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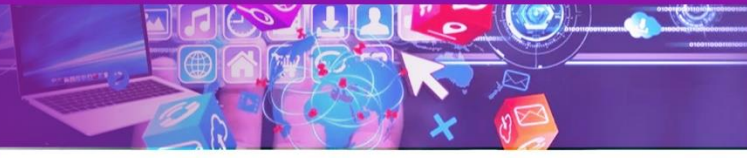

More than 18,000 child abuse cases recorded

○ Some 16,000 reports involved rape, physical sexual assault on a child and incest

PETALING JAYA: The Bukit Aman Women and Children Sexual Crime Investigation Division has revealed a total of 18,326 cases involving child victims of sexual crimes were recorded from 2018 to November 2023.

Women's Centre for Change (WCC) advocacy coordinator Hastiny Subramaniam said 16,447 of the total cases fell under the top three categories of rape, physical sexual assault on a child and incest.

"Despite the efforts and existence of comprehensive laws that address the matter, many cases still go unreported due to a lack of awareness on the dangers of child sexual abuse," she said, adding that sexual abuse can impact any child regardless of gender, sexual orientation, disability or socioeconomic status.

"These intersecting factors contribute to a child's vulnerability in disclosing sexual abuse and accessing justice. Children from marginalised groups and the stateless are likely to face more obstacles in

seeking justice.

"Disable children are also at a higher risk of being sexually abused due to the cognitive and communication challenges."

Hastiny said perpetrators will take advantage of their disabilities to continue abusing them and often groom their victims, manipulate, exploit their trust and desensitize them through gifts and attention.

She said child sexual abuse may also happen in families, plagued by poverty, substance abuse and domestic violence.

"Parents and guardians often believe child sexual abuse is typically committed by strangers. However, police statistics and WCC data show over 90% of the perpetrators already possess the children's or family members' trust, which makes them less likely to be discovered or accused."

She also said many cases remain unreported because parents assume the child is lying about the abuse or "imagining" it, adding that it is extremely rare for a child to lie about such incidents.

"When children believe they are not being taken seriously, it discourages them from coming forward, leading to the likelihood of the abuse continuing.

"This could also impact the child's trust in adults and their relationships with peers, fearing that anyone could resemble the perpetrator. Survivors find it difficult to form healthy relationships as they struggle

with feelings of mistrust and vulnerability."

Hastiny emphasised the importance of parents teaching their children the concepts of "good touch" and "bad touch" to ensure their safety and well-being.

"Remind your children they have a right to their bodies and to inform their trusted adults if anyone touches them in a way that makes them uncomfortable."

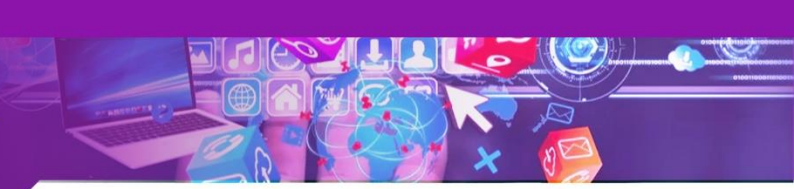
United Nations Children's Fund (Unicef) Malaysia child protection chief Saskia Blume said children are also prone to experience sexual abuse online, including being blackmailed to engage in sexual activities, having their nude pictures shared without permission and being coerced into engaging in sexual activities through promises of money or gifts.

Unicef Malaysia data reported in 2022 that at least 4% or 100,000 of internet-using children, aged between 12 and 17, have experienced online sexual exploitation and abuse.

Saskia said children experience abuse or other unwanted online interactions of a sexual nature on social media platforms such as Whatsapp, Facebook, WeChat and Telegram.

She said 9% of the children received sexual comments about them, with most of the comments coming from someone they knew.

"Children often get unwanted requests to talk about sex online. Therefore, it is crucial to talk about staying safe online."



18,433 wanita derita kegunaan rumah tangga

KUALA LUMPUR: Sebanyak 18,433 wanita di negara ini menderita akibat menjadi mangsa kegunaan rumah tangga dalam tempoh empat tahun lalu.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri berkata, mengikut laporan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), sebanyak 3,616 kes kegunaan rumah tangga dalam kalangan wanita direkodkan pada 2020 diikuti 2021 (5,131 kes), 2022 (4,762 kes) dan 2023 (4,924 kes).

"Punca kes didapati berubah pada setiap tahun iaitu disebabkan perselisihan faham dengan sebanyak 2,412 kes pada 2020 manakala tahun 2021 dan 2022 pula berpunca daripada masalah dadah yang masing-masing merekodkan 1,747 kes serta 1,640 kes," katanya ketika ditemui Utusan Malaysia di pejabatnya di Bangunan Parlimen Malaysia, di sini baru-baru ini.

Bagi tahun lalu pula katanya, punca utama berlaku adalah disebabkan panas baran iaitu 1,406 daripada 4,924 kes kegunaan rumah tangga.

Beliau berkata, kementerian cuba menyelami dan merungkai penyebab punca-punca yang membawa kepada kegunaan rumah tangga itu terjadi. Jelas beliau, kementerian mengambil beberapa langkah untuk menangani permasalahan rumah tangga termasuk juga isu perceraian, iaitu antaranya enubuhan Pusat Sakongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS).

"Kementerian pergi lebih dalam iaitu sebagai contoh mengapa dia ambil dadah. Kita akan tanya lebih lanjut dan terperinci melalui sesi kaunseling kerana ingin pastikan tidak berlakunya perceraian.

"Jika mengikut laporan daripada pihak polis, sebanyak 429 dan 216 kes pasangan dalam proses perceraian direkodkan sejak dua tahun kebelakangan ini iaitu bermula dari tahun 2022 sehingga 2023.

"Di pihak kementerian, kami melihat dari sudut untuk cuba menyatukan keluarga semula jadi kami bukan sahaja berbincang dengan pengadu tetapi turut pergi ke yang diadu iaitu dalam kes ini si suami,"ujarnya.

Mengulas lanjut, Nancy berkata, dengan kewujudan PSSS itu, maka dijadikan sebagai rujukan dan perkhidmatan bimbingan kaunseling terutamanya kumpulan sasaran kementeriannya iaitu golongan wanita dan keluarga yang bermasalah.

"Kita ada kaunselor yang bertugas di PSSS, di situ kadang-kadang ia 'pandai' untuk balik semula, terfikir untuk merujuk semula. Polis adalah tempat untuk dia (mangsa) melapor sahaja tetapi kami memang rasa lebih baik mereka dapat dibantu untuk merujuk kembali.

"Kadang-kadang waktu kita panas (marah) cakap nak cerai dan sebagainya tetapi kita tidak mahu itu berlaku, kementerian ada acara tersendiri," jelasnya.

Nancy yang juga Ahli Parlimen Santubong berkata, sehingga kini terdapat tujuh buah PSSS mudah alih di serata tempat yang mana antara terbaharu adalah di Rantau Panjang, Kelantan.

"Setakat ini, sebanyak 42,974 kes aduan diterima dari tujuh buah penubuhan PSSS sehingga bulan Disember 2023," katanya.

Tambahnya, kementerian itu juga bekerjasama dengan agensi dan pertubuhan bukan kerajaan (NGO) bagi bersedia untuk memberi pusat perlindungan kepada wanita yang menjadi mangsa kegunaan rumah tangga terutamanya melibatkan kecederaan fizikal.

"Terdapat empat masjid di Kuala Lumpur manakala satu masjid Perlis dijadikan pusat transit sementara. Ada 12 lagi masjid dijadikan sebagai pusat aduan," katanya.

Namun begitu, jelas Nancy, lokasi sebenar kedudukan masjid yang dijadikan sebagai tempat perlindungan tidak diadahkan secara umum bagi menjamin keselamatan mangsa.

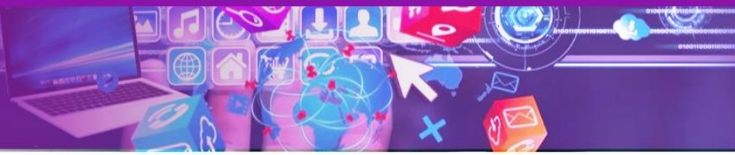
Beliau turut memaklumkan bahawa mangsa atau pengadu juga boleh memanfaatkan Talian Kasih iaitu 15999, di mana perkhidmatan itu beroperasi 24 jam setiap hari yang berfungsi untuk mengemukakan sebarang aduan mahupun permohonan.

"Jadi apabila pengadu telah mengemukakan masalah mereka melalui talian panas ini, pihak kami akan memberi arahan seterusnya, sama ada mereka memerlukan pusat perlindungan sementara di lokasi masjid yang dirahsiakan.

"Selain daripada itu juga, Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) boleh mengeluarkan Perintah Perlindungan Kecemasan (EPO).

"Ini di mana autoriti yang dikeluarkan oleh pihak JKM adalah tindakan segera untuk menyelamatkan mangsa tanpa menunggu pihak polis," katanya.

Dalam pada itu, katanya, langkah-langkah yang dimaklumkan oleh beliau itu adalah seiring dengan Tribunal Anti Gangguan Seksual yang bertujuan meningkatkan kesedaran dan mencegah berlakunya gangguan seksual termasuk kegunaan rumah tangga. – UTUSAN

Nancy sumbang dana untuk 3 masjid, 5 surau Zon Bako sempena Ramadan

KUCHING, 4 Mac: Sebanyak tiga masjid dan lima surau di Zon Bako menerima sumbangan dana fasa satu dan Ramadan berjumlah RM30,000.

Sumbangan itu disampaikan oleh Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat merangkap Ahli Parlimen Santubong, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri semalam.

Setiap masjid akan menerima dana sumbangan masing-masing sebanyak RM5,000, manakala untuk surau pula akan menerima dana sumbangan masing-masing RM3,000.

Dana tersebut merupakan sumbangan fasa satu untuk setiap masjid dan surau menjalankan aktiviti pada bulan Ramadan yang akan datang.

KUALA LUMPUR: Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) menerusi Persatuan Wanita TNB (Pelitawanis), memperkasa kaum wanita dengan memperkukuh peranan mereka berteraskan 5K iaitu kepimpinan, kesihatan, kekeluargaan, kepribadian dan kewangan.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri berkata, program bertemakan 'Wanita Inspirasi Perintis Generasi' dirancang supaya para peserta dapat mendalami peranan wanita dalam semua aspek.

Katanya, inisiatif TNB itu mencerminkan kesungguhan wanita terhadap perjuangan mereka sama ada sebagai pekerja, isteri, ibu dan anak.

"Wanita yang berbekalkan pendidikan serta kegigihan sendiri mampu menembus tembok-tembok penghalang karier mereka.

"Kini, wanita diberi kepercayaan di peringkat membuat keputusan termasuk sebagai Menteri, Timbalan Menteri, Ahli Parlimen, hakim-hakim, ketua setiausaha, ketua pengarah, naib canselor dan ketua setiausaha Kerajaan Negeri.

"Hal ini secara tidak langsung membuktikan bahawa wanita mampu memimpin dan memegang tampuk kepimpinan," katanya merasmikan Seminar *Women in Leadership* di Pusat Konvensyen Leo Moggie TNB Platinum, Bangsar di sini, hari ini.

Majlis tersebut turut dimeriahkan dengan penyampaian Anugerah Wirawati Kepimpinan, Anugerah Wirawati Lestari dan Anugerah Wirawati Harapan kepada Srikandi TNB.

Dalam pada itu, Nancy berkata, kerajaan akan terus menggerakkan agenda pembangunan dan pemerksaan wanita agar golongan itu dapat menyumbang kepada pertumbuhan ekonomi sekali gus meningkatkan kualiti hidup.

"Dalam aspek kewangan dan kepimpinan, perlu diakui bahawa wanita kini merupakan sebahagian penting daripada tenaga kerja global dan ekonomi domestik. Peranan mereka dalam memajukan ekonomi keluarga dan negara tidak dapat dinafikan.

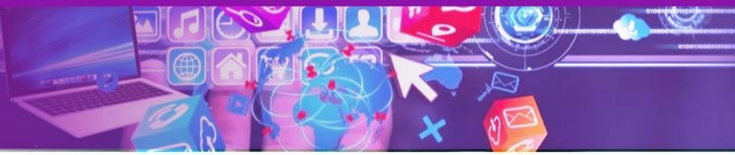
"Penting bagi kita untuk memastikan kesaksamaan jantina dalam pekerjaan dan peluang ekonomi serta menyediakan akses kepada pendidikan dan latihan kepemimpinan supaya wanita dapat memberi sumbangan sepenuhnya kepada ekonomi Malaysia Madani," katanya.

Sementara itu, katanya, kerajaan juga sangat mengambil berat mengenai kaum wanita dengan mengumumkan enam inisiatif pemerksaan Wanita Madani.

Katanya, ia bertujuan membangunkan masyarakat secara inklusif agar berdaya saing dalam menghadapi cabaran global.

"Antara inisiatif yang diperkenalkan adalah program i-Sayang di bawah Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) dan Tabung KASIH Wanita untuk golongan B40 serta pengenalan garis panduan pelaksanaan program Advokasi Anti Gangguan Seksual.

"Inisiatif tersebut mengukuhkan usaha kerajaan dalam mewajibkan pelantikan 30 peratus wanita sebagai pembuat keputusan di syarikat berkaitan kerajaan (GLC)," katanya. - UTUSAN

[COLUMNIST] Investing in Women: Accelerating Progress

WE will soon be celebrating International Women's Day (IWD) on the 8th of March 2024. This year's official theme is "Investing in Women: Accelerating Progress", calling on governments, corporations and ordinary citizens everywhere to invest in the economic empowerment of women.

We are at a critical juncture in history, and investing in our women is more urgent than ever.

Female economic agency is central to achieving Gender Equality and promoting the wellbeing and prosperity of our families, societies and economies. Without female economic empowerment, we risk half our population being left behind and as vulnerable as ever in the face of a world that is rapidly changing.

Within just the last few years, new AI technology has revolutionised the digital world, climate change has been making its presence keenly felt - Malaysia being no exception, with flooding becoming more unpredictable each year - and a global pandemic has come, and stayed, leaving thousands on our own shores and millions around the globe still reeling from its effects.

Unfortunately with limited economic power, it is often women who are most vulnerable to disasters and change. We witnessed this firsthand when the pandemic led to increasing cases of physical and economic violence against women, rampant poverty - especially in female headed households - and the increase in female Unpaid Care Work burdens.

We must learn from the lessons of our recent past. As economic agency is the cornerstone of resilience, it is crucial to dismantle the structural, social and cultural barriers that prevent women from participating fully in the economy and in public life.

What Malaysia Stands to Gain

Women make up 50% of Malaysia's population, yet we have one of the lowest Female Labour Force Participation Rates (FLFPR) amongst Upper Middle Income Countries. Only 55.8% of Malaysian women participate in the labour force, compared to 81.9% of men. With only a little over half the female population engaged in the labour force, we are losing out on so much untapped potential.

Research has shown that Malaysia stands to grow its income per capita by 26.2% if all economic barriers are removed for women. This translates into an average income gain of about RM9400 (US\$2,250) - a considerable amount.

The simple truth is that when women work, economies grow. Investing in our women means investing in us all.

Furthermore, when women have equal access to economic resources and opportunity, there are not only positive economic effects, there are also positive multiplier impacts on the wellbeing of society as a whole.

When women have financial agency, they are able to engage meaningfully in public life, for example by entering policymaking roles (because at the end of the day, women need money to run for elections). Research has shown that when more women are empowered as economic and political actors, our policies are more reflective of the diverse needs on the ground.

Ways Forward

There are several ways Malaysia can economically empower women, and they involve addressing the structural, social and cultural barriers that restrict women's economic opportunities.

Ensuring full access to Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR) is essential to economic empowerment. When both men and women have access to Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) and reproductive health services, including contraceptives for family planning, women will have better control over the timing and spacing of their own births. They will be able to plan their careers better and reduce career gaps, which is one of the main factors driving the persistent Gender Pay Gap.

According to the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) latest figures, women currently make 33% less than men a year, a staggering jump from the 3.5% difference recorded for the year before.

Ensuring SRHR and expanding education is also key to addressing unintended adolescent pregnancy in Malaysia, which is a significant disruptor to female educational attainment and economic opportunity. A joint report by the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) and UNICEF on adolescent pregnancy in Malaysia highlights the need for CSE so girls are able to make better informed decisions about their reproductive health, alongside introducing educational programs for both boys and girls that cover issues of consent, harmful gender norms and violence.

Instating equal Parental Leave for both men and women also keeps more women in the workforce by reducing career gaps and fostering healthier, more equal gender dynamics for Unpaid Care Work at home.

Currently, men in Malaysia only have 7 days of paternity leave as compared to 98 days for women around the country, which places the burden of caregiving post-birth on women. This mismatch in maternity and paternity leaves also leaves women vulnerable to discrimination in job seeking, which once again limits their economic opportunities and agency.

With that said, it is important that reforms in parental leave apply to all states in Malaysia so no one group is left behind - currently Sabah and Sarawak have still not mandated the minimum 7 days of paternity leave. Sabah and Sarawak have FLFPRS of 49% and 51.2% respectively, both significantly below the national average of 55.8%.

Furthermore, establishing The Care Economy in Malaysia also has the potential to further the economic might of women. We applaud the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development for committing to investing in The Care Economy, recognising its potential to contribute between 10 - 39% of our national GDP, and look forward to supporting continued progress in formalising our national care economy framework.

In fact, latest research by the World Bank titled "Filling the Gaps: Childcare Laws for Women's Economic Empowerment" (based on data from 80 countries spanning a 20-year period - 2000-2020) showed that the enactment of childcare laws increases women's labour force participation with 2 - 4% increases within the first 5 years of its enactment.

However, for all the above to come to fruition - it is vital for the Ministry of Economy to have a bigger and more proactive stakeholder role. For without an economic roadmap and in-depth understanding of the socio-economic barriers withholding women's potential - the resources and investments needed to build the necessary inclusive infrastructures will never tangibly materialise and in tandem withholding Malaysia from achieving the 2030 SDGs.

Real Change, Not Buzzwords

Gender Equality and women's empowerment are not just catchphrases- they are words with real weight, about goals critical for our collective wellbeing. There are real lives and real futures at stake.

There should be nothing performative about economic inclusivity. True inclusivity involves making meaningful and sometimes difficult change, having uncomfortable conversations and challenging long-entrenched social and cultural norms that for too long have kept women from achieving their full potential, economic or otherwise.

With economic agency, women are free to make their own decisions, achieve their full potential, or safely leave abuse or situations that are harmful. Ultimately, all Malaysian citizens irrespective of gender should have the right to choice, and the full Bodily Autonomy to decide how they live their lives with access to adequate resources.

On this International Women's Day and beyond, we call on every Malaysian - from the government, to the private sector, to ordinary men and women on the street - to accelerate investment into economically empowering our women. Our collective future depends on it.

Corporate leadership and Gender Diversity Initiatives (GDIs) have increased from 2020, with 32% of companies now having women CEOs, and according to the Sustainable, Family and Community Development Ministry (SFCMD), companies with women CEOs have significantly more balanced boards than those led by men.



With progress in the workplace, Malaysia stands as a beacon of hope, with 30.9% of women now sitting on the boards of the top 100 public listed companies (PLCs) in Malaysia.

This evidence that it is possible to bridge the gender gap and sustain an environment of equality in the workplace with good governance, progressive measures and collaboration.

Transitioning from Malaysia to the global stage, as of Jan 10, 2024, a United Nations' report revealed that 28 women were heads of state and government across 20 countries.

This figure, while indicative of progress, underscores the persistent gender parity in the highest echelons of power.

According to the report, progress that is currently slow, achieving gender equality in these roles will take a staggering 100 years of labouring status that demonstrates urgency.

Despite some headway, disparities persist in the distribution of leadership roles.

Only 15 countries boast women as heads of state, and 18 have women as head of government.

The representation of women in cabinet positions globally stands at 22%, with more than 20 countries achieving gender parity or better in these crucial decision-making roles.

The report sheds light on the portfolio of countries led by women Cabinet Ministers, emphasising areas such as women and gender equality, family and children affairs, social inclusion and development, social protection and social security, and religious and minority affairs.

While commendable, this concentration underscores the persistent gender stereotypes that continue to influence the allocation of responsibilities among governments.

In the realm of parliamentary representation, progress is evident but slow-moving.

Women currently hold 25.1% of seats in major state legislatures, a marked increase from 19% in 2000.

Yet, only six countries have achieved gender parity or improvement in their Parliaments, with an additional 23 countries reaching or surpassing the 40% mark.

Women's significant disparities persist, with 22 states still lagging with less than 10% female participation.

Regionally, Latin America and the Caribbean boast the highest parliamentary representation with 36%, followed by Europe and Northern America with 32%.

Conversely, regions such as sub-Saharan Africa, Eastern and South-Eastern Asia, Central and Southern Asia, Northern Africa and Western Asia are lagging, highlighting the need for concerted efforts to bridge these gaps.

Beyond national politics, the report also examines women's representation in local government bodies, where they constitute 35.4% of elected members globally.

While some countries have achieved parity in local government, regional disparities persist, reflecting broader challenges in promoting gender equality across different levels of government.

Another global trend, regional variations often hinge on the complex interplay of cultural, social and political factors shaping women's participation in leadership roles.

While Europe maintains the highest number of countries led by women, regions such as Central and Southern Asia, and the Pacific, notably, still face the lowest representation of women in national politics, signifying the need for robust interventions to address systemic barriers.

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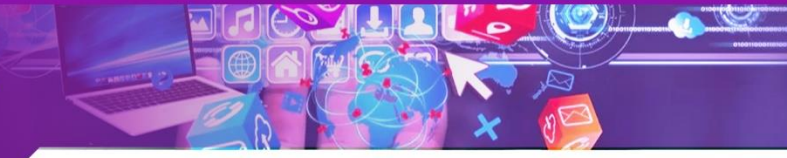

Kuala Lumpur: Kementerian Sumber Manusia (Kesuma) mendapati pelaksanaan dasar satu peratus orang kurang upaya (OKU) berkhidmat dalam sektor awam perlu dijadikan petunjuk prestasi utama (KPI) bagi semua kementerian dan agensi di bawahnya.

Menterinya, Steven Sim Chee Keong berkata, Kesuma akan mengambil tanggungjawab dan memandang serius terhadap dasar itu.

Menurutnya, beliau menggesa semua pihak sama ada sektor awam atau swasta perlu memberi peluang kepada golongan OKU dengan melihat kemahiran dan keberhasilan mereka berbanding limitasi golongan itu.

Katanya, di Malaysia, seramai 691,630 OKU berdaftar di bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat

(JKM) sehingga 31 Januari lalu, dengan 117,092 daripada mereka berusia 19 hingga 45 tahun.

"Lingkungan usia ini boleh dikatakan masih mempunyai keupayaan untuk bekerja dengan baik dari sudut fizikal, mental atau menggunakan keupayaan sedia ada.

"Saya melihat diskriminasi ke atas OKU disebabkan ketidakupayaan masyarakat memahami limitasi mereka termasuk kesedaran bagi menggaji pekerja daripada golongan OKU ini," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian mengulas laporan muka hadapan akhbar ini pada tarikh 2 dan 3 Mac lalu mengenai isu dasar satu peratus golongan OKU di dalam sektor awam hanya mencapai 0.33 peratus sejak perkenal pada 1988.

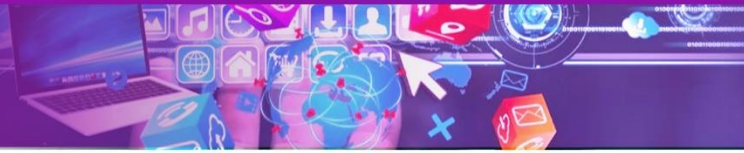

Only 0.3% of public sector workforce are disabled

THE public sector has yet to fill 1% of its positions with persons with disabilities (OKU), said Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

However, she told the Dewan Rakyat that there was an increasing trend in the number of OKU working in the sector from 2014 to 2023.

She said 0.23% of the public workforce was filled with OKU in 2014, followed by 0.25% (2015), 0.28% (2016), 0.29% (from 2017 to 2022) and 0.3% (2023).

"Data also shows that the number of applications from OKU for positions did not reach 1%.

"Between 2019 and 2023, there was only an increase from 0.3% to 0.64% in the number of applications," she said yesterday.

Dr Zaliha added that a survey



conducted by the Public Services Department on the satisfaction of OKU in the public sector revealed various challenges faced by the group.

These include adapting to supervisors, colleagues and surroundings.

It also included feeling pressured to provide the best services due to their limited abilities, and the acceptance of department heads to provide support and facilities needed by OKU in the public sector.

Dr Zaliha was responding to a question by Datuk Seri Shahidan

Kassim (PN-Arau) who asked about the number of OKU in the public sector, and the challenges faced by the group throughout their service.

In a supplementary question, Lim Lip Eng (PH-Kepong) asked about the number of OKU working for the Kuala Lumpur City

Hall (DBKL) and called for OKU to be employed in Parliament itself.

To this, Dr Zaliha said OKU represented 0.5% of those working at DBKL.

She also agreed with the suggestion by Lim to increase the proportion of OKU working in Parliament.

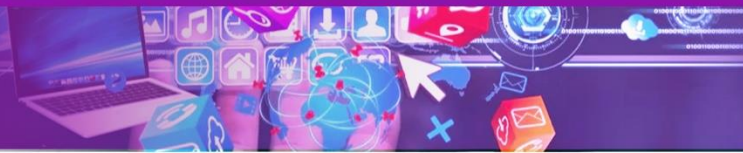

Minister shocked by bank's campaign headline of 84 pct Sarawakian kids being undernourished

KUCHING: A statement about 84 per cent of Sarawakian children being undernourished highlighted in a bank's social funding campaign comes as a shock to a state minister.

A view over the Alliance Bank's website shows the campaign titled 'Feed a Child Today. Your Donation Fights Hunger, Nourishes Dreams', which also cites the Household Income Survey Report 2022 (Department of Statistics Malaysia) in saying that more than 97,000 hardcore poor families live in the rural areas of Sarawak.

In a statement issued yesterday, Minister for Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah described the campaign's headline as 'shocking'.

"To say that 84 per cent of Sarawakian children are undernourished, this shocks me, especially when the statistics from National Institutes of Health showed that in 2016, 19.4 per cent of children below the age of five were underweight; in 2023, the figure was 15.6 per cent," she said.

In Sarawak, according to Fatimah, the state government has been providing the Special Annual Grant (GTK) for registered early childhood learning institutions since 2019.

"The GTK can be used to provide balanced and healthy meals to the children, as well as to facilitate the running of fun

learning, experiential learning and digitalisation of early childhood care and education.

"It also includes the parents' involvement programmes, and continuous professional development for educators and caregivers.

"Since 2019, this grant has helped 13,716 early childhood learning institutions through total allocation of RM68.84 million.

"Moreover, the Ministry of Education (MoE) also implements the 'Supplementary Food Programme' (RMT) for schoolchildren.

"If we could be furnished with the names of schools (in Sarawak) meant to be provided with meals, the state Ministry of Education, Innovation and Talent Development and the state Education Department could verify the situation on the ground, whether or not the primary schoolchildren did receive the RMT, which is a federal-funded programme," said Fatimah in the statement.

Hope Place Kuching aids family with schizophrenic parent

KUCHING: A 54-year-old man facing difficulties putting food on the table for his mentally ill wife and two young children has approached Hope Place Kuching for assistance.

The non-governmental organisation (NGO) in a statement said the wife, Imelda Affendy, 44, was first diagnosed with schizophrenia in 2017.

"She used to work in a factory in Kuching but as her condition worsened, she had to quit.

"Mostapa works as a storekeeper assistant and is now the sole income provider for his wife and two kids aged eight and 12," Hope Place said in

a statement, following a visit by its representative to the family's small rented room in Petra Jaya recently.

During the visit, Mostapa told the NGO that his wife's condition is unpredictable and she may be in a state of hallucination if overwhelmed or stressed.

"Imelda receives treatment at a government health clinic once every three weeks. She still made an effort to engage with the Hope Place team during the visit.

"Though slow in speech, Imelda tried her best to respond, knowing that her children's welfare should come first," it added.

According to Mostapa, his

elder child stopped schooling last year, while his younger child did not enter Primary 1 after kindergarten.

The father confessed that he could not afford to send his children to school since he has debts to settle.

"Furthermore, his job is also on the line now since he has been taking leave whenever his wife has a breakdown," said Hope Place.

Mostapa said his children understand their mother's condition, and they are well behaved and try to create a calm and peaceful atmosphere.

He added that his elder child does most of the chores and looks after her younger brother and her mother when he is at

work.

Imelda, who holds a disability card, receives RM300 monthly from the Welfare Department.

Hope Place is providing the family basic food aid and sponsoring their children's education.

The NGO hopes to register the children at a nearby school and will provide school fees, necessities and transportation, if necessary.

Hope Place tampil bantu keluarga berdepan masalah kewangan

KUCHING: Persatuan Kebajikan Harapan Kuching atau Hope Place tampil membantu sebuah keluarga yang berdepan masalah kewangan di Petra Jaya di sini baru-baru ini.

Ketua keluarga tersebut yang hanya ingin dikenali sebagai Mostapa terdesak menghubungi Hope Place untuk mendapatkan bantuan bagi isteri dan dua anaknya yang masih kecil.

Isterinya Imelda Affendy yang berusia 44 tahun disahkan menghidap skizofrenia pada 2017 dan terpaksa berhenti kerja selepas keadaannya semakin teruk.

Mostapa yang bekerja sebagai pembantu stor kini menjadi pencari pendapatan tunggal untuk isteri dan dua anaknya yang berusia 8 dan 12 tahun.

“Keadaan isteri saya tidak

dapat diramalkan. Jika dia berasa terharu atau tertekan dia akan berhalusinasi perkara yang mengerikan,” katanya kepada wakil Hope Place yang mengunjungi keluarganya baru-baru ini yang menyewa sebuah bilik kecil di Petra Jaya.

Mostapa turut memaklumkan bahawa isterinya mendapat rawatan di klinik kesihatan setiap tiga minggu sekali.

Disebabkan keadaan isterinya yang tidak menentu, anak-anak pasangan ini juga telah berhenti sekolah tahun lepas.

Malah anak lelakinya yang berusia lapan tahun tidak memasuki darjah satu selepas tamat pendidikan tadika.

Keputusan untuk memberhentikan anaknya daripada persekolahan adalah disebabkan oleh masalah kewangan,

kata Mostapa.

Mostapa bagaimana bersyukur isterinya yang merupakan pemegang kad orang kurang upaya (OKU) menerima bantuan bulanan RM300 daripada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

Simpati dengan keadaan keluarga Mostapa, Hope Place semasa mengunjungi keluarga ini turut menghulurkan bantuan makanan asas.

Hope Place juga akan menaja sepenuhnya pendidikan kedua-dua anak Mostapa dan berharap dapat mendaftarkan anak-anak ini di sekolah berhampiran apabila sesi persekolahan bermula kelak.

Ipoh: Bapa saudara kepada Attar Azim Syukran Jamil akan menggalas tanggungjawab menjaga kanak-kanak berkenaan yang kehilangan empat ahli keluarga termasuk ibu bapanya dalam kemalangan jalan raya di Kilometer 76.5 Jalan Kota Bharu-Gua Musang dekat Kampung Pah, Kuala Krai, Kelantan pada Sabtu lalu.

Nor Azam Ab Hamid, 45, berkata tugas menjaga Attar Azim berusia sembilan tahun itu yang juga anak arwah adiknya, Syukran Jamil Ab Hamid, 35, akan dilaksanakannya sebaik mungkin.

Nor Azam adalah anak keempat manakala Syukran Jamil anak kelapan daripada sembilan adik-beradik.

"Setelah berbincang, keluarga kami di (Felda) Trolak yang akan menjaga Attar," katanya ringkas ketika dihubungi Bernama di sini hari ini.

Sementara itu, Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga, Kebajikan Masyarakat, Pembangunan Usahawan dan Koperasi Perak Datuk Salbiah Mohamed berkata pihak Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) negeri akan memberikan bantuan yang sewajarnya kepada Attar Azim.

Beliau berkata pihak JKM sudah mengadakan kunjungan ke rumah waris keluarga Attar Azim di Felda Trolak Utara, Sungkai hari ini.

"Kebiasaannya, kita akan memberikan bantuan kanak-kanak, sekiranya waris tiada untuk menjaganya, kita akan tempatkan di rumah perlindungan.

"Insyallah kita akan bantu mengusahakan untuk bantuan kanak-kanak kepada adik Attar Azim," katanya.

Semalam, jenazah Syukran Jamil dan isterinya, Noor Aishah Razali, 35, bersama dua anak mereka, Ahya Rafiqi, 6, dan Lufya Adeena berusia setahun selamat dikuburkan di dalam satu liang lahad kira-kira 11 malam.

Dalam kejadian pada 1.40 tengah hari Sabtu lalu, Syukran Jamil bersama Noor Aishah dan Lufya Adeena disahkan meninggal dunia di lokasi kejadian, manakala Ahya Rafiqi meninggal dunia ketika menerima rawatan di hospital.

Namun Attar Azim terselamat dan hanya mengalami kecederaan.

Kemalangan dipercayai berlaku ketika Perodua Myvi dipandu Syukran Jamil dari arah Kota Bharu menghala ke Gua Musang bertembung dengan sebuah Nissan March dipandu warga Thailand yang masuk ke laluan dari arah bertentangan.

Kelima-lima mereka dalam perjalanan pulang ke Kuala Lumpur selepas menziarahi ahli keluarga dan bercuti di Kota Bharu, Kelantan.

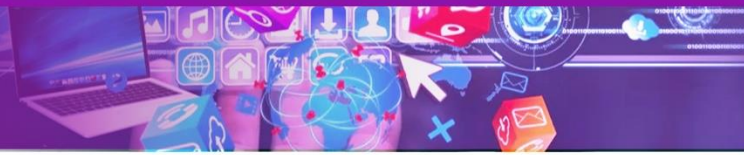

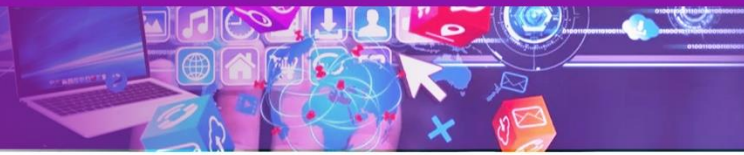

PETALING JAYA – Seorang bekas wartawan warga asing mendakwa, wanita berkulit putih tidak selamat berada di Kuala Lumpur dan berpotensi dicabul bagi setiap dua minit jika berada di bandar berkenaan.

Dakwaan itu dibuat susulan kisah tular pasangan pelancong asing yang bukan sahaja dipukul, malah teman wanitanya juga dirogol bergilir-gilir ketika berada di India.

"India bukan satu-satunya tempat seperti ini. Seorang wanita kulit putih yang berjalan melalui Kuala Lumpur boleh menjangkakan payudaranya diraba kira-kira setiap dua minit," katanya menerusi satu ciapan di aplikasi X.

Dia kemudiannya 'berkongsi' pengalaman berdepan dengan 50 lelaki yang dikatakan cuba meraba dirinya ketika sedang berjalan dari Central Market ke Shangri-La, di ibu kota.

Katanya lagi, dia pernah tinggal di Kuala Lumpur selama lapan tahun dan sentiasa diganggu begitu, sama seperti rakan wanitanya lain yang juga berkulit putih.

Susulan itu katanya, dia berpindah ke Singapura dan mula bawa payung besar serta memukul sesiapa sahaja yang memegang buah dadanya.

Wanita berkenaan terus bertegas dengan dakwaannya itu apabila orang ramai mula mempertikaikan pendedahan dibuat yang dianggap tidak berasas.

"Berjalan kaki dari Central Market ke Shangri-La pada suatu hari lalu lintas sangat teruk, saya memukul kira-kira 50 lelaki semuanya Melayu, cuba mencapai payudara saya. Ketika itu saya sedar, saya kena pindah.

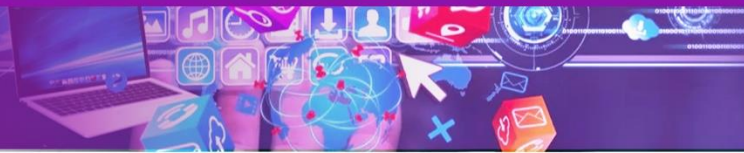
"Ia bukan rogol tetapi ia adalah serangan seksual. Negara yang baik akan mendakwa (kes berkenaan)," tambahnya.

Pengasuh sebabkan kematian kanak-kanak didenda RM10,000

SIBU: Mahkamah Majistret di sini, semalam menjatuhkan hukuman denda RM10,000 atau penjara dua tahun ke atas seorang pengasuh kanak-kanak yang meninggalkan seorang kanak-kanak perempuan berusia tiga tahun di dalam kereta sehingga menyebabkan kematiannya.

Majistret Flavian Edward Henry menjatuhkan hukuman itu selepas Nurul Fatirah Sazali, 28, dari Kampung Bungin, Spaoh, mengaku bersalah atas pertuduhan mengikut Seksyen 33(b) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 kerana membiarkan Fateen Naziatul Azyan Zaid tanpa pengawasan munasabah yang membawa kepada kematiannya akibat strok haba setelah terperangkap dalam kenderaan.

Dia melakukan kesalahan itu pada 30 Mac tahun lepas kira-kira jam 1.10 petang di tempat letak kereta Kilang Gergaji Tiong Guang di Jalan Chew Kung, Empawah di sini.

Kesalahan itu boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 33 akta sama yang membawa hukuman denda tidak melebihi RM20,000 atau penjara tidak melebihi lima tahun atau kedua-duanya sekali jika sabit kesalahan.

Mahkamah turut memerintahkan tertuduh melakukan khidmat masyarakat selama 36 jam dalam tempoh enam bulan dari tarikh sabitan.

Berdasarkan fakta pertuduhan kes, mangsa disahkan meninggal dunia pada jam 7.46 malam pada 30 Mac 2023 oleh pegawai perubatan di Hospital Sibu selepas ditinggalkan dalam kereta selama kira-kira lima jam pada hari kejadian.

Tertuduh ditahan susulan laporan polis yang dibuat oleh bapa saudara mangsa.

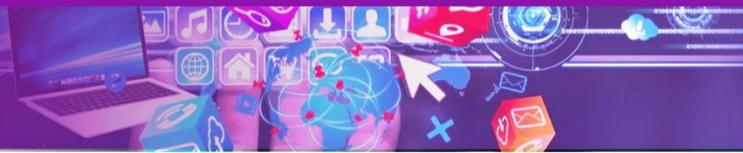

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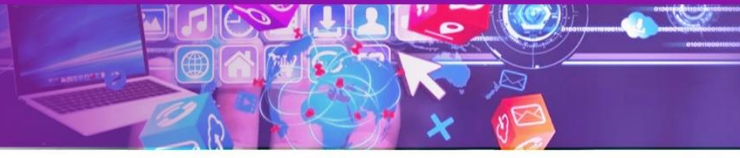

“Masa kamu (tertuduh) buat (rogol dan cabul), tak fikir ke isteri, anak-anak? Isteri kamu tengah sarat tapi kamu cari (melakukan) hubungan terlarang termasuk dengan emak mangsa.”

Demikian teguran Hakim Mahkamah Sesyen sebelum menjatuhkan hukuman penjara 69 tahun dan 20 sebatan terhadap seorang pekerja kontrak yang mengaku bersalah merogol dan mencabul anak angkatnya sejak tiga tahun lalu, semalam.

Tertuduh berusia 33 tahun berhadapan lima pertuduhan dengan empat daripadanya membabitkan kes rogol manakala satu amang seksual fizikal, membuat pengakuan itu sebaik pertuduhan dibaca jurubahasa di hadapan Hakim Abu Bakar Manat.

Ketika prosiding menjatuhkan hukuman, isteri tertuduh yang menunggu hari bersalin serta adik perempuannya kelihatan menitikiskan air mata.

Sebelum menjatuhkan hukuman, Abu Bakar memberitahu, mahkamah hanya mempertimbangkan pengakuan salah tertuduh dan faktor lain lebih kepada pemberatan hukuman berdasarkan kesalahan dilakukan tertuduh.

Hukuman tambahan bagi Seksyen 16 (1) pula, mahkamah menjatuhkan penjara dua tahun dan dua sebatan bagi setiap pertuduhan.

Hukuman seksyen ini berjalan sebagai hukuman kesalahan terdahulu selesai. Semua hukuman penjara berjalan serentak bermula daripada tarikh tertuduh ditahan pada 16 Januari 2024.

Ini bermakna, tertuduh hanya perlu menjalani hukuman penjara 21 tahun dan 20 sebatan.

Mahkamah juga mengarahkan tertuduh menjalani pengawasan polis dua tahun sebaik selesai menjalani semua hukuman selaras dengan peruntukan Seksyen 27 AKKSTKK.
