed Nordin berkata, pihaknya menerima laporan mengenai kejadian itu jam 4.38 pe-

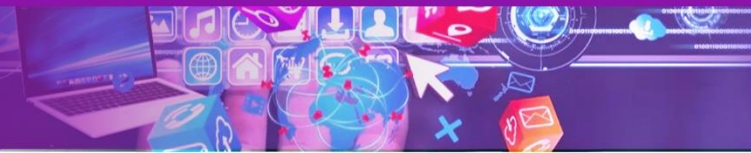
tang kelmarin.

Siasatan awal, katanya, mendapati pelajar itu hadir ke sekolah Jumaat lalu dalam keadaan tidak sihat kerana mengalami kesakitan di kaki dan berjalan menggunakan tongkat.

"Pihak sekolah menghubungi ibu bapa pelajar kira-kira jam 7.30 pagi Jumaat lalu bagi memaklumkan keadaan itu sebelum mereka memutuskan untuk membawanya pulang ke rumah.

"Berikutan keadaannya masih tidak sihat, pelajar itu dibawa ke Hospital Seri Manjung untuk rawatan di Unit Kecemasan sebelum dipindahkan ke Unit rawatan Rapi (ICU) jam 10.10 malam.

"Bagaimanapun, pada jam 12.06 tengah malam Sabtu, pihak hospital memaklumkan pelajar berkenaan meninggal dunia di bilik ICU Hospital Seri Manjung," katanya melalui kenyataan.

Daftar bantuan eBelia Rahmah bermula Isnin

Pemohon layak boleh guna tiga penyedia perkhidmatan e-dompot terima kredit RM200

Putrajaya: Belia berumur 18 hingga 20 tahun atau pelajar sepenuh masa di institusi pengajian tinggi (IPT) boleh mula mendaftar untuk menerima kredit RM200 bagi program eBelia Rahmah mulai Isnin, 26 Jun ini jam 8 pagi.

Kementerian Kewangan (MoF) dalam kenyataan semalam berkata, tempoh pendaftaran dan tuntutan eBelia Rahmah mulai 26 Jun hingga 22 Ogos depan.

MoF berkata, belia yang layak boleh mendaftar melalui satu daripada tiga penyedia perkhidmatan e-dompot, iaitu Boost, Setel dan Touch 'n Go eWallet.

"Kredit eBelia Rahmah dan manfaat padanan daripada penyedia perkhidmatan e-dompot berkenaan boleh dibelanjakan secara *offline* hingga 31 Ogos 2023," kata MoF.

MoF berkata, program berkenaan terbuka kepada belia warganegara yang mencapai umur 18 hingga 20 tahun pada 2023 iaitu mereka yang lahir pada 2003

hingga 2005 atau berstatus aktif sebagai pelajar sepenuh masa di IPT dalam negara.

MoF berkata, selain bantuan RM200 dalam bentuk kredit e-tunai daripada kerajaan, penyedia perkhidmatan e-dompot terbabit turut memberikan insentif tambahan dalam bentuk baucar, pulangan tunai atau diskaun mata ganjaran sepanjang tempoh program berkenaan.

"Kredit RM200 ini boleh dimanfaatkan di peruncit atau peniaga yang menerima pembayaran melalui kod QR DuitNow dengan menggunakan salah satu e-dompot terbabit dalam program ini, namun tertakluk kepada transaksi dibenarkan," kata MoF seperti laporan *BERNAMA*.

Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yang juga Menteri Kewangan ketika membentangkan Belanjawan 2023 Malaysia MADANI di Dewan Rakyat pada 24 Februari lalu menyatakan kerajaan akan memberikan kredit e-tunai berjumlah RM200 kepada dua juta belia berusia 18

hingga 20 tahun, membabitkan peruntukan RM400 juta.

Ringankan beban pelajar

Sementara itu, Presiden Majlis Perundingan Pelajar Kebangsaan (MPPK), Wan Amsyar Hadie Wan Mahadi, berkata bantuan eBelia Rahmah itu sewajarnya dimanfaatkan bagi meringankan beban pelajar dalam hal berkaitan pembelajaran.

"Sebaiknya, elak menghabiskan wang itu untuk perkara tidak bermanfaat, termasuk yang hanya menurus kepada gaya kehidupan atau hiburan.

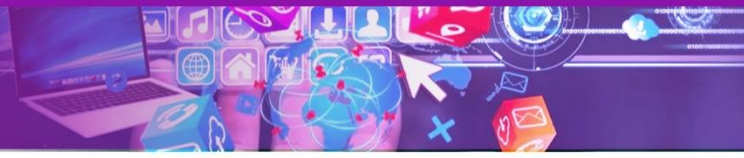
"Sebaliknya, gunakan bantuan ini bagi membeli buku rujukan atau apa sahaja yang boleh membantu kelancaran pelajaran, lebih-lebih lagi sebahagian besar penerima adalah mereka yang baru memasuki pusat pengajian," katanya ketika dihubungi *BH*, semalam.

Penggunaan bantuan dengan betul, jelasnya, akan memastikan matlamat kerajaan meringankan beban pelajar tercapai.

Hampir 5 juta pesakit manfaatkan khidmat IJN

Johor Bahru: Hampir lima juta pesakit menerima rawatan di Institut Jantung Negara (IJN) sejak pusat perubatan itu ditubuhkan pada 1992, menurut Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif IJN Datuk Dr Aizai Azan Abdul Rahim.

Beliau berkata, IJN tidak berhadapan dengan masalah bagi menampung kapasiti tersebut berikutan mempunyai kakitangan serta kelengkapan fasiliti yang mencukupi.

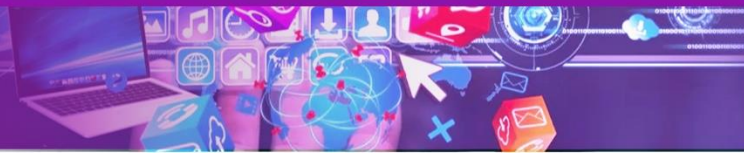
ram kolaborasi penyelidikan dan inovasi bersama pakar perubatannya serta penyelidik UTM di peringkat yang lebih tinggi.

Tasek Gelugor: Kehilangan peserta Malaysia Everest (ME) 2023 Muhammad Hawari Hashim, 33, sejak 19 Mei lalu merentap perasaan isterinya, Saffiyah Tang Xie Lie, 34, dan kini buntu memikirkan masa depan apatah lagi dia tidak bekerja.

Saffiyah yang juga orang kurang upaya (OKU) pendengaran seperti suaminya, sudah lama tidak bekerja selepas melahirkan anak sulungnya yang kini berusia empat tahun.

Menurutnya, pekerjaan terakhirnya ialah sebagai guru di sebuah sekolah agama swasta di Kulim.

Melalui temu bual menerusi catatan pada buku nota, Saffiyah memaklumkan dia bersedia menerima apa jua tawaran kerja sekiranya diberikan peluang oleh mana-mana majikan.

"Saya akan terima (tawaran kerja) demi anak-anak dan menantu (ibu Hawari) untuk kelangsungan hidup kami sekeluarga.

"Dulu, saya ada memohon kerja dengan agensi kerajaan tetapi saya tahu ia amat sukar. Saya mempunyai kemahiran dalam komputer dan tahu kerja-kerja berkaitan pentadbiran serta perkeranian tetapi untuk menjawab telefon, saya tidak boleh kerana kekurangan yang ada pada diri saya," katanya ketika ditemui di rumah mentuanya di Kampung Permatang Kerai Besar, di sini, kelmarin.

Saffiyah berkata, suaminya membeli rumah pertama mereka tidak jauh dari kediaman mentuanya, namun tidak tahu status bayaran kediaman berkenaan susulan kehilangan Muhammad Hawari.

"Rumah itu belum lagi kami duduk namun bayarannya sudah dibuat melalui potongan gaji suami tetapi sekarang saya tidak tahu statusnya.

"Selain itu, suami juga ada buat pinjaman peribadi mengubah suai rumah. Apabila saya fikir mengenai hal ini, ia buat saya bertambah buntu kerana sekarang tidak bekerja.

"Anak sulung saya pula tahun depan akan ke sekolah, sudah tentu memerlukan perbelanjaan dari segi bayaran yuran dan sebagainya," katanya.

Sementara itu, ibu mentuanya, Che Tom Hassan, 64, berkata dia berharap ada pihak sudi menawarkan pekerjaan untuk menantunya.

"Apabila dia (Saffiyah) bekerja dia akan sibukkan diri dan pada masa sama, segala masalah difikirkan selama ini perlahan-lahan akan hilang.

"Sudahlah kerap menangis kerana kehilangan Hawari, kemudian ditambah pula selalu fikir mengenai masa depan sebab itu maccik hendak dia bekerja supaya boleh lihat dunia luar serta dapat mengurangkan sedikit kekusutan fikirannya," katanya.

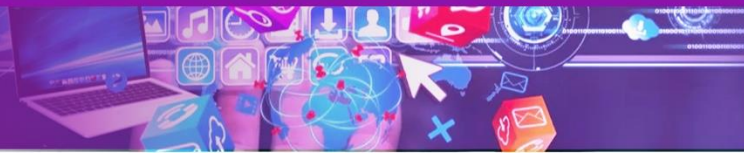

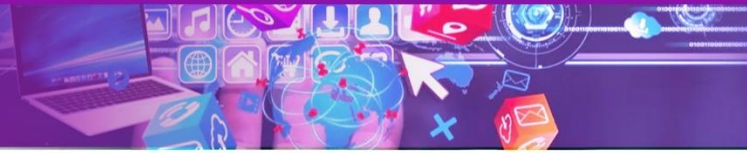

Gadis berketinggian 157sm tak kekok ceburi profesion didominasi lelaki, warga asing

Untuk bergelar pengajar selam skuba bukanlah sesuatu yang mudah kerana seseorang itu perlu mengharungi pelbagai latihan dan ujian mencabar.

Namun, bagi si kecil molek berketinggian 157 sentimeter, Nur Sabrina Mohamad Fuzad, 25, ia bukanlah halangan untuknya menceburi profesion itu yang didominasi lelaki dan warga asing.

Berkongsi pengalamannya, gadis berhijab berasal dari Perak itu berkata, dia menjadi pengajar selam skuba pada 2017 ketika berusia 19 tahun iaitu selepas memperoleh lesen menyelam peringkat *Dive-master*.

"Perjalanan ini tidak dirancang, ia bermula ketika saya menunggu keputusan SPM (Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia), ibu bapa saya tawarkan saya untuk tinggal di Pulau Perhentian bagi mengikuti latihan selam skuba peringkat *Dive-master*," katanya yang kini mengajar di sebuah operator menyelam di Pulau Perhentian.

Katanya, selepas setahun menimba pengalaman sebagai *Dive-master*, dia meneruskan latihan ke peringkat pengajar dengan mengambil kursus pembangunan pengajar (IDC) dan pemeriksaan pengajar (IE) sebelum layak bergelar pengajar selam skuba yang diiktiraf Persatuan Jurulatih Selaman Profesional (Padi).

Ditanya berkaitan pemilihan kerjaya itu yang jarang diceburi golongan hawa, Nur Sabrina berkata, dia meminati bidang itu kerana terinspirasi melihat kebanyakan pengajar selam skuba yang ada di pulau di Malaysia adalah warga asing.

"Pengajar selam skuba ramai orang luar (warga asing), mereka golongan profesional seperti pekerja bank dan jurutera, tapi sanggup berhenti semata-mata untuk tinggal dan kerja di pulau.

"Jadi saya rasa ini peluang saya untuk membuka mata orang ramai terutama wanita Melayu dan yang berhijab bahawa kita mampu m-

mikul kerjaya ini, sekali gus menggalakkan lebih ramai untuk menceburinya," katanya.

Anak sulung daripada tiga beradik itu berkata, melatih pelajar selam skuba sehingga mereka berjaya mendapatkan lesen adalah satu kepuasan dan kegembiraan yang tidak dapat digambarkan dengan kata-kata.

"Ada pelajar yang asalnya fobia, panik dengan kedalaman air dan ada juga yang hampir putus asa, tapi apabila saya berjaya pujuk dan mengatasi ketakutan mereka itu sehingga menamatkan kursus, saya rasa puas dan gembira," katanya.

Sementara itu, ibunya, Noorazizah Yusof berkata, selain Nur Sabrina, beliau dan suami serta dua anaknya yang lain turut memiliki lesen selam skuba serta aktif menyelam di beberapa pulau seperti Pulau Perhentian, Sipadan, Phuket, Gili Asahan dan Maldives.

"Dulunya, setiap kali cuti perkolahan, kami akan bawa anak-anak bercuti ke pulau dan secara tidak langsung, pada 2013, kami ambil lesen permulaan selam skuba di Pulau Perhentian selepas tertarik dan timbul minat ingin mencuba aktiviti itu.

"Tidak disangka, dengan hanya suka-suka, kini ia menjadi hobi kami sekeluarga dan akan melakukan selaman bersama setiap kali bercuti di pulau sehingga ke hari ini," katanya.

Suri rumah itu berkata, beliau bangga dengan pencapaian Nur Sabrina yang menjadikan jurulatih selam skuba sebagai kerjayanya.

"Kami akan sentiasa menyokong

apa yang Nur Sabrina buat kerana itu minatnya...walaupun masih berhijab dan perlu menjaga batas sebagai seorang Muslimah, tapi masih mampu melakukan tugas yang mencabar," katanya.

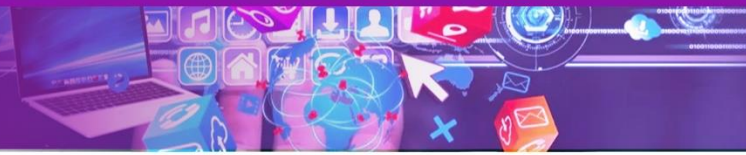

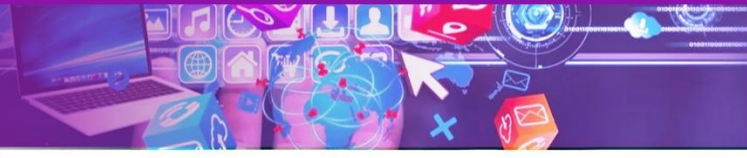
Kedah folk lost RM5.2m to online scams

Music teacher charged with dangerous driving, causing death

GEORGE TOWN: A part-time music teacher was charged at the magistrate's court with dangerous driving and causing the death of a female motorcyclist last month.

Oo Cheng Sing, 28, claimed trial to the charge that was read before magistrate Nur Melati Diana Abdul Wahab.

He indicated to the court interpreter that he understood the charge that was read to him.

Oo allegedly committed the offence at Jalan Loh Poh Heng about 10.20am on May 8.

The charge was framed under Section 41(1) of the Transport Act 1987, which provided for imprisonment of up to 10 years and a fine of not more than RM50,000

upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Nurul Atikah Asharaf Ali urged the court to set bail at RM10,000 in one surety.

Zainal Akram Zainal Azahar, who represented Oo, pleaded for lower bail, saying that his client had presented himself in court this morning when contacted by the police to do so.

"My client was released on police bail (in the course of the investigation). And when contacted by the police to be present in court, he did.

"My client is of no flight risk as he has a permanent address in Persiaran Gurney. The bail is merely to secure his attendance in court," he said, adding that his

client, a bachelor, earned RM2,000 a month.

Nur Melati set bail at RM3,000 in one surety and fixed July 26 for mention.

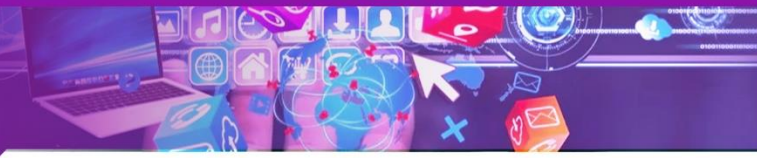
It was reported that a female motorcyclist died after being hit

Being small-sized no hindrance to Nur Sabrina as scuba diving instructor

KUALA LUMPUR: Being small-sized and only 157 centimetres tall are no hindrance for 25-year-old Nur Sabrina Mohamad Fuad to become a professional scuba diving instructor.

What is more, the profession is considered challenging as well as dominated by men and foreigners even though the sport has been popular in Malaysia for a while.

Sharing her success with Bernama, Nur Sabrina, who hails from Perak, said she first became a diving instructor in 2017 when she was merely 19 years old after she obtained a Divemaster-level diving licence.

"My journey was not planned, but while I was waiting for my Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) results, my parents offered me the chance to go to Pulau Perhentian to follow the Divemaster-level diving course.

"After a year of gaining experience as a Divemaster, I went on to take the Instructor Development Course (IDC) and Instructor Examination (IE) before qualifying as a scuba diving instructor recognised by the Professional Association of Diving (PADI)," said Nur Sabrina, a diving operator in Perhentian Island.

When asked about her choice

of career which women rarely pursue, Nur Sabrina said she became interested in it because she noticed that many scuba diving instructors in Malaysia were foreigners.

"Many scuba diving instructors are foreigners, and they are professionals such as engineers and bank employees, but willing to quit just to stay on the island to work, and this made me think...

"So, I felt this is my chance to open the public's eyes, especially for Malay women and those wearing the hijab, that we are

capable of being involved in this career thus encouraging more to venture into it," she said.

The eldest of three siblings also shared her experience teaching scuba diving to participants until they obtained a (diving) licence, and this brought her immense satisfaction and happiness.

"There have been students who had a phobia, and panicked when in the water. Some almost gave up but I coaxed them and they managed to overcome their fears until they completed the course," she said.

Meanwhile, Nur Sabrina's

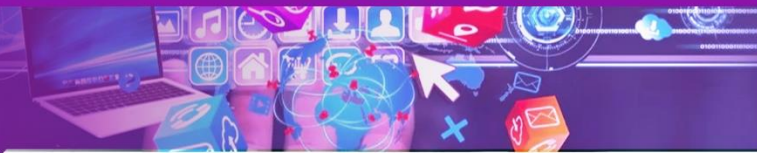
mother Noorazizah Yusof said besides Nur Sabrina, both she and her husband as well as two other children hold scuba diving licences and actively dive in the waters around Pulau Perhentian, Sipadan, Pulau Mabul, Phuket, Similan islands, Aceh, Lombok, Bali, Gili Asahan and the Maldives.

"In the past during each school holidays, we take our children on holidays to the islands, and in 2013, we took the beginner's licence for scuba diving on Pulau Perhentian as we were attracted to this activity.

"It (scuba diving) was just for fun but now it has become a hobby for our family and we will dive together every time we vacation on the island until now," she said.

Noorazizah, a housewife, said she she proud of Nur Sabrina's achievement of becoming a scuba diving instructor which is rarely pursued by today's younger generation.

"We always support whatever Nur Sabrina does because this is her interest. In this way (her career), she can show the beauty of Islam, even though she still wears the hijab and has to keep the boundaries as a Muslim, but she is still able to do challenging tasks," she added. — Bernama

Purse theft lands duo three months in jail

KUCHING: Two men were each sentenced to three months in jail by a magistrates' court here yesterday for stealing a purse belonging to a 48-year-old woman.

Woman in her 20s falls victim to phone scam, loses RM28,600

SIBU: A corporate sector employee in her 20s here has lost RM28,600 to a phone scam.

Sibu police chief ACP Zulkipli Suhaili said the victim received a call from an unknown individual on June 16.

He said the individual claimed to be a Pos Laju staff member and that the woman had sent a package containing an identification card, credit cards, and bank tokens.

"The victim was then connected to the 'police', who later told the victim she was involved in human trafficking and money laundering," Zulkipli said in a statement.

He said the victim was instructed to click on a link and told to fill in her personal banking information.

"Feeling worried and afraid, the victim followed all the instructions given to her," Zulkipli said.

On June 19, the victim checked her account and found that there were three transfers totalling RM28,600 into unknown local bank accounts.

The victim felt suspicious and realised she had been duped, leading her to lodge a police report on June 19.

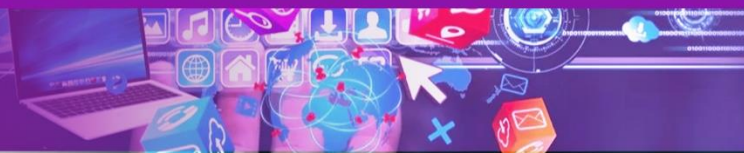
Zulkipli said the case is being investigated under Section 420 of the Penal Code for cheating.

As a preventive measure, he advised the public not to panic or feel anxious when receiving phone calls from unknown individuals claiming to be from any government department or financial institution.

22 foreign women working as GROs nabbed

KUALA LUMPUR: Some 22 foreign women who worked as guest relation officers (GROs) were among 27 people rounded up following raids at two entertainment outlets in Klang.

Sources said five caretakers of the premises were also detained in the raids conducted at about 11pm on Saturday by Bukit Aman CID.

"The 22 GROs comprised 18 Vietnamese, two Cambodians, one Thai and one Filipino aged between 27 and 50," sources said.

They said the GROs would earn tips between RM50 and RM200 for providing personal service to their customers.

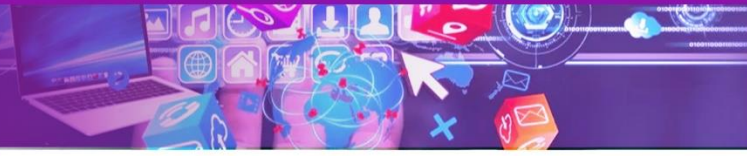
"They also earn a commission of RM30 for every beer bucket sold to customers. Investigations showed the GROs did not offer sexual services."

It is learnt both outlets have been in operation since January.

"They only cater to regular customers who go in through secret doors. When the raids were conducted, most of the customers were drunk and did not cooperate with the authorities.

"However, the situation was under control," sources said.

When contacted, Bukit Aman CID director Comm Datuk Seri Ayob Khan Mydin Pitchay confirmed the arrests.

Disabled woman caring for sister with stage four cancer

A DISABLED woman has been taking care of her younger sister diagnosed with stage four cancer, *Berita Harian* reported.

Despite having speech and hearing problems, as well as being a slow learner, Siti Zaleha Saleh, 49, has been faithfully caring for Rohayu Salleh, 44.

"Actually, it was supposed to be my responsibility to take care of my sister because she is disabled, but now she is the one caring for me.

"I am no longer able to walk like before. My sister takes care of my bathroom needs. She combs my hair and feeds me," said Rohayu, adding that they commu-

nicate with each other through sign language.

Before she was diagnosed with cancer, they lived in Kampung Baru Nami, Kedah, and ran a small business selling kuih to support themselves.

They are now living with another sister, Noor Azliana Mat Isa, 33, to be closer to Hospital Sultanah Bahiyah.

According to Rohayu, their mother died about 22 years ago while their father remarried.

Rohayu said she was diagnosed with intestinal cancer last year after experiencing lower abdominal pain which she thought was gastric.

The cancer caused her weight to drop from 48kg to 37kg.

"If possible, I want to sell kuih like before, and earn money to fund the cost of treating my illness," she said.

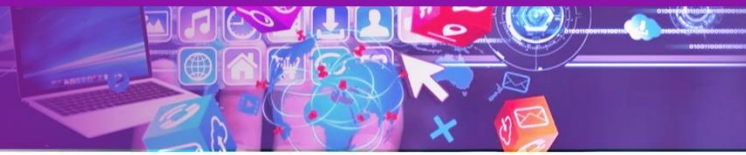
> "After all that had happened, the door to my heart has closed," said Nurul Shuhada Mat Shukri, 29, about her divorce with actor Hafidz Roshdi.

Ex-soldier with heart of gold

Noor Hasni ever willing to help despite having small income

KEPALA BATAS: Former soldier Noor Hasni Saad certainly has a big heart.

Despite earning only a meagre income as a hawker, the 57-year-old father of nine does not hesitate to fork out his own money to help the needy.

Usually, the people who approach him are those struggling to find food for their family or even those who have outstanding monthly housing loans.

"I come from a poor family, so I understand their predicament when faced with such situations.

"When they come knocking on my door, I don't have the heart to say no. Most of the time, I will try my very best to help them," he said in an interview.

Noor Hasni, who left the army in 1995, said his mettle was tested during the initial period of the Covid-19 pandemic when a lot of people faced difficulties because they lost their jobs and stable income.

As a food and drinks trader in Teluk Ayer Tawar, Noor Hasni said he only survives on his daily earning which is not much.

He said he would deliver food packages to anyone who asks for his help and try to help the poor and less fortunate the best he can. "After sending the food pack-

ages, I will try to get help from the local assemblyman or get other non-governmental organisations (NGOs) to assist as well.

"The reason I do so is because I know I don't have the ability to help them again, so the best way is to get help from those who have the ability and means," he said.

Noor Hasni, who has been active in community work since 1995, raised funds through his

daily income and sometimes from well-wishers who donated money for his efforts.

He said that sometimes his friends and Good Samaritans pitched in to help too.

He said he does not keep stocks of basic needs such as rice, eggs, sugar, flour, condensed milk and noodles in his house and only buys the items when someone needs it.

"Normally, they will call me or come straight to my house. Without saying no, I will go to a grocery shop nearby and get them the items they need," said the grandfather of four.

He said most of the people who came to seek help were from the B40 group in the Kepala Batas district.

He said he is grateful to have a wife who is very supportive of his



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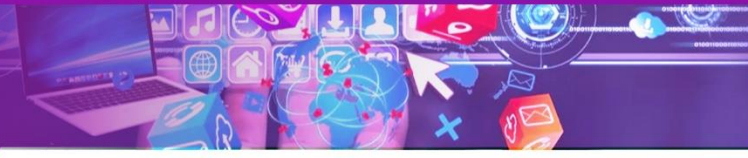

mission to help the underprivileged.

"She has been my strongest supporter, helping me at the stall and to care for our nine children. Without her, I don't think I can manage this on my own," he said.

Families tell of how they saved lives

PETALING JAYA: Former nurse Jenny Ursula Peter James had registered as a donor and told her family and friends about it.

When she was 33, Jenny, the third of five siblings, suffered a brain haemorrhage and went into a coma on April 4. She was declared brain dead the next day.

Her family then agreed to donate her corneas to two patients who were urgently in need.

Her sister Marilyn, 40, said the doctors asked if the family was

willing to donate her healthy organs to help save lives.

"Our family sat down to discuss it and decided to go ahead. We felt that it would not only save lives; part of her would still be alive," she said.

"I think we made the right decision. I believe she would be proud."

Tan Jian Wei, 31, was a construction worker who was killed when a lorry hit his motorcycle while he was travelling from Kuala Lumpur to Petaling Jaya on Feb 18.

He, too, had pledged to donate his organs.

The family donated his organs

after he was pronounced brain dead after the accident.

His elder brother, Jun How, 36, said his brother was rushed to the Universiti Malaya Medical Centre (PPUM) but was pronounced brain dead a day later.

His brother had pledged to donate his corneas and kidneys.

"There were immediate recipients for the two kidneys and corneas, which was fortunate because corneas only have a two-week deadline," he said.

He added that his younger brother never drank or smoked and spent most of his time working at construction sites.

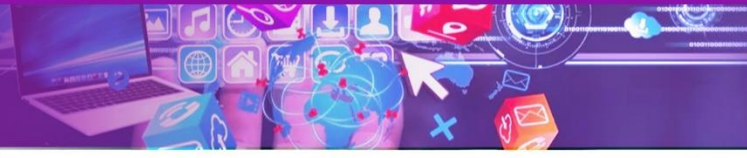
"He had two wishes in life: the first was to buy a house and the second was to find a girlfriend and get married.

"While he achieved his first dream, he will never be able to attain the second," he said.

According to Jun How, doctors successfully performed surgery to remove his brother's corneas and kidneys on Feb 20.

Both Jun How and Marilyn hoped that the stories of their siblings would encourage more Malaysians to register as organ donors.

They said they want to help people who really need the organs to live.

Take the time to get it right

Set up Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal properly rather than quickly, say groups

PETALING JAYA: Despite the delay in setting up the Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal, experts say the government should get it done properly and effectively rather than quickly and hastily.

This includes hiring people with the right skills, ensuring that judgments are enforced and putting in place proper procedures for victims to get timely access to justice, they said.

"We must ensure that (tribunal members) are gender sensitive with a track record of survivor-centric approach," said Women's Aid Organisation (WAO) advocacy director Abinaya Mohan.

"There must also be gender sensitivity training for frontliners who are attending to these cases," she said.

The tribunal is a critical part of

the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act 2022 (Act 840), which was passed by Parliament in August and gazetted in October last year.

The tribunal will deliberate sexual harassment complaints, and provide a mechanism for anyone who has been sexually harassed to seek redress.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri had said the ministry was in the process of establishing the tribunal and appointing its members, which is expected to be completed by the end of this year.

Malaysian Trades Union Congress (MTUC) president Mohd Effendy Abdul Ghani said the tribunal must also be given enough support to enforce its judgments.

"The Act will be meaningless if there is no awareness, implementation and enforcement," he said.

He said the tribunal could also break the silence surrounding

sexual harassment cases especially among men.

"Although the majority of the cases involve women, with more awareness, men can also have the courage to step forward.

"The genderless Act has the potential to get more people to bring their cases to the tribunal.

"So, we must also generate discussion on the topic to break the cycle of sexual harassment," he said.

Women Leadership Foundation (WLF) chairperson Datuk Dr Hafsa Hashim said although the public would like the tribunal to be formed promptly, the process would require several rounds of engagement with relevant stakeholders.

"WLF recognises the urgency of its establishment since the law was passed last August and gazetted in October, but we also took cognisance of the delay in implementing the Act.

"However, we are aware that the ministry is diligently working to create a comprehensive and precise implementation plan.

"This may take time as it will involve necessary engagements with the industry and relevant parties," Hafsa said.

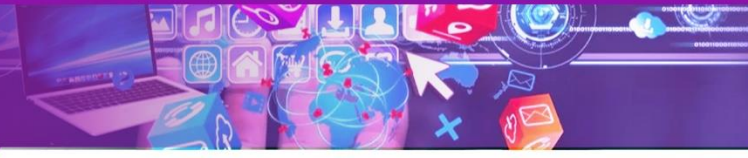
WAO's Abinaya said it was

important the public be kept in the loop and regularly updated on the status of the tribunal.

"More and more cases of sexual harassment are being reported following the passing of the Act," she said, adding that their needs must be met while the tribunal was being set up.

"A prolonged delay could hinder survivors from speaking up. As such, there should not be any further delay in the stipulated period to set up the tribunal, so that survivors are able to access justice," she said.

Despite the absence of the tribunal, the ministry announced that several sections of the Act have come into force, including Section 1 – Simple Tides and Commencement; (ii) Section 2 – Interpretation; (iii) Section 24 – Administrator; (iv) Section 25 – Functions and powers of the administrator; and (v) Section 26 – Power to make regulations.

Teacher claims trial to reckless driving

GEORGE TOWN: A part-time music teacher charged with reckless driving and killing a female motorcyclist in Tanjung Bungah last month was granted RM3,000 bail by a Magistrate's Court here.

Oo Cheng Sing, 28, pleaded not guilty to driving recklessly before hitting and causing the death of the 59-year-old woman in Jalan Loh Poh Heng at about 11.20am on May 8.

The charge under Section 41(1) of the Road Transport Act 1987 can lead to jail time of up to 10 years and a fine of not more than RM50,000 upon conviction.

Magistrate Nur Melati Diana Abdul Wahab granted RM10,000 bail with one surety for Cheng Sing yesterday, but during mitigation, his counsel Zainal Akram Zainal Azahar requested that the amount be lowered.

"The accused is single. He is working as a part-time music teacher earning RM2,000 monthly.

"He has a permanent address on Gurney Drive and is already on police bail, in addition to having attended proceedings without fail," he said.

Nur Melati then lowered the bail amount to RM3,000 with one surety before fixing July 26 for the

submission of documents.

Cheng Sing, who posted bail, was accompanied by his father at the courthouse yesterday.

It was reported on June 8 that Cheng Sing, his father Oo Teck Yeon, 55, and mother Chuah Chew Ting, 54, had claimed trial on a charge of rioting in a public place following the road accident.

They were charged under Section 160 of the Penal Code,

which carries a jail term of six months or a RM1,000 fine, or both, upon conviction.

Each accused was allowed a bail of RM2,500 with one surety.

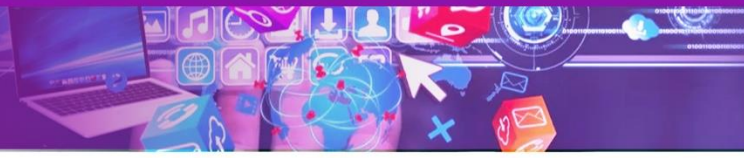
On May 12, police arrested six individuals allegedly involved in a scuffle following the accident.

A video of the accident had also gone viral, showing a car crashing into a motorcyclist, with

both the victim and the car crashing into the pavement along a housing area.

The motorcyclist, who sustained severe head injuries, died at the scene.

Undeterred by her pint size, Nur Sabrina qualifies as a scuba diving instructor

KUALA LUMPUR: Being pint-sized and only 157cm tall is no hindrance to Nur Sabrina Mohamad Fuad in her effort to become a professional scuba diving instructor.

Things are already tough with the profession considered challenging besides being dominated by men and foreigners.

Sharing her success with Bernama, Nur Sabrina, who is from Perak, said she first became a diving instructor in 2017 when she was 19 after obtaining a dive-master-level diving licence.

"My journey was not planned, but while I was waiting for my SPM results, my parents offered me the chance to go to Pulau Perhentian to follow the dive-master-level diving course.

"After a year of gaining experience as a dive-master, I went on to take the Instructor Development Course (IDC) and Instructor Examination (IE) before qualifying as a scuba diving instructor recognised by the Professional Association of Diving (PADI)," said Nur Sabrina, who is a diving operator in Pulau Perhentian.

Asked about her choice of career rarely pursued by women, Nur Sabrina said she became

interested in it because she noticed that many scuba diving instructors in Malaysia were foreigners.

"And they are professionals such as engineers and bank employees, but willing to quit just to stay on the island to work, and this made me think.

"So, I felt this is my chance and that women are also capable of being involved in this career," she added.

The eldest of three siblings also shared her experience teaching scuba diving to participants until they obtained a (diving) licence, and this brought her immense satisfaction and happiness.

"There were students with a phobia, who panicked when in the water.

"Some almost gave up but I coaxed them and they managed to overcome their fears until they completed the course," she said.

Nur Sabrina's mother, Noorazizah Yusof, said she and her husband and two other children had scuba diving licences and actively dived around Pulau Perhentian, Sipadan, Pulau Mabul, Phuket, Similan islands, Aceh, Lombok, Bali, Gili Asahan and the Maldives.

"In the past during the school holidays, we took our children to the islands. In 2013, we took a beginner's licence for scuba

diving in Pulau Perhentian as we were interested in this activity.

"What started for fun has now become a hobby for our family and we dive together each time we are on vacation," she said.

The housewife said she was proud of Nur Sabrina's career as a scuba diving instructor.

"We always support whatever Nur Sabrina does because this is her interest," she added.

Healing from abuse

PETALING JAYA: With the rising number of domestic violence and abuse cases in the country, survivors are in dire need of rehabilitation programmes with innovative approaches to help quicken the healing process.

Clinical psychologist Dr Ainul Azreen Johari said police data released last year showed that 7,468 cases of domestic violence and abuse were recorded in 2021, which is the highest thus far.

She said this compares with Women, Family and Community Development Ministry records, that contained a total of 19,268 such cases for three years - from 2020 to 2022.

Ainul Azreen said with the help of effective psychological interventions, rehabilitation programmes and support networks, survivors could learn to overcome their trauma and get on with life.

"Survivors of domestic violence and abuse often face a range of physical and emotional challenges that can leave them feeling isolated, helpless and alone. To overcome these challenges, victims should seek counselling at rehabilitation centres," Ainul Azreen said.

A 34-year-old domestic violence and abuse survivor, who wished to be known only as Racheal, said by the time she got married at the age of 28 and had a child shortly after, the verbal, emotional and physical abuse from her husband had become a common part of her marriage.

"Although there were occasional glimpses of the person I thought he was when I fell in love with him, I found myself considering leaving my husband several times. I packed a few things

and some money, but the reality of my situation always set in before I made a move.

"In spite of working two jobs, all my money went into his account, which made it difficult for me to afford to rent a room. I wasn't ready to burden my parents and lived in fear of his threats, until my colleague told me about an NGO that provided free shelter, counselling and crisis support to abused women and children."

Racheal said she thought she would not survive without her husband but her colleague, the NGO and a specialist there protected her until she recovered from the abuse.

Ainul Azreen said the most effective treatment for survivors of domestic violence and abuse include psychotherapy, group therapy and social support.

"It is essential that all medical professionals are trained to recognise signs of domestic violence and provide support to their patients."

"Survivors should also be encouraged to seek psychological help in the aftermath of their trauma. This can be done by providing them with access to information about support lines and mental health clinics."

She said psychological interventions can play a crucial role in the recovery process of domestic violence and abuse victims.

"A psychologist can help reduce shame, fear, and deprogramme the information that an

abuser may have instilled."

Ainul Azreen said NGOs dealing with domestic violence and abuse could also increase social support for survivors by rebuilding connections with family and friends the abusers may have cut off. A safety plan is also vital to ensure survivors can maintain distance and stay safe from their abusers.

"Survivors who seek rehabilitation programmes often face common challenges, such as lack of resources and fear of leaving their situation."

"Psychologists and medical professionals can help bridge the gap by discussing how a survivor can access rehabilitation programmes and provide them with guidance on how to reach such facilities."

"To assist individuals to overcome domestic violence and abuse, rehabilitation centres and shelters for survivors must be easily noticed by the public."

Ainul Azreen said support networks play a vital role in the rehabilitation process for survivors of domestic violence, adding that community leaders, friends and family members should be educated about it as well, to provide meaningful support to survivors.

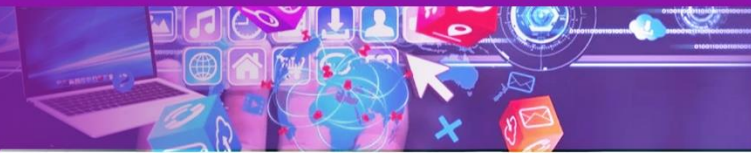
There are resources available for funding and supporting rehabilitation programmes for



domestic violence survivors. These include hotlines, emergency rooms and clinics that provide psychological treatments.

Ainul Azreen said it is essential to remember that domestic violence is a complex problem, and survivors need support and guidance to escape their situation.

"With the help of effective psychological interventions, rehabilitation programmes and support networks, survivors can overcome the emotional and physical challenges of domestic violence and abuse," she said.

RM960m paid to disaster victims

KUALA LUMPUR: Financial assistance of RM963.23 million was distributed to eligible disaster victims from 2020 to 2022, the Dewan Negara was told yesterday.

Deputy Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Sabah, Sarawak Affairs and Special Functions) Datuk Wilson Ugak Kumbong said it comprised RM5.4 million for 2020, RM113.63 million for 2021 and RM844.62 million for 2022.

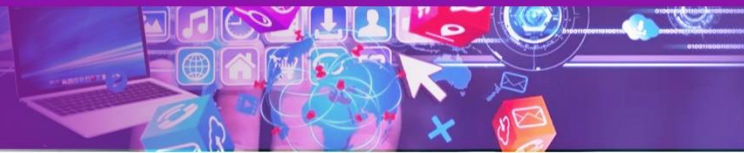
"For the Northeast Monsoon 2022/2023, the government channeled an early allocation of RM330 million to all states to ensure disaster aid could be delivered during the period," he said during the Senate question and answer session.

Wilson was replying to a question from Senator Tan Sri Low Kian Chuan, who wanted to know if all allocations for the disaster aid had been audited, with the breakdown of disaster expenditure from 2020 to date.

He said all disaster operation aid allocations were channeled directly to the related state governments, which would be audited by the respective state governments.

Replying to a supplementary question from Senator Rita Sarimah Patrick Insol on the types of aid channeled during the disaster, Wilson said the government will continue to assist victims who are eligible for assistance such as Bantuan Wang Ihsan (BWI) involving RM1,000 to each head of household and RM1,000 to the next of kin of each victim who died in the disaster.

"Apart from that, the Bantuan Barang Keperluan Asas, which is RM2,500 for each head of household and Bantuan Pembaikan Rumah, with a maximum of RM5,000 for each head of household." - Bernama

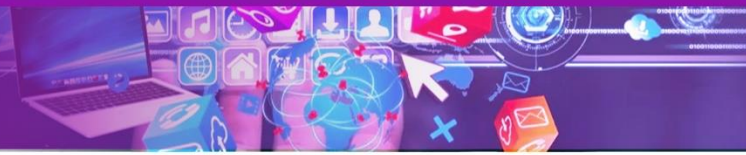

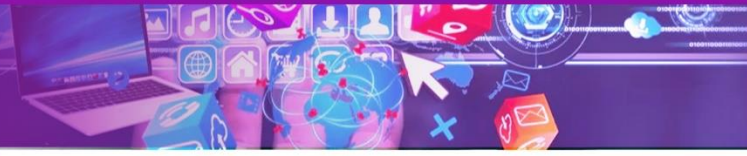
Lumpur, kelmarin.

Ditanya sama ada usaha itu (mewajibkan kursus) sebagai penyelesaian terbaik untuk membendung peningkatan kadar perceraian dalam kalangan pasangan Malaysia, Nancy berkata: “Saya tidak fikir formula itu berkesan.

“Walaupun anda mewajibkan tetapi jika mereka mahu bercerai, anda tidak dapat mengawalinya kerana sepanjang perkahwinan banyak perkara mungkin berlaku, jadi ia sangat subjektif,” katanya.

Terperdaya panggilan 'scammer', wanita rugi RM28,000

Mangsa panik setelah didakwa terlibat kegiatan pemerdagangan manusia, pengubahan wang haram

SIBU: Seorang wanita di sini kerugian RM28,000 selepas terjerat dengan tipu helah sindiket penipuan yang mendakwa dia terlibat dalam kegiatan pemerdagangan manusia dan pengubahan wang haram.

Terperdaya dengan pembohongan suspek yang tidak dikenali, mangsa yang juga seorang kakitangan di sektor korporat menjadi takut dan hanya menurut semua arahan yang diberikan suspek.

Ketua Polis Daerah Sibul ACP Zulkipli Suhaili berkata, wanita berusia 20-an itu menerima panggilan daripada individu tidak dikenali ketika berada di rumahnya pada 16 Jun lalu.

Katanya, pihaknya dari Bahagian Siasatan Jenayah Komersial Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Sibul menerima satu laporan daripada wanita warga tempatan pada Isnin.

"Berdasarkan laporan, mangsa telah menerima satu panggilan daripada individu yang memperkenalkan diri

sebagai 'wakil' Pos Malaysia.

"Suspek memaklumkan mangsa ada mengirinkan barang yang mengandungi kad pengenalan, kad kredit dan token bank dan panggilan kemudian disambungkan kepada seorang pegawai polis yang menyatakan bahawa mangsa terlibat dengan kegiatan pemerdagangan manusia dan pengubahan wang haram," katanya menerusi satu kenyataan kelmarin.

Katanya, mangsa seterusnya diarahkan untuk

menekan satu pautan bagi mengisi maklumat peribadi serta perbankan.

"Oleh kerana mangsa panik dan takut, dia terpaksa menurut semua arahan yang

diberikan oleh suspek.

"Tiga hari kemudian, mangsa mendapati terdapat tiga transaksi pemindahan wang daripada akaunnya berjumlah RM28,600 ke

akaun yang tidak dikenali tanpa pengetahuannya," katanya.

Menurut Zulkipli, selepas menyedari dirinya ditipu mangsa hadir ke balai polis berdekatan untuk membuat laporan polis pada 19 Jun lalu.

Kes tersebut katanya, disiasat di bawah Seksyen 420 Kanun Keseksaan kerana menipu.

Sehubungan itu, Zulkipli menasihati orang ramai agar tidak mudah panik atau berasa cemas apabila menerima panggilan telefon daripada

individu yang tidak dikenali mendakwa daripada mana-mana jabatan kerajaan atau institusi kewangan.
