Kepolisian komuniti penting bantu tangani ancaman pornografi kanak-kanak

Kuala Lumpur: Kepolisian komuniti atau *community policing* adalah pendekatan penting dalam membantu menangani isu pemilikan dan penggunaan bahan terlarang di negara ini, termasuk kandungan pornografi membabitkan kanak-kanak.

Pakar Pengurusan Perkhidmatan Teknologi Maklumat di Pertama Digital Berhad, Dr T Sashi Kumar berkata, pergantungan semata-mata kepada pihak berkuasa atau agensi tertentu tidak mencukupi untuk menangani masalah itu secara berkesan.

"Kita perlu menggabungkan kepakaran daripada Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM), Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC), CyberSecurity Malaysia, serta kepolisian komuniti yang kini semakin relevan.

"Apabila komuniti yang menggunakan Internet menyedari kewujudan sumber atau saluran yang menyebarkan bahan terlarang ini, perlu ada mekanisme untuk mereka membuat laporan atau memberikan maklumat, supaya pengurusan sumber risiko menjadi lebih berkesan," katanya kepada Bernama.

Sashi Kumar turut menekankan bahawa pemilikan dan penggunaan kandungan pornografi kanak-kanak kini membimbangkan, kerana sesiapa saja boleh mengakses bahan itu melalui pelbagai saluran, termasuk platform bukan arus perdana seperti *dark web*.

Beliau menjelaskan bahawa saluran itu sukar dipantau secara komprehensif kerana ia berada di luar radar penguatkuasaan pihak berkuasa.

"Oleh itu, kita perlu mengubah pendekatan pemantauan terhadap pemilikan dan penggunaan video ini. Kita tidak boleh hanya bergantung kepada kaedah tradisional seperti laporan atau penguatkuasaan biasa.

"Sebaliknya, kita perlu menggunakan perisikan mendalam untuk mengenal pasti punca bahan terlarang ini disimpan dan disebarkan," katanya.

Pada Selasa, Ketua Polis Negara Tan Sri Razarudin Husain memaklumkan seramai 13 lelaki tempatan, termasuk seorang warga emas, ditahan kerana disyaki melakukan kesalahan seksual secara dalam talian membabitkan bahan penderaan seksual kanak-kanak (CSAM) dalam serbuan di enam negeri.

Pemeriksaan ke atas peranti yang dirampas di kediaman semua suspek berusia antara 20 hingga 74 tahun menemukan kira-kira 40,000 bahan CSAM dan bahan pornografi.

Mengulas mengenai keselamatan siber, Sashi Kumar berkata, cabaran utama kini ialah keupayaan pihak penggodam yang lebih maju berbanding teknologi dan perisian keselamatan sedia ada, selaras perkembangan pesat teknologi anti-keselamatan (*anti-security*).

"Persekitaran penggodaman dan kompromi keselamatan sangat dinamik. Syarikat perlu segera berkongsi maklumat mengenai jenis serangan baharu yang mereka hadapi, supaya langkah pencegahan boleh diambil dengan lebih pantas.

"Selain itu, laporan kepada pihak berkuasa seperti CyberSecurity Malaysia juga penting untuk memastikan maklumat terkini dapat dikongsi dengan semua pihak berkaitan," katanya.

Sashi Kumar turut menyambut baik penguatkuasaan Akta Keselamatan Siber 2024 (Akta 854), yang menurutnya menyediakan asas kukuh untuk menangani pelbagai isu keselamatan siber seperti penggodaman, buli siber, dan jenayah penipuan (*scam*).

"Akta Keselamatan Siber 2024 adalah undang-undang yang baik untuk menangani masalah sedia ada. Dengan penguatkuasaan yang lebih ketat, saya percaya kita dapat mengekang isu-isu berkaitan keselamatan siber," katanya.

Don't just rely on cops to check child porn, says expert

KUALA LUMPUR: Community policing is an essential approach in addressing the possession and use of illicit materials in the country, such as pornography, particularly when it involves children, according to an information technology (IT) expert.

Pertama Digital Bhd IT service management specialist Dr T. Sashi Kumar said relying solely on the expertise of authorities or agencies is not enough to tackle the issue effectively.

"We need to combine the expertise of the Royal Malaysia Police, the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission, CyberSecurity Malaysia, and also community policing, which is very important today.

"When members of the community using the Internet become aware of sources or channels dis-

tributing illicit materials, there needs to be a mechanism for them to report or provide information so that the management of intelligence resources can be more effective," he told Bernama.

At the same time, Sashi Kumar expressed concern over the possession and use of child pornography, as anyone could gain access to such materials through various channels, including non-mainstream ones like the dark web.

He said this is because such channels cannot be comprehensively monitored as they are outside the radar of enforcement, control and supervision by the relevant authorities.

"What we need to do is change the way we monitor the possession and use of these videos, not just relying on conventional methods like reports or regular

enforcement. Instead, we need to have some intelligence by using deeper surveillance or moles to try to identify where these illicit videos or materials are stored and distributed," he said.

On Wednesday, Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain announced that 13 local men, including an elderly person, had been arrested on suspicion of committing online sexual offences involving child sexual abuse material (CSAM) in raids across six states.

Examinations of devices used at the residences of all the suspects, aged between 20 and 74, revealed an estimated 40,000 CSAM files and pornographic materials.

Commenting on cybersecurity, Sashi Kumar said the main challenge at present is the increasing

sophistication of hackers compared to the companies or software used to protect cybersecurity, due to the rapid development of anti-security measures.

As a result, he said, the dynamic changes occurring in the hacking environment or security compromises must be given appropriate attention.

Meanwhile, the IT expert also said the Cybersecurity Act 2024 (Act 854) provides an opportunity for more comprehensive enforcement in addressing any issues related to cybersecurity, including hacking, cyberbullying and scams.

"In the context of Malaysia, the Act is a good law to address the problems we face and I believe stricter enforcement of it will curb any issues we may encounter in cybersecurity," he said.

KUANTAN: Situasi banjir di Pahang menunjukkan perkembangan positif apabila jumlah mangsa semakin berkurangan susulan banjir di daerah Raub pulih sepenuhnya selepas penutupan pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS) pagi tadi.

Menurut Sekretariat Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Daerah (JPBD) Raub, seramai empat mangsa daripada satu keluarga yang ditempatkan di PPS Balairaya Kampung Tersang sejak 11.30 pagi semalam telah dibenarkan pulang ke kediaman masing-masing sekitar pukul 8 pagi tadi.

Sementara itu, di daerah Lipis, seramai 89 mangsa daripada 28 keluarga masih berada di dua PPS setakat 11.30 pagi ini, menurut portal Info Bencana Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM). Mereka ditempatkan di Masjid Kampung Beletik dan Sekolah Kebangsaan Lubuk Kulit.

Semakan di portal Public Info Banjir Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) pula mendapati empat sungai di negeri ini berada dalam keadaan waspada, iaitu Sungai Pahang di Kuala Krau, Temerloh; Sungai Kuantan di Kuantan Bypass, Kuantan; Sungai Dong di Kampung Peruas, Raub; serta Sungai Jelai di Jeti Lipis, Lipis.

GIRLS MAKE UP MOST MISSING CHILDREN IN MALAYSIA

They face higher societal pressures, restrictions than boys, say activists

GIRLS vastly outnumbered boys among missing children in Malaysia this year.

Data from Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Child Investigation Division (D11) showed that in the first half of the year, 421 of the 572 reported missing children were girls, making up 73.6 per cent of the total.

Data also showed that most missing children were aged 13 to 18, and 59 cases involved younger children aged 7 to 12.

According to the statistics, the majority of the disappearances took place in January, with 117 children reported missing that month.

Up to June, 484 had been found, with 88 still missing.

Child activist Datuk Dr Hartini Zainudin, co-founder of Yayasan Chow Kit, attributed the higher number of missing girls to additional social pressures and restrictions that might lead them to run away.

She said girls were often targeted more for exploitation, which could account for some disappearances.

She added that there might be an under-reporting of missing boys due to societal expectations of male independence.

"There is a longstanding preference for sons over daughters. How much does this play a factor?"

Such preferences, said Hartini, could lead to neglect and undervaluing of girls, increasing their vulnerability.

"This can result in adverse situations, including running away

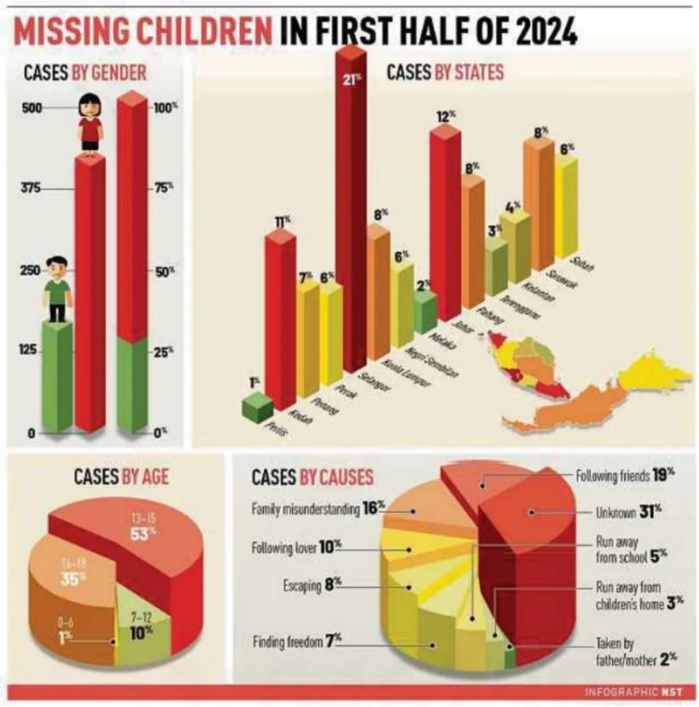

or being trafficked. "Girls may feel) misunderstood or unsupported at home, seeking independence or an escape from strict rules, or due to peer pressure and the desire to fit in with friends, as well as romantic relationships disapproved of by parents, abuse, neglect, or other serious family problems," she said.

Fellow activist and Suriana Welfare Society chairman Dr James Nayagam supported these observations, emphasising the influence of romantic relationships.

"Most of the time, there's a boyfriend in the picture. Either he disliked her parents or the relationship with the parents is very, very weak."

Nayagam added that in some cases, it was due to a group or a gang deciding to run away with the girl.



A lack of school attendance has also been identified as a significant contributor to the growing issue of runaways and missing children.

"(Not attending school causes) reduced adult supervision and structure in a child's life," said Hartini.

According to the data, 82 children were not attending school at the time of their disappearance, while 104 had stopped attending school in the past.

This absence, Hartini said, deprived children of essential support mechanisms.

"(There would be) fewer opportunities to build positive peer relationships," she said, highlighting how school environments fostered healthy social connections.

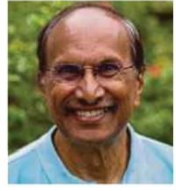
Beyond social interactions, schools offer critical resources that can safeguard children from negative influences.

Hartini warned that a lack of structured education "increases the risk of engaging in risky behaviours" and might push children towards dangerous choices.

Nayagam agreed, drawing attention to a pattern he has observed.

"I have yet to come across a child (who is regularly) attending school going missing," he said.

He noted that many children

who went missing often came from "the lower-performing class" of the school, struggling academically.

Nayagam also raised the alarm on criminal elements linked to

cases of runaway and missing children, especially among older minors.

"The girls are lured into prostitution and other things such as pornography," he said, adding that in these cases, there were at times the involvement of criminal networks.

He also said in many cases he had handled, young male peers acted as facilitators.

"In situations involving young girls that I have dealt with, it's basically the boy who acts as a pimp."

He said the financial incentive for such activities could be significant, entrenching the cycle of exploitation.

Nayagam said these young girls often remained in such situations willingly, lured by the promise of income.

While police's statistics showed that only a handful of missing children cases involved criminal elements, Nayagam said the situation needed greater examination.

"It is something that we need to look at in much greater detail, rather than just accepting the figures," he said.

Earlier this year, Home Minister Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail said an average of two children went missing each day between 2020 and September 2024.

'INTERNET IS NOW A DARK PLAYGROUND'

Bukit Bendera MP calls for reforms to end digital predation on children

THE recent Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC, which led to the arrests of individuals for possession and distribution of child sexual abuse material (CSAM), exposes a disturbing reality within our society.

Bukit Bendera member of parliament Syerleena Abdul Rashid has called for Malaysia to end digital predation on children.

"The fact that suspects were able to operate under false identities on platforms like X and Telegram, accessing and distributing explicit content with ease, is a glaring indictment of the state of online governance.

"The communications minister's proposal for a social media licensing framework is a step in the right direction, but it is insufficient. We must demand immediate and comprehensive reforms that hold these platforms accountable for the content they host," she said in a statement.

Syerleena said the Internet had become a dark playground for those seeking to exploit children.

"From predators lurking behind anonymous profiles to harmful content masquerading as entertainment, children are bombarded with threats to their safety and wellbeing.

"Social media platforms, gaming communities and even educational apps have become gateways for cyberbullying, grooming and exposure to disturbing material.

"The lack of accountability in digital spaces has allowed these horrors to flourish unchecked, so there is an urgent need to strengthen and ensure the protection of our children through clear regulations."

She urged the government to implement stringent regulations that would compel social media companies to prioritise user safety and actively prevent the dissemination of CSAM.

"Protecting our children is not just a collective responsibility, but a moral imperative that demands immediate and decisive action," Syerleena said.

Information technology expert Dr T. Sashi Kumar told Bernama that relying solely on the expertise of authorities or agencies was insufficient to tackle the issue.

"We need to combine the expertise of the police, the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), CyberSecurity Malaysia and also community policing.

"When community members using the Internet become aware of sources or channels distributing illicit materials, there needs to be a mechanism for them to report or provide information, so that managing intelligence resources can be more effective."

He also expressed concern that anyone could gain access to child pornography through various channels, including non-mainstream ones like the dark web.

Such channels, he said, could not be comprehensively monitored as they were outside the authorities' radar of enforcement, control and supervision.

"We need to change the way we monitor possession and use of these videos, and not just rely on conventional methods like reports or regular enforcement.

"We need to gather intelligence through deeper surveillance or moles to identify where these illicit videos or materials are stored and distributed," Sashi Kumar said.

On Monday, the police and the MCMC launched a blitz against individuals suspected of possessing and distributing CSAM across six states.

The raids led to the arrests of 13 individuals and the seizure of 40,000 CSAM and pornographic content.

The operation came after a series of reports by the *New Straits Times* on the rampant sale of Malaysian-made explicit content, including CSAM, on social media and messaging platforms.

Muhammad Syarifuddin Manan, 24 mendakwa, anak sulungnya yang kini berusia 41 hari sering mengalami sawan berikutan insiden yang berlaku pada 17 November lalu.

JPS menerusi kenyataan memaklumkan jajahan terbabit ialah Tumpat, Pasir Mas, Kota Bharu, Pasir Puteh, Bachok, Tanah Merah, Machang, Kuala Krai dan Jeli.

"Di jajahan **Tumpat**, banjir dijangka membabitkan lembangan Sungai Golok, Sungai Kelantan dan Sungai Pengkalan Nangka.

Sementara di **Pasir Mas** membabitkan lembangan Sungai Golok dan lembangan Sungai Kelantan.

"Di **Kota Bharu** pula membabitkan tiga lembangan sungai iaitu lembangan Sungai Kelantan, lembangan Sungai Pengkalan Datu dan lembangan Sungai Semerak. Selain itu, di Pasir Puteh membabitkan lembangan Sungai Kelantan dan lembangan Sungai Semerak," menurut kenyataan itu.

Bagi jajahan **Bachok**, banjir dijangka membabitkan lembangan Sungai Kemasin dan lembangan Sungai Semerak, manakala di Tanah Merah, membabit-

kan lembangan Sungai Golok dan lembangan Sungai Kelantan.

Di **Kuala Krai**, banjir dijangka membabitkan lembangan Sungai Kelantan, manakala di Jeli, membabitkan lembangan Sungai Golok dan lembangan Sungai Kelantan.

"JPS akan terus melakukan pemantauan secara berterusan dan mengemas kini hebahan amaran banjir jika hujan signifikan berterusan di lembangan sungai itu," menurut kenyataan itu.

Banjir diramalkan boleh berlaku lebih awal atau lewat daripada tarikh jangkakan. Oleh itu, semua agensi pengurusan bencana serta penduduk di kawasan berisiko diminta berwaspada dan sentiasa peka terhadap arahan pihak berkuasa seperti laporan **BERNAMA**.

Hilang punca pendapatan

Sementara itu di **Setiu**, Terengganu seorang warga emas orang kurang upaya (OKU) cacat penglihatan hilang punca pendapatan selepas tanaman di atas tanah seluas 0.4 hektar rosak akibat banjir November lalu.

Ibarat sudah jatuh ditimpa tangga apabila kejadian itu turut memusnahkan pelbagai barang selepas kediaman didiaminya bersama isteri dan tiga anak di Kampung Seri Kenangan, Pelong, di sini, ditenggelami air sedalam tiga meter.

Warga emas terbabit, Mat Zin Sulaiman, 61, berkata beliau mengalami kerugian hampir RM15,000 apabila semua tanaman kacang panjang dan jagung musnah.

Flooding forecast in 9 districts in Kelantan; floods ease in Pahang

KOTA BARU: The Irrigation and Drainage Department (DID) said there might be flooding in nine districts in Kelantan for three days from Sunday.

The districts are Tumpat, Pasir Mas, Kota Baru, Pasir Puteh, Bachok, Tanah Merah, Machang, Kuala Krai and Jeli.

“For Tumpat, the areas at risk include the Sungai Golok, Sungai Kelantan and Sungai Pengkalan Nangka basins.

“In Pasir Mas, the Sungai Golok and Sungai Kelantan basins are at risk.

“In Kota Baru, three river basins are at risk — Sungai Kelantan, Sungai Pengkalan Datu and Sungai Semerak.

“In Pasir Puteh, the Sungai Kelantan and Sungai Semerak basins are at risk,” the department said in a statement yesterday.

For Bachok, the forecast covers the Sungai Kemasin and Sungai Semerak basins, while in Tanah Merah, it covers the Sungai Golok and Sungai Kelantan basins.

“In Kuala Krai, the Sungai Kelantan basin is at risk, while in Jeli, the Sungai Golok and Sungai Kelantan basins are at risk.

“The department will continue monitoring and provide updates on flood warnings if significant rainfall persists in these

basins,” the DID said.

The department said floods could occur earlier or later than the forecast.

Disaster management agencies and residents, especially those in flood-prone areas, were advised to remain vigilant and heed instructions from the authorities.

In **Pahang**, the flood situation saw improvement, with a decrease in the number of evacuees at temporary flood relief centre (PPS) yesterday.

The Raub Disaster Management Committee Secretariat said four evacuees from one family sheltering at the Balairaya Kampung Tersang PPS since Wednesday returned home at 8am yesterday. The centre was then closed.

In Lipis, the Social Welfare Department’s Info Bencana portal reported that 89 flood victims from 28 families remained at two PPS, namely Masjid Kampung Beletik and SK Lubuk Kulit.

The DID’s Public Infobanjir portal showed that four rivers in the state were at the alert level — Sungai Pahang in Kuala Krau, Temerloh; Sungai Kuantan at the Kuantan Bypass; Sungai Dong in Kampung Peruas, Raub; and Sungai Jelai at the Lipis Jetty.

Tertuduh didakwa mengikut Seksyen 292 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman penjara sehingga tiga tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya jika sabit kesalahan.

Semua video dan gambar itu dirakam ketika mereka sedang mandi dan juga menyalin pakaian dalam bilik.

Pada prosiding itu, pendakwaan diketuai Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Fa-

rah Wahidah Mohd Sharip manakala tertuduh diwakili Tan Song Yan daripada Yayasan Bantuan Guaman Kebangsaan (YBGK).

Terdahulu, pihak pendakwaan memohon mahkamah menjatuhi hukuman penjara kerana bimbang kemungkinan tertuduh akan melakukan perkara sama jika dikenakan denda.
