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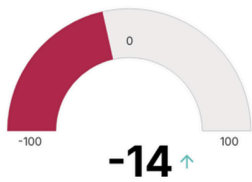

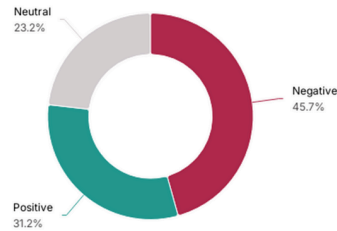

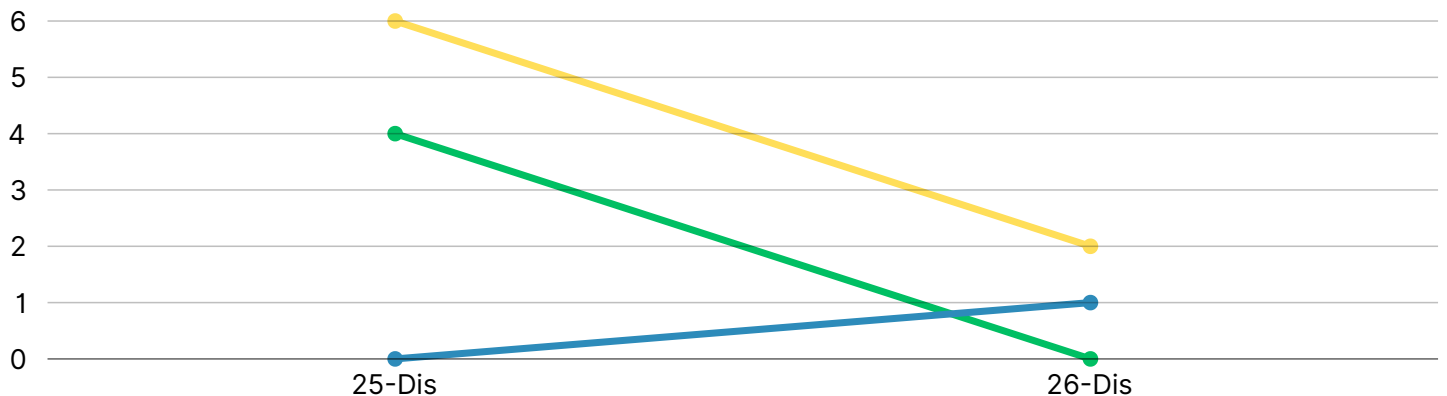

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## Call to address disparities in autism care service provision

Govt could target regions in need and ensure equitable distribution of treatment: NGO

**PETALING JAYA:** The National Autism Society of Malaysia has called on the government to conduct a comprehensive mapping exercise to address regional disparities in the provision of autism care services.

Its programme head Rusmawati Abdullah said data from the Social Welfare Department could be used for the purpose, and the initiative would provide insights and prioritise areas that lack sufficient resources for the autistic community.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said as of Oct 31, there were 33 autism care centres in the country while the number of autistic individuals with learning disabilities in the same period totalled 65,191.

She said the government could target regions in need of support and ensure a more equitable distribution of care and services for autistic individuals across the country, especially in underserved areas.

"The mapping effort could serve as a foundation for future policy decisions and resource allocation, improving the quality of care and services for individuals with autism."

She said while the services are more accessible in the Klang Valley area, there is a need for centres in northern and southern Peninsular Malaysia, Sabah and Sarawak.

"The shortage stems from the increasing prevalence of autism, limited facilities, lack of trained professionals and financial constraints faced by families. While we have made strides in addressing autism care, the infrastructure is inadequate to meet the demand."

She said limited private sector involvement, underfunded NGOs filling service gaps, low public awareness on autism care's financial needs, geographical inequalities in rural and semi-urban areas, and high initial infrastructure costs hinder the expansion of autism care services.

Johor Disabled Children Charitable and Cares Organisation founder and president Dr Yahya Haidrus said the gap between service demand and availability is substantial, with many existing centres being overcrowded, resulting in long waiting lists and limited one-on-one support.

He said there is limited availability of specialised training programmes in Malaysia, which affects the quality of care being provided.

"Many caregivers and therapists lack the skills to handle complex autism cases while the shortage of certified professionals has resulted in unequal access to therapy. This highlights the need for service expansion."

Hua Ming Autism Society members echoed the concerns and said the shortage of autism care services has placed significant strain on families through stress and financial burden as they are left to manage without adequate support.

"While help exists through various agencies, it is insufficient. Collaboration between government bodies, NGOs and private companies needs improvement and faster implementation," it said in a statement to *theSun*.

UiTM Faculty of Communication and Media Studies senior lecturer Dr Mohd Yusof Zulkefli, who is also an expert in autism and communication, said the gap between available care centres and the number of autistic individuals in the country underscores a systemic inadequacy in service provision.

"This disparity often leaves families with limited access to essential support, resulting in delayed intervention, unequal opportunities for skills development and heightened financial stress. The lack of sufficient facilities also places pressure on existing centres, potentially compromising the quality of care."

He said insufficient care centres delay access to critical therapies that improve communication, social interaction and cognitive skills, especially when early intervention is pivotal for shaping the developmental trajectory of children with autism.

"A comprehensive national policy focused exclusively on autism care that includes early diagnosis and intervention programmes in all primary healthcare facilities is crucial as developmental milestone tracking for children starts from infancy."

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## Perkukuh Keselamatan Digital, Hukuman Lebih Berat Tangani Isu Kanak-Kanak Hilang, Penderaan Seksual

KUALA LUMPUR, 27 Dis (Bernama) -- Perikatan Komuniti Selamat mencadangkan pengukuhan keselamatan digital serta mengenakan hukuman lebih berat antara langkah utama untuk membendung peningkatan kes kanak-kanak hilang dan penderaan seksual.

Pengerusinya Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye berkata isu ini memerlukan tindakan segera memandangkan statistik mendedahkan ramai kanak-kanak hilang berisiko menjadi mangsa eksploitasi termasuk pemerdagangan orang dan penderaan seksual.

"Trend membimbangkan ini mencetuskan ancaman serius kepada keselamatan dan kesejahteraan kanak-kanak kita - golongan paling rentan dalam masyarakat. Setiap kanak-kanak berhak hidup dalam suasana yang bebas ketakutan, bahaya dan eksploitasi.

"Kehilangan setiap kanak-kanak ialah satu tragedi menyedihkan buat keluarga mereka dan membimbangkan masyarakat. Penderaan seksual kanak-kanak, sama ada dilakukan oleh individu tidak dikenali atau dikenali adalah jenayah keji yang meninggalkan kesan jangka panjang dari segi psikologi dan fizikal," katanya dalam satu kenyataan hari ini.

Lee berkata adalah penting memperkukuh langkah keselamatan siber bagi mengesan dan memberantas aktiviti haram, memandangkan ramai pemangsa beroperasi dalam talian.

Selain itu, ibu bapa juga perlu diberikan pendedahan mengenai cara yang lebih berkesan untuk memantau aktiviti dalam talian anak-anak mereka.

Beliau juga menyeru pelaksanaan pendidikan seks yang komprehensif dengan sekolah melaksanakan program yang sesuai dengan peringkat umur bagi mendidik kanak-kanak mengenai kepentingan sempadan peribadi, mengenal pasti tingkah laku yang tidak sesuai, dan melaporkan penderaan tanpa rasa bimbang.

Semua institusi termasuk sekolah, organisasi keagamaan, dan pusat rekreasi perlu mengamalkan protokol laporan mandatori untuk kes yang disyaki penderaan kanak-kanak.

Talian bantuan dan platform digital untuk laporan tanpa nama perlu dipromosikan secara meluas manakala undang-undang melindungi kanak-kanak mesti diperketat dan dikuat kuasa dengan lebih tegas.

"Mengenakan hukuman lebih berat terhadap pelaku penderaan seksual kanak-kanak dan pemerdagangan orang.

"Selain itu, agensi penguatkuasaan undang-undang perlu dilengkapi dengan alat dan latihan yang lebih baik bagi memastikan kanak-kanak yang hilang dapat dijumpai dengan cepat, dan lebih peka ketika mengendalikan kes penderaan," katanya.

Lee berkata kesedaran masyarakat terhadap isu-isu ini perlu dipertingkatkan, mendidik ibu bapa, penjaga, dan pengasuh mengenai risiko dihadapi oleh kanak-kanak serta dilatih untuk mengenal pasti tanda-tanda pengantunan atau penderaan.

Penyertaan masyarakat di semua peringkat seperti program rondaan kejiranan dan komuniti serta inisiatif sukarela perlu digalakkan kerana boleh menjadi barisan pertama dalam melindungi kanak-kanak.

Lee turut menyentuh mengenai keperluan pembiayaan mencukupi untuk rumah perlindungan, perkhidmatan kaunseling, dan program pemulihan.

"Kami menggesa semua pihak berkepentingan - ibu bapa, pendidik, pembuat dasar, penguat kuasa undang-undang dan masyarakat - bersama-sama mewujudkan persekitaran lebih selamat untuk kanak-kanak. Kita tidak boleh berputus asa dalam usaha melindungi maruah kanak-kanak dengan itu kita juga melindungi masa depan negara," katanya.

**Kuala Lumpur:** Seorang bekas pembantu sebuah pusat asuhan mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini semalam, atas pertuduhan menganiaya seorang kanak-kanak lelaki sehingga menyebabkannya mengalami kecederaan fizikal, lima bulan lalu.

Nur Iffatinnadwah Mat Lias, 22, didakwa melakukan kesalahan itu terhadap mangsa yang berusia tiga tahun dua bulan di sebuah pusat asuhan di Plaza Damas di sini, antara jam 5.15 petang hingga 6.15 petang, 9 Julai.

Pertuduhan dibuat mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-kanak 2001 yang boleh dihukum mengikut seksyen sama, yang memperuntuk hukuman denda

maksimum RM50,000 atau penjara tidak lebih 20 tahun atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Pada prosiding itu, tertuduh yang tidak diwakili peguam merayu jaminan RM20,000 ditawarkan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nadia Eleena Jamaludin Akbal, dikurangkan atas alasan dirinya anak yatim dan menyara hidup dengan berniaga.

Hakim Egusra Ali membenarkan jaminan RM10,000 dengan seorang penjamin serta syarat tambahan tertuduh menyerahkan pasport kepada mahkamah sehingga kes selesai, selain menetapkan 7 Februari depan sebagai sebutan semula kes. **BERNAMA**

## Woman claims trial to abusing boy

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A former childcare assistant pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court here to charges of abusing a three-year-old boy, resulting in injuries.

Nur Iffatinnadwah Mat Lias, 22, was charged with committing the offence at a daycare in Plaza Damas between 5.15pm and 6.15pm on July 9.

The charge, under Section 31(1) (a) of the Child Act 2001, carries a fine of up to RM50,000, 20 years in prison or both, upon conviction, Bernama reported.

During the hearing yesterday, the accused, who was unrepresented, appealed for a reduction in the RM20,000 bail proposed by deputy public prosecutor Nadia Eleena Jamaludin Akbal.

Nur Iffatinnadwah added that she is an orphan and supports herself through business.

Judge Egusra Ali granted bail at RM10,000 in one surety and additional conditions, including the surrender of her passport until the case is completed.

The court set Feb 7 for next mention of the case.

## Jurutera didenda RM6,000 miliki video porno kanak-kanak

**Balik Pulau:** Seorang jurutera didenda RM6,000 oleh Mahkamah Majistret, di sini, semalam selepas mengaku bersalah atas dua pertuduhan memiliki video pornografi kanak-kanak selepas ditahan pihak berkuasa, Isnin lalu.

Majistret Chia Huey Ting turut memerintahkan Koay Lian San, 45, menjalani hukuman penjara enam bulan jika gagal membayar denda bagi kedua-dua pertuduhan itu.

"Selepas mengambil kira pengakuan bersalah dan fakta kes, mahkamah menjatuhkan denda RM4,000 atau penjara enam bulan jika gagal membayar denda bagi kesalahan pertama dan

denda RM2,000 atau penjara tiga bulan jika gagal membayar denda kesalahan kedua.

"Semua barangan yang dirampas dalam kes ini akan dilupuskan selepas proses rayuan selesai," katanya pada prosiding.

Berdasarkan pertuduhan pertama, lelaki itu didapati memiliki video pornografi kanak-kanak di rumahnya di Taman Sungai Ara, Bayan Lepas, jam 9.20 malam, 23 Disember lalu.

Dia didakwa melakukan kesalahan di bawah Seksyen 10 Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 (Akta 792) yang boleh dihukum di bawah Seksyen sama.

Ia memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum lima tahun atau denda sehingga RM10,000 atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Bagi pertuduhan kedua, tertuduh didapati memiliki video lucah yang disimpan dalam komputer miliknya pada waktu dan di lokasi sama.

Bagi kesalahan itu, tertuduh didakwa mengikut Seksyen 292 (a) Kanun Keseksuan yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga tiga tahun atau denda atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Pendakwa dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya R Lushani manakala

tertuduh diwakili peguam dari Yayasan Bantuan Guaman Kebangsaan (YBGK).

Media pada Selasa lalu melaporkan, seorang jurutera ditahan dalam serbuan 'Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC' di kediaman tiga tingkat di kawasan kejiranan mewah di Bayan Lepas.

Serbuan diketuai Bahagian Siasatan Seksual, Wanita dan Kanak-Kanak (D11) Bukit Aman dengan kerjasama Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC).

Ia bagi menahan individu disyaki memiliki dan mengedar bahan penderaan seksual kanak-kanak (CSAM).

## Fined for having child porn

### Father of two admits to possession of X-rated videos

**BALIK PULAU:** A father of two has been fined RM6,000 by a Magistrate's Court here for possessing child sexual abuse materials (CSAM) and pornographic videos on his computer.

Koay Lian San, a 45-year-old engineer, pleaded guilty to two charges before magistrate Chia Huey Ting yesterday.

For the first charge, he is accused of possessing CSAM at his residence in Bayan Lepas at 9.20pm on Monday.

He was charged under Section 10 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017, which carries a maximum jail sentence of five years, a fine of up to RM10,000 or both, upon conviction.

For the second charge, he is accused of possessing pornographic videos at the same location and time.

He was charged under Section 292 (a) of the Penal Code, which provides for a jail sentence of up to three years, a fine or both upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor R. Lushani urged the court to impose an appropriate sentence as a lesson to the accused.

Koay's lawyer from the National Legal Aid Foundation requested that his client be fined only as he has to support his wife, children and mother.

"The accused has apologised, repented and promised not to

repeat this offence," he said.

Chia then imposed a RM4,000 fine for the first charge and RM2,000 for the second.

It was reported earlier this week that the police and Malaysian Communications and

Multimedia Commission, working together under Ops Pedo Bersepadu, had arrested several individuals from different socio-economic backgrounds for possession and distribution of CSAM.

The operation, spearheaded by Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Children Investigation Division, involved a series of coordinated raids in Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang and Perak.

## ENGINEER PLEADS GUILTY TO CHILD PORN POSSESSION

He is fined RM6,000 after also admitting to having obscene videos

**A**N engineer, who was arrested under Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC, has become the first to be sentenced following the joint crackdown.

Koay Lian San, 45, was fined RM6,000 by the magistrate's court here yesterday after pleading guilty to possession of child pornography and possession of obscene videos.

Koay, one of 13 people arrested in a series of raids in Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang and Perak, had been remanded for four days following his arrest on Dec 23 for possessing child sexual abuse material (CSAM).

Police found a hoard of pornographic material, some suspected to be CASM, during a raid on his home in an affluent Bayan Lepas neighbourhood.

The raid was part of an operation spearheaded by federal police's Sexual, Women and Child Investigations Division (D11), supported by intelligence provided by the Malaysian Com-

munications and Multimedia Commission, to nab those suspected of possessing and distributing CSAM.

Magistrate Chia Huey Ting fined Koay RM4,000 in default six months' jail for the possession of child pornography, and RM2,000 in default three months' jail for the possession of obscene videos in his computer.

"All seized items in the case will be disposed of after the appeal process," Chia said.

Koay admitted to committing the offences at his home in Taman Sungai Ara at 9.20pm on Dec 23.

The first offence was framed under Section 10 of the Sexual

Offences Against Children Act, which carries a maximum penalty of five-year imprisonment and RM10,000 fine, upon conviction.

The second offence was under Section 292 (a) of the Penal Code, which carries a maximum jail term of three years, a fine, or both, upon conviction.

Earlier in mitigation, a lawyer from the National Legal Aid Foundation representing Koay told the court that he works as an engineer earning RM4,500 monthly.

"He has a wife and two children, apart from his mother, to care for.

"His guilty plea has saved the

court's time. He apologises for his mistakes and asks the court to impose a minimal fine," the lawyer said.

Deputy public prosecutor R. Lushani urged the court to impose an appropriate punishment to serve as a deterrent.

Last week, the *New Straits Times* ran a series of reports on the rampant sale of Malaysian-made explicit content, including CSAM, on social media and messaging platforms.

The NST's investigation also showed how CSAM content was being sold for as cheap as RM1 per video, raising concern among parents about the safety of their children.

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## **Egyptian man pleads not guilty to abusing his children**

KUALA LUMPUR: An Egyptian man pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court, on Friday (Dec 27), to charges of wrapping a telephone cable around his son's neck and throwing his daughter onto a bed, last week.

The 37-year-old man is accused of abusing his children, a four-year-and-two-month-old son and a one-year-and-six-month-old daughter, resulting in injuries to both victims.

The incident allegedly occurred at 8.30am on Dec 17, in a rented room on Jalan Maarof, Bangsar, Brickfields, here.

The charge is framed under Section 31(1)(a) of the Child Act 2001, which carries a penalty of up to RM50,000 in fines or a maximum prison sentence of 20 years, or both, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Joshua Tee Yee Khuan did not offer bail on the grounds that the offence was non-bailable and the accused was unrepresented.

Judge Siti Aminah Ghazali set Jan 20 for mention of the case, to allow for the submission of documents and the appointment of a lawyer. - Bernama

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## Pernah dicekik, dipukul ketika hamil, wanita di Johor Bahru dedah kisah jadi mangsa keganasan rumah tangga

**SEORANG** wanita di Johor Bahru, Johor tampil berkongsi kisahnya yang pernah menjadi mangsa keganasan rumah tangga sebagai satu kesedaran buat masyarakat.

Wanita yang hanya dikenali sebagai Teo, 33, mendedahkan bahawa suaminya mula bertindak agresif dengan memukulnya kira-kira dua tahun lalu ketika sedang hamil anak pertama mereka.

Menurut Teo, mereka sering bertengkar kerana suaminya kerap mengunjungi pusat hiburan pada waktu malam.

Katanya, beberapa bulan sebelum Teo melahirkan anak, satu pergaduhan besar berlaku dan ia merupakan detik pertama suaminya memukulnya.

Teo juga mendakwa suami memukulnya beberapa kali selama bertahun-tahun, malah pernah cuba mencekiknya ketika dia sedang hamil.

Tambahnya, perbalahan mereka juga berpunca daripada tabiat suaminya yang gemar bermain judi.

"Saya fikir dengan cara tinggal berasingan sejak September lalu dapat mengubah dirinya.

"Jadi, saya bersetuju untuk membenarkan dia melawat dua anak kami untuk meraikan Festival Solstis Musim Sejuk bersama-sama pada Ahad lepas.

"Bagaimanapun, dia tetap mengungkit masa lalu termasuk perselisihan faham antara ibu kami dan keadaan menjadi tegang kembali.

"Keadaan tidak terkawal. Dia menampar saya beberapa kali dan menolak saya ke dinding sehingga menyebabkan lebam di lengan dan belakang badan," katanya.

Tidak dapat menanggung kesakitan itu lagi, Teo mengambil keputusan untuk membuat laporan polis selepas kejadian itu.

Jelasnya lagi, pihak berkuasa dan undang-undang mesti melindungi mangsa keganasan rumah tangga supaya mereka berani bersuara tentang penderitaan mereka.

"Sebagai ibu, kami juga bimbang tentang kebajikan anak-anak apabila kami dipanggil ke balai polis untuk membantu siasatan.

"Siapa yang akan membantu kami menjaga mereka?" katanya.

Sementara itu, Ketua Polis Daerah Johor Baru Selatan Asisten Komisioner, Raub Selamat mengesahkan bahawa laporan polis sudah diterima dan siasatan sedang dijalankan. — *The Star/YEE XIANG YUN*
