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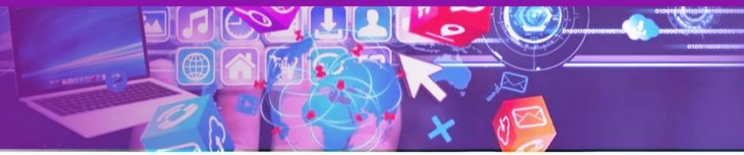

## Imigresen tahan 34 warga asing di pusat hiburan

**Kuala Lumpur:** Jabatan Imigresen Kuala Lumpur menahan 34 warga asing atas pelbagai kesalahan imigresen dalam operasi penguatkuasaan di sebuah pusat hiburan di Jalan Pudu Ulu, di sini, tengah malam kelmarin.

Pengarahnya, Syamsul Badrin Mohshin, berkata mereka yang ditahan terdiri daripada 15 lelaki dan 19 wanita membabitkan warga Thailand, Myanmar dan Laos, berusia lingkungan 25 hingga 40 tahun yang bekerja sebagai pe-

layan pelanggan (GRO), penari dan penyanyi di pusat hiburan berkenaan.

Katanya, antara kesalahan yang dikesan ialah menetap lebih masa, tidak mempunyai dokumen pengenalan diri dan menyalahgunakan pas.

"Operasi ini dibuat susulan aduan orang awam dan bertindak atas maklumat itu, risikan dijalankan selama dua minggu sebelum serbuan dilakukan," katanya pada sidang media tengah malam kelmarin.

Syamsul Badrin berkata, semua tahanan akan dibawa ke Depot Tahanan Imigresen Bukit Jalil untuk direman selama 14 hari bagi membantu siasatan mengikut Seksyen 51(5)(b) Akta Imigresen 1959/63, Seksyen 6(1) (C) dan Seksyen 15(1) (C) akta sama serta Perkara 39(b) Peraturan Imigresen 1963.

Operasi kira-kira setengah jam yang bermula pada 11 malam itu disertai 40 pegawai dan anggota penguat kuasa jabatan itu.

# Penerima bantuan hidup ceria selepas pembedahan

## Tabung Kemanusiaan Media Prima-NSTP bantu individu kurang mampu

**Kuala Lumpur:** Lega dan gembira, itu riak yang tergambar pada wajah ibu bapa apabila si kecil kesayangan semakin sihat dan membesar seperti kanak-kanak lain. Ini kerana nasib anak mereka berubah selepas menjalani rawatan dan pembedahan komplikasi jantung hasil bantuan Tabung Kemanusiaan Media Prima-NSTP diperolehi daripada sumbangan orang ramai dan badan korporat.

Catherine Teng Kai Xuan, 6, kini mampu tersenyum riang menikmati kehidupan selepas kesihatannya pulih hasil pembedahan jantung kedua November lalu di Hospital Gleneagles Kuala Lumpur dengan kos RM150,000.

Anak bongsu daripada tiga beradik itu disahkan menghidap penyakit jantung terbalik, jantung berlubang dan saluran darah ke paru-paru sempit, selain pernah menjalani pembedahan pada 2018.

Ibunya yang juga suri rumah, Lim Siew Lee, 43, berkata anaknya kini semakin aktif dan menjalani kehidupan biasa namun tetap perlu berpantang makanan berasaskan hijau bagi memastikan tiada alahan pada kesihatannya.

"Setakat ini kami memantau keadaannya melalui alat tekanan

darah dua minggu sekali dan doktor menasihatkan supaya dia tidak makan rumpai laut atau aiskrim teh hijau kerana boleh menimbulkan alahan kepadanya.

"Selain itu, pakar juga menasihatkan supaya terus memberikan tumpuan sepenuhnya dan mengelakkannya daripada terjatuh.

"Sebagai persediaan untuknya memasuki sekolah tahun depan, doktor memberikan surat rujukan yang mengecualikannya daripada melakukan aktiviti lasak fizikal," katanya.

Catherine antara 10 kanak-kanak yang menjalani pembedahan di Hospital Gleneagles Kuala Lumpur bersama keluarga diraikan pada program 'Celebrating Our Heart Heroes' di Zoo Negara, semalam.

Ia bersempena Hari Jantung Sedunia pada 29 September depan yang bermatlamat memberi kesedaran mengenai kepentingan penjagaan jantung.

Kisah mereka pernah dipaparkan dalam akhbar *Berita Harian*, *Harian Metro* serta *New Straits Times* dan semuanya selamat me-

njalani rawatan dan pembedahan berjumlah RM511,203.26 di pusat perubatan terbabit.

### Nur Ayesha makin pulih

Sementara itu, keadaan Che Nur Ayesha Inara Che Muhammad Azri, 13 bulan yang menjalani pembedahan injap jantung terbalik atau 'transposition great arteries' (TGA) pada November tahun lalu kini bertambah baik.

Menurut ibunya, Syafiqah Walmasri, 24, berkata kesihatan anaknya semakin baik dan mula menunjukkan tanda aktif berbanding keadaan sebelum pembedahan.

Katanya, anaknya lahir normal namun wajahnya kebiruan, tidak mahu minum susu dan hanya mengangis dan doktor menyatakan ia mungkin akibat masalah kuning berpanjangan.

"Namun ketika usianya dua bulan setengah, doktor kata dia ada masalah lain dan minta kami buat pemeriksaan lanjut dan baru tahu

Inara ada masalah jantung.

"Kami sangat bimbang kerana pernah kehilangan bayi yang dilahirkan pramatang dan bertahan hanya dua jam... keadaan Inara ini sangat merustringkan apatah kos pembedahan yang besar.

"Mujur dengan bantuan Tabung Kemanusiaan Media Prima-NSTP, Inara akhirnya dibedah dan dia semakin sihat, cuma doktor nasihatkan supaya orang tidak dibenarkan mencium wajahnya, berada dekat dengan perokok dan pesakit kronik untuk mengelakkan kesihatannya terjejas," katanya.

Bagi ibu Vinveera Rao Veeran, K Manemekhalah 34, anak sulungnya semakin sihat selepas pembedahan ketika usia 14 bulan sekitar 2019.

"Sudah lima tahun usianya dan kami sekeluarga sangat bersyukur dia sembuh dan dia ada seorang adik berusia empat tahun.

"Masa dia dilahirkan, jantungnya berhubung dengan saiz 0.3

sentimeter dan pembedahan dibuat setahun selepas itu dan dia sihat sehingga sekarang dan memerlukan susulan doktor setiap satu atau dua tahun sekali," katanya.

Sejak penubuhan pada 1991, Tabung Kemanusiaan Media Prima-NSTP membantu ramai individu kurang berkemampuan untuk menjalani rawatan perubatan dan pembedahan menyelamatkan nyawa.

Tabung Kemanusiaan Media Prima-NSTP menumpukan usaha menyokong tiga aspek meliputi bantuan perubatan, bantuan bencana dan komuniti yang memerlukan sokongan kewangan.

## Ebit fail saman fitnah Caprice, Mondy

**Kuala Lumpur:** Pendakwah bebas, Ebit Irawan Ibrahim Lew atau Ebit Lew yang terpalit kontroversi berhubung dakwaan gangguan seksual memfailkan saman fitnah terhadap pempengaruh sosial, Caprice dan wanita Indonesia, Mondy.

Ebit Lew menerusi hantaran di laman sosial kelmarin, memberitahu tindakan itu diambil menerusi peguam yang dilantik, Datuk Akberdin Abdul Kader.

"Peguam saya, Datuk Akberdin sudah memfailkan saman fitnah terhadap Caprice dan Mondy di Mahkamah Shah Alam tadi (kelmarin)," tulisnya di Facebook.

Sebelum ini Pengarah Jabatan Siasatan Jenayah Bukit Aman, Datuk Seri Mohd Shuhaily Mohd Zain, berkata 13 akan dipanggil bagi membantu siasatan kes gangguan seksual dan fitnah membabitkan Ebit Lew serta pempengaruh media sosial, The Mondy Tattoo dan Caprice.

Mohd Shuhaily berkata, polis membuka dua kertas siasatan membabitkan Seksyen 376 Kanun Keseksaan atas kesalahan rogol dan Seksyen 500 kanun yang sama atas kesalahan

fitnah.

Katanya, siasatan kes berkenaan sedang diselesaikan berdasarkan dua laporan yang diterima.

"Pengadu Rita Restu Amanda (The Mondy Tattoo) membuat laporan di Shah Alam, berhubung gangguan seksual manakala Ebit membuat laporan selepas dia kembali dari luar negara.

"Sehubungan itu siasatan dijalankan terhadap kedua-dua laporan yang dibuat oleh The Mondy Tattoo dan Ebit Lew," katanya.

Sebelum ini, The Mondy dan Caprice membuat laporan polis berhubung

gangguan seksual yang didakwa dilakukan seorang pendakwa bebas terkenal di negara ini terhadap Mondy.

Ebit Lew atau nama sebenarnya, Ebit Irawan Ibrahim Lew kemudian membuat laporan penafian bersama laporan fitnah di Balai Polis USJ 8, Subang Jaya, kelmarin.

Isnin lalu, polis Subang Jaya mengesahkan menerima laporan Ebit Lew berkaitan satu dakwaan fitnah sekembalinya dari luar negara.

Laporan polis dibuat pada jam 2.17 pagi itu susulan dakwaan pendakwah tersebut difitnah menerusi

satu program bual bicara (podcast) di media sosial.

Pada 11 September lalu, media tempatan melaporkan The Mondy Tattoo mendedahkan cerita sebenar mengenai bantuan Ebit Lew menerusi program podcast khas yang dikendalikan Caprice.

## 'Parents, NGOs can help ministry attract non-Bumis to join armed forces'

**PORT DICKSON:** Defence Minister Datuk Seri Mohamad Hasan said the percentage of non-Bumiputeras in the armed forces, which stands at three per cent, is still low.

He said this should not be as protecting the nation was the responsibility of all people, irrespective of race and religion.

Mohamad called on parents and non-governmental organisations (NGOs) to help the ministry encourage non-Bumiputeras to join the armed forces.

"Despite efforts and programmes, the number of non-Bumiputeras joining the armed forces is still low.

"I do not think the lack of interest among non-Bumiputeras in joining the armed forces is due to salary since the rates are much better now.

"I hope parents and NGOs will help us promote more non-Bu-

miputera communities to join the armed forces, subsequently increasing the percentage to more than 10 per cent," he said after the passing-out parade at the Army Basic Training Centre (Pusasda) here yesterday.

Present were Armed Forces chief General Tan Sri Mohamad Ab Rahman and Army chief General Datuk Muhammad Hafizuddeain Jantan.

Mohamad said the ministry was looking into ways to improve the career development of members of the armed forces, and elevate their wellbeing and livelihood.

"We always provide the opportunity for members of the armed forces to develop themselves through furthering their tertiary education and help them build their careers.

"We have many diploma holders in various fields, and we will

continue to help them progress."

Earlier, Mohamad said 1,013 young soldiers, comprising 661 males and 352 females, completed their basic military training, which started on March 27 and ended yesterday, at Pusasda.

"Generally, the intake of recruits is carried out three times a year.

"However, the intake of female soldiers (for basic military training) is carried out once a year, depending on the vacancies available or the quota that needs to be filled.

"Nevertheless, we hope to see more non-Bumiputeras joining the armed forces."

At the event yesterday, Faddry Izhan Norhan, 21, from Keningau, Sabah, was named the Best Overall Young Soldier and Nur Faraain Md, 21, from Bentong, Pahang, bagged the Best Young Female Soldier award.

# Helping the poor keep their eyesight

**GEORGE TOWN:** One of the earliest signs of ageing will be failing eyesight.

Be it for myopia (near-sightedness), astigmatism (blur vision) or presbyopia (far-sightedness), prescription lenses can cost a bomb to the B40 community.

Unable to afford the expensive lenses that range from RM500 to RM4,000 each, these less fortunate people have a tendency to neglect their vision problems.

Various social organisations have stepped in to help them.

Peace and Harmony Home founder Tan Swee Ban said elderly people in need of aid seldom admit that they have vision issues.

"It takes a lot of coaxing to get them to go for eye checks," he said.

Penang Community Care (PCC) founding president Wendy Ang said the poor needed to save to get a pair of spectacles with multi-focal lenses.

"Several single mothers have approached us for help to get them the corrective spectacles," she said, added that the organisation also arranged for senior citizens to go for eye check-up or undergo treatments at government health institutions.

"We know many who have undergone cataract surgery. For those who only encounter a reading problem, the solution is easy – they just need a pair of reading glasses that costs as low as RM5 each," she added.

A volunteer who only wished to be known as Tan said that he paid special attention to those from underprivileged backgrounds

who are suffering from vision problems. The 63-year-old encountered near- and far-sighted vision issues a few years ago.

"I picked up a pair of ready-made multi-focal glasses for RM1,300 but regretted it soon after. It gave me severe headache.

"Then, an optometrist recommended for me to get prescription lenses that cost RM2,500. It took me some time to save up enough money for it, but I can see clearly now," he smiled.

With his experience, Tan has been actively helping the less fortunate community with vision problems by engaging charitable groups and philanthropists to help them.

Optometrist Edric Tan, 35, said those aged between 40 and 55 formed the largest consumer group for multi-focal lenses.

"Custom-made multi-focal lenses can cost as much as RM4,000, but ordinary sets of between RM500 to RM900 are most popular among the people," he said.

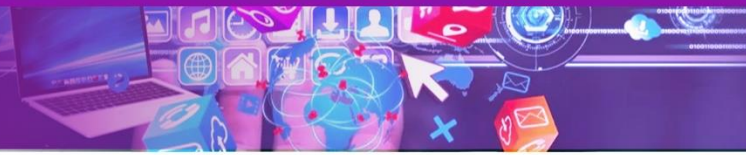
Another optometrist, Thok Chuan Tan, 54, said the pricier lenses are worth it as they offer better optics with less distortion to reduce dizziness and allow a wider field of view.

Lions Clubs International governor for district 308B2 Dr Alan Thoo said almost 1,000 pairs of spectacles have been given out to underprivileged people this year.

About 90% of the recipients were students, he said.

He added that fellow Lions in Selangor also helped the needy to undergo cataract surgery for free since more than 15 years ago.

This year, about 100 people had the surgery.

**SIBU:** Eighteen people from three families were left homeless in the fire that razed three wooden houses at Jalan Kampung Nangka here yesterday morning.

One of the fire victims, Hajjiah Ahmad Nawas when met said the incident happened in the blink of an eye.

"There were four us at home – my two daughters aged six and 11 years and my relative's son who is in his 20s," she said, adding that she was at the lower floor of the two-floor wooden house at the time of the incident.

"I was doing some sewing work when suddenly I heard something dropped. Initially, I thought it was the sound made by a cat, so I did not pay much attention to it," she told thesundaypost.

"Then, there was a smell of something burning, followed by the buzzing sound from the circuit breaker panel. I then decided to check the upper floor of the house, and was too shocked to see thick, black

smoke coming from my sister's room."

The mother of four, whose two elder children were at work at the time of the incident, said the fire was raging fiercely and despite her panicky state, she ran downstairs and grabbed her younger two children to safety.

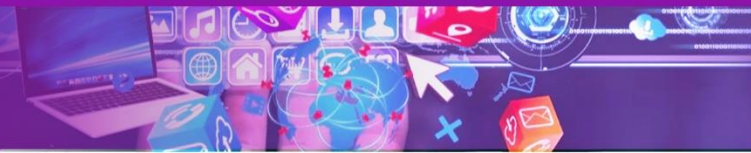
"It all happened so fast that I could not save any of our belongings, including our important documents," she said in between tears.

Meanwhile, Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) Sibu chief Andy Alie said a distress call was received at 10.44am and teams from the Sungai Merah and Sibu Central fire stations were rushed to the scene.

According to Andy, 18 people from three families were left homeless in the incident.

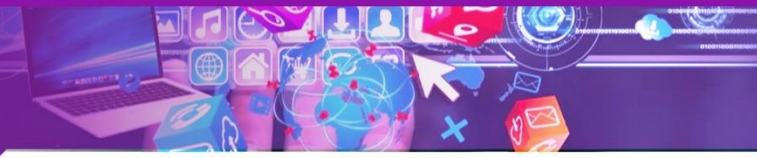

## Nancy: Strategic plans under the Policy on PwD are currently being implemented

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The strategic plans covering 15 areas under the Policy on Persons With Disabilities (PwD) are currently being implemented to ensure that the group has equal rights to opportunities and full participation in the community.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said the areas among others, were related to advocacy, health, rehabilitation, accessibility, education, employment, and research.

“This year, the ministry’s plan includes two studies on PwDs specifically their opportunities in getting employed and support system for PwD caregivers.

“The programme which is expected to start next year will allow the caregivers involved to make their task as a career and no longer a voluntary effort, with the Social Institute of Malaysia as the main agency to help the ministry provide courses and training.”

She said this at the Malaysian Association of the Blind (MAB) 2021/2022 Excellence Achievement Award ceremony here yesterday.

In a speech read by Social

Welfare Department (JKM) PwD Development Division director Zuhami Omar, Nancy said based on JKM data as of July, of the 663,650 PwDs registered in the country, 57,043 were in the visually-impaired category.

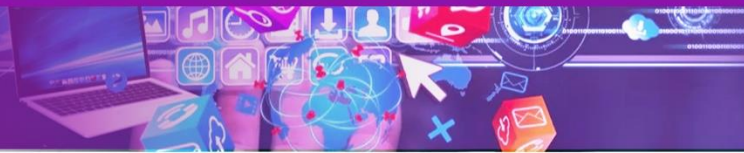
In terms of employment, she said 0.31 per cent or nearly 3,800 PwDs were appointed to various positions in the public service as of end of last year.

This was in line with the policy of hiring one per cent of PwDs in the public sector that was introduced in 1988, outlining the affirmative action must be taken by ministries, agencies, and local authorities to make the move a success.

“At the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry, we have exceeded the one per cent target with 144 (1.77 per cent) out of 8,138 positions filled by PwDs,” he said.

As for students who are visually impaired, Nancy said their number in inclusive schools was low but hoped it would increase in the future.

At the ceremony, 19 PwDs received awards in recognition of their outstanding efforts in the education, entrepreneurship and sports fields.

facilities is needed as most of the patrons who visit public markets are senior citizens who require friendlier facilities to move around,” she told reporters after the walkabout yesterday.

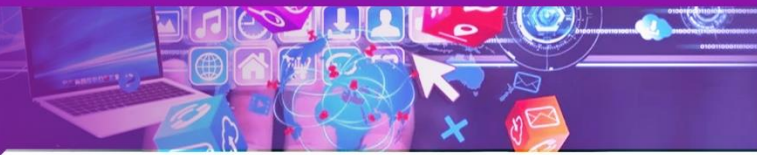

"We also offer those who are interested to learn about our prestigious International Primary Curriculum the chance for their

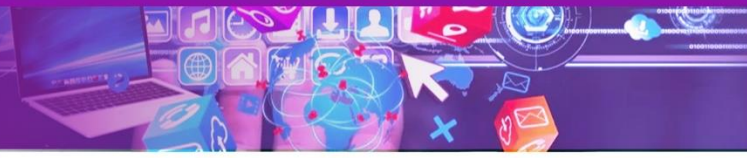
family to join real classes and meet the teachers and students," she said.

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Pelan strategi di bawah Dasar Orang Kurang Upaya (OKU) dalam 15 bidang sedang giat dilaksanakan bagi memastikan golongan itu mendapat kesaksamaan hak dan peluang bagi penyertaan penuh dalam masyarakat.

“Rancangan kementerian saya untuk tahun ini termasuk menjalankan dua kajian mengenai OKU, khususnya mengenai peluang

pekerjaan untuk OKU dan sistem sokongan untuk penjaga OKU.

“Program yang dijangka bermula tahun depan ini akan membolehkan penjaga terbabit menjadikan tugas itu sebagai kerjaya dan bukan lagi sekadar sukarela dengan Institut Sosial Malaysia akan menjadi agensi utama bagi membantu kementerian memberikan kursus dan latihan tersebut,” katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian sempena majlis Anugerah Pencapaian Kecemerlangan Persatuan Orang Buta Malaysia (MAB) 2021/2022, di sini semalam.

Teks ucapan beliau dibacakan oleh Pengarah Jabatan Pembangunan OKU di Jaba-

tan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Zuhami Omar.

Nancy berkata berdasarkan data JKM pada Julai lalu, seramai 663,650 OKU telah berdaftar di negara ini dengan 57,043 daripadanya dalam kategori OKU penglihatan.

Dari segi pekerjaan, beliau berkata terdapat 0.31 peratus atau hampir 3,800 OKU telah dilantik ke pelbagai jawatan dalam perkhidmatan awam sehingga akhir tahun lepas.

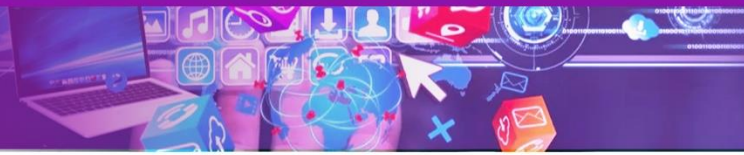
Perkembangan itu selaras dengan dasar pengambilan satu peratus OKU di sektor awam yang diperkenalkan pada 1988, menggariskan tindakan afirmatif yang harus diambil oleh kementerian,

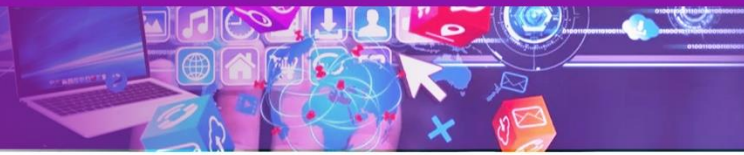
"Apa yang penting, anda bijak dalam memilih koordinasi warna dan menggunakan pakaian atau aksesori yang bersesuaian dengan tempat

Wanita minta  
bantuan selamatkan  
adik, beberapa rakyat  
Malaysia dipaksa  
jadi 'scammer'  
di Myanmar

**SARIKEI:** Seorang wanita membuat laporan polis bagi memohon bantuan menyelamatkan adiknya serta beberapa rakyat Malaysia lain yang dipercayai menjadi mangsa penipuan pekerjaan di Myanmar.

Ketua Polis Daerah Sarikei Superintenden Awang Arfian Awang Bujang berkata, wanita tempatan berusia 34 tahun itu memaklumkan, adiknya berusia 29 tahun telah terkandas dan menjadi mangsa penipuan pekerjaan oleh agensi pekerjaan di Myanmar yang menawarkan gaji lumayan.

"Berdasarkan laporan yang dibuat oleh kakak mangsa, adiknya telah menghubunginya melalui WhatsApp yang memaklumkan dia (adiknya) bersama dengan sepupunya bertumur 35 tahun kini berada di Myanmar.

"Dalam laporan itu, kakak mangsa turut memberitahu mangsa dan sepupunya telah didera oleh majikan mereka dan kadangkala dipaksa untuk makan makanan tidak halal sekiranya gagal mencapai sasaran.

"Mangsa-mangsa tersebut telah dipaksa bekerja sebagai 'scammer' dan jika mereka tidak mencapai sasaran atau tidak produktif, mereka digugat serta didera atau dijual kepada ejen yang lain," katanya dalam kenyataan kepada media kelmarin.

Kata Awang Arfian, laporan tersebut telah diterima daripada kakak mangsa pada jam 12.43 tengah hari, Khamis lalu.

Menurutnya lagi, kesemua mangsa terbabit dipercayai telah terperdaya dengan tawaran kerja yang kononnya menawarkan gaji dan pendapatan lumayan di media sosial.

"Berdasarkan siasatan awal, dipercayai adik mangsa telah pergi ke Thailand pada bulan Julai lalu, manakala sepupunya pada Jun.

"Mangsa telah dibawa ke Myanmar oleh ejen dengan tawaran gaji sebanyak RM3,000 sebulan, namun tidak tahu tentang pekerjaan yang bakal mereka lakukan.

"Pada masa yang sama, pasport dan kad pengenalan mangsa dilaporkan telah diambil dan disimpan oleh majikan mangsa," katanya.

Kini kata Awang Arfian, pihak polis sedang berusaha membawa pulang mangsa menerusi pihak Interpol dan Kedutaan Malaysia.

Justeru katanya, pihak polis menasihatkan orang ramai agar tidak mudah terperdaya dengan tawaran kerja dengan gaji lumayan khususnya di media sosial atau ejen yang tidak dikenali terutama yang melibatkan agensi pekerjaan di luar negara.
