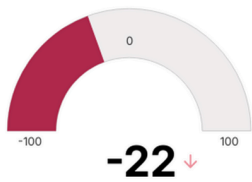

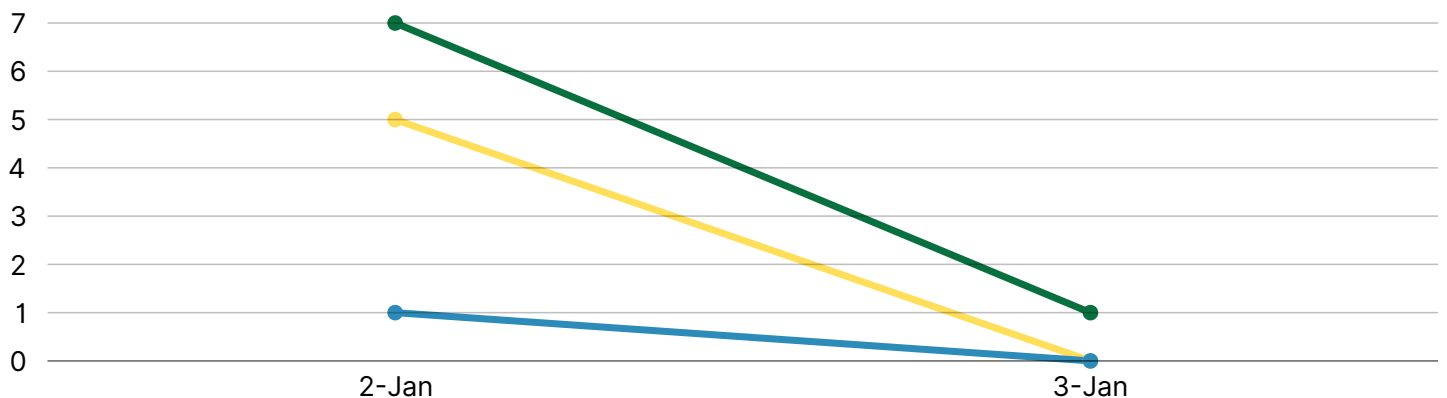

LIPUTAN BERITA

- Putrajaya: Kementerian Pendidikan Malaysia (KPM) akan menyelaraskan semula pendidikan anak-anak GISB Holdings Sdn Bhd (GISBH) yang diselamatkan dalam Op Global pada September tahun lalu.
- Menterinya, Fadhlina Sidek berkata, penyelarasan pendidikan itu akan dibuat mengikut umur serta kesesuaian mereka untuk mengikuti pendidikan di sekolah di bawah KPM.
- "Anak-anak ini (GISBH) ada sebahagiannya sudah pulang ke pangkuan keluarga masing-masing.
- "Di peringkat KPM, kita sedang menyelaraskan semula (pendidikan mereka) kerana ada anak-anak ini yang terus kekal di rumah selamat di bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

CADANGAN

Sistem Pemantauan Pendidikan Kanak-kanak dengan mewujudkan sistem bersepadu untuk memantau perkembangan kanak-kanak yang mengikuti pendidikan alternatif, dengan melibatkan KPM dan JKJ. Selain itu, laporan berkala kepada keluarga dan pihak berkuasa mengenai perkembangan anak-anak. Cadangan ini bertujuan untuk memastikan hak pendidikan anak-anak terus dijaga tanpa mengabaikan kebajikan dan kesejahteraan mereka, seiring dengan kepentingan pembangunan masyarakat yang inklusif.

Registered childcare centres to get plaques to display details

KUALA LUMPUR: Childcare centres registered with the Welfare Department will soon be provided with a plaque to display their details, including registration numbers, said the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry.

Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said: "The ministry is committed to ensuring registered childcare centres display their registration details. We will provide plaques for this purpose, starting January 2025, *In-syaAllah*."

This was in response to a *New Straits Times* survey of 11 childcare centres in the city, which revealed that over half had not displayed their Welfare Department registration numbers, since Jan 1.

The survey found that some centres were not registered with the department.

Nancy said the plaques will include QR codes or barcodes to allow parents and guardians access to information, and would need time to be implemented.

"This will allow parents and guardians to scan and check details, such as the registration expiry date, ensuring greater transparency and accountability."

She added: "We understand compliance is a challenge, but we are working to ensure all centres meet these requirements and are registered with the department."

Last month, she said childcare centres registered under the department would be required to display their registration numbers at their premises from Jan 1.

She said the move was necessary to assure parents about the centres' licensing status.

Meanwhile, activists are urging for stricter oversight and systemic reform to address the issue of unregistered childcare centres.

Suriana Welfare Society chairman Dr James Nayagam highlighted the challenges centres face in obtaining registration.

"To register, childcare centres must first secure permits from local authorities, the Health De-

partment and Fire and Rescue Department," he said.

"Many fail to do this and continue operating without registration."

Last month, Deputy Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Dr Noraini Ahmad told the Dewan Rakyat that cases of abuse and neglect in childcare centres were still occurring, with most involving unlicensed premises.

She said 4,424 cases of child abuse and neglect had been recorded up to August last year.

Nayagam refuted claims that the permits were expensive and urged the government to enforce compliance and audit these centres.

He said the government may be overwhelmed due to the number of childcare centres, and suggested outsourcing the registration and training to non-governmental organisations or appointed entities.

Childline Foundation project director Datin Wong Poai Hong echoed the concerns, but said permit costs could impact centres catering to middle- and lower-income groups as they were passed on to consumers.

"In some cases, exorbitant fees

are charged, which childcare centres serving the M40 or B40 groups find difficult to pay."

Stricter oversight and support key for childcare centres

KUALA LUMPUR: Childcare centres operating without registration with the Social Welfare Department (JKM) have sparked concern among activists, who are urging for stricter oversight and systemic reform to address the issue.

This was after a New Straits Times survey of 11 childcare centres across the city yesterday showed that more than half have not adhered to the requirement to display their Social Welfare Department (JKM) registration number, which went into effect Jan 1.

The survey also revealed the other centres were not registered with the department at all.

Suriana Welfare Society chairman Dr. James Nayagam highlighted the hurdles centres face in obtaining this registration.

"In order to register, childcare centres must first apply for various permits from the local authorities, Health Department, and Fire and Rescue Department. They fail to do this and many continue to operate without registering," he said.

In December 2024, Deputy Women, Family, and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Dr. Noraini Ahmad in the Dewan Rakyat said [cases of abuse and neglect in childcare centres](#) are still occurring, with most involving unlicensed premises.

She said a total of 4,424 cases of child abuse and neglect had been recorded as of August last year.

Nayagam refuted claims that the permits are prohibitively expensive, urging the government to enforce compliance and conduct audits of these centres.

He said the government may be overwhelmed due to the number of such centres, and suggested outsourcing the registration and training processes to non-governmental organisations (NGOs) or appointed entities.

Nancy said the plaques which would incorporate QR codes or barcodes would provide parents access to key information about the particular centre.

Manfaat untuk wanita, kanak-kanak negeri Pahang

SHAH ALAM - Dasar dan Pelan Tindakan Wanita Pahang terus memberi manfaat bagi meningkatkan kualiti hidup wanita dan kanak-kanak demi memperkasa ekonomi, pendidikan, kemahiran, sosial dan kebajikan mereka menerusi pelbagai strategi serta program yang dirangka.

Exco Bekalakan Masyarakat, Pembangunan Wanita Dan Keluarga Negeri Pahang, Datuk Sabariah Saidan berkata, dengan peruntukan sebanyak RM1 juta setiap tahun, dasar yang dilancarkan sejak 2022 itu terbukti memberi kesan positif dalam memberi sokongan kepada golongan memerlukan demi mendepani cabaran hidup.

Menurutnya, Kerajaan Negeri Pahang akan memastikan golongan ibu tunggal, wanita B40, suri rumah, warga emas, remaja perempuan dan kanak-kanak tidak tercicir dalam menerima manfaat daripada program-program yang bersesuaian.

"Apabila kerajaan melihat Dasar dan Pelan Tindakan Wanita Pahang ini banyak memberikan impak yang bagus dalam memajukan wanita Pahang, jadi dasar ini diteruskan untuk tahun hadapan menerusi peruntukan Belanjawan 2025 Negeri Pahang.

"Ia menekankan usaha meningkatkan penyertaan wanita dalam latihan kemahiran dan keusahawanan yang penting untuk wanita luar bandar agar mereka dapat menjana pendapatan melalui perniagaan kecil-kecilan atau kerajinan," katanya dalam Program Podcast Sinar Harian di Studio Sinar Harian di sini, baru-baru ini.

Meningkatkan kemahiran, kebolehpasaran wanita Tambah bellow, Anggun Maju merupakan antara program utama yang wajar dimanfaatkan demi meningkatkan kemahiran dan kebolehpasaran wanita menerusi suntikan modal atau geran perniagaan.

Di bawah program berkenaan, kerajaan negeri juga memperkenalkan SuriTekno untuk memberi pendedahan ilmu keusahawanan kepada golongan suri rumah.

"Kita berikan latihan dan kemahiran keusahawanan kepada suri rumah, seperti kursus pembuatan kraftangan dan jahitan untuk membantu mereka memulakan perniagaan kecil-kecilan dari rumah.

"Kita juga sediakan program kemahiran dan latihan pemasaran digital untuk mereka mempromosikan jualan dalam talian serta penggunaan platform e-dagang untuk membantu mereka memasarkan produk lebih meluas.

"Kerjasama dilaksanakan bersama agensi seperti Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO) dan Pembangunan Sumber Manusia Berhad (HRDF) dengan mengadakan kursus pendek untuk beri peluang suri rumah menjalankan perniagaan," katanya.

Jelas bellow, inisiatif yang dilaksanakan tidak terhad kepada anak kelahiran Pahang tetapi ia layak untuk memastuaitu tetap.

"Wanita Pahang sangat bertuah berada di Pahang. Jika suami orang Pahang, wanita ini telah lama duduk di Pahang, kita tidak meminggirkan mereka.

"Bantuan yang disediakan juga tidak terhad kepada inisiatif sedia ada tetapi mereka yang memerlukan boleh memohon melalui Unit Pembangunan Wanita dan Sosial dalam bentuk bantuan lain sekiranya wujud keperluan," katanya.

Bantu pasangan B40 bina masjid

Dalam masa sama, Sabariah berkata, Program Anggun Suri iaitu program perkahwinan beramai-ramai menjadi antara inisiatif unik yang diteruskan tahun hadapan.

Katanya, program tersebut menyaksikan penglibatan seramai 40 pasangan B40 bagi tahun ini.

"Ia merupakan satu inisiatif yang unik dan bermakna untuk meringankan beban kewangan pasangan yang ingin mendirikan rumah tangga khususnya dalam kalangan golongan B40.

"Salah seorang daripada pasangan mesti merupakan anak kelahiran Pahang dan perkahwinan pertama untuk melayakkan mereka menyertai program ini," katanya.

'Bidadari Merah' untuk gadis suli

Pada masa sama tambah bellow, kebajikan golongan kanak-kanak dan remaja perempuan diberi perhatian di bawah Kluster Keluarga.

Katanya, program bersama keluarga dan ibu bapa dengan kerjasama agensiagensi berkaitan dilaksanakan bagi memberi pendedahan kepada mereka.

"Kita ada memberikan kursus, membawa mereka keluar dari rumah atau kawasan kejiranan dengan membuat program bersama pemimpin-pemimpin setempat dan agensi-agensi berkaitan untuk mereka.

"Paling penting bawah Kluster Keluarga kita wujudkan satu program dinamakan Bidadari Merah untuk kanak-kanak perempuan yang berumur daripada sembilan sehingga 17 tahun dengan mendedahkan mereka tentang hal, perijagaan dan kesan kehidupan mereka akan datang.

"Fokus kita bagaimana memberi pendedahan kepada mereka untuk memasuki gerbang remaja. Kita panggil doktor-doktor pakar dan pakar motivasi untuk bercakap dan beri pendedahan," katanya.

Inisiatif seimbang, tiada diskriminasi

Berkongsi lanjut, bellow berkata, setiap program dirangka dengan seimbang termasuk untuk warga emas, antara di bawah Majlis Tindakan Sosial Negeri Pahang (MTSP).

Selain itu katanya, program Bidadari Emas juga dilakukan di kawasan pedalaman seperti di perkampungan Orang Asli dan di kampung-kampung yang jauh dari bandar, memberi fokus kepada perijagaan kesihatan mereka.

"Melalui MTSP, kita juga ada khidmat bantu di rumah yang menyediakan khidmat bantuan di rumah golongan kurang upaya.

"Salah satunya, sekiranya warga emas itu tinggal seorang, kita adakan gotongroyong dan bersih rumah untuk membantu mereka," katanya.

Sehubungan itu, dengan segala inisiatif yang digerakkan, besar harapan bellow agar wanita Pahang membina sebuah komuniti yang inklusif, progresif, dan seimbang.

"Saya ingin melihat mereka terus maju dalam pelbagai bidang sama ada dalam pendidikan, perniagaan atau kepimpinan dengan sokongan penuh daripada pelbagai pihak dan kerajaan negeri.

"Wanita perlu diberi peluang dan platform adil tanpa diskriminasi untuk menyumbang kepada pembangunan negeri," katanya.

FADHLINA: WE'RE READY FOR FLOODS DURING SPM

Ministry ready to reactivate Op Payung to ensure exam proceeds smoothly

THE Education Ministry is ready to reactivate Op Payung in flood-hit states to ensure the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) examination proceeds smoothly.

Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek said the ministry, as well as state and district education offices, had made preparations.

"If anything arises, especially floods, we are ready to activate Op Payung again," she said at a press conference on the SPM examination.

She said the situation in high-risk states was under control.

"We received reports on floods.

But candidates remained at their examination centres and sat the exams there as the floods are manageable."

Fadhlina said the turnout for the examination was strong.

She said the ministry was monitoring special needs students and those taking exams at hospitals or under detention.

In **Batu Pahat**, Education director-general Azman Adnan said the ministry had identified 133 alternative exam centres in six states to ensure candidates could sit the examination if their venues were hit by floods.

He said these centres, located in Kelantan, Terengganu, Kedah, Pahang, Johor and Sabah, were in flood-prone areas.

"This measure ensures that the SPM examination is uninterrupted despite potential challenges posed by floods," he said after a working visit to SMK Tinggi Batu Pahat.

He said the ministry implemented the contingency plans in collaboration with the National Disaster Management Agency, the armed forces, the Meteorological Department, the Fire and Rescue Department, the Civil De-

fence Force, the Social Welfare Department and the Health Ministry.

"If a school designated as an exam centre is affected by flooding, candidates will be relocated to an alternative centre," he said.

Azman said state education department directors had confirmed there were no issues affecting the examination, despite some schools being impacted by floods.

"Up to yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon, I was informed that all affected students had returned home, and exam centres nationwide are operating as scheduled."

This year, 402,956 candidates are sitting the written SPM examination, which runs from yesterday to Feb 6 at 3,337 centres nationwide.

Among these candidates, 87.1 per cent, or 350,943, are from government-aided schools, while the rest are private candidates and others.

Additionally, 2,081 candidates with special education needs are taking the exam, supported by 44,968 exam personnel.

The ministry is prepared to provide psychosocial support for candidates affected by floods.

Teams of guidance counsellors at schools, district education offices and state education departments are on standby.

"Our response mechanism includes relocating candidates to schools with boarding facilities, just as we successfully implemented during the SPM oral exam in past flood seasons," Azman.

Meanwhile, he said examinations in Johor would proceed as

planned on Monday, despite the state declaring a public holiday to mark the transition to a new weekend schedule.

He said the decision was made following discussions between the ministry and the state government.

"The English and Tasawwur Islam tests will take place as scheduled.

"Candidates will report to their schools. Exam personnel, including teachers, will carry out their duties."

He said the state Education Department would manage a replacement leave mechanism for teachers and staff working on the public holiday.

RM500 aid for residents affected by floods

ALOR SETAR: The Kedah government has announced RM500 in aid for each head of household affected by the floods in November, including those who were unable to relocate to temporary relief centres.

Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor said the total number of eligible households is still being verified.

For those who did not evacuate, confirmation will need to be obtained from the Village Community Management Council chairman and the village head.

The RM500 aid will be distributed once the final figures are confirmed, with the process expected to be completed by the end of this month. – Bernama

Ministry: SPM candidates affected by floods can seek help

IPOH: SPM candidates facing problems sitting for the examination must notify the education authorities immediately, says Deputy Education Minister Wong Kah Woh.

"We are ready to help the affected candidates."

"Candidates faced with problems can contact their education departments or examinations board operations centres," he said after visiting SMK Kampong Pasir Puteh on the first day of the SPM written test here yesterday.

He was asked to comment on SPM candidates in states hit by floods like Kelantan, Perak and Johor, with a number of them still seeking shelter at relief centres.

The SPM written test, which began yesterday, will go on till Feb 6.

Wong said the ministry had been handling the flood problem with the SPM oral tests having started last month.

"We have helped flood victims sit for

the exam. The ministry will continue with Ops Payung to ensure that the affected students can take their papers.

"The ministry is working closely with the National Disaster Management Agency (Nadma) and Meteorological Department on the flood issue," he added.

Meanwhile, Perak Education director Safuan Raba'ai said a total of 31,705 candidates would sit for the SPM in the state.

He said they consisted of 27,942 from government schools, 1,358 under government agencies, 65 from state religious schools, 287 from private schools, 1,562 individual candidates and 491 Sekolah Agama Rakyat students.

"We also have 135 special needs candidates for the SPM, compared with 119 in 2023," he said.

Safuan added that there were 323 examination centres and 3,145 people appointed as supervisors and invigilators.

"We have also appointed 390 volunteer invigilators for the first time," he said.

133 PPA di enam negeri berisiko banjir

Batu Pahat: Sebanyak 133 Pusat Peperiksaan Alternatif (PPA) disediakan bagi menempatkan calon Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) di enam negeri yang berisiko sekiranya pusat sedia ada dilanda banjir.

Ketua Pengarah Pendidikan, Azman Adnan, berkata PPA itu diwujudkan Kelantan, Terengganu, Kedah, Pahang, Johor dan Sabah sebagai langkah awal bagi menghadapi sebarang kemungkinan sepanjang peperiksaan SPM berlangsung khususnya berkaitan Monsun Timur Laut (MTL).

Beliau berkata, ini kerana Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) telah mengenalpasti enam negeri terabit berisiko dilanda banjir sekali gus boleh menjejaskan persediaan calon

untuk menduduki SPM.

“Kita juga mengambil kira kemungkinan ada sekolah yang terlibat sebagai pusat peperiksaan dan sekolah itu dilanda banjir.

“Untuk itu, KPM telah pun bersiap siaga dengan semua mekanisme dan juga pelan mitigasi yang melibatkan kerjasama pelbagai agensi antaranya Agensi Pengurusan Bencana Negara (Nadma), ATM, Jabatan Meteorologi, Jabatan Bomba dan Penyelamat, APM, JKM dan juga Kementerian Kesihatan.

“Sekiranya musibah itu berlaku, kita akan alihkan calon ini ke PPA yang telah kita sediakan,” katanya pada sidang media selepas meninjau hari pertama peperiksaan bertulis SPM di Sekolah Tinggi Batu Pahat (HSBP), semalam.

Kerajaan negeri memperuntukkan RM3.5 juta bagi membantu keluarga yang terjejas akibat banjir pada November tahun lalu.

Menteri Besar Kedah, Datuk Seri Muhammad Sanusi Md Nor, berkata menerusi peruntukan itu, setiap ketua isi rumah akan menerima RM500 yang juga akan diagihkan kepada mangsa banjir yang tidak berpindah ke pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS).

Katanya, jumlah itu disemak semula selepas kerajaan negeri mendapati bilangan sebenar mangsa banjir hampir dua kali ganda daripada angka yang direkodkan di lokasi PPS.

"Ada juga orang yang berpindah walaupun rumah dia tak tenggelam tapi dia berpindah kerana jalan terputus, ada juga PPS terlalu padat, maka dipilih untuk duduk rumah dan kita benarkan, kita hantar makanan macam biasa.

"Kita akan jalankan bantian jumlah sebenar mangsa banjir, kita akan minta Pengerusi Majlis Pembangunan dan Keselamatan Kampung (MPKK) untuk pengesahan.

"Kita anggarkan jumlah sebenar mangsa banjir hampir dua kali ganda, jadi kita peruntukkan RM3.5 juta supaya setiap isi rumah menerima sekurang-kurangnya RM500. Bayaran akan dibuat pada bulan Januari, dan kita ha-

rap sekurang-kurangnya dapat bantu mangsa untuk buat persiapan anak-anak kembali ke sekolah," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika ditemui selepas Perhimpunan Penjawat Awam negeri di Wisma Darul Aman di sini, semalam.

Muhammad Sanusi berkata kerajaan negeri juga sudah membuat persiapan untuk menghadapi kemungkinan bencana alam

tahun ini termasuk musim kemarau berpanjangan dan banjir.

Katanya, Lembaga Sumber Air Negeri Kedah (LSANK) diarahkan untuk memastikan bekalan air mencukupi selain memberi tumpuan kepada projek tebatan banjir.

"Banyak projek tebatan banjir tertangguh selama bertahun-tahun dan kini sedang dalam pelaksanaan. Kita harap kementen-

rian dan agensi yang bertanggungjawab dapat mempercepatkan projek-projek ini," katanya.

Mengulas lanjut, Muhammad Sanusi turut menzahirkan ucapan terima kasih kepada Kerajaan Persekutuan kerana menyalurkan peruntukan untuk membaiki infrastruktur yang rosak akibat banjir di Kedah.

"Terima kasih juga kepada penjawat awam dan agensi lain yang bertungkus-lumus semasa banjir di Kedah antara 17 September hingga 16 Oktober dan seterusnya dari 26 hingga 28 November tahun lalu," katanya.

Ministry preparing GISB kids for mainstream education

KUALA LUMPUR: The Education Ministry is working to “realign” education pathways for children under Global Ikhwan Services and Business Holdings Sdn Bhd (GISB).

Education Minister Fadhlina Sidek said the ministry was focused on ensuring these children receive an appropriate education.

She said realigning the children’s education pathways aims to transition them to mainstream education.

“We will realign their education, taking into account their age and suitability for continuing their studies in public schools,” she said.

Previously, Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said 136 GISB children had not been claimed by their families.

The children remain under the Welfare Department’s care.

The children were placed at the department’s institutions in accordance with Section 25(2)(a) of the Child Act, which covers care

and protection provisions.

GISB came under the spotlight last year after police raided 20 welfare homes in Selangor and Negri Sembilan linked to the organisation.

A total of 402 people, mostly children and teenagers, were rescued.

Police said investigations indicated elements of child labour, abuse and neglect. GISB has denied the allegations.

KPM selaras semula pendidikan anak GISBH



Putrajaya: Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM) akan menyelaraskan semula pendidikan anak-anak GISB Holdings (GISBH), melihat kepada usia dan kesesuaian mereka mengikuti pendidikan arus perdana di sekolah kerajaan.

Menteri Pendidikan, Fadhlina Sidek, berkata terdapat sebahagian daripada anak-anak itu sudah pulang ke pangkuan keluarga masing-masing, manakala ada yang terus kekal di rumah selamat di bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM).

“Di peringkat KPM, kita sedang menyelaraskan semula kerana ada anak-anak ini yang terus kekal di rumah selamat, yang mana kita akan selaraskan semula pendidikan mereka,” katanya pada sidang media Pengoperasian Peperiksaan SPM 2024 di sini, semalam.

Pada 5 Disember lalu, Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, berkata seramai 130 kanak-kanak yang diselamatkan dari rumah amal dikaitkan

dengan GISBH masih belum dituntut ibu bapa mereka.

Beliau berkata, ia kemungkinan disebabkan ibu bapa kanak-kanak itu bimbang akan ditahan jika mereka datang mengambil anak-anak mereka.

Sejak Op Global fasa pertama bermula pada awal September lalu, sejumlah 415 individu, termasuk pengurusan tertinggi GISBH ditahan, manakala 625 mangsa berusia dua bulan hingga 28 tahun berjaya diselamatkan pihak polis.

Pontian: Polis menyiasat ibu bapa kanak-kanak lelaki lima tahun yang ditemukan dalam kebun jagung di Jalan Tok Serah, Kampung Pulau Sebatang di sini, 29 Disember lalu kerana pengabaian anak.

Ketua Polis Daerah Pontian, Superintendan Mohammad Shofee Tayib berkata, siasatan awal mendapati ahli keluarga kanak-kanak berkenaan tinggal di Parit Jawa, Muar.

Katanya, selepas hebahan media disiarkan, ibu saudara kanak-kanak itu yang berusia 42 tahun tampil menuntut di Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Pontian.

"Polis akan melakukan siasatan mengikut Seksyen 31(1) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 berkaitan pengabaian kanak-kanak.

"Kita nak tahu kenapa kanak-kanak itu ditinggalkan di dalam kebun jagung berkenaan," katanya dalam kenyataan hari ini.

Dalam pada itu, Mohammad Shofee berkata siasatan turut mendapati ibu bapa kanak-kanak mempunyai rekod lampau berkaitan dadah.

Isnin lalu akhbar ini melaporkan kanak-kanak lelaki itu ditemukan orang awam dipercayai ditinggalkan dalam kebun jagung berkenaan.

KLUANG, 2 Januari- Mahkamah Majistret Kluang memerintahkan seorang penganggur yang dituduh mencabul seorang wanita di Kluang, bulan lalu untuk menjalani pemeriksaan psikiatri selama sebulan di Hospital Permai, Johor Bahru.

Perintah tersebut dikeluarkan Majistret Mustaqim Sukarno terhadap tertuduh, Mohamad Sopor @ Nasir, 34 tahun selepas pertuduhan semula dibacakan terhadapnya.

Mengikut pertuduhan, tertuduh didakwa menggunakan kekerasan jenayah untuk mencabul seorang wanita di dalam tandas awam di Laman Kreatif Kampung Melayu, Kluang, 5.20 petang, 17 Disember lalu.

Dia didakwa mengikut Seksyen 354 Kanun Keseksaan.

Sebelum itu, pada 19 Disember lalu, Mohamad Sopor mengaku salah ketika dihadapkan ke Mahkamah Sesyen Kluang selepas pertuduhan dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Mujib Saroji.

Pendakwaan dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwaraya Siti Nurfara Fazilun Izylin Ahmad manakala tertuduh tidak diwakili peguam.

Sebutan semula kes ditetapkan 4 Februari depan.
