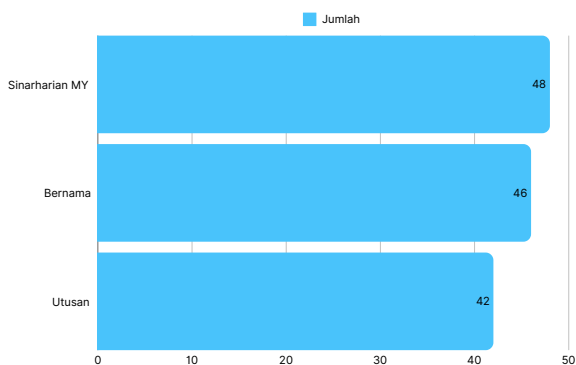

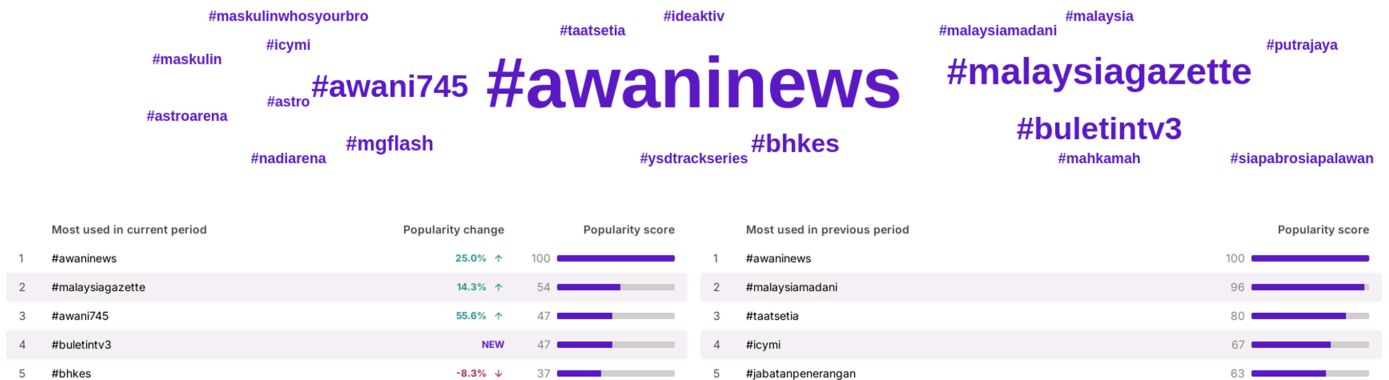

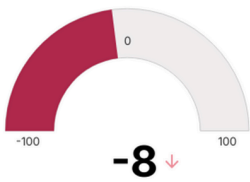

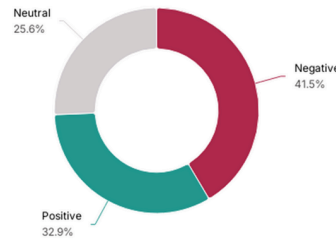

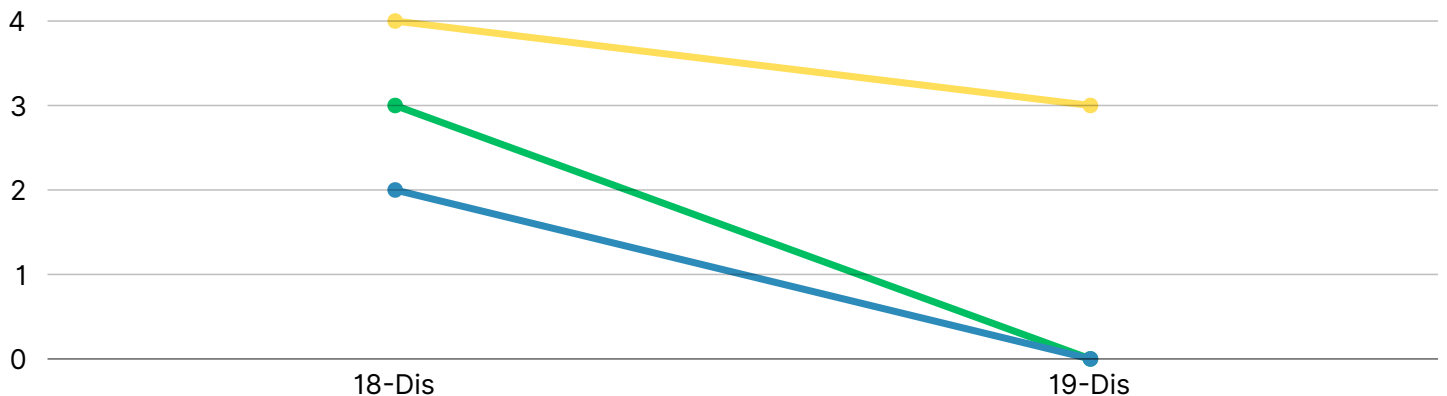

Kes amang seksual kanak-kanak meningkat

KUALA LUMPUR: Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) melaporkan peningkatan 21.1 peratus kes amang seksual fizikal melibatkan kanak-kanak dengan 1,389 kes dicatatkan pada 2023 berbanding 1,147 kes pada 2022.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, berkata, kesalahan seksual melibatkan kanak-kanak menerusi media sosial turut meningkat kepada 525 kes pada 2023 berbanding 360 kes pada tahun sebelumnya.

“Banyak faktor yang mendorong kepada peningkatan kes ini antaranya pemahaman mangsa mengenai seksualiti, privasi dan batasan-batasan yang sihat,” katanya dalam Dewan Negara hari ini.

Beliau menjawab soalan Senator Michael Mujah Lihan yang memintanya menyatakan faktor dan statistik peningkatan bilangan kesalahan amang seksual fizikal terhadap kanak-kanak di negara ini.

Dalam pada itu, beliau berkata, bagi mengatasi perkara ini, Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) telah melakukan pelbagai usaha antaranya melancarkan Program Advokasi Perlindungan Kanak-Kanak : KASIH Kanak-kanak.

“Program ini merupakan inisiatif KPWKM dalam usaha menangani dan mencegah berlakunya penderaan dan pengabaian kanak-kanak, yang jika serius boleh membawa kepada kematian,” katanya.

Katanya, menerusi program ini, kanak-kanak turut didedahkan mengenai batasan-batasan yang wajar dan sihat, seperti perbezaan antara sentuhan yang dibenarkan (good touch) dan sentuhan yang salah (bad touch).

“Diharap pelaksanaan program advokasi dapat meningkatkan kefahaman semua pihak agar lebih peka dan cakna terhadap isu kanak-kanak.

“Dalam pada masa yang sama, keterlibatan dan kebertanggungjawaban semua pihak adalah perlu dalam usaha mengurangi kesalahan atau layanan yang tidak wajar terhadap kanak-kanak daripada terus berlaku,” jelasnya. – [UTUSAN](#)

Multi-ministry effort to combat porn involving schoolkids

PUTRAJAYA: Allegations of pornography videos involving schoolchildren will be given serious attention through a collaboration of several ministries.

Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek said her ministry is working with all relevant parties, including the Home, Communications as well as Women, Family and Community Development ministries to tackle the matter.

Her response came following recent media reports on the easy accessibility of child sexual abuse material in Malaysia.

According to the reports, what was once hidden on the dark web is now being openly traded on social media for as little as RM1.

Fadhlina said any complaints or allegations related to this issue must follow the proper procedures set by authorities.

"We treat this matter with the utmost seriousness and are

responsible for ensuring that our children remain protected, especially those at the school level.

"I will follow up on it from time to time," she told reporters after her ministry's final monthly assembly of the year yesterday.

Fadhlina also said the ministry had conducted advocacy through awareness and warning programmes to ensure that children are kept safe from exposure to pornography.

"If there is any (follow-up), the discussion will only involve our peers at the ministry level and the authorities to ensure the case is contained in terms of safety, as it involves schoolchildren," she said.

On another matter, she announced that her ministry will present a report on improvements to the Supplementary Food Programme (RMT) on March 1 next year.

She said the report aims to assess the effectiveness of the RMT, including its cost, in ensuring that children from the B40

group receive the nutrition they need.

"We are working with the Health Ministry to ensure that the menu meets all nutritional requirements," she said.

Additionally, Fadhlina announced that the proposed amendment to the Education Act 1996 (Act 550) to make secondary education compulsory is expected to be tabled in the next parliamentary meeting in February next year.

The Education Ministry, she said, has submitted the Bill concerned to the Attorney General's Chambers for review.

Fadhlina added that the Bill is crucial to the ministry's preparedness in managing the situation of children who may leave school earlier than others in the future.

"These children may find the job market more rewarding, but they also face different barriers compared with those who continue with their education.

"Our challenge is to keep on

convincing parents that education will transform their lives and the lives of their children.

"This compulsory secondary education policy reflects our commitment to ensuring that no child is left behind, even at the upper secondary level," she said.

She said this will extend the compulsory primary education policy, in effect since 2003, with significant amendments to Act 550.

Separately, Fadhlina dismissed claims circulating via Telegram that the 2024 Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia English Language oral test paper had been leaked.

She said the ministry had investigated the allegations and found no evidence to classify it as a "leak".

KISAH konflik rumah tangga sering menjadi carian paling popular terutamanya di media sosial, malah bukan hanya melibatkan selebriti tetapi kisah masyarakat umum turut mendapat perhatian.

Pelbagai hantaran berkaitan konflik keluarga telah didedahkan dan secara tidak langsung juga menyumbang kepada trend bagi golongan belia serta dewasa berhubung isu ini tanpa memikirkan risiko yang akan berlaku.

Perunding Motivasi dan Kaunseling, Hushim Salleh berkata, komunikasi merupakan kunci utama menyelamatkan rumah tangga kerana ia berfungsi sebagai medium untuk mengetahui segala isi yang terbuka di hati.

Rentetan itu, pelbagai maklum balas diterima berhubung isu keganasan rumah tangga yang menjadi perdebatan dalam kalangan rakyat sama ada kes dialami perlu disebar di media sosial ataupun tidak.

Ada yang menyokong dan sebaliknya, namun masing-masing mempunyai hujah serta pandangan tersendiri.

Sokong

Cara mangsa untuk selamatkan diri

Saya bersetuju sekiranya mangsa keganasan rumah tangga menyebarkan mengenai penganiayaan yang terjadi kepada mereka.

Saya berpendapat, ia mungkin terpalit dengan dakwaan membuka aib tetapi jika itu sahaja cara untuk mendedahkan perkara yang dilakukan oleh pelaku zalim, adakah masih dianggap mengaibkan?

Dengan syarat, mangsa harus mengikuti saluran yang betul sebelum mendedahkan di media sosial, contohnya dengan membuat aduan kepada pihak polis terlebih dahulu.

Saya percaya, mangsa keganasan rumah tangga ini tidak berniat untuk mengaibkan pelaku sama ada suami atau isteri, tetapi mereka bertindak sedemikian kerana beberapa faktor yang kuat.

Faktor keselamatan diri dan anak-anak memainkan peranan penting dalam hal ini, jadi, jika masyarakat masih menganggap isu ini sebagai membuka aib, lebih elok sekiranya kita menadah telinga untuk mendengar keluhan mangsa yang dizalimi.

Kita tidak mahu mangsa terutama wanita yang selayaknya dilindungi dan disayangi menjadi mangsa sepak terajang suami dayus sehingga mampu menyebabkan kematian. - Eksekutif televisyen, Arif Aiman Ahmad Lela, 35

Media sosial medium paling efektif

Saya berpendapat menyebarkan keganasan rumah tangga di media sosial merupakan salah satu cara paling efektif untuk mendapatkan perhatian dan keadilan bagi mangsa yang dizalimi.

Ini bukan berkenaan mengaibkan pelaku, tetapi lebih kepada untuk menyebarkan kesedaran kepada masyarakat dan menamatkan penderitaan mangsa.

Saya dapat melihat satu trend pada masa kini yang mana media sosial menjadi agen penggerak kepada pihak bertanggungjawab untuk bertindak terhadap sesuatu kes yang tular.

Ini menunjukkan bahawa tanpa tekanan atau pendedahan umum, ia mungkin tidak mendapat perhatian yang sewajarnya daripada pihak berkuasa.

Perkara tersebut adalah satu diskriminasi terhadap mangsa.

Jadi saya sangat bersetuju sekiranya media sosial menjadi platform penyebaran kerana ia dapat mempercepatkan proses keadilan terhadap mangsa sekali gus memberi kesedaran kepada masyarakat berhubung isu tersebut. - Pekerja swasta, Shafiq Zafirah Mohd Zainuddin, 26

Bangkang

Berdosa jika sebar aib pasangan

Saya tidak setuju sekiranya seorang mangsa bertindak menyebarkan perihal keganasan rumah tangga di media sosial kerana perkara tersebut ibarat membuka pekung si pelaku sendiri serta rumah tangganya.

Dalam Islam, membuka aib seseorang, apatah lagi pasangan sendiri dianggap sebagai dosa tanpa mengira niat kita.

Sebagai seorang suami saya berpendapat, dosa yang dilakukan itu bukan hanya tertumpu pada niat, tetapi tindakan membuka aib orang lain secara terbuka.

Jika sekiranya tiada jalan lain dan mangsa sudah tidak tahan serta mahu melaporkan kepada pihak berkuasa seperti menunjukkan bukti yang boleh membawa ke arah perceraian, ia dibolehkan.

Namun, jika mangsa menyebarkan aib di media sosial hanya untuk menunjukkan keburukan pasangan tanpa tujuan yang sah, itu adalah tidak boleh dan perlu dielakkan.

Bagi saya, seeloknya jika suami dan isteri itu berkomunikasi secara aman serta elakkan perkara menyebarkan aib yang berlaku dalam urusan rumah tangga. - Jurutera Perisian, Mohammad Aliff Iskandar Mohd Zaid, 24

Ganggu keharmonian rumah tangga

Saya berpendapat, masalah rumah tangga seeloknya dibincang secara privasi oleh pasangan dan tidak perlu disebar ke pengetahuan awam.

Ia kerana pendedahan masalah rumah tangga secara terbuka mampu memberi kesan yang amat buruk terhadap keharmonian hubungan antara suami dan isteri.

Masalah sepatutnya diselesaikan secara tertutup dan melalui perbincangan teliti antara pasangan atau dengan bantuan pihak ketiga yang profesional seperti kaunselor serta pihak berkuasa.

Pendedahan kepada media sosial bukan sahaja membuka aib tetapi juga mewujudkan tanggapan buruk masyarakat terhadap pasangan yang dituduh.

Perkara itu juga membuka ruang untuk orang luar memberikan pendapat dan campur tangan yang mungkin hanya memburukkan keadaan.

Saya berani katakan bahawa tidak mustahil pendedahan oleh mangsa di media sosial itu mampu mencetuskan perasaan malu, rasa tidak dihormati atau dendam antara pasangan yang menjadikan penyelesaian masalah menjadi lebih sukar.

Lebih baik isu ini ditangani secara bijak dan penuh pertimbangan serta memberi ruang untuk kedua-dua pihak berusaha memperbaiki hubungan dengan lebih baik. - Pembuat kek, Nurin Mirza Yusof, 27

Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil warns pornographers of severe consequences, write **ALIZA SHAH and AMALINA KAMAL**

If you dare break the law, be prepared to face the music. This was the warning issued by Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil following reports of a surge in accounts distributing and selling local pornographic content, including child sexual abuse material (CSAM).

"If you break the law, you can be taken to court, and the consequences are severe," Fahmi said. "Do you really want to throw your life away? Do you really want to jeopardise your future for short-term income?"

Fahmi attributed the involvement of individuals producing such content to "legal illiteracy".

"I think they don't understand how this constitutes a crime. They think it is just about earning money on the side."

The *New Straits Times* has, over the past few days, exposed the widespread presence of pornographic content on social media, including CSAM.

The growing demand for such explicit material and the lack of safeguards on these platforms have heightened parents' concerns about their children's safety.

Investigations revealed numerous Malaysian accounts offering explicit material, including storyline-driven content rivaling international productions. This trend is raising fears that Malaysia could become a hub for illicit content, posing significant risks to children online.

Fahmi said authorities would not remain silent and would continue to monitor the situation closely and take action against account owners found soliciting and profiting from the distribution of explicit content.

He also called on parents to play a more active role in supervising their children, especially those who are underage.

"Many parents think devices can act as nannies. They believe that kids will be able to look after themselves. That's absolutely not the case," Fahmi said above all, social media platforms need to play a bigger role by ensuring safety features are easily accessible and activated.

He said some platforms have yet to demonstrate genuine commitment to supporting Malaysian laws, cooperating only when it is convenient for them or benefits their interests.

CID chief links rising statutory rape cases to explicit content

KUALA LUMPUR: With a career spanning more than two decades in the force, Datuk Seri Mohd Shuhaily Mohd Zain has seen more than his fair share of serious crimes.

However, as the world evolves with liberal socialisation and advanced technologies, the negative effects of modern development have made the federal Criminal Investigation Department (CID) director very worried.

Thanks to the limitless potential of social media and networking, the spread of pornographic content has become unchained and rampant on the Internet.

Furthermore, easy access to such explicit content is threatening the younger generation with moral decay.

For Shuhaily, a father of three daughters, the problem is bringing too close to home.

"As a cop, all I want is to bring back the peaceful times, like what we had growing up," he told the *New Straits Times* recently.

Shuhaily believes that the surge in statutory rape cases may be driven by perpetrators who have watched explicit content on social media, highlighting the need to address this growing concern.

"Cases of statutory rape are on the rise and that worries me. The statistics that police have are based on reported cases."

The Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) is looking at data that hasn't been reported, so it is obviously higher than what we have.

"But what does this tell you? It shows the correlation between accessing pornography and rape," he said.

In May, Shuhaily announced that the statutory rape involving teenagers aged 16 and below had increased 1.8 per cent to 202 cases last year compared with the year before.

He commended the hard work of Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil and Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Law and Institutional Reform) Datuk Seri Amalina Othman Said in pushing for the registration of social media platforms and proposing the Online Safety Bill.

The CID, he said, is also working closely with the Crime Prevention and Community Safety Department and MCMC to raise awareness and address issues related to the distribution of explicit content on social media.

He said the responsibility also lies with parents, who must ensure their children's safety.

At a father, he acknowledged the challenges in monitoring his children's activities.

"Having three girls at home, once I start taking away their phones for a week and they said, 'Okay dad, take it. It only means we don't have to do homework for a week.'"

"So it is a double-edged sword and we can't do away with it or we'll be left behind. So the question is, where is the limit?"

While acknowledging the complexities of an ever-changing world, Shuhaily shared his hope of restoring the ease and peace of mind that once defined parenting experience.

"As a cop, I always want to bring back the peaceful times we experienced growing up. In those days, our parents didn't even have to worry about us taking public buses, for example."

"We were more independent because the environment was safe then. I'm not saying that the environment now is unsafe, but the risk is always there."

Fadhli: Ministry committed to protecting schoolkids

PUTRAJAYA: The Education Ministry is taking the allegations of pornography videos involving schoolchildren very seriously.

Minister Fadhlina Sidek said the ministry was working closely with other authorities, including the Home Ministry, the Communications Ministry and the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry, to address the issue.

"We take this matter with utmost seriousness and are committed to ensuring the protection of our children, especially those in schools," she said after her ministry's monthly assembly yesterday.

"The nature of this bill is very important and critical for us. We already have a primary school education policy and through it, we have achieved an exceptionally high enrolment rate of between 98 and 99 per cent."

"With the compulsory secondary school education policy, we are reaffirming our commitment to ensuring that no child is left behind, particularly at the upper secondary level."

Fadhlina said the ministry was regularly conducting awareness programmes and provides reminders to parents of children from becoming involved in such activities.

"The safety of schoolchildren must always be a top priority. When we speak of schoolchildren, their parents come first."

"Therefore, we hope that in the upcoming parliamentary session, we will be ready to take this in the Dewan Rakyat."

Earlier, Fadhlina shared an incident in Terengganu involving several students who had dropped out.

The headmaster told me that the parents came to school and 'threw' the textbooks, saying 'our child doesn't want to go to school anymore.'"

"This is sad and a challenge for us as the ministry to convince parents that education can change both them and their children."

The Present Education Policy states that under the Education Act 1996, education is only compulsory up to Year 10.

In March last year, it was reported that the Education Ministry had submitted a draft proposal to the A-GC to make secondary school education compulsory.

Govt names 8 platforms that must obtain licence

KUALA LUMPUR: The government has identified eight social media and online messaging platforms that will be required to obtain a licence under the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 by next year.

Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil, in an exclusive interview with the *New Straits Times*, said the platforms included Meta's WhatsApp, Facebook and Instagram, Elon Musk's X (formerly Twitter), Google's YouTube, Pheed Data's Telegram, Tencent's WeChat and Bytedance's TikTok.

He said these platforms had met the threshold of at least eight million users in the country, and added that they were not being specifically targeted.

Fahmi said the ministry was currently engaging with the platforms to explain and emphasise the necessity of the requirement.

He said some platforms had pushed back, citing reasons such as concerns over stifling innovation and challenges of establishing a local office.

However, he expressed confidence that given the profits these platforms generate and the significance of the Malaysian market, they should comply with local laws.

Using Meta as an example, Fahmi said the company earned approximately RM15 billion annually from the Malaysian market through advertising.

On top of that, he said Malaysian had reportedly lost more than RM400 million to scams published on Meta's Facebook, which accounted for 90 per cent of the RM500 million of gambling and fraud content that the government had ordered to be removed.

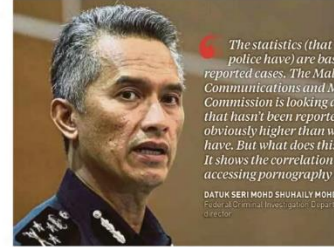
"What makes you (platform providers) so extraordinary or special that you can make money from us, but our laws don't apply to you?" Fahmi Fadzil

He said the government had ordered speech or hindering innovation.

"The automotive industry is licensable, but that doesn't stop a wide variety of innovative products from entering the market," he said.

Fahmi noted that many other platforms had indicated their willingness to comply with the licensing requirement.

"Telegram representatives came last week, and our engagement was very positive. I met Google last week and I am meeting Meta this week. This kind of engagement is ongoing. We believe that when we highlight our intent to make the Internet in Malaysia safer for children and families, how can you not get behind a message like that?" he said.

"Golongan wanita muda pula mudah terpengaruh dengan godaan lelaki berusia kerana mereka dikatakan lebih romantik, berpengalaman serta berchara," katanya.

Bagi golongan wanita berusia pula, katanya, mereka berani mengambil tindakan bercair meskipun sudah berkahwin puluhan

tahun kerana sudah 'penat'.

"Ramai klien wanita saya memaklumkan, mereka sudah penat berhadapan dengan kerenah suami termasuk yang curang.

"Sebelum ini, mereka bertahan kerana anak masih kecil. Apabila anak sudah besar dan bekerja, si isteri nekad untuk bercair kerana berasakan beban tanggungjawab terhadap anak sudah tiada.

"Sepatutnya, apabila kita bercair, ini adalah masanya kita berkumpul dengan anak dan cucu tetapi sukar untuk berbuat demikian sekiranya pasangan bercair kerana mereka sudah tidak tinggal serumah," katanya.

PERKAHWINAN PULUHAN TAHUN BERKECAI 'LEPAS SEMBUH, DIA CURANG'

"Saya sudah tidak cukup kuat untuk mempertahankan perkahwinan meskipun sudah 30 tahun berkahwin dengan bekas suami," kata ibu tunggal yang hanya mahu dikenali sebagai Ida, 55.

Menceritakan semula kesengsaraan dialaminya, Ida berkata, dia berkahwin pada usia 22 tahun manakala bekas suaminya berusia 25 tahun ketika itu.

"Sepanjang tempoh perkahwinan kami, saya banyak berbaras dengan kerenah bekas suami. Dia kerap memukul saya serta kerap berlaku curang.

"Apa yang mengurangkan jika saya untuk meneruskan perkahwinan ini adalah anak. Sepanjang tempoh berkahwin, suami tidak pernah berubah, malah menjadi semakin panas baran," katanya ditemui.

Ida berkata, kesabarannya mencapai kemuncak apabila berlaku pertengkaran besar dengan bekas suaminya selepas lelaki terbabit curang lagi pada 2021.

Pada 2021, saya juga suami kerana dia terlanjut sakit selama tiga bulan. Selepas dia sihat, saya dapat tahu dia curang dengan wanita lain.

"Apa yang mengejutkan saya adalah hubungan sulit mereka sudah terjalin selama beberapa tahun. Hati isteri mana yang tidak sakit di perkahwinan sedemikian.

"Malah, dia mengugut sa-

supaya membenarkannya berkahwin lagi. Saya memfalkan cerai kerana tidak sanggup hidup dalam keadaan sakit hati serta sedih," katanya.

Menurutnya, selepas bercair, dia berkahwin dengan lelaki yang dikenali sebagai Sidi, 55, berkata, mahligai perkahwinannya juga musnah gara-gara orang ketiga.

"Perkahwinan dengan bekas suami ini yang berusia 59 tahun adalah yang kedua ketika saya berusia 22 tahun. Sebelum ini, saya pernah berkahwin sebelum bercair tiga tahun kemudian kerana tiada persefahaman.

"Pada awalnya, suami yang juga pekerja kilang melayan saya dan anak dengan baik sebelum saya dapat di curang dengan rakan sekerja.

"Banyak kali dia curang, namun pelbagai alasan diberikan bagi menafikan hubungan itu sehingga saya sendiri terserempak dengan mereka di pasar raya," katanya.

"Apa yang lebih menyakitkan hati, katanya, hubungan

perdepan dilema ekoran konflik antara tiga isterinya masing-masing berusia 50-an, 40-an dan 30-an.

Menurut Wan, ketiga-tiga isterinya tidak bekerja dan bergantung sepenuhnya kepada pendapatannya.

KPM pandang serius dakwaan video pornografi babitkan murid

Putrajaya: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) memandang serius sebarang dakwaan mengenai video pornografi yang membabitkan murid sekolah.

Menterinya, Fadhlina Sidek, berkata KPM bekerjasama dengan semua pihak seperti Kementerian Dalam Negeri (KDN), Kementerian Komunikasi serta Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWK M) bagi membendung isu itu.

Beliau berkata, dalam konteks itu apa sahaja yang membabitkan aduan dan dakwaan perlu melalui proses pihak yang bertanggungjawab.

"KPM sering melakukan advokasi melalui program kesedaran dan peringatan agar anak-anak tidak terbabat dengan gejala ini," katanya pada Program Perhimpunan Bulanan KPM, di sini semalam.

BH sebelum ini melaporkan, bahan penderaan seksual kanak-kanak (CSAM) amat mudah diakses di Malaysia, dengan video dijual di platform media sosial hanya dengan harga RM1. Permintaan semakin mening-

kat untuk kandungan sedemikian menyemarakkan lagi pengeluaran bahan pornografi kanak-kanak buatan tempatan, menimbulkan kebimbangan mendalam tentang keselamatan golongan berkenaan.

Dalam pada itu, Fadhlina berkata, pihaknya mengambil

serius isu itu dan KPM bertanggungjawab untuk memastikan kanak-kanak terus dilindungi, khususnya di peringkat sekolah.

Katanya, setakat ini KPM masih tidak menerima sebarang laporan dan pihaknya akan mengambil tindakan susulan dari semasa ke semasa.

Sementara itu Fadhlina berkata, rang undang-undang (RUU) untuk meminda Akta Pendidikan 1996 bagi mewajibkan pendidikan hingga peringkat sekolah menengah dijangka dibentangkan di Dewan Rakyat pada Februari depan.

Beliau berkata, perkara itu juga sudah selesai proses semakan di peringkat Jabatan Peguam Negara (AGC).

"Kita sudah ada dasar pendidikan sekolah rendah yang de-

ngan adanya dasar tersebut kita mencapai enrolmen sangat tinggi iaitu antara 98 hingga 99 peratus.

"Dasar pendidikan wajib sekolah menengah ini maknanya kita nak zahirkan komitmen kita untuk memastikan tidak berlaku keciciran di sekolah menengah, khususnya menengah atas," katanya.

RUU berkenaan mewajibkan pendidikan daripada peringkat rendah hingga menengah dalam usaha memastikan setiap kanak-kanak warganegara Malaysia mendapat akses pendidikan berkualiti tanpa mengira kepelbagaian latar belakang.

Govt open to exploring legislation on sharenting with stakeholders - Teo

KUALA LUMPUR: The government is open to engaging with stakeholders to evaluate the necessity of dedicated legislation to regulate the practice of sharenting.

Deputy Minister of Communications Teo Nie Ching stated that such efforts would help ensure children are protected from exploitation and their privacy and security are safeguarded.

"Malaysia does not have existing legislation to address sharenting specifically. But we are ready to hold engagement sessions with stakeholders, non-governmental organisations, and ministries such as the Ministry of Women, Family, and Community Development.

"Whether we need a dedicated bill on the matter requires the agreement and consensus of all parties involved," she told Bernama today.

She appeared as a guest on an exclusive Bernama Radio interview on the topic, Online Safety: Government Commitment and the Role of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 (Act 588).

The term sharenting combines the words sharing and parenting. It refers to the phenomenon where parents share photos, videos, and other personal information about their children on their social media accounts.

Teo explained that to address this issue, the ministry, through the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), consistently conducts awareness programmes to educate the public about the dangers of oversharing and to encourage safer online practices.

"Our advice to all adults is to avoid oversharing—not just information about children but also personal details about themselves. Such information can ultimately be exploited by criminals," she emphasised.

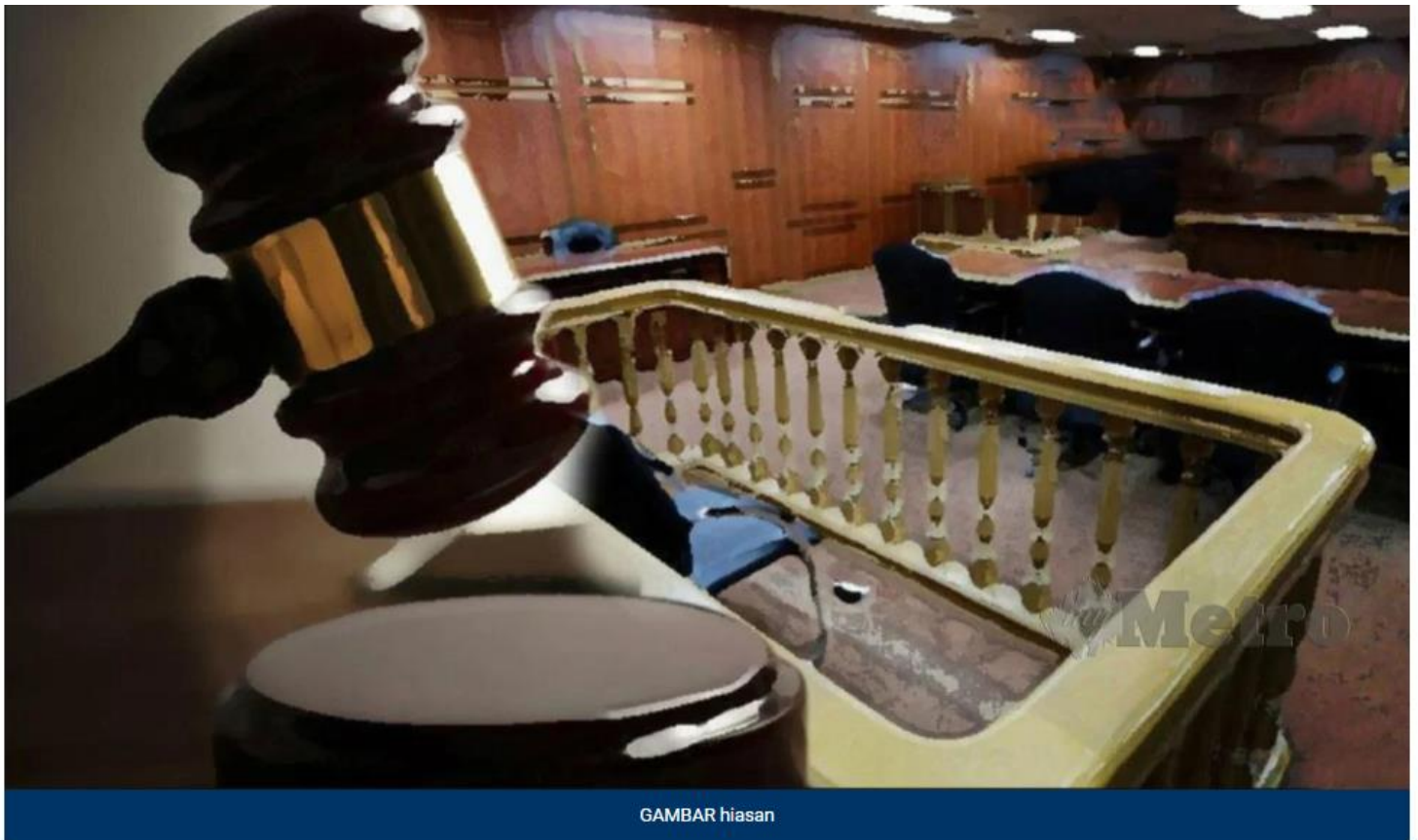

Punched-in-the-eye molester pleads guilty

KLUANG: A jobless man, sporting a black eye, pleaded guilty at the Sessions Court to outraging the modesty of a woman in a public toilet here.

Muhamad Sopor@Nasir, 34, was charged before judge Mujib Saroji yesterday.

The incident took place in the women's washroom at Laman Kreatif Kampung Melayu at about 5.30pm on Tuesday.

The offence was framed under Section 354 of the Penal Code, which is punishable with a jail term of up to 10 years, or a fine or whipping, or any two of the punishments, upon conviction.

When the judge asked Muhamad why he had a black eye, the accused claimed that he was punched by the victim.

"She entered my toilet (cubicle), yet I was blamed. My right eye is swollen because she punched me.

"I also want to ask for bail to be reduced as I am still young," he said.

The court fixed bail at RM10,000 and set Jan 21 for next mention at the Magistrate's Court.

The prosecuting officer was Insp Suniza Nan Yan while the accused was not represented.

On Wednesday, Kluang OCPD Asst Comm Bahrin Mohd Noh was reported to have said that a man was apprehended by members of the public for allegedly trying to molest a woman inside a public toilet.

The suspect is said to have pushed the victim, causing her to fall to the floor before attempting to molest her.

School principal charged with grooming 16-year-old student

MARANG: A secondary school principal pleaded not guilty to two charges of child grooming by sexually communicating with a female student.

On the first count, Mohd Tajudin Mokhtar, 59, was charged with sexually communicating with the 16-year student in his office at 8.30am on July 2.

The father of four is also charged with committing non-physical sexual assault on the girl by showing pictures of sexy girls on his mobile phone to her at the same location and time.

The charges are brought under Section 11(1)(a) and Section 15 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017 respectively.

Magistrate Zur Azureen Zainalkefli allowed the accused bail of RM10,000 with two sureties for both charges.

She also ordered him not to intimidate the victim and to report himself at a nearby police station every month.

She set Jan 14 for mention, according to Bernama.

The prosecution was conducted by deputy public prosecutor Maisarah Abd Razak while lawyer Abdul Haiyyi Salim represented the accused.

In a separate case in Kuala Lumpur, a security guard was sentenced to a total of six years in jail by the High Court after pleading guilty to four terrorism-related charges.

Justice K. Muniandy handed down the sentence on Muhamad Norulaini Supardi, 34, who was sentenced to one year and six months in jail on each count.

However, the court ordered the jail term for all four charges to be served concurrently from the date of arrest on June 23 this year.

According to the first to the third charges, he was charged with possessing three books, a drawing of a flag and two videos associated with the Daesh group on his mobile phone at a house in Kajang at 9.25am on June 23.

The charge, framed under Section 130B(1)(a) of the Penal Code, provides a jail term of up to seven years or with a fine and shall also be liable to forfeiture of the items, upon conviction.

He was also charged under Section 130B(1)(b) of the same law Penal Code with providing an article associated with the Daesh group at the same place, date and time.

According to an expert report read in court, the materials owned and prepared by the accused have subversive elements or a tendency to generate hatred towards individuals, governments or leaders and can threaten the well-being of the country.

The materials were found to support the ideology of the Daesh group and could incite feelings of hatred and extreme discontent.

Bagi kesalahan itu, tertuduh didakwa mengikut Seksyen 11(1)(a) Akta Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak (AKSTKK) 2017 (Akta 792) yang boleh dihukum penjara maksimum tiga tahun.

Bagi pertuduhan kedua, tertuduh didakwa melakukan amang seksual bukan fizikal de-

ngan cara menunjukkan gambar perempuan seksi melalui telefon bimbitnya kepada mangsa di tempat, tarikh dan waktu sama.

Tertuduh yang didakwa mengikut Seksyen 15(e) AKSTKK 2017 (Akta 792) berdepan hukuman penjara maksimum 10 tahun atau denda RM20,000 atau kedua-dua sekali, jika sabit kesalahan.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Maisarah Abd Razak manakala tertuduh diwakili peguam, Abdul Hayyi Salim.

Mahkamah menetapkan 14 Januari tahun depan untuk sebutan semula kes.

Zur Azureen membenarkan tertuduh diikat jamin sebanyak RM10,000 bagi kedua-dua pertuduhan dengan dua orang penjamin dan tertuduh membayar jaminan itu.

Selain itu, mahkamah turut menetapkan syarat tambahan iaitu tertuduh tidak boleh mengganggu mangsa dan melaporkan diri setiap 19 haribulan di balai polis berdekatan.

School principal charged with child grooming

MARANG: A secondary school principal pleaded not guilty in the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to two charges of child grooming by sexually communicating with a female student.

On the first count, Mohd Tajudin Mokhtar, 59, was charged with sexually communicating with the 16-year student in his office at 8.30am on July 2, 2024.

The father of four is also charged with committing non-physical sexual assault on the girl by showing pictures of sexy girls on his mobile phone to her, at the same location and time.

The charges are framed under Section 11(1)(a) and Section 15 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017, respectively.

Magistrate Zur Azureen Zainalkefli allowed bail of RM10,000 with two sureties for both charges, and ordered the

accused to not intimidate the victim and to report himself at a nearby police station every month.

She also set Jan 14 for mention.
