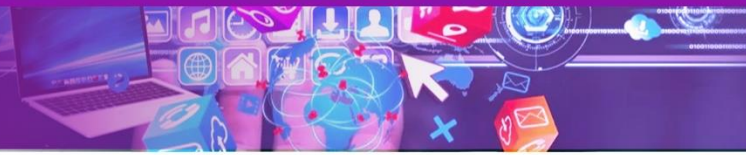

57-year-old nabbed for molesting delivery rider

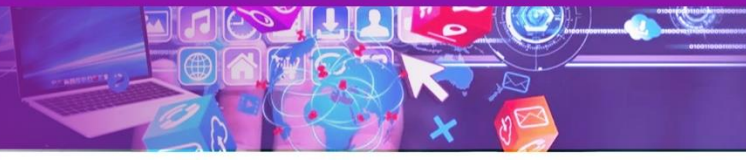
IPOH: A 57-year-old man has been arrested for molesting a male food delivery rider who was delivering food to a house in Sungkai, Tapah, on Thursday.

Tapah OCPD Supt Mohd Naim Asnawi said the 34-year-old victim filed a police report claiming the suspect molested him by holding his private parts and kissing his cheek in the incident at 9.30pm.

"The suspect was arrested at 10.30pm the same day. After the investigation was carried out, the suspect was released on police bail yesterday (Friday) at 1am," he said in a statement yesterday.

Mohd Naim said the case is being investigated under the Penal Code and an offender is liable to be jailed up to 10 years or fined or whipped or any two of the punishments, if convicted.

Early education teachers to be taught to identify special needs kids

MELAKA: A special course for kindergarten (tabika) and nursery (taska) teachers of the Community Development Department (Kemas) is being proposed from next year to help them identify special needs children who require special attention.

State rural development, agriculture and food security committee chairman Dr Muhamad Akmal Saleh said this effort was seen as important as an early detection measure since there were still parents who only realise their children have autism spectrum disorder (ASD) when they enter primary school.

"It must be made clear that early detection is not for the purpose of segregating them, but we want to be able to provide them with special treatment and ensure they receive the best education so that their potential and talents can be fine-tuned – and also so that they will be able to manage themselves in their daily life.

"Sometimes, parents can overlook (these signs) at home, but in nurseries and kindergartens, it is these teachers who can give exposure to and educate these children," he told reporters after officiating at the state-level 'Hari Potensi Tabika dan Taska Kemas

2023' event in Ayer Keroh here yesterday.

Kemas director-general Datuk Ahmad Kamal Idris Mohd Nawawi and Kemas early childhood education director Anisah Saidin also attended the event, Bernama reported.

In his speech, Dr Muhamad Akmal advised parents not to be in denial if they find out that their children are different from others, but to be brave in finding solutions so as to ensure their children receive proper education and treatment.

He also said he and his wife had raised their autistic eldest child,

who is now nine years old, adding that he was grateful for the exposure and early childhood education as his son is now independent and studies in a mainstream class with other children.

"With early education, we can find out these children's talents and potential. Perhaps not in studies, but they have other talents that can be honed," he added.

"So, we should never feel that our children are less than others because all children have gifts and advantages that need to be unearthed."

Meanwhile, Anisah said Kemas

is always improving quality and standards, especially in the field of early childhood education, and among the new programmes introduced this year was the Tabika Pra Tahfiz Kemas programme in collaboration with Yayasan Pahang.

She said the programme is an added value for the Islamic Education Appreciation Module and its main goal is to give special emphasis to two aspects – the learning of worship and Quranic studies.

She added that in Melaka, there are three kindergartens involved in the Pra Tahfiz pilot project.

Mum and beau nabbed after boy with 'extensive tissue injury' dies

SERDANG: A 44-year-old woman and her boyfriend lodged a police report claiming that her five-year-old son had been run over by a lorry.

But they have now been detained over suspected abuse that led to the child's death, while also testing positive for drug use.

Serdang OCPD Asst Comm AA Anbalagan said the boy was sent to Hospital Serdang for treatment at about 12.50am on Aug 22.

"He was unconscious when he arrived at the hospital. Despite administering CPR, the medical personnel could not revive him and he died.

"Medical personnel were initially told that the victim had been hit by a vehicle," he said in a statement yesterday.

However, further checks revealed several bruises and old wounds on the boy's body, believed to be signs of abuse, he added.

"Upon questioning the mother and her boyfriend, we found that they had lodged a false police report stating that the boy was run over by a lorry," he said.

ACP Anbalagan said the mother and her 29-year-old boyfriend from Taman Puncak Jalil were detained on the same day.

"Investigations showed that they have been in a relationship since her husband died last year.

"Both suspects tested positive for methamphetamine and amphetamine. They are being remanded until Tuesday," he said.

The post-mortem revealed extensive soft tissue injury to the boy from multiple counts of blunt force trauma, he said.

"We are still investigating the matter," he added.

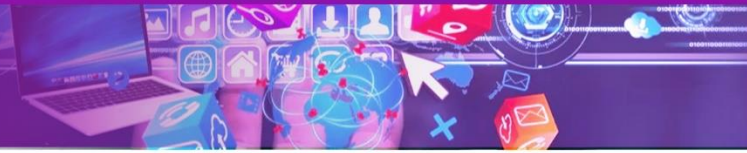
Meanwhile, Bernama reported Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri as saying that a seven-year-old boy who was allegedly abused by his mother and her friend in Pasir Gudang, Johor, early this month, had been placed under the care of his aunt.

The assessment by the Social Welfare Department found that his aunt is eligible to take up the responsibility as she is the victim's closest family member.

"However, throughout the caregiving period, the department will monitor and check on the boy as he is still traumatised.

"We have provided rehabilitative treatment to the victim to help restore his confidence," she told reporters after officiating at the Young Women Leaders Forum organised by the Women's Institute of Management yesterday.

On Aug 16, a single mother and her female friend pleaded not guilty at the Johor Baru Sessions Court to abusing and neglecting the boy.

Man detained after firing shots at vehicle in Sungai Pinang

JULAU: A man, in his 20s, is now under police custody, following a report of him having fired shots at a vehicle in the Sungai Pinang neighbourhood, at Jalan Wak Buku Pakan here late Wednesday.

District police chief DSP Andam Sulin said the incident, said to have occurred at 10.45pm, might have been caused by the man's frustration over being rejected by a woman.

"The complainant, a family member of the woman, reported that the pick-up truck belonging to his son was shot at on the way

back to their house at Sungai Pinang.

"The report was lodged at 5.30pm on Aug 24, and following that, officers from the Criminal Investigation Department (D9) of Sarawak Police Contingent, together with a team from the Criminal Investigation Division of Julau District police headquarters went to apprehend the suspect.

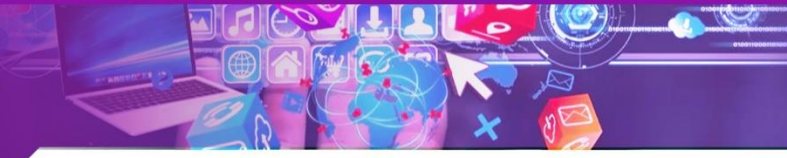
"In arresting the man, police also seized two shotguns and two rifles, one live bullet and one bullet casing," said Andam in a statement.

He said remand application had been submitted to the Sarikei Court, which ordered for the man to be in custody at the Julau police station for four days, pending further investigation.

"We strongly advise the public against taking the law into their own hands.

"We also remind all that it is illegal to possess homemade firearms under the Firearms Act 1960.

"Police would not compromise if any party is found to in violation of this Act," said Andam.

THE latest stop for the breast cancer screening outreach campaign run by the Society for Cancer Advocacy and Awareness (SCAN) and Sarawak Breast Cancer Support Group (SBCSG) in Kapit recently, signified the importance of this programme.

The 38-door longhouse Rumah Untang in Ulu Yong, Kapit, was the fourth leg of this project, led by Dr Melissa Lim.

Located about a 45-minute drive from Kapit town, this village is home to about 150 people.

For the health screening, there were just 39 villagers attending as many of them were away during the last weekend of July, when it was already payday.

"Despite the low turnout, we deem this initiative as a success, in line with its general objective of significantly impacting the rural community's health and well-being, and specifically raising awareness of cancer and providing vital support and advice to those in need."

"Great news is SCAN and SBCSG have been invited to come back early next year to conduct a larger-scale health screening and cancer awareness campaign in Kapit," said Dr Lim, also a lecturer at Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas).

"We're honoured that Deputy Minister in Sarawak Premier's Department (Native Law and Customs) Jefferson Jamit Uyat was present to officiate at the event."

"SBCSG president Datin Juriah Sulehan led the breast screening programme, while six nurses from Kapit Health Clinic, headed by Matron Daisy, facilitated the health screening, as well as the blood pressure, glucose and cholesterol checks on the villagers," added Dr Lim.

Moreover, Datu Dr Zukifli Jantan and Dr Nurdalila Zainal Abidin from Kuching also joined the programme, where they provided personalised diagnoses and general health counselling to those getting check-ups.

SCAN advisor Datin Dayang Mariani Abang Zain and University of Technology Sibu vice-chancellor Prof Datuk Dr Khairuddin Ab Hamid were also in the team.

The womenfolk of Rumah Untang underwent breast health screening, from which some came out with abnormal findings.

The clinical breast examination were undertaken with better precision using a portable hand-held ultrasound machine, previously donated by the Church of Latter-Day Saints.

Outreach project highlights breast cancer awareness

This specialised procedure was performed by Dr Sharifah Ashrina Wan Ali, a breast surgeon from Sarawak General Hospital (SGH). "Among the women who came

for screening, two out of 24 were found with abnormal and suspicious findings, and were referred to Kapit Health Clinic for mammogram referral and further investigation.

"YB Jamit's staff members James Sandak and Robert Anyaw also facilitated this event, assisted by longhouse chieftain Untang Jitan," added Dr Lim.

Kapit District Officer Cerisologo Sabut was also present.

SCAN president Chris Cheng, speaking on behalf of SCAN and SBCSG, welcomed the guests and Rumah Untang folks at the event.

Jamit, who is Bukit Goram assemblyman, gave a heartfelt speech in Iban, calling upon all villagers to always pay attention to their health and specifically to the womenfolk, to always be aware of their breast health.

SBCSG nurse Veronika Benjah Luusa, who spoke fluent Iban,

also advised the womenfolk to not be afraid and embarrassed to check for breast abnormalities, stressing that early detection could help save lives.

Dr Tan, in her remark, said, "That said, the heartfelt welcome from the villagers and the cultural exchanges during this outreach session gave us, the team, a chance to understand more about the Kapit Iban culture, as well as the challenges and barriers when it comes to dealing with cancer."

"In alignment with SCAN's mission to increase awareness of cancer and to understand the local issues that concern cancer patients and caregivers in Sarawak, SCAN was awarded a grant from the Union of International Cancer Control (UICC) to document the gaps and challenges faced by the marginalised communities across Sarawak."

For the Kapit outreach

programme, a film crew was also brought along to capture interviews and the living conditions of breast cancer survivors living in Kapit District.

The SCAN team managed to interview two women from two longhouses in Kanowit, after two months of searching for breast cancer survivors who were willing to speak out.

The interviews revealed an unspoken taboo about cancer, a disease many found difficult to discuss.

Through another research project funded under Unimas Pilot Grant Scheme, the team also conducted a series of interviews with some residents at Kapit and Kanowit longhouses.

Through the interviews, it was clear that there was low awareness of cancer as a disease and the treatments that would entail the diagnosis.

"Breast cancer patients are often detached from the rest of their community upon diagnosis, and they often have to depend on their headman to assist with the funds meant to cover travels, among other necessities, for treatments in the bigger towns or cities," said Dr Tan, adding that the intention behind the research was to understand the connection between indigenous values and low communities would respond to cancer diagnosis and treatments.

Before Kapit, the team had already conducted the programme for the rural communities in Ba Kelalan and Dulit.

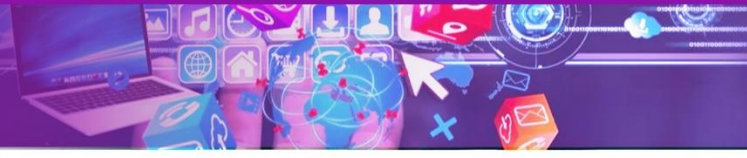
"The preliminary analysis suggested that more targeted work must be done to raise awareness of cancer and general healthy living in the longhouses here, so as to enable these communities establish their own support system to care for the ill and those in need," Dr Tan pointed out.

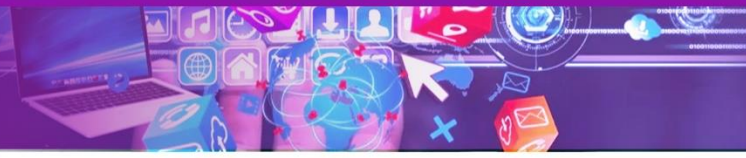

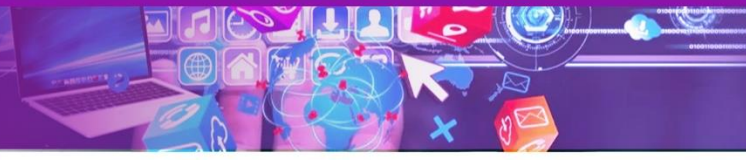

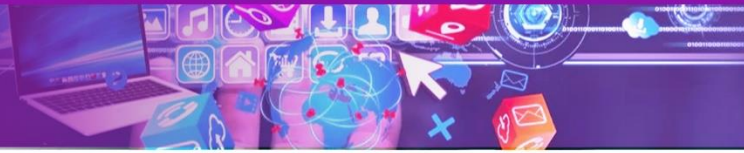

'Kakak dipukul, dikurung sindiket kerja di Myanmar'

Ahli keluarga dimaklumkan mangsa minta segera diselamatkan

Kuala Lumpur: Hasrat seorang wanita mencari pendapatan lebih bagi merawat tumor fibroid bertukar mimpi ngeri apabila dia menjadi mangsa sindiket penipuan pekerjaan di Myanmar.

Akibatnya, wanita tempatan berusia 45 tahun itu bukan hanya dipukul hingga tidak boleh berjalan selama dua minggu, malah dikurung dan dipaksa melakukan penipuan dalam talian di sebuah lokasi di utara Myanmar oleh sindiket terbabit.

Adik perempuan mangsa yang hanya ingin dikenali Miss Lee, berkata perkara itu terbongkar selepas kakaknya yang disangka sedang bercuti di luar negara menghubungi seorang rakan menerusi WhatsApp dan e-mel, sebelum perkara itu dimaklumkan kepada keluarga.

Mengulas lanjut, katanya, kakaknya terpedaya dengan iklan tawaran pekerjaan sebagai penterjemah yang dilihatnya di Facebook pada Jun lalu dan sanggup meninggalkan kerja sebagai kakitangan pentadbiran di sebuah

syarikat di ibu kota untuk mencari wang bagi menampung kos rawatannya.

"Kakak hanya ceritakan hal itu ketika sedang bercuti di China. Saya memintanya balik berhubung dengan keluarga dahulu.

"Pada penghujung Jun lalu, saya dapat WhatsApp beritahu dia sudah ada di Bangkok, Thailand untuk temu duga pekerjaan. Itu kali terakhir kami berhubung," katanya ketika ditemui pada sidang media di Biro Aduan dan Perkhidmatan Awam PKR Wilayah Persekutuan di sini, semalam.

Miss Lee berkata, berdasarkan maklumat diterima, kakak dibawa ke Myanmar dari Thailand oleh sindiket dengan diugut dan telefon bimbitnya turut dirampas.

Katanya, rakan yang dihubungi itu memaklumkan kakaknya turut minta diselamatkan segera, sebelum dia tampil membuat laporan polis untuk tindakan lanjut.

"Kakak ada hantar gambar kecederaannya kepada rakan dan memberitahu dia dipukul jika tidak mahu buat kerja menipu. Dia juga dilarang menghubungi keluarga dan jika sindiket dapat tahu akan teruk dipukul," katanya.

Sindiket ubah modus operandi

Sementara itu, Setiausaha Agung Pertubuhan Kemanusiaan Malaysia (MHO), Datuk Hishamuddin Hashim mendakwa setakat ini kira-kira 20 mangsa penipuan sindiket pekerjaan dipercayai masih terperangkap di Myanmar.

"Kes ini bukan baru sebaliknya berlaku sejak dua tahun lalu dan kini sindiket dikesan mengubah modus operandi mereka dengan membuat iklan tawaran pekerjaan di Thailand, Dubai dan sebagainya.

"Tapi mangsa disuruh hadir temu duga di Bangkok sebelum mangsa kemudian dibawa ke Myanmar. Mangsa dikurung, diancam dan dipukul sepanjang berada di sana," katanya.

Justeru, beliau merayu kerajaan mengambil tindakan menyelesaikan masalah itu, termasuk menjalin kerjasama dengan ASEAN dan Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (PBB) untuk memberi tekanan kepada Kerajaan Myanmar supaya menyelamatkan mangsa sindiket berkenaan.

Keluarga buat laporan polis

Beliau berkata, kejadian turut disaksikan guru dan murid lain kerana ia berlaku ketika murid sedang menduduki soalan kertas peperiksaan Pendidikan Islam bagi Ujian Pertengahan Tahun.

Katanya, susulan kejadian itu keluarga membuat laporan polis pada hari sama jam 2.30 petang dan polis mengarahkan mangsa membuat pemeriksaan kesihatan.

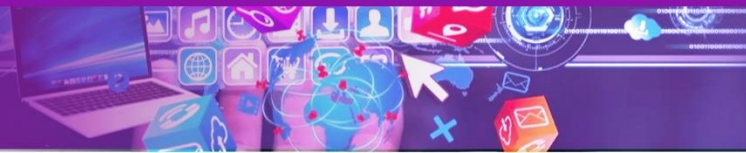
"Kami ke Hospital Universiti Sains Malaysia (HUSM) dan anak ditahan wad selama dua hari. Saya dimaklumkan anak cedera tisu lembut serta mengalami pendarahan di kedua-dua belah telinga dipercayai kesan pukulan," katanya.

Anak jadi trauma, pendiam

Ibu mangsa berusia 32 tahun pula berkata, tujuan laporan polis dibuat bukan untuk memalukan mana-mana pihak, sebaliknya dijadikan iktibar dan mengelakkan murid lain mendapat kesan sama seperti anaknya.

"Sejak kejadian, anak saya menjadi pendiam dan kurang selera makan akibat trauma," katanya.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Kota Bharu, Asisten Komisioner Mohd Rosdi Daud ketika dihubungi semalam mengesahkan menerima laporan berhubung kejadian itu dan berkata siasatan lanjut sedang dijalankan.

Wanita, teman lelaki ditahan sebabkan kematian anak

Kuala Lumpur: Polis menahan seorang wanita bersama teman lelakinya berhubung kematian budak lelaki berusia lima tahun yang juga anak kepada wanita terbabit yang disyaki didera di Pangsapuri Mayang di Taman Puncak Jalil, dekat Seri Kemangan Selasa lalu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Serdang, Asisten Komisioner A A Anbalagan, berkata wanita berusia 44 tahun dan lelaki berusia 29 tahun itu ditahan selepas pemeriksaan ke atas badan kanak-kanak itu menemukan kesan lebam dan luka lama pada badan disyaki akibat didera.

Terdahulu, katanya, kanak-kanak itu dihantar ke Jabatan Kecemasan Hospital Serdang jam 12.50 tengah malam Selasa lalu selepas tidak sedarkan diri dengan pihak hospital dimaklumkan mangsa dilanggar kereta.

"Pasukan perubatan memberikan bantuan CPR, tetapi tiada tindak balas positif sebelum mangsa disahkan meninggal dunia.

"Pemeriksaan lanjut mendapati kesan lebam dan luka lama pada badan mangsa, disyaki akibat didera," katanya melalui kenyataan, semalam.

Anbalagan berkata, siasatan dilakukan kemudian mendapati teman lelaki kepada ibu mangsa ada membuat laporan polis mendakwa melanggar kanak-kanak itu dengan sebuah lori.

Siasatan lanjut kemudian mendapati tiada kejadian sedemikian dan semakan terhadap lori didakwa dipandu lelaki itu sebenarnya kenderaan curi yang dilaporkan hilang di Kajang.

"Hasil siasatan lanjut ke atas kedua-dua suspek akhirnya mereka mengaku mendera mangsa sehingga menyebabkan kematian.

"Berikutan itu, ibu mangsa yang tidak bekerja dan teman lelakinya yang bekerja sebagai pemandu lori ditahan untuk membantu siasatan," katanya.

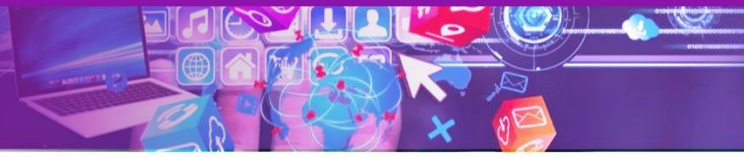

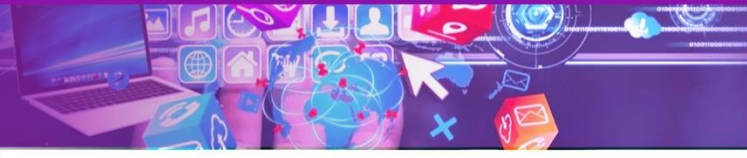

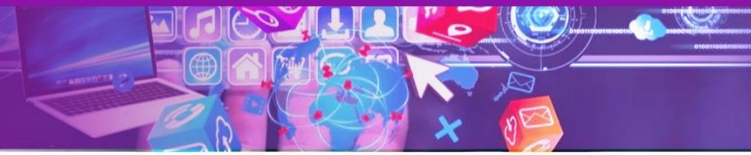

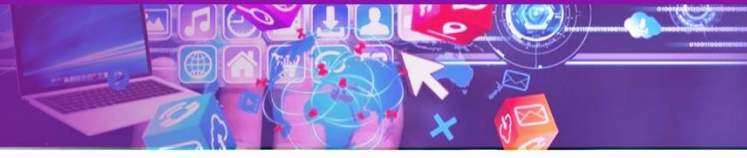
Fire and Rescue Department operation commander Firdaus Abdullah said: "We are unable to determine who drove the car, as one of the victims was pinned in the wreckage, while

DUPED BY SOCIAL MEDIA ADVERTISEMENT

WOMAN ABUSED BY JOB SCAM SYNDICATE

She was brought to north Myanmar on the pretext of undergoing training

A 45-YEAR-OLD Malaysian is being held by a job scam syndicate in northern Myanmar, where she was allegedly beaten until she could not walk for two weeks.

The woman's younger sister, who only wanted to be known as Miss Lee, said she was told about the situation by her sister's friend.

"The last time I contacted my sister was in June, and I told her to return to Malaysia to undergo treatment for her fibroid ailment.

However, she refused to do so and said she had things to settle.

"I had no contact with her since then. Late last month, a friend of hers in Singapore told me that she was in north Myanmar after being duped by a job scam syndicate."

Miss Lee was speaking at a press conference jointly held by Federal Territory PKR Complaints and Legal Bureau and the Malaysia International Humanitarian Organisation (MHO) here, yesterday.

Miss Lee, 42, said she was told that her sister applied for a job as a translator in the Philippines after seeing a social media advertisement.

"When she arrived in the Philippines, however, she was barred entry because she had no work permit. She contacted the job agent, who told her to go to Bangkok for an interview.

"There, she was told that she needed to undergo training and was brought to north Myanmar.

She realised she was a victim of a scam when her handphone was seized and she was forced to work as a scammer."

Miss Lee said her sister contacted a friend in Singapore via WhatsApp and secretly sent an email to ask for help.

She lodged a report on Aug 2 before seeking help from the Federal Territory PKR Complaints and Legal Bureau.

Federal Territory Complaints and Legal Bureau vice-chief Deric Teh said he and the MHO would find a way to help the victim and other Malaysians held by the syndicate.

MHO secretary-general Datuk Hishamuddin Hashim urged Wisma Putra and the prime minister to put pressure on Myanmar's government in regards to the case.

Hishamuddin said 20 families had sought the help of MHO after their loved ones fell victim to the syndicate.
