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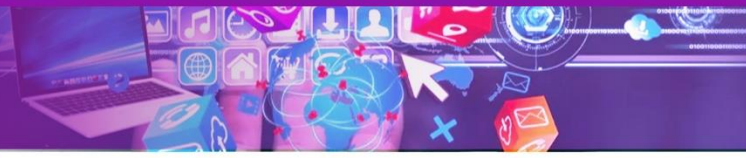

Polis buru lelaki cuba cabul wanita di stesen LRT

Kuala Lumpur: Rapid Rail Sdn Bhd (Rapid Rail) bekerjasama dengan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) untuk memburu seorang lelaki disyaki mengalami gangguan mental yang bertindak agresif mencero boh landasan Transit Aliran Ringan (LRT) dan cuba mencabul seorang penumpang wanita di Stesen LRT Maluri, semalam.

Rapid Rail dalam kenyataan, memaklumkan kejadian dilaporkan jam 7.58 pagi membabitkan seorang lelaki bertindak melulu mencero boh landasan LRT menerusi platform 1 ke platform 2.

“Suspek kemudian cuba mencabul seorang wanita yang sedang menunggu tren di platform itu.

“Ketika kejadian, anggota polis bantuan yang sedang bertugas di platform bertentangan bergegas turun ke bahagian bawah untuk ke platform tempat kejadian bagi memberikan bantuan kepada mangsa yang sedang bergelut dengan suspek,” katanya.

Menurut kenyataan itu, orang awam yang berada di tempat kejadian berjaya membantu meleraikan mangsa daripada suspek, namun gagal member-

kasnya kerana suspek bertindak agresif.

“Suspek kemudian mencero boh landasan dan mengetuk dinding tren yang kebetulan sedang berhenti di stesen. Bagaimanapun, suspek berjaya meloloskan diri daripada stesen berkenaan jam 8.05 pagi.

“Mangsa dan saksi dibawa oleh anggota polis ke balai polis bagi tindakan selanjutnya,” katanya.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Cheras, Asisten Komisioner Zam Halim Jamaluddin, berkata pihak polis membuka satu kertas siasatan berhubung

kejadian berkenaan dan siasatan lanjut sedang dilakukan bagi mengenal pasti suspek.

Katanya, kira-kira jam 9 pagi kelmarin polis mengesan satu rakaman video berdurasi satu minit 10 saat di aplikasi Twitter dimuat naik oleh pemilik akaun ‘localrkyt’.

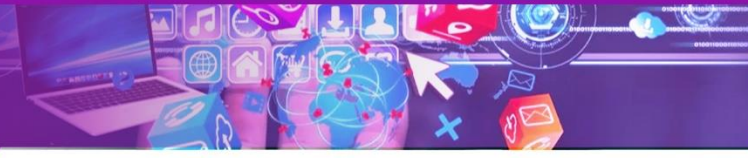
“Rakaman itu memaparkan seorang lelaki melakukan gangguan seksual terhadap seorang wanita di platform LRT, Stesen Maluri, Cheras.

“Hasil semakan mendapati, pada jam 8.49 pagi semalam (kelmarin) polis menerima satu laporan daripada seorang wani-

ta warga tempatan berusia 27 tahun susulan kejadian gangguan seksual itu.

“Polis menasihatkan orang ramai supaya tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi, andaian atau pendapat yang boleh menimbulkan kekeliruan, kekusaran dan ketenteraman awam,” katanya.

Orang ramai yang mempunyai maklumat mengenai lelaki itu boleh memaklumkan kepada pihak polis di talian Hotline Polis Cheras di talian 03-9284 5050/5051, Hotline Polis Kuala Lumpur di talian 03-2115 9999 atau mana-mana balai polis yang berdekatan.

Untuk rekod, kediaman pusaka dihuni mereka terbakar pada 15 April lalu.

Kelmarin, Harian Metro melaporkan Mohd Kamal bersama bapa, Mashuri Mislam, 68, dan ibu, Mas-konah Dahlan, 68, isteri serta lima anak berusia lapan hingga 21 tahun, ter-

Keluarga terbabit dikatakan masih belum mendapat rumah baharu seperti dijan-

jikan menyebabkan mereka tiada pilihan selain berlindung di dalam khemah itu.

"Saya diarahkan pindah, kalau tidak rumah tak dapat.

Syukur ada rumah kosong sekali gus membolehkan kami berteduh sementara rumah baharu dibina. "Saya ucap terima kasih kepada semua termasuk Harian Metro kerana sudi berkongsi kisah kami sekeluarga hingga mendapat perhatian pelbagai pihak," katanya.

Dalam pada itu, Ahli Parlimen Muar Syed Saddiq Syed Abd Rahman berkata, keluarga terbabit bersetuju untuk berpindah sementara menunggu rumah baharu siap.

"Saya bersama pasukan Pusat Khidmat Parlimen Muar sudah melawat dan menyampaikan bantuan wang kecemasan pada 16 April lalu. Ada beberapa pihak tawar untuk tinggal di tempat mereka dan ada rumah sewa, tetapi mangsa memilih untuk tinggal di dalam khemah," katanya.

ner Amihizam Abdul Shukor dilaporkan berkata, sia-

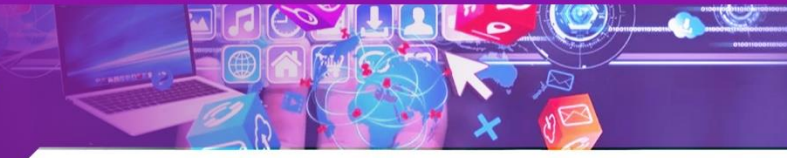

Sementara itu, adiknya, Nur Fathini Khalillah mengakui cenderung dan meminati bidang perniagaan.

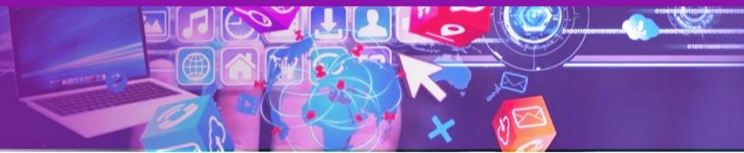

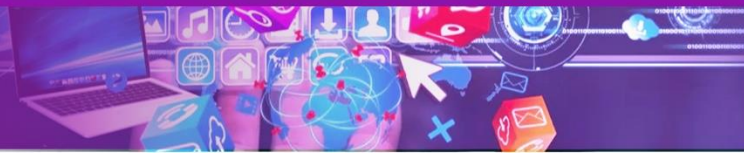

mun akhirnya janji tinggal janji apabila saya mengandung.

“Secara ikhlas saya tidak sanggup untuk menggugurkan kandungan namun kerana diugut oleh lelaki berkenaan menyebabkan saya bertindak berani walaupun mengetahui dosa dan akibat yang akan ditanggung.”

“Saya amat sedih kerana bukan sahaja terlanjur, malah turut bertindak menggugurkan janin yang tidak berdosa,” katanya ketika ditemui di Pejabat Kebajikan Masyarakat Daerah Kuantan di sini, kelmarin.

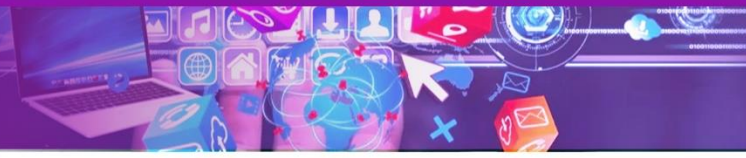
Menurutnya, mahkamah menjatuhkan hukuman kerja khidmat masyarakat selama 120 jam di bawah seliaan Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Pahang selepas mereka ditahan pihak

berkuasa.

“Nasi sudah menjadi bubur...menyesal tidak berguna lagi apabila perbuatan sumbang telah tersebar dan hukuman yang dijatuhkan perlu dilalui dengan reda.”

“Episod hitam yang memalukan keluarga ini mungkin tidak berlaku sekiranya saya menjaga batasan. Kami lupa pada dosa setiap kali melakukan perbuatan yang dilarang agama,” katanya.

Katanya, program khidmat masyarakat termasuk sesi kaunseling yang disertai memberi keinsafan dalam dirinya, sekali gus menambah semangat untuk meneruskan kehidupan yang terang sebelum ini.

RE-ENTERING WORKFORCE

Care-Economy initiative gives single mums chance to work

MELAKA: The government's move to provide a conducive environment for the setting up of affordable childcare centres through the Care-Economy initiative will help housewives, especially single mothers, to re-enter the workforce.

In facilitating the licensing of unregistered nurseries and childcare centres nationwide, the initiative could address systemic issues, such as unpaid care work, gender discrimination and family-support policies.

Melaka Single Mothers' Association chairman Banun Mat Lazim said housewives, especially those widowed at a young age, faced various challenges and were often at a loss on whether

they should go out to work, or stay home to look after their children.

"If they choose to stay home to take care of their children, they will not be able to earn a regular income, forcing them to depend on related government agencies or parties to make ends meet.

"However, if they are employed, they will still need to bear the expensive fees for childcare, and this would be burdensome if they have two or more children" she said yesterday.

As such, Banun said the government's initiative to introduce affordable childcare centres would ease the burden of those struggling to cope after the death of a spouse or breadwinner.

"The children will be in a safer place when their mother goes out to work, and the mothers will also feel more at ease.

"This is a great initiative launched by the government to help the needy, thus encouraging and increasing women's independence and participation in the labour force," she said.

State Women's Affairs, Family Development and Welfare Committee chairman Datuk Kalsom Nordin said as many as 18 nurseries in the state were undergoing the legalisation process.

Among the criteria set was to comply with the conditions outlined by the Social Welfare Department (JKM), the Malaysian Fire and Rescue Department

(JBPM), the state Health Department and local authorities (PBT).

"JBPM, the Health Department and local authorities will conduct a comprehensive inspection, especially on the safety and hygiene of the premises," she said.

National Council of Women's Organisations (NCWO) president Professor Emerita Tan Sri Dr Sharifah Hapsah Syed Hasan said the organisation was pleased with the emphasis on Care Economy and social protection, which could help in reducing the unpaid burden of care, which inordinately fell on women.

"The demand for services in childcare, elderly care, care for people with disabilities, care for children with special needs, in

particular autism, which is on the rise, mental health, personal social and domestic services is increasing with the ageing population and migration of young people away from home.

"Public spending on long-term care against gross domestic product would not be sustainable if the burden of care is not shared with the non-governmental sector and private enterprises."

She said NCWO was committed to promoting the growth of the Care Economy nationwide, which had the potential to attract investments and create jobs, especially for the B40 group, women and youths, thus reducing the dependency on low-skilled foreign workers. **Bernama**

COPS PROBING ALLEGED MOLEST ATTEMPT

Commuters help free woman from clutches of suspect at Maluri platform

A MAN who is believed to be mentally ill allegedly encroached on the Light Rail Transit (LRT) track at the Maluri station and tried to molest a woman on Friday.

Rapid Rail Sdn Bhd said the incident took place before 8am.

"The suspect had attempted to molest a woman who was waiting for a train at the platform.

"Auxiliary police on duty at the opposite platform rushed to assist the victim.

"Members of the public separated the victim from the suspect. But they were unable to restrain the suspect as he was aggressive.

"The suspect then encroached on the track and banged on the side of a train that was waiting at the station. The suspect fled the station at 8.05am."

Rapid Rail said police brought the victim and eyewitnesses to a

police station for further action.

It said auxiliary police were assisting police with investigations to track down the suspect.

"Rapid Rail regrets the incident. Swift action has been taken to heighten safety measures by adding more auxiliary police at the station to prevent a recurrence of the incident."

A one-minute long video of the incident made its rounds on social media on Friday.

On Twitter, a woman claiming to be the victim issued a public plea for the video not to be shared, citing trauma as well as the ongoing investigation.



Cheras district police chief Assistant Commissioner Zam Halim Jamaluddin said the victim lodged a report on Friday.

"Police received a report from a 27-year-old Malaysian woman on July 28 at 8.49am on the incident. An investigation paper has been opened under Section 354 of the Penal Code.

"Investigations are ongoing to identify the suspect."

Model who insulted traffic policemen out on bail

KUALA LUMPUR: A model who allegedly insulted two policemen for issuing her a traffic summons has been released on police bail.

Police said the woman's statement was recorded after she was brought in for questioning.

On Thursday, police spotted a 40-second clip on TikTok of the incident involving the model and social media influencer.

In the clip, the woman lost her cool at two policemen who confronted her for not wearing a seat-belt and using a mobile phone while driving in Brickfields here.

The *New Sunday Times* learnt that the woman was detained at her house and brought to the Brickfields district police headquarters to record her statement.

Brickfields district police chief Assistant Commissioner Ami-

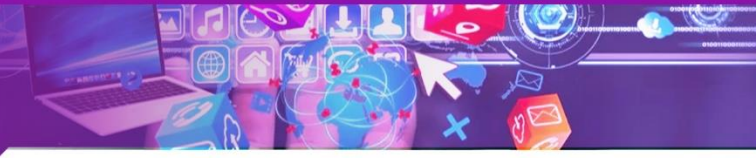
hizam Abdul Shukor said the case was being investigated for obstructing civil servants from carrying out their duty and for offensive online content intended to threaten or harass another person.

"The provocation happened on Monday about 3.40pm.

"The video is still accessible on TikTok. It has 274 shares on Facebook and 5,414 shares on TikTok.

"We are concerned that the video on social media will affect the image of the police."

Checks by the NST found that the 40-second video clip, which was widely shared on TikTok and Facebook, was not recorded or uploaded by the suspect, but by TikTok user @chellom01.

Chumbaka way to develop children's life skills

Social enterprise aims to ignite the passion for learning in kids

PETALING JAYA: When Choo Wai Heng and Dr Teoh Chin Soon founded a training organisation focusing on providing training to engineers in the electrical and electronics industry in 2002, they noticed one aspect that stuck out like a sore thumb.

Many engineering graduates seemed to be having difficulties in answering fundamental science questions.

Despite possessing high grades, the graduates were not motivated to learn.

Realising this, both Choo and Dr Teoh started hands-on science workshops for children.

Concurrently, Teach for Malaysia fellows Nigel Sim and Chong Zhi Xiong noticed the exact problems at schools they were teaching where they too decided to adopt project-based learning in their classrooms.

As fate would have it, the quartet then crossed paths in 2014, with discussions leading to the birth of Chumbaka.

Having officially started in 2016, the social enterprise has

since expanded from its first chapter in Cyberjaya to nine across major cities in Malaysia.

In addition, the social enterprise also made its way into Singapore, Thailand and Australia.

At present, Chumbaka has successfully reached over 1,000 schools, benefiting more than 1,500 teachers and 5,000 students across the country.

Chong, who is now Chumbaka's chief technology officer, said the social enterprise aimed to develop children's life skills through technology and innovation enrichment programmes.

"We help students learn through open-source technologies, covering domains such as coding, programming, electronics, app development, Artificial Intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT), Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR), among others.

"We aspire to reignite all children's passion for learning. Technology was chosen as the learning subject as today's learners need to be more technologically fluent to thrive in the current technology-rich world," he said.

Chong added that there were

free and paid programmes tailored for students, educators, schools and communities.

Chumbaka also works closely with teachers through professional training and capacity building, to enable them to empower schools with up-to-date technology content relevant to the Fourth Industrial Revolution (IR4.0), he said.

Its vision, Chong said, was to implement a 'Go Deep' approach in 100 schools across Malaysia by 2025.

"We want to provide comprehensive technology and innovation education for all students, not only beyond but also within schooling hours.

"Our goal is to ensure that 50% of these schools come from underprivileged communities with funding secured through grants and our own initiatives.

"Simultaneously, the remaining 50% will actively contribute to the financial sustainability of Chumbaka's operations," he said.

As a social enterprise, Chong said Chumbaka is committed to keeping costs low through using open-source software and hardware to ensure their content was

affordable and accessible to all children in the country.

"Educational content is offered to private and international schools. In alignment with our social commitment, the same high-quality content and capacity building opportunities are extended to teachers from public school.

"We are also working closely with other organisations to bring tech education to students in need," he added.

Chong said ultimately, Chumbaka was about integrating human values and life skills in students' courses through project-based learning.

"Our students are always given real-world problems to solve, to help them develop problem-solving skills and learn to work collaboratively.

"In addition to technical skills, students can develop teamwork, communication skills and critical thinking through public showcases and peer-learning environments.

"These are essential for success in today's world but are not usually taught in traditional classrooms," he said.

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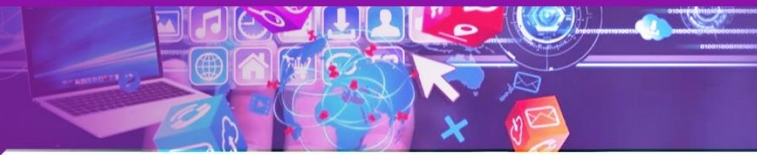

Johor Baru Befrienders looking for volunteers

JOHOR BARU: The Befrienders here is hoping to get at least 30 new volunteers this year to field calls to the centre.

Johor Baru Befrienders president Danny Loo said 60% of its existing 60 volunteers are women.

"They have been with us for many years," he said.

Loo said most of them are retir-

ees aged 60 years or above and previously worked as nurses, teachers, human resource managers or senior management staff.

He said besides retirees, there are also working adults aged between 30 and 60 who spend three hours weekly at the association taking calls from those suffering from mental health issues such as anxiety and depression.

"It's always a challenge for us to

get volunteers and we are hoping to get at least 30 more new volunteers this year," said Loo, adding that new volunteers will have to undergo a 10-week training.

However, the dropout rate among the trainees is rather high.

"Out of 20 new volunteers attending the training, half will quit halfway through," he said.

On being a volunteer at Befrienders, Loo said the candidate has to have passion and

patience. They must not be judgemental or emotional apart from being willing to listen to anonymous callers.

He said on average, they receive 500 calls monthly compared with 800 during the Covid-19 pandemic when many Malaysians were out of jobs and facing difficulties during the health crisis.

Johor Baru Befrienders, said Loo, is also focusing on outreach programmes by setting up booths

at government and private hospitals, tertiary institutions and schools here.

He said the association is also looking to raise RM150,000 to build a training room to teach public listening skills and stress management for free.

He said an annual dinner will be held on Aug 4, with a table going for RM1,500 or RM2,000 each.
