# 9 ditahan bantu siasatan kes dera bayi sehingga mati

Mangsa dengan kesan penderaan dilaporkan meninggal dunia ketika terima rawatan di HSJ

**Bukit Mertajam:** Polis menahan sembilan individu bagi membantu siasatan berhubung kes kematian seorang bayi lelaki berusia 12 bulan yang dipercayai akibat didera.

Ketua Polis Daerah Seberang Perai Tengah, Asisten Komisioner Tan Cheng San, berkata polis menerima maklumat daripada Hospital Seberang Jaya (HSJ) pada jam 7 malam kelmarin yang memaklumkan mereka menerima pesakit yang mempunyai kesan dera.

Ketika itu kanak-kanak warga tempatan berkenaan tidak sedarkan diri sebelum disahkan meninggal dunia.

"Hasil siasatan mangsa (bayi lelaki) itu dibawa (ke hospital) oleh seorang lelaki yang tidak dikenali berusia lingkungan 30-an.

"Lelaki itu (suspek) mengatakan si mati pengsan dan memerlukan rawatan sebelum beredar meninggalkan kawasan hospital," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

## Ditahan di Seberang Perai

Mengulas lanjut, Cheng San berkata, susulan insiden itu, polis menjejaki keberadaan suspek sebelum menahan sembilan individu di sekitar Seberang Perai semalam.

"Mereka yang ditahan membabitkan empat lelaki dan lima wanita warga tempatan berusia 16 hingga 48 tahun bagi membantu

siasatan kes ini.

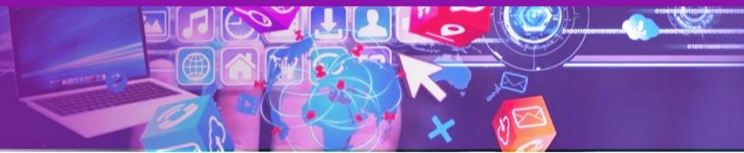
"Seorang daripada sembilan suspek yang ditahan mempunyai lima rekod jenayah dalam pelbagai kesalahan.

"Semua yang ditahan akan dibawa ke Mahkamah Majistret Bukit Mertajam untuk tujuan reman," katanya.

## Guru rugi RM37,750 ditipu iklan kucing Munchkin

**Alor Gajah:** Seorang guru kerugian RM37,750 selepas terpedaya dengan penjualan seekor kucing baka Munchkin yang tidak wujud di Facebook, pada Rabu lalu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Alor Gajah, Superintendan Arshad Abu, berkata kejadian berlaku ketika wanita berusia 39 tahun yang tinggal di Alor Gajah itu pada mulanya tertarik dengan iklan jualan kucing baka berkenaan yang ditawarkan pada harga RM600 di platform media sosial itu.

“Mangsa kemudian diminta membayar deposit berjumlah RM300 ke akaun bank yang diberikan sindiket penipuan berkenaan.

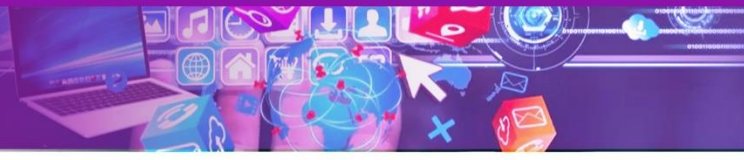
“Ketika awal pembelian, kucing itu dikatakan dari Pontian, Johor, tetapi selepas pembayaran dibuat mangsa dimaklumkan

kucing terbabit dari Jakarta, Indonesia.

“Susulan itu, wanita terbabit diminta membuat beberapa bayaran berperingkat (kononnya) bagi tujuan lesen Jabatan Perlindungan Hidupan Liar dan Taman Negara (PERHILITAN), kos penerbangan dari luar negara serta lesen import kucing dengan jumlah keseluruhan RM37,750 dalam tempoh tiga hari bermula Khamis lalu,” katanya dalam kenyataan di sini, semalam.

Beliau berkata, apabila guru itu menyedari ditipu selepas melakukan transaksi berkenaan, mangsa kemudian membuat laporan polis di Balai Polis Alor Gajah, kelmarin dan kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 420 Kanun Keseksaan kerana menipu.

## Kerjaya pereka barangan kemas dapat permintaan tinggi

**Kuala Lumpur:** Minat berhias, melabur barang atau perhiasan emas membuatkan kerjaya bidang berkaitan turut menjadi kerjaya tumpuan serta mendapat permintaan tinggi dalam pasaran pekerjaan.

Pensyarah Kanan, Jabatan Seni Reka Logam Halus, Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), Kelantan, Rozita Shamsuddin, berkata barang kemas atau perhiasan diri diperbuat daripada bahan berharga seperti perak dan emas adalah seni warisan masyarakat Melayu.

Katanya, logam itu digunakan sebilangan masyarakat sebagai cagar hidup untuk menghimpun

hartanya, selain sebagai perhiasan diri kalangan wanita.

"Pereka barang kemas berperanan sebagai pakar mereka bentuk barang kemas dan penghasilan aksesori selepas menerima kursus atau latihan di mana-mana institusi pengajian tinggi awam atau Institusi Kraf-tangan Negara.

"Kalangan mereka ini mempunyai imaginasi dan kreativiti meluas di dalam mereka bentuk barang kemas. Bukan itu sahaja beberapa tahun ini, perkembangan pesat industri barang kemas negara membuatkan kerjaya tukang emas semakin diminati dan popular.

"Kedai emas baharu banyak dibuka seperti di Kelantan dan Terengganu," katanya.

Faktor yang mendorong populariti dan minat terhadap pereka barang kemas kerana lepasan bidang terbabit mahir mereka bentuk perhiasan emas mengikut permintaan pelanggan.

"Mereka juga berupaya melukis lakaran barang kemas secara manual atau komputer; selain dengan kepakaran dimiliki mereka berupaya mengambil pesanan pelanggan melalui tempahan yang memerlukan cadangan atau idea rekaan.

"Mereka boleh membangunkan reka bentuk barang kemas

untuk koleksi kedai atau syarikat," katanya.

Rozita berkata, lulusan bidang seni logam juga sering mengambil bahagian dalam pameran dan pertandingan rekaan barang kemas untuk tujuan promosi dan peningkatan kerjaya.

"Mereka juga mahir memberi khidmat nasihat cadangan konsep dan idea rekaan kepada pelanggan. Jadi kelayakan menjadi pereka barang kemas dengan memperoleh sijil atau diploma atau ijazah sarjana muda dari mana-mana institusi yang menawarkan bidang rekaan barang kemas.

"UiTM satu-satunya IPTA

yang menawarkan bidang pengkhususan rekaan barang kemas pada peringkat ijazah sarjana muda dan diploma," katanya.

Pengajian peringkat sijil boleh diperoleh di IKN atau mana-mana pusat latihan atau akademi sama ada oleh pihak kerajaan atau swasta (syarikat persendirian).

"Kursus dalam reka bentuk rekaan barang kemas adalah kursus kreatif dan menawarkan pemahaman mengenai idea rekaan dan teknik pembuatan perhiasan serta melangkaui pengetahuan di dalam bidang metalurgi, kajian logam, kajian batu permata (gemologi) dan keusahawanan," katanya.

# Seragam perubatan si cilik dapat sambutan

Bekas jururawat terima tempahan 5 kali ganda menjelang sambutan Hari Kebangsaan

**Kota Bharu:** Idea seorang wanita menghasilkan baju seragam jururawat versi kanak-kanak seawal usia dua tahun membuahkan hasil apabila kini menerima tempahan lima kali ganda sepanjang menjelang sambutan Hari Kebangsaan.

Noor Ellahi Mohd Suhaimi, 35, yang juga pengusaha pakaian seragam perubatan di Kota Bharu, pada awalnya menjahit baju jururawat untuk dua anaknya sekadar suka-suka, namun tidak menyangka mendapat permintaan tinggi daripada pelanggan.

Katanya, baju versi kanak-kanak menjadi pilihan kerana sering digayakan pada sambutan Hari Kebangsaan dan Hari Malaysia yang melambangkan pelbagai kerjaya yang ada di Malaysia.

"Selain pakaian jururawat sebagai produk utama, saya turut menghasilkan baju bagi jawatan lain seperti penolong pegawai perubatan, ketua jururawat (berwarna biru), lab coat dan pembantu perawat kesihatan versi kanak-kanak.

"Saya juga menerima tempahan untuk uniform agensi lain seperti polis, askar dan bomba mengikut permintaan pelanggan. Sebenarnya, saya memfokuskan kepada seragam perubatan memandangkan saya sendiri adalah bekas jururawat memilih berhenti kerja untuk menjalankan perniagaan.

"Setiap hari, saya boleh menghasilkan sehingga 50 seragam versi kanak-kanak dengan dibantu 10 pekerja bagi memenuhi permintaan pelanggan yang sangat ramai terutama sepanjang bulan ini," katanya ketika ditemui di gudang Boonga Amanda miliknya, di Peringat, di sini.

Baju dijual serendah RM55 sehingga RM75 bergantung kepada saiz serta rekaan, selain dipasarkan ke seluruh negara termasuk Sabah dan Sarawak.

Dia dan suami, Nik Azarudin Nik Mustafa, 38, mempromosikan melalui media sosial sejak April lalu supaya dapat menyediakan tempahan dengan lebih awal.

"Walaupun seragam dihasilkan hanya untuk dipakai kanak-kanak, kami menjahit de-

ngan penuh ketelitian serta menggunakan kain berkualiti tinggi supaya selesa dipakai dan cantik 'terletak'.

"Apa yang membuatkan saya lebih bersemangat ialah apabila melihat reaksi anak yang memakai seragam itu. Selain dilihat comel, ia turut memberi inspirasi kepada kanak-kanak untuk menyambut Hari Kebangsaan dengan cara tersendiri.

"Jika sebelum ini ibu bapa hanya menggayakan anak mereka dengan memakai pakaian berunsurkan Jalur Gemilang, tetapi sekarang mereka lebih advance dengan mengenakan seragam pekerjaan versi kanak-kanak yang lebih menarik," katanya.

#### Dapat permintaan tinggi

Noor Ellahi berkata, dia juga pernah menghasilkan seragam jururawat dari negara lain seperti Singapura dan Thailand versi kanak-kanak seperti permintaan ibu bapa mereka.

Ibu kepada tiga cahaya mata berusia tujuh hingga 10 tahun itu, mengakui gembira terbahagi dalam bidang ini dan tidak menyesal meninggalkan kerjaya sebagai jururawat pada 2018.

"Berhenti kerja suatu pilihan



yang agak berisiko kerana suami ketika itu berkhidmat sebagai pegawai perubatan di sebuah klinik kerajaan mengambil keputusan sama. Alhamdulillah, kami di-anugerahkan rezeki lebih luas dalam perniagaan ini.

"Bagi uniform perubatan dewasa menjadi produk utama turut mendapat permintaan sehingga ke luar negara seperti Arab Saudi dan Singapura, mem-babitkan kakitangan kesihatan di sana," katanya.

# 'Aku tenang di laut'

Kanser tak halang ibu enam anak bantu suami menangkap ikan

Walaupun disahkan menghidap kanser ovari, ia tidak menghalang ibu kepada enam anak di Kampung Nail, Kuala Besut di sini, menjadi nelayan.

Jika keadaan cuaca mengizinkan, Sapinah Mohd, 59, bersama suami, Wan Jusuh Ayob, 61, keluar ke laut untuk menangkap ikan dan aktiviti itu dilakukan sejak lebih 10 tahun lalu.

Pasangan itu biasanya keluar selepas solat Subuh kira-kira jam 6 pagi dan pulang bergantung kepada hasil tangkapan serta cuaca antara jam 1 tengah hari hingga 3 petang.

Menurutnya, dia sebelum ini hanya suri rumah dan tidak pernah terfikir untuk ke laut mengikut suaminya. "Sebelum ini, saya duduk di rumah, namun apabila disahkan ada penyakit itu selain pernah terkena serangan jantung, saya tidak boleh duduk seorang diri dan ambil keputusan untuk ikut suami.

"Kalau duduk saja di rumah saya akan fikirkan masalah kesihatan, lebih baik saya ke laut, setidaknya ti-

dak berfikir sangat tentang masalah kanser yang dihidapi.

"Pada mulanya ia sekadar suka-suka namun lama-kelamaan bertukar menjadi minat, apatah lagi menengangkan suami bersendirian keluar mencari rezeki.

"Suami sebelum ini keluar bersama seorang pekerja, namun kerana hasil tangkapan tidak seberapa, suami tidak mampu membayar upah menyebabkan saya mengambil keputusan keluar bersamanya," katanya di rumah mereka, baru-baru ini.

Sapinah berkata, suaminya tidak pernah memaksa mengikutnya ke laut, namun ia dilakukan kerana minat dan mahu mencari ketenangan selain ingin membantu mencari rezeki.

"Memang tak ramai nelayan dalam kalangan wanita sekarang ini, tetapi seperti peribahasa 'alah bisa, tegal biasa', ia sudah sebatian dengan saya.

"Mula-mula rasa janggal dan susah sangat, tetapi lama-kelamaan ia sudah jadi biasa kerana ini punca pendapatan kami sejak dahulu," katanya.

Menurutnya, antara cabaran terpaksa dihadapinya pada peringkat awal ialah berdepan mabuk laut, namun sejak kebelakangan ini, hasil tangkapan merosot

hingga adakalanya pulang tanpa sebarang tangkapan.

"Memang biasa pulang tanpa sebarang tangkapan, tetapi kami tiada pilihan, jika tidak keluar ke laut 'dapur tidak berasap' kerana kami tiada sumber pendapatan lain.

"Mahu atau tidak, suka atau sebaliknya, saya serta suami tidak boleh bergantung sepenuhnya kepada anak-anak kerana mereka juga mempunyai kehidupan dan tanggungjawab.

"Biasanya hasil tangkapan yang diperolehi dijual di Kompleks Lembaga Kemaajuan Ikan Malaysia, Kuala Besut selain ada dijadikan lauk dan diproses untuk dijadikan ikan kering bagi meringankan beban perbelanjaan harian.

"Jika diikutkan pendapatan memang tidak seberapa tetapi ini punca pendapatan kami sejak lebih 10 tahun lalu.

"Saya sendiri rela mengikut suami menjadi nelayan walaupun saya tahu tidak ramai wanita yang sanggup melakukan kerja ini yang lebih sinonim dengan lelaki," katanya.

Sementara itu, Wan Jusuh berkata, dia tidak pernah memaksa Sapinah menjadi nelayan sebaliknya ia dilakukan dengan kerelaan isterinya sendiri.

"Memang pada awalnya

dia ikut sebab bosan di rumah kerana anak-anak sudah besar tetapi lama-kelamaan menjadi rutin dia bersama saya.

"Apabila kami bersama, sekurang-kurangnya saya tidak risau mengenangkan dia bersendirian di rumah berikutan penyakit dihidapinya.

"Sebagai suami, saya tidak memaksa dan andainya satu hari nanti, dia tidak mahu lagi ke laut, saya terima, tetapi setakat ini, dia bertegas mahu bersama-sama membantu saya mencari rezeki," katanya.

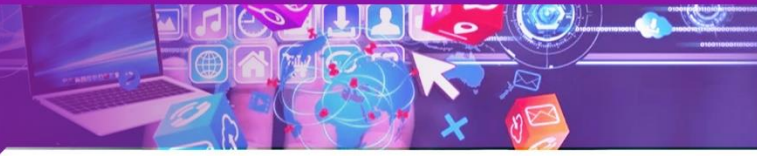
"Mangsa juga mengugut untuk terjun ke bawah," katanya dalam satu kenyataan, semalam.

"Kami kemudian mendapatkan rawatan susulan di sebuah pusat perubatan swasta dan doktor mengesyaki suami menghidap barah usus selepas melakukan ujian endoskopi sebelum dirujuk ke Hospital Sultanah Bahiyah (HSB) Alor Setar," katanya di rumah mereka di Jalan Alor Mengkudu di sini, semalam.

Menurutnya, disebabkan kerap berulang-alik ke HPP, mereka terpaksa meninggalkan dua anak, Nur Inas Raisha Mohamad Idris, 12, dan Nur Inas Rania, 6, kepada ibu, Che Tom Darus, 70, untuk dijaga di rumah.

Katanya, dia juga melakan urusan sendirian termasuk pemeriksaan ke-

him Hussain, 70, yang membawa suami dan menemaninya ke HPP kerana saya berpantang.

"Suami diberhentikan

kerja, manakala saya juga terpaksa berhenti kerja kerana mahu memberi tumpuan kepada suami menyebabkan kami hilang punca

pendapatan.

"Segala kos rawatan dibayar menggunakan wang sendiri dan makin berkurangan setakat ini tambahan pula suami pakai beg stoma pada saluran najis yang perlu dibeli sendiri," katanya.

Katanya, mereka menggunakan wang sumbangan untuk membiayai kos rawatan, ulang-alik ke hospital serta persekolahan anak-anak selain menerima tempahan nasi lemak, nasi arab atau nasi tomato.

Orang ramai yang ingin membantu boleh berbuat demikian melalui akaun CIMB 7046382026 atas nama Mohamad Idris Md Desa.

Sementara itu, Pengerusi Cancer Survivors Malaysia (CSM), Zuraini Kamal turut menghulurkan sumbangan kepada pesakit termasuk wang tunai dan barangan keperluan dapur serta memberi sokongan supaya meneruskan rawatan.

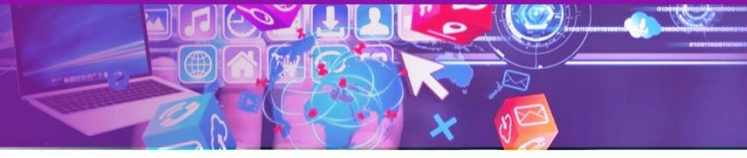

"Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah kompeten untuk mendengar perkara itu. Kami bersetuju bahawa

hakim Mahkamah Tinggi di mahkamah sivil tidak mempunyai bidang kuasa untuk menyemak keputusan Mahkamah Syariah.

"Mahkamah sivil dan Syariah adalah dua sistem perundangan yang berasingan dan Mahkamah Syariah bukanlah tribunal rendah yang tertakluk kepada semakan kehakiman. Kesimpulannya, rayuan ditolak, keputusan hakim Mahkamah Tinggi Sivil disahkan," katanya ketika menyampaikan keputusan

itu melalui prosiding dalam talian.

Azizah yang bersidang bersama Datuk See Mee Chun dan Datuk Azizul Azmi Adnan, menolak permohonan itu tanpa arahan mengenai kos.

Peguam, Fahri Azzat mewakili wanita itu manakala Peguam Kanan Persekutuan Ahmad Hanir Hambaly dan Peguam

Persekutuan Mohammad Sallehuddin Md Ali, mewakili empat responden.

Wanita berusia 33 tahun itu, yang dilahirkan dalam keluarga bapa seorang muallaf dan ibu menganut agama Islam, merayu terhadap keputusan Mahkamah Tinggi pada 15 Jun lalu yang menolak permohonan-

nya untuk mendapat kebenaran bagi memulakan

semakan kehakiman.

Dalam permohonan itu, yang difailkan pada 4 Mac tahun lalu, dia menamakan Mahkamah Rayuan Syariah, Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah, Majlis Agama Islam Wilayah Persekutuan (Maiwp) dan Kerajaan Malaysia sebagai responden.

Wanita itu memohon sekurang-kurangnya 12 perintah mahkamah termasuk deklarasi bahawa dia bukan lagi seorang Islam serta berhak mengaut dan mengamalkan

agamanya iaitu Konfusianisme serta Buddhisme.

Dia turut memohon deklarasi Mahkamah Tinggi sivil bahawa keputusan Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah dan Mahkamah Rayuan Syariah yang menolak permohonannya untuk diisytihar sebagai murtad adalah tidak sah, menyalahi undang-undang serta batal.

Pada 27 Julai 2020, Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah menolak permohonan wanita itu untuk diisytihar sebagai bukan Islam dan memerintahkan dia melalui 'istitabah' atau bertaubat dan mengikuti kelas agama Islam serta kaunseling akidah selanjutnya.

Dia kemudian merayu kepada Mahkamah Rayuan Syariah yang mengekalkan keputusan Mahkamah Tinggi Syariah pada 8 Disember 2021.- Bernama

Community at Heart Award is a testament to Assunta Hospital's ethos of compassion, empathy and inclusivity.

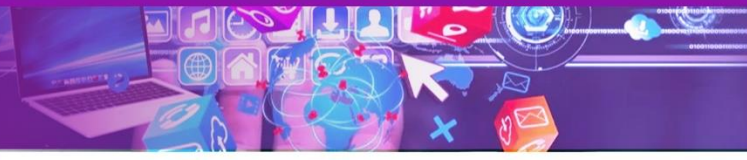

# WOMAN FAILS IN BID TO RENOUNCE ISLAM

Only Syariah Court has jurisdiction to determine renunciation cases, rules appeals court

PUTRAJAYA

**T**HE Court of Appeal yesterday dismissed a woman's appeal to obtain leave to commence a judicial review challenging the Syariah Court's decision that barred her from renouncing Islam.

A three-member panel chaired by Datuk Azizah Nawawi, in a

unanimous decision, ruled that only the Syariah Court has the jurisdiction to determine issues of renunciation as per Article 121(1A) of the Federal Constitution.

"The Syariah High Court is competent to hear the matter. We agree that the High Court judge at the Civil Court had no jurisdiction to review the decision of the Syariah Court.

"The Civil and Syariah Courts are two separate legal systems, and the Syariah Court is not an inferior tribunal subject to judicial review.

"In conclusion, the appeal is dismissed, and the decision of the Civil High Court judge affirmed," she said when delivering the decision via online proceedings.

Azizah, who sat with Datuk See Mee Chun and Datuk Azizul Azmi Adnan, dismissed the application with no order as to costs.

Lawyer Fahri Azzat represented the woman, while senior federal counsel Ahmad Hanir Hambaly and federal counsel Mohammad Sallehuddin Md Ali appeared for the four respondents.

The 33-year-old woman, who was born to a Muslim convert father and a Muslim mother, was appealing against the June 15 High Court ruling dismissing her application for leave to challenge the Syariah Court's dismissal of her legal suit.

In her judicial review filed in the High Court on March 4 last year, the woman named the Syariah Court of Appeal, the Syariah High Court, the Federal

Territories Islamic Religious Council and the government of Malaysia as respondents.

She had sought at least 12 court orders as part of her lawsuit, including declarations that she is no longer a Muslim and that she is entitled to profess her religion of Confucianism and Buddhism.

She also asked the Civil High Court to declare the decisions by the Syariah High Court and Syariah Court of Appeal — which re-

jected her bid to be recognised as being no longer a Muslim — as illegal, unlawful and void.

The Syariah High Court on July 27, 2020, dismissed the woman's bid and ordered her to go through *istitabah* or repentance and Islamic classes and further *akidah* counselling.

She then brought the matter to the Syariah Court of Appeal, which also rejected her appeal on Dec 8, 2021. **Bername**

# 'Get students to understand more about democracy'

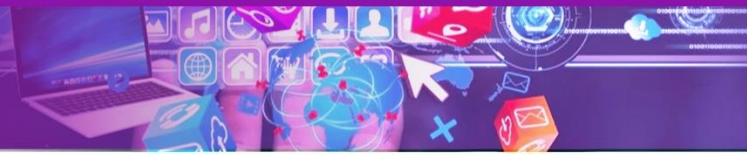

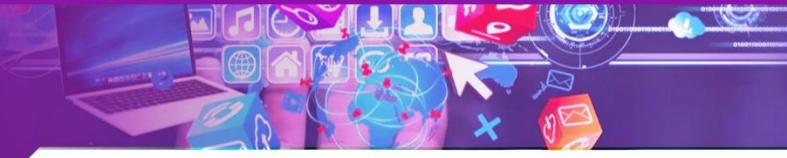

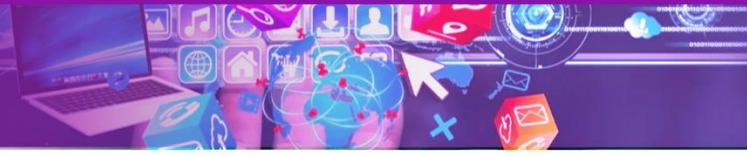

## Halfway home for mentally-ill homeless folks to be set up soon

**KUCHING:** The Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Ministry would set up a halfway home for the homeless with mental illness, said its minister Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah.

Fatimah said the shelter would be built in Kuching and should be ready by next year.

"The site for the building has been identified and construction work will begin next year," she said when met by reporters at Majma Mall here, before heading a homeless survey operation late Sunday.

Fatimah said a fund of RM750,000 had already been approved for the setting up of the home and its operation costs.

She said the ministry had yet to identify the management team to operate the shelter, but would prefer a non-profit organisation (NGO) with expertise in the subject of mental health.

"This is important to ensure that the homeless and vulnerable people who are referred to Hospital Sentosa will continue to receive necessary care and support that they need for recovery.

"For example, homeless people who are rescued and are found to have mental illness, have to be admitted to Hospital Sentosa for a few days.

"So before being discharged, they will be placed at this house so that continuous treatment can be carried out. We recommend this halfway house will be operated by an NGO that consists of mental health experts," she said.

Fatimah also noted that despite the state having a few temporary homeless shelters, they were not equipped with proper care and support for those with mental illness.

Citing the latest data from the ministry's study into the cause of homelessness, she said 38 per cent was due to family problems, 33 per cent had mental health issues, 12 per cent had nowhere to stay, 10 per cent involved alcohol and substance addiction, and the remaining percentage was due to the individuals losing their jobs.

Fatimah added that the study also found that homeless people with mental illness who had been rescued, usually had a history of hospitalisation.

She said the homeless individuals would usually be taken to the mental hospital for observation when the authorities found them sleeping on the streets and they would be discharged from the hospital once their condition had stabilised.

"But despite being discharged from the mental hospital, their condition continues to deteriorate

due to lack of proper care and medical support during their recovery period.

"They often face relapse because they are not able to take care of themselves. They sometimes forget to take their medication. And our temporary shelters here are not equipped with specialised care for mentally-ill people."

Fatimah said placing the homeless in the welfare institutions such as Desa Bina Diri (DBD) in Samarahan and Anjung Singgah in Satok was a challenge, as there were those who wanted to continue to move freely, experienced mental health problems, had infectious and chronic diseases, abused drugs and substances, and had been disowned by their families.

"Based on the statistics on the Prevalence and Mapping of Permanent Homelessness by Sarawak Social Development Council (MPS), a total of 91 homeless had been profiled in Sarawak from January to July this year, with 31 of them identified as permanently homeless.

"The remaining number are those who undergo rehabilitation programmes at the temporary transit centre in Sibul (TTG Sibul) where social, work and living skills are taught to them to prepare them to live independently," said the minister.

Kuching has the highest prevalence of homelessness with 32 people, followed by Sibul with 17, Bintulu with 13, and Miri with nine.

Fatimah said a total of 97 homeless people had stayed at TTG Sibul from January until Aug 24 this year, and 83 of them had already left the centre.

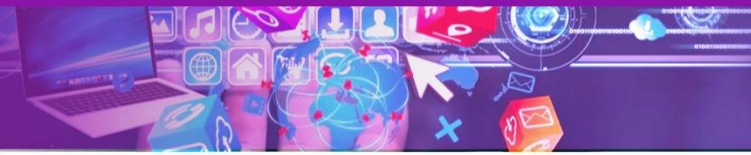
Describing TTG Sibul as a success story, she said the centre had helped homeless people to find employment and a place to stay, adding that those assessed to have a high potential for reintegration, were placed on employment schemes and house rental schemes.

Fatimah said more effort would be needed to ensure that homeless people would be getting the support that they needed.

She thus called for a more integrated collaboration from the public, private, NGOs, local communities and individuals or philanthropists with the state government to deal with the issue.

"Social issues such as homelessness are complex problems and cannot be dealt with in silos.

"Focusing on the homelessness issue can improve the well-being of the community in an inclusive manner in addition to addressing the impact on public health, public safety, urban cleanliness and tourism in our major cities in Sarawak."

## Joint op finds 9 homeless persons with mental health issues

**KUCHING:** A joint operation by Sarawak Homeless Management Committee (JPGS) to observe the homeless in Kuching on Sunday night had discovered nine individuals having mental health issues.

According to the operation report, they were among 15 individuals, all men, found sleeping on streets around the city.

"Nine of them have mental health issues, two individuals are found to be involved in drugs and substance abuse, and one person had family problems.

"Two homeless folks preferred to sleep outside rather than at transit centres to keep their

freedom. Another person's reason was finding job" the report said.

Meanwhile, Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Minister Sarawak Dato Seri Fatimah Abdullah said the operation was a preliminary review to gain insights and identify homeless hotspots in Kuching Division.

"The Integrated Homeless Observation Operation, led by the Welfare Department Sarawak, is the first integrated observation operation held for Year 2023 in Kuching.

"We set our key performance indicators (KPI) to have at least one integrated operation to rescue the homeless in Kuching, Sibuloh, and

Bintulu and Miri for Year 2023.

"I would like to record my infinite appreciation and gratitude to all members for their input, contribution and support throughout 2022 and 2023 to implement a social intervention programme involving the homeless community in Sarawak," she said during the briefing at Majma Mall Ramlee here, conducted prior to the Sunday night operation – covering Kuching Waterfront and Jalan Padungan, India Street Pedestrian Mall and Saujana building, Taman Jubli and Bandar Baru Samariang, and areas in front of the National Anti-Drug Agency (AADK) office here and Jalan Satok.

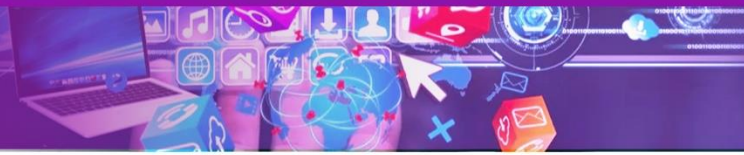

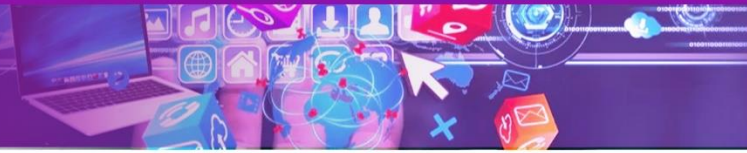

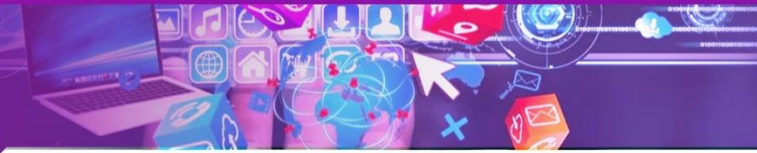

## Teacher loses RM38k to Munchkin cat scam

**MELAKA:** A teacher, who wanted to buy a RM600 Munchkin cat offered on social media, ended up losing almost RM38,000.

“She had engaged in a deal to buy the feline after seeing an advertisement on Facebook at 3pm on Aug 23,” he said yesterday.

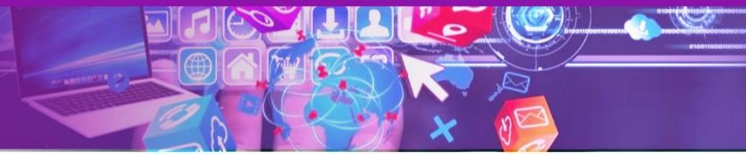
The 39-year-old teacher had agreed to purchase the cat when the price was offered at RM600.

were concluded.

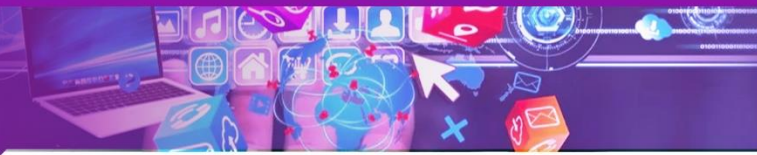

transferred RM300 into a bank account after deciding to purchase the pet, which was offered for sale at RM600 on Aug 23.

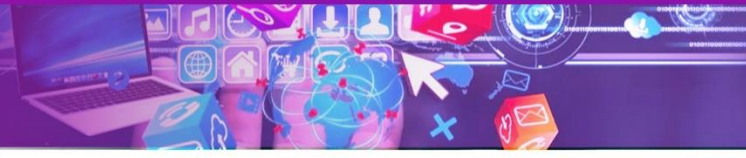
"She was instructed to make several more payments over three

## Woman's bid to renounce Islam dismissed

**PUTRAJAYA:** The Court of Appeal yesterday dismissed a woman's bid to obtain leave to commence a judicial review to challenge a syariah court decision that disallowed her from renouncing Islam.

A three-member panel chaired by justices Datuk Azizah Nawawi, Datuk See Mee Chun and Datuk Azizul Azmi Adnan ruled unanimously that only a syariah court has the exclusive jurisdiction to determine issues of renunciation, as per Article 121(1A) of the Federal Constitution.

"The Syariah High Court is competent to hear the matter. We agree that the High Court judge has

no jurisdiction to review the decision of the syariah court.

"The civil and syariah courts are two separate legal systems and the syariah court is not an inferior tribunal subject to judicial review. Thus, the appeal is dismissed and the decision of the High Court judge (is affirmed," Azizah said in dismissing the application with no order as to costs.

Fahri Azzat represented the woman, while senior federal counsel Ahmad Hanir Hambaly and federal counsel Mohammad Sallehuddin Md Ali represented the respondents - the Syariah Court of Appeal, Syariah

High Court, Federal Territories Islamic Religious Council and the government.

The 33-year-old woman, who was born to a Muslim convert father and a Muslim mother, was appealing against a June 15 High Court ruling dismissing her application for leave to challenge the syariah court dismissal of her suit.

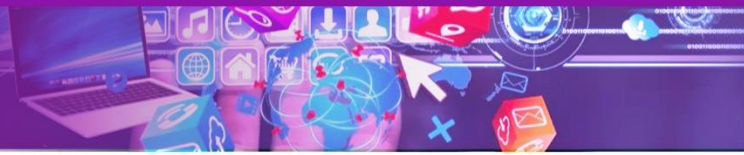
She filed her judicial review in the High Court on March 4 last year.

She is seeking at least 12 court orders, including declarations that she is no longer a Muslim and that she is entitled to profess her religion of Confucianism and Buddhism.

The woman also sought the High Court to declare the decisions by the Syariah High Court and Syariah Court of Appeal, which rejected her bid to be recognised as no longer a Muslim, as illegal, unlawful and void.

The Syariah High Court on July 27, 2020, dismissed the woman's bid to be declared no longer a Muslim and ordered her to go through *istitabah*, or repentance, and Islamic classes and further counselling.

She then brought the matter to the Syariah Court of Appeal, which also rejected her application on Dec 8, 2021. - Bernama

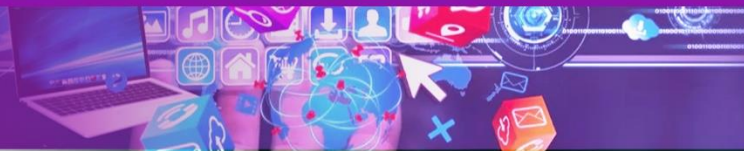

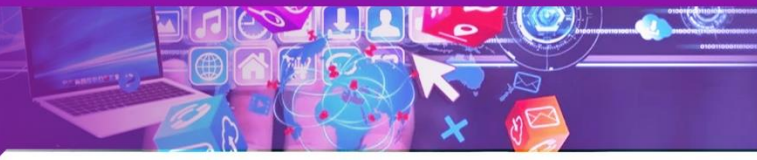
“Mangsa kemudian diminta membayar deposit berjumlah RM300 ke akaun bank yang diberikan sindiket penipuan berkenaan.

terlalu muda.

Allana bagaimanapun perlu menjalani pemeriksaan rutin setiap bulan di Hospital Umum Sarawak (HUS).

Disebabkan masalah kesihatan yang dialaminya itu Allana ketika ini perlu meng-

gunakan mesin penyedut dan tiub penyusuan.

Selain Allana pasangan itu dikurniakan dua lagi cahaya mata yang sudah bersekolah.

Bekerja sendiri sebagai mekanik dengan penda-

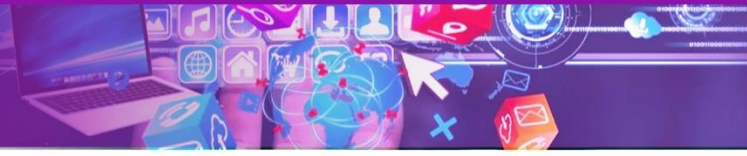
patan yang tidak menentu sudah pastinya pendapatan diperoleh suami Nur Waheeda tidak mencukupi bagi menampung keperluan khas anak kecil mereka itu.

Mangsa Zayyan Nazeem Zainal Abidin, 6, dikatakan terperangkap dalam kebakaran terbabit dalam sebuah rumah dan ditemui dalam keadaan rentung ketika kerja 'overhaul' dijalankan.

Penolong Pengarah Bahagian Operasi Kebompaan dan Penyelamat Sarawak Henderi Ardiansyah memberitahu, pihaknya menerima laporan kejadian sekitar jam 1.12 petang melibatkan lima rumah separuh

kekal dua tingkat berkeluasan 30 x 20 kaki persegi.

Menurutnya, sebaik menerima laporan, sepasukan anggota dari Balai Bomba dan Penyelamat (BBP) Batu Lintang dan Padungan bergegas ke lokasi kejadian.

"Dari segi butiran kejadian, kita terima panggilan sekitar jam 1.12 petang dan anggota dari Batu Lintang tiba seawal yang boleh iaitu sekitar jam 1.20 petang diikuti anggota bantuan dari BBP Padungan.

"Ketika kejadian, difahamkan ketika itu terdapat dua individu di rumah kedua iaitu nenek dan mangsa.

"Neneknya memberitahu

bahawa terdapat seorang mangsa (cucu) terperangkap di rumah kedua dan disebabkan faktor kemerebakkan api itu terlahu cepat menyebabkan anggota sukar untuk menyelamatkan mangsa," katanya ketika ditemui media di lokasi kejadian semalam.

Bomba menjelaskan, pihaknya dari BBP Batu Lintang menggunakan satu aliran 200 kaki dan dua nozel bagi memadam kebakaran tersebut

manakala anggota dari BBP Padungan melakukan 'fire break' di rumah keempat dan kelima. Akibat insiden itu, dua rumah iaitu rumah pertama dan kedua

musnah 100 peratus manakala rumah ketiga (60 peratus), rumah keempat (50 peratus) dan rumah kelima (20 peratus).

"Setelah keadaan terkawal dan tiada lagi punca kebakaran, pihak bomba melakukan kerja 'overhaul' di rumah kedua dan ketiga serta berusaha mengesan seorang mangsa kanak-kanak yang dikatakan terperangkap.

"Kanak-kanak itu bagaimanapun dijumpai dalam keadaan rentung sekitar jam 3.33 petang di rumah kedua iaitu di bahagian bilik tingkat atas rumah berkenaan," jelasnya.

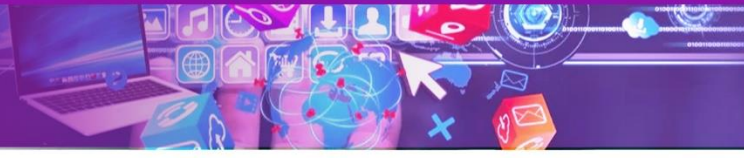

**KUCHING:** Kerajaan Sarawak telah mengenal pasti sebuah lokasi serta meluluskan peruntukan sebanyak RM1.5 juta bagi pembinaan 'Halfway Home Shelter' untuk golongan gelandangan orang kurang upaya (OKU) mental di sini.

Fatimah juga menambah bahawa gelandangan OKU mental berkenaan biasanya akan kembali kepada keadaan asal selepas diselamatkan pihaknya.

Maka dengan tertubuhnya 'Halfway Home Shelter' itu nanti dengan peruntukan

RM750,000 pada tahun depan diharapkan akan membantu golongan rentan yang memerlukan ini.

"Mereka akan dihantar ke Hospital Sentosa untuk dirawat di sana terlebih dahulu dan setelah dibenarkan keluar akan disertakan ubat namun biasanya mereka akan lupa makan ubat tersebut dan kembali kepada keadaan asal.

"Halfway Home Shelter pula adalah sebuah pusat untuk memantau mereka ini dengan bantuan daripada ahli dalam sebuah pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) yang mempunyai keahlian yang pakar akan kesihatan mental," katanya.

Diharap juga ujar Fatimah, angka-angka gelandangan yang mencatatkan sebanyak 33 peratus kes gelandangan dari Januari hingga Julai 2023 akan berkurangan sebanyak 30 peratus menerusi intervensi sosial berkenaan.

## Remaja ditahan, disyaki bunuh rakan kerana cemburu

IPOH: Polis menahan seorang remaja lelaki berusia 17 tahun kerana disyaki membunuh seorang lelaki yang mayatnya ditemui dalam parit di Jalan Pasir, Kampung Sungai Payung Baruh, Rungkup, Bagan Datuk, Rabu lepas.

Ketua Polis Daerah Hilir Perak ACP Ahmad Adnan Basri berkata remaja itu ditahan di Hutan Melintang, Sabtu lepas.

“Mayat dikenal pasti merupakan seorang lelaki tempatan berusia 21 tahun dan mereka berdua adalah rakan dan jiran di sebuah taman perumahan di Te-

luk Intan,” katanya dalam kenyataan semalam.

Beliau berkata siasatan awal mendapati punca pembunuhan adalah disebabkan suspek cemburu kepada si mati kerana mengganggu teman wanitanya yang berusia 20 tahun.

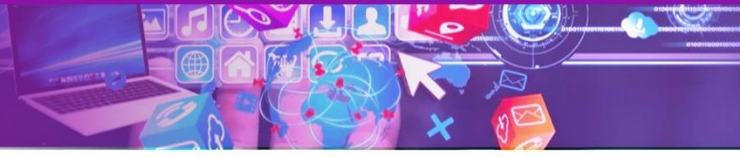
Katanya suspek mengaku membunuh mangsa pada 20 Ogos lepas sebelum membuang mayat si mati di lokasi penemuan mayat tersebut.

Ahmad Adnan turut menafikan maklumat tular mendakwa terdapat dua orang mangsa bunuh dalam kejadian itu.

Rabu lepas, polis menerima maklumat jam 4.48 petang daripada orang awam mengenai penemuan mayat dalam keadaan tertiarap dalam parit di kawasan kebun sawit.

Mangsa yang memakai baju berwarna merah dan berseluar pendek ditemui dengan beberapa kesan luka pada bahagian tangan, kaki dan leher.

Hasil bedah siasat yang dijalankan di Hospital Raja Permaisuri Bainun, Ipoh mendapati punca kematian disebabkan oleh luka potongan pada bahagian kepala dan leher. — Bernama

**KUCHING:** Tempat Transit Gelandangan (TTG) Kuching kini sedang dalam proses tender untuk kerja pengubahsuaian bangunan di Seksyen 8 KTLD Jalan P. Ramlee di sini.

Menurut Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Kanak-Kanak dan Kesejahteraan Komuniti Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah, TTG Kuching itu bakal beroperasi sepenuhnya mulai Mac 2024.

“TTG ini adalah bagi memampatkan serta menawarkan perkhidmatan kepada golongan gelandangan dalam bandar raya Kuching,” katanya kepada pemberita selepas menjalankan Operasi Bersepadu Cerapan Gelandangan malam kelmarin.

Keperluan tersebut penting kerana permasalahan gelandangan paling ramai berlaku di dalam bandar raya Kuching yang juga merupakan ibu negeri Sarawak, tambahnya.

berpunca daripada banyak perkara seperti masalah kewangan, kesihatan, sosial dan isu kekeluargaan yang menyebabkan mereka memilih untuk tinggal di lokasi

tertentu.

Lokasi yang sering kita lihat mereka berada adalah di jalan, perhentian bas, jeti, di bawah pokok, kaki lima bangunan dan sebagainya.

Statistik pihaknya menunjukkan dari Januari hingga Julai tahun ini Kuching mencatatkan jumlah tertinggi golongan gelandangan iaitu seramai 32 orang diikuti Bintulu (13),

Miri (9), Sarikei (8), Kapit (6), Samarahan (6), Sri Aman (5), Serian (4) dan Mukah (1).

Daripada jumlah tersebut 69 daripadanya merupakan gelandangan lelaki dan 24 orang lagi terdiri daripada wanita.

Semalam hasil operasi cerapan bersepadu pihaknya yang dibantu 11 agensi lainnya berjaya mengesan 15 gelandangan lelaki.

Pihaknya telah ke lokasi Lebu Java, Tebingan Kuching, Lebu India, Saujana, Taman Jubli, Bandar Baru Samariang, bangunan hadapan Pejabat AADK dan di Satok.

“Hasil daripadanya didapati sembilan kes mengalami masalah kesihatan mental, dua kes melibatkan masalah dadah dan memerlukan kebebasan dan satu kes masing-masing berkaitan masalah keluarga dan ingin mencari pekerjaan.

Bagaimanapun operasi bersepadu untuk menyelamatkan gelandangan akan di laksanakan pada 2 September depan.
