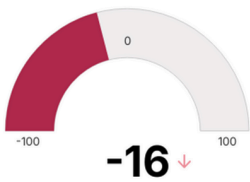

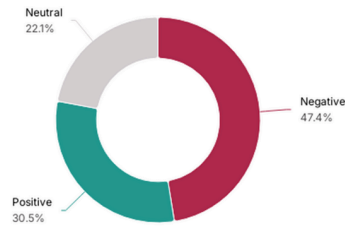

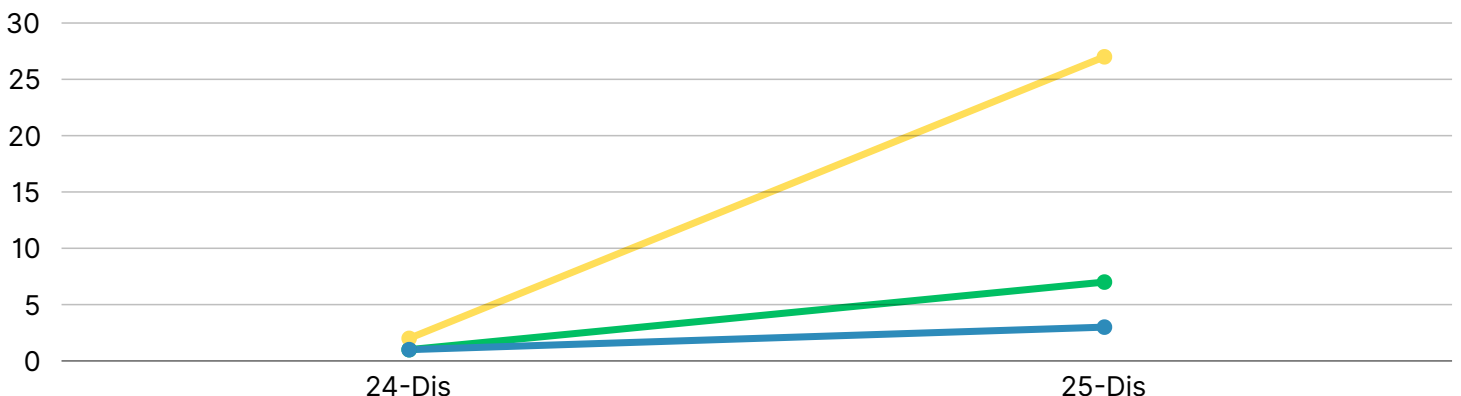

KPWKM sedia beri kaunseling kepada mangsa, waris

Bukit Besi: Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) bersedia menyalurkan bantuan kaunseling kepada waris mangsa yang maut dan mereka yang terselemat dalam kemalangan di KM204 Lebu Raya Utara Selatan arah utara di Alor Gajah, Melaka, malam kelmarin.

Timbalan Menterinya, Datuk Seri Dr Noraini Ahmad berkata

pihaknya sedang menunggu laporan penuh Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) dan Polis Diraja Malaysia berkaitan nahas yang meragut tujuh nyawa itu.

“Memang JKJ akan turun (bantu), kementerian ingin bantu dari segi kaunseling. Kita ada kaunselor untuk mendampingi mereka dan keluarga.

“Saya dan seluruh warga KPWKM amat berdukacita de-

ngan kemalangan ini,” katanya selepas menghadiri Majlis Ramah Mesra Ketua Wanita UMNO Malaysia bersama Ketua Wanita UMNO Cawangan, Bahagian Dungun, di sini semalam.

Tujuh termasuk lima sekeuarga maut manakala 33 cedera dalam kemalangan membabitkan sebuah bas persiaran yang membawa 27 penumpang, dua lori, sebuah kereta dan kende-

raan pelbagai guna (MPV) jenis Toyota Estima di KM204 Lebu Raya PLUS arah utara, 8.45 malam kelmarin.

Siasatan awal polis mendapati bas persiaran itu melanggar tayar lori tercabut di lorong tengah dan menyebabkannya hilang kawalan dan terbabas ke laluan bertentangan sebelum bertembung dengan tiga kenderaan.

Ketua Polis Daerah Alor Ga-

jah Supt Ashari Abu Samah berkata mereka yang terkorban ialah pemandu MPV Khairul Ikhwan Mazupi, 32, bersama penumpang Fadzlenna Ramli; Ramli Ab Wahab, 66; Fauziah Jaafar, 69; Muhammad Umar Khairul Ikhwan, 2; pemandu bas persiaran Noorisnien Khamid, 56, dan penumpang bas persiaran warga Singapura Lamrah Asid Ali, 66. Ops Pedo crucial in protecting children from online paedophiles, says Nancy

KUALA LUMPUR: The Ops Pedo spearheaded by Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women, and Child Investigations Division (D11) is crucial to ensure the safety of children and combat crimes that harm our community.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, said the operation had also focused on tackling online paedophilia activities, which involved collaboration with the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC).

"I would like to extend my highest congratulations to the police, especially the D11, for the successful execution of Ops Pedo.

"The operation focused on tackling online paedophilia activities and such swift and effective actions are crucial to ensure the safety of children and combat crimes that harm our community," she said in a statement today.

Last night, police and MCMC launched a blitz on individuals suspected of **possessing** and distributing Child Sexual Abuse Material (CSAM).

The operation, codenamed "Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC", spearheaded by Bukit Aman's D11, involved a series of coordinated raids across six states: Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang, and Perak.

The raids, which saw the authorities descend on homes in affluent neighbourhoods as well as middle and low-cost areas, led to the arrest of 13 suspects.

It also resulted in the seizure of 40,000 CSAM and pornographic content from various devices, including computers, cell phones, and external hard disks.

The ages of those arrested ranged between 20 and 74. Some of the suspects admitted to finding and buying explicit content via social media and messaging platforms such as X and Telegram.

The crackdown followed surveillance and undercover work by the police, supported by intelligence provided by MCMC.

The raiding parties also comprised Bukit Aman's Forensic Laboratory Division (D10), Technical Assistance Division (D6), and Criminal Investigation Department.

The raids came after the New Straits Times' weeklong series of reports on the rampant sale of Malaysian-made explicit content, including CSAM, on social media and messaging platforms.

The NST's investigation also showed how **CSAM** content was being sold for as cheap as RM1 per video, raising concerns among parents over the safety of their children.

Bukit Aman's D11 principal assistant director, Senior Assistant Commissioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan, had spoken on trends which showed that access to such pornography had made predators even more brazen, with some going to the extent of attempting to abduct children.

She also highlighted how easy access to pornographic content has led to severe addiction, resulting in children, some as young as primary school pupils, becoming involved in creating and profiting from CSAM content.

The United States' Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) had told the NST how cybercriminals trafficking in CSAM were exploiting advanced encryption technology to avoid arrest.

Malaysia, it said, has forged alliances with the FBI and other international entities to leverage real-time coordination of **operations** to shut down priority and high-impact targets.

Meanwhile, Youth and Sports Minister Hannah Yeoh also congratulated the police for the successful operation.

She also called for many collaborations between the authorities to protect Malaysian children from such abuse.

"The D11 successfully apprehended individuals behind online pedophilia through Ops Pedo. Many victims of pedophilia suffer in silence and carry their wounds into their teenage years which affect their youth.

"Hence, I would like to commend the police who worked with the MCMC in bringing down these perpetrators.

"More of such joint ops please to protect our young Malaysians!" she said.

Autism cases among children in M'sia soar by 815 pct, reaching nearly 64,000 by Sept 2024

KUCHING, Dec 24: The number of children in Malaysia diagnosed with autism has shown a significant increase, rising by 815 per cent from 6,991 cases in 2013 to 63,966 cases as of September 2024.

Federal Minister of Women, Family, and Community Development, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, revealed that this marks an increase of 10,859 children with autism compared to 2023, Harian Metro reported in October.

"Efforts and support for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) cases involve a cross-ministerial approach and require various expertise and assistance.

"This approach is necessary to ensure that the support provided is holistic, promoting development, equality of rights and opportunities, as well as active participation.

"The support encompasses aspects of care, rehabilitation and intervention, education, healthcare, and employment. This requires the full involvement of every agency based on their expertise, jurisdiction, and respective roles," she stated in a written reply in Parliament.

To enhance the quality of life for individuals with autism, the Ministry has developed two key modules, namely the 'Child Care and Caregiving Module for Children with Autism' and the 'Psychological Support Module for Caregivers of Persons with Disabilities (PwD)'.

Additionally, psychological and counselling services are offered to parents of children with autism through the Community-Based Rehabilitation Programme (PDK), which includes psycho-educational interventions and group counselling sessions.

Nancy also acknowledged the shortage of certified professionals to handle services related to children with autism.

Following this, the issue will be brought to the committee under the National Council for Persons with Disabilities (MBOKU) for further deliberation. — DayakDaily

“Kesedaran dalam kalangan ibu bapa meningkat tapi penerimaan orang ramai masih belum meningkat. Maksud saya penerimaan ke arah sudut yang positif, org kita masih rasa kesian, lepas itu tak tahy nak buat apa jika berhadapan dengan anak-anak macam ini,” katanya.

Tambah guru tersebut, permohonan murid berkeperluan khas di sekolah mengalami peningkatan setiap tahun.

“Sebagai guru pendidikan khas, data murid berkeperluan khas di sekolah setiap tahun memang meningkat terutama di Kuala Lumpur sebab saya mengajar di Kuala Lumpur, dan memang jika 10 murid yang masuk tujuh daripada lapan orang adalah kategori autisme.

“Murid sekolah saya sendiri tahun lepas lebih 90 orang dan tahun ini lebih 100 orang jumlahnya,” katanya.

Terdahulu, Kosmo! menerusi laporan khas mendedahkan seramai 60,217 penghidap autisme berdaftar di bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) setakat 30 Jun 2024.

Kuala Lumpur: Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) merampas 40,000 bahan penganiayaan seksual kanak-kanak dan menahan 13 lelaki dalam Op Pedo, kelmarin.

Ketua Polis Negara, Tan Sri Razarudin Husain, berkata tangkapan dilakukan dalam serbuan berasingan di enam negeri iaitu Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Pulau Pinang, Perak, Johor dan Terengganu.

Katanya, semua suspek ialah lelaki tempatan berusia antara 20 hingga 74 tahun itu.

"PDRM melaksanakan operasi bersepadu pada 23 Disember (semalam) dengan kerjasama Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC) terhadap suspek yang disyaki melakukan kesalahan seksual secara dalam talian membabitkan bahan penganiayaan seksual kanak-kanak.

"Kita melakukan pemeriksaan terhadap peranti yang digunakan di premis kediaman semua suspek dan menemui kira-kira 40,000 bahan penganiayaan seksual kanak-kanak dan bahan pornografi dewasa," katanya dalam kenyataan, semalam.

Seorang lelaki berusia 30-an ditahan selepas pihak berkuasa menemui sejumlah besar bahan penderaan seksual kanak-kanak (CSAM) dalam komputernya ketika serbuan di rumahnya di Taman Sri Andalas di sini, malam kelmarin.

Bagaimanapun, lebih mengejutkan pihak berkuasa adalah apabila pemeriksaan mendapati beberapa fail itu mempunyai label seperti *Kids Porn* dan *Rape*. Suspek yang bekerja di sebuah kedai peralatan elektrik berada di rumah ketika polis melakukan serbuan yang didiaminya bersama keluarga.

Serbuan itu dijalankan oleh pegawai dari Bahagian Siasatan Seksual, Wanita

dan Kanak-Kanak (D11) Bukit Aman dan Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC) sebagai sebahagian daripada Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC.

Bahagian Makmal Forensik (D10) dan Bahagian Bantuan Teknikal (D6) Bukit Aman membantu dalam operasi itu yang diadakan di enam negeri.

Semakan pada komputernya mendapati dia telah memuat turun lebih 500 gigabit (GB) bahan lucah termasuk CSAM yang disyaki melalui pautan BitTorrent.

Sebagai konteks, saiz fail lagu MP3 adalah sekitar empat megabit (MB). Ruang cakera keras 500GB sudah memadai untuk 125,000 lagu.

Dari satu folder ke folder lain, beberapa label *Kids Porn* dan *Child Porn* juga ditemui pada komputer itu. Manakala sebuah folder

mengandungi label 'rogol'. Semakan juga mendapati tiga daripada folder itu di muat turun pada hari serbuan manakala beberapa lagi di muat turun awal tahun ini.

Pemeriksaan lanjut mendapati, suspek turut memuat naik data bersaiz terabait kepada pengguna BitTorrent yang lain.

Ketika berita ini ditulis, pihak berkuasa masih mencari lebih banyak fail CSAM pada komputer itu. Suspek dibawa ke Ibu Pejabat Polis Daerah Klang Selatan untuk siasatan.

Serbuan ini dilakukan susulan siri laporan New Straits Times (NST) minggu lalu mengenai penjualan kandungan lucah buatan Malaysia termasuk CSAM, yang semakin berleluasa di platform media sosial dan

aplikasi pemesejan.

Siasatan NST turut mendedahkan, bagaimana kandungan CSAM dijual serendah RM1 setiap video, mencetuskan kebimbangan dalam kalangan ibu bapa mengenai keselamatan anak-anak mereka.

Ketua Penolong Pengarah Bahagian D11 Bukit Aman, Senior Asisten Komisioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan berkata, terdapat trend yang menunjukkan akses kepada pornografi seperti ini telah menjadikan pemangsa semakin berani, dengan setengahnya cuba menculik kanak-kanak.

Beliau juga menekankan akses mudah kepada kandungan pornografi telah menyebabkan ketagihan serius sehingga melibatkan kanak-kanak, termasuk murid sekolah rendah, yang terlibat dalam penghasilan dan penjualan kandungan CSAM untuk mendapatkan keuntungan.

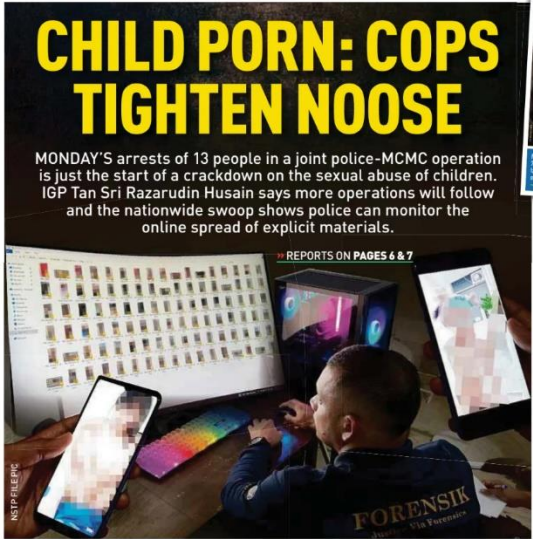

13 people arrested, 40,000 child sexual abuse material and pornographic content seized in raids across KL and five states

THE police will not hold back on taking action against anyone involved in sexual crimes against children, the country's top cop warned.

"This is the message we sent through our joint operation with the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC)," Tan Sri Razarudin Husain told *New Straits Times*.

Razarudin said Monday night's Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC, which led to the arrests of 13 people for possession of child sexual abuse material (CSAM), demonstrated the police's commitment to cracking down on sexual crimes, particularly those involving minors.

He added that this was just the beginning, with more efforts being planned to curb such crimes.

The operation, spearheaded by Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Child Investigations Division (D1), involved a series of raids across Kuala Lumpur and five states — Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang and Perak.

Authorities descended on homes in affluent neighbourhoods, as well as middle and low-cost areas, and seized 40,000 CSAM and pornographic content from various devices.

They began moving in on their targets at 9pm, with police knocking on the doors of 20 homes belonging to the suspects.

Razarudin said the operation highlighted the police's ability to track down and crack down on those creating, possessing and distributing explicit materials on digital platforms.

"We also want to send a strong message against becoming an 'industry player' in the production and distribution of CSAM.

"The police will not compromise on crimes against children," Razarudin said. "Op Pedo also served to remind social media and digital messaging companies of their responsibility in regulating their platforms.

"They must upgrade their policies and safety features to comply with Malaysian laws and enhance monitoring over their platforms to protect children from sexual exploitation online."

He gave his assurance that the police would stop at nothing to protect youths from online sexual crimes.

All the suspects arrested yesterday are expected to be investigated under Section 10 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act for accessing child pornography even more brazen, with some going as far as to attempt child abductions.

Raid uncovers folders labelled 'Kids Porn' and 'Rape'

KLANG: The authorities found files and folders with chilling labels when they raided a house here on Monday night as part of Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC.

A man in his 30s was arrested after child sexual abuse material was found on his computer during the raid on his home in Taman Sri Andalas here.

However, what left them even more disturbed was the discovery of files and folders that bore labels such as "Kids Porn", "Rape" and "Child Porn".

The suspect, who works at an electrical appliance store, was at home when police raided the double-storey house where he lived with his family.

Investigators found that he had downloaded more than 500GB — the equivalent of about 100 DVDs — of pornography, including materials featuring children.

It is believed the suspect used file-sharing service BitTorrent to download the material.

Checks also suggested that three of the folders were downloaded on the day of the raid itself while several others were downloaded earlier this year.

Further checks found that the suspect had shared his trove of pornography with other users via BitTorrent.

At the time of writing, the authorities were still searching the suspect's computer.

The man was brought to the South Klang police headquarters for further investigations.

Police seized his computer and router as part of the probe.

In another raid in **Wangsa Maju**, Kuala Lumpur, a freelance designer folded when police confronted him about possessing child pornography.

Police said the suspect, a father of one, lived separately from his wife and daughter, and was living with his parents. His parents were in the house during the raid.

The suspect claimed to have accessed the explicit material through a Telegram group, which he paid RM50 to join.

The group contained over 800 explicit photos and videos and had 500 subscribers.

He told investigators that he discovered the group via social media platform K.

The items seized included his mobile phone, a router, a modem and cables.

It is learnt that the suspect was brought to the Jinjang police station lock-up.

Crackdown on child porn

40,000 material seized, 13 men nabbed during raids in six states

KUALA LUMPUR: 13 men have been detained during raids in six states for possessing child sexual abuse material.

"The raiding teams seized 40,000 of such items," said Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain.

Among those caught were an account manager, a travel operator and several electricians.

"Many others were jobless," he said, adding that their ages ranged from 20 to 74.

Razarudin said the joint raids, given the codename "Ops Pedo Bersepadu", were conducted by the police and the Malaysian Communication and Multimedia

Commission (MCMC).

He said that 107 personnel and officers were involved.

A total of 18 teams were formed consisting of several divisions from the Bukit Aman Criminal Investigation Department (CID) including the Sexual, Women and Child Investigation Division (D11), Forensic Laboratory Division (D10) and Technical Assistance Division (D6), as well as officers from MCMC, he said when contacted yesterday.

The swoops took place in Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Penang, Perak, Johor and Terengganu on Monday.

"Eighteen premises were raided and devices belonging to the 13 men were seized," the IGP said.

Among the items seized were seven desktop computers, a laptop, 11 mobile phones, seven modems, nine routers, a DVD unit and a hard disk, he added.

Razarudin said six men were detained in Johor, three in Selangor, plus one each from Kuala Lumpur, Perak, Penang and Terengganu.

Five of them were remanded for four days, four suspects remanded for three days, two remanded a day while two others were released on police bail.

"We are investigating the case under Section 10 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act for possession of child pornography and Section 292 of the Penal Code for possession of pornographic material," he added.

Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil commended the police – especially the D11 – along with the MCMC on the success of Ops Pedo Sepadu.

"Such stern action is proof of the commitment of the authorities in curbing sexual crimes against children," he said.

He added that the government would continue to be supportive of efforts to protect the safety and well-being of children.

Fahmi also urged all online platform providers to be more proactive in blocking immoral and illegal activities.

"We also advise parents to play a part in monitoring their children's use of social media, especially those who are underage," he said in a statement.

Online smut risks for kids

Unfiltered internet searches, unsupervised access to devices, peer-shared links and intrusive pop-up ads exposing young children to explicit content, including pornography.



Parents warned of preteen exposure to pornography

➤ Unsupervised access to devices, peer-shared links and intrusive pop-up ads identified as main sources of risk

PETALING JAYA: The Malaysia Cyber Consumer Association has warned parents to beware as social media, online games and unfiltered internet searches are exposing children aged between nine and 12 to explicit material, including pornography.

"The prime reasons for such exposure are unsupervised access to devices, peer-shared links and intrusive pop-up advertisements," said its executive council for education member Maswanhizzly Masri.

His warning comes on the heels of Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil saying that Section 233 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 would be amended to allow two forms of offences – paedophilia and the sale of online pornography – to be arable offences.

Fahmi also said platforms such as Facebook, TikTok, Instagram and X are in the community standard, which mandates that only those aged 13 and above can open an account on social media platforms.

Maswanhizzly said such platforms, including YouTube, are high-risk due to the ability of hackers to bypass their filters.

He said online gaming platforms with chat functions, such as Roblox and Discord, also pose a threat, enabling players to share

explicit links.

Messaging apps such as WhatsApp and Telegram further compound the issue through private or group chats.

"Unfiltered search engines worsen the problem when parental controls or "Safe Search" features are not enabled," he said.

He added that a National Population and Family Development Board Malaysia study showed that 78.3% of parents allowed their children to have mobile phones, citing educational and current needs as driving factors.

Maswanhizzly said tools such as Google Family Link for Android and Apple Screen Time for iOS, offer basic features like content filtering and screen time limits.

For more comprehensive monitoring, options like Qustodio, Norton Family and Kaspersky Safe Kids provide social media tracking, detailed activity reports and real-time alerts for "risky behaviour".

Executive director Benny Kong of Focus on the Family, which is a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to helping families thrive, said parents and educators should watch for signs like increased device use without supervision.

"Children's withdrawal from family, anxiety about body image or pushing sexual boundaries are indications of exposure to inappropriate content and should be investigated further.

"Early exposure to pornography can harm emotional, mental and social development as it can cause emotional distress, foster negative body image and normalise objectification."

Kong said children may imitate harmful behaviour seen online, leading to child-on-child abuse.

This is especially concerning as explicit content is increasingly accessible and getting more violent.

"Parents can provide age-appropriate sex education to prevent addiction to explicit content, and without shaming their children by setting up device filters and teaching self-regulation.

"Building strong relationships can address unusual behaviour, while seeking professional help is vital if they are unable to deal with the matter.

"Parents should also encourage open communication, set clear boundaries and create screen-free zones at home," he said.

CEO Murugason Thangaratnam of Novem CS, which specialises in solving cyber security challenges, said Malaysia recently passed the Online Safety Bill 2024, which is a step toward enhancing online safety in Malaysia.

The Bill, enacted under the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998, regulates harmful content and holds service providers, including Application Service Providers and Content Application Service Providers operating in Malaysia, responsible for filtering out explicit material.

Its First Schedule categorises harmful content such as child sexual abuse material, obscene content and indecent material, with specific protection for children.

KUALA SELANGOR: Seorang guru taska yang didakwa mencubit pipi dan telinga bayi lelaki berusia 11 bulan menukar pengakuan kepada tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, semalam.

Tertuduh, Nur Suhadah Saharudin, 24, mohon dibicarakan selepas pertuduhan dibacakan semula di hadapan Hakim Nurul Mardhiah Mohammed Redza.

Mengikut pertuduhan, dia didakwa menganiaya mangsa hingga menyebabkan kecederaan fizikal di sebuah taska di Puncak Alam di sini, pukul 6.15 petang, 13 Disember lalu.

Justeru, Nur Suhadah melakukan kesalahan mengikut Seksyen 31(1) (a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum 20 tahun atau denda tidak lebih RM50,000 atau kedua-duanya sekali.

Jumaat lalu, wanita itu mengaku bersalah atas pertuduhan berkenaan selepas dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen Klang yang juga pada hari pernikahannya, namun semalam ditetapkan bagi serahan fakta kes dan jatuh hukum.

Tertuduh dibenarkan dijamin sebanyak RM10,000 dengan seorang penjamin dan tidak mengganggu mangsa dan mahkamah kemudian menetapkan sebutan kes pada 4 Februari 2025 bagi serahan dokumen.

Utusan Malaysia sebelum ini melaporkan rakaman kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) memaparkan suspek mencubit pipi bayi dengan kesan cedera pada telinga I mangsa namun bukan dipial.

Siasatan awal polis mendapati suspek tiada sijil bertauliah dan ditahan pada 14 Disember lalu selepas ibu bapa mangsa mendapati kesan lebam pada pipi dan telinga kanan anak mereka.

Difahamkan, suspek memberi alasan lebam itu akibat terjatuh meja, namun penyelia taska memaklumkan ia disebabkan tindakan pekerjaanya.

KUALA LUMPUR: A convenience store employee pleaded guilty to insulting the modesty of his co-worker by recording her while she was using the toilet, four days ago, at the Ampang Magistrate's Court today.

The teenager, 19, was charged with recording the cashier in the restroom of the premises in Jalan Ampang Hilir, Hulu Langat, at 8.23 pm on Dec 20.

He was charged under Section 509 of the Penal Code, which carries a maximum sentence of five years imprisonment, a fine, or both upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Norhidayah Abdullah Sani proposed bail at RM6,000 with one surety, while the unrepresented accused requested a lower sum on the basis that he was supporting his family.

Magistrate Amalina Basirah Md Top granted bail at RM2,800 with one surety and prohibited the accused from contacting the victim or interfering with prosecution witnesses.

The court scheduled Feb 5 for the next case mention to obtain a social welfare report on the young offender, before sentencing.
