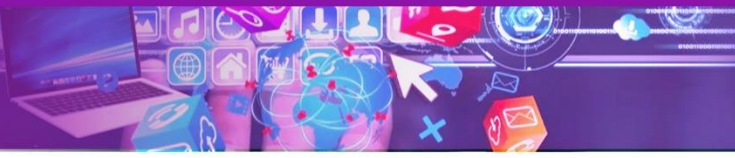

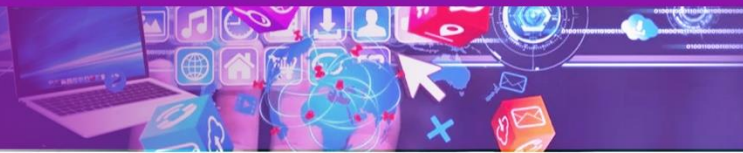

Kehilangan mangsa disedari anak saudaranya yang terlihat kesan tapak kaki serta tompokan darah di tebing sungai itu.

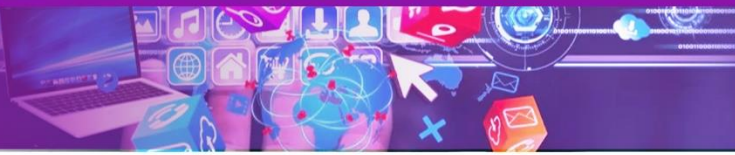
Nancy berkata, beliau yakin mangsa amat arif dengan keadaan sungai berkenaan kerana sudah lama mencari lokan.

## Futile search for woman feared attacked by croc

**LUNDU:** The search for an elderly woman, who was feared to have been attacked by a crocodile at Sungai Kampung Rayu on April 17, enters its second day today.

According to reports by the Fire and Rescue Department (Bomba) the search area now covers a one-kilometre stretch upstream and downstream from the last known location of the victim, identified as 76-year-old Minu Khien.

Firefighters conducted ongoing "Water Surface Searching" efforts with searches focusing on river pools and narrow streams within the search area.

The Bomba K9 Unit is also assisting in the search. So far there have been no new findings.

Also present today at the search site was Minister of Women, Family, and Community Development Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

Earlier, Minu was reported to have accompanied her 54-year-old daughter to the river to gather clams at around 8 am.

According to Lundu police chief DSP Damataries Lautin, the daughter heard her mother's cries for help and hurried to her side, only to discover she had gone missing.

"The daughter quickly returned home to Kampung Sungai Belian and notified other family members of the incident.

"The family suspects that Minu was attacked and pulled into the river by a crocodile, considering the area's known presence of crocodiles," he stated in a press release.

# 'Opposition needs to agree with terms for federal allocations'

**KUCHING:** The Opposition would have to agree with the terms set by the federal government so that allocations could be extended to their elected representatives, said Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

In this regard, the Santubong MP said the extension of allocations to elected representatives from the Opposition had been under

discussion for a long time, but the mechanism had not been finalised.

On Thursday, Fadillah had said that the Unity Government Secretariat Supreme Leadership Council had agreed, in principle, to consider extending federal allocations to the elected representatives from the Opposition.

In a statement, the Deputy Prime Minister said a draft memorandum of understanding (MoU) would be drawn up and extended to the Opposition for further discussions.

# Take domestic abuse seriously

## Interim protection order can help victims stay safe, says Nancy

**PETALING JAYA:** More community awareness is needed on domestic violence so that perpetrators do not think they can get away with threats and crimes easily, say authorities.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, whose ministry is in charge of handling domestic violence cases, said it is a communal duty to safeguard the rights and safety of women.

She said that while domestic violence victims should seek out immediate help, others around the victims should also ensure they are rescued.

Nancy pointed out that the recent Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) Terminal 1 shooting of a wife allegedly by an estranged husband has once again raised the issue to the fore.

"Following the recent distressing act of violence at KLIA

Terminal 1, it is essential for us to continuously safeguard the rights and safety of women in the country.

"The Domestic Violence Act 1994 offers protection and help for victims of domestic violence.

"It is crucial that these laws are rigorously enforced and updated regularly to address the new challenges that women face today.

"In addition, the Department of Women's Development, which introduced the Skwad Waja initiative in 2021, aims to empower communities by offering psychosocial support and organising outreach activities, all conducted by local volunteers.

"If you or someone you know is experiencing domestic violence, I urge you to seek help right away. You can contact the police and get an interim protection order (IPO) to keep you safe," said Nancy.

She said victims fearing for their safety can also apply for an emergency protection order (EPO) through the Social Welfare

Department in all districts.

"Also, check with our community-based organisations for more information on who to call in distressing times.

"There is also the 24-hour Talian Kasih helpline at 15999 or WhatsApp 019-261 5999 to report any cases of domestic violence.

"By working together, supporting each other and utilising these resources, we can strive towards a community where every woman feels safe and respected," said Nancy.

According to police, an IPO or EPO will lower the risk of victims being attacked by their estranged or former spouses and partners.

Bukit Aman Sexual, Women and Child Investigations Division (D11) principal assistant director Asst Comm Siti Kamsiah Hassan said no agency is able to monitor each and every victim who makes a report to ensure their safety.

"This is why there is the IPO to lessen the risk of threats. The protection order will be the mecha-

nism to mitigate aggressive actions against the victim. Should he or she go against the protection order, severe punishment awaits," she said.

Former minister Tan Sri Shahrizat Abdul Jalil, who had pushed for anti-domestic violence laws during her tenure as Women, Family and Community Development Minister, said reports of domestic violence should be taken seriously.

"I hope this case (KLIA shooting) will push the police to listen more to victims of domestic violence. The danger is very real, and the victims are not exaggerating.

"There are success stories where the police reacted very quickly, which in turn helps address the cycle of violence because domestic violence is repetitive and has a very high potential of escalating.

"Women do not easily lodge complaints on domestic violence, especially when it involves their husband.

"In fact, the aim of the Domestic Violence Act is to provide protection to women who report incidents of violence, and break the cycle of violence within a family," said Shahrizat, who is currently the Umno Women and Family Affairs Council (Hawa) chairman.

On April 14, shots were heard in KLIA Terminal 1 where a man attempted to kill his estranged wife in the arrival hall.

Travel agency owner Farah Md Isa, better known as Farah Cie, was waiting for her clients' return from umrah at the time.

Her husband, Hafizul Harawi, allegedly threw a firecracker in her direction, causing injuries to two members of the public, before allegedly opening fire at her.

Her bodyguard saved her life but was shot in the process.

Hafizul then escaped to his car that was parked at Block C of the airport car park.

He was caught in Kota Baru the next day and is currently under remand.

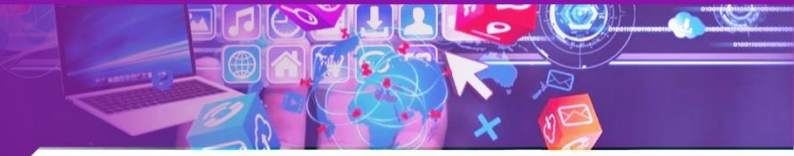

"Setakat ini, empat ke lima suspek berusia enam hingga lapan tahun dipercayai terlibat.

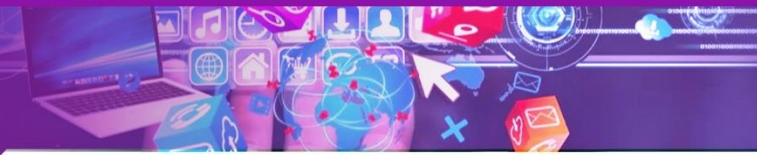

"Selain itu, kanak-kanak itu juga sering terkurung di dalam rumah serta tidak dihantar ke sekolah dan sering ponteng," katanya.

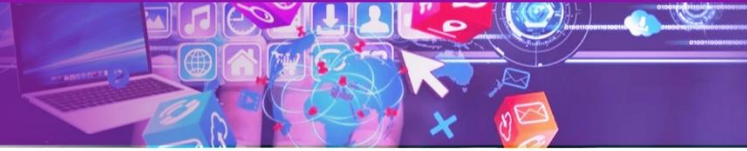

# International Women’s Month: A review of the good, the bad and the questionable — Malaysia Women & Girls Forum

APRIL 19 — March was an eventful month for Malaysian gender policy. With the annual International Women’s Day (IWD) falling on the 8th of March came a flurry of workshops, conferences, reports and launch events by both private and public entities, all with the goal of spurring conversations on creating a more gender equitable society.

Against this backdrop of heightened gender awareness, this month also saw several significant developments unfold within the policy space.

Several were welcome — this included renewed financial commitments by the government to empower women, the introduction of sexual harassment guidelines in public education institutions, and the long awaited appointment of Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal members.

On the other hand, less equitable developments included the recent furore over The Citizenship Bill amendments, and an earlier controversial proposal announced on IWD by the Prime Minister targeting female public servants.

### The good

Earlier in the month, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim pledged RM1 billion to the Bumiputera Micro Credit Financing Fund, which aims to support women, youth and military veterans. This is an encouraging move, as research has shed light on the positive link between access to microfinance and women’s participation in economic, public and political life. Access to finance has shown to increase the wellbeing of female recipients and their families, and act as a bulwark against poverty. In post-pandemic Malaysia where female-headed households in particular are economically vulnerable, this is an encouraging start.

Additionally, during the government’s official International Women’s Day launch on the 8th of March, Prime Minister Dato’ Seri Anwar Ibrahim announced that a grant totalling RM50,000 would be distributed between 100 female leaders to fund their non-partisan community programs, events and grassroots initiatives. The grant was meant as “a catalyst to amplify women’s ideas and contributions”.

In the realm of education, the Ministry of Education and the Prime Minister’s Department of Legal Affairs signed a Memorandum of Cooperation during the inaugural National Convention On Protection Of Students Against Sexual Exploitation. During the convention, a Ministry of Education official presented the official guide for the management of sexual misconduct in schools, which had been in development since 2022. Minister of Education Fadhlina Sidek expressed her commitment to coming down hard on any teacher found to be guilty of sexual offences, and outlined her vision of ‘safe schools’ across Malaysia. Lastly, on the 21st of March the government finally appointed 30 members for the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development’s (KPWKM) Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal, following the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act’s historic passing back in August 2022. The Tribunal is now fully operational, and KPWKM Minister Nancy Shukri has encouraged survivors to come forward to file complaints.

### The bad

Despite some progress on several policy fronts, one fundamental Gender Inequality issue remained unresolved. Existing Malaysian mothers of overseas born children (OBC) were left dismayed after the Constitution (Amendment) Bill 2024 was finally tabled on the 25th of March. The Bill has been amended to allow Malaysian mothers to automatically confer citizenship to their overseas born children — however this would only apply to children born after the Bill becomes law, leaving all existing children and adult children to apply for citizenship, unlike the automatic citizenship which OBC of Malaysian fathers have always been entitled to.

The non-retroactive nature of the Bill is a stark reminder of the unequal second class status of women in Malaysia. It’s also deeply disappointing for rights groups and Malaysian mothers with OBC who have spent years campaigning for women to be treated as equal in the eyes of the law.

In fact, according to the latest United Nations figures, 1.86 million Malaysian women live overseas, ie 12% of the total female population of 15.6 million. That is a staggering 57% female migration rate, far higher than the global average of 48%.

Malaysia’s Unequal Citizenship laws are one further barrier which prevents qualified Malaysian women with overseas born children from returning home due to the severe socio economic and psychological barriers faced in every arena, including access to education, healthcare and life cycle opportunities.

Following the amendment, future OBC of Malaysian women would have their automatic right to Citizenship guaranteed — a commendable development Malaysia should be proud of — yet it is incongruous and puzzling that the same right will not be accorded to women who have fought tirelessly for this change to begin with, and to existing OBC, going back a few generations.

The citizenship application window for stateless individuals has also further narrowed, from the age of 21 previously, down to 18. This essentially robs OBC above the age of 18 of their current right to obtaining citizenship via application, through no fault of their own. Some of these children have had cases pending for years by virtue of an unjust system, and through this amendment they have now “aged out” of their right to apply to become Malaysian.

Further negatively impacting families and children, the amendments will remove the ability for permanent residents to register their Malaysian-born children as citizens — a decision which threatens to exacerbate statelessness. This is particularly the case for underserved and Orang Asli and Orang Asal communities living outside of urban centres, where individuals are classified as permanent residents in their country of birth, to which they are indigenous to, all due to their lack of documentation.

The only silver lining to all this is that the Citizenship Bill has not yet been passed. We urge the government to refer the Bill to a Parliamentary Special Select Committee to be refined further in order to ensure it is genuinely Gender Equitable and non discriminatory before being tabled again.

### The questionable

Sometimes, policies can be well-intentioned, but lack a holistic Gender Lens. During his International Women’s Day speech, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim proposed that female civil servants be given the option to work fewer hours so they could better balance work and family duties. However with the reduction in office hours, their wages may also be revised downwards accordingly.

While this proposal highlights the very real struggle experienced by working women, especially when their “double burden” of simultaneously tending to work and home commitments significantly impacts their physical and mental wellbeing, it sidesteps one crucial component: the reality of how Unpaid Care Work (UCW) is disproportionately borne by women.

By reducing women’s working hours and their pay the government risks further entrenching gendered Unpaid Care Work norms, and worsening the significant 33.33% Gender Pay Gap as noted by DOSM in 2023.

The now well-cited Time Use study in 2018 by Khazanah Research Institute (KRI) revealed that women devote 3.6 hours of their time to Unpaid Care Work — 63.6% more than men at just 2.2 hours.

The government has indeed expressed their commitment time and time again to empowering women and increasing female LFPR from 56% to 60% within 10 years, but the problem must be tackled at its root: Unpaid Care Work must be shared equitably between men and women, particularly while Care Industry infrastructure is still lacking. At the policy level, the government must begin to value and make visible the important role Unpaid Care Work plays in our societies and economies.

Overlooking the Gender Gap in crucial caregiving and domestic duties also means we will be unable to address gaping Economic Inequality due to Gender - whether in terms of women’s LFPR, career longevity and promotion prospects, or unequal wages and income across industries.

Unpaid Care Work is the missing link. It is important for the government to acknowledge and take action in this across economic policymaking and budgetary allocations. We must make our “Care Economies” visible, and acknowledge it as the central force driving our economic engine.

To echo the recently published report by the WHO “Fair share for health and care: gender and the undervaluation of health and care work”, to achieve true Gender Equality, we must invest in our health and care infrastructures — from strengthening our healthcare systems, to providing essential child and elderly care — all especially crucial for Malaysia’s near future demographics as birth rates fall while the population is also rapidly ageing.

### Where do we go from here?

In line with this year’s theme for International Women’s Day “Invest in Women: Accelerate Progress”, we have already been seeing the government’s willingness to invest in the safety of our women and girls, through the commitment to establishing “safe schools” and the newly operational Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal.

However, ‘Investing In Women’ also means ensuring their fundamental constitutional rights to Equal Citizenship — both retroactively and in the future — as advocacy groups such as Family Frontiers have been tirelessly campaigning.

Finally, it is vital that the policies we implement are evidence-based and solutions oriented, tackling problems at their root, or we are merely being performative.

Often, meaningful societal change is driven by slow and difficult structural change, and for long standing issues like economic gender inequality, there are no quick-fixes.

For any government committed to achieving Gender Equality, it is crucial that this vision is shared equally between all ministries — however it is especially important for key Ministries such as the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Economy to take the lead.

With their buy-in and leadership in carving out Malaysia’s vision for a robust Care Economy and working to strengthen our health and care infrastructures, Malaysia will be taking significant steps to creating healthier gender dynamics and fostering shared duties of care — and through that, ensuring women’s equal participation in public, political and economic life.

All of which is the foundation of national development to benefit every Malaysian, not just women.

# MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER OF INFANT SON

Security guard shows no emotion when charge is read to him, mention set for May 28

**A** WOMAN was in tears yesterday as her husband was hauled to the magistrate's court to be charged with murdering their 6-month-old son.

The woman was seen speaking to counsel Arif Azmi, and she later sat in the public gallery to fol-

low the court proceedings.

Her husband, a 25-year-old security guard, was brought into the court compound by several Criminal Investigation Department policemen.

Mohamad Aizat Samin, however, showed no emotion when the charge was read out to him before magistrate Nurdiyana Mohd Nawawi.

He nodded when asked if he understood the charge read to him by the court interpreter.

No plea was recorded as murder cases fall under the jurisdiction of the High Court.

According to the charge sheet, Aizat had, between 8pm on April 14 and 7.40pm on April 15, murdered Muhammad Aysar Wildam Mohamad Aizat at Pangsapuri Baiduri in Bandar Tasik Kesuma in Beranang near here.

The offence carries a death penalty or imprisonment of not less than 30 years and not more than 40 years.

If the death sentence is not meted out, there will also be not less than 12 strokes of the cane.

Deputy public prosecutor Siti Nur Liyana Mohd Sulaiman did not offer bail.

She asked the court to set a mention date pending chemist, toxicology, forensics and post-mortem reports.

Magistrate Nurdiyana did not grant bail and set May 28 for mention.

On Wednesday, district deputy

police chief Superintendent Muhammad Nasir Drahman said Aizat had told police at 8.52am on Monday that the baby was found unconscious.

Nasir said an initial examination found no injuries on the baby's body. However, a forensic examination by the Kajang Hospital Forensic Department discovered evidence of abuse on the victim's body.

The results confirmed that the baby's injuries were not caused by an accident, but by criminal action.

Aizat was detained at the department's compound at

11.30pm the same day to be investigated for murder.

He tested positive for methamphetamine.

It was reported that the baby was believed to have been beaten, swaddled, had his head hit on the sofa, apart from his mouth being stuffed with a piece of cloth and left lying face down in a dark room without supervision before he was found dead.

The incident occurred when the wife and their eldest child aged 2 had gone to her in-law's house, and the husband was left alone with the baby in the apartment unit.

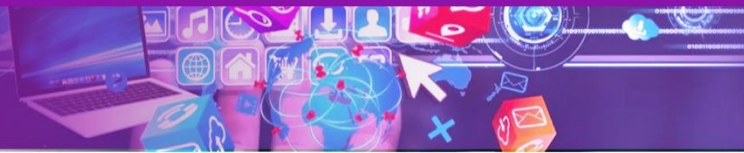

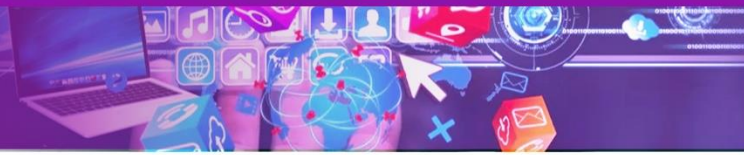

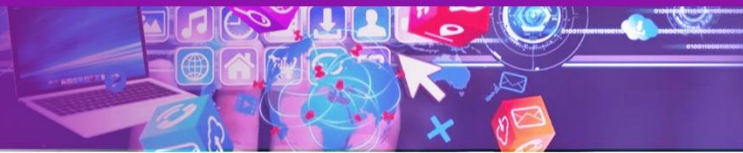

# Restaurant worker pleads guilty to raping underage girlfriend

**MUAR:** A restaurant worker pleaded guilty in the Sessions Court here to charges of raping his underage girlfriend, resulting in her giving birth at a house in Batu Pahat last year.

The accused, Ong Cheng Jun, 19, made the plea after the charges under Section 376(1) of the Penal Code were read before judge Irwan Suainbon.

Under the charge, he is liable to a jail term not exceeding 20 years and caning.

According to the charge sheet, Ong was accused of raping his 15-year-old girlfriend at his home in Batu Pahat about 5pm in January last year.

Based on police reports, the incident was discovered by a teacher after noticing physical changes in the victim.

The teacher informed the victim's parents, who refused to believe it and assumed their child had stomach problems.

On Aug 21 last year, the victim

was taken to Sultanah Nora Ismail Hospital in Batu Pahat for examination, and the doctor confirmed that she was 23 weeks pregnant at the time.

Following that, the victim's family lodged a report at the Batu Pahat police headquarters.

Acting on the information, police apprehended the accused in Jalan Tanjung Laboh, Batu Pahat, at 3pm on Sept 25 last year.

The victim was reported to have dropped out of school and gave birth in October last year.

Deputy public prosecutor Daniah Munir prosecuted, while the accused was unrepresented.

Earlier, the prosecution urged the court not to offer bail to the accused due to the severity of the offence.

After considering the arguments and appeals of the accused, the court granted RM8,000 bail with one surety.

The court set April 23 for the re-mention of the case.
