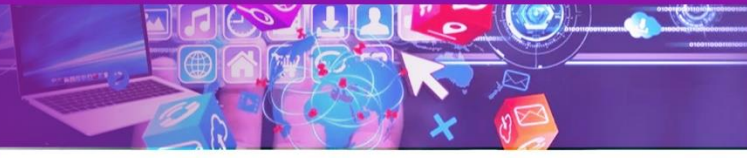

KPM minta sekolah laksana penilaian risiko

Nibong Tebal: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) akan meminta pengurusan sekolah di seluruh negara melaksanakan penilaian risiko terhadap ancaman bahaya persekitaran dan peralatan digunakan bagi memastikan keselamatan guru serta pelajar terjamin.

Menterinya, Fadhlina Sidek, berkata KPM sudah menyarankan pihak sekolah melaksanakan penilaian terbabit dan berada dalam pemantauan Kementerian.

"Tak ada masalah laksanakan pemantauan kerana itu memang kita buat.

"Ia adalah susulan peruntukan RM70,000 untuk menaik taraf dan penyelenggaraan sekolah termasuk tandas.

"Ini memang sangat kena pada masanya dan dalam masa sama

kita ingatkan semua sekolah ambil langkah berhati-hati dalam memastikan keselamatan murid dalam bangunan, kawasan atau premis sekolah," katanya.

Beliau mengulas saranan Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pendidikan, Pengajian Tinggi, Belia dan Sukan Perak, Khairudin Abu Hanipah, yang meminta pihak sekolah di negeri itu melakukan penilaian risiko terhadap ancaman persekitaran dan peralatan yang digunakan di sekolah.

Ia susulan kejadian seorang murid perempuan Tahun Tiga Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Perpaduan di Perak cedera selepas tangki pam tandas jenis seramik runtuh dan menyimpannya sehingga menyebabkan kecederaan.

Fadhlina yang juga Ahli Parli-



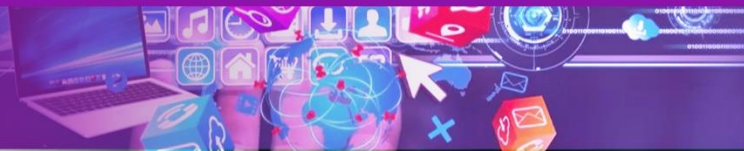

Polis berjaya mengesan seorang individu yang didakwa sering mengganggu seorang jurugambar wanita secara seksual seperti didedahkan mangsa di media sosial, baru-baru ini.

Ketua Polis Daerah Petaling Jaya, Asisten Komisyoner Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid berkata, semakan dilakukan pihak polis terhadap individu berkenaan mendapati dia sedang menerima rawatan di sebuah hospital bagi masalah mental dialaminya.

"Selepas kita berjaya kesan individu terbabit, kita dapati dia sedang menerima

rawatan di wad pesakit mental di Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL).

"Kami difahamkan bahawa individu berkenaan baru sahaja menerima rawatan itu selepas dihantar oleh ahli keluarganya.

"Siasatan masih dijalankan dan maklumat lanjut berhubung perkara ini akan dimaklumkan

kemudian," katanya ketika dihubungi, semalam.

Terdahulu, Harian Metro melaporkan pihak polis mengesahkan menerima laporan berhubung gangguan seksual dalam talian di-

hadapi jurugambar wanita pada 2018.

Sebelum ini, mangsa menerusi satu hantaran di Instagram, baru-baru ini, berkongsi kisah bagaimana dirinya sering diganggu secara seksual oleh individu berkenaan.

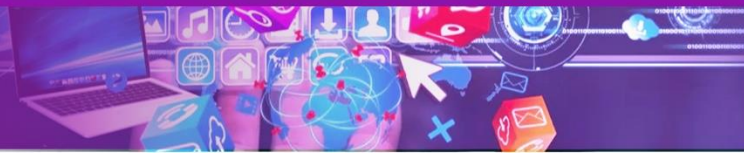
Mangsa mendakwa kerap menerima mesej lucah dan video memaparkan suspek berkenaan berkelakuan jelicik.

Susulan itu, sebuah media tempatan melaporkan, suspek berkenaan mula mengganggu mangsa sejak 2016 dengan meninggalkan komen di halaman blognya.

Suspek terbabit dikatakan mula menghendap mangsa sejak 2017 malah pernah mengekori mangsa ke sebuah restoran makanan segera dan ke rumah mangsa.

Alor Gajah: “Semuanya musnah terbakar, hanya tabung berisi syiling saja yang selamat,” kata mangsa kebakaran, Mohd Faizal Abu Hasan, 38.

Terdahulu, pada kejadian jam 7 malam kelmarin, rumah dihuni Mohd Faizal di Kampung Sungai Petai di sini, musnah terbakar.

“Kebakaran berlaku begitu pantas. Kami sedang menonton televisyen dan mendengar bunyi seakan-akan kayu terbakar sebelum api tiba-tiba marak di ruang hadapan rumah.

“Saya dan anak-anak hanya berseluar menyelamatkan diri kerana tidak sempat mencapai baju kerana api marak,” katanya.

Mengimbau kejadian, katanya, sebaik menyedari rumah terbakar, mereka tergamam dan kaku seketika.

“Syukur, jeritan jiran membuatkan kami tersedar sebelum bergegas menyelamatkan diri,” katanya lagi.

Menurut bapa kepada dua anak berusia enam dan tujuh tahun itu, ketika kejadian kesemua tujuh ahli keluarganya termasuk isteri, ibu mentua, adik ipar serta ibu saudaranya berada di ruang tamu menonton televisyen.

Katanya, dia dan keluarga langsung tidak menyangka rumah pusaka arwah bapa

mentua yang menjadi tempat mereka berteduh tiba-tiba terbakar.

“Kami sekeluarga juga bagaikan kebingungan ketika itu. Jiran terus menjerit menyuruh kami menyelamatkan diri.

“Walaupun tinggal sehelai se-

pinggang namun saya bersyukur kerana kami semua selamat,” katanya.

Sementara itu, jurucakap Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Melaka berkata, pihaknya menerima panggilan kebakaran jam

7.13 malam sebelum tiga jentera dari Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat (BPP) Alor Gajah, Cheng dan Tangga Batu digerakkan ke lokasi kejadian.

“Enam belas anggota membantu memadam kebakaran. Api dikawal 40 minit kemudian. Operasi tamat jam 10.34 malam, punca kebakaran masih dalam siasatan,” katanya.

Katanya, enjin dalam keadaan hidup serta lampu menyala namun apabila menghampiri kereta itu terdapat seorang wanita dalam keadaan tidak sedarkan diri.

'Nurse's negligence caused premature baby to fall off incubator'

JOHOR BARU: The Johor Health Department has confirmed that a 73-day-old premature baby girl in government hospital care fell off an incubator due to the attending nurse's negligence.

Department director Dr Mohtar Pungut said an inquiry revealed that the nurse had acted negligently and failed to adhere to the "top-to-toe" standard operation procedure, as outlined in the nursing procedure manual.

The nurse allegedly did not ensure the baby's safety during the procedure, he said.

The baby's mother underwent an emergency Caesarean delivery on May 7.

The baby girl, who was 26 weeks old at delivery, weighed 930g.

The baby was placed in an incubator as she was underweight and needed medical care.

The incident occurred at 11pm on July 16 when the nurse on duty conducted a routine "top-to-toe" procedure on the 12 infants at the ward.

Another nurse was also on duty at the same ward.

"Top-to-toe", also known as "topping and tailing", is a procedure where infants are cleaned. It starts from the infant's face, neck, hands and bottom, including their nappy area.

Dr Mohtar said the nurse in

question performed the procedure on three infants.

The first infant was in a baby cot, while the remaining two infants, including the victim, were in incubators.

"She had carefully carried out the 'top-to-toe' procedures on the two infants.

"However, while she was conducting the same procedure on the third infant, the nurse heard 'a sound indicating that something fell'.

"The baby was no longer in the incubator.

"She had fallen and was lying face up on the floor."

The nurse picked up the baby

and placed her back in the incubator.

Dr Mohtar said medical attention was immediately given, and her vital signs, including her blood pressure heart rate, were checked. "She had a bulging anterior fontanelle and a haematoma on the right forehead."

A bulging fontanelle occurs when fluid accumulates in the skull cavity or when pressure increases in the brain.

The infant was given treatment, and after a computerised tomography (CT) scan, she was referred to Sultanah Aminah Hospital's specialist neurosurgery for monitoring.

On July 17, the hospital's medical specialist met the girl's parents to explain the situation.

The parents wanted to see the nurse to demand an apology.

Dr Mohtar said the hospital management declined the request, as it was procedure for police to complete their investigations first. The girl's condition stabilised on July 18 and she was feeding well without the need for oxygen. The swelling on her head had also subsided.

Dr Mohtar said the hospital administration assured the parents that investigations were ongoing, and action would be taken based on its findings.

Siti Kasim unfazed by bomb threat

KUALA LUMPUR: Activist and lawyer Siti Zabedah Kasim, better known as Siti Kasim, says she is not intimidated by the improvised explosive device (IED) that was placed under her car recently.

She said she was still going about her job and would attend court proceedings in Kelantan tomorrow.

She pledged to continue advocating for groups, particularly the Orang Asli.

Siti Kasim said this was not the first time people had tried to scare her, citing past threats against her on social media.

"I had once lodged a report about a threat, and several people were detained by police. Many people post threats. Some wanted to see me dead because they hated me.

"They perceive me as anti-Islamic, but that is a misunderstanding because I spoke out

against politicians who used the religion for their own purposes or other things," she told *Harian Metro*.

Siti Kasim, who spoke on Facebook Live, said she had postponed sending her car for servicing.

She said she was glad that she sent her car to the workshop on Friday.

"The people who work at the workshop said, God was on my side.

"I was supposed to send in my car much earlier. If I had done that, I wouldn't have known about the bomb."

She said the court proceedings in Kelantan were related to the deaths of five Orang Asli children, who ran away from SK Pos Tohoi in Gua Musang eight years ago.

They were among seven pupils who fled from the school hostel on Aug 23, 2015, for fear of being

punished for bathing in a river without permission.

After almost 50 days, two children were found alive near Sungai Perias.

The skeletal remains of the remaining five were found in the same area.

"I will go (to Kelantan) and nothing is going to stop me. I have to be there for my Orang Asli

friends to support them. This is something I must do," Siti Kasim said, choking with emotion.

On Friday, Siti Kasim posted on Facebook that she was alerted to an object that was planted on one of her car tyres.

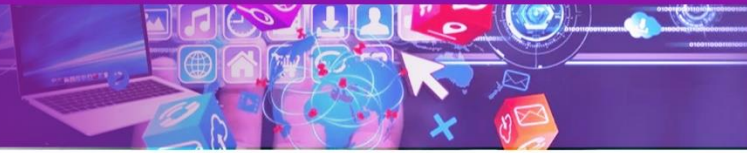
The police confirmed it was an IED.

Brickfields district police chief Assistant Commissioner Ami-

hizam Abdul Shukor said the matter was confirmed by a test carried out by the bomb disposal unit.

"The police are doing their best and investigations are ongoing," Siti Kasim told the *New Straits Times* on Friday.

Amihizam said police had recorded statements from Siti Kasim and a witness.

Initiatives to help Indians

Mitra to focus on community's education and well-being

PETALING JAYA: The Malaysian Indian Transformation Unit (Mitra) has initiated several subsidy programmes, with focus on education, career development and social well-being for the Indian community.

Its chairman Datuk Ramanan Ramakrishnan said 10,000 undergraduates would receive a one-off education aid of RM2,000.

"This subsidy will be disbursed in phases from August," he said, adding that it was also open to students of private higher learn-

ing institutions on a first come first served basis.

"Mitra will also disburse subsidy amounting to RM2.49mil to preschool children and has signed agreements with the first batch of 42 kindergartens with a total 1,035 children.

"Another sum of over RM5.095mil will be disbursed to the second batch of recipients involving 71 kindergartens and 2,123 children," he said in a statement yesterday.

He also said a joint programme

between Mitra and Weststar Aviation Services in aircraft maintenance had been launched for 100 Indian youth.

Applications would open from July 26 until Aug 30, Ramanan added.

He said those interested could also sign up the Drone Operations Technical Programme as well as the Data Services and Electrified Advancement Programme, which will also open for application on July 26.

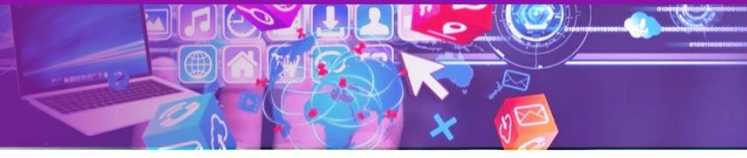
A programme for Tamil schools

on refurbishing personal computer would be implemented next month, he said.

Ramanan added that for a start, the unit was targeting 527 schools nationwide.

"We have also launched the dialysis aid subsidy programme for some 9,000 Indians suffering from chronic kidney disease," he said.

Each recipient would get RM9,600 in subsidy for a term of up to a year, beginning next month, he added.

Siti Kasim remains defiant after bomb threat

PETALING JAYA: Activist-lawyer Siti Kasim says she will continue speaking up against the use of religion in politics.

A day after discovering a bomb was planted on her car, Siti Kasim continued with her trademark defiant tone, lambasting her critics and those who had prayed for her death.

"For those who prayed for my death, you need to understand that I am not afraid of death, because everyone will die (one day). If you think praying for someone's death is Islamic, then go ahead. Nobody is stopping you.

"If it is written as qada and qadar (fate) that I will die like that for doing the right thing, then I

will die happily," she said in an Instagram video.

On Friday, two bottles filled with wires were discovered under the rear of Siti Kasim's car, which the police confirmed were improvised explosive devices (IEDs).

Siti Kasim said the discovery was made by her mechanic at a workshop in Bangsar where she had left the car for servicing.

"All I know is that I will (continue) to be a useful human being while I am alive.

"To me, that is the most Islamic thing to do, to do your best in your life, in whatever manner, in whatever way you can.

"But to those who do not understand me, that is up to you. You answer to God," she said.

Siti Kasim, who has been accused of being anti-Islam, reit-

erated that she had never spoken against the religion, but only to those who use it in politics.

"I have never said Islam is bad. Islam is my religion, I love my religion. I only speak up because I do not agree with what is happening in this country.

"If you agree to be jailed for 30 years, being fined RM100,000, receiving 100 strokes of the rotan just because you do not fast, not dressing up according to syariah law, not praying or committing other (wrongdoings) that do not result in victimising people, that is up to you.

"But I do not agree, because (syariah) law covers me as well, it is forced upon me. I do not agree with these politicians who make decisions about my religion. That is what I have been saying," she said.

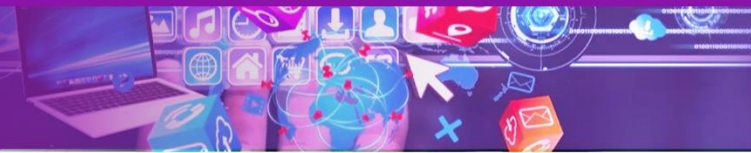
Siti Kasim said she would continue to speak for the oppressed and warned culprits behind the car bomb that the law would catch up with them.

"I will continue to talk. I am not afraid of death. If I am (to be) murdered by these fanatics, that is up to you.

"Whatever you want to do, you just think carefully. I do believe the people who did this believe that faith is on their side. Well, I'm sure the police will get you," she said.

Meanwhile, more than 50 civil society groups said they stand in solidarity with Siti Kasim and condemned the persons responsible for planting the bomb underneath her car.

The groups also called on the police to provide Siti Kasim with security.

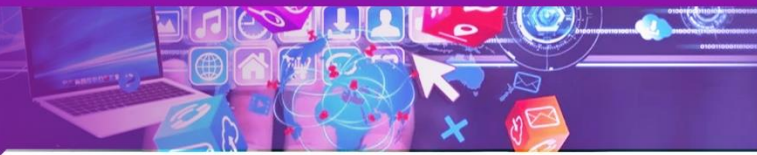

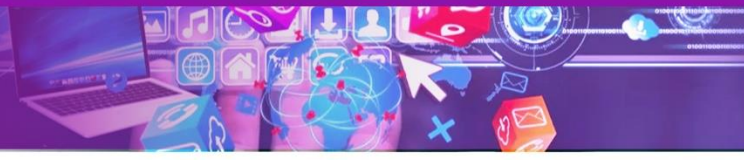

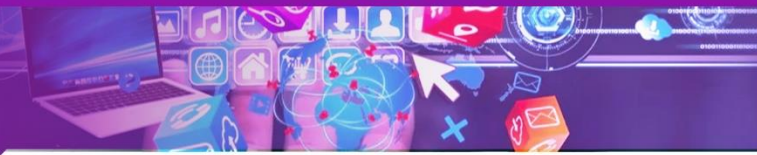
