## JKM Perlis berjaya kurangkan jurang pendapatan, ekonomi rakyat

**PADANG BESAR:** Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) negeri telah berjaya mengurangkan jurang pendapatan dan ekonomi rakyat melalui bantuan-bantuan yang telah disalurkan.

Selain itu, pelbagai peluang bagi menjana pendapatan disediakan tanpa mengira kaum bagi menamatkan kemiskinan tegar di negeri ini.

Keseluruhan penerima bantuan kewangan bulanan aktif JKM adalah 9,151 melibatkan peruntukan RM40 juta setahun.

JKM Perlis turut menyertai Program Kayuhan MAIPs Peduli yang dianjurkan oleh Majlis Agama Islam dan Adat Istiadat Melayu Perlis (MAIPs).

Ia turut meliputi program saringan kesihatan, memberi sumbangan dan menyantuni asnaf serta beramah mesra bersama rakyat negeri ini yang diketuai sendiri oleh Raja Muda Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullail.

Kolaborasi ini secara tidak langsung mewujudkan rangkaian kerjasama pelbagai agensi negeri dan Persekutuan serta pihak swasta di Perlis dalam usaha untuk sama-sama membantu para penerima bantuan, mengenalpasti keperluan atau masalah dan mencari kaedah penyelesaian yang bersesuaian.

Pengarah JKM Perlis, Ku Chik Ku Mat Esa menyatakan sebanyak 240 buah keluarga telah disantuni dari lawatan ke rumah oleh JKM melalui 80 siri Program MAIPs Peduli pada tahun 2023.

Melalui program ini juga JKM berjaya menyenarai pendek mereka yang berkelayakan untuk diteruskan bantuan atau diberi kelulusan-kelulusan baharu.

Program yang berkonsepkan turun padang ini juga dapat mengenal pasti penerima bantuan sedia ada melalui kemaskini bantuan seperti permohonan yang tidak layak atau tidak menepati kriteria kelulusan bantuan yang ditetapkan.

"Saya juga ingin mempersembahkan ucapan tahniah dan menjunjung kasih kepada Tuanku Syed Faizuddin merangkap Yang Dipertua MAIPs yang merupakan tunjang penggerak program Kayuhan MAIPs Peduli ini.

"Baginda cakna menzahirkan komitmen tinggi dan berterusan serta sentiasa mengambil berat dan responsif perihal kebajikan rakyat khususnya golongan yang memerlukan di negeri ini," kata Ku Chik.

Maklumat tersebut dikongsikan oleh Ku Chik selepas mengiringi baginda ke Majlis Sumbangan Agihan Zakat MAIPs yang diadakan di Masjid Ali bin Abi Talib Perawah, Datuk Kayaman, Bukit Keteri.

Tuanku Syed Faizuddin berkenan menyampaikan sumbangan MAIPs kepada 70 orang asnaf terpilih dari kalangan anak kariah Perawah dan 70 orang lagi dari kariah Ngulang.

Setiap penerima mendapat sumbangan wang tunai sebanyak RM700 bagi menampung keperluan harian. Pihak MAIPs menyalurkan RM98,000 untuk program kali ini. -UTUSAN



## Child marriages in Selangor drop by 82%

An official tells UN body that the drop between 2018 and 2022 was due to a national strategic plan.

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*Putrajaya is conducting a mid-term review of the Handling the Causes of Child Marriage 2020-2025 to assess the efficacy of its strategies and programmes.*

**PETALING JAYA:** The number of cases of child marriages in Selangor has declined by 82.8% between 2018 and 2022, according to the women, family and community development ministry.

An official from the ministry told the United Nations Human Rights Council that this was an example of how the ministry's National Strategic Plan in Handling the Causes of Child Marriage 2020-2025 had helped reduce child marriages.

She said the government was conducting a mid-term review of the strategic plan to assess the efficacy of its strategies and programmes.

"This plan covers awareness campaigns on sexual and reproductive health, gaps in legislation, education, strengthening family support systems and collecting socio-economic data," the official said in Geneva, Switzerland last night.

"Through the implementation of this strategy, there has been a significant reduction of child marriage cases.

"In the state of Selangor, for example, there was a reduction of 82.8% between 2018 and 2022," she told the council during its periodic review of Malaysia's human rights record.

In May 2022, the then women, family and community development minister Rina Harun said Putrajaya did not have any plans to ban underage marriages.

Her successor, and current minister, Nancy Shukri was reported to have said in March last year that though the unity government was against child marriages, it could not impose such a ban nationwide as the matter falls under the jurisdiction of the respective state governments.

The minister added that Putrajaya had already written to each state government on the matter.

Meanwhile, the ministry official reiterated that Malaysia remained committed to protecting children's rights, pointing out the formation of the new children's development department in September as an example.

"(The department) focuses on prevention, rehabilitation, development and integration of children into society. This department will enhance Malaysia's efforts towards child protection, including in handling cases of child abuse and neglect."

The official also said the department will have 900 personnel by 2026, so that the ratio of protection officers to children will increase in stages. The current ratio of one officer to 108 children will increase to one to 30.



# No one will believe me, say male victims of sexual harassment

When 29-year-old marketing executive Jake was with his previous company, he was often told to do "whatever it takes" to close a sale. This would include entertaining customers, most of whom were female bosses.

Jake admits that he felt singled out because he's tall and good looking and his female colleagues would say things like, "if you have it, flaunt it" and "nobody would say no to that cute face".

"My boss (a female) and colleagues would often joke that I had to 'please all the sugar mummies to close sales'.

"Although they said it jokingly, and I never really had to do anything, I felt uncomfortable about the explicit innuendos," he says.

"I didn't report it because I took it as part of the job. I guess I was young and impressionable at that time," says Jake who wished to go by a pseudonym for this article.

"Of course, I was worried about my job security too."

He never told anyone about it and admits he didn't realise that he was experiencing sexual harassment till much later.

"I didn't want to be embarrassed and I also felt that I wouldn't be taken seriously.

"It wasn't until recently that I heard about the anti-sexual harassment law and gender-based violence, which women's groups have been advocating about and I want to say that not only women, but men also face this."

Nik, a 34-year-old male, says he stopped going to the gym because he has been "harassed" by other men.

"There was this guy who would often walk very near me when I was exercising on the machines. He never said anything but he tried to brush against me as he walked past.

"Initially I thought it was accidental, but it happened once too often that I started to get suspicious," says Nik.

"Then it got worse, he would come near me and stare at me in the washroom/shower area," he says.

"I never thought to do anything about it like report it because it sounds silly and, would people even believe me?"

"He would just deny it and it would be his word against mine since nobody else saw what happened," he adds.

When it comes to domestic violence or intimate partner violence (IPV) and harassment, the dominant narratives are on men as perpetrators, given the disproportionate number of women who are victims of gender-based violence.

There is a scarcity of research, worldwide, on male victims of IPV and harassment, and the limited existing research shows that male victims are less likely to seek help compared to female victims.

One of the reasons for this is the pervading narratives on masculinity that cause stigma around the idea of men as victims (which relates to their believability), according to a study, "Barriers To Men's Help Seeking For Intimate Partner Violence" published in the *Journal Of Interpersonal Violence* in 2021.

The concept of men as "victims" (or women as perpetrators) requires people to "move outside the traditional boundaries of thinking," says researcher Mohammad Mazher Idriss in his paper "Abused By The Patriarchy: Male Victims, Masculinity, Honour-Based Abuse And Forced Marriages", which was published in 2021.

In October last year, during the opening of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Advocacy programme, Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri reported that more Malaysian men have started to come forward to report sexual harassment.

Out of the 762 cases reported from July 6 to Oct 2, 2023, 187 reports were from men, she highlighted.

According to Nancy, there are four levels to categorise the severity of a sexual harassment case: low level (sexual jokes against victim), mid level (sexual gestures or verbal language), high level (request for sexual acts, looking at victim in an inappropriate manner) and critical (harassment to the extent of causing physical and mental harm).

She added that Kelantan had the highest number of reports from men (52 cases) during that period with the majority of the cases involving harassment made using jokes.

Nancy said the number of people lodging sexual harassment complaints had gone up and attributed it to the advocacy programmes that have helped the victims - whether men, women or children - to speak up.

"The frequency of sexual harassment cases is probably higher than the reported cases," she added.

### Empowering male victims

According to educator and mental health consultant Prof Dr Desmond Cheah, there needs to be "a progressive shift in attitudes to foster an environment where men feel more empowered to openly share their experiences".

"This evolving cultural mindset will encourage both men and women to step forward and report incidents of sexual harassment which have been long veiled in stigma and silence," says Cheah who is founder and chief learning officer of MeMori Cerdia, a learning institution for children.

Cheah is also founder and president of Mind Integration and Mental Invention Convention.

"Awareness campaigns and educational initiatives have played a pivotal role in shedding light on the prevalence of gender-based violence against men.

Such efforts will empower individuals to recognise and report incidents that might otherwise go unnoticed," he adds.

According to Cheah, men "encounter myriad gender-based violence including unwelcome advances, inappropriate comments, and physical harassment, and this can extend beyond the physical to psychological, verbal, and online".

PDRM data from 2013 to 2017 revealed that 21% of reported sexual harassment cases involved male victims.

Out of 1,218 reported cases, 257 were from men stepping forward to report incidents of sexual harassment in the workplace.

"The contrast between the number of reported cases involving male victims and the total cases reveals the historically underreported nature of gender-based violence against men.

"While societal norms and stereotypes have long discouraged men from reporting such incidents, a positive shift is underway and men are finding the courage to overcome these barriers, contributing significantly to the increase in reported cases," he says.

### Not a sudden phenomena

But, says Cheah, the rise in reported cases does not necessarily indicate a sudden surge in incidents.

"Instead, it reflects a positive shift towards a more inclusive and supportive environment where men feel empowered to break their silence and speak up."

"Men's hesitancy to report is due to societal expectations, prevailing stereotypes, and challenges unique to male victims.

"One of these challenges is society's expectation that men should embody strength, machismo, and resilience, fostering disbelief when they disclose their experiences as victims.

"This contributes to a culture of silence, where men fear ridicule, scepticism, or doubt about the validity of their experiences.

"The apprehension of not being taken seriously and the potential backlash are formidable deterrents, dissuading many men from reporting incidents," he says.

"Men who encounter gender-based violence and sexual harassment also encounter challenges in accessing dedicated support systems.

"Unlike women, who benefit from more well-established organisations advocating for their rights, the landscape for men is less defined although avenues for support do exist," says Cheah who is also a sponsor and volunteer with the Women's Aid Organisation.

"With the introduction of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Act 2022 and the setting up of the Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal, as well as programmes such as the Women's Ministry's Anti-Sexual Harassment Advocacy Programme, it is hoped that more men and women will report sexual harassment."

"In the past, those who chose to report have found themselves navigating a prolonged and emotionally-taxing investigation period, often compounded by the necessity to continue working alongside their alleged perpetrator," he highlights.

"To encourage reporting, enhancing legal frameworks and fostering supportive environments where victims can confidently come forward without the fear of judgement, is necessary," he says.

"And, if the victim decides to pursue legal action, documenting incidents, preserving evidence, and maintaining a record of the harassment is valuable."

Cheah says that bystanders, irrespective of gender, play an important role in addressing gender-based violence.

"If you know a male friend going through it, there are ways to support them: provide a listening ear without judgement, create a safe space by encouraging them to speak openly about their feelings and experiences, offer emotional support and reassurance, and suggest seeking professional help if needed," he advises.

"Counselling or therapy can be a safe space for men to process their emotions and navigate the challenges associated with being a victim of harassment," he concludes.

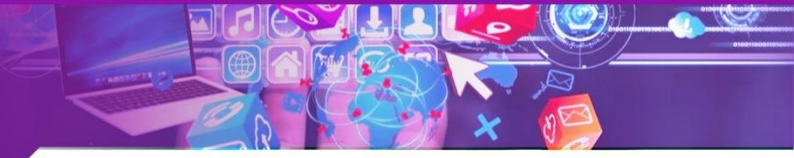

## Fatimah: Sarawakian mom, kids stranded in Philippines to be brought home soon

KUCHING (Jan 26): A Sarawakian mother and her two young children who are currently stranded in Manila, the Philippines are expected to be brought home soon.

Minister of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah said the mother, Dewi Farisha, 25, has been stranded in the Philippines since 2019 after she and her mother visited her grandfather who had fallen ill.

“Due to financial constraints, Dewi stayed back in Manila while her mother went back to Sarawak,” Fatimah told a press conference here today.

She added that during this period, Dewi gave birth to two children – Aurora Aisy and Arwaa Aisy – in 2021 and 2023 respectively.

According to Fatimah, Dewi in 2022 had visited the Malaysian Embassy in Manila to obtain an Emergency Travel Document for her first child to return to Malaysia.

“However, her application fell short as her documents were not complete,” she added.

Fatimah continued, as Dewi is expected to be overstaying in the country, the embassy also advised her to apply for a Motion of Reconsideration for overstaying.

She added that in 2023, Dewi gave birth to her second child and the penalty for overstaying in the Philippines as of Jan 17 this year has climbed to a total of RM29,439.

“On Jan 19, representatives from the Malaysian Embassy has met the Philippines’ Bureau of Immigration unit tourist visa head Raymond D. Remigio.

“During the talks, an agreement was reached where the penalty for overstaying will be reduced to RM12,249. This was made possible due to our close relationship with the Filipino government,” said Fatimah.

She added that the Malaysian Embassy has also issued Emergency Travel Documents for both of Dewi’s children to travel to Malaysia.

Prior to meeting with the Philippines’ Bureau of Immigration (BI) and the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), representatives from the Malaysian Embassy had met with Dewi and her two children.

“The family was found in Taytay in Rizal, Manila and to be living in a rented room with a shared toilet. The living conditions are not conducive to raising children as there are no beds, and the living space is said to be very small,” said Fatimah.

According to Fatimah, Dewi also claimed that drug activities are rampant in the area.

“Immediate action was taken by the embassy to relocate the family to a temporary shelter at Hotel Berjaya in Makati City on Jan 19,” she added.

Fatimah also added that the Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof, who was informed of the incident, had channeled RM3,400 (RM340 per day) to help the family with their expenses and accommodation cost.

It was also revealed that the expenses to bring home Dewi and her two children will be managed by Sarawak Volunteers involving a sum of RM24,696 which includes the RM3,400 that was channeled by Fadillah.

These include their accommodation, living expenses, flight tickets and the fine for overstaying in the Philippines.

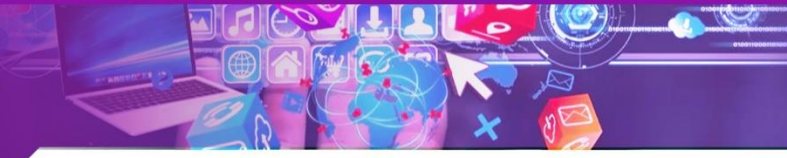
Also present at the press conference was Albony Basir, a representative from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Malaysia, Sarawak regional office; and Dewi’s mother Sheryl Balisia.

“I have contacted her (Dewi) and she is optimistic that she will return home sometime next week,” said Sheryl.

She also expressed her gratitude to everyone involved to bring her daughter and grandchildren home.

## Revitalising connections as Gardenia KL's Factory Tour Programme returns

The tour programme temporarily suspended in 2020 due to the pandemic, was recently relaunched with new features.

**GARDENIA** (Lestis Tempur) Sdn Bhd factory tour, temporarily suspended in 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic, was relaunched with new features on Jan 18.

Gardenia KL is the current market leader in the bread manufacturing industry in Malaysia, where their products are manufactured in eight facilities in Peninsula Malaysia, capable of producing 59 types of products, with approximately 3.8 million units of products produced every day.

Gardenia KL, established in 1988, is known for its joint venture between *Perusahaan Nasional Bhd* (Permas) of Malaysia and Singapore-based *GMF*.

The tour programme, initiated in 1995, serves as an educational and engaging experience for visitors of all ages, attracting an average of 45,000 visitors annually.

Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Haniyah Shuhri said the tour programme is for both children and adults alike, "holding special classes."

"It is clear that this programme is perfect for everyone and is a fantastic social activity for all age groups. Its educational value and it provides the opportunity for positive social engagement are exemplary, effectively bringing together Malaysians from all walks of life," she said at the launch event.

In line with her ministry's commitment to lead in community development and foster shared prosperity, Haniyah said they will continue to explore initiatives that align with the goal, focusing mainly on the well-being of Malaysians and its citizens.

While highlighting the significant role Gardenia plays in Malaysia's bakery industry, Haniyah also commended Gardenia KL's resilience during challenges such as the Covid-19 pandemic and floods.

"They have bounced back bravely, not only how they got everything up and running again, but they have also added some new features and improvements," Haniyah added.

At the event, the Malaysian Reserve (MRB) got to experience how their 'homemade' bread products are produced using cutting-edge automated baking machinery with dedicated staff that are always monitoring around the clock.

The staff informed us that the factory produces one type of bread per day so as to not get the products mixed up. For example, they will make QuikBites vanilla cream rolls on Monday and QuikBites cream rolls on Tuesday.

Created with the comfort of visitors in mind, the facility boasts an observation deck and a theatre for visiting families, schools and professional groups.

The maximum occupancy is up to 80 visitors per tour, while the preferred number of visitors is 50 people as the observation deck is quite narrow.

Bengkel Daya, operating under AJK, is dedicated to providing support for PwDs who encounter difficulties in finding employment in the general job market.

"Even though they are PwDs, they can think very well. They are just like normal people, only physically less able, but they can move around themselves," Haniyah commented, highlighting several cases of PwDs that the ministry has encountered during her tenure.

She emphasised that there are a variety of disabilities with unique needs, so there are different ways to teach the participants how to perform tasks and earn a living.

This workshop not only delivers training but also presents employment projects in diverse fields, while placing particular emphasis on sectors like bread and pastry production, aiming to create a reliable source of income for PwDs.

At present, BDA oversees the management of two Bengkel Daya facilities, namely Bengkel Daya Klang and Bengkel Daya Sungai Peta.

Another highlighted programme is "Anjang Sinar", a temporary transit centre designed to provide a robust social support system for children transitioning out of AJK.

## Preparedness for Possible MCO

With the surge of Covid-19 cases, TMI used Gardenia for their preparedness for a possible Movement Control Order (MCO) and how it might impact bread supply.

From the panic buying phenomena during the previous MCO, we found that shelves nationwide were wiped clean of white bread as people bought in bulk.

Being the preferred choice of bread among Malaysians from various walks of life, it is a commodity that is sought after daily. Gardenia Corporate Affairs and Public Relations (GM Relations) Haniyah told TMI that they would continue baking and ensure the bread supply would be adequate in the event.

of another MCO occurring in the future. "We can produce up to 45,000 loaves of white bread per hour. So, it is sufficient for everybody as we can operate up to 20 hours per day.

"Gardenia can produce 3.8 million units of products per day including fresh bread, bread rolls, cake rolls, waffles and yellow noodles.

"Unfortunately, during the first MCO, people were afraid that they would not have enough food during isolation, hence they hoarded," she said.

Learning from the past, Haniyah said in the case of another MCO, Gardenia is prepared to handle the situation. "We all have gone through MCO, so we know what to do now," she noted.

The Gardenia factory is equipped with temporary containers for better social distancing and workers are segregated based on which machine or equipment they are assigned to.

"One group handling the same machinery will stay in the same hostel," she added.

At the end of the tour, Haniyah encouraged Gardenia's loyal customers to experience the tour to explore the new features of the Gardenia KL factory tour programme.

"Coming to Gardenia is like being in our kitchen at home. The smell of fresh bread is just so comforting and healthy," she commented.

Meanwhile, Haniyah emphasised Gardenia's commitment to quality and freshness, and urged the public to come and witness for themselves.

"With Gardenia's commitment and innovation, we can maintain our products' freshness and quality," she concluded.

## Bag-2-School Programme

Gardenia KL upholds its tradition of aiding children from the bottom 40% income (B40) households by providing school kits to the Trinity Community Children Home Society (TCC) this year.

Since 2015, Gardenia has made a positive impact on 33,000 children, ensuring they have the essential school supplies to be ready when the school session starts.

TCC is a home for children who have faced home challenges in their early years, including orphans, single-parented children, abandoned, battered, abused or neglected by their parents and relatives.

This sanctuary, which promotes holistic principles, also conducts emotional and psychological healing through group counselling sessions, while not neglecting their education by offering them homeworking sessions, tuition, cooking and baking lessons, and music classes.

Gardenia KL invited TCC to the tour rebroadcast event, where 10 children represented the home to receive the necessary school supplies.

TCC resident Mizbanah Mior, who joined the tour, noted the cleanliness and spaciousness of the factory.

"I am excited because this is the first time that I see how bread is made," she commented, adding that she would like to come to the tour again if she is given the chance.

As for Elna Jayne from Kuala Lipis, she loved watching the waffle-making machines and was interested in learning how to make some herself.

"The aroma is so nice that you can smell it outside the factory. This tour has also inspired me to learn how to make bread so that I can take care for the needy," she told TMI.

About Gardenia's Bag-2-School programme, both participants were very happy to receive the school supplies.

"I am so grateful because the help of this school bag can lighten my family's burden.

"Of course, there will be a lot of school expenses when the new school term starts," Elna said, adding that she is committed to studying hard to help her family live a better life.

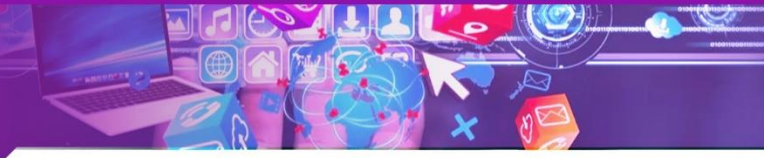

## Pengabalan warga emasancam kesejahteraan negara

### Warga emas menurut undang-undang di Malaysia

Sehingga artikel ini ditulis, masih belum wujud apa-apa pindaan perundangan undang-undang khusus terkait warga emas. Turut dilaporkan bahawa pada 2019, satu rang undang-undang warga emas dicadangkan untuk dibentangkan di parlimen pada awal tahun 2021. Pun begitu, usaha awal Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) menyatakan bahawa satu rang undang-undang warga emas akan dicadangkan bagi dibentangkan di Parlimen nampaknya belum berjaya dilaksanakan.

Dalam aspek hak warga emas, masih belum ada undang-undang khusus yang dipinda bagi maksud ini sebagaimana Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 (Acta 611). Peruntukan undang-undang yang ada bersifat umum ke atas semua lapisan masyarakat tanpa membezakan perundangan khas ke atas warga emas.

Sebagai contoh, perkara 5 sehingga 13 Perlembagaan Persekutuan menyentuh tentang aspek kebebasan diri, kesamarataan undang-undang dan sebagainya secara umum kepada semua lapisan masyarakat termasuk warga emas. Perlembagaan tidak menyebut secara khusus kepada golongan warga emas semasa-masa.

### Penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas

Penderaan dan pengabalan ini boleh didefinisikan sebagai keagungan yang berlaku kepada warga emas. Keagungan melibatkan penganiayaan yang dilakukan ke atas seseorang jama'ah dengan perlakuan seragang, serang sentuh, gangguan, kekejaman fizikal dan mental atau apa-apa bentuk lain penganiayaan.

Malangnya, penderaan dan pengabalan secara mental yang melibatkan herdikan, makian, warga emas tidak memberikan perhatian kepada mereka, tidak marakan dan tidak membarikan solangon kepada perkara yang mereka ingin lakukan dan sebagainya. Bagaimanapun, pengabalan warga emas menjadi satu isu dari sudut yang lain kerana ia sukar ditentukan sama ada ia dilakukan dengan sengaja atau tidak sengaja, ia boleh dilakukan oleh anak-anak atau penjaga dan sebagainya.

Penderaan secara fizikal adalah satu tindakan yang agresif terhadap tubuh badan termasuk perbuatan memanjat, menolak, menendang memukul dengan objek dan sebagainya. Perlakuan secara fizikal ini apabila dilakukan kepada tubuh seorang yang tua pasti akan meninggalkan kesan yang lebih teruk berbanding tubuh badan seorang yang muda.

Contohnya, satu kejadian yang berlaku di Kedah, seorang anak bertindih memukul dan menendang bapa ibunya kerana enggan memberikan wang untuk membeli dadah, mangsa mengalami bengkok di bahagian kiri badan akibat daripada tingkah laku agresif pelaku tersebut. Contoh lain tindakan seorang wanita menengking dan memukul bu kandungan yang mengandungnya sehingga mendedahkan kecederaan. Kejadian ini berlaku akibat dari satu perbalahan yang berpunca akibat air di tangki bilik air di rumahnya habis yang menyebabkan pelaku tidak boleh mandi.

Sekalinya, pengabalan secara fizikal adalah suatu keadaan apabila kehidupan warga emas itu tidak dibekalkan dari sudut keperluan, kesihatan dan sebagainya. Bahkan sesetengah ahli keluarga jarang menghubungi atau melawat ibu bapa mereka yang tua kerana sibuk bekerja. Fibah ibu bapa tidak mampu memikul beban kepada anak-anak mereka yang bekerja atau yang telah berumah tangga dan mempunyai pelbagai komitmen.

Oleh sebab itu, golongan warga emas yang tidak dipedulikan hak atau keperluan hidup oleh ahli keluarga atau masyarakat sekeliling ini memilikn untuk hidup sendiri dengan taraf hidup yang sangat dalil bahkan ada yang menjadi gendangandan mengemuti di jalanan.

Selain itu, golongan warga emas terutamanya wanita juga tidak terlepas daripada penderaan seksual yang berlaku ke atas mereka. Satu kejadian yang berlaku di Johor Bahru, seorang lelaki telah ditahan polis kerana dituduh mencaraboh jasad kebajikan orang tua dan merogol seorang wanita warga emas yang sedang tidur. Ternyata jenayah rogol bukan sahaja berlaku kepada wanita muda, malah warga emas turut menjadi mangsa untuk melampiasakan nafsu seorang lelaki yang tidak berperikemanusiaan.

### Faktor penderaan penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas

Apabila seseorang individu mencapai usia warga emas, dia akan lebih bergantung kepada ahli keluarga yang lain atau faktor kesihatan dan sebagainya. Oleh sebab itu, dapat dilihat kebanyakan pelaku kes penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas ini adalah dalam kalangan anak merantau atau suadara yang lain.

Faktor pengabalan warga emas yang berlaku pada zaman kini adalah disebabkan oleh kehidupan anak-anak yang memiliki komitmen tinggi untuk keluarga sendiri. Ada yang terpaksa mendahulukan komitmen tugas berbanding kebajikan ibu bapa. Malahan, anak-anak yang bekerja ini sudah pastinya akan sibuk dengan kehidupan harian mereka sekaligus akan mengurangkan komunikasi antara anak dan ibu bapa.

Jurang komunikasi antara ibu bapa dan anak ini juga boleh menjadi faktor penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas ini. Sebagai contoh, kasih sayang atau lisan kekeluargaan yang erat dalam ahli keluarga tidak dipukul sejak kecil menyebabkan hubungan ibu bapa dan anak kurang erat. Oleh sebab itu, apabila ibu bapa sudah menjelang usia tua, anak-anak berasa lekaik untuk menjaga ibu bapa. Hal ini seterusnya akan membawa kepada pengabalan ibu bapa.

Ibu bapa adalah idola kepada anak-anak semasa kecil. Setiap perlakuan akan dicontohi oleh anak-anak sama ada baik atau buruk. Sekiranya ibu bapa adalah seorang yang turut mengabaikan atau mendera datuk dan nenek, pola ini cenderung akan berulang kepada diri mereka sendiri. Perkara ini juga merupakan salah satu faktor yang membawa kepada isu penderaan dan pengabalan ibu bapa di masa hadapan.

### Perlindungan warga emas

Aspek perundangan amat penting bagi memastikan penguatkuasaan dalam membarteras kes penderaan dan pengabalan ini dapat dilakukan dengan sistematik. Namun begitu, sejauh manakah perundangan sedia ada dapat memastikan perlindungan warga emas di Malaysia dijamin?

Oleh itu, penelitian perundangan ini dilaksanakan untuk menguji perlindungan warga emas di Malaysia yang sedia ada dan seterusnya menganalisis keberkesannya dalam melindungi hak-hak warga emas yang menjadi mangsa penderaan dan pengabalan ini.

Setiap undang-undang yang digubal adalah untuk kesejahteraan dan keharmonian kehidupan rakyatnya termasuk undang-undang berkaitan dengan perlindungan kepada warga emas ini. Undang-undang perlindungan warga emas dibuat di Malaysia juga antaranya adalah untuk memahyut prinsip United Nation Principles for Older Persons (UNPO) 1991. Perubahan Bangsa-Bangsa Berseutu telah mewujudkan prinsip ini yang juga dikenal sebagai Resolusi 46/91.

Antara prinsip yang dikemukakan adalah tentang kebebasan, penyertaan, penjagaan, keupasan diri dan maruah. Secara asasnya, prinsip-prinsip ini turut menjadi rujukan kepada pembentukan Dasar Warga Emas Negara.

### Cadangan penambahbaikan undang-undang warga emas

Keperluan pengabalan satu undang-undang khusus untuk warga emas adalah diperlukan di Malaysia. Cadangan kerajaan untuk memperkukuhkan akta khusus bagi melindungi kebajikan warga emas amat tepat memandangkan jumlah mereka yang semakin bertambah saban tahun.

Hal ini adalah ekoran kes penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas yang semakin meningkat dan masih terdapat banyak lagi kes yang tidak dilaporkan. Selain untuk menjamin kebajikan warga emas di negara kita, langkah ini juga adalah sesuai sebagai satu penderaan Malaysia menjadi negara tua menjelang tahun 2035.

Undang-undang sedia ada di Malaysia sememangnya membarikan perlindungan kepada warga emas namun ia hanyalah secara umum dan tidak menyentuh pelbagai aspek kehidupan warga emas seperti emosi dan kewangan. Undang-undang tersebut boleh dikatakan masih berbentuk tidak komprehensif dan holistik untuk menjamin keselamatan warga emas atas sebab terdapat lakunya yang masih boleh ditambah baik dari masa ke masa.

Malaysia boleh mengambil pendekatan untuk menggubal Akta Warga Emas seperti mana Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 yang khusus kepada kanak-kanak dibuat. Hal ini adalah penting untuk mengawal kes penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas pada masa hadapan.

Satu cadangan agar Malaysia menetapkan had umur warga emas khusus dalam undang-undang turut boleh dilakukan oleh kerana tiada perlembagaan dan kesepakatan tentang berapa had umur warga emas itu sama ada di Malaysia atau luar negara. Sebagai contoh, negara maju meletakkan had umur warga emas ialah 65 tahun dan ke atas memandangkan kehidupan warga emas mereka pada usia tersebut masih aktif dan berenergi. Di samping itu, Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Kibajikan dan Masyarakat mengkatagorikan warga emas kepada tua muda, tua-tua dan paling tua-tua. Kategori ini dibuat bagi memudahkan pendekatan aktiviti sesuai dengan lapisan usia berbeza.

Manakala Dasar Warga Emas Negara pula meletakkan umur 60 tahun dan ke atas sebagai kategori warga emas. Oleh itu, langkah untuk meletakkan penetapan kepada had usia warga emas ini mungkin boleh dibuat sebagai permulaan kepada hati yang cerah dan bagi memudahkan pengkaji urusan berkaitan warga emas di Malaysia pada masa hadapan.

Kerajaan juga boleh mengambil pendekatan untuk menyedangkan pelbagai insentif kewangan bagi majikan yang mengaji atau mengkatagorikan memandangkan warga emas pada masa kini masih ramai yang sihat dan boleh menyumbang tenaga dan buah fikiran kepada pembangunan negara.

Hal ini juga mungkin boleh membarikan dalam perkembangan program keselamatan sosial di negara kita kerana kajian menunjukkan pendapatan perseorangan bagi kebanyakan warga emas adalah tidak mencukupi. Ditambah pula dengan keadaan Malaysia yang sedang menghadapi inflasi, sudah pasti program keselamatan sosial sebegini dilihat lebih komprehensif untuk ditetapkan dan dibangunkan.

Warga emas berhadapan dengan fasa kehidupan paling mencabar kerana mereka mengalami perubahan dari segi fizikal, emosi dan mental. Oleh kerana itu, Islam melarang melakukan perbuatan kasar dengan golongan warga emas dan mereka hendaklah dihormati memandangkan persaraan mereka terukut pada peringkat ini.

Islam memulakan setiap ummatnya termasuk warga emas. Oleh itu, Islam menyediakan mekanisme perlindungan kepada warga emas sebagai salah satu cara untuk membarikan golongan warga emas meneruskan kehidupan harian di hujung usia mereka. Hal ini kerana umum mengkehendaki bahawa seseorang yang telah mencapai usia tua, sudah tidak mampu bekerja kerana mempunyai kekurangan dari sudut fizikal dan akal fikiran.

Sekiranya mereka tidak dibantu dari segi makanan, minuman, pakaian dan tempat tinggal ini sudah pasti ia akan menjejaskan taraf hidup dan kesihatan mereka. Oleh itu, penyediaan mekanisme ini adalah untuk memastikan keselamatan setiap ummatnya terjaga dan kemudaranya dapat dihindarkan.

Dalam matlamat pembangunan mampan ketiga, kerajaan mengatiskan berkenaan kesihatan baik dan kesejahteraan bagi memastikan kehidupan sihat dan mengkatagorikan kesihatan dalam semua lapisan umur. Islam juga menyatakan bahawa masalah sosial yang berlaku dalam kalangan masyarakat sebagai 'fasad fi an-nahw' iaitu di mana itu keadaan dan pertumbuhan darab di muka bumi. Lantaran itu, Dasar Kebajikan Masyarakat negara ini digubal bagi mewujudkan suatu keadaan sosial dalam masyarakat di Malaysia termasuk dalam kalangan warga emas.

Warga emas sering dilambatkan sebagai warga tua atau veteran yang sudah mencapai usia tua. Di Malaysia, penggunaan istilah warga emas merujuk kepada individu yang sudah lama hidup, sudah berumur atau meningkat usia. Dari aspek kebajikan warga emas, kesepatan teknologi dan kemajuan intelek tampaknya masih gagal mencerminkan jati diri dan kemahiran insan yang luhur terhadap golongan ini. Hal ini dibuktikan dengan peningkatan isu jenayah dan moral dalam kalangan masyarakat termasuk penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas.

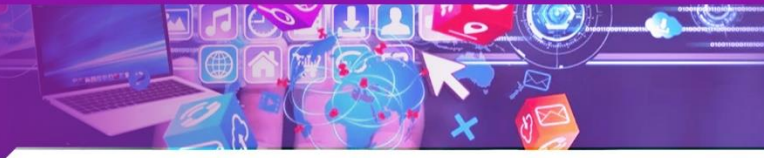
Kajian terbitan Lancet Global Health mendapati anggaran 16% warga emas melibatkan 28 buah negara telah mengalami penderaan sama ada dari segi fizikal, seksual, psikologi, kewangan dan sebagainya. Penemuan daripada kajian itu memberi impak membandingkan berbilang bentuk penderaan yang berlaku kepada warga emas berupaya memberi kesan besar kepada aspek kesihatan dan kesejahteraan negara.

Di Malaysia, laporan terbaru yang dikeluarkan oleh Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 20% kes penderaan dan pengabalan ibu bapa oleh ahli keluarga sendiri. Kajian menunjukkan 1 daripada 100 orang warga emas di Malaysia pernah dipukul dalam soal kewangan.

Penipuan ini dilakukan oleh ahli keluarga sendiri atau melibatkan sindiket. Golongan ini sering menjadi sasaran manusia yang tidak bertanggungjawab berikutan mereka dianggap rentan dan tidak lagi berkarya untuk melawan. Bahkan, dengan perkembangan teknologi yang semakin pesat membuatkan mereka lebih banyak ketinggalan dan kurang pengetahuan tentang sindiket penipuan yang berleluasa.

Lantaran itu, dalam usaha mencari solusi ke atas kes penderaan dan pengabalan warga emas, institusi keluarga dilhat sebagai unit terpenting dan paling hampir dalam memberi perlindungan kepada warga emas. Kesedaran kepada komuniti dan unit keluarga juga penting apabila didapati wujud lambakan kes melibatkan anak kandung mengabaikan dan menganiaya ibu bapa sendiri.

Satu laporan kes melibatkan seorang warga emas berusia 68 tahun dipaksa oleh anaknya untuk menandatangani dokumen pindah milik rumah di samping si anak bertindak mengabaikan wang simpanan ibunya atas usuhan peribadi menjadi bukti untuk mengingatkan langkah kesedaran bermula dari unit keluarga.



## Bekas majikan tinggalkan bayi pekerja di kaunter hospital

Bayi lelaki ditinggalkan seorang lelaki di kaunter sebuah hospital swasta di Johor Bahru pada bulan lalu dan kini di bawah jagaan sementara JKM.

### JOHOR BAHRU - Seorang bekas majikan sanggup meninggalkan bayi lelaki pekerja wanitanya di kaunter pertanyaan sebuah hospital swasta di sini baru-baru ini.

Pegawai Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Johor Bahru, Adnan Md Yassin berkata, lelaki berkenaan meninggalkan bayi berusia lima hari itu selepas mendapati hospital swasta berkenaan tidak lagi menyediakan khidmat pelindung 'baby hatch'.

Beliau berkata, pihak JKM Johor Bahru menerima maklumat berkaitan bayi lelaki berkenaan dari Jabatan Kerja Sosial Perubatan Hospital Sultanah Aminah (HSA) di sini.

"Bayi berkenaan dirujuk ke HSA selepas dibawa oleh polis untuk mendapatkan rawatan. Berdasarkan laporan polis pada 19 Disember 2023, pengadu memaklumkan lelaki tersebut meninggalkan bayi itu di kaunter pertanyaan hospital swasta tersebut pada 8.30 pagi, 18 Disember lalu.

"Pihak pengurusan hospital kemudian menempatkan bayi terbabit di taska di hospital itu kerana menjangka waris kanak-kanak itu akan tampil menuntunya.

"Bagaimanapun selepas tiada sebarang tuntutan dilakukan oleh keluarga, bayi itu dirujuk kepada polis untuk tindakan lanjut," katanya kepada pemberita di sini pada Jumaat.

Beliau berkata, hasil semakan lelaki yang meninggalkan bayi berkenaan berjaya dikesan polis dan siasatan mendapatinya merupakan bekas majikan kepada ibu kandung bayi tersebut.

"Difahamkan, ibu kandung meminta bantuan lelaki itu untuk menempatkan kanak-kanak di 'baby hatch' yang terdapat di hospital berkenaan namun lelaki itu buntu selepas mendapati perkhidmatan itu tidak disediakan lagi oleh hospital.

"Lelaki itu kemudian bertindak meninggalkan bayi di kaunter pertanyaan hospital sebelum beredar," katanya.

Adnan berkata, hasil pemeriksaan fizikal dan perkembangan kanak-kanak, pegawai perubatan menganggarkan usia bayi terbabit ketika dirujuk kepada HSA baru berusia lima hari dan kini dianggarkan berusia enam minggu.

JKM ujarnya, mengklasifikasikan bayi itu memerlukan pemeliharaan dan perlindungan.

Menurutnya, JKM juga memohon perintah di bawah Subseksyen 30(7) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 untuk bayi berkenaan ditempatkan di Rumah Perlindungan Kanak-Kanak Johor bagi membolehkan pihaknya menjalankan siasatan lanjut.

Adnan berkata, bayi berkenaan dinamakan sebagai Kaisar Aryan selain berharap waris bayi berkenaan tampil menghubungi JKM bagi membincangkan masa depannya.

**KUALA LUMPUR** : Seorang bayi perempuan berusia setahun terkunci hampir sejam dalam rumahnya di tingkat 12 sebuah apartmen di Jalan Wangsa Kuarza, Wangsa Maju, di sini hari ini.

Satu panggilan kecemasan diterima Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat Malaysia (JBPM) Kuala Lumpur daripada keluarga bayi itu sekitar pukul 11.37 pagi.

Kesalahan itu, mengikut Seksyen 14 (b) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017, membawa hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan jika sabit kesalahan.

Mahkamah menetapkan 21 Feb untuk tarikh sebutan seterusnya dan membebaskan tertuduh dengan ikat jamin RM5,000 beserta dua orang penjamin setiap seorang.

Kedua-dua tertuduh, yang saling berkawan, turut diperintah melaporkan diri di balai polis berhampiran sebulan sekali.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Muhammad Azizi Hamil mengendalikan pendakwaan.

Mohamad diwakili peguam Datuk Nelson Angang manakala Afiq tidak diwakili.

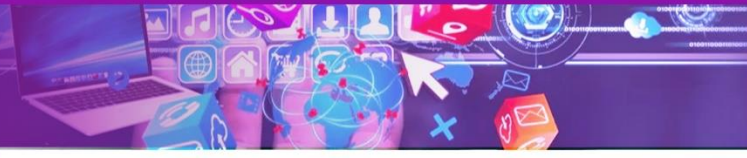

# Father of 3, two women charged over sale of sex videos online

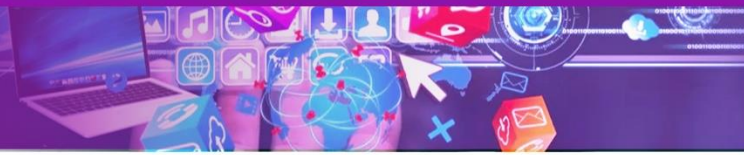
**KUALA LUMPUR:** A man believed to have been a "gigolo" who sold explicit videos of himself engaging in sexual activities with more than 20 women on the Telegram chat application was yesterday charged with two female friends. Father of three Hasli Ikhwan Arif Zul Hasli, 32, Norshazrina Md Zamri, 27, and Norhidayah Mahadi, 24, pleaded not guilty after the charge was read out to them before Sessions Court judge Siti Aminah Ghazali. According to the charge sheet, the three were found to have made advertisements for sexual activities on the X social media platform (formerly Twitter) under the han-

dle Notyourdaddy (@Hotdaddyxx) at the office of the federal police Anti-Vice, Gaming and Secret Societies Division (D7). They were alleged to have committed the offence on Jan 16 at 10.10am. The charge was framed under Section 372(1)(e) of the Penal Code, read together with Section 34 of the same code. They face up to 15 years' jail, whipping and a fine. Deputy public prosecutor Nidzuwan Abd Latif did not offer bail as it is a non-bailable offence. He said if the court allowed bail, it should be fixed at RM20,000 with one surety for each accused. "The proposed bail of RM20,000 is fair to protect the interests of the

public," he said, adding that the offence was serious. The accused were represented by Mohd Faris Abrar Othman and Muhammad Faiz Mustafa. Faris, in pleading for minimum bail, said the sum should not be excessive, but enough to ensure the accused's attendance in court. He said there was no probability that his clients would abscond. "They are Malaysians and have family here. They will answer the charge in court." He said Hasli Ikhwan has three children, aged 12, 10 and 4, and was supporting his father who has kidney disease. He said Norhidayah had no

fixed income, while Norshazrina earns about RM4,000 monthly as an area manager. "They are innocent until proven guilty. If the bail is too high, it is like a punishment." Siti Aminah set bail at RM10,000 with one surety for each accused and set Feb 28 for case mention and document submission. The three were arrested by D7 officers at a house in Kampung Janda Baik, Bentong, Pahang. Federal Criminal Investigation Department director Datuk Seri Mohd Shuhaily Mohd Zain had said the male suspect was identified through investigation by his department into his self-pro-

motion of recorded sexual activities on the Telegram app. He said this was the first such case in the country. Initial investigations revealed that the main suspect, who is twice divorced, began selling sexual enhancement drugs from China on social media early last year. Shuhaily said to improve sales, the suspect learnt how to record videos of himself engaging in rough sex with his female companions to sell on three channels on Telegram since July last year. The suspect, who is believed to have been a gigolo or hired escort, also had sex with his female customers.

## Advertising sexual services: Man, female companions claim trial

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A man and his two female friends pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court here yesterday to charges of advertising sexual services on X – formerly Twitter – last week.

Hasli Ikhwan Arif Zul Hasli, 32, Norshazrina Md Zamri, 27, and Norhidayah Mahadi, 24, were jointly charged under Section 372(1)(e) of the Penal Code which provides a maximum of 15 years' imprisonment with whipping and a fine, if convicted.

Deputy public prosecutor Nidzuwan Abd Latif did not offer any bail for the three accused as this was an unbailable offence, but proposed a sum of RM20,000 for each if the court granted them bail.

Counsel Mohd Faris Abrar Othman, representing the three accused, requested a minimal bail amount, highlighting that his three clients are supporting their families.

"Hasli is a father of three aged between four and 12, and also supports his father who is a kidney patient. Norshazrina takes care of her 56-year-old

mother who has heart disease, and Norhidayah has no fixed income," said Mohd Faris who was assisted by lawyer Muhammad Faiz Mustafa.

Judge Siti Aminah Ghazali allowed bail of RM10,000 with one surety for each accused and fixed Feb 28 for case mention and submission of documents.

Earlier, the media reported that a man was arrested for allegedly selling explicit videos through social media, showing him engaging in sexual activities with over 20 women of various races. On Jan 18, he and his two female friends were arrested at a house in Janda Baik, Pahang by Bukit Aman police. — Bernama

donated 15 packets of rice and some dry food items.

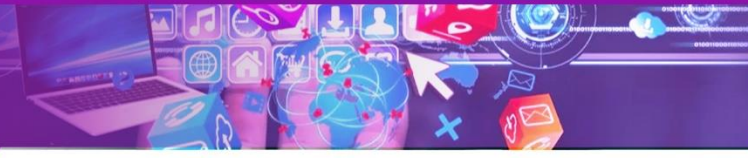
On a separate matter, Boon said Masa has now relocated from Senadin to the current location since April last year.

# Fatimah: Mum, kids stranded in Philippines to be brought home

**KUCHING:** A Sarawakian mother and her two young children who are currently stranded in Manila are expected to be brought home soon.

Minister of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development Dato Sri Fatimah Abdullah said Dewi Farisha, 25, has been stranded in the Philippines since 2019 after she and her mother visited her grandfather who had fallen ill.

"Due to financial constraints, Dewi stayed back in Manila while her mother went back to Sarawak," Fatimah told a press conference here yesterday.

She added that during this period, Dewi gave birth to two children - Aurora Aisy and Arwaa Aisy - in 2021 and 2023, respectively.

According to Fatimah, Dewi in 2022 had visited the Malaysian Embassy in Manila to obtain an Emergency Travel Document for her first child to return to Malaysia.

"However, her application fell short as her documents were not complete," she said, adding the embassy had advised Dewi to apply for a Motion of Reconsideration for overstaying.

She added that Dewi's penalty for overstaying in the Philippines as of Jan 17 this year had climbed to RM29,439.

"On Jan 19, representatives

from the Malaysian Embassy met the Philippines' Bureau of Immigration (BI) unit tourist visa head Raymond D. Remigio.

"During the talks, an agreement was reached where the penalty for overstaying will be reduced to RM12,249. This was made possible

due to our close relationship with the Philippine government," said Fatimah.

She added that the Malaysian Embassy has also issued Emergency Travel Documents for both of Dewi's children to travel to Malaysia.

Prior to meeting with the BI and the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI), representatives from the Malaysian Embassy had met with Dewi and her two children.

"The family was found in Taytay in Rizal, Manila and to be living in a rented room with a shared toilet. The living conditions are not conducive to raising children as there are no beds, and the living space is said to be very small," said Fatimah.

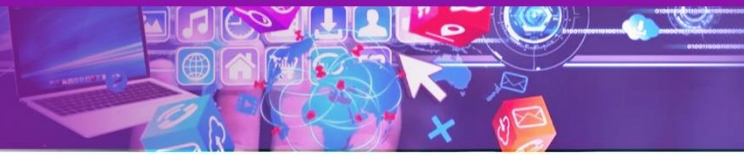
She said immediate action was taken by the embassy to relocate the family to a temporary shelter at Hotel Berjaya in Makati City on Jan 19.

Fatimah added that Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Fadillah Yusof, who was informed of the incident, had channelled RM3,400 (RM340 per day) to help the family with their expenses and accommodation costs.

It was also revealed that the expenses to bring home Dewi and her two children will be managed by Sarawak Volunteers involving a sum of RM24,696 which includes the RM3,400 that was channelled by Fadillah.

Meanwhile, Dewi's mother Sheryl Balisia, who was present at the press conference, said her daughter was optimistic of being able to return home sometime next week.

She also expressed her gratitude to everyone involved for helping to bring her daughter and grandchildren home.

He also took the opportunity to encourage the elderly to practise an active lifestyle by

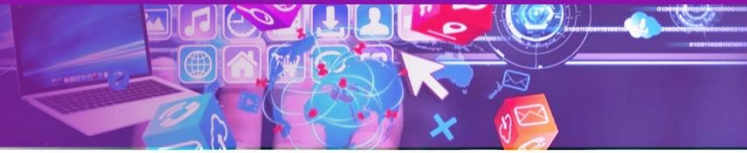
exercising and being involved in other activities that would benefit their health.

## Cold water thrown on 'Hot Daddy' and two girlfriends

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**KUALA LUMPUR:** A father of three, infamously known as "Hot Daddy", and his two girlfriends have been charged for offering sexual services on X (formerly known as Twitter).

Hasli Ikhwan Arif Zul Hasli, 32, Norhidayah Mahadi, 24, and Norshazrina Md Zamri, 27, pleaded not guilty before Sessions Court judge Siti Aminah Ghazali here yesterday.

According to the charge sheet, the accused advertised sexual activities using X, whereby a reasonable person would understand it as "prostitution services".

The offence was allegedly committed at the anti-vice, gambling and secret societies division (D7) office in Bukit Aman on Jan 16.

They were charged under Section 372 (1)(e) of the Penal Code, read together with Section 34 of the same Act, which carries a jail term of up to 15 years, whipping and fine, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Nidzuwan Abd Latif did not offer bail on grounds the charge was a non-bailable offence and taking into consideration public interest.

"However, if the court allows bail, the prosecution suggests a RM20,000 bail for each," he said.

Lawyer Mohd Faris Abrar Othman, who represented all

three accused, sought a minimum bail amount.

He said his clients are not a flight risk as they are locals and have families.

"Hasli Ikhwan has to care for his 67-year-old father, who has kidney illness. He has three children aged 12, 10 and four.

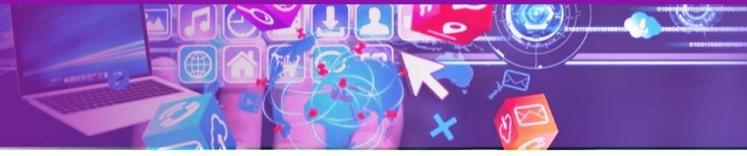
"Norshazrina works as a manager in the private sector with a RM4,000 monthly income.

"She has to look after her 56-year-old mother, who has heart disease while Norhidayah does not have a fixed income," he said.

Siti Aminah allowed bail at RM10,000 in one surety for each accused. The case is fixed for mention on Feb 28.

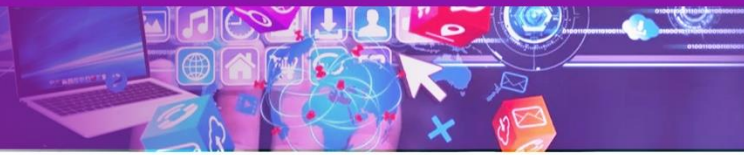

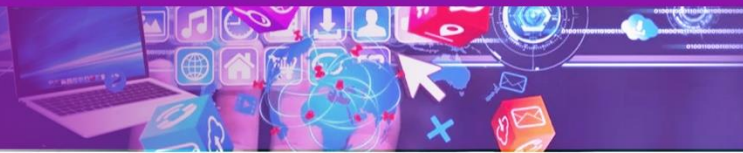

## Rakam video lelaki buang air kecil, penyelia kedai didenda RM3,500

**KUCHING:**Seorangpenye-  
lia kedai didenda RM3,500  
atau empat bulan penjara  
oleh Mahkamah Majistret  
semalam selepas mengaku  
bersalah merakam video  
seorang pemuda sedang  
membuang air kecil dengan  
niat menceroboh privasi  
mangsa.

Majistret Syarifah Fati-  
mah Azura Wan Ali men-  
jatuhkan hukuman tersebut  
terhadap Christopher Levy  
Nojim, 32, yang membuat  
pengakuan tersebut sebaik  
didakwa mengikut Seksyen  
509 Kanun Keseksaan.

Seksyen berkenaan mem-  
peruntukkan hukuman  
penjara sehingga lima tahun  
atau denda atau kedua-du-  
anya jika sabit kesalahan.

Berdasarkanpertuduhan,  
tertuduh didakwa melaku-  
kan perbuatan tersebut  
terhadap mangsa (pengadu)  
berusia 23 tahun pada 23  
Januari 2024, sekitar jam  
11.10 malam di tandas  
lelaki terletak di tingkat tiga  
sebuah pusat beli-belah di  
Jalan Wan Alwi di sini.

Fakta kes mendedahkan  
semasa pekerja (pengadu)  
di salah sebuah kedai di  
situ berada di dalam tandas,  
dia terlihat bayang-bayang  
seseorang (tertuduh) dan  
sebuah telefon pintar yang  
merakam perbuatannya se-

dang membuang air kecil.

Berikutan itu, pengadu  
dengan segera memohon  
bantuan rakan sekerja dan  
pihak pengawal kesela-  
matan di pusat beli-belah  
berkenaan untuk menang-  
kap tertuduh.

Setelah tertuduh ber-  
jaya ditangkap, soal siasat  
terhadap tertuduh dibuat  
dan tertuduh mengaku  
telah membuat rakaman  
terhadap pengadu yang  
sedang membuang air kecil  
di dalam tandas awam  
berkenaan.

Kejadian itu dimaklum-  
kan kepada pihak polis  
dan tertuduh ditangkap  
semula beberapa jam ke-  
mudian, sekitar jam 12.56  
tengah malam bersama  
barang rampasan iaitu se-  
buah telefon pintar milik  
tertuduh.

Hasil siasatan polis men-  
dapati telefon pintar ter-  
tuduh mengandungi video  
pengadu yang sedang be-  
rada di dalam tandas, malah  
mangsa turut mengenali se-  
longsong telefon tertuduh.

Difahamkan, tertuduh  
berbuat demikian untuk  
kepuasan sendiri.

Pendakwaan dilakukan  
oleh Pegawai Pendakwa  
ASP Arman Ibrahim se-  
mentara tertuduh tidak  
diwakili peguam.
