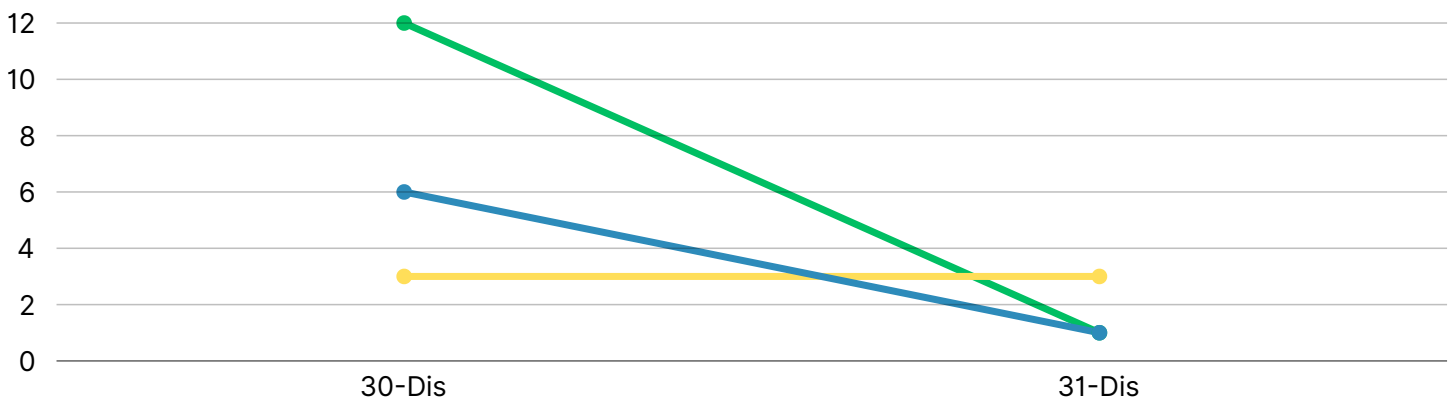

TOPIK UTAMA

MAYAT BAYI DIBUANG DI PLAZA TOL SELEPAS DILAHIRKAN DI TANDAS PUSAT BELI-BELAH LIPUTAN BERITA

- Subang Jaya: Mayat bayi yang dipercayai dilahirkan di tandas sebuah pusat beli-belah di Puchong dibuang di tandas Plaza Tol Batu 14, Lebuhraya Damansara-Puchong (LDP) di sini, minggu lalu.
- Kejadian mengejutkan itu terbongkar apabila remaja perempuan yang melahirkan bayi itu menerima rawatan di Hospital Sultan Idris Shah, Serdang, pada 18 Disember lalu, selepas mengalami sakit perut dan demam.
- Polis mengesahkan pasangan kekasih berusia 16 dan 19 tahun terbabit dalam kejadian itu, dengan bayi berkenaan dipercayai dilahirkan dalam keadaan tidak cukup bulan.
- Menurut sumber, remaja wanita itu yang sakit perut dan demam mendapatkan rawatan di hospital terbabit sebelum doktor menyedari remaja itu pernah bersalin.

SERI NEGERI 30 Disember – Bantuan berjumlah RM129.6 juta disalurkan Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Negeri Melaka kepada 31,356 penerima bagi tempoh Januari hingga November tahun ini.

Exco Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Komuniti negeri Datuk Kalsom Noordin berkata, bantuan itu disalurkan kepada penerima dalam kalangan keluarga miskin, orang kurang upaya (OKU), pesakit terlantar, warga emas dan kanak-kanak.

“Daripada keseluruhan peruntukan sejumlah RM108.9 juta adalah melalui peruntukan Kerajaan Persekutuan, manakala RM17.7 juta lagi menerusi peruntukan Kerajaan Negeri.

“Peruntukan ini diagihkan kepada penerima seluruh Negeri Melaka tanpa mengira kaum atau bangsa,” katanya ketika menjawab soalan Dr. Mohd Aleef Yusoh (PN-Sungai Udang) pada Persidangan Ketiga (Bajet) pada Penggal Ketiga Dewan Undangan Negeri Melaka Yang Kelima Belas, di sini, hari ini.

Kalsom yang juga Ahli Dewan Undangan Negeri (Adun) Pengkalan Batu-BN berkata, daripada peruntukan itu sejumlah RM2.2 juta disalurkan JKM kepada penerima di Dewan Undangan Negeri (DUN) Sungai Udang yang memberi manfaat kepada 502 orang.

“Berdasarkan pecahan penerima bantuan mengikut daerah pula, di Melaka Tengah terdapat 16,432 penerima (RM66,234, 825), Daerah Alor Gajah seramai 7,340 orang (RM29,392, 769) diikuti 7,584 penerima (RM31,016, 061) dari daerah Jasin,” katanya.

Peruntukan tambahan akan dimohon untuk keperluan penduduk terjejas banjir

Keadaan banjir di Kuala Krai

TANAH MERAH, 30 Disember- Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Kelantan akan memohon peruntukan tambahan untuk keperluan penduduk terjejas banjir bagi melicinkan pengurusan Pusat Pemindahan Sementara (PPS) seluruh negeri itu sekiranya perlu.

Bagaimanapun, Timbalan Pengarah JKM Negeri, Md Yani Mat Zin berkata, ketika peruntukan kerajaan pusat mahupun negeri yang disalurkan kepada jabatan itu mencukupi.

Operasi PPS di seluruh jajahan sejak gelombang pertama banjir lalu di Kelantan juga masih terkawal.

"Semua barang-barang sudah ada di pangkalan hadapan, jadi pengurusan akan melibatkan pegawai di PPS masing-masing, Pusat Kawalan Operasi Bencana (PKOB) jajahan pun telah meletakkan satu jawatankuasa.

"Jadi bekalan pangkalan hadapan telah ada semuanya terkawal dan tenang," katanya.

Beliau ditemui RTM selepas melawat PPS Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Batang Merbau, di sini

Dalam pada itu 160 pangkalan hadapan yang diwujudkan di seluruh jajahan juga berfungsi dengan baik seterusnya memudahkan proses agihan barangan keperluan kepada penduduk terjejas.

Sementara itu, keadaan terkini banjir melibatkan tiga jajahan di Kelantan beransur pulih berikutan cuaca baik sejak pagi.

Berdasarkan portal Info Bencana Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM), setakat pukul 4.00 petang tadi, penduduk terjejas yang ditempatkan di 13 PPS berkurang kepada 742 orang berbanding lebih 900 orang tengah hari tadi.

Lebih ramai penduduk terjejas turut dijangkakan pulang ke rumah masing-masing menjelang malam nanti.

Perkasa undang-undang pedofilia demi keselamatan kanak-kanak



Kerajaan perlu meminda rang undang-undang baharu berkaitan pedofilia bagi menyesuaikan dengan keadaan semasa.

PETALING JAYA: Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 wajar dikaji semula bagi memastikan ia relevan dengan cabaran semasa serta mampu mengekang jenayah pedofilia yang kian meningkat.

Bekas Peguam Negara, Tan Sri Abu Talib Othman berkata, undang-undang sedia ada tidak boleh bersifat statik dan perlu dirombak mengikut perkembangan teknologi serta modus operandi penjenayah yang semakin kompleks.

"Dulu kita tidak menghadapi cabaran seperti video lucah kanak-kanak atau eksploitasi digital. Kini, dengan perubahan cara hidup dan teknologi, kelemahan undang-undang sedia ada menjadi lebih ketara.

"Maka, rombakan menyeluruh perlu dilakukan demi memastikan keselamatan kanak-kanak terjamin," katanya ketika dihubungi Utusan Malaysia.

Semalam, akhbar ini melaporkan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) giat menyiasat kemungkinan 40,000 video dan gambar pornografi kanak-kanak serta dewasa yang ditemukan pada komputer milik 13 suspek yang ditahan, untuk dijual dalam media sosial atau sesawang gelap.

Dalam operasi bersepadu PDRM dan Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia (MCMC) itu, seramai 13 individu berusia 20 hingga 74 tahun ditahan menerusi serbuan terhadap 18 premis di Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Pulau Pinang, Perak, Johor dan Terengganu.

Mengulas statistik terkini Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) yang menunjukkan peningkatan kes pedofilia, Abu Talib berkata, penguatkuasaan undang-undang harus disertai dengan mekanisme pencegahan yang lebih komprehensif, termasuk pendidikan kepada masyarakat.

"Kerajaan mesti menyediakan peruntukan yang memastikan undang-undang ini tidak hanya adil kepada mangsa, tetapi juga memberi ruang pembelaan kepada tertuduh mengikut lunas perlembagaan.

"Dalam masa yang sama, tindakan tegas perlu diambil terhadap mana-mana pihak yang melanggar peraturan ini," tegasnya.

Beliau turut menyarankan agar kerjasama erat antara agensi penguat kuasa seperti PDRM dan MCMC dipertingkatkan, khususnya dalam menangani jenayah pedofilia yang melibatkan platform dalam talian.

"Kita perlu memastikan bahawa undang-undang ini bukan sahaja relevan, tetapi cukup berkesan untuk mengekang aktiviti jenayah yang bertentangan dengan keselamatan dan kesejahteraan kanak-kanak," tambahnya.

Abu Talib turut mengingatkan rombakan undang-undang ini mestilah dilakukan demi kepentingan rakyat dan bukan mana-mana pihak tertentu.

"Keselamatan kanak-kanak adalah tanggungjawab bersama. Jika undang-undang tidak lagi efektif, ia mesti dipinda untuk memastikan perlindungan yang menyeluruh kepada generasi muda negara ini," katanya. – UTUSAN

DG: RM40 million to repair Kemas kindergartens, childcare centres

GOPENG: The Rural and Regional Development Ministry has allocated RM40 million to the Community Development Department (Kemas) to carry out upgrades and repairs on 'tabika' (kindergartens) and 'taska' (childcare centres) nationwide.

Kemas director-general Datuk Mohd Hanafiah Man said approximately 60 per cent of the 10,600 kindergartens and childcare centres would be prioritised for immediate maintenance, addressing the dilapidated and damaged conditions of many premises.

"Priority will be given to older buildings to ensure the safety and well-being of the children attending these kindergartens.

"We want to ensure that the facilities are safe, enabling children to pursue their studies without concern," he said at a press conference after a meeting with Kemas Perak staff at the Kemas Community Activity Centre here yesterday.

According to Hanafiah, all states are currently finalising data on Kemas kindergartens in need of upgrades and renovations.

"Insyaa-Allah (God-willing), we anticipate starting the quotation and tender processes for the work by early February," he added.

He also announced that 17 new kindergartens, including two in Kampar and Tambun, would be constructed in the coming year to meet the growing demand.

"The interest from parents in enrolling their children continues to rise. Currently, over 20,000 children are on the waiting list to attend Kemas kindergartens," he said. — Bernama

SKSSR: 512,518 housewives registered this year with total contribution of RM61.5 mln

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 512,518 housewives have registered as contributors to the Housewives' Social Security Scheme (SKSSR) this year, with a total contribution of RM61.5 million.

Kasthuri Patto, the chairman of the Social Security Committee for Housewives at the Social Security Organisation (Socso), says this achievement marks the fulfilment of the target set by Socso and the Ministry of Human Resources for the year.

"As of November, Socso has approved 2,019 claim cases, disbursing benefits worth RM3.9 million to the housewives.

This highlights the effectiveness of the scheme in safeguarding the welfare of housewives, thereby enhancing their social well-being," she said in a press conference on SKSSR's achievements this year.

She added that among the claims approved were those related to domestic accidents, including incidents while managing household duties and caring for family members, as well

as disability and death claims.

According to Kasthuri, Selangor recorded the highest number of voluntary registrations for the SKSSR, with 13,546 contributors.

Sabah, meanwhile, led in

registrations through state government initiatives, with 88,034 contributors.

"Despite over half a million housewives registering for the SKSSR, this still represents only 16.5 per cent of the total, leaving more than 2.6 million housewives unregistered for this protection," she said.

Kasthuri emphasised that the government remained committed to safeguarding women in the 'care economy' sector, offering flexible contribution payment options.

These include payments by husbands, the housewives themselves, family members, or third parties.

Additionally, a wife voucher card or 'scratch card' worth RM120 has been introduced, allowing it to be gifted to housewives or given as a wedding gift.

Kasthuri also highlighted that

10 companies had sponsored SKSSR contributions totalling RM558,360 to assist women in the B40 (low-income) group who are unable to afford the contribution.

This initiative stems from a memorandum of understanding between Socso and the National Welfare Foundation.

This year, the Madani government has introduced tax exemptions under Section 44(6) of the Income Tax Act 1967 for companies contributing RM120 for female workers from the B40 group, whether directly or through a husband or family member.

"Therefore, private companies nationwide are encouraged to leverage this tax exemption as part of their corporate social responsibility, and estate managers are urged to contribute for their B40 female workers as well," she added. — Bernama

Kuala Lumpur: Seramai 512,518 wanita dilindungi di bawah Skim Keselamatan Sosial Suri Rumah (SKSSR) setakat 15 Disember lalu membabitkan jumlah caruman RM61.5 juta.

Ia sekali gus mencapai 100 peratus sasaran Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (Perkeso) pendaftaran 500,000 suri rumah sebagai pencarum tahun ini.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Keselamatan Sosial Suri Rumah Perkeso, Kasthuri Patto berkata, daripada jumlah itu, pencarum tertinggi dicatatkan di Sabah iaitu 88,034 orang, diikuti Sarawak (87,775) dan Kelantan (67,755) ditanggung kerajaan negeri menerusi bantuan e-Kasih manakala Selangor mencatatkan ju-

mlah tertinggi pencarum sukarela iaitu 13,546.

"Skim ini mempunyai banyak kelebihan bagi melindungi golongan wanita terutamanya bagi kemalangan di rumah, tempat kerja, penyakit, kemasukan ke wad dan mendapatkan rawatan.

"Dengan hanya bayaran RM120 setahun, wanita di bawah umur 55 tahun boleh mencarum skim ini dengan faedah diperoleh jika berlaku kemalangan atau penyakit ke atas mereka.

"Tanpa mengira latar belakang pekerjaan sama ada sektor kerajaan, swasta, kerja sendiri, bujang atau berkahwin, ada anak atau belum, kaum wanita ini boleh mencarum dan dapatkan perlindungan asalkan mereka mela-

kukan kerja suri rumah," katanya di Wisma Perkeso semalam.

Kasthuri berkata, daripada jumlah suri rumah mendaftar sebagai pencarum SKSSR sehingga November lalu, Perkeso meluluskan 2,019 kes tuntutan dengan faedah bernilai RM3.9 juta terdiri daripada faedah perlindungan keilatan, kemalangan ketika menguruskan rumah tangga dan kematian.

"Ini membuktikan keberkesanan skim ini menjaga kebajikan suri rumah, sekali gus membantu meningkatkan kesejahteraan sosial mereka," katanya.

Menurutnya, walaupun lebih setengah juta suri rumah bagi SKSSR mendaf-

tar di bawah Perkeso bagi 2024, namun ia hanya 16.5 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan dan masih ada lebih 2.6 juta suri rumah belum lagi mendaftar untuk perlindungan ini.

"Skim SKSSR menyediakan perlindungan komprehensif kepada suri rumah yang berstatus warganegara Malaysia, pemastautin tetap dan berumur 54 tahun semasa bayaran caruman dilakukan.

"Sekiranya suri rumah meninggal dunia sebelum usia 55 tahun, waris layak menerima Faedah Pengurusan Mayat (FPM) RM3,000 serta Pencen Penakat sehingga RM300 sebulan berdasarkan kelayakan tanggungan.

"Kerajaan komited melindungi wanita dalam sektor *care economy* dengan fleksibiliti pembayaran caruman oleh suami, suri rumah sendiri, ahli keluarga, atau pihak ketiga selaras dengan pengenaln kad bawcer suri atau *sc-ratch card* RM120 boleh dihadiahkan kepada warga suri rumah atau sebagai hantaran kahwin," katanya.

Jumlah pencarum berjaya capai sasaran PERKESO

Kuala Lumpur: Seramai 512,518 wanita mencarum dengan Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO) pada tahun ini mengikut Akta Skim Keselamatan Sosial Suri Rumah (SKSSR), sekali gus berjaya mencapai sasaran 100 peratus.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Keselamatan Sosial Suri Rumah PERKESO, Kasthuri Patto, berkata jumlah itu membabitkan nilai ke-

seluruhan caruman RM61.5 juta.

Katanya, meskipun akta berkenaan menyatakan mengenai suri rumah, ia turut terbuka kepada wanita bujang, sudah bercerai, kehilangan suami, ibu tunggal serta wanita berkerjaya.

"Dengan hanya mencarum RM120 setahun, golongan wanita ini akan menerima manfaat seperti perlindungan bencana domestik sekiranya mereka mengalami kemalangan atau insiden ketika menjalankan tanggungjawab dan urusan di rumah.

"SKSSR turut melindungi suri rumah yang ditimpa penyakit atau keuzuran. Faedah perlindungan bencana domestik termasuk faedah perubatan, faedah hilang upaya kekal, elaun layanan sentiasa, faedah pengurusan mayat, kemudahan pemulihan jasmmani atau dialisis serta pencen penakat.

"Malah, SKSSR ini turut melindungi wanita yang ditimpa kemalangan atau kecederaan lain ketika sedang bercuti dalam negara," katanya pada sidang media, di sini, semalam.

SKSSR adalah cetusan idea isteri Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail ketika beliau menjadi Timbalan Perdana Menteri pada 2018.

Ia mula dilancarkan pada 1 Disember 2022 dengan mencatat 1,092 pencarum secara sukarela selepas lapan hari dikuatkuasakan.

2,019 kes tuntutan dilulus

Sementara itu, Kasthuri berkata setakat November lalu, PERKESO sudah meluluskan 2,019 kes tuntutan dengan faedah bernilai RM3.9 juta membabitkan suri rumah yang mendaftar sebagai pencarum SKSSR.

Katanya, antara tuntutan paling tinggi adalah kemalangan ketika menguruskan rumah tangga, faedah keilangan dan kematian.

"Meskipun jumlah suri rumah yang mencarum mencecah setengah juta, itu hanyalah 16.5 peratus daripada jumlah keseluruhan golongan berkenaan.

"Masih terdapat 2.6 juta golongan berkenaan belum mendaftar bagi mendapatkan perlindungan," katanya.

Kasthuri berkata, Selangor menjadi negeri tertinggi pendaftaran pencarum sukarela iaitu 13,546, diikuti Johor (6,847) dan Perak (4,853).

Katanya, bagi mencarum dengan inisiatif kerajaan, paling tinggi adalah di Sabah dengan 88,034, diikuti Sarawak (87,775) dan Kelantan (67,755).

Kasthuri berkata, SKSSR turut membuat penambahbaikan sistem penyampaian maklumat dengan menterjemah risalah dalam beberapa bahasa selain bahasa Melayu dan Inggeris.

Surge in evacuees in Kelantan and Terengganu

Johor also hit by more floods after heavy rainfall

KUALA LUMPUR: The flood situation in Kelantan and Terengganu has worsened, with more victims evacuated to temporary relief centres (PPS), while Johor has been hit by floods again following heavy rain.

In Kelantan, the number of flood evacuees rose to 882 yesterday morning involving 267 families housed at 19 PPS, compared with 482 people on Sunday night.

The Disaster Info Portal of the Social Welfare Department said Tanah Merah district recorded the highest number of evacuees at 633 people from 208 families housed at 13 PPS.

This was followed by Kuala Krai with 165 people from 38 families at four PPS, and Machang with 84 people from 21 families at two PPS, Bernama reported.

The Irrigation and Drainage Department's Public Infobanjir portal reported that the level of Sungai Golok in Rantau Panjang is at 9.11m, exceeding the danger level. Two rivers in Tanah Merah are at warning levels – Sungai Golok in Kampung Jenob at 23.16m and Sungai Sokor at 22.49m.

In Terengganu, the number of evacuees rose to 651 from 177 families yesterday compared with 112 people from 37 families on Sunday night.

The State Disaster Management Committee Secretariat reported that Hulu Terengganu recorded the highest number of evacuees at 412 from 111 families.

This is followed by Besut (228 people from 61 families) and Kemaman (11 people from five families).

It said all of them were housed at 17 PPS and that the number of evacuees is expected to rise as rainfall continues in several areas of the state.

According to the Public Infobanjir portal, only Sungai Telemong in Kuala Ping (F1) station in Hulu Terengganu is at danger level, at 20.89m.

The levels of Sungai Tebak at Jambatan Tebak, Kemaman; Sungai Terengganu at Rumah Pam Pulau Bahagia (F1), Kuala Terengganu; and Sungai Nerus at Kampung Bukit, Setiu; are at warning levels.

Meanwhile, floods have forced the closure of stretches of a federal and state road in Machang to all traffic, according to the Public Works Department (JKR).

Kelantan JKR director Nik Soh Yaacoub said FT 479 Jalan Kemuning-Bukit Belah and D16 Jalan Batu 30-Temangan were inundated.

"Landslides occurred on the access road to the VHF station at Bukit Bakar and FT 008 Jalan Kota Baru-Gua Musang near Dataran Bukit Belah.

"JKR has placed warning signs and barricades at the affected locations to ensure road users exercise caution and adhere to the established rules to prevent any untoward incidents," he said.

Nik Soh added that they could utilise alternative routes and visit the website <https://bencana.jkr.gov.my/> for further updates on the current situation, including road closures and landslides in the affected areas.

In Johor, 12 people from

Kampung Baru Sungai Mas in Kota Tinggi district were evacuated to a relief centre in Dewan Kampung Baru Sungai Mas yesterday.

State disaster management committee chairman Tan Sri Dr Azmi Rohani said the water level of Sungai Ulu Pontian Besar in Kampung Melayu Bukit Batu, Kulai, was at alert level with a reading of 11.49m.

On the weather update, he said three districts were reported to expect rain, namely Mersing, Kluang and Tangkak.

"Four other districts – Muar, Segamat, Kota Tinggi and Kulai –

had cloudy weather while it was sunny in Johor Baru, Pontian and Batu Pahat," he said in a statement.

Meanwhile, the Malaysian Meteorological Department (Met-Malaysia) has issued a continuous rain warning at the alert level in Pahang and Johor.

The areas affected in both states are Pekan and Rompin (Pahang), as well as Mersing and Kota Tinggi (Johor).

It also said the monsoon surge is expected to occur from Jan 5-9 based on the analysis of the latest weather model.

"This can potentially lead to continuous rain in the east of the peninsula as well as north and south of Sarawak," it added.

It advised the public to stay informed by checking the latest weather updates on MetMalaysia's website, the myCuaca mobile application or the department's official social media channels.

It was earlier reported that the northeast monsoon, which began on Nov 5, is expected to continue until March.

In January and February, heavy rainfall is likely in Pahang, Johor, Sabah and Sarawak.

FLOODS EASE IN EAST COAST

But Sungai Golok's water level rises above danger mark due to heavy rain

FLOODS in east coast states are easing, with a decrease in the number of evacuees in Kelantan and Terengganu compared with the previous day.

The Welfare Department's Info Bencana portal showed that the number of evacuees in Kelantan fell to 573 people from 178 families yesterday afternoon from 882 people from 267 families at 19 centres earlier.

Tanah Merah, the worst-hit district, had the most evacuees at 571 people from 177 families at 6pm.

In Kuala Krai, only two flood victims from one family remained at one relief centre.

Despite the fall in evacuees, the water level of Sungai Golok in Rantau Panjang rose to 10.23m yesterday afternoon, which was 1.23m above the 9m danger level. This was an increase from 9.11m at 7.30am.

The river's water level was rising due to continuous heavy rain since Sunday.

In **Terengganu**, the number of

evacuees fell from 238 people yesterday afternoon to 43 people from 11 families in the evening, involving two relief centres in Besut.

The Terengganu Disaster Management Committee Secretariat said there was an increase in flood victims earlier in the day as rivers had overflowed due to heavy rainfall.

In **Johor**, Kota Tinggi recorded 13 flood victims from four families at one relief centre.

On Sunday, heavy rain lasting more than two hours caused flash

floods that hit 11 houses in Kampung Melayu Bukit Nyamuk and Kampung Sumber Jaya.

Eight families were evacuated to a flood relief centre in Kampung Bukit Nyamuk, which was activated at 8.40pm.

Johor Disaster Management Committee chairman Tan Sri Dr Azmi Rohani said the district's Civil Defence Force was alerted to the rising floodwaters by a village chief at 7.30pm.

In **Sabah**, only one relief centre in Semporna remains open, housing 71 evacuees from 12 families.

The Disaster Info Portal of the Social Welfare Department said Tanah Merah District recorded the highest number of evacuees at 633 from 208 families who are housed at 13 centres, followed by Kuala Krai with 165 from 38 families at four centres, and Machang with 84 from 21 families at two centres.

The Irrigation and Drainage Department's Public Infobanjir portal reported the water level of Sungai Golok in Rantau Panjang has risen to 9.11m, exceeding the 9m danger mark.

Two rivers in Tanah Merah are above warning levels – Sungai Golok in Kampung Jenob at 23.16m (warning level at 22.5m) and Sungai Sokor at 22.49m (warning level at 21m).

In **TERENGGANU**, the number of evacuees rose to 651 from 177 families yesterday morning, compared with 112 people from 37 families on Sunday night.

Di **Terengganu** pula jumlah mangsa meningkat kepada 651 mangsa daripada 177 keluarga pagi semalam berbanding 112 orang daripada 37 keluarga malam kelmarin.

Sekretariat Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Nege-

CLOSING A POLICY GAP

IMPROVING SUPPORT FOR SEX ABUSE VICTIMS

Health Ministry working with other agencies to get them better care, says Dzulkefly

THE government is enhancing policies to better support sexual abuse victims, address potential addictions and reduce the risk of victims becoming sexual predators themselves.

Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr Dzulkefly Ahmad said the ministry was exploring collaborations with other agencies to better support and treat abuse victims.

Dzulkefly said the ministry was working closely with the Women, Family, and Community Development Ministry, the Communications Ministry and the Digital Ministry, and law enforcement agencies to establish a victim-centred approach to addressing sexual abuse and its long-term impacts.

"The Health Ministry recognises the significance of this issue

and is committed to addressing the growing concerns surrounding child pornography and its effects on both victims and society."

He said there were One-Stop Crisis Centres in government hospitals nationwide to provide support to abuse victims.

"These centres are designed to provide immediate, multidisciplinary care for victims of abuse, including medical, psychological, and social support.

"For children who are identified as victims or at risk, referral to mental health professionals for therapy is a key component of the intervention process," he said.

Dzulkefly was commenting on a *New Straits Times* report quoting Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women and Child Investigations Division (D11) principal assistant director, Senior Assistant Commissioner Siti Kamsiah Hassan, who said that many sexual predators were themselves sexually abused as children.

She said there was a gap in the legal system, as sexual abuse victims were not compelled to get psychological treatment.

Siti Kamsiah said despite referring sexual abuse victims for psychiatric care, many failed to complete the treatment, which was critical to ensure their trauma

was properly addressed.

Dzulkefly said the Health Ministry had introduced guidelines to tackle behavioural addiction that may predispose individuals to harmful activities.

"These guidelines emphasise a structured and multidisciplinary approach to ensure victims receive care tailored to their needs.

"The Health Ministry is committed to strengthening policies to address this gap. We are exploring inter-agency collaborations to establish a more robust framework that enhances mechanisms for tracking and supporting victims throughout their treatment journey," he said.

Dzulkefly said the ministry had also developed a training module for law enforcement officers, educators and healthcare providers on the importance of rehabilitating sexual abuse victims.

He said the module was also developed to address the growing concern about sexual abuse in vulnerable groups.

The NST had, in recent weeks, reported on a rise in local child sexual abuse material on social media, with some sold for as low as RML. It has raised concerns among parents and authorities over the safety of children.

Siti Kamsiah said there were cases of sexual predators abducting children.

Social media licensing can make the Internet safe, say experts

KUALA LUMPUR: The government's decision to require social media platforms to secure a regulatory licence can play a significant role in making the Internet a safe place for all, especially for children.

Experts believe that the anonymity and accessibility provided by social media platforms have made it easy for perpetrators to groom children or distribute exploitative content.

Universiti Utara Malaysia School of Multimedia Technology and Communication senior lecturer Dr Azian Muhamad Adzmi said the licensing framework not only ensured accountability, but also created opportunities to empower citizens through digital literacy to complement regulatory efforts.

It also highlighted the need for a balanced approach to combat the twin challenges of online fraud and misinformation

while preserving free speech.

"This is not just a regulatory initiative.

"It signals Malaysia's intent to position itself as a regional leader in digital governance.

"This comparison with international frameworks such as Australia's Digital Services Act underscores the global relevance of the issues and reflects Malaysia's proactive stance," she said.

She added that the initiative was not merely about censorship but also about fostering accountability by promoting the responsible and appropriate use of social media, ensuring a safer online environment free from threats and dangers.

Criminologist and Universiti Malaya Law Faculty deputy dean (postgraduate affairs) Dr Haezreena Begum Abdul Hamid said children sexualised or exposed to pornography had higher

chances of suffering devastating and life-long emotional and psychological consequences.

"Sometimes children who were victimised in this aspect may normalise those acts of sexualisation, making them think that it is normal.

"These will cause them to fall into depression, get traumatised or lose trust among people.

"As a result, they might invite others to engage in such acts or worse, do it to other children.

"They might view being sexualised as an expression of love when it's the exact opposite."

She said although the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017 (Act 792) was in place to punish those linked to child sexual abuse material (CSAM), it did not address the issue holistically.

She said with the rise of artificial intelligence (AI), perpetrators engaging in CSAM could take advantage of the technology to communicate and engage with an unknowing child and persuade them to, among others, perform sexual acts.

The authorities, she said, should consider giving manda-

tory counselling or rehabilitation programmes for those convicted of committing online sexual offences, especially CSAM.

She said CSAM stemmed from an abnormal obsession about children, which could go out of control and disrupt the future of generations to come.

"To offenders, this is just like an interest, but interests do not just fade away. As such, it would require long-term monitoring to see what is wrong with that particular person.

"For instance, it's not normal for a 50-year-old man to be sexually attracted to a child who is 9. We're talking about their obsession and fetish towards children, which definitely calls for attention from the public.

"To do this, it should go beyond just physical aspects. It's also monitoring against any chances of committing this offence online," she said. **Bername**

OP PEDO BERSEPADU PDRM-MCMC

SECOND MAN PLEADS GUILTY TO HAVING CHILD PORN

Ice factory worker among 13 suspects arrested last week

KUALA BERANG

THE second of 13 suspects arrested during Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC last week pleaded guilty to charges of possessing child sexual abuse material (CSAM) and pornographic videos yesterday.

Ice factory worker Muhammad Affandi Mohd Azi, 33, was charged with committing the offences at a house in Kampung Batangan at 8.50pm on Dec 23.

On the first charge, he faces a

penalty of up to five years in prison, a maximum fine of RM10,000, or both, upon conviction.

For the other charge, he faces a maximum of three years' imprisonment, a fine or both, if convicted.

Prosecuting officer Assistant Superintendent Tuan Norhasnida Tuan Nordin offered bail at RM12,000 for both offences.

The accused, who was not represented, pleaded for lower bail.

Magistrate Zur Azureen Zainalkefli allowed bail of RM8,000 with one surety and set Jan 15 for sentencing at the Marang magistrate's court.

On Dec 27, the first of the 13 suspects, 45-year-old engineer Koay Lian San, was fined RM6,000 by the Balik Pulau magistrate's court after pleading guilty to two counts of possessing

child pornography and obscene videos.

Police and the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) launched a blitz on those suspected of possessing and distributing CSAM last week.

Op Pedo Bersepadu PDRM-MCMC was spearheaded by Bukit Aman's Sexual, Women, and Child Investigations Division (D11), and it involved raids in Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, Johor, Terengganu, Penang and Perak.

The raids, which saw the authorities descending on homes in affluent neighbourhood as well as middle- and low-cost areas, led to the arrest of 13 suspects.

It resulted in the seizure of 40,000 CSAM and pornographic content from various devices.

The ages of those arrested ranged between 20 and 74.

Some of the suspects had admitted to finding and buying explicit content via social media and messaging platforms, such as X and Telegram.

The crackdown followed surveillance and undercover work by the police, supported by intelligence provided by MCMC.

The raiding parties comprised Bukit Aman's Forensic Laboratory Division (D10), Technical Assistance Division (D6) and Criminal Investigation Department.

The raids came after the *New Straits Times'* weeklong series of reports on the rampant sale of Malaysian-made explicit content, including CSAM, on social media and messaging platforms.

KUALA LUMPUR: Seorang pengangkut sampah mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini hari ini atas pertuduhan melakukan amang seksual bukan fizikal terhadap seorang kanak-kanak perempuan, minggu lalu.

Mengikut pertuduhan, tertuduh, Muhammad Ikmal Mansor, 29, didakwa telah melakukan amang seksual bukan fizikal terhadap mangsa berusia lapan tahun semasa kejadian dengan cara membuka zip seluarnya supaya dilihat oleh kanak-kanak tersebut bagi tujuan seksual.

Perbuatan itu dilakukan di Program Perumahan Rakyat (PPR) Desa Tun Razak, Cheras, pada pukul 11.30 pagi, pada 25 Disember lalu.

Lelaki itu didakwa di bawah Seksyen 15(a)(1) Kanun Keseksaan yang dihukum di bawah Seksyen 15(a) Akta Kesalahan-kesalahan Seksual yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum 10 tahun atau denda tidak melebihi RM20,000 atau kedua-duanya, jika sabit kesalahan.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Atiqa Nazihah Azmi mencadangkan jaminan sebanyak RM10,000 dengan seorang penjamin tempatan beserta syarat tambahan.

“Kes ini merupakan kesalahan yang tidak boleh dijamin namun terpulung kepada atas budi bicara mahkamah sekiranya mahkamah membenarkan jaminan pihak pendakwa mencadangkan jaminan sebanyak RM10,000 dengan syarat tambahan.

“Tertuduh juga perlu melaporkan diri di balai polis dan tidak mendekati mangsa memandangkan tertuduh dan mangsa tinggal di PPR yg sama,” kata Atiqa Nazihah.

Bagaimanapun, peguam bela Mohamad Zaidi Othman yang mewakili tertuduh merayu kepada mahkamah untuk mengenakan jumlah jaminan yang rendah dalam memastikan kehadiran tertuduh.

“Difahamkan anak guam saya bakal berkahwin pada awal tahun hadapan serta ibunya menghidap penyakit kanser payudara dan masih dalam proses untuk mendapatkan rawatan lanjutan. Mohon jaminan yang minima diberikan kepada tertuduh,” kata Zaidi.

Hakim Mohd Kafil Che Ali kemudian membenarkan tertuduh diikat jamin sebanyak RM5,000 dengan seorang penjamin tempatan serta menetapkan syarat tambahan iaitu tertuduh tidak boleh mendekati mangsa dan perlu melaporkan diri ke balai polis sebulan sekali sehingga kes selesai.

Mahkamah juga menetapkan 13 Februari hadapan untuk sebutan semula kes. – UTUSAN

Bukit Aman, Senior Asisten Komisioner Siti Kamariah Hassan berkata, suspek sudah ditahan reman bagi membantu siasatan.

“Kes mengikut Seksyen 14 (a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017,” katanya kepada Harian Metro semalam.

“Ahli keluarga bawa mangsa buat laporan polis, kemudian dibawa ke hospital untuk pemeriksaan”

TAIPING: Seorang pembantu kedai dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen di sini hari ini atas tiga pertuduhan termasuk merogol dan melakukan amang seksual terhadap anak tiri perempuan berusia 15 tahun, Februari lalu.

Tertuduh berusia 37 tahun itu bagaimanapun mengaku tidak bersalah selepas kesemua pertuduhan dibacakan jurubahasa di hadapan Hakim Nabisha Ibrahim.

Mengikut pertuduhan, lelaki itu didakwa merogol mangsa di mana perhubungan itu tidak dibenarkan di bawah undang-undang, hukum agama, adat dan kebiasaan yang terpakai untuk berkahwin.

Perbuatan itu dilakukan tertuduh di sebuah rumah di Blok Damai Jalan Abdul Raof, Parit Buntar pada pukul 1 pagi, 7 Februari 2024.

Bagi kesalahan itu, tertuduh didakwa mengikut Seksyen 376 (3) Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman penjara minimum lapan tahun dan maksimum 30 tahun serta tidak lebih 10 sebatan jika disabitkan kesalahan.

Tertuduh turut didakwa bagi dua pertuduhan lain iaitu melakukan amang seksual fizikal dengan cara memegang payudara mangsa dan melakukan hubungan seksual memasukkan jari ke dalam kemaluan mangsa tanpa kerelaannya di lokasi, masa dan tarikh yang sama.

Bagi kesalahan itu, tertuduh didakwa di bawah Seksyen 14(a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 yang membawa hukuman penjara tidak lebih 20 tahun dan boleh disabitkan dengan Seksyen 377CA Kanun Keseksaan yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara minimum lima tahun dan maksimum 30 tahun serta sebat, jika sabit kesalahan.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Muhammad Fahmi Kamaluddin manakala tertuduh diwakili peguam Yayasan Bantuan Guaman Kebangsaan (YBGK), Ng Wei Jun.

Terdahulu, Muhammad Fahmi tidak menawarkan jaminan atas alasan kacau ganggu berikutan tertuduh merupakan bapa tiri mangsa selain pertuduhan yang dihadapinya disifatkan sebagai berat.

Bagaimanapun, Wei Jun memohon agar tertuduh diberikan jaminan minimum atas alasan bekerja di kedai elektrik dengan pendapatan bulanan RM1,000 selain menanggung isteri yang tidak bekerja dan lima anak berusia antara sebulan hingga 15 tahun.

Nabisha membenarkan permohonan pihak pendakwaan dan menetapkan 3 Februari depan sebagai tarikh sebutan semula kes sementara menunggu laporan perubatan. - UTUSAN

Teen pleads guilty to rape, fined RM10,000

PETALING JAYA: A teenager who committed statutory rape on a 14-year-old girl nearly three years ago was fined RM10,000 after he pleaded guilty to the charge.

Magistrate Nurshahida Abdul Rahim, who sat in the court for children in Kangar, Perlis, also ordered the victim to be compensated RM4,000, as allowed under the Child Act 2001.

The offender's mother paid the fine and compensation.

Nurshahida also ordered the offender, accompanied by his mother, to report to the nearest social welfare department office on the first week of every month for two years beginning from the date of the court order.

The offender, now 19 and working, was also directed to attend an interactive workshop over a period of two years at a place and time to be determined by the department.

He admitted to committing the offence at a house in Kuala Perlis at about 3am on Jan 16, 2022, when the girl was 14 years and 10 months old.

Nurshahida noted that the offender, a 16-year-old student when the offence was committed, had entered an unconditional plea of guilt which had saved the court's time and prevented his underage victim the embarrassment of testifying at trial.

The magistrate said her decision was premised on a probationary report and the views of two advisers who had sat with her to hear the case.

"This court is aware that the order given must reflect social changes occurring in society at this time.

"Public interest must be given priority and, at the same time, the welfare of the offender has to be considered," Nurshahida said, adding that a good behaviour bond would have been too lenient for the offence.

"However, an order to send him to an institution would be too excessive and not in the best interest of the child, as stated in the probation report," her written judgment, released last week, read.

She noted that the report concluded that the offender needed family support to become a responsible citizen.

He had also realised the difficulties his family had been put through in raising funds to pay the fine and the compensation to the victim.

The prosecution had submitted that the offender had a prior record and called for a heavy sentence to be imposed, including sending the offender to the Henry Gurney correctional school.

The facts of the case revealed that the girl had admitted that the offender was her boyfriend and that they had spent the night at a friend's house.

The girl's father was the complainant in the case and had made a police report.

The prosecution has filed an appeal in the High Court.

Divorcee gets 26 months' jail for threatening his children, pointing sword at ex-wife [WATCH]

BATU PAHAT: A 43-year-old personal driver was sentenced to 26 months' jail and fined RM5,000 after he pleaded guilty to six charges of possessing, threatening, and pointing a sword at his ex-wife and children.

Nik Helmi Jamsus pleaded guilty to committing the offences when he was charged at the Sessions Court and magistrate's court here today.

In the Sessions Court, Nik Helmi was charged with possessing a 100cm sword at his house in Parit Haji Yusof, Sri Medan, at 10am on Dec 28.

The charge was framed under Section 7(1)(a) of the Corrosive and Explosive Substances and Offensive Weapons Act 1958, which carries a maximum penalty of 10 years' jail and whipping.

Deputy public prosecutor Sharifah Natasha Syed Ahmad prosecuted while Nik Helmi was not represented.

Judge Osman Affendi Mohd Shalleh sentenced Nik Helmi to RM5,000, in default of 10 months' jail, for the offence.

Nik Helmi also pleaded guilty to five other charges when he was produced at the magistrate's court.

For the first and second charges, Nik Helmi was charged with injuring his 13-year-old daughter and 17-year-old son at 10.30pm on Dec 27.

For the third charge, Nik Helmi was charged with threatening his son by uttering the words "mampus kau."

He also admitted to injuring and pointing the sword at his ex-wife during the same incident.

Magistrate Suhaila Shafi'uddin sentenced Nik Helmi to six months' jail for each of the first and second charges and four months' imprisonment for the third charge.

She also sentenced Nik Helmi to two months' jail for the fourth charge and four months' jail for the fifth charge.

She ordered that the jail sentences run concurrently, effective from his arrest on Dec 28.

Deputy Public Prosecutor Farah Wahidah Mohd Sharip prosecuted the case, while the accused was represented by Normahani Raais from the National Legal Aid Foundation.

“Susulan itu, suspek ditahan pada jam 5.45 petang 23 Disember lalu oleh sepasukan polis dari Bahagian Siasatan Jenayah Daerah (BSJD) Ampang Jaya di Jalan Permai Taman Dato Ahmad Razali,” katanya dalam satu kenyataan, kelmarin.
