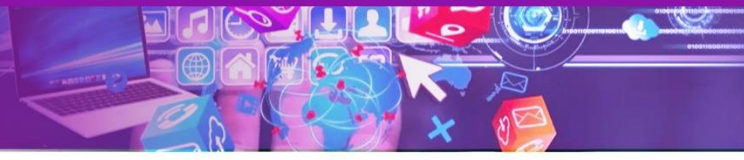

KKM diminta perinci agihan dana penyakit jarang jumpa

Peruntukan RM25j dibentang dalam Belanjawan 2023 bolehkan pesakit dapatkan rawatan

Kajang: Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob meminta kerajaan menerusi Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) memperincikan agihan dana berjumlah RM25 juta yang diperuntukkan untuk penyakit jarang jumpa yang sebelum ini dibentangkan menerusi Bajet 2023.

Bekas perdana menteri berkata, peruntukan itu sudah dibincangkan dalam pentadbirannya sebelum ini ketika Khairy Jamaluddin menjadi Menteri Kesihatan.

Katanya, peruntukan itu dapat membantu pesakit yang disahkan menghidap penyakit jarang jumpa mendapatkan rawatan yang memerlukan kos pembedahan yang tinggi.

"Sebelum pertukaran kerajaan, Menteri Kewangan ketika itu, Tengku Datuk Seri Zafrul Abdul Aziz, sudah membentangkannya dalam Bajet 2023.

"Namun, setakat ini saya tidak tahu sebarang perkembangan berkenaan peruntukan itu dan jika tidak disambung, kita harap pelaksanaannya diteruskan.

"Jika bajet itu sudah ada (diteruskan kerajaan sekarang) kita sudah ada dana terkumpul dan sumbangan daripada orang ramai dapat membantu merawat

pesakit penyakit jarang jumpa," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian selepas melawat Sufi Syafrina Mohd Shafiq yang menghidap penyakit Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) Type 1 di Kampung Sungai Kantan di sini, semalam.

Sufi Syafrina yang berusia enam bulan, memerlukan dana untuk membeli ubat Genetik Zolgensma berharga RM9 juta.

Pada Oktober 2022, Tengku Zafrul, yang memegang jawatan Menteri Kewangan mengumumkan dalam Belanjawan 2023 bahawa kerajaan memperuntukkan RM25 juta bagi menampung kos rawatan bagi penyakit jarang jumpa di negara ini.

Peruntukan berkenaan disalurkan kepada Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) dan Hospital

Tunku Azizah (HTA) sebagai pusat rujukan bagi berkenaan.

Minta bantuan kerajaan

Mengulas mengenai anak bongsu daripada tiga beradik itu, Ismail Sabri berkata, beliau akan menulis surat secara rasmi kepada Menteri Kesihatan, Dr Zaliha Mustafa untuk meminta kerajaan membantu bayi itu melalui peruntukan berkenaan.

Beliau juga berharap, orang ramai dan pihak korporat dapat turut sama membantu bayi berkenaan mendapatkan rawatan untuk penyakitnya itu.

"Saya amat tersentuh melihat keadaan Sufi Syafrina yang terpaksa bergantung kepada alat bantuan pernafasan 24 jam untuk meneruskan kehidupan.

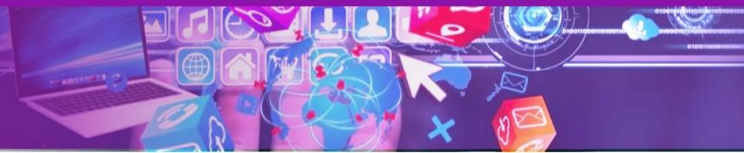
"Saya turut dimaklumkan rawatan ini perlu dilakukan sege-

ra atau sebelum usianya mencecah dua tahun.

"Oleh itu, saya berharap lebih banyak pihak seperti syarikat korporat dan pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) turut sama membantu supaya rawatan ini dapat disegerakan dan Sufi Syafrina dapat menjalani kehidupan lebih baik selepas ini," katanya.

Ketika ini, Sufi Syafrina juga perlu menggunakan ubat Risdiplam bernilai RM40,400 yang bertahan selama sebulan bagi membantu mengekalkan tahap kesihatan supaya tidak bertambah merosot.

Sufi Syafrina hidap SMA Type 1 perlu RM9j beli ubat genetik

Kajang: Keadaan Sufi Syafrina Mohd Syafiq yang didiagnos dengan penyakit Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) Type 1, kini semakin baik, selepas tiga hari diberi ubat Risdiplam berharga RM40,400 yang mampu bertahan selama sebulan.

Bagaimanapun, bayi berusia enam bulan itu masih memerlukan bantuan kewangan untuk membeli ubat Genetik Zolgensma berharga RM9 juta bagi merawat penyakit jarang jumpa dihidapinya.

Bapa Sufi Syafrina, Mohd Syafiq Idrus, 38, berkata pada hari pertama dan kedua anaknya mendapatkan ubat berkenaan, dia mengalami masalah sesak nafas dan demam dipercayai kerana kesan ubat berkenaan.

Beliau berkata, masuk hari ketiga keadaan anaknya sudah semakin baik dan dia berharap ubat yang perlu dibeli setiap bulan itu mampu membantu tahap kesihatan anaknya sementara menunggu wang mencukupi bagi membeli ubat Genetik Zolgensma.

"Ketika ini juga setiap dua hari sekali saya akan membawa Sufi Syafrina membuat fisioterapi bagi memastikan sarafnya berfungsi dengan baik dengan kos sebanyak RM2,700 sebulan.

"Dengan keadaan anak yang memerlukan penjagaan rapi, saya tidak lagi dapat memberi tumpuan kepada pekerjaan sebagai penternak lembu," katanya di rumahnya di Kampung Sungai Kantan di sini, semalam.

Sufi Syafrina disahkan menghidap SMA ketika berusia empat bulan selepas menjalani pemeriksaan akibat demam dan ditahan selama 10 hari di Hospital Kajang dan keadaannya bertambah teruk hingga terpaksa di hantar ke Hospital Tunku Azizah (Hospital Wanita Dan Kanak-Kanak KL) selama sebulan.

Mohd Syafiq berkata, sebelum itu dia perasan ada sedikit perubahan pada anaknya seperti kaki dan tangannya tidak boleh diangkat dan kepala yang tidak mampu bergerak ke kiri dan kanan.

Mohd Syafiq berkata, setakat ini dana terkumpul hanya lebih RM60,000 dan jumlah itu masih belum mencukupi.

Malah, katanya, sumbangan untuk ubat yang berharga RM9 juta masih belum ada kerana dana yang sedia ada digunakan untuk membeli ubat sokongan serta keperluan lain.

"Saya berharap anak bongsu dapat mengambil ubat Zolgensma secepat mungkin sebelum usianya mencapai dua tahun bagi membantu merawat sepenuhnya penyakit berkenaan," katanya.

Selepas empat hari operasi pencarian nelayan yang hilang dipercayai dibaham buaya di sungai Kampung Mas-Mas Nasib Kita, dekat sini, Rabu lalu akhirnya menemukan mayat mangsa dalam perut reptilia itu, semalam.

Ini berikutan buaya di-anggarkan sepanjang 4.26

meter dengan berat lebih 800 kilogram (kg) ditembak mati selepas dikesan anggota Jabatan Hidupan Liar (JHL) jam 3 pagi.

Ketua Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat (BBP) Tawau, Jemishin Ujin berkata, pasukan JHL membelah perut buaya berkenaan sebelum menemui anggota badan manusia dipercayai milik mangsa.

"Proses pengeca-

man dilakukan ahli keluarga mangsa di Pusat Kawalan Operasi Bencana (PKOB) sebelum diserahkan kepada pihak polis untuk tindakan lanjut," katanya, di sini.

Sementara itu, Pegawai JHL Tawau Primus Lambut ketika dihubungi mengesahkan perkara tersebut.

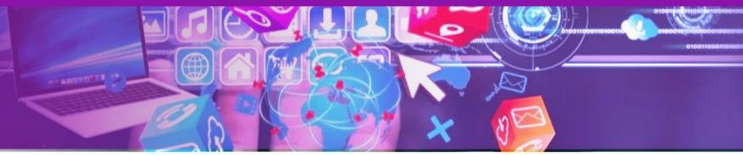
Menurutnya, buaya jantan itu ditembak di kawasan laut, 1.5

kilometer dari lokasi mangsa dilaporkan dibaham.

"Kami menerima maklumat daripada pihak bomba pada hari kedua operasi dan mengarahkan anggota membantu operasi pencarian," katanya.

Media sebelum ini melaporkan mangsa, Addi Bangsa, 60, dilaporkan hilang dipercayai disambar buaya ketika hendak turun dari bot untuk menangkap ikan jam 4 pagi.

Kajang: Bekas Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob menyarankan kerajaan dapat memperincikan pelaksanaan peruntukan RM25 juta dalam Belanjawan 2023 bagi menampung kos rawatan penyakit jarang jumpa yang memerlukan belanja mencecah jutaan ringgit.

"Sebelum ini, kita juga sudah membawa peruntukan itu (sebelum pertukaran kerajaan) yang dibentangkan oleh Menteri Kewangan ketika itu Tengku Datuk Seri

Zafrul Abdul Aziz pada Belanjawan 2023.

Ismail Sabri berkata, be-

liau prihatin dengan keadaan Sufi Syafrina dan berharap orang ramai serta semua pihak dapat terus

membantu bayi berusia enam bulan itu mendapatkan rawatan untuk penyakitnya itu.

"Saya difahamkan penyakit Sufi Syafrina jenis jarang ditemui dan memerlukan RM9 juta untuk mendapatkan suntikan bagi merawat penyakitnya itu sebelum dia berusia dua tahun.

"Saya akan tulis surat secara rasmi kepada Menteri Kesihatan (Dr Zaliha Mustafa) untuk meminta kerajaan membantu bayi ini melalui peruntukan berkenaan.

"Saya juga menyeru orang ramai dan semua pihak untuk membantu Sufi Syafrina meneruskan kehidupannya dengan baik," katanya.

Pada Oktober tahun lalu, media melaporkan kerajaan memperuntukkan RM25 juta bagi menampung kos rawatan Penyakit Jarang Jumpa yang kian meningkat.

Tengku Zafrul dipetik berkata, kerajaan sudah mengambil langkah proaktif dengan menjadikan Hospital Kuala Lumpur (HKL) dan Hospital Tunku Azizah (HTA) sebagai pusat rujukan bagi penyakit berkenaan.

Berat ujian pasangan suami isteri, Intan Maszura Nordin dan Mohd Azizi Zakaria yang diuji dua daripada empat anaknya berstatus orang kurang upaya (OKU).

Anak ketiga mereka, Nurul Alieya Aqielah, 16, menghidap autisme sejak lahir dan kini mendapat pendidikan di Sekolah Menengah (SM) Vo-

Pasangan suami isteri pinjam duit rakan, keluarga urus 2 zuriat

kasional Pendidikan Khas Kuantan, Pahang.

Anak bongsunya pula, Muhammad Hairi Haikal, 15, kini terlantar dan disahkan cerebral palsy (CP) ketika berusia enam bulan.

Berkongsi cerita lanjut, Intan Maszura mengakui

bukan mudah untuk membesarkan dua anak syurganya itu.

Menurutnya, ia kerana selain perlu kuat mental dan fizikal, dia dan juga suami perlu bersedia daripada segi kewangan.

"Suami hanya kerja seba-

gai buruh saja namun bukan bekerja tetap jadi pendapatan tak menentu.

"Anak bongsu masih perlu dirujuk ke Hospital Segamat, Hospital Batu Pahat dan Hospita Tangkak namun ji-

ka nak

ke sana (hospital) terpaksa menaiki kenderaan e-hailing kerana ada ketika suami tiada dan saya pula tak pandai memandu.

"Tambangnya bukan murah dan sebab itu ada-kalanya tak dapat ke hospital kerana perlu gunakan duit

untuk perbelanjaan lain terutama sewa bulanan rumah sebanyak RM300," katanya ketika dihubungi Harian Metro.

Menurut Intan Maszura, dia ada menerima bantuan penjagaan OKU terlantar sebanyak RM500 daripada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

Bagaimanapun, katanya, bantuan diterima tidak cukup untuk menampung perbelanjaan bulanan dan meringankan beban suaminya.

Menurutnya, dia dan suami juga perlu menyara dua lagi anak normal dengan anak sulungnya, Nurul Aqilah, 20, masih menuntut di Politeknik Metro Johor Bahru (PMJB) manakala anak kedua sudah mendapat tawaran di Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) Kampus Alor Gajah, Melaka dan bakal menyambung pengajian pada September ini.

"Jadi, kami semua bergantung dengan pendapatan suami saja hingga pernah ikat perut kerana tiada duit makan.

"Ada juga satu ketika kami terpaksa pinjam duit dengan rakan dan keluarga kerana terdesak.

Man's body found inside crocodile

TAWAU: The body of a senior citizen was found inside a crocodile a few days after he was reported to have been attacked by the reptile in Sungai Mas-Mas Nasib Kita.

The victim was identified as Addi Bangsa, 60.

Body of missing fisherman found in crocodile's stomach

TAWAU: The search for a missing fisherman, who was believed to have been devoured by a crocodile in Sungai Kampung Mas-Mas Nasib Kita here last Wednesday, ended yesterday with his body being found in the reptile's stomach.

Tawau fire station chief Jemishin Ujin said the search for the victim, Addi Bangsa, 60, was carried out by the Wildlife Department.

"On the fourth day of the search operation, the Wildlife team found a crocodile that was believed to have eaten the victim.

The team went on to shoot the animal and slit its stomach and found the victim's body in it.

"Family members identified the victim's body which was handed over to the police for further action," he said in a statement yesterday.

Meanwhile, Tawau Wildlife Department officer Primus Lambut when contacted confirmed the matter.

He said the male crocodile, with an estimated weight of 800kg and length of 4.26m, was shot early yesterday morning about 1.5 kilometres from the location where the victim was reported to have been snatched by the reptile.

"We received information from

the Fire and Rescue Department on the second day of the operation and deployed a team to join in the search," he added.

The fisherman's family members had reported his disappearance at about 4am on July 19. — Bernama

KGC's free health screenings to also cover those offered by private sector

KUCHING: The latest privilege made available under the Kenyalang Gold Card (KGC) programme, namely free health screenings for the cardholders, would cover medical services offered by the providers from the private sector, said Minister for Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Sarawak Dato Sri

Fatimah Abdullah.

According to her, her ministry is still in discussion with the federal Ministry of Health (MoH) in finalising the list of general practitioners (GPs), private clinics and hospitals to be included in the card programme meant for the elderly group aged 60 and above.

"Private clinics and hospitals will be included because we want to relieve congestion at government hospitals, where the

waiting time is quite long.

"We are still looking at it together with the MoH, on the list of GPs, private clinics and hospitals," she told The Borneo Post yesterday when asked if the recent announcement by Premier Datuk Patinggi Tan Sri Abang Johari Tun Openg on the free health screenings for KGC holders would include medical services offered by private hospitals.

Adding on, Fatimah said

her ministry was working out the final details including the financial implications on offering free health screenings under the KGC.

She disclosed that the costs of the free health screenings, to be borne by the state government, had not been budgeted for and as such, the ministry would have to study the possible financial implications.

"For good governance, we need to look at the financial implications and such budget would have to be tabled under the Supplementary Budget, subject to approval by the State Legislative Assembly (DUN)," she said, adding that in terms of making the KGC free health screenings possible, the costs would be capped but the amount had yet to be determined.

"It might be something similar to the benefits offered in Selangor, but those in Selangor are meant for the B40 (low-income) group.

"Our KGC is not limited to B40, as it is meant for all senior citizens aged 60 and above," said Fatimah.

The minister said the Premier would announce the details in due time once her ministry's final papers had been endorsed by him and the Sarawak Cabinet.

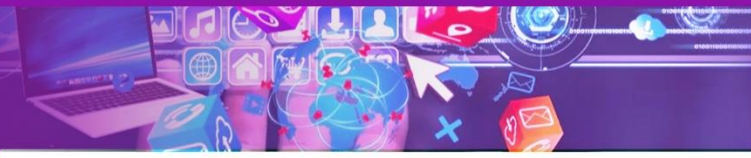
On Wednesday, Abang Johari said KGC holders would be provided with free health screenings.

"I've recently instructed for health check-ups for senior citizens aged 60 and above to be included as one of the benefits under KGC.

"This means that the privilege of this card is not only from the point of view of giving discounts when purchasing goods, but also of the cost of health examinations for this group being borne by the government," said the Premier at the state-level Maal Hijrah Assembly last week.

KGC was introduced by the Sarawak government to allow senior citizens in the state with the 'K' status on their MyKad or are Sarawak permanent residents, to enjoy special privileges and discounts from the participating companies and vendors involved in optical services, health services, dental services, reflexology, bus and transport, food outlet, pharmacy, retail, tailoring and hair salon business - among other operations.

At present, there are more than 200,000 KGC holders all over Sarawak.

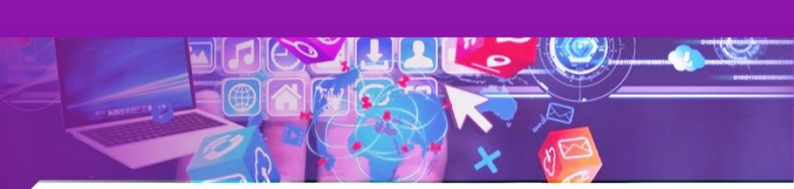

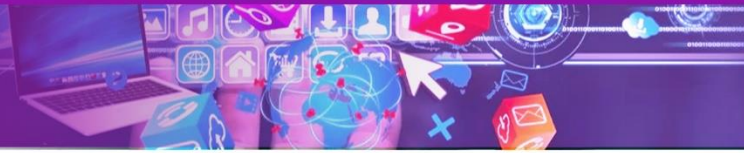

A heart for the homeless

Tan driven by passion to care for single seniors for past 18 years

GEORGE TOWN: The sight of many elderly folk sleeping at bus stops in the early 1990s led Peter Tan down an eventful road to help those in need.

Having run Persatuan Syukur Penayang Pulau Pinang for 18 years now, Tan has taken in almost 100 people over the years, many of whom have regarded him as their godson.

"It has been a long journey and it began with a voice in my head getting louder every time I came across someone homeless, especially an elderly person.

"We make sure to help those in need. But our main criteria is they must be single or without immediate family members.

"Usually, our residents are referred to us by the hospitals, Social Welfare Department or people who come across cases in need," he said.

Tan said the only exception was one case involving a mother and her daughter.

The daughter is mentally-challenged while her elderly mother has physical disabilities.

"They do not have anyone else and cannot take care of themselves," he said.

Tan, 55, said currently, they were looking after 40 residents

including a 72-year-old, who has been staying in the home since it opened in 2006.

"He was living in a hut without proper walls but I managed to convince him to follow me and stay here all these years.

"I started the home with three residents I found living by the roadside. It has now grown to 40 with 13 staff members.

"Over the years, we lost 57 residents to old age and diseases," he said.

Tan said they also took in those with health issues including cancer, visual impairment, the disabled, accident victims and even those with Alzheimer's.

"We not only look into their physical well-being and health but make sure they are happy, feel at home and valued," he said.

Tan said the residents range from those in their 50s to those in their 90s.

"We also provide nursing aid. Although most of them are mobile, they need help such as taking a shower and medication on time.

"We have night shift staff to ensure there is constant care round the clock.

"For me, this is just a small contribution to society. We will continue to do our best to assist the less fortunate for as long as we can," he said.

Prior to this journey, Tan said he worked for his brother in Sabah in 1997.

Back then, he witnessed many homeless people loitering and scavenging for things, and such vivid memories kept playing on his mind.

"Whenever I see someone homeless, it breaks my heart.

"Not long after, I quit my job and joined a monastery in Taiwan for a few years before returning to Malaysia in 2001.

"It was then that I had a vision to start a home to look after the needy and elderly," said Tan, who hails from Melaka.

He said he narrowed down the location to three cities – Johor, Kuala Lumpur and Penang – before choosing the latter.

"Here, I started by working part-time as a driver, delivering flowers.

"This helped me to familiarise with the roads before I became a social worker," he said.

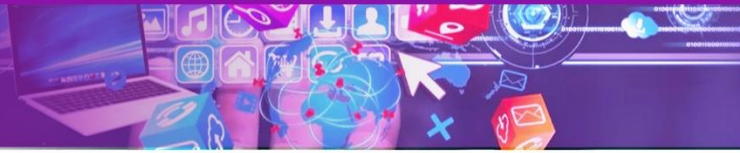
Tan said at the end of 2004, he registered the association before putting his plan into action.

"There were a few obstacles along the way.

"I only managed to start the home on Jan 1, 2006, and have never looked back since.

"We have our regular donors and good Samaritans who come to the office to donate.

"Their contributions help us to sustain our upkeep year in, year out," he said.

GOVERNMENT TO UPGRADE LIVING CONDITIONS AT PPRs

THE Local Government Development Ministry has been allocated RM50mil to ensure a safe environment at the People's Housing Projects (PPRs) – with priority on replacing dilapidated elevators.

This is one of the various measures to improve liveability at PPRs, as announced by the Prime Minister when tabling Belanjawan 2023 in February.

PPRs have been implemented for decades to provide home ownership for the low-income rakyat. The Unity Government wants to improve living conditions at such schemes.

Allocations for maintenance work include:

- > Quotation limit for lift repairs and maintenance procurement increased from RM500,000 to RM1.2mil.

- > RM200mil for low-cost public housing maintenance in Kuala Lumpur.

- > RM44.4mil for Tabung Penyelenggaraan Perumahan Malaysia (Malaysian Housing Maintenance Fund).

- > RM46mil for state low-cost public housing maintenance.

- > RM25mil for upgrading and maintenance work of Kampung Baru Cina.

Aside from upgrading and maintenance of facilities, other efforts to improve the liveability of PPRs include:

- > Free internet access at 56 selected PPRs.

- > RM15mil to support NGOs' remedial classes for children who fall behind in studies.

- > RM30mil for the people's commercial activities, for instance,

food businesses using the Cloud Kitchen platform under the supervision of Yayasan Hasanah.

- > RM1.3mil for zero waste community development among selected PPR communities as localised Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

New PPR projects

An allocation of RM367mil has been given to develop new PPR

projects to benefit 12,400 new residents.

The Rumah Mesra Rakyat programme under Syarikat Perumahan Negara Bhd (SPNB) will see the construction of 4,250 housing units with an allocation of RM358mil.

Syarikat Jaminan Kredit Perumahan (SJKP) has been providing government guarantees to assist borrowers without a fixed income.

In 2023, SJKP is ready to stand guarantor for up to RM5bil in loans to benefit 20,000 borrowers.

To further encourage home ownership, the government will continue to exempt stamp duty for first-time owners – full exemption of stamp duty for a home valued at RM500,000 and below, and 75% exemption for units costing more than RM500,000 to RM1mil.

Corporate social responsibility

Government-linked companies (GLC) and government-linked investment companies (GLIC) contribute to various programmes for the welfare of the rakyat and the country. This includes a corporate social contribution of up to RM250mil to help uplift the hardcore poor.

ThinkCity, a subsidiary of Khazanah Nasional Bhd, is working with KL City Hall (DBKL) to beautify focal locations in the city to raise the potential of historical and cultural assets.

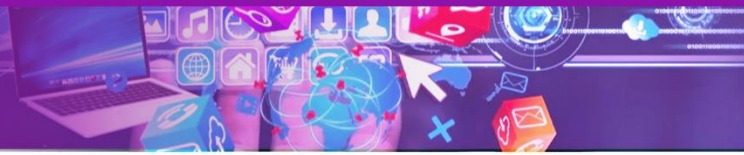
To preserve our national heritage, Khazanah Nasional will spearhead a fund to procure RM700mil for the restoration of heritage buildings. This includes the redevelopment of Bangunan Sultan Abdul Samad and Carcosa Seri Negara, in collaboration with ThinkCity.

Help for all

Under Belanjawan 2023, the government has introduced various measures to help B40 communities, whether urban or rural.

Those who qualify and have not applied for government aid are encouraged to do so, as the application process has been simplified and is user-friendly, and the benefits will be disbursed swiftly to successful applicants.

Hunting a man-eating croc

Human remains found inside stomach of largest reptile in area

KOTA KINABALU: A process of "deduction and elimination" helped wildlife rangers pick out and kill a man-eating crocodile in Tawau.

Sabah Wildlife Department director Augustine Tuuga said the rangers were surveying the crocodile-infested area around Kg Sungai Mas Mas for a while and zoomed in on the largest reptile in the area.

The rangers shot the crocodile after a four-day search and rescue operations for a missing 60-year-old man, Addi Bangsa.

"The one they shot was the biggest in the search area," Augustine said yesterday.

The others were juveniles so they were spared because they were unlikely to cause fatal attacks on humans, he said when contacted.

He said the rangers recorded some 12 juveniles in the area while the only crocodile that would likely have attacked the missing man was the largest.

The man's crushed body, including legs, were recovered from the stomach of the 800kg reptile.

He said the 4.29m male crocodile was spotted about 1.5km away from the house where the victim was attacked at about 4am

on July 19.

Upon cutting up the stomach of the crocodile, the rangers found human remains.

A Sabah Fire and Rescue Services Department spokesman

said family members confirmed the body was that of Addi.

The remains were sent to hospital for a post-mortem and further police investigation into the incident.

Search teams comprising firemen and police together with villagers had carried out surface search since July 19 and covered a 3km radius around the river mouth about 70km from Tawau.

"My crew and I have been working to promote and sell the book throughout the country to raise funds and help many more people," he said.

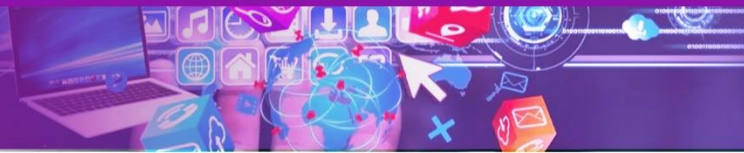
"The book is not all about politics, but more about what I have contributed to society and the organisations and associations that I have been a part of in my years of service.

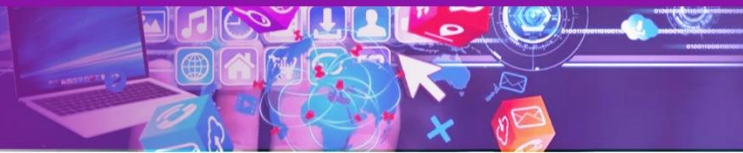

"Baru-baru ini saya telah mengarahkan untuk

pemeriksaan kesihatan warga emas kita yang berusia 60 tahun ke atas, dimasukkan ke dalam KGC dan ditanggung oleh kerajaan.

"Bermakna, manfaat kad tersebut bukan sahaja dari sudut pemberian diskaun untuk membeli barang, tetapi juga pemeriksaan kesihatan mereka akan ditanggung oleh kerajaan," katanya.

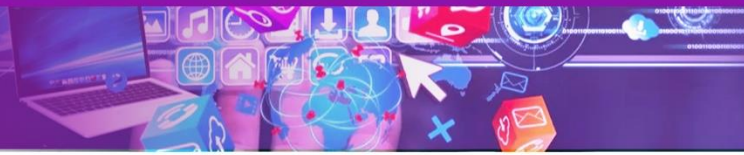
