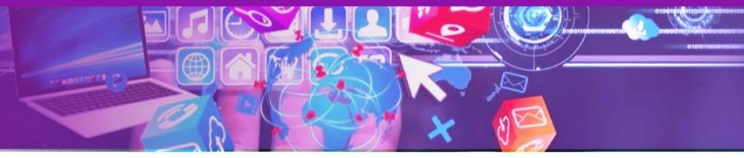

Muar: Seorang juruteknik tidak mengaku salah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam atas dua pertuduhan mencabul kehormatan anak tiriinya tahun lalu dan awal tahun ini.

Tertuduh berusia 32 tahun membuat pengakuan selepas pertuduhan dibaca jurubahasa mahkamah di hadapan Hakim Abu Bakar Manat.

Mengikut pertuduhan pertama, dia didakwa mencabul anak tiri perempuan ketika itu berusia 13 tahun di sebuah rumah di Kluang, pada jam 9.30 malam, Mei 2022.

Juruteknik nafi noda anak tiri



TERTUDUH diiringi anggota polis di Mahkamah Sesyen Muar, semalam.

Tertuduh sekali lagi didakwa mengulangi perbuatan terhadap mangsa dengan di tempat sama jam 10 malam, Januari 2023.

Bagi pertuduhan pertama, dia didakwa melakukan kesalahan mengikut Seksyen 14 (a) manakala pertuduhan kedua, Seksyen 14 (b) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017.

Kedua-dua kesalahan boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 14 dan dibaca bersama Seksyen 16 (1) akta

sama yang boleh dipenjarakan sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan serta penjara lima tahun dan sebatan tidak kurang dua kali bagi tambahan Seksyen 16 (1), untuk setiap pertuduhan dikenakan.

Mengikut fakta kes, mangsa menceritakan perkara itu kepada bapa kandungnya di Mersing bahawa dia dicabul tertuduh ketika berada di rumah ibunya.

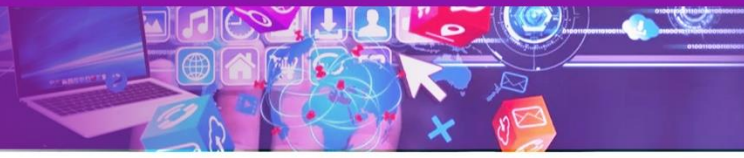
Susulan itu, satu laporan dibuat di Balai Polis Mersing jam 3.30 pagi, 17 Ogos lalu. Kes dirujuk ke Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Kluang dan tangka-

pan dibuat terhadap tertuduh pada keesokan hari.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Muhammad Arif Marzuki manakala tertuduh tidak diwakili peguam.

Selepas mendengar rayuan tertuduh serta pihak pendakwaan, mahkamah menetapkan jaminan RM12,000 dengan seorang penjamin.

Mahkamah kemudian menetapkan 26 September depan untuk sebutan kes, serahan dokumen serta lantikan peguam oleh tertuduh.

Kuala Nerus: Walaupun menjangkau usia emas namun seorang nenek masih berupaya mendaki bukit yang curam untuk mengutip durian sebelum mengandar hasil pertanian itu untuk dipasarkan.

Wan Minah Wan Derman, 72, dari Kampung Lingai, dekat sini berkata, seawal jam 7 pagi dia akan ke kebun setiap hari dan tibanya musim durian menjadikan rutin hariannya semakin sibuk.

Menurutnya, jarak untuk naik dan turun dari bukit sejauh tiga kilometer (km) dan rutin itu dilakukan lima kali sehari dengan anggaran lebih 15 km sehari.

Katanya, hasil durian yang dikumpul dijual di bahu jalan di kampung itu dan tempoh durian berbuah boleh menjangkau sehingga tiga bulan semusim.

"Alhamdulillah, walaupun sudah menjangkau usia emas namun saya masih mampu untuk mendaki bukit yang curam untuk

mengutip durian.

"Durian akan dikandar untuk dibawa turun ke bawah bukit sebelum diletakkan di atas motosikal untuk

dibawa keluar ke lokasi jualan," katanya yang mempunyai tiga cahaya mata dan tujuh orang cucu.

Wan Minah berkata, dia

melakukan aktiviti memanjat bukit memungut durian apabila tiba musimnya sejak berusia 20 tahun dan pengalaman lebih 50 tahun

memanjat bukit memberi stamina buatnya untuk meneruskan pekerjaan itu.

"Saya ke bukit setiap hari dan rutin membersihkan

kebun seluas satu hektar menjadi pekerjaan hakiki saya sejak muda," katanya.

Jirannya, Rohaidah Jusoh, 57, pula berkata, dia mengayuh basikal pergi dan balik sejauh lapan kilometer dari rumah ke kebun.

"Sebaik tiba di kebun, saya perlu meredah anak sungai sebelum mengutip durian dan membungkusnya dengan kain batik serta dijunjung meredah anak sungai.

"Selepas itu buah berkenaan akan dikandar pula untuk dibawa keluar dari kebun dan diletakkan di atas basikal untuk dibawa pulang sebelum dijual," katanya.

Menurutnya, rutin pergi dan balik itu biasanya dilakukan sebanyak tiga kali sehari dan jarak yang perlu dilalui melebihi 25 kilometer sehari.

Katanya, pengalaman memungut durian menggunakan basikal sejak berusia 17 tahun memberikan kekuatan kepadanya untuk melakukan kerja bermusim itu.

Pemilik restoran warga Jepun nafi cederakan teman wanita

Kuala Lumpur: Seorang pemilik restoran warga Jepun didakwa di Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam atas pertuduhan menyebabkan kecederaan terhadap teman wanitanya dalam kejadian dua bulan lalu.

Bagaimanapun, tertuduh, Shozo Kamizato, 32, mengaku tidak bersalah dan minta

dibicarakan sebaik jurubahasa mahkamah membacakan pertuduhan dalam bahasa Inggeris di hadapan Majistret Nurul Izzah Sharuddin.

Mengikut pertuduhan, lelaki itu dengan sengaja menyebabkan kecederaan terhadap Gomi Mikiko, 30, dengan menggunakan tangan

di sebuah rumah di Kepong, pada jam 2 pagi, 14 Jun lalu.

Dia didakwa mengikut Seksyen 323 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman maksimum penjara setahun atau denda RM2,000 atau kedua-duanya.

Pendakwa dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nadia Eleena Jamaluddin

Akbal, manakala tertuduh diwakili peguam Azman Aziz.

Nadia Eleena menawarkan jaminan RM4,000 dengan syarat tambahan tertuduh diminta melaporkan diri di balai polis berdekatan sebulan sekali.

Bagaimanapun, Azman berkata, ia kali pertama anak

guamnya didakwa dengan kesalahan dan meminta jaminan dikurangkan memandangkan lelaki itu sudah menetap di Malaysia selama 12 tahun.

Azman turut membantah syarat tambahan lapor diri di balai polis terdekat berikutan anak guamnya mempunyai perniagaan res-

toran di negara ini.

Mendengar hujah kedua-dua pihak, Nurul Izzah membenarkan tertuduh diberi ikat jamin RM3,000 dengan seorang penjamin tempatan serta syarat tambahan perlu melapor diri di balai polis terdekat dan menetapkan 22 September untuk sebutan semula kes.

Penjawat awam wanita dari negara jiran antara ditahan

Georgetown: Seorang wanita mendakwa kakitangan kerajaan di negara jiran antara lapan warga asing ditahan polis kerana disyaki terbahit aktiviti persundalan di negeri ini Jumaat lalu.

Aktiviti semua wanita berkenaan dibongkar menerusi tujuh serbuan dijalankan di beberapa premis seperti hotel bajet, rumah tumpangan dan pangsapuri di sekitar daerah Timur Laut antara jam 6 petang hingga 10 malam.

Ketua Polis Daerah Timur Laut, Asisten Komisioner Soffian Santong berkata, semua lapan wanita warga asing itu berusia antara 25 hingga 47 tahun dan masuk ke Malaysia menggunakan pas lawatan sosial.

"Mereka didapati mencari pelanggan menerusi aplikasi WeChat dengan mengenakan kadar bayaran antara RM150 hingga RM250 bagi perkhidmatan seks.

"Selain RM2,200 yang dirampas, polis menemukan beberapa peralatan digunakan bagi menjalankan aktiviti itu," katanya menerusi kenyataan di sini, semalam.

Terdahulu, laporan mengenai serbuan turut tular di media sosial yang mendakwa seorang daripada wanita terbahit berstatus isteri pegawai penjawat awam berpangkat tinggi di luar negara.

Menurut Soffian, siasatan mendapati seorang daripada wanita ditahan mengaku sebagai penjawat awam di se-

buah negara jiran.

Katanya, wanita itu mendakwa datang ke Malaysia bagi menjalankan aktiviti persundalan untuk memperoleh pendapatan tambahan.

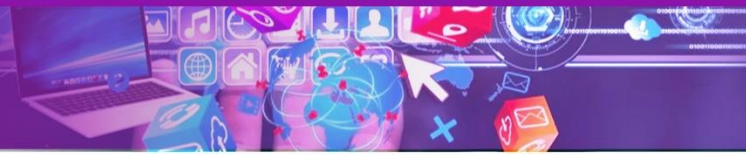
"Polis dalam usaha mendapatkan pengesahan berkaitan daripada kedutaan negara berkenaan.

Man charged with molesting stepdaughter, 13

MUAR: A technician yesterday pleaded not guilty at the Sessions Court to two counts of outraging the modesty of his underage stepdaughter last year and in January.

The 32-year-old claimed trial after the charges were read by the court interpreter before judge Abu Bakar Manat.

According to the first charge, framed under Section 14(a) of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017, the accused was alleged to have molested the then 13-year-old girl at a house in Kluang, near here, about 9.30pm, some time in May last year.

On the second charge, framed under Section 14(b) of the same act, he was accused of making the

child touch him, at the same house, about 10pm some time in January this year.

For each charge imposed, the jail term is up to 20 years with caning, as well as five years in prison and not less than two strokes of the rotan.

According to the facts of the case, the victim told her biological father who lives in Mersing what the stepfather had done at her mother's house.

Following that, a report was made at the Mersing police station on Aug 17.

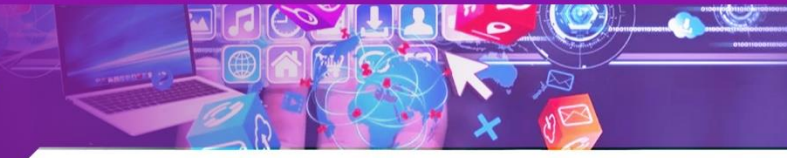
The case was referred to the Kluang police headquarters and an arrest was made against the accused the next day.

Deputy public prosecutor Muhammad Arif Marzuki offered bail of RM20,000, taking into account the serious nature of the crime.

However, after hearing an appeal from the unrepresented accused to lower the bail amount, the court set it at RM12,000 with one surety.

The court, however, ordered the accused to report to the Kluang police headquarters every month and prohibited him from coming into contact with or harassing the victim.

The court then fixed Sept 26 for mention, submission of documents and the appointment of a lawyer by the accused.

Child entrepreneur finds fluency in Mandarin a good selling point

KUALA LUMPUR: Mandarin songs such as 'Till We Meet Again', 'Red Scarf', 'Your Name Engraved Herein' and 'It Might Break Your Pinky Heart' can be heard playing in the background each time 12-year-old Nik Izz Nur Arissa Nik Mohd Izafudin Shah goes 'live' on TikTok to promote and sell her bundled soft toys.

Affectionately called Iris by her family and friends, the schoolgirl has succeeded in stealing the hearts of social media users with her endearing style and eloquence as well as her ability to confidently respond to any question posed by potential buyers.

Not only that, she is also winning over Chinese customers with her fluency in Mandarin.

Iris, a Primary 6 pupil at Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan (C) Yuk Tze in Tumpat, Kelantan has accumulated more than 13,000 followers of all ages and from various backgrounds since becoming active on TikTok in February this year.

Meanwhile, her live videos, delivered in Bahasa Melayu and Mandarin, have been garnering over 100,000 'likes' each.

The spirited youngster told Bernama she is using social media not only as a platform to help out with her family's soft toy bundling business but also to hone her business talent and communication skills.

Father main motivator

Almost every day after school, Iris would go live on TikTok, usually accompanied by her father Nik Mohd Izafudin Shah Nik Mat, 42, at their home in

Kampung Geting, Pengkalan Kubor in Tumpat.

Their bundled soft toys are sold under the brand name Iriz Collection and the ones that are most sought-after are key chains featuring cartoon characters such as Garfield and Care Bears, and those from the animated series 'PAW Patrol'.

Also in demand are the soft toy variations of Japanese anime characters such as Sotoru Gojo, Jujutsu Kaisen and Naruto.

Iris, the eldest of four children, attributed her courage to go live on social media to her father who she said was her biggest motivator.

"Initially my father made me go live with him as he felt my communication skills were weak.

"But over time I became more confident and couldn't wait to start (live) broadcasting on my own.

"Of course, at first I was nervous thinking about the public's first impressions of me.

"But my father provided me with the inspiration, guidance and opportunities to constantly improve myself when I broadcast live (on TikTok)," she told Bernama when contacted recently.

She added that although she encountered people who were "not too supportive" of her good command of Mandarin, their disapproval only spurred her to excel in all her endeavours and gain more contacts from other ethnic communities.

"It's fun each time I go live (on social media) as all my friends from my (Chinese-medium) school also come to support me.

"Sometimes they would buy almost all the soft toy bundles I'm selling," she said, adding that she completes her homework first before starting her live streaming sessions.

Language a unity tool

Iris said whenever she does

her sales pitch in Mandarin during her live broadcasts, her non-Chinese customers are also eager to know what she has been talking about as they don't want to miss out on her products.

She said initially she was worried about conducting her live streaming sessions in Mandarin.

"I wasn't sure how I would be received.

"But my anxiety disappeared after I started getting positive feedback.

"It makes me so happy to get comments like 'you are great and thank you for learning our language, we will support you'," she said, adding that

since language is a tool that can unite people, one should learn and master other languages as well.

Nik Mohd Izafudin Shah, meanwhile, said he is proud his daughter is fluent in Mandarin, adding that she has been learning the language since she was in pre-school at the age of four.

"I hope Iris will also learn about their (Chinese community's) work culture and use their positive elements to guide her in life.

"If possible, I would like her to learn as many languages as she can... not for my sake but it will be a bonus for her later in life," he added.

On his business which he started only early this year, Nik Mohd Izafudin Shah said he gets his stocks of soft toys from a factory and gives them a thorough cleansing first before they are bundled and offered for sale at reasonable prices. (Bundling is a marketing strategy where businesses sell several products or services together as a single combined unit.)

"The bundling business previously applied to (the sale of) used or second-hand goods but now the perception has changed," he said, adding that he intends to open a warehouse and supply bundled soft toys to small entrepreneurs. — Bernama

Homelessness: Improvements to Destitute Act 1977 needed

KUCHING: Resolving the issue of homelessness is very complicated as there are many underlying problems that go beyond poverty.

While the Destitute Persons Act 1977 provides the legal framework to address the issue, Sarawak Welfare Department (JKM) chief assistant director (Enforcement) Harry Silas Tirau said amendments are needed to improve the Act.

He said the review is expected to clearly define the roles of JKM and the Health Ministry (MoH) on matters relating to mental illness among the homeless.

"A review of the Act began in July last year and I hope to see improvements to tackle the issue of homelessness, especially avoiding duplication (of duties) when it comes to mental illness.

"The review is expected to create a clear division between JKM and MoH on mental health issues involving the poor and beggars, including the homeless.

"If we (JKM) deal with homeless people who do not have mental health issues, I think we will be able to manage them," he told The Borneo Post.

Agreeing with Harry was Desa Bina Diri principal Tiong Kunyok, who said the amendment is crucial towards providing a specific interpretation of 'destitute person'.

She said if possible, the issue of mental health should not be placed under the purview of JKM but handed over to the appropriate ministries.

"If the nature of the Act is not clearly defined, if there are homeless people with mental disorders, it will be assumed that the responsibility is borne by JKM.

"If JKM is equipped with experts in the issue, it will not be a problem for us to handle those with mental issues but as it is now, we do not have the expertise to treat them."

JKM personnel, according to Tiong, are trained to manage social cases and not those related

to mental health.

"This is actually one of the things that 'bothers' us because under Section 11 of the Mental Health Act 2011, JKM officers or any social-related officers are empowered to take mentally-disturbed individuals to be sent to the hospital," she added.

Earlier this year, Women, Family

and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said the revision to improve the Destitute Persons Act 1977 is expected to be completed by next month.

The ministry, she said, would announce the findings of its study as well as the next steps to be taken to amend the Act.

The findings of the study which began in July last year will set the direction related to the issue of beggars and homeless people since there is currently no specific authority and legislation in the operation and management of these groups in Malaysia.

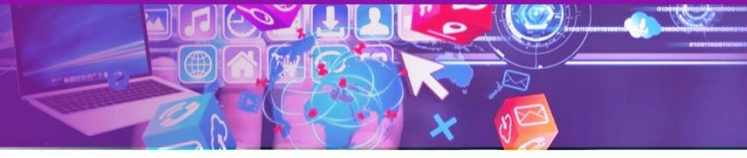
Under the Act, adult beggars who are Malaysian citizens aged below 60 and who have no family members will be placed in Desa Bina Diri, which is a home run by JKM. Those aged above 60 are sent to Rumah Seri Kenangan which is also under JKM.

Desa Bina Diri was established to provide care, protection and rehabilitation for beggars and the underserved to produce skilled and productive individuals towards reintegrating them into society.

There are five such institutions nationwide – Selangor, Johor, Pahang, Sabah and Sarawak – housing a total of about 11,000 institutions.

The Desa Bina Diri in Sarawak is located at Jalan Datuk Muhammad Musa in Kota Samarahan.

Mechanism for free check-ups finalised

KGC benefit expected to start in 2024 to give seniors alternative to get regular health screenings at zero cost

KUCHING: The free health screening benefit for Kenyalang Gold Card (KGC) cardholders is expected to be initiated next year, said Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

The Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Minister said her ministry has worked on the mechanism of this privilege which was announced by Premier Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg in July. "We will table this at the state Cabinet meeting after our Premier returns from his working trip to Sweden, Norway and London.

"God willing, we can implement this by 2024," she told reporters when met after witnessing the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) between her ministry and Swinburne Sarawak Sdn Bhd for the Sarawak Social Wellbeing Index (SSWI) Research 2023 here yesterday.

Fatimah said the benefit was to provide Sarawakian senior citizens with another alternative to acquire regular health checks at no cost.

"We know that if we go to government hospitals, the health services are free but there would be a lot of people and sometimes, the waiting time there would be long.

"So we are looking at another alternative because our concern is the well-being of our senior citizens," she said.

Previously, Fatimah told The Borneo Post that the free health screenings for KGC cardholders would cover medical services offered by providers from the private sector.

At the time, she said her ministry was still in discussion with the Ministry of Health to finalise the list of general practitioners, private clinics and hospitals to be included in the card programme meant for the elderly group aged 60 and above.

Abang Johari at an event on July 19 announced that health check-ups for senior citizens aged 60 and above would be

included as one of the benefits of KGC and that the cost of the health examinations would be borne by the state government.

Meanwhile, touching on the SSWI 2023 research, Fatimah said it will cover all 45 districts in the state.

This, she pointed out, will ensure that the research findings are valid and reliable at all levels.

"The parameters of SSWI 2023 are based on the State Social Transformation Framework that consists of 10 pillars, 25 social domains and 79 sub-domains.

"The study will take nine months starting July 1 and is expected to be fully completed on March 31 next year," she said.

The 10 pillars are Family Institution; Capacity Building; Social Harmony; Health and Social Protection; Social Responsibility; Housing; Environmental Security; Public Safety; Social Space and Infrastructure; and Good Governance and Practice.

She added that through the strategic collaboration of research groups from Swinburne University of Technology Sarawak Campus, University of Technology Sarawak (UTS) and Curtin University Malaysia, she believed the Sarawak Social Development Council (MP5) would be able to identify the domains that could affect social well-being at the state, divisional and district levels.

The SSWI research was approved as a new programme in the 11th Malaysia Plan to be conducted once every three years commencing 2019. This research is identified as a vital tool to measure the impact of the social inclusion aspiration under the Post Covid-19 Development Strategy (PCDS) 2030.

Fatimah said previously, the SSWI 2019 research only covered 24 districts in the state.

"Each division was only represented by two districts; one representing the urban area and another representing the rural. "Hence, the reliability of the findings in SSWI 2019 was only up to the state and divisional levels," she said.

She said she looked forward to the findings of SSWI 2023 as these findings were vital for her ministry to formulate effective social development policies, design impactful

programmes, and implement targeted interventions to enhance community wellbeing in Sarawak.

Meanwhile, Swinburne Sarawak pro vice-chancellor and chief executive officer Prof Lau Hieng Ho said the SSWI research will measure the level of social wellbeing and identify social domains that could influence social wellbeing at state, divisional and district levels.

"From SSWI 2023, we anticipate evidence-based input for social wellbeing for each division and district in Sarawak for the purpose of planning for social investment initiatives; review of the current social wellbeing index, government policies, intervention strategies and programmes; detailed analysis and review of the changes in each pillar, domain and subdomains of SSWI 2019; and proposal on policies, strategies, action and implementation plans where appropriate to increase the social wellbeing of Sarawakians.

"We hope that the research, based on the State Social Transformation Framework will yield rich data shaping the policies that the Ministry of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development will implement to enhance wellbeing in Sarawak," he said.

Lau said Swinburne Sarawak

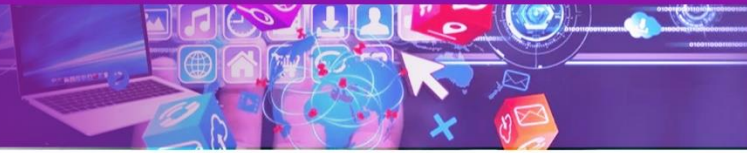
along with UTS and Curtin Malaysia will work closely with the Research Steering Committee and Research Technical Committee, represented by various Sarawak ministries, agencies and bodies, in gathering critical socio-economic data.

"This partnership aligns with Swinburne's 2005 moon shots strategic framework to embolden and energise our staff, students and partners to make a real difference.

"The SSWI 2023 is crucial because it moves the focus from purely economic outcomes to a more comprehensive understanding of what constitutes a good life, where citizens do not just survive, but thrive," he said.

Fatimah later witnessed the signing of the MoA where Ministry of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development permanent secretary Noriah Ahmad signed on behalf of the ministry, while Lau represented Swinburne Sarawak.

Also present were Fatimah's deputy ministers Datuk Rosey Yunus and Mohammad Razi Sitam, MPS executive secretary Dr Zufar Yadi Brendan Abdullah, and Swinburne Sarawak deputy pro vice-chancellor Prof Ida Fatimawati Badlozaman, who is also the project director for the SSWI 2023 Research Team.

Sarawak to be aging state by 2028 – Fatimah

KUCHING: Sarawak is predicted to be an aging state by 2028, said Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Minister Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

She disclosed this after receiving a courtesy call from Head of Economic Affairs of the Netherlands Embassy, Eva Oskam, at her ministry yesterday.

The courtesy call was to reciprocate the visit by a delegation from the Ministry for Women, Early Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development (KPWK) to the Netherlands two weeks ago, which included Fatimah, where they delved into cooperation opportunities in areas such as

elderly care, addressing the needs of an aging population, early childhood development, and determining the types of support that can be extended to children, including healthcare insurance.

"We are very happy to have a follow-up discussion like this after our working visit to the Netherlands to strengthen the possible collaboration between our state government and the Netherlands.

"Today's visit focused on our preparation towards an aging society," said Fatimah.

Fatimah added that Sarawak is expected to become an aging state by 2028, ahead of other Malaysian states that have been projected to hit the status by 2030.

She explained that they will examine the existing policies and initiatives in the Netherlands for

the elderly, with the intention of selecting and customising approaches that best suit Sarawak's specific needs.

"By 2028, our goal is not only to achieve developed status for Sarawak but also to significantly elevate the social well-being index of our residents.

"That is our aim and aspirations for an aging state," she said.

Additionally, she said that trips to the Netherlands, Sweden, and Singapore formed part of the ministry's preparedness for an aging population, through identifying the necessary steps that should be undertaken.

"We have to collaborate with other ministries, with first recognising that aging is a social issue.

"Based on our study visits, we've learnt that our elderly

prefer to 'age in place', whereby these elderly desire to stay within their own homes and not relocate elsewhere.

"If this is what they desire, we need to ensure there are necessary support systems. In case of a medical emergency, for example, the elderly individual should have immediate access to the necessary assistance," she said.

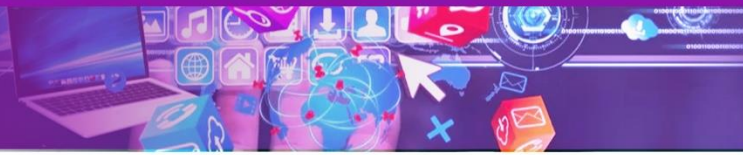
A proposal to establish a dedicated Cabinet committee as preparation for an aging population will be put forth at the cabinet meeting on Sept 14.

"We will present our ideas to the Cabinet, including health benefits that are given to the elderly through the Kenyalang Gold Card.

"If it's approved, it will be implemented in 2024," she said.

Woman killed, five injured in crash along Bintulu-Miri road

MIRI: A woman was killed in a single-vehicle crash along the Pan Borneo Highway near the Alam Bumi junction, some 110km from here Sunday.

The accident also saw five others, three of whom were children, injured.

The Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) said Diana Tinsie Douglas, 20, died at the scene.

Bomba Miri head Ismaidi Ismail said the department received

an emergency call regarding the accident at 4.36pm.

Personnel from the Batu Niah fire station was sent to the scene located around 24km away.

"Arriving at the scene, the operation team found that there had indeed been an accident involving a Miri-bound saloon car coming from Bintulu, which skidded and hit the metal railing at the scene," Ismaidi said.

"The Bomba team later found that a woman, who was in the back seat behind the driver, was unconscious," he said in a

statement.

Firefighters had to work to extricate the body, which was pinned in the vehicle, and later handed it over to police for further action.

Based on information obtained from the police, there were six victims in the vehicle – two women, one man, two boys, and a girl.

"Five of the victims were first helped out of the car by the public and rushed to a nearby clinic," said Ismaidi.

Police are investigating the cause of the accident.

Improving basic needs of Sidam folk

M'sian-Thai rep prioritises people's well-being

SUNGAI PETANI: Tackling bread-and-butter issues in the small town of Sidam will be the main task for newly-elected assemblyman Bau Wong Bau Ek, one of the few Malaysian-Thai lawmakers in the country.

He has also promised to improve the basic necessities, the infrastructure and the Internet connection for the people in the area.

"Some roads are in poor condition. Also, the Internet connection is lacking in certain areas here.

"Low water pressure is also a big problem that most residents complained about.

"These are the issues that I have in mind and would like to resolve for the people," he said.

The 57-year-old from PKR is no stranger to the constituency, having served as a special officer to former Sungai Petani MP Tan Sri Johari Abdul from 2008 to 2022 as well as to the current MP Mohammed Taufiq Johari.

On Aug 12, Bau Wong won the seat after beating Perikatan Nasional's Juliana Abdul Ghani with a 954-vote majority.

He was among the three assemblymen from Pakatan Harapan who survived the "green wave"

in Kedah.

The other two are DAP's Teh Swee Leong (Kota Darul Aman) and PKR's Adam Loh (Bakar Arang).

"I was over the moon upon being told that I had won the seat. But I was immediately brought down to earth upon learning that Pakatan only won a few seats in the state election.

"My victory would be more meaningful if Pakatan had formed the state government," he said.

Despite being the first assemblyman from the Siamese community, Bau Wong has vowed to look beyond race and religion.

He said there were only about

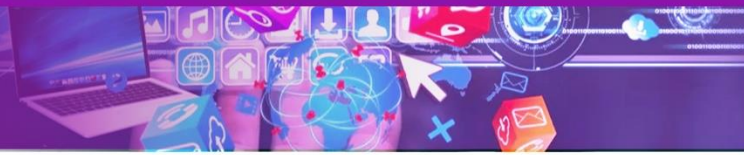
300 members of the Siamese community living in the area, with the majority of the voters being Malay as well as a sizeable number of Chinese and Indians.

"The Sidam constituency is considered a semi-urban area. There are also those living in rural areas.

"The well-being of the people will be my priority, regardless of race and religion.

"I'll work closely, not only with the Federal Government, but also with the PAS-led state government," he added.

Bau Wong, who hails from Kampung Olak Madu in Sidam Kiri, joined PKR in 2008. He is married with two children.

rendah yang lebih berkesan, konsisten dan bersasar.

“Justeru, kementerian telah memperkenalkan program Rahmah untuk mem-

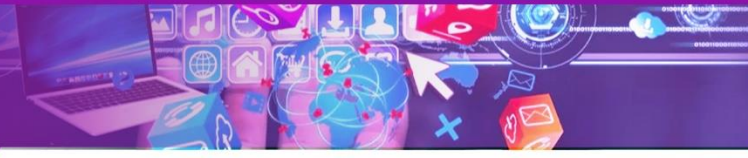
bantu kumpulan miskin tegar dan golongan kurang berkemampuan untuk mendapatkan bantuan makanan dan barangan keperluan asas

dalam mendepani kenaikan kos sara hidup,” jelasnya.

KUCHING: Manfaat pemeriksaan kesihatan percuma untuk pemegang Kenyalang Gold Card (KGC) dijangka akan mula dilaksanakan pada tahun depan.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Kanak-Kanak dan Kesejahteraan Komuniti (KPWK) Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah berkata, kementeriannya telah mengusahakan mekanisme berhubung inisiatif itu yang diumumkan oleh Premier Sarawak Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg pada Julai lalu.

“Kita akan membentangkan perkara ini dalam mesyuarat kabinet negeri selepas Premier Sarawak Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg kembali dari lawatan kerjanya ke Sweden, Norway dan London.

“Jadi insya-Allah, saya rasa kita boleh melaksanakan mekanisme ini pada tahun 2024,” katanya ketika ditemui pada Majlis Menandatangani Memorandum Perjanjian (MoA) Antara KPWK dengan Swinburne Sarawak Sdn Bhd tentang Kajian Indeks Kesejahteraan Sosial Sarawak (SSWI) 2023 di sini, semalam.

Fatimah berkata, inisiatif pemeriksaan kesihatan percuma itu bertujuan menyediakan alternatif lain kepada warga emas Sarawak bagi mendapatkan pemeriksaan kesihatan secara berkala.

“Kita tahu kalau kita pergi ke hospital kerajaan, perkhidmatan kesihatan adalah percuma tetapi orang ramai akan pergi ke sana dan kadang-kadang perlu menunggu tempoh yang lama.

“Jadi kita sedang mencari

Beliau berkata kementerian-

nya masih dalam perbincangan dengan Kementerian Kesihatan untuk memuktamadkan senarai pengamal am, klinik swasta dan hospital untuk dimasukkan ke dalam kad KGC bagi golongan warga emas berumur 60 tahun ke atas.

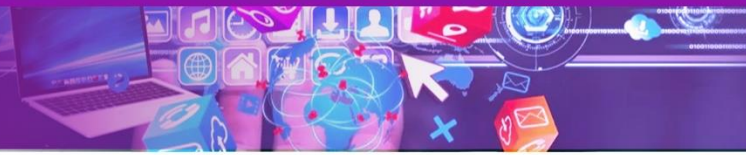
Pada 19 Julai lalu, Abang Johari berkata, kerajaan akan menanggung kos pemeriksaan kesihatan untuk warga emas Sarawak yang me-

megang KGC.

“Baru-baru ini saya telah mengarahkan untuk pemeriksaan kesihatan warga emas kita yang berusia 60 tahun ke atas dimasukkan ke dalam KGC dan ditanggung oleh kerajaan.

“Bermakna, manfaat kad tersebut bukan sahaja dari sudut pemberian diskaun untuk membeli barang tetapi juga pemeriksaan kesihatan mereka akan ditanggung oleh kerajaan,” katanya pada Majlis Perhimpunan Maal Hijrah Peringkat Negeri Sarawak Tahun 1445H/2023M di sini.

Untuk rekod, KGC merupakan kad yang diperkenalkan oleh Kerajaan Sarawak untuk memberi tawaran potongan harga, pengecualian pembayaran barangan serta perkhidmatan yang ditawarkan oleh sektor awam, swasta dan gerai komersial yang merupakan rakan strategik KPWK.

Seorang maut, lima cedera kereta langgar penghadang jalan

MIRI: Seorang wanita maut manakala lima yang lain termasuk tiga kanak-kanak cedera dalam kemalangan membabitkan sebuah kereta di Lebuhraya Pan Borneo berhampiran Suai, kelmarin.

Mangsa, Diana Tinsie Douglas, 20, disahkan meninggal dunia di tempat kejadian dan mayatnya telah diserahkan kepada pihak polis untuk tindakan lanjut.

Menurut Ketua Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Zon 6 Miri Ismaili Ismail, pihaknya telah menerima panggilan kecemasan berhubung kemalangan itu pada jam 4.36 petang.

Berikutan itu katanya sepasukan anggota dari Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat Batu Niah telah bergegas ke lokasi yang terletak pada jarak 24 kilometer.

“Setelah melakukan pemeriksaan di tempat kejadian, anggota bertugas mendapati seorang wanita yang berada di tempat duduk belakang pemandu dalam keadaan tidak sedarkan diri,” katanya dalam kenyataan yang dikeluarkan kelmarin.

Serentak itu kata Ismaili, anggota bomba terus melakukan operasi untuk mengeluarkan mangsa yang tersepit di dalam kenderaan tersebut.

Sebaik dikeluarkan, mayat mangsa kemudian diserahkan kepada pihak polis untuk tindakan lanjut.

Katanya berdasarkan maklumat yang diperolehi daripada pihak polis, terdapat enam mangsa di dalam kenderaan tersebut.

“Terdapat enam mangsa di dalam kenderaan itu yang terdiri daripada tiga orang dewasa iaitu dua wanita dan seorang lelaki serta tiga kanak-kanak iaitu dua lelaki dan seorang perempuan.

“Lima daripada mangsa telah dikeluarkan terlebih dahulu oleh orang awam dan dikejarkan ke klinik berhampiran,” ujarnya.
