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639 newborns rescued in 16 years through OrphanCare's baby hatch initiative

KUALA LUMPUR: The OrphanCare Foundation (OrphanCare) has saved 639 newborns over its 16 years since its establishment in 2008.

This year marked the highest number of cases handled by OrphanCare, with 81 babies saved through the Baby Hatch initiative as of November, Sinar Harian reported.

OrphanCare Foundation Advocacy and Communications Manager Riza Alwi told the Malay daily that the number of babies saved this year had significantly increased compared to last year, when 55 cases were recorded.

"This year, the months of March, April, May, and July each recorded the highest number of babies saved, with 10 babies per month.

"This was followed by February with nine babies and August with seven," she said.

Riza said the 51 babies had been placed with suitable adoptive families.

"2024 has also seen a significant milestone, with no cases referred to the Social Welfare Department and no reported fatalities," she said.

She said the numbers indicate growing public awareness of the Baby Hatch's purpose, with more people inclined to save babies rather than abandon them.

The Baby Hatch is a specially designed space where mothers can leave their babies anonymously and safely.

It is equipped with sensors that alert staff when a baby is placed inside.

Rescued babies are then enrolled in either an adoption programme or a suitable care institution.

To date, more than 400 of the 639 babies have been adopted by families through legal processes, while 224 babies are being cared for by their biological mothers or families.

For the Baby Hatch initiative, 128 babies were left anonymously, with no information about their biological parents' identities, Riza said.

In March, Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri revealed that a total of 509 cases of baby dumping were reported between 2018 and February this year.

DECEMBER 29 — As of January 2023, Malaysia had 637,537 registered persons with disabilities (PWDs) under the Department of Social Welfare (JKM).

Of this number, nearly 40 per cent (235,731) fall into the category of PWDs with learning disabilities.

In other words, four out of every 10 PWD children in Malaysia are classified as having learning disabilities.

However, not all disabilities are visible or readily noticeable. Learning disabilities are often associated with “invisible disabilities”, which significantly affect the educational outcomes and quality of life for children with special needs.

Hence, children with special needs often require tailored education to address their unique requirements.

This may involve enrolling in special education programmes, hiring private tutors or therapists, or considering private schooling options that better meet their needs.

To ensure these children can eventually lead independent lives, parents face considerable financial challenges, leaving them vulnerable to financial insecurity.

The issue is rather simple to understand but challenging to address — when services become scarcer, prices inevitably rise.

In essence, as supply decreases and demand increases, costs surge, in line with the economic principle of supply and demand.

Specialised educational services often come at a higher cost than mainstream education.

This does not even include the medical expenses associated with frequent doctor visits, medications, surgeries, and assistive devices.

Many children with special needs require assistive devices and technologies to help them navigate daily life and enhance their mobility.

These include wheelchairs, hearing aids, communication devices, sensory equipment, and specialised software.

It is widely acknowledged that the costs of acquiring and maintaining such devices are prohibitive.

These expenses often escalate over time, especially if the child has complex or chronic medical conditions.

Children with comorbidities — two or more concurrent health conditions — also face additional medical expenditures.

Moreover, health insurance or takaful coverage may not fully encompass the treatments required, leaving parents to shoulder a heavy financial burden.

For instance, autistic children often need regular sessions of occupational therapy, speech therapy, and behavioral interventions, which can be very costly.

These costs can accumulate rapidly, straining family finances, particularly if insurance or government assistance programs fall short.

Caring for children with special needs demands significant time and attention, making it challenging for parents to maintain full-time employment or advance in their careers.

Parents may need to reduce their working hours, take unpaid leave, or, in the worst cases, leave their jobs altogether to provide intensive care and support.

This can lead to a decline in household income and financial instability.

In addition, some employers may not accommodate flexible schedules, or the time off required by parents of children with special needs, further limiting their employment options.

For example, parents of children with severe physical disabilities may need to be on constant standby to assist with personal care, mobility, and medical needs.

These caregiving responsibilities often make it difficult to sustain traditional employment.

Many developed countries have support systems to assist families with children who have special needs, including disability benefits, tax credits, and educational support.

However, these programs often fall short in covering the wide range of expenses involved in raising a child with special needs.

This is due to stringent eligibility criteria, complex application processes, bureaucratic red tape, and long waiting lists for services.

Consequently, parents struggle to access the financial resources they need to adequately support their children.

While various incentives are announced annually during budget presentations to target specific groups, what about parents of children with special needs?

In the short and medium term, similar financial incentives could be extended to parents of children with special needs registered with JKJ.

Such assistance could be modelled after the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program in the United States, which provides direct cash transfers to low-income parents with children with special needs.

For the long term, the government should establish a trust fund for children with special needs in Malaysia, drawing inspiration from Singapore's Special Needs Trust Company (SNTC).

For instance, the SNTC runs a Special Needs Savings Scheme that allows families to allocate funds in trust for the long-term care of children with special needs.

Through this scheme, parents can open a trust account in their child's name with regular or lump-sum contributions.

These funds are professionally managed to ensure financial growth and stability and can only be used for the child's needs, such as care, education, or medical expenses.

This ensures that individuals with special needs have access to dedicated savings to meet their requirements throughout their lives, including after their parents or guardians die.

By establishing such a trust fund, families can safeguard the financial well-being of their loved ones with special needs, ensuring continued care and support throughout their lives.

This initiative aligns with the aspirations of the Madani Economy, emphasising social justice, public welfare, and the creation of an inclusive society.

By providing financial security to families of children with special needs, the nation can strengthen its social safety net and build a more sustainable and prosperous future for all.

Female-only parking sparks **debate** on long-term impact

➤ Experts call for better enforcement, infrastructure and cultural change to enhance women's safety

PETALING JAYA: Female-only car parks are designed to enhance women's safety but their long-term effectiveness remains uncertain, according to All Women's Action Society deputy president Khairiah Abdul Malik.

She noted that while such designated spaces may provide immediate reassurance for women, they do little to address broader public safety concerns.

"The introduction of female-only car parks in Malaysia aims to address women's safety concerns in urban areas, particularly following incidents like the tragic 2003 case of Canny Ong, who was abducted from a basement car park and later found murdered."

Khairiah said female-only facilities, such as parking spaces, show mixed results in reducing crime.

She referenced a 2020 nationwide survey by Engender Consultancy, an organisation promoting women's empowerment and gender equality, which found that 58.6% of respondents had experienced sexual harassment in public spaces, with 70.4% of incidents occurring during the daytime.

"These findings demonstrate that while women-only zones offer a temporary buffer against certain crimes, they do not address the underlying systemic issues contributing to gender-based violence."

Khairiah said female-only parking spaces are often strategically located near mall entrances and should be made mandatory in all multi-storey buildings for safety.

Essential features include better lighting, surveillance cameras, panic buttons and security personnel to enhance protection.

"Female-only parking spaces promote security, empowering women to engage in public life more freely. However, misuse by men or couples undermines their purpose. This issue persists due to insufficient legal enforcement as there are no penalties for rule-breakers," she said.

Lee Ming Hui, a 24-year-old banker from Damansara, expressed frustration over the frequent misuse of female-only parking spaces by men.

"I usually shop alone and always park in the female-only section. Many times, I've seen men parking there despite clear signs indicating it's reserved for women. It's infuriating and I always confront them, but they just brush it off, claiming there's no difference in where anyone parks."

"I'm sure there are CCTV cameras or security personnel around but every time this happens it feels like nothing is being done to address it," she said.

Women's Aid Organisation acting executive director Nazreen Nizam stressed that stricter enforcement

and penalties are necessary to prevent the misuse of female-only parking spaces.

"The effectiveness of these spaces depends on rigorous enforcement and public respect. While they contribute positively to women's safety, continuous efforts are crucial to ensure their impact," she said.

Nazreen suggested penalties, such as fines or towing vehicles, to deter misuse.

Additionally, constant surveillance through CCTV, regular security patrols and clear signage would support enforcement efforts and increase the likelihood of detection and punishment.

"These measures not only reinforce the rules but also underscore the importance of these spaces in protecting women's safety in public areas," she said.

Khairiah highlighted that several factors still need to be addressed to improve the safety of female-only parking areas, including better infrastructure and, more importantly, changing societal attitudes towards

women's safety.

"Many malls in Malaysia offer good security for female-only car parks, but poor lighting, inadequate surveillance and unclear signage can undermine their effectiveness, increasing fear. Well-maintained areas with good lighting and visible security are essential for safety," she said.

While female-only car parks provide temporary relief, Khairiah stressed the need for a broader approach encompassing better urban design, stricter rules and cultural education to create inclusive and safe public spaces for everyone.

"Safety in female-only car parks is a shared responsibility among women, facility management and the public. Women should also remain vigilant and use available security systems."

"Through cooperation, awareness, and consistent use of safety resources, female-only parking spaces can achieve their intended purpose of providing a secure and accessible environment for women."

Call to amend legislation to reflect rights of **single fathers**

► While law stipulates that male parent can seek custody in court cases, process usually favours maternal care for young children, says association president

PETALING JAYA: The Father's Rights Association of Malaysia is calling for the Law Reform (Marriage and Divorce) Act 1976 to be amended to reflect present-day norms, and the evolving roles of fathers in the family unit.

Its president Malcolm Fernandez said while the law outlines the rights of single fathers in custody and child support cases, it is often seen as favouring mothers in custody decisions.

"While fathers can seek custody, the process often favours maternal care for younger children. Child support is legally required, but enforcement is difficult when former partners are uncooperative."

Fernandez added that bias extends beyond the law into societal perceptions, with single fathers facing assumptions that men are less capable caregivers.

"This stigma leads to our exclusion from parenting networks, the reluctance of school heads to engage us as primary caregivers, and even judgement from extended families."

He said such biases isolate single fathers and discourage them from seeking help or joining parenting programmes, affecting their ability to support their children emotionally.

Fernandez said up to 40% of single-parent families, including those led by fathers, face financial challenges as they often earn less than the median income.

He said single fathers also face limited childcare options and have to

deal with workplaces that lack family friendly policies.

He added that they frequently encounter difficulties in navigating educational and healthcare systems, which are often designed with mothers as the primary caregivers.

Despite challenges, single fathers like Linus Liao, 52, remain committed.

Liao, a financial consultant, focuses on his responsibilities rather than the biases or societal perceptions.

"I'm not affected by what people say. I was raised to believe a father must be involved in his children's upbringing."

"It was tough at first. After the breakup, I couldn't see my son, and everything seemed chaotic. But over time, things improved. I reconciled with my ex-wife, and now I see my son more often and without issues."

Liao, who has two sons aged 18 and seven, expressed concern about not being able to monitor his younger child's upbringing.

"My older son lives with me and my seven-year-old lives with his mother. I see him every Monday and Thursday for two hours and he stays with me every other weekend."

"When my ex-wife is at work, her

parents care for him, but they struggle with his education. That's why I spend as much time as I can to help him."

"At his age, learning is crucial, and I worry he's missing out on this important phase of his life. Fathers are meant to be there for their children. Without a father figure, children can feel lost and lack guidance."

However, for Alexander Joseph, 51, societal perceptions significantly impacted his life.

Joseph, who separated in 2020 and recently finalised his divorce, said his breakup affected his work and relationships, causing him to lose clients, respect and family support.

"The toughest part was being alienated from my child. For nearly two years, I couldn't see him or share everyday moments."

He added that despite a difficult custody battle, things are improving, and he now treasures every moment with his son.

"Balancing work and parenting is tough, but time with my child makes it all worthwhile. I've learnt to forgive and let go because anger only causes harm. Above all, I have to put my son first, even if it means making compromises."

JPS ramal bah berlaku di tiga daerah di Pahang susulan amaran hujan berterusan tahap waspada

Kuantan: Penduduk yang tinggal di kawasan rendah di daerah ini bersiap sedia menghadapi banjir kali kedua yang dijangka berlaku berikutan hujan berterusan sejak malam kelmarin.

Sekiranya hujan terus berlarutan, beberapa kampung dan taman perumahan yang terletak berhampiran dengan Sungai Belat, Sungai Seri Damai dan Sungai Jaya Gading diancam banjir.

Penduduk Kampung Sungai Belat, Jalan Kuantan-Pekan, Maznah Sulaiman, 71, seolah tidak lengkap sekiranya tidak berpeluang bertemu dengan banjir setiap tahun yang berakhir dengan episod kami sekeluarga terpaksa berpindah.

"Awal bulan ini banjir dan tidak mustahil berlaku sekali lagi selepas hujan berterusan sejak malam tadi. Paras air Sungai Belat sudah mula naik.

"Belum sempat berkemas barangan dalam rumah selepas banjir sebelum ini, banjir dijangka sekali lagi berlaku. Inilah nasib

penduduk yang tinggal di kawasan rendah dan hampir dengan Sungai Belat," katanya, di sini semalam.

Sejak lebih 50 tahun tinggal di Kampung Sungai Belat, hampir setiap tahun berhadapan bencana banjir sekali hingga dua kali, sudah menjadi lumrah rumah ditenggelami air pada akhir tahun.

Maznah berkata, disebabkan setiap tahun rumahnya ditenggelami banjir menyebabkan dia sekeluarga tidak lagi berminat menyediakan perabot dan barangan tertentu kerana pasti rosak apabila ditenggelami air.

Kelmarin, Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) meramalkan banjir akan berlaku di tiga daerah di Pahang susulan amaran hujan berterusan tahap waspada bermula semalam dan hari ini.

Pusat Ramalan dan Amaran Banjir Negara (PRABN) meramalkan banjir memabatkan Kuantan, Pekan dan Rompin.

JPS memaklumkan hujan berterusan tahap waspada dijangka memabatkan daerah Kuantan

yang mengakibatkan limpahan aliran di Lembangan Sungai Pahang, Lembangan Sungai Kuantan, Lembangan Sungai Cherating dan Lembangan Sungai Ular.

"Lembangan Sungai Pahang itu meliputi Sungai Lepar, Alur Sungai Belat, Parit Chendering, Parit Jawa, Parit Rangin, Sungai Galing, Sungai Jelai, Sungai Kenau, Sungai Lepar, Sungai Penor, Sungai Pinang, Sungai Soi dan Sungai Terus.

"Lembangan Sungai Kuantan memabatkan Sungai Lepar, Sungai Penor, Sungai Rangin, Sungai Tiram dan Sungai Kenau," katanya.

Di Kuala Lumpur, BER-NAMA melaporkan, Jabatan Pengairan dan Saliran (JPS) diramal berlaku banjir di Kelantan dan Pahang dua selama dua hari bermula semalam susulan amaran hujan berterusan.

Ramalan awal banjir di-

keluarkan pada 2 petang semalam, JPS memaklumkan 10 daripada 11 jajahan di Kelantan dijangka terlibat iaitu Tumpat, Pasir Mas, Kota Bharu, Pasir Puteh, Bachok, Tanah Merah, Machang, Kuala Krai, Jeli dan Gua Musang.

Pemantauan berterusan

Banjir juga diramal melanda Pahang memabatkan lima daerah iaitu Kuantan, Pekan, Rompin, Jerantut dan Maran.

"JPS akan membuat pemantauan berterusan dan mengemas kini bebahan amaran banjir sekiranya hujan yang signifikan terus berlaku di lembangan sungai itu.

"Banjir diramalkan berlaku lebih awal atau lewat daripada tarikh yang dijangkakan," kata kenyataan itu.

Di Kuala Krai, hujan lebat sejak pagi semalam menyebabkan runtuhnya tanah di lereng bukit yang menghempak bahagian hadapan sebuah rumah di Kampung Nanga, di sini, tengah hari semalam.

Bantuan kecemasan itu memabatkan 260 bungkusan makanan sedia dimakan, satu set peralatan dapur seperti periuk nasi, dapur gas dan cerek air dan 50 set survival kit.

A NEW wave of floods has hit 14 villages in low-lying areas of two districts in the state yesterday.

The water level rose to between 0.5m and 1m in 14 villages following continuous rain the previous night.

State Civil Defence Force director Colonel Mohd Adzhar Mujaib said the two affected districts were Tanah Merah and Kuala Krai, with 11 of the villages in Tanah Merah and the remaining three in Kuala Krai.

The villages were Kampung Bendang Nyiur, Kampung Klewek, Kampung Batu Gajah, Kampung Manal, Kampung Batu 8, Kampung Baroh Pial and Kampung Gual Ipoh.

The others were Kampung Batu

5, Felda Kemahang, Kampung Jedok Tua, Kampung Batang Merbau, Kampung Lubuk Simpul, Kampung Bukit Sireh and Kampung Pasir gajah Keroh.

"So far, the situation is still under control and we will be monitoring the situation," he added.

Checks at Sultan's Pier here showed that Sungai Kelantan level had yet to exceed its maximum level.

The Malaysian Meteorological Department (MetMalaysia) yesterday said it expected heavy rain to persist across the state, as well as in Terengganu and Pahang until today.

In an alert issued at 12.30pm yesterday, MetMalaysia said wet weather was expected in Kuantan, Pahang, as well as in Jeli, Tanah Merah, Machang, Pasir Puteh and Kuala Krai in Kelantan.

An "alert level" continuous rain advisory was also issued for parts of Kelantan, including Tumpat, Pasir Mas, Kota Baru, Bachok and Gua Musang until today.

Other areas covered by the MetMalaysia advisory were Jerantut, Maran, Pekan and Rompin in Pahang, as well as Mersing in Johor.

Operation against porn, paedophiles to continue nationwide, says deputy IGP

IPOH

THE police will be intensifying operations to capture those who possess, store and distribute child sexual abuse material (CSAM) under Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC.

Deputy Inspector-General of Police Datuk Seri Ayob Khan Mydin Pitchay said the operation, involving Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Child Investigation Division (D11) and the Malaysia Communication and Multimedia Commission (MCMC), would continue until the offenders are nabbed.

He said police were in the midst of identifying even more suspects.

"We will continue our efforts to identify and track down those involved, including those who possess or promote pornographic content.

"The operation, conducted jointly with MCMC, will be intensified to track down even more people suspected of being linked to CSAM," he said after officiating at the closing ceremony of the Criminal Investigation Department's Future Leaders Programme 2024 at Empangan Sultan Azlan Shah here.

On Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-

MCMC, he said the majority of those detained said they didn't know that possessing, storing and distributing obscene material and CSAM was an offence.

He dismissed the excuse as "illogical", as the authorities had on numerous occasions issued statements that it was a criminal act.

"We are not dismissing the possibility that these heinous acts are limited only in the six states of the operation," he said.

On Dec 23, police and MCMC mounted a massive joint operation across Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang and Perak to detain those suspected of pos-

sessing and distributing CSAM.

The raids, which saw the authorities descending on 18 homes in affluent neighbourhoods, as well as middle and low-cost areas, led to the arrest of 13 suspects.

The ages of those arrested ranged between 20 and 74.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain said the raids resulted in the seizure of 40,000 CSAM and pornographic content from computers, cell phones and external hard disks.

The crackdown followed surveillance and undercover work by the police, supported by intelligence provided by MCMC.

The raiding parties also comprised personnel from Bukit Aman's Forensic Laboratory Division (D10), Technical Assistance Division (D6) and Criminal Investigation Department.

The arrests were made under Section 10 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act for accessing child pornography and Section 292 of the Penal Code for possession of obscene material.

On Friday, an engineer from Penang was the first of the 13 suspects to be charged with two counts of possession of child pornography.

The Balik Pulau magistrate's court fined him RM6,000 after he pleaded guilty.

Prior to the raids, the New Straits Times ran a series of reports on the rampant sale of locally produced explicit content, including CSAM, on social media and messaging platforms.

The NST's investigation also showed how CSAM was sold for as cheap as RM1 per video, raising concerns among parents over the safety of their children.

Deputy IGP: Most child porn suspects claimed ignorance

IPOH: Most suspects arrested during Op Pedo on Dec 23 claimed they were unaware that possessing, keeping or distributing pornographic materials and child sexual abuse materials (CSAM) is a crime.

“Operations conducted with the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission will also be intensified to track down others involved in CSAM-related offences,” he said after the closing ceremony of the Royal Malaysia Police Criminal Investigation Department (CID) 2024 Future Leaders Programme at the Sultan Azlan Shah Dam here yesterday.

The event, held for the first time, brought together 30 police officers and personnel from Bukit Aman’s CID, Bernama reported.

The programme ran from Dec 16 until yesterday in various locations along the Titiwangsa Range

The shocking incident came to light when the teenage girl who gave birth to the baby sought treatment at Hospital Sultan Idris Shah, Serdang, on Dec 18, after experiencing stomach pain and fever.

Police confirmed that a couple, aged 16 and 19, were involved in the incident, with the baby believed to have been born prematurely.

According to sources, the teenage girl, who was suffering from stomach pain and fever, sought treatment at the hospital before doctors realised she had given birth.

"The teenager then admitted to giving birth in the toilet of a shopping centre in Puchong before her boyfriend discarded the baby in the toilet at the toll plaza.

"Members of the public using the toilet at the toll plaza found the lifeless baby at 10pm on Dec 18 and immediately contacted the police," the source said.

Meanwhile, Subang Jaya district police chief, Assistant Commissioner Wan Azlan Wan Mamat, confirmed the incident when contacted.

He said the couple was detained last week before being released on police bail.

"Investigations found that the baby was born prematurely.

"The suspect was released on police bail pending a chemical report," he told Harian Metro tonight.

Wan Azlan said the case is being investigated under Section 318 of the Penal Code.

Terdahulu, pihak pendakwaan menawarkan ikat jamin RM25,000 serta syarat tambahan termasuk menyerahkan pasport kepada mahkamah.

Two soldiers charged with raping 10-year-old girl

KOTA BARU: Two soldiers have pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court to raping a 10-year-old girl in Bachok, Kelantan.

Mahadi Ismail, 39, and Muhammad Aizat Hakim Mohamad, 20, were accused of raping the child at a house in Taman CT Jaya, Kampung Surau Bator, Jelawat, Bachok, in April 2023.

They were charged under Section 376 (2)(e) of the Penal Code, which carries a jail term of between 10 and 30 years, as well as caning upon conviction.

Both men pleaded not guilty after the charges were read before Judge Ahmad Bazli Bahrudin

yesterday, Bernama reported.

Deputy public prosecutor Kamarul Hasyime Rosli appeared for the prosecution while the accused were represented by lawyers Majidah Muhamad and Mohd Firdaus Zainal Abidin.

Kamarul Hasyime asked that bail be set at RM30,000 and RM20,000 for Mahadi Ismail and Muhammad Aizat Hakim respectively due to the seriousness of the offence.

Muhamad Firdaus appealed for a minimum sum for Mahadi, saying his client earns RM4,500 a month and is the sole breadwinner for his family with four chil-

dren aged between four and 14.

"Since the allegations, he has never attempted to flee.

"He voluntarily surrendered at the Bachok police station in October and has served as a civil servant for 20 years and six months. He is due to retire on June 17 next year," he said.

He also requested a minimum bail for Muhammad Aizat, saying his client supports two younger siblings and earns RM1,900 a month.

"The accused was arrested around May and has not attempted to interfere with the investigation or evade court proceedings.

He is a civil servant who completed training earlier this month and is due to report for duty tomorrow.

"At only 20 years old, I believe the law classifies him as a young offender, and he should be eligible for bail," Muhammad Firdaus added.

The court granted bail at RM10,000 with one surety for each accused and ordered them to report periodically to the nearest police station and not to contact the victim or prosecution witnesses.

The case is set for mention and document submission on Feb 2 next year.

Court sets bail at RM10,000 each after both plead not guilty

TWO soldiers were charged at the Sessions Court here yesterday with raping a 10-year-old girl.

The accused — Mahadi Ismail, 39, and Aizat Hakim Mohammad, 20 — pleaded not guilty after the charges were read to them before judge Ahmad Bazli Bahrudin.

The charges, read separately, stated that both were accused of raping a girl who was then 10 years and 8 months old, during

the day at a house in Taman CT Jaya, Jelawat, Bachok, in April last year.

The charges were framed under Section 376(2)(e) of the Penal Code, which carries a jail term of between 10 and 20 years, along with whipping.

Deputy public prosecutor Kamarul Hasyime Rosli led the prosecution, and the accused were represented by lawyers Majidah Muhamad and Mohd Firdaus Zainal Abidin.

Kamarul Hasyime did not offer bail, citing that the victim was a child.

In his appeal, Firdaus request-

ed bail, arguing that his clients, who are public servants, had cooperated fully with the police and voluntarily surrendered at the Bachok police station.

"One of my clients is nearing mandatory retirement next year

and has to support four school-going children. The other just completed his training and is scheduled to report for work tomorrow (today)," he said.

The court granted bail of RM10,000 for each accused, with

the condition that they report to the nearest police station every month. They are also prohibited from contacting or harassing witnesses.

The court set Feb 2 for case mention.

In the Bernama report, Razali's lawyer Mohd Shahir Mat Jusoh appealed for a lower sum as his client is unemployed.

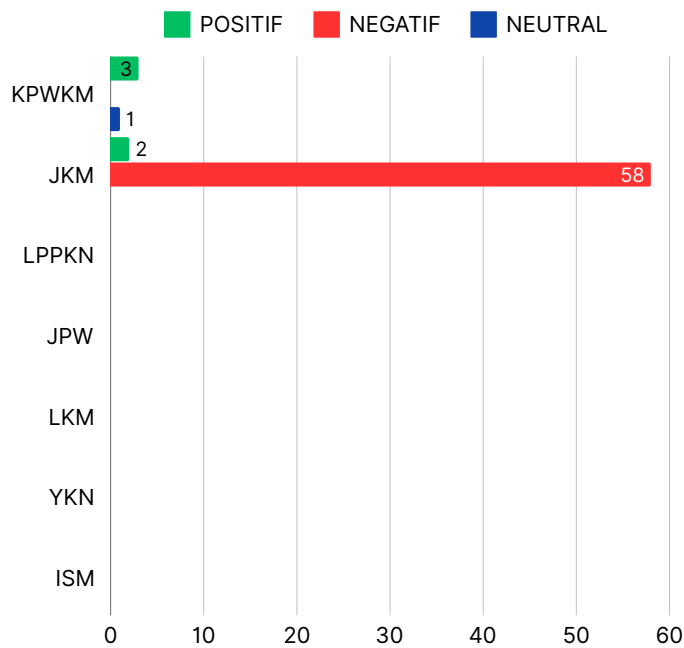

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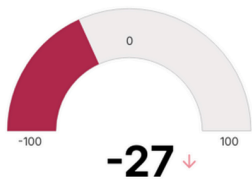

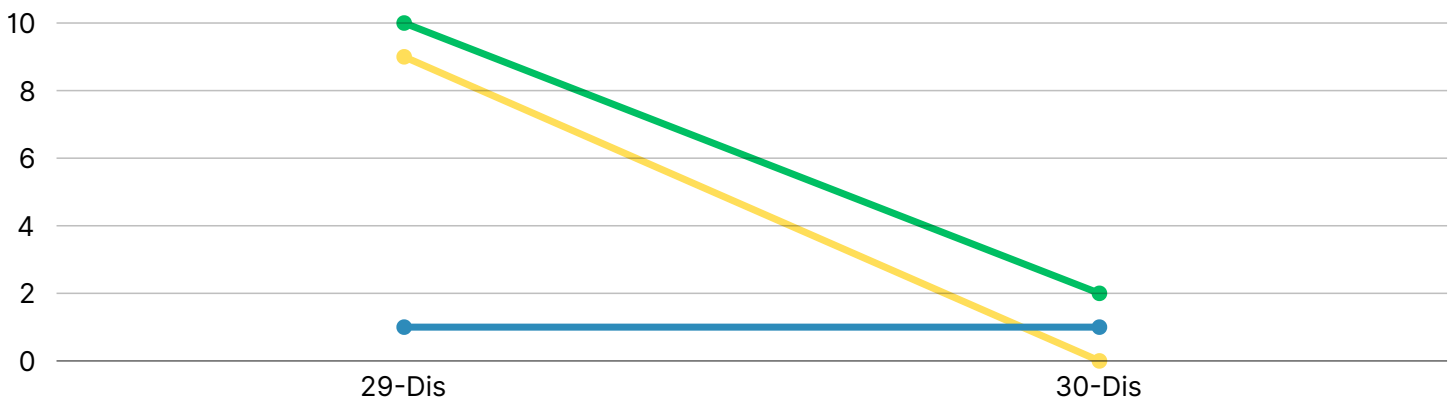
