Anak pukul bapa sampai mati, buang mayat tepi jalan

Lelaki berang selalu kena marah ketuk ayah guna penyodok pasir

Petaling Jaya: Berang kerana terlalu kerap dimarahi dan dihina kerana malas bekerja dipercayai menjadi motif seorang lelaki memukul bapanya dengan penyodok pasir sehingga mati dalam kejadian di sebuah rumah di Jalan PJS 10/9A, Bandar Sunway di sini, Sabtu lalu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Petaling Jaya, Asisten Komisioner Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid, berkata kejadian dipercayai berlaku kira-kira jam 12 tengah malam, ketika dua beranak itu bertengkar kerana isu sama.

Menurut beliau, siasatan mendapati suspek sudah dua tahun tidak bekerja dan kerap menghabiskan wang untuk membeli minuman keras.

"Perkara itu menjadikan mang-

sa kerap memarahi suspek sehingga pada hari kejadian, suspek yang berusia 40-an dipercayai hilang sabar dan memukul kepala serta tubuh bapanya beberapa kali dengan penyodok pasir.

"Suspek kemudian membalut tubuh bapanya yang tidak sedarkan diri dengan langsir dan dimasukkan ke dalam kereta sebelum memandu ke Jalan PJS 10/24 dan mencampakkan bapanya di tepi jalan," katanya dalam sidang media di sini, semalam.

Katanya, seorang saudara mangsa yang menyedari mangsa tiada di rumah kemudian cuba mencarinya sebelum menemuinya dalam keadaan terbaring di tepi Jalan PJS10/24, iaitu dua kilometer dari rumah mangsa, kira-kira jam 2.15 pagi, hari sama.

Proses bedah siasat

"Perkara itu dilaporkan ke Balai Polis Sungai Way sebelum sepasukan polis dan pasukan perubatan dari Pusat Perubatan Universiti Malaysia (PPUM) dikejarkan ke lokasi.

"Bagaimanapun, pasukan perubatan mengesahkan mangsa sudah meninggal dunia dan mayatnya kemudian dihantar ke PPUM untuk proses bedah siasat," katanya.

Berikutan itu, katanya polis

menahan seorang lelaki yang juga anak mangsa berusia 40-an pada jam 9.10 pagi hari sama di kawasan perumahan di Jalan PJS 10/9A untuk siasatan.

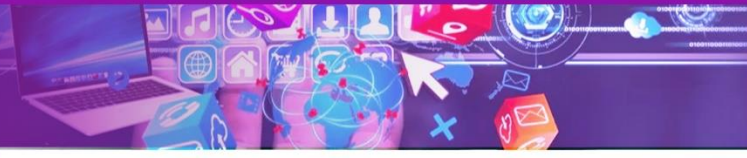
"Pada jam 11.30 pagi, sepasukan polis ke rumah mangsa dan merampas satu penyodok pasir yang dipercayai digunakan suspek memukul bapanya. Polis turut merampas sebuah kereta jenis Perodua Kelisa yang digunakan suspek.

"Motif pembunuhan ini adalah kerana suspek tidak berpuas hati dengan tindakan mangsa yang selalu menghina suspek dan memberi tekanan kepada suspek yang malas bekerja dan gemar minum minuman keras," katanya.

Tambah Mohamad Fakhruddin, suspek dan mangsa tinggal bersama berdua dan sering bertengkar kerana perangai suspek yang tidak bekerja.

"Semakan mendapati suspek mempunyai dua rekod lampau kes jenayah berkaitan kes pecah amanah dan memiliki senjata berbahaya, manakala ujian saringan air kencing pula negatif.

"Suspek kini direman tujuh hari hingga 2 September ini dan kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan iaitu pembunuhan," katanya.

Tidak tahan dikritik dikatakan menjadi punca seorang lelaki tergamak memukul bapa kandungnya sehingga mati menggunakan penyodok pasir di kediaman mereka di Jalan PJS10 di sini, jam 12 tengah malam Sabtu lalu.

Ketua Polis Daerah Petaling Jaya Asisten Komisyoner Mohamad Fakhru-din Abdul Hamid berkata, mangsa yang ketika itu dipercayai mabuk, memukul bapanya sehingga mati.

Menurutnya, suspek kemudian membalut mayat mangsa menggunakan kain langsir sebelum di buang di tepi jalan di mana

Bunuh bapa tak tahan dihina

Lelaki pukul bapa guna penyodok pasir sebelum balut mangsa guna kain langsir

dia ditemui jam 2.15 pagi.

"Suspek yang dipercayai sudah dua tahun tidak bekerja itu pernah berkahwin sebelum tinggal bersama bapanya di rumah terbabit.

"Motif pembunuhan dipercayai kerana suspek tidak berpuas hati terhadap mangsa yang selalu menghina dan memberi tekanan kepada suspek yang malas

bekerja.

"Mangsa juga sering menegur suspek kerana dia gemar mengambil minuman beralkohol," katanya pada sidang media di Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Petaling Jaya di sini, semalam.

Terdahulu, Harian Metro melaporkan mayat seorang warga emas ditemui berbalut langsir diper-

cayai mati akibat dibelasah anak kandung.

Menurut sumber, mayat lelaki berusia 70-an itu ditemui di tepi jalan berhampiran Kondominium Suriamas di sini, tidak jauh daripada rumah keluarga itu.

Pemeriksaan di rumah mangsa menemui kesan tompokan darah di dinding dan pintu bilik tidur

mangsa serta kesan seretan di ruang tamu.

Mengulas lanjut, Fakhru-din berkata, mayat mangsa ditemui saudaranya yang sedang mencari warga emas itu kerana diberitahu mangsa menghilangkan diri.

Katanya, saudara mangsa membuat laporan jam 2.15 pagi selepas menemui mangsa dalam keadaan tidak sedarkan diri di tepi jalan terbabit.

"Suspek berusia 40-an ditahan anggota IPD Petaling Jaya jam 9.10 pagi Sabtu di sekitar kawasan perumahan Jalan 10/9A, Bandar Sunway di sini.

"Hasil soal siasat, pada jam 11.30 pagi, polis pergi ke sebuah rumah di PJS10 dan merampas sebatang penyodok pasir dipercayai digunakan dalam kejadian itu," katanya.

Seorang penghuni sebuah pusat jagaan rehabilitasi ketidakupayaan mental dan warga emas dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam atas dakwaan membunuh seorang peng-

huni lain, minggu lalu.

Bagaimanapun, tiada pengakuan direkodkan daripada tertuduh, Lai Mun Kong, 50, apabila pertuduhan dibacakan di hadapan Majistret Jessecia Daimis.

Berdasarkan kertas pertuduhan, lelaki itu didakwa membu-

nuh dengan menyebabkan kematian Lim Han Tong, 42, di Blok A, pusat jagaan di Chemor di sini, antara jam 6 pagi hingga 6.50 pagi pada 24 Ogos lalu.

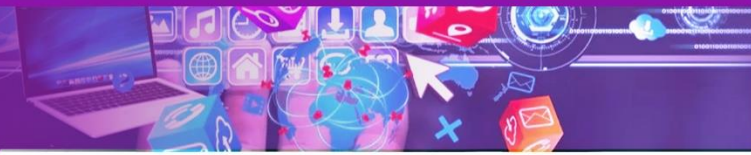
Kesalahan didakwa mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan, yang jika sabit kesalahan mem-

peruntukkan hukuman mati.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan oleh Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Nur Aqilah Syaza Ariffin manakala tertuduh tidak diwakili peguam.

Tiada jaminan ditawarkan dan mahkamah menetapkan 29 September depan sebagai tarikh sebutan semula kes sementara menunggu laporan kimia.

KKM beri vaksin Tdap cegah pertussis percuma tahun depan

Putrajaya: Semua ibu hamil di Malaysia termasuk bukan warganegara diberikan vaksin kombinasi tetanus-difteria-pertussis (Tdap) percuma, bermula tahun depan (2024).

Menteri Kesihatan Dr Zaliha Mustafa berkata, berkata inisiatif baharu berkenaan membabitkan peruntukan tahunan RM25 juta meliputi anggaran 500,000 ibu hamil pada setiap tahun, bertujuan mengurangkan risiko jangkitan pertussis terutama dalam kalangan bayi berumur bawah lima bulan.

Beliau dalam kenyataan berkata, pelaksanaannya bermula selepas urusan perolehan bekalan vaksin Tdap selesai dan bekalan vaksin berkenaan tersedia

di kemudahan kesihatan Kementerian Kesihatan (KKM) di seluruh negara.

“Apabila dilaksanakan kelak, semua ibu hamil, termasuk bukan warganegara, diberikan satu dos vaksin Tdap ketika trimester kedua atau ketiga kehamilan (antara tempoh kehamilan 13 hingga 36 minggu) secara percuma di fasiliti kesihatan primer KKM di seluruh negara,” katanya.

Menurut Dr Zaliha, pemberian vaksin Tdap kepada ibu hamil memberi perlindungan kepada bayi bermula dari dalam kandungan sehingga lahir dan melengkapkan tiga dos primer vaksin pertussis pada umur lima bulan, melalui antibodi dari tubuh ibu

yang dipindahkan kepada bayi dari dalam kandungan.

Beliau berkata, bayi berumur bawah lima bulan adalah kumpulan paling berisiko tinggi mendapat jangkitan pertussis dan mengalami komplikasi penyakit berkenaan seperti pneumonia (radang paru-paru), encephalopathy (radang otak) dan kematian.

Dr Zaliha berkata, ia berlaku kerana antibodi dalam tubuh bayi hanya mencapai tahap perlindungan optimum apabila bayi lengkap menerima tiga dos vaksin pertussis yang diberikan di bawah Program Imunisasi Kebangsaan apabila berumur lima bulan.

Sazali mohon dana pembedahan isteri

Kuala Lumpur: Anak Allahyarham Tan Sri P Ramlee, Sazali, 64, (*gambar*) memohon bantuan kewangan buat isterinya, Hamidah Hitam, 61, yang akan menjalani pembedahan akibat masalah tulang belakang dan saraf di leher.

Sazali berkata, isterinya yang sudah lama berdepan masalah kesihatan itu dinasihatkan doktor supaya membuat pembedahan di leher segera, namun tidak dapat berbuat demikian kerana keangan kewangan dihadapi.

"Saya pun ada masalah kesihatan dan sudah tidak boleh bekerja lagi macam dulu. Pendapatan daripada royalti arwah bapa saya yang diterima setiap tahun me-

mang menjadi sumber kewangan untuk meneruskan kelangsungan hidup.

"Malah, bayaran royalti terakhir P Ramlee untuk bahagian saya yang diterima pada 31 Julai lalu daripada Badan Perlindungan Hak Cipta Muzik Berhad (MACP) hanya kira-kira RM9,000 dan tidak cukup untuk menampung kos pembedahan isteri," katanya.

Sazali berkata, doktor memaklumkan kos pembedahan itu sebanyak RM14,000.

Sazali juga sangat berharap dapat berjumpa dengan Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim untuk memohon bantuan.

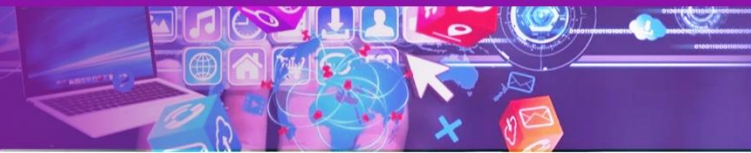

Cops believe unemployed man murdered father for constantly berating him

An elderly man, in his 70s, is believed to have been killed by his son last Saturday.

Petaling Jaya district police chief Assistant Commissioner Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid said the murder was believed to have occurred at 12.30am at the victim's home.

He said police received information at 2.15am on the same day after the body was discovered by a relative by the roadside at PJS 10/24 here.

The body was found wrapped in a curtain fabric with injuries to the head and a broken left hand as well as bruises on the chest.

"Based on the information received, police detained a man in his 40s at a housing

area in PJS 10/9A, Bandar Sunway, here.

"The suspect, who has been jobless for two years, is believed to have been enraged by the victim's insults and constant pressure to find work.

"The victim is said to have kept pressuring the suspect for being lazy and constantly consuming alcohol," he said at a press conference at the district police headquarters yesterday.

Fakhruddin said police seized a shovel, which is believed to be the murder weapon, and a car believed to have been

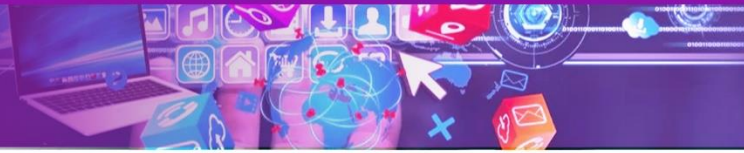
used by the suspect to transport the body.

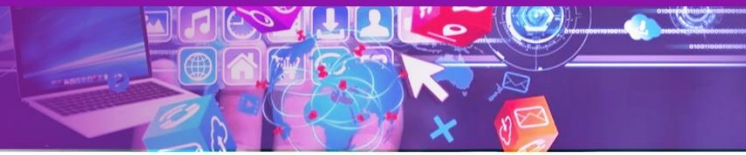

MoH's C-HAT project out to address obesity problem among Malaysian schoolkids

KUCHING: The rising number of obese schoolchildren has prompted the Ministry of Health (MoH) to implement the 'C-HAT (Your Best Way of Living) Intervention Project', meant to guide them towards leading a healthier lifestyle.

In stating this, Deputy Health Minister Lukanisman Awang Sauni said based on National Health and Morbidity Survey (NHMS), the prevalence of overweight teenagers aged 13 to 17 in Malaysia increased from 14 per cent in 2012 to 15.2 per cent in 2017, and 16.2 per cent last year.

He also said the same survey showed the prevalence of obesity among these youngsters had also increased from 10.6 per cent in 2012 to 13.3 per cent in 2017, and 14.3 per cent in 2022.

However, the Sibuti MP said in order for the programme to work, it would need the cooperation from the parents.

"It is also not an extra burden on the teachers, but as a way to create a healthier school environment.

"We also intend to make it applicable by the Ministry of Education in the future for the schools to draft suitable activities for the students.

"As you can see from the students who have turned up

at today's event, some of them are big-sized and heavyset. They are whom we want to do intervention; in other words, to slim the kids down.

"This is also to prevent other problems such as bullying and mental health issues from afflicting them," the federal deputy minister said in a press conference held after the launch

of the C-HAT Intervention Project at SK St Thomas here yesterday.

Lukanisman also said nowadays, children had become more exposed to processed foods, which many working parents might deem as being more affordable and easier to prepare.

"The parents might not be

monitoring the consumption, which could lead to the children not having the right nutrition.

"The Covid-19 pandemic for three years could also have contributed to this, as children did get to do physical activities," he added.

Earlier in his speech, Lukanisman said apart from reporting the prevalence of overweight and obesity, the NHMS also stated that 92 per cent of children aged 10 to 17 did not eat enough vegetables daily, 67 per cent did not eat enough fruits daily, and 70 per cent did not eat breakfast.

"It's very worrying because it (survey) shows an increasing trend and unhealthy eating practices. In addition, Malaysia also has the second highest

number of obese children and adolescents in Southeast Asia," he said.

Lukanisman added that this problem encompassed all socio-demographic categories including areas (urban or rural), household income, ethnic group, occupation and education level. He said children who were overweight and obese would be at risk of developing diet-related non-communicable diseases (NCDs) such as diabetes and hypertension upon becoming adults.

"Furthermore, many children look at screens such as computer

games, tablets, television for more than two hours a day. Such long period of time is associated with the problem of obesity in children, apart from excessive food intake."

On the C-HAT Intervention Project, Lukanisman said it involved 49 schools in 10 states, with a total of 2,427 students having agreed to participate.

According to him, the project is implemented by MoH in collaboration with the United Nations Children's Fund (Unicef), which has contributed US\$250,000 for the six-month

intervention programme involving the provision of body fat analyser equipment, 'bodymeters', pedometer watches, exercise mats and a host of other items.

"This obesity intervention project is based on a comprehensive intervention module involving the components of nutrition, physical activities and exercises, as well as mental health and psychology," he said, adding that the MoH would welcome any collaboration with those from the corporate sector towards implementing similar

programmes in schools.

"The country is not just facing the problem of obesity but also malnutrition, especially among children under five years of age and this requires serious attention and a more sustainable approach towards obtaining optimal impact."

Also present yesterday were Health deputy director general (Public Health) Datuk Dr Norhayati Rosli, Department of Health Sarawak director Dr Ooi Choo Huck and deputy Unicef representative in Malaysia, Sanja Saranovic.

No critical whooping cough cases in Sarawak — Lukanisman

KUCHING: Only 11 cases of whooping cough or 'batuk kokol' (pertussis) have been recorded in Sarawak as of this month, said Lukanisman Awang Sauni.

The figure is 3.2 per cent of the total 343 whooping cough cases recorded throughout the country this year.

"In Sarawak, so far we have not received any critical cases," Lukanisman, who is Deputy Health Minister, told reporters after officiating at a Ministry of Health (MoH) event here yesterday.

Also present were deputy director general of Health (Public Health) Datuk Dr Norhayati Rosli and Sarawak Health director Dr Ooi Choo Huck.

Four of the cases in the state were recorded in Kapit, three in Miri, two in Bintulu, while there was one case each in Kuching and Sibu.

All the cases were classified as light and stable.

Despite the low cases of whooping cough in Sarawak, Lukanisman urged pregnant mothers to sign up for the tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine, which will be provided by MoH to lower pertussis infection risks.

He stressed that the vaccination is important and called for greater awareness through the media.

"We have to admit there are still anti-vaccine groups among us. There are also some parents unaware on what to, which is why we need to raise the awareness level.

"This is because the big chunk of 343 cases reported in Malaysia involved infants under five months old," he pointed out.

According to an MoH statement issued on Aug 28, there were 24 fatalities from the 343 pertussis cases recorded nationwide this year.

A total of 173 (50.4 per cent) cases were infants under five months old, while 19 of the 24 deaths occurred within this vulnerable age group.

MoH said the Tdap vaccination programme for expectant mothers will grant vital immunity to infants from

conception until birth, effectively delivering the necessary three primary pertussis vaccine doses by the age of five months through maternal antibodies transfer.

The programme, with an annual RM25 million budget, aims to cover 500,000 pregnant women each year.

The initiative is set to begin in 2024, depending on vaccine's availability at MoH health facilities across the country.

All pregnant women, including non-citizens, will be provided with a single dose of the Tdap vaccine for free during their second or third trimester (between 13 and 36 weeks) at MoH primary health facilities nationwide.

Pertussis is said to cause serious illness in people of all ages but is most dangerous for babies, with vaccination providing the best protection.

Recently, social media posts had urged the public not to go to or meet with people in Pekan and Rompin in Pahang following reports of a pertussis outbreak.

The authorities have since dismissed the posts, stressing the situation is under control.

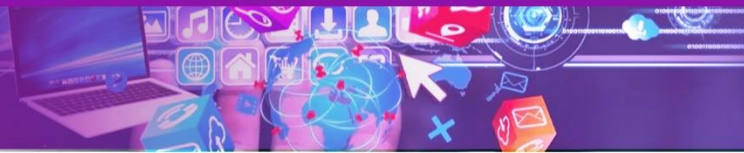

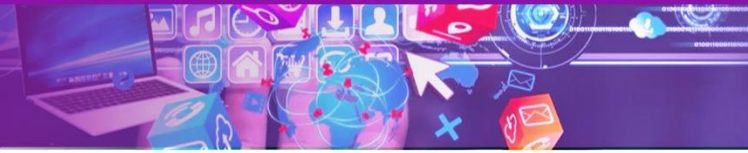

Nancy: Tribunal for Anti-Sexual Harassment needs AGC's nod

KUALA LUMPUR: The much-awaited Tribunal for Anti-Sexual Harassment is merely waiting for the final nod from the Attorney-General's Chambers (AGC), says Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri. She said the approval of the AGC was crucial as members of the tribunal comprised lawyers.

"We have already submitted a complete list with the names of the members that will be on the tribunal.

"But for this, we have to refer to the AGC because the members are lawyers. As such, they must know

how to read and translate the law themselves.

"This is because the members are the ones who will make the decisions at the tribunal. Cases at the tribunal are considered civil cases," she said yesterday.

Asked about the timeline for the tribunal, Nancy again reassured that it would be set up before the year's end.

The tribunal is a critical part of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act 2022, which was passed by Parliament in August last year.

Since its gazettelement on Oct 18, 2022, many groups have anticipated that the tribunal will also be set up soon.

Without the presence of the tribunal, the ministry announced in

March that only several sections of the Act have come into force, including (i) Section 1 – Simple Titles and Commencement; (ii) Section 2 – Interpretation; (iii) Section 24 – Administrator; (iv) Section 25 – Functions and powers of the administrator; and (v) Section 26 – Power to make regulations.

However, the setting up of the tribunal has taken much longer than expected by stakeholders, many of whom have been waiting for decades for the law to come into force. Members of the tribunal will comprise a president and a deputy, who must have judicial experience.

There will be a minimum of five other members who also

must have judicial or legal experience.

The tribunal will deliberate on sexual harassment complaints and provide a mechanism for anyone who has been sexually harassed to seek redress.

Earlier, Nancy, together with Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek, joined the Malaysian Social Institute (ISM) Social Talk Series 7 held in conjunction with the National Women's Day celebration on Aug 25.

The Social Talk themed *Women and the Formation of a Civilized Malaysia*, saw Nancy talk on the topic *From Women to Women* while Fadhlina spoke on *Women and Education, Leading Change*.

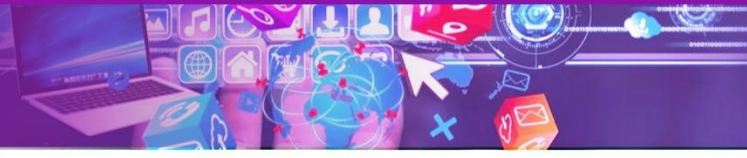
On another matter, Nancy said

the ministry alone could not resolve the issues brought to it alone, as it required the collaboration of several relevant ministries to help address and find solutions.

She said the National Social Council (MSN) meeting, chaired by Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Ahmad Zahid Hamidi, was an avenue to work in a coordinated manner.

"People may think we can solve every problem, but it cannot be done by one ministry alone.

"I am thankful that the Cabinet members attended the (MSN) meeting to ensure that we can work together," she said, adding that the MSN, which was last held on July 27, would be held on a quarterly basis.

Son kills father with a shovel after constant insults

PETALING JAYA: An unemployed man bludgeoned his father to death with a shovel for constantly insulting and belittling him.

The incident occurred in their house at PJS10 at around 12.30am on Saturday following a big argument. In the heat of the moment, the son grabbed a shovel and

attacked his elderly father.

He then wrapped the motionless victim in a curtain and carried him into a car.

After driving for about 2km, he dumped the body by the side of the road.

OCPD Asst Comm Mohamad Fakhruddin Abdul Hamid said police were alerted of the incident at around 2.15am on Saturday.

"Several relatives went looking for the elderly man when they

realised he had gone missing.

"They drove around the area and found his remains by the roadside," he told reporters yesterday.

ACP Mohamad Fakhruddin said police arrested a suspect, in his 40s, near Jalan PJS10/9A, Bandar Sunway, at around 9.10am on the same day.

"Checks showed the suspect has a prior record for criminal breach of trust and possession of

a dangerous weapon.

"He then led us to a house where we found a shovel which was believed to have been used in committing the crime," he said, adding that police also seized a Perodua Kelisa car which was believed to have been used to transport the body.

ACP Mohamad Fakhruddin said the motive for the murder was that the victim was constantly insulting and pestering the sus-

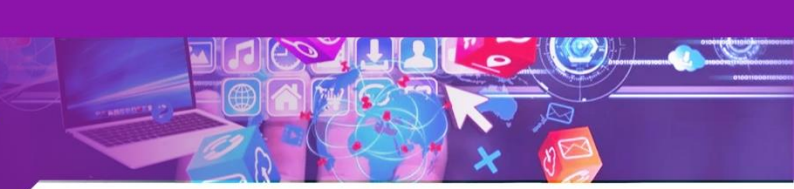
pect to get a job and stop drinking.

"We have remanded the suspect for one week to help with investigations," he said.

According to earlier reports, an elderly man was found dead near a condominium in the PJS10 area.

The victim, wrapped in a curtain, sustained injuries to his head and a broken left hand.

There were also bruises on his chest.

Son of the late P. Ramlee seeks financial aid

THE son of the late Malay cinema icon, Tan Sri P. Ramlee, is requesting financial assistance for his wife's surgery, reported *Harian Metro*.

Sazali, 64, said his wife, Hamidah Hitam, 61, would be undergoing surgery due to spine and nerve problems in her neck.

Sazali said Hamidah had been facing health issues for a long time and was advised by doctors to undergo surgery but was unable to due to financial constraints.

"I also have health problems and can no longer work like I used to. Our main source of income came from my late father's royalties that we receive every year.

"In fact, the last royalty payment was received on July 31 from the Music Copyright Protection Authority. The amount was only around RM9,000 and not enough to cover the cost of my wife's surgery," he said, adding that doctors had told him that the surgery would cost RM14,000.

Sazali said he hoped to meet the Prime Minister to discuss the contract for his father's royalties, which ended on May 29 this year, 50 years after his death.

Previously, Sazali's request for an extension of the royalties' contract was expected to be resolved by the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Minister, Datuk Seri Sala-

huddin Ayub, but the Pulau MP unexpectedly died on July 23.

"Now, I do not know where else to go and discuss the extension of the royalty contract," said Sazali, who also receives RM900 in monthly assistance from the Selangor Zakat Center and Social Welfare Department.

P. Ramlee died of a heart ailment on May 29, 1973, leaving an artistic legacy through film artwork and songs.

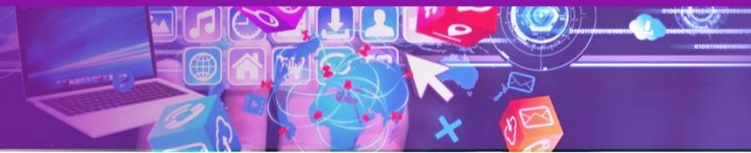

KUCHING: Sejumlah 10 sekolah di sekitar Kuching dan Padawan terlibat dengan projek Inisiatif Pemerkasaan Persatuan Ibu Bapa Dan Guru (PIBG): Cara Hidup Anda Terbaik yang dikenali sebagai Inisiatif C-HAT.

Timbalan Menteri Kesihatan Lukanisman Awang Sauni berkata, projek kolaboratif antara Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) dengan Tabung Kanak-Kanak Pertubuhan Bangsa-Bangsa Bersatu (UNICEF) itu merupakan usaha yang berterusan dalam mengekang masalah obesiti dalam kalangan murid sekolah.

Menurutnya, Tinjauan Kesihatan dan Morbiditi Kebangsaan (NHMS) yang mendapati terdapat peningkatan prevalen berlebihan berat badan dalam kalangan remaja berumur 13 hingga 17 tahun dari tahun 2012 hingga 2022, adalah sangat membimbangkan.

Selain itu katanya, kajian NHMS 2017 juga melaporkan 92 peratus murid berumur 10-17 tahun tidak mengambil sayur-sayuran yang mencukupi sehari, 67 peratus murid tidak mengambil buah-buahan mencukupi sehari dan 70 peratus murid tidak

mengambil sarapan pagi.

Menyedari situasi ini katanya, pihak KKM telah melaksanakan Inisiatif C-HAT yang melibatkan ahli PIBG/PIBKS secara sukarela dilantik sebagai Jurulatih Utama (JU) C-HAT untuk melaksanakan aktiviti pemakanan dan kesihatan ke arah menangani masalah obesiti di sekolah.

“Selain itu, pelaksanaan projek ini juga bermula susulan daripada kejayaan program pengurusan berat badan Smart Fit di beberapa sekolah di Perak, Pulau Pinang dan Program Less Obesity di Johor,” ujarnya ketika berucap pada

Majlis Kick-Off Projek Intervensi C-Hat di Sekolah Kebangsaan St Thomas, di sini semalam.

Mengulas lanjut beliau berkata, untuk pelaksanaan projek ini, pihak UNICEF telah bermurah hati memperuntukkan sejumlah AS\$250,000 bagi intervensi selama enam bulan.

“Ia melibatkan pemberian peralatan (kesihatan) seperti bodyfat analyser, bodymeter, pedometer watch, exercise mat dan sebagainya kepada pihak sekolah dan murid-murid terlibat.

“Projek Intervensi Obesiti ini berpandukan kepada satu modul intervensi

komprehensif melibatkan komponen pemakanan, aktiviti fizikal dan senaman, kesihatan minda dan psikologi yang telah dibentuk,” kata Ahli Parlimen Sibuti itu.

Beliau dalam pada itu berharap projek itu berjalan dengan baik, mencapai objektif yang telah digariskan dan seterusnya memberi impak yang sangat membanggakan kepada semua pihak termasuk KKM, Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia (KPM), pihak sekolah, ibu bapa dan yang paling utama murid-murid yang terlibat.

hukuman menanti pesalah ialah penjara antara 10 dan 30 tahun dan sebatan.

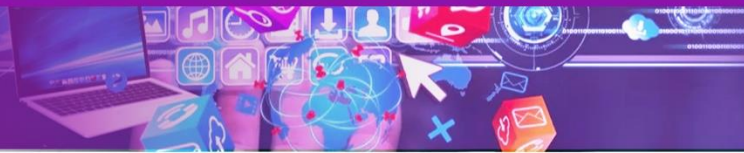

Terdahulu menurut Ismaidi, mereka turut menerima satu panggilan kecemasan berhubung kebakaran melibatkan sebuah rumah kosong di Lorong Melor 2B, Tudan Fasa 1 di sini, semalam.

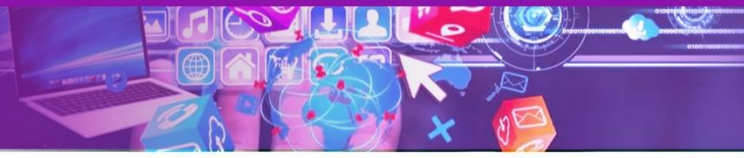

Tiada kes kritikal batuk kokol di Sarawak

KUCHING: Tiada kes kritikal membabitkan wabak pertussis atau batuk kokol dilaporkan di Sarawak setakat ini, ujar Timbalan Menteri Kesihatan Lukanisman Awang Sauni.

Beliau berkata, walaupun tidak menerima sebarang kes yang agak kritikal, pihaknya menekankan mengenai kepentingan vaksin kombinasi tetanus-difteria-pertussis (Tdap) bagi golongan ibu-ibu hamil. Ia ujarinya, bagi mengurangkan risiko jangkitan pertussis, terutamanya dalam kalangan bayi berumur bawah lima bulan.

"Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) telah mengeluarkan kenyataan rasmi pada Isnin (28 Ogos 2023) yang menyatakan bagi tahun ini sehingga 23 Ogos 2023, sejumlah 343 kes batuk kokol dengan 24 kematian dilaporkan di seluruh Malaysia.

"Daripada 343 kes tersebut, 173 daripadanya membabitkan bayi berumur lima bulan ke bawah. Di sini kita dapat melihat perlunya kesedaran untuk membuat vaksinasi kepada bayi-bayi secara lengkap.

"Vaksinasi sangat penting dan kita berusaha untuk bekerjasama dengan
