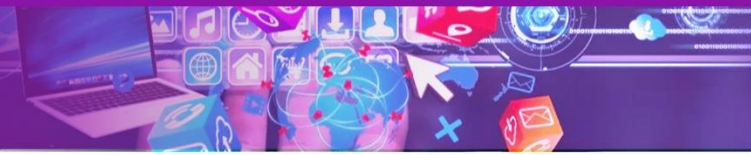

Ipoh: Sepuluh lelaki masing-masing lima warga tempatan dan Indonesia, dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam, atas dakwaan menyeludup seramai 35 migran warga Indonesia termasuk seorang kanak-kanak, bulan lalu.

Tertuduh terdiri daripada Tan Ke Huat, 52; S Ananthan, 48; P A Suresh, 38; Mohd Johan Musa, 38; dan S Sivalingam, serta lima warga Indonesia iaitu Eko Rahmadani, 22; Erfanni, 32; Tuah, 23; Siprianus Nahak Lutan, 36, dan Klau Nofrianus Erick, 34.

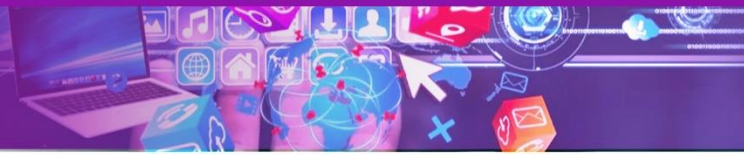
Semua tertuduh yang memahami pertuduhan ketika dibacakan dalam bahasa Melayu, mengaku tidak bersalah dan minta dibicarakan.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan, kesemua mereka secara bersama didakwa melakukan penyeludupan 35 warga Indonesia di kawasan kebun sawit di Batu 10, Segari, dalam daerah Manjung antara 20 hingga 30 Jun lalu.

Oleh itu, mereka melakukan kesalahan yang boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 26A Akta Anti Pernerdagangan Orang dan Anti Penyeludupan Migran (ATIPSOM) 2007 yang dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang jika sabit kesalahan memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan denda atau kedua-duanya.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Afiqah Izzati Mazlan, di hadapan Hakim, Azizah Ahmad, dengan lima daripada tertuduh berkenaan diwakili peguam.

Afiqah Izzati memohon mahkamah memberikan tempoh dua bulan bagi urusan merakam percakapan semua 35 migran yang diseludup.

Bayi mati dipercayai tersedak susu di rumah pengasuh

Ibu mangsa terima panggilan anak sudah tak sedarkan diri

Melaka: Seorang bayi perempuan 11 bulan maut dipercayai tersedak susu ketika dalam jagaan pengasuhnya di Rumah Awam Ayer Molek, di sini, kelmarin.

Ibu mangsa yang hanya mahu dikenali sebagai Zaidah, 35, berkata dia dihubungi pengasuh

sekitar jam 11 pagi memaklumkan anaknya tidak sedarkan diri dengan badan kebiru-biruan.

Menurutnya, anaknya itu dijaga pengasuh sejak berusia empat bulan.

"Saya hantar anak ke rumah pengasuh kira-kira jam 7.30 pagi sebelum pergi bekerja di Sungai Udang, manakala suami kerja di Pulau Gadong.

"Sekitar jam 11 pagi pagi pengasuh telefon beritahu anak saya tidak sedarkan diri dan tubuhnya sudah kebiru-biruan mungkin sebab tersedak susu.

"Saya memintanya segera bawa anak ke klinik berhampiran sementara saya bergegas ke sana," katanya ketika ditemui pemberita di rumah keluarganya di Kampung Titian Bintangor, Alor Ga-

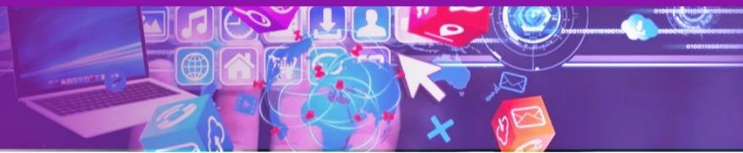
jah, malam kelmarin.

Tunggu laporan bedah siasat Zaidah yang tinggal di Taman Desa Ayer Molek berkata, setakat ini pihak hospital belum mengesahkan punca kematian anaknya kerana perlu menunggu laporan lengkap bedah siasat.

Terdahulu, jenazah anaknya dikuburkan di tanah perkuburan kampung berkenaan kira-kira jam 10.30 malam.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Melaka Tengah, Asisten Komisioner Christopher Patit ketika dihubungi mengesahkan kejadian itu.

Katanya, setakat ini kes diklasifikasikan sebagai mati mengejut sementara menunggu laporan penuh bedah siasat.

Pekerja restoran ulang-alik 300km rogol remaja 14 tahun

Muar: Seorang lelaki sanggup berulang-alik sejauh hampir 300 kilometer semata-mata mahu melakukan perbuatan teruk terhadap remaja sebelum ditahan kelmarin.

Suspek berusia 22 tahun bekerja di sebuah restoran makanan segera dilaporkan menunggang motosikal dari Kuala Pilah, Negeri Sembilan ke Bukit Kepong, dekat sini sebelum merogol kenalannya di belakang sebuah rumah.

Difahamkan, kejadian berlaku sejak Mac lalu apabila suspek dikatakan membuat temu janji dengan mangsa berusia 14 tahun sebelum mereka bertemu untuk melakukan perbuatan itu dalam kebun sawit.

Kejadian itu bagaimanapun terbongkar apabila abang mangsa hairan adiknya kerap 'hilang' setiap jam 1.30 pagi.

Ketua Polis Daerah Muar Asisten Komisioner Raiz Mukhliz Azman Aziz, berkata abang mangsa kemudian menyiasat sebelum mengetahui

adiknya melakukan hubungan seks dengan suspek.

Katanya, susulan itu satu laporan polis dibuat di Balai Polis Bukit Kepong kelmarin berhubung kejadian itu.

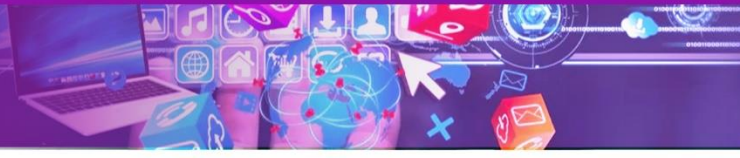
"Siasatan awal mendapati kejadian itu berlaku sejak Mac lalu dan kali terakhir bulan lalu.

"Daripada maklumat diterima suspek akan menghubungi mangsa terlebih dahulu sebelum mereka berjumpa di kebun sawit belakang rumahnya," katanya.

Raiz Mukhliz berkata, bertindak atas laporan dibuat, suspek ditahan untuk membantu siasatan.

Sementara itu, Mahkamah Majistret mengeluarkan perintah reman seminggu terhadap suspek bermula hari ini.

Perintah reman dikeluarkan Majistret Fatimah Dalilah Khalid bagi membolehkan siasatan dijalankan mengikut Seksyen 376 Kanun Keseksan kerana merogol.

Kuala Lumpur: Seorang pereka grafik didakwa di Mahkamah Majistret, di sini, semalam, atas tuduhan menyebabkan kematian teman wanita di sebuah kondominium, dua minggu lalu.

Bagaimanapun, tiada pengakuan direkodkan daripada tertuduh, Sean Edward Kenneth Quinn, 30, sejourus pertuduhan dikemukakan terhadapnya di hadapan Majistret, Nurul Izzah Shahrudin.

Ia berikutan kes bunuh berada di bawah bidang kuasa Mahkamah Tinggi.

Mengikut pertuduhan, Sean Edward yang juga berdarah kacukan Kanada melakukan kesalahan menyebabkan kematian Nurin Najmina Mohd Redzuan, 24, di sebuah kondominium di Jalan Damansara, Bukit Kiara, jam 3 pagi, 12 Julai lalu.

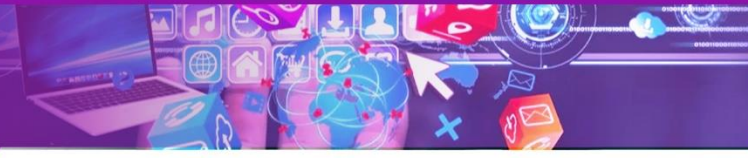
Pendakwaan mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan yang

membawa kepada hukuman mati jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Sean Edward diwakili peguam, Vivek Sukumaran, manakala pendakwaan dikendalikan, Sareeka Balakrishnan.

Majistret kemudian menetapkan 25 September ini untuk sebutan semula kes.

Difahamkan, berlaku pergaduhan antara tertuduh dan mangsa sebelum insiden kematian berkenaan.

Rumah Bonda yang memfailkan permohonan itu menerusi pengerusinya, Siti Bainun Ahd

Razali, antara lain mendakwa Tindakan Notis Lak dikeluarkan JKM pada 9 Julai 2021 dan pelaksanaan tindakan itu pada 12 Julai dipengaruhi desakan masyarakat susulan laporan media mengenai dakwaan berlaku penderaan terhadap remaja berumur 13 tahun dikenali sebagai Bella di premis berkenaan.

Kamaludin dalam keputusannya, berkata panel sebulat suara bersetuju ada merit dalam rayuan Rumah Bonda dan semakan kehakiman berkenaan perlu dibicarakan secara substantif di Mahkamah Tinggi.

"Kebenaran diberikan kepada perayu (untuk memulakan pro-

siding semakan kehakiman) dan keputusan Mahkamah Tinggi diketepikan," katanya.

Panel itu tidak membuat sebarang perintah berhubung kos.

Melalui permohonan difailkan pada 13 Ogos 2021 itu, Rumah Bonda mendakwa, kedua-dua responden bertindak sedemikian sebagai suatu reaksi terburu-buru selepas desakan masyarakat menuntut JKM dan kerajaan mengambil tindakan tegas ke atas penderaan terbabit, sedangkan remaja berkenaan tiada kaitan dan bukan penghuni rumah itu.

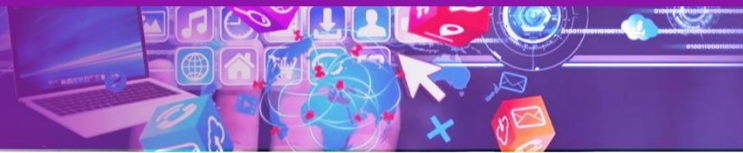
Menurut rumah kebajikan itu, remaja terbabit sebaliknya anak jagaan Siti Bainun yang diperintahkan Mahkamah Kanak-Kanak Kuala Lumpur pada 14 Julai 2021 kepada Siti Bainun atas kapasiti peribadi sebagai rang Yang Layak dan Sesuai.

Terdahulu, Asiah berhujah bahawa Rumah Bonda didaftarkan sejak awal 2019 dan borang serta surat sokongan yang ditandatangani oleh kedua-dua responden sudah dihantar kepada JKM Wilayah Persekutuan.

Beliau berkata, jabatan bomba meluluskan premis itu dan Jabatan Kesihatan dan Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur menetapkan tarikh untuk membuat pemeriksaan, bagaimanapun COVID-19 menyukarkan dua agensi itu membuat pemeriksaan.

Katanya, premis itu disita dan tindakan lak dibuat secara terburu-buru selepas lima hari kes Bella tular di media sosial.

Sementara itu, Nur Idayu berhujah, dakwaan kes itu membatikan kepentingan awam adalah tidak benar kerana tindakan lak dilakukan selepas rumah berkenaan tidak berdaftar dengan JKM Wilayah Persekutuan dan beroperasi secara haram.

Mereka boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 26A Akta Anti Permerdagangan Orang dan Anti Penyeludupan Migran (ATIPSOM) 2007 yang dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksaan yang jika sabit kesalahan memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan denda atau kedua-duanya.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Afiqah Izzati Mazlan di hadapan Hakim, Azizah Ahmad, dengan lima daripada tertuduh berkenaan diwaki-

li peguam.

Afiqah Izzati memohon mahkamah memberikan tempoh dua bulan bagi merakam percakapan semua 35 migran yang diseludup.

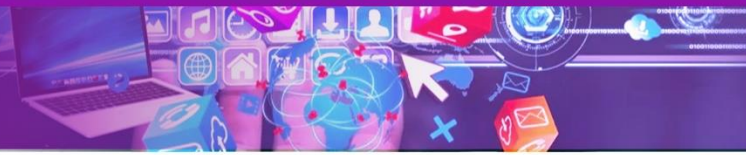

Katanya, susulan itu satu laporan polis dibuat di Balai Polis Bukit Kepong Ahad lalu berhubung kejadian itu.

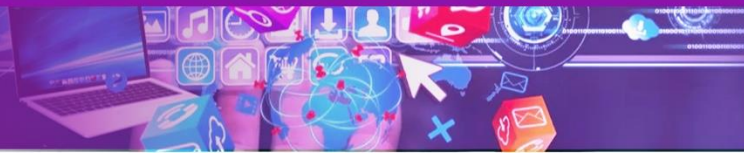

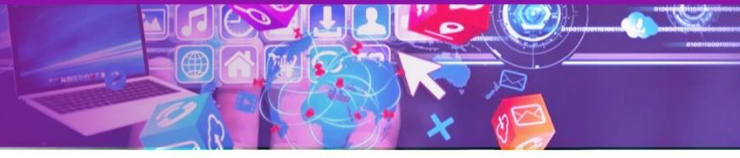

Saksi kelima berusia 45 tahun itu mendedahkan dia yakin anaknya tidak terbabit dalam aktiviti hubungan sejenis, sebaliknya dipaksa oleh tertuduh atau nama sebenarnya Azman Syah Alias, 42.

Dalam keterangan di hadapan Hakim Datin Surita Budin, wanita itu mendakwa anak lelakinya yang kini berusia 18 tahun memberitahu dicabul PU Azman ketika berbual di dapur rumah mereka di Klang, Selangor antara 21 Ogos hingga 29 Ogos 2022.

"Dia (anak) lelaki normal, saya tahu anak bukan macam itu (songsang). Dia cakap PU Azman pegang-pegang, tetapi dia tidak kata pegang di mana, mungkin dia segan nak cakap (dengan saya).

"Saya terkejut dan tergamam bila dapat berita ini, anak kata jangan beritahu ayah sebab dia tahu ayahnya tegas," katanya.

Menurutnya, dalam tempoh seminggu itu, anaknya mendapat cuti sakit dan hanya berada di rumah selepas terbabit dalam kemalangan motosikal.

Katanya, dia yakin anak kedua daripada lima beradik itu tidak menipu dalam kes amang seksual PU Azman walaupun hanya mengenali penceramah itu di televisyen.

Ketika disoal oleh peguam yang mewakili PU Azman, Fahmi Adilah bahawa adakah dia mengetahui anaknya pernah meminta wang daripada tertuduh.

Wanita itu menjawab tidak tahu, namun satu transaksi wang berjumlah

Ibu yakin anak tidak songsang

RM200 pernah dimasukkan ke dalam akaun banknya daripada pengirim bernama Azman Syah pada 27 Ogos 2022 dengan rujukan rawatan kemalangan.

"Masa itu saya tidak tahu nama sebenar PU Azman adalah Azman Syah Alias. Anak hanya minta nombor akaun bank kerana nak pulangkan duit sebab tersalah buat pesanan.

"Saya pun tidak tanya lanjut, anak kata kawan yang masukkan duit, selepas 2 September 2022 baru saya tahu nama sebenar PU Azman daripada pegawai polis," katanya.

Terdahulu, tertuduh yang turut dikenali dengan nama Cik Man tiba di Kompleks Mahkamah Seremban, di sini, kira-kira jam 9.30 pagi dengan memakai baju berwarna hijau serta berkopiah.

Dalam pada itu, saksi keenam berusia 20 tahun yang juga kenalan kepada seorang mangsa dilihat kurang selesa ketika memberi keterangan berikutan kehadiran PU Azman dalam kandang tertuduh.

Lelaki itu memaklumkan dia menjadi mangsa seksual tertuduh dan mengetahui seorang rakannya turut menjadi mangsa selepas bertanya sendiri bagi mendapatkan kesahihan.

"Saya yang tanya pada dia (mangsa lain) sebab dia rapat dengan Cik Man, selepas saya sendiri kena gangguan seksual.

"Kejadiannya itu berlaku di rumah saya di Klang pada 10 Jun 2022,

masa itu ada ibu, adik, saya, dia (mangsa lain) dan Cik Man," katanya.

Mahkamah kemudian memutuskan prosiding perbicaraan dijalankan secara tertutup selepas saksi keenam itu dilihat tidak selesa yang mana tertuduh diperintahkan duduk di bahagian belakang (kerusi orang awam) dan dihadang dengan tirai.

Pendakwaan kes dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nurul Balkis Zunaidi, Husni Fairoz Ramly dan Goh Hsiao Tung manakala tertuduh diwakili peguam Mohamad Zahid Ahmad, Fahmi Adilah dan Norman Mohd Nasir.

Seramai 26 saksi dijangka dipanggil sepanjang perbicaraan ini yang bermula kelmarin hingga 28 Julai depan.

Pada 12 Oktober 2022, PU Azman didakwa atas lima pertuduhan melakukan amang seksual fizikal terhadap dua remaja lelaki pada Februari dan Julai tahun lalu.

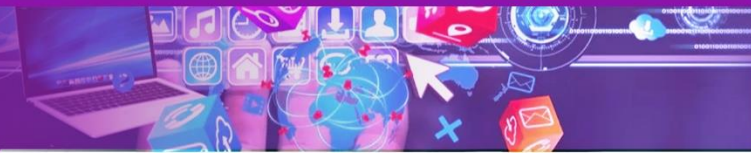

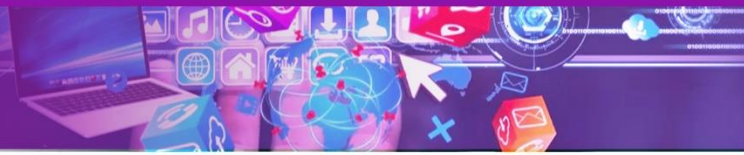
berjumlah RM116,000. Ia bagi tebusan emas kononnya dari kedai pajak gadai dan pembelian emas daripada pelanggan.

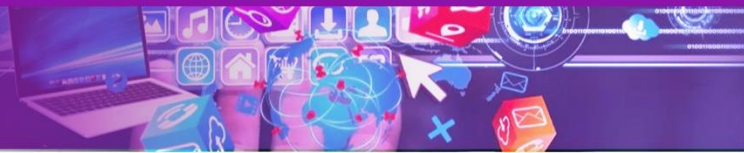

Seorang bayi perempuan berusia 11 bulan maut selepas dipercayai tersedak susu ketika dalam jagaan pengasuhnya di Ayer Molek di sini, kelmarin.

Ibu mangsa yang mahu dikenali sebagai Zaidah, 35, dari Taman Desa Ayer Molek di sini, berkata dia dihubungi pengasuh kira-kira jam 11 pagi memaklumkan keadaan anaknya tidak sedarkan diri dan badan kebiru-biruan.

Menurutnya, anaknya di-

jaga oleh pengasuh terbabit sejak berusia empat bulan berikutan dia dan suami bekerja.

Zaidah yang tinggal di Taman Desa Ayer Molek berkata, setakat ini pihak hospital belum mengesahkan punca kematian anaknya kerana perlu menunggu laporan lengkap bedah siasat.

Terdahulu, jenazah anaknya dikebumikan di tanah perkuburan kampung berkenaan kira-kira jam 10.30 malam kelmarin dengan dihadiri ahli keluarga terdekat.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Melaka Tengah, Asisten Komisioner Christopher Patit berkata, pihaknya masih menjalankan siasatan dan menunggu laporan penuh bedah siasat bayi perempuan terbabit.

KUALA LUMPUR: Yet another stalking incident has come to light, this time in Serdang, Selangor.

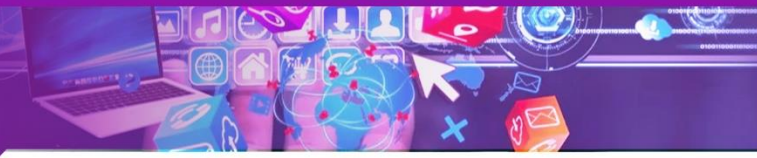

'Clear sexual harassment policy a must in every workplace'

KUCHING: Every workplace must have a clear policy stressing that no form of sexual harassment would be tolerated, said Minister for Women, Early Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

She added that there must also be a system in place at the in workplace for reporting and investigating cases of sexual harassment, and for a range of actions that could be taken against the perpetrators.

The minister stressed that any probe launched must be conducted fairly, and confidentiality to be accorded to both the accuser and the accused, adding that there should be no party seeking retribution on anyone.

According to her, in most abuse cases, the person reporting it is likely to be in a position of less

power than the accused.

"Policy is a start, not an end. All employers need to know about it – not just those in their posts when it is launched, but also those who join the company afterwards.

"It (policy) also needs to be known by the sub-contractors and members of the public who have dealings with the company.

"The workplace is not just a building where the employees sit in," she said when officiating at the 'Zero Tolerance for Sexual Harassment' programme at Sarawak Energy Bd (SEB) Tower here yesterday.

Fatimah also reminded all about sexual harassment being a serious matter regardless of where it took place – be it at the workplace, on the street or within one's social and family networks.

She said when sexual harassment 'is hidden, ignored, tolerated or even in some settings,

it is part of the work culture, the firm is hurting itself as well as its employees'.

"Those staff members who are being targeted will be hurting, and it will cause their productivity and loyalty to the firm to drop. It will add to staff turnover and those remaining will be fearful, upset and angry.

"When the public learn about the sexual harassment, the firms that have been found wanting in taking action will be headline news for all the wrong reasons," she added.

Adding on, Fatimah commended the SEB for taking steps to raise awareness of sexual harassment to ensure that every staff member would be equipped with the necessary knowledge to address and combat this serious issue.

"There may be a lot of things to think through and put in place,

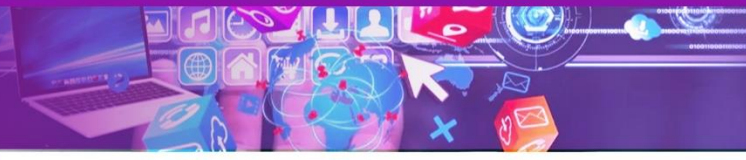
but I am confident that SEB has the commitment towards achieving its goal.

"I am so proud of Sarawak Energy – you are facing these challenges and acting by launching your programme today. I am confident you will be a role model within the corporate sector."

According to Fatimah, Malaysia's Anti-Sexual Harassment Act 2022 also requires companies, like SEB, to actively educate their employees about and raise their awareness of sexual harassment by displaying relevant posters and materials.

"Furthermore, any company that fails to act against incidents of sexual harassment at the workplace could be fined up to RM50,000 per incident."

SEB group chief executive officer Datu Sharbini Suhaili was also present at the session.

Betong housewife loses RM116,000 to gold scam

KUCHING: A housewife in her early 30s from Betong has lost RM116,000 in a gold scam.

Sarawak police commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri said in a statement the victim had advertised for a dropship agent on Facebook.

"On June 27, 2023, a woman (suspect) contacted the victim via WhatsApp expressing interest in becoming a dropship agent to find customers interested in selling pawned gold or gold items at pawnshops.

"The victim, using financial assistance from her friend, then made 20 payment transactions to the suspect's bank account between July 1, 2023 and July 8, 2023 amounting to RM116,000," he said.

Mohd Azman explained that these transactions were purportedly for redeeming gold

On June 27, 2023, a woman (suspect) contacted the victim via WhatsApp expressing interest in becoming a dropship agent to find customers interested in selling pawned gold or gold items at pawnshops.

from pawnshops and purchasing gold from the suspect's customers.

"On July 11, 2023, the suspect sent a parcel weighing 347.78 grams, said to contain gold, to the victim via an express bus from Miri to Kuching.

"The victim had the gold item inspected at her friend's gold shop in Kuching, only to find out that it was fake gold," he said.

The victim only realised she

had been deceived when she requested for her money back but was told by the suspect it could not be returned as it had been used for other matters.

Feeling dissatisfied, the victim lodged a police report.

The public are advised not to engage with unknown individuals offering gold sales.

Victims of cyber scams such as phone scams, love scams, e-commerce scams, non-existent loans, and others can contact the

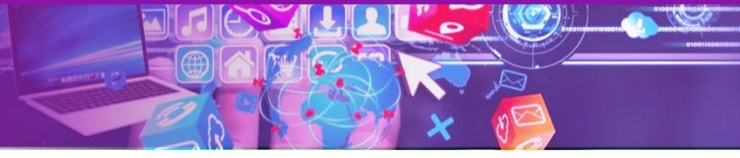
National Scam Response Centre (NSRC) on 997.

Those who have just made a money transfer to a suspect's bank account or e-wallet are encouraged to report it immediately.

The public can also download the Whoscall application from the Google Play or Apple App Store to screen incoming calls.

Cops thwart gangs' migrant-smuggling attempts

PADANG BESAR: Police have arrested two main suspects, aged 39 and 41, believed to be the masterminds of the Bang Sun and Along Lubuk syndicates involved in the smuggling of illegal immigrants into the country.

Padang Besar police chief ACP Mohd Shokri Abdullah said police arrested a manual labourer believed to be the main suspect from the Bang Sun Gang in Kubang Geruh, Titi Tinggi at 11pm last Friday.

"The suspect was travelling in a Honda Civic car and police inspection found a foreign man hidden in the car boot," he told reporters here yesterday.

He said police also stopped a Proton Persona car but the suspect fled.

"Eight foreign men who were in the front and back seats of the car were detained," he said.

Mohd Shokri said a separate raid conducted on July 24 led to the arrest of two local suspects – a 39-year-old main suspect and a 45-year-old guide – around Padang Besar.

He said the arrest was a follow-up to the police's success in arresting five foreigners along with a local at the Wang Kelian Viewpoint route a day earlier.

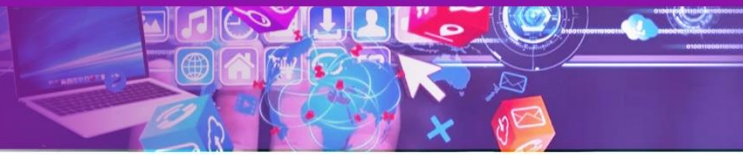
He said the syndicate was known as Along Lubuk Gang, and the main suspect was a masseuse who had been involved in ketum smuggling activities.

"The investigation found that the two syndicates charged between RM7,000 and RM12,000 per person," he said.

He said the four suspects were remanded for 28 days, while all the illegal immigrants were detained for 14 days for further investigation.

The case was investigated under Section 26A of the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Anti-Smuggling of Migrants Act 2007, and Section 6(1)(c) of the Immigration Act 1959/63.

Mohd Shukri said as of Monday, Padang Besar police have managed to arrest 66 illegal immigrants from various nationalities at the Malaysia-Thailand border this year. — Bernama

Inflammable substances found in suspected IED, says deputy IGP

KUALA LUMPUR: Initial analysis report by the bomb unit found there were combustible substances in the two plastic bottles believed to be an improvised explosive device (IED) discovered in the rear tyre of lawyer and social activist Siti Kasim here last Friday.

Deputy Inspector-General of Police Datuk Seri Ayob Khan Mydin Pitchay said police however are still awaiting the full report on the explosive materials found.

"The distance the bomb could explode is also being investigated...making this bomb is not difficult as it could be learned from the internet," he told a media conference in Bukit Aman here yesterday.

Earlier, Ayob Khan handed over the World Police & Fire Games Winnipeg 2023 flag to Sarawak police commissioner Datuk Mohd Azman Ahmad Sapri. The ceremony was witnessed by Bukit Aman Management Department director Datuk Azmi Abu Kassim.

He said the case is now being investigated under Section 7 of the Explosives Act and so far police had taken statements from 12 individuals among them the workshop employees and owner, security guards, court and Malaysia Volunteers Corp Department personnel and members of the Orang Asli community.

Ayob Khan said police are also checking the closed-circuit television recording in places involving the lawyer.

"Police will investigate from the overall aspect including suspects using IEDs for revenge,"



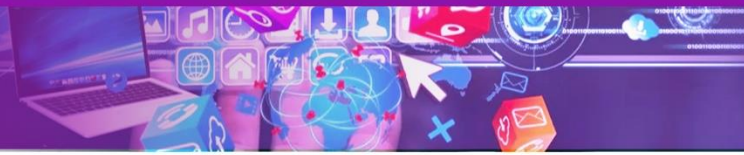
A screengrab of a video by Siti Kasim and shared on Facebook of the suspected IED when it was discovered last week.

he said.

He said before this there were no reports of criminal threats on Siti Kasim received by police.

On Monday, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain was reported as saying that police did not rule out the possibility that the suspects who set up the two bottles believed to be IED at the back of Siti Kasim's car learned the technique to make the device from internet.

Last Friday, two bottles which appeared to be explosives were found in the brake section of the rear tyre of the Toyota Celica owned by Siti Kasim when the car was sent to a service centre in Jalan Maarof, Bangsar. — Bernama

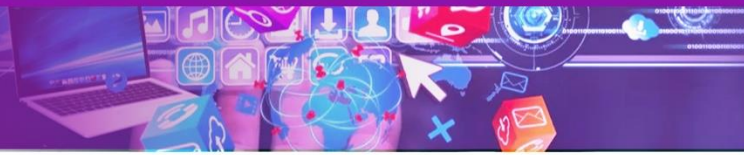

Pos Tohoi tragedy: Govt to pay RM1.2 mln to children's families

KUALA LUMPUR: The government is to pay RM1.2 million as a full settlement in negligence suits filed by the Orang Asli families over seven children who went missing from a school hostel in Pos Tohoi, Gua Musang, Kelantan, eight years ago.

Based on the settlement terms recorded before Kota Bharu High Court Judge Datuk Mohamad Abazafree Mohd Abbas Monday, both parties reached an agreement that the defendant (government) is to pay RM1.2 million and costs of RM60,000 as a full and final settlement for the case.

The full and final settlement of the case is also without any acknowledgement of liability from all defendants.

In addition, the third party (the insurance company) agreed to pay RM150,000 including costs as a full and final settlement for all the cases.

Lawyer and activist Siti Kassim, who was supposed to appear as the first witness in the trial when contacted said the settlement was agreed upon after discussions between government representatives and the families' lawyers outside of court just before the trial.

In 2018, the plaintiffs filed the suit against nine defendants for breach of constitutional duty, statutory duty and fiduciary duty, causing the seven Orang Asli children of Sekolah Rendah Pos Tohoi in Gua Musang to go missing from their hostel for 47

days.

They named the government of Malaysia, the Minister of Education, the Director General of Education, the headmaster of the school, the hostel warden, the Minister of Rural Development, the Director General for Orang Asli Development, the Inspector-General of Police and Gua Musang Police District Chief as defendants.

The seven victims, comprising six girls and a boy, escaped from the school's hostel on Aug 23, 2018, for fear of punishment after going for a swim in a river without permission.

Of the seven, only Norieen Yaakob, then 11, and Miksudiar Aluj, then 12, survived after getting lost in the nearby jungle for 47 days.

Norieen's younger brother,

Haikal, eight; Ika Ayel, nine; Juvina David, seven; Linda Rosli, eight, were found dead in the jungle, while Sasa Sobrie, also eight, was not found.

The plaintiffs were represented by several lawyers among others Datuk Gurdial Singh Nijar, Andrew Yeap and Tan Hooi Ping while Senior Federal Counsel Andi Razalijaya A. Dadi acted for all defendants. — Bernama

Senior citizen jailed for sexual assault on neighbour's granddaughter

PUTRAJAYA: A senior citizen was sent to jail for a year for committing physical sexual assault on his neighbour's five-year-old granddaughter four years ago.

This followed a decision by the Court of Appeal's three-member panel comprising Justices Datuk Vazeer Alam Mydin Meera, Datuk M. Gunalan and Datuk S.M. Komathy Suppiah yesterday in allowing the prosecution's appeal to reinstate the Kangar Sessions Court decision which found Harun Dahman guilty of the offence.

The 78-year-old former rubber tapper will also receive one stroke of the cane and to be placed under police supervision for two years after his release from prison.

The court ordered Harun to begin his sentence yesterday.

In delivering the court's decision, Justice Vazeer said the prosecution's appeal had merits.

In reinstating the Kangar Sessions Court's decision, Justice Vazeer set aside the decision of the Kangar High Court in acquitting and discharging Harun of the offence.

He ruled that the High Court judge failed to apply the correct principles when he overturned the Sessions Court's decision.

"We are of the view that the High Court judge erred when he interfered with the decision and findings of fact made by the Sessions Court judge who

had heard the evidence given by witnesses, particularly the victim and the appellant (Harun)," he said, adding that the Sessions Court's decision and findings of fact were not plainly wrong.

According to the charge, Harun had sexually assaulted the girl, who was then five-year-old, in a house in Arau district, Perlis, at 6.30 pm on Feb 15, 2019.

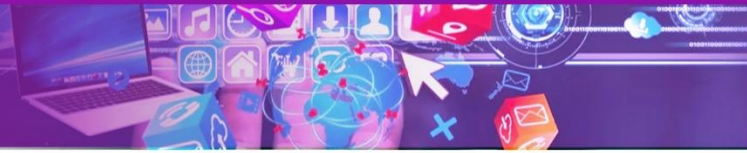
The charge was framed under Section 14(a) of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017.

On Nov 6, 2020, Sessions Court judge Ainul Shahrin Mohamad found Harun guilty and sentenced him to a year's jail. She also ordered Harun to be given one stroke of the cane and ordered him to be under police supervision for two years after he completed his jail sentence.

Harun then appealed to the High Court and on Feb 17 last year, High Court judge Dr Arik Sanusi Yeop Johari (now Judicial Commissioner) overturned the Session Court's decision and acquitted Harun. This prompted the prosecution to appeal to the Court of Appeal.

According to the facts of the case, a neighbour saw Harun entering his house followed by the girl and he then closed the door of the house.

Deputy public prosecutor Tetralina Ahmed Fauzi appeared for the prosecution while lawyer Norharniza Rusli represented Harun. — Bernama

Ten charged with smuggling 35 migrants

IPOH: Ten men, including five Indonesians, were charged in the Sessions Court here yesterday with smuggling in migrants last month.

They are five local men, namely, Tan Ke Huat, 52; S. Ananthan, 48; S. Sivalingam, 47; P. A. Suresh, 38, and Mohd Johan Musa, 38, while the other five men are Indonesians - Eko Rahmadani, 22; Tuah, 23; Erfanni, 32; Klau Nofrianus Erick, 34, and Siprianus Nahak Lutan, 36.

All of them pleaded not guilty when the charges were read simultaneously, before Judge Azizah Ahmad.

According to the charge sheet, they were charged together with a common intention of having smuggled in 35 Indonesian migrants, at the Batu 10 oil palm plantation area in Segari, Manjung, between June 20 and 30, this year.

The charges are framed under Section 26A of the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Anti-Smuggling of Migrants Act 2007, read together with Section 34 of the Penal Code, which provides for a prison sentence of not more than 20 years and a fine, or both, if convicted.

Deputy public prosecutor, Afiqah Izzati Mazlan, appeared for the prosecution, while lawyer Mohamad Khazali Yin represented Eko Rahmadani; lawyer Raja Segaran represented Tan, Suresh and Sivalingam while lawyer Kashvinder Singh represented Ananthan; the other five accused were unrepresented.

Afiqah Izzati requested a period of two months to record the statements of all 35 migrants at the Manjung magistrates' court and to file the case at the High Court.

The three lawyers requested that bail be allowed for their clients, but no bail money was offered as it is not under the purview of the Sessions Court to hear bail applications in the case.

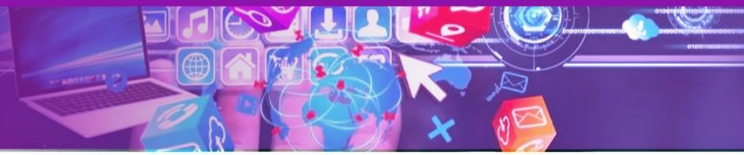
The court then set Sept 25 for the case to be transferred to the High Court.

On June 30, the media reported that 35 illegal immigrants, who hid in palm oil plantations when they first landed on the coast of Segari, Manjung, were arrested after the police received information about a boat stranded on the coast, which was said to be boarded by foreigners.

The search of the oil palm plantation found a group of illegal immigrants hiding, consisting of 24 men, 10 women and a child before the police arrested two local men at a seafood restaurant near Kampung Bharu, Manjung. — Bernama

She said her husband works at Pulau Gadong.

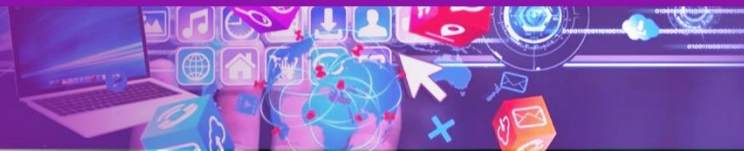
"I asked the babysitter to rush my child to a nearby public clinic before I rushed there.

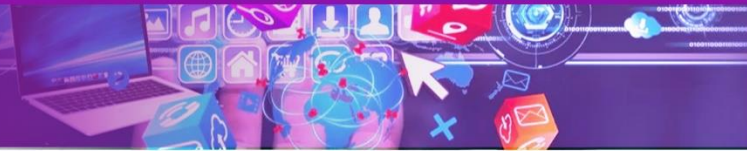

She said the officer would already have an idea of their medical condition as they had submitted their reports upon registering.

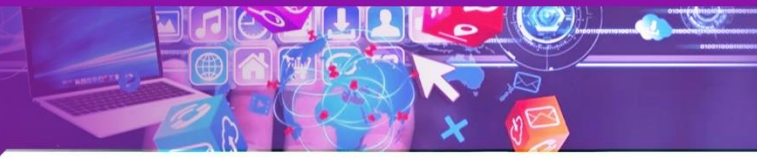
"We hope action can be taken to rectify the situation so that such matters would not recur," Fatimah said.

Ten men claim trial to human trafficking

IPOH: Ten men, including five Indonesians, claimed trial in the Sessions Court here after being jointly charged with human trafficking.

The accused, aged between 22 and 52 years old, are said to have smuggled 35 Indonesian migrants at an oil palm estate in Batu 10, Segari, Manjung, between June 20 and 30.

Tan Ke Huat, S. Ananthan, PA Suresh, S. Sivalingam, Mohd Johan Musa, Eko Rahmadani, Erfanni, Tuah, Siprianus Nahak Lutan and Klau Norfrianus Erick are facing charges under Section 26A of the Anti-Trafficking in Persons and Anti-Smuggling of Migrant Act 2007.

The offence carries a maximum jail term of 20 years, a fine or both, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Afiqah Izzati Mazlan requested for a period of two months to get statements from the migrants and

to transfer the case to the High Court.

Lawyer Kashvinder Singh, who

represented Ananthan, asked the court to grant bail to his client.

"We hope the court can use its

"His health has deteriorated and his family had to bring medicine to him," he added.

Mohamad Khazali Yin, who represented Eko Rahmadani, said his client is married to a local and has a family.

"We have no issues in getting two sureties and any conditions set if allowed bail," he said.

Tan, Suresh and Sivalingam were represented by R. Rajasegaran.

Judge Azizah Ahmad said the court has no jurisdiction to hear the accused's requests for bail.

She also allowed a period of two months for management of the case and to record statements from the migrants.

The court set Sept 25 for mention.

84 foreign women held in raid

KUALA LUMPUR: Police on Sunday arrested 84 foreign women suspected of working as guest relation officers (GRO) at an unlicensed entertainment centre in Bukit Bintang.

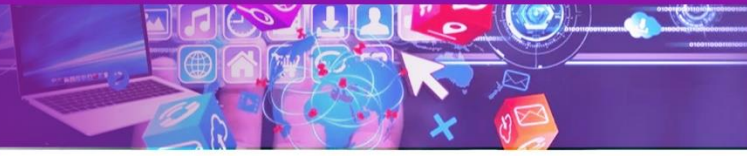
The women, aged 18 to 46, were detained in a 1am raid conducted by the Crime Prevention Unit, D7 Division of the Bukit Aman Criminal Investigation Department.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain said nine other individuals, including the centre's manager and employees, aged between 31 and 45, were also arrested.

He said they checked 22 local GRO, 46 employees and 336 customers, with six testing positive for methamphetamine and ketamine abuse.

"We seized sales receipts, GRO employee receipts, liquor, a mobile phone, two video recorders, two microphones and RM14,862 in cash during the raid," he said in a statement yesterday.

Razarudin said the centre has a karaoke bar concept that offers 17 karaoke rooms with charges of between RM3,800 and RM25,000, apart from providing foreign and local GRO upon request. - Bernama

Risks of elderly living alone

○ Prompted by choice to be independent, such lifestyle isolates individuals from access to help in emergencies

PETALING JAYA: The public has been urged to keep an eye on senior citizens who live alone, after several cases of them being found dead in their houses were reported this year.

In two of the latest cases, a senior citizen was found dead in his house in Taman Suria, Johor Baru on May 10 while on June 27, an elderly woman was found dead in a house in Taman Sri Gombak, Selangor.

Third Age Media Association founding president Cheah Tuck Wing said senior citizens choose to live alone mainly because they value their independence and do not wish to burden their children, while some were forced to do so as their children had moved abroad.

Third Age Media is a non-profit organisation that engages a variety of media channels to make information available for the elderly in Malaysia.

The Statistics Department said senior citizens are expected to account for 15.3% of the population by 2030.

"But this might not be correct and the figure is most likely to be about 16% or slightly higher," Cheah said, adding that living alone and not socialising is why deaths involving such individuals are usually not discovered for several days.

A survey in 2018 estimated that 7.4% of the elderly live alone.

"Local community centres play an important role in helping the elderly to make friends and keep themselves busy. They exercise, have coffee and go shopping together. This can be described as 'seniors looking after seniors'.

"When a person fails to turn for an activity, his friends would be the first to know. They can contact him to ascertain if all is well, or alert the authorities if they suspect something amiss."

Cheah said a friend of his who lived alone died recently. However, since he hardly socialised, no one knew about his death for some time.

He suggested the government step in and help fund and maintain community centres where people could socialise, adding that such a move would be a good initiative as the

government would not be able to take on the full responsibility of looking after senior citizens.

"With the existence of community centres, senior citizens can help each other. Exercise also plays an important part in keeping senior citizens healthier."

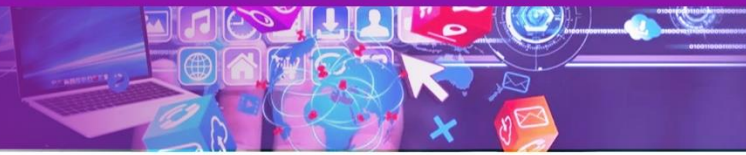
He said installing anti-slip floor tiles and handrails in bathrooms and other senior citizen-friendly equipment in a house would prevent falls. An emergency button in a home would also help as people living nearby could be alerted if help is needed.

Former Kuala Lumpur Hospital director Datuk Dr Zaininah Mohd Zain said: "There is no magic wand to handle an ageing population. Different countries and cultures will have different approaches."

On providing help to the elderly to ensure they are missed if they were to "suddenly disappear", Zaininah said isolation impacts all demographics of the population, leading to a rise in mental health issues.

"The elderly who live alone should be encouraged to register with a local community centre or a senior citizens' activity centre so that officials can make regular visits to check on their welfare."

Zaininah urged senior citizens to exercise regularly as this could help them improve their overall health and well-being, leading to a better quality of life.

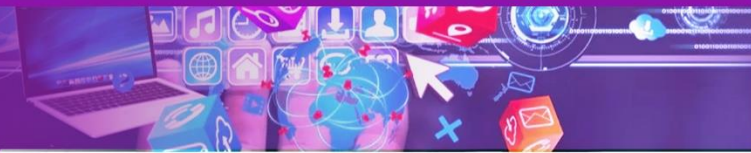

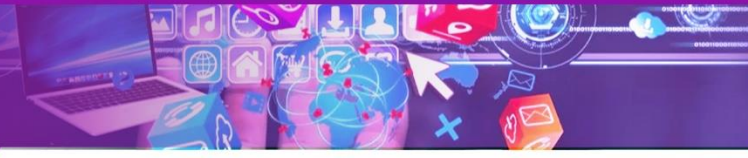

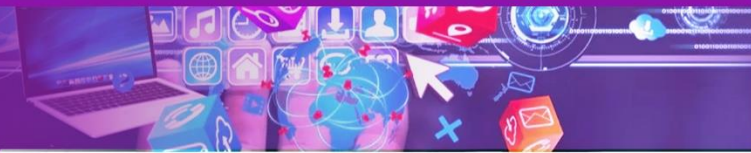

Panel tiga hakim Mahkamah Rayuan diketuai Datuk Seri Kamaludin Md Said dalam keputusan sebulat suara berkata terdapat merit dalam rayuan Rumah Bonda dan mahkamah juga bersetuju permohonan itu akan didengar secara substantif.

“Oleh itu, keputusan Mahkamah Tinggi sebelum ini diketepikan dan kebenaran diberikan kepada perayu untuk memulakan semakan kehakiman di mahkamah itu,” kata beliau yang bersidang bersama-sama Datuk Mohd Nazlan Mohd Ghazali dan Datuk Collin Lawrence Sequerah dalam prosiding secara sidang video.

Mahkamah turut menetapkan 8 Ogos ini untuk sebutan kes di Mahkamah Tinggi.

Pada 15 Nov 2021, Mahkamah Tinggi Kuala Lumpur menolak permohonan Rumah Bonda untuk mendapatkan kebenaran daripada mahkamah bagi memulakan semakan kehakiman terhadap tindakan Lak atau sita terhadap premis berkenaan di Taman Setapak, susulan dakwaan penderaan remaja sindrom down dikenali sebagai Bella selepas membenarkan bantahan Jabatan Peguam Negara terhadap permohonan tersebut.

Rumah Bonda selaku pemohon menerusi pengurusinya Siti Bainun Ahd Razali memfailkan permohonan itu pada 13 Ogos 2021 dengan menamakan Pengarah JKM Wilayah Persekutuan serta Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat sebagai responden pertama dan kedua.

Antara lain, Siti Bainun

mendakwa Notis Tindakan Lak yang dikeluarkan JKM pada 9 Julai 2021 terhadap pemohon dan pelaksanaan tindakan itu pada 12 Julai tahun sama adalah dipengaruhi desakan masyarakat susulan laporan media mengenai dakwaan berlaku penderaan terhadap Bella yang tular pada 5 Julai 2021.

Siti Bainun mendakwa kedua-dua responden bertindak sedemikian sebagai suatu reaksi terburu-buru selepas desakan masyarakat yang menuntut JKM dan kerajaan mengambil tindakan tegas dalam kes itu sedangkan remaja tersebut tiada kaitan dan bukan penghuni Rumah Bonda.

Beliau memohon deklarasi bahawa sepanjang masa itu, Rumah Bonda sedang dalam proses permohonan pendaftaran dengan JKM, justeru ia bukan sebuah rumah perlindungan atau pusat jagaan haram.

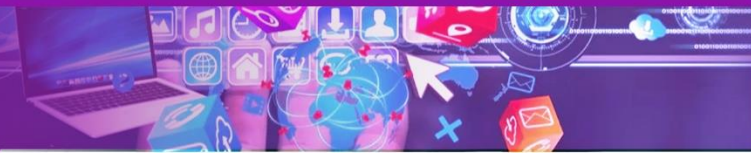
Dalam prosiding semalam, peguam Asiah Abd Jalil yang mewakili Rumah Bonda berhujah bahawa kes itu berkepentingan awam dan mempunyai merit untuk didengar.

Peguam itu berhujah, pihak perayu dalam proses mendaftarkan Rumah Bonda sejak awal 2019 dan borang serta surat sokongan yang ditandatangani oleh responden pertama dan kedua untuk tujuan pendaftaran telah dihantar kepada JKM Wilayah Persekutuan.

“Pada masa itu, Jabatan Bomba telah meluluskan premis dan dua pihak lagi iaitu Jabatan Kesihatan dan Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur telah menetapkan tarikh untuk membuat pemeriksaan.

“Namun, ketika itu negara mengalami pandemik COVID-19 menyukarkan dua agensi itu membuat pemeriksaan ke atas premis tersebut yang kemudiannya telah disita,” kata Asiah yang turut memaklumkan tindakan Lak itu dibuat secara terburu-buru selepas lima hari kes Bella tular di media sosial pada 5 Julai 2021.

Bagi pertuduhan itu, dia didakwa mengikut Seksyen 379 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman penjara sehingga tujuh tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya sekali jika sabit kesalahan.

Mengikut fakta kes, pada 15 Julai 2023, kira-kira jam 12.04 tengah malam, pengadu mendapati satu gegelung aluminium pendingin hawa telah hilang dari premis syarikat.

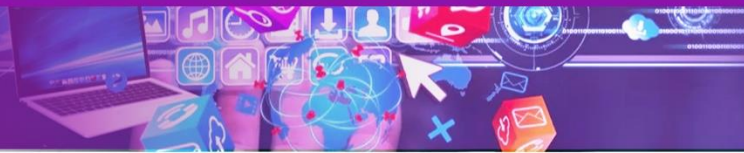
Pemeriksaan melalui kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) mendapati seorang wanita mengambil gegelung tersebut dan kerugian dianggarkan kira-kira RM1,500.

Pengadu kemudian membuat laporan polis.

Pada 19 Julai 2023, kira-kira jam 6.10 petang, pihak polis telah menahan dua suspek termasuk tertuduh di Jalan Foochow.

Sisatan mendapati tertuduh bersama seorang lelaki telah pergi ke premis terbabit dan mencuri satu unit gegelung aluminium pendingin hawa sebelum melarikannya menggunakan sebuah kereta.

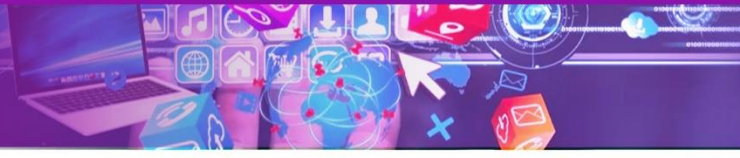

Tragedi Pos Tohoi: Kerajaan akan bayar RM1.2 juta

Penyelesaian penuh terhadap saman keluarga tujuh pelajar Orang Asli

KUALA LUMPUR: Kerajaan akan membayar RM1.2 juta sebagai penyelesaian penuh terhadap saman yang difailkan keluarga Orang Asli berhubung kehilangan tujuh anak mereka dari asrama sekolah di Pos Tohoi, Gua Musang, Kelantan, lapan tahun lepas.

Berdasarkan terma penyelesaian yang direkodkan di hadapan Hakim Mahkamah Tinggi Kota Bharu Datuk Mohamad Abazafree Mohd Abbas kelmarin, kedua-dua pihak mencapai persetujuan bahawa pihak defendan (kerajaan) membayar sebanyak RM1.2 juta dan kos RM60,000 sebagai jumlah penyelesaian penuh dan muktamad bagi kes itu.

Penyelesaian penuh dan muktamad kes itu juga adalah tanpa sebarang perakuan liabiliti daripada semua defendan.

Selain itu pihak ketiga (syarikat insurans) bersetuju membayar RM150,000 termasuk kos sebagai penyelesaian penuh dan muktamad bagi semua kes saman itu.

Peguam dan aktivis Siti Kassim, yang sepatutnya hadir sebagai saksi pertama dalam perbicaraan ketika dihubungi berkata, penyelesaian itu dipersetujui selepas perbincangan antara wakil kerajaan dan peguam keluarga di luar mahkamah sebelum perbicaraan.

Pada 2018, plaintif memfailkan saman itu terhadap sembilan defendan atas pelanggaran kewajipan Perlembagaan, kewajipan statutori dan kewajipan fidusiar menyebabkan tujuh kanak-kanak Orang Asli yang bersekolah di Sekolah Rendah Pos Tohoi, Gua Musang hilang selama 47 hari.

Mereka menamakan kerajaan Malaysia, Menteri Pendidikan, Ketua Pengarah Pelajaran, guru besar sekolah, warden asrama,

Menteri Kemajuan Luar Bandar, Ketua Pengarah Jabatan Kemajuan Orang Asli, Ketua Polis Negara dan Ketua Polis Daerah Gua Musang sebagai defendan.

Tujuh mangsa terdiri daripada enam perempuan dan seorang lelaki, melarikan diri dari asrama sekolah pada 23 Ogos 2015 kerana takut dihukum selepas berenang di sungai tanpa kebenaran.

Daripada tujuh itu, hanya Norieen Yaakob, ketika itu 11, dan Miksudiar Aluj, yang berumur 12 tahun semasa kejadian, terselamat, selepas mereka hilang selama 47 hari di dalam hutan berhampiran.

Adik Norieen, Haikal, lapan; Ika Ayel, sembilan; Juvina David, tujuh; Linda Rosli, lapan, ditemui meninggal dunia selepas 47 hari manakala Sasa Sobrie, lapan, tidak ditemui.

Plaintif diwakili beberapa peguam antaranya Datuk Gurdial Singh Nijar, Andrew Yeap dan Tan Hooi Ping manakala Peguam Kanan Persekutuan Andi Razalijaya A. Dadi mewakili semua defendan. — Bernama
