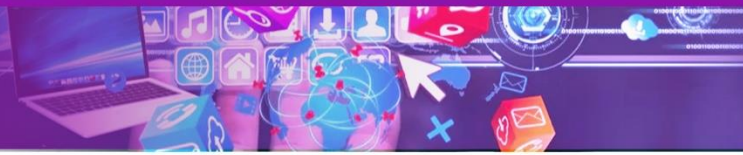

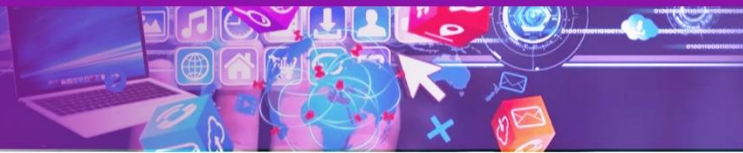
"Hari raya adalah hari yang memang ditunggu-tunggu oleh semua yang setelah menjalani bulan puasa selama sebulan.

Govt must address with urgency spike in child-on-child sexual abuse cases, says Wanita MCA

KUALA LUMPUR, April 8 — Putrajaya must act immediately to stem the reported rise in juvenile sex crimes and set up counselling centres in both urban and rural areas for abuse survivors, Malaysian Chinese Association (MCA) Wanita national chairman Wong You Fong said.

The Wanita chief called on the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development to formulate plans to curb sexual abuse among minors through the latter's newly established Child Development Department (JPKK).

"The authorities and the government could establish go-to counselling centres in more central locations and even the outskirts to enable counselling and recovery, a safe avenue that is easily accessible for both adult carers and child victims.

"As social media postings can become viral easily while sexual offences against children is a very worrisome issue in society, the JPKK needs to formulate strategic plans and execute solutions to tackle child sex fiends," she said in a press statement today.

Wong also urged parents, guardians or caregivers to actively inform children of the dangers of such acts and to keep an eye on children's online activity.

"As the police have highlighted that the misuse of social media becomes a gateway for abused kids to turn perpetrator, parents and guardians need to switch on or install safeguards on their electronic devices," she added.

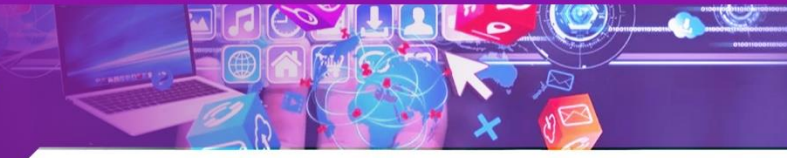
Additionally, Wong advised parents to teach their children to distinguish between safe and unsafe touches so children would be aware of what is acceptable and what is not.

She also warned that the statistics provided by Bukit Aman for a report by English national daily *The Star* today on underaged sexual predators may fall short of the real numbers.

"When a victim-turns-aggressor, this scenario suggests that normalisation of sexual abuse has befallen," Wong said.

This morning, *The Star* reported that minors are becoming sexual predators themselves and abusing other children, some of whom are below the age of 10.

Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Child Investigation Division's (D11) principal assistant director Assistant Commissioner of Police Siti Kamsiah Hassan revealed that there were 912 reported cases of child sexual abuse by other children last year, 1,006 cases in 2022 and 731 cases in 2023.

Has celebrating disability days brought any benefit to the disability community?

EACH year, we celebrate a number of disability days, often with the involvement of the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development (KPWK), Ministry of Health (MoH) and, at times, the Ministry of Education (MoE).

Recently, we observed World Autism Awareness Day (April 2). In March, we celebrated World Down Syndrome Day (March 21). There are also International Day of Persons with Disabilities (Dec 3), World Cerebral Palsy Day (Oct 6), Invisible Disabilities Week (Oct 17-23) and many others.

These events will usually have statements made by the relevant ministers, invariably illustrated by photo-ops of the ministers with persons with disabilities and some infographics or images on the respective social media pages of KPWK, MoH and MoE.

These days and events are critical to focusing the nation's attention on the lived experiences of persons with diverse disabilities. And, they should continue.

At the same time, we need to ask: what impact have they made on the rights and support services landscape of the disability community? Have they galvanised KPWK, MoH, MoE and other government agencies to enlarge and improve

the national services for persons with disabilities and the disability community?

For voters and taxpayers, independent and regular audits of the performance of ministries and all government entities are long overdue. Malaysian voters and taxpayers have a right to access the results of independent assessments of the scope and effectiveness of government services, performance and annual/longer-term plans for persons with disabilities. With their care partners, persons with disabilities account for more than 30 per cent of the population. With the rapid ageing of Malaysian society and the ageing-disability intersectionality, we must acknowledge that the 30 per cent will further rise. Yet, the disability community is one of the most poorly served in the nation.

Here are critical questions that KPWK, MoH and MoE need to answer on plans that each has outlined for the disability community.

1. What has happened to the National Autism Council whose formation the Ministry of Health announced in July 2022? Does it take two years for its inception? Services for autistic persons are limited, with most services provided outside of government

agencies.

Autistic persons, and other persons with disabilities, face barriers throughout their life course, from inadequate access to timely diagnosis and support services to the absence of systematic, long-term efforts to reduce stigmatization and discrimination, especially for OKU card holders, thus discouraging many from being formally registered as OKU.

2. Could Suruhanjaya Perkhidmatan Awam (SPA) and the Chief Secretary to the Government explain why we have failed, after 35 years (since 1988), to meet a government policy target and promise of 1 per cent civil service jobs for disabled persons? The current rate is 0.3 per cent. Most telling is that the majority of persons with disabilities who attempt to apply for a job via SPA do not even get called for an interview. Discriminatory practices against OKU who have the necessary qualifications extend beyond recruitment to job security and career advancement for the very few OKU in the civil service.

Why are such practices silently condoned and perpetuated? Why is there no leadership in ending the injustice of discrimination against qualified OKU in the civil service?

3. The Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development has a good 'Pelan Tindakan OKU 2016-2022'. Could KPWK inform the Malaysian people what it has achieved for the 10 Plan strategies, as well as many objectives and targets? After 2022, why is there no follow-up Pelan Tindakan OKU? Without a Pelan Tindakan OKU since Jan 1, 2023, how does KPWK allocate resources for OKU?

4. The Minister, KPWK, announced that amendments to the Persons with Disabilities Act 2008 would be tabled in Parliament in June 2023. Nine months later, we are still waiting for meaningful amendments to harmonise the Act with the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) that Malaysia ratified in 2010. Noteworthy is the 10th core strategy (under KPWK's Pelan Tindakan OKU 2016-2022) to 'implement laws in accordance with the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities'. Could KPWK explain what it has done to include and reflect the CRPD in amendments to the Act?

5. The Family Health Development Division, Ministry of Health, has a detailed 'Health Care for Persons with Disabilities

Plan of Action 2011-2020'. It would be good to know what has been achieved. In the case of MoH too, why has the plan for the disability community stopped without a follow-up plan and, in this case even earlier, at 2020? Is it customary that a plan or its follow-up takes years to be launched?

6. In the case of the development of the National Dementia Plan of Action whose custodian is MoH, the process commenced in 2019, with civil society inputs in 2022 for the revival of the draft Plan and again in March 2024, with no indication to the concerned public when it will be launched.

7. The Ministry of Education has a meaningful 'Malaysian Education Blueprint 2013-2025' (MEB) which outlines that '75 per cent of students with special needs should be enrolled in inclusive programmes by 2025'. MoE recently announced that the MEB 'achieved success'. And yet, those of us who work with children with disabilities know how limited inclusion into mainstream education still is.

It is time to take stock of the real achievements on inclusive education by listening to the ground realities of the disability community.

8. Why are the reports of the work undertaken by the

National Council for Persons with Disabilities (MBOKU) and its subcommittees not made available on the KPWK website for easy access by OKU and the entire disability community that includes parents, allies and all concerned with OKU rights?

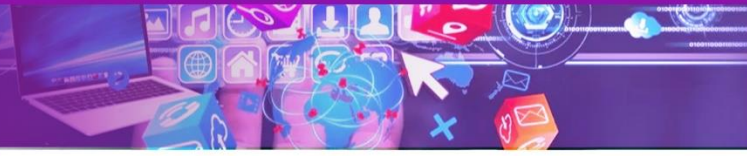
Celebrating disability days is good for awareness raising – their original purpose – but only if reinforced by comprehensive efforts that yield meaningful change in the lives of persons with disabilities at the household and community levels.

Nice speeches, plans and ideas are of no value unless translated into reality on the ground. The disability community is languishing. Children with disabilities are not fulfilling their potential. Adults with disabilities are struggling for equitable inclusion in all aspects of mainstream society. Malaysia is ill-prepared for disability with rapid ageing. This is a system-wide failure that calls for an urgent reality check and corrective actions.

The answers to the above questions are a telling measure of the state of societal wellbeing.

With their care partners, persons with disabilities account for more than 30% of the population. With the rapid ageing of Malaysian society and the intersection of age and disability, we must acknowledge that the figure of 30% will rise further. Yet, the disability community is one of the most poorly served in the nation.

Here are critical questions that the three ministries need to answer on the plans that they have outlined for the disability community:

1. What happened to the "National Autism Council" whose formation the health ministry announced in July 2022?

Does its inception need two years? Services for autistic people are limited, with most services provided outside of government agencies.

Autistic people and other persons with disabilities face barriers throughout the course of their lives: from inadequate access to timely diagnosis and support services, to the absence of systematic and long-term efforts to reduce stigmatisation and discrimination, especially for card-carrying persons with disabilities, discouraging many from being formally registered as such.

2. Could the Public Services Commission (SPA) and chief secretary to the government explain why we have failed after 35 years (since 1988) to meet a government policy target and promise of 1% of civil service jobs for disabled people?

The current rate is 0.3%. Most telling is that the majority of persons with disabilities who attempt to apply for a job via SPA do not even get called for interviews. Discriminatory practices against persons with disabilities with the necessary qualifications extend beyond recruitment to job security and career advancement for the very few persons with disabilities in the civil service.

KENINGAU: Pembantu Menteri Kerja Raya Datuk Robert Tawik @ Nordin mencadangkan agar dua orang kanak-kanak yang menjadi mangsa dera pasangan suami isteri baru-baru ini ditempatkan di pusat jagaan kanak-kanak dibawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat.

Beliau berkata, dua kanak-kanak yang menjadi mangsa penderaan suami isteri yang tidak berperikemanusiaan itu perlu perlindungan bagi membolehkan mereka meneruskan kehidupan seperti insan yang lain.

Pada masa sama Robert meminta pihak berkuasa supaya mengambil tindakan yang lebih berat kepada suami isteri yang melakukannya sebagai satu pengajaran.

Jadi, kemungkinan saya akan dapat berpindah, tidak lama lagi," katanya ditemui pada program Ziarah Seni Madani, Perbadanan Kemajuan Filem Nasional Malaysia (FINAS) 2024 bersama Menteri Komunikasi, Fahmi Fadzil di kediamannya di Apartmen Sri Baiduri, di sini, baru-baru ini.

Buat masa ini, Penyanyi Wanita Popular untuk edisi pertama Anugerah Bintang Popular BH (ABPBH) pada 1987 itu menumpang dengan anak angkatnya, Che Sikah Ismail atau Ika, 48, dengan menyewa rumah di Apartmen Sri Baiduri, di sini dengan bayaran RM1,000 sebulan.

Pada 17 September tahun lalu, Zaiton meluahkan kisahnya yang memerlukan bantuan kewangan bulanan untuk mengurangkan bebanan kos sara hidup dihadapi selepas kekurangan tawaran menyanyi.

Kesempatan hidup Zaiton turut mendapat perhatian Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yang kemudian menghantar wakil iaitu Setiausaha Politik, Ahmad Farhan Fauzi untuk melawat dan menyampaikan bantuan kewangan serta bakul makanan.

Pada masa sama, Zaiton tidak menyangka kepayahan hidup dan masalah kesihatan dialami sejak beberapa tahun lalu mendapat perhatian Fahmi.

Katanya, dia bersyukur Fahmi bersama wakil FINAS sanggup meluangkan masa menziarahinya di rumah.

"Paling tak sangka Fahmi sendiri datang ke rumah saya untuk menyantuni dan menghulurkan sedikit bantuan. Saya sangat berterima kasih kerana masih ada yang prihatin dengan artis bernasib malang seperti saya.

"Saya berasakan lagu sendiri memang ada kena mengena dengan jalan hidup. Kadang-kadang saya terfikir orang sudah lupakan saya ke?"

"Tapi, bila tiba-tiba menteri datang hendak berjumpa, ia satu penghormatan kepada saya," katanya.

Pada 14 November 2022, Zaiton menerima Kad Orang Upaya (OKU) menerusi kategori OKU Fizikal: Traumatic Brain Injuries (Trauma Kecederaan Otak) daripada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Wilayah Persekutuan.

Ia susulan kemalangan ngeri yang menimpanya di Batang Kali, Selangor pada 1990 yang mengakibatkan anak tunggalnya, Allahyarham Azirwan Abu Bakar yang ketika itu berusia 13 tahun meninggal dunia.

supaya jangan membuat spekulasi yang bukan-bukan kerana perkara ini masih lagi dalam siasatan," katanya.

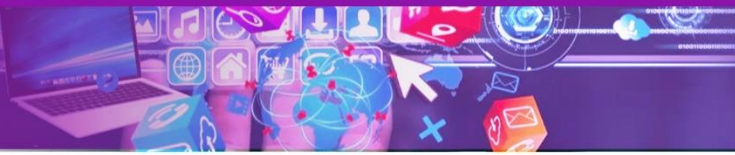

Ajak ke rumah nak ukur jersi

Jurulatih bola sepak sambilan kena dakwa lakukan amang seksual terhadap 3 pelajar lelaki

lalu. Berikutan itu, tertuduh didakwa mengikut Seksyen 14 (a) dan (b) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 dan boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 14 dan dibaca bersama Seksyen 16 (1) akta sama.

Seksyen 14 memperuntukkan hukuman penjara tidak melebihi 20 tahun dan boleh dikenakan sebatan manakala Seksyen 16, penjara tidak melebihi lima tahun dan juga sebatan tidak kurang dua kali.

Berdasarkan laporan dibuat mangsa, tertuduh di-

dakwa mengajak pelajar-pelajarnya datang ke rumah kononnya mahu mengukur jersi bola.

Kesemua mangsa itu adalah pemain bola sepak mewakili sekolah manakala tertuduh yang juga penjual burger, menjadi jurulatih sambilan kepada mereka.

Pada hari kejadian, tertuduh bukan mahu mengukur jersi, tetapi dengan niat mahu mengambil kesempatan terhadap ketiga-tiga mangsa.

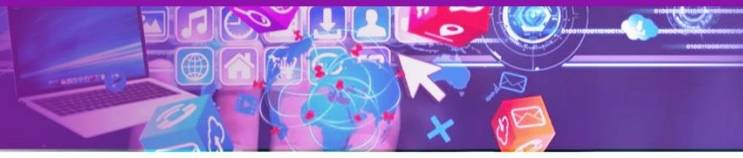
Tidak tahan dengan perbuatan lelaki itu, mangsa mengadu perkara itu ke-

pada guru kaunseling sebelum membuat laporan polis.

Ketua Polis Daerah Ampang Jaya Asisten Komisioner Mohd Azam Ismail berkata, terdahulu, pada jam 11.50 malam 28 Mac lalu, mangsa memaklumkan kepada ibunya yang berusia 32 tahun berkaitan kejadian.

"Mangsa memaklumkan yang dia dicitum selain menjadi mangsa amang seksual lelaki terbabit di sebuah hotel di Taman Melawati.

"Kata mangsa, sebelum itu ju-

ga, suspek didakwa memukul bahagian dada mangsa. Ibu mangsa kemudiannya tampil membuat laporan polis.

"Susulan itu, pada jam 7.35 malam Jumaat, anggota Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah (IPD) Ampang Jaya menahan suspek berusia 37 tahun," katanya.

Di samping itu, Mohd Azam berkata, semakan mendapati, suspek tidak mempunyai rekod jenayah lampau.

"Ujian air kencing mendapati, suspek positif dadah jenis AMP, Methamphetamine dan THC.

"Suspek direman seminggu bermula semalam (kelmarin) hingga 12 April ini bagi membantu siasatan mengikut Seksyen 14 (a) Akta kesalahan seksual terhadap kanak-kanak 2017," katanya.
