235 mangsa kebakaran paip gas terima kaunseling dan sokongan emosi

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri menyantuni mangsa insiden kebakaran paip gas Petronas di Pusat Pemindahan Sementara (PPS) Putra Heights di Masjid Putra Heights hari ini/BERNAMA

SUBANG JAYA, 7 April- Seramai 235 mangsa kebakaran saluran paip gas di Putra Heights, Subang Jaya telah disantuni dan menerima perkhidmatan kaunseling dan sokongan emosi serta intervensi psikososial.

Menurut Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, usaha itu bagi membantu mereka menghadapi tekanan selain trauma kesan daripada insiden berkenaan.

Perkhidmatan disediakan Yayasan Kebajikan Negara (YKN) melibatkan 10 orang kaunselor bertauliah dan berdaftar yang ditempatkan di Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) setiap hari.

"Daripada kaunseling itu, di PSSS, kita dapat mengetahui apa yang mereka perlukan. Jadi, kita telah menyantuni mereka mengikut keperluan, lebih kepada keperluan individu dan bukan keperluan secara menyeluruh lagi.

Ini kerana ada individu yang memerlukan telefon bimbit. Ada yang telefon mereka rosak, walaupun kita tidak bagi kepada semua tetapi mengkaji kepada keperluan masing-masing," kata Datuk Seri Nancy kepada pemberita, hari ini.

Beliau ditemui selepas mengadakan tinjauan dan menyantuni mangsa insiden kebakaran paip gas di Pusat Pemindahan Sementara (PPS) Masjid Putra Heights, di sini.

Jelas beliau, sejak dua PPS beroperasi, YKN telah menyalurkan bantuan sebanyak RM106,523 merangkumi bantuan kewangan dan keperluan harian.

Tambah Nancy, sebanyak RM29,533 bantuan pelbagai barangan hasil sumbangan tunai orang ramai yang disalurkan melalui YKN, setakat ini.

JKM jamin tunai bantuan dimohon mangsa

Subang Jaya: Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) memberi jaminan akan menaikan sekecil-kecil bantuan yang dimohon setiap individu yang menjadi mangsa tragedi letupan paip gas bawah tanah di Putra Heights, baru-baru ini.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, mengakui hasil temu bual ketika sesi kaunseling dijalankan kaunselor JKJ, ramai mangsa yang berada di pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS) memerlukan bantuan yang berbeza dan berbentuk peribadi.

Beliau berkata, antara barang yang perlu disegerakan untuk dihulurkan kepada mangsa ialah minyak angin, telefon bimbit, penapis udara dan keperluan wanita bagi ibu yang mempunyai bayi.

Katanya, sokongan kewangan juga perlu diberikan kepada beberapa mangsa bagi memudahkan pergerakan untuk ke sana sini.

"Dalam sesi kaunseling yang berlangsung kepada 353 orang, kita mengetahui apa yang diperlukan setiap daripada mereka dan dari situ kita mendapati keperluan mereka bukan ber-

sifat menyeluruh tetapi secara individu.

"Ada yang terdesak memerlukan telefon dan ada yang memerlukan penapis udara kerana mempunyai anak autisme. Malah ada ibu yang memerlukan 'nursing bra' kerana masih mempunyai anak kecil.

"Kaunselor kita juga mendapati ada setengah mangsa hanya memerlukan minyak angin kerana pening berada di PPS. Ini semua kita akan santuni segera kerana itu keperluan masing-masing," katanya selepas melawat di PPS Masjid Putra Heights, di sini semalam.

Mengulas lanjut, Nancy juga berkata, JKJ juga akan memberi bantuan berbentuk tunai khusus untuk mangsa yang memerlukan bantuan dalam pengurusan diri dan ahli keluarga.

"Contohnya, ada seorang mangsa yang mempunyai keseluruhan keluarga dirawat di hospital dan dia perlu berulang-alik ke hospital. Pastinya dia memerlukan wang," katanya.

Dalam perkembangan sama, beliau berkata, Yayasan Kebajikan Negara sudah mengumpul sejumlah RM29,533 untuk disumbangkan dalam tragedi itu.

Nancy: Social Welfare Dept will address even the smallest needs

SHAH ALAS: The government, through the Social Welfare Department, will aim to meet even the smallest requests from Putra Heights gas pipeline fire victims.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said victims expressed different needs for assistance during counselling sessions by the department's counsellors.

She said urgently needed items included (including medical aid, mobile phones, air purifiers and women's necessities for mothers with infants).

She said some victims needed financial support for transportation.

"During counselling sessions with 235 victims, we found out what they needed. Their needs are not universal, but individual."

"Some desperately wanted phones, others needed air purifiers. Some mothers needed nursing bras."

"Our counsellors found that some victims only needed medical aid because they were feeling unwell at the temporary evacuation centre."

"We will address these individual

needs immediately," she said after visiting the Masjid Putra Heights temporary evacuation centre yesterday.

She said the department would provide cash aid to victims who needed help managing themselves and their families.

"One victim's entire family is receiving treatment at the hospital and needs to travel back and forth. The victim needs money for transportation, like Grab."

She said every victim would be treated with the utmost care, not just out of sympathy but with great empathy.

She said the department would coordinate with other agencies to fulfil the victims' needs.

"Some requests need to be handled by other agencies. The department is responsible for coordinating between victims and the relevant parties."

On claims of cramped tents and requests for faster relocation, Nancy said no victim would stay at the centre if they had a choice, but the space had been arranged as best as possible.

She said the National Welfare Foundation had raised RM29,533 for the victims.

Putra Heightsfire: Less than 1 pct suffers serious trauma — Nancy

KUALA LUMPUR: A total of 253 victims of the gas pipeline fire in Putra Heights, Subang Jaya here near last week have received counseling assistance at the One-Stop Social Support Centre set up at the temporary relief centre.

Nancy Shukri said reports from the counselling sessions conducted by 10 counsellors every day revealed that only a small number of the victims experienced serious trauma.

Yes, there are some who suffer serious trauma but not that many. In terms of percentage, it is probably less than one per cent.

Most of these victims just want to get out of here (relief centre) to get fresh air and have someone to talk and share their problems with.

So through this counselling session we can only provide emotional support but also identify the specific needs of the victims," she told reporters after visiting the victims at the relief centre at the Putra Heights

rescue yesterday.

Nancy said among the urgent needs of the victims were mobile phones, air purifiers for autistic children, nursing bras for mothers who had just given birth, balms or ointments for headaches and disposable diapers.

"We also learned that the victims also need cash to manage personal matters such as paying for transportation and from the hospital to visit family members who were admitted there, as well as buying other necessities.

"For this, we have provided them with financial assistance through the National Welfare Foundation," she added.

The Petronas gas pipeline fire which shook the nation last Tuesday, saw flames soaring over 30 metres high, reaching temperatures of up to 1,000 degrees Celsius.

It took nearly eight hours to extinguish the fire completely.

Meanwhile, Housing and Local Government Minister Ng Kor Ming said he was scheduled to

meet with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim yesterday to discuss the best format to help the victims.

"An announcement will be made when the matter has been decided," he told a press conference after delivering a keynote address at the Affordable Housing Project Conference.

Corresponding to his absence at the incident site and the relief centre, which had drawn criticism from certain quarters, Nancy said such remarks did not warrant attention as his priority was to ensure comprehensive assistance for the affected.

"Frankly, we don't need to entertain such criticisms. What truly matters is resolving the issues faced by the people. As of today, we can see that all ministries have mobilised aid to support the relief centre and given 100 per cent of the funds to the victims. So everyone is helping. I am focused on providing a total solution," he said.

Kurang satu peratus mangsa alami trauma serius: Nancy

KUALALUMPUR: Seramai 253 mangsa yang terjejas dalam insiden kebakaran gas di Putra Heights, Suhang Jaya menerima bantuan kaunseling di Pusat Sokongan Sosial Scimpat yang disediakan di pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS).

Stenteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat Datuk Sri Nancy Shukri berkata, daripada sesi kaunseling yang dianjurkan oleh 10 kaunselor pada setiap hari itu, didapati hanya sebilangan kecil mengalami trauma serius.

“Ada yang betul-betul trauma (serius), tapi tak ramai. Mengikut peratusan, mungkin kurang satu peratus saja.

Mereka ini

kebanyakannya mahukeluar dari sini (PPS) untuk mendapatkan fresh air dan nak ada iman untuk fctkongsi masalah. jadi menerusi sesi kaunseling ini, kita bukannya mencirikan sokongan cncsi malah dapat mengenal pasti keperluan khusus mangsa,” katan5a.

Beliau berkata demikian selepas mengadakan tinjauan dan menyantuni mangsa di PPS di zsjia Putra Heights semalam.

Nancy berkata, antara keperluan yang amat diperlukan mangsa ialah telefon bimbit, alat pemis udara untuk anak-anak autistik, bra penyusuan untuk ibu baru bersalin, minyak angin dan lampin pakai buang.

“Selain itu, kita dapat tahu mangsa juga memerlukan wang tunai untuk menguruskan hal peribadi seperti mcmhayar tambang pengangkutan pergi balik ke hospital untuk mclawai anggota keluarga yang sedang m eoe rim a rawatan se rta meatbcli baraagaa keperluan lain.

“Jadi untuk ini, kami ada membri hantuan kewangan mclalui Yayasan Kebajikan Negara,” katan9a.

Kebakaran saluran gas Petronas pada 8.10 pagi Sclnsa lcpas mcnga kibar kan api mcnjulang setinggi lebih 30 meter dengan suhu meocvmh 1,000 darjah Celsius dan mengambil masa hampir lapan dm uniuik dipadamkan scpcnuhnya. — Bernama

Putra Heights disaster victims' welfare takes priority - Selangor MB

KUALA LUMPUR: The welfare of the victims of the gas pipeline disaster in Putra Heights, Subang Jaya remains a priority, with various efforts being carried out including additional contributions and rental assistance.

Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari said that the contributions of RM5,000 and RM2,500 from Petronas are in addition to the assistance previously announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim.

He said the contributions, based on the level of house damage, mean that victims whose homes were completely destroyed will receive a total of RM10,000, while those with partially damaged homes and tenants will each receive RM5,000.

Additionally, Amirudin announced that the state government would provide rental assistance of RM2,000 to affected victims for six months, depending on the repair period of each home, involving a financial implication of RM7.4 million.

Following the incident, which occurred on the morning of the second day of Hari Raya (April 1), Amirudin said the estimated value of loss and damage to affected residences was about RM65.4 million, with 437 houses confirmed as the final number of residences impacted.

He said the figure was based on inspections conducted by a technical team led by the Malaysian Fire and Rescue Department, confirming that 81 houses were completely destroyed with structural damage exceeding 40 percent, 81 houses were partially damaged, 57 were affected but not burnt, while 218 houses were not affected.

Selangor Deputy State Secretary (Development) and Director of the State Economic Planning Unit, Datuk Johary Anuar, has also been appointed to lead the Recovery Phase, including restoration methods for homes, roads, infrastructure, and public facilities.

Meanwhile, the Prime Minister's Political Secretary Datuk Azman Abidin expressed hope that more corporate companies would come forward to contribute to the victims to help ease their burden, despite various forms of assistance already provided by the government and related agencies.

He said that as of today, a total of RM1.4 million had been channelled to affected victims, including immediate aid from the Implementation Coordination Unit (ICU) of the Prime Minister's Department and initial assistance from Petronas.

In addition to financial assistance, victims are also receiving counselling support at the Local Social Support Centre established at the temporary evacuation centre (PPS) there.

Minister of Women, Family and Community Development Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said that a total of 253 victims have received counselling assistance at the Local Social Support Centre at the PPS.

Housing and Local Government Minister Nga Kor Ming is also reported to be meeting the Prime Minister today to discuss the best formula to assist the victims.

The Ministry of Health further informed that 41 out of the total 149 victims involved in this tragedy are still receiving treatment at hospitals and clinics. Of this number, 19 victims are being treated in general wards of government hospitals, while 22 are receiving care at private health facilities.

Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Razarudin Husain, meanwhile, said that aside from criminal elements and negligence, which are among the focuses of police investigation, other factors are also being considered in efforts to identify the cause of the incident, including the possibility of underground soil movement at the location. - BERNAMA

Subang Jaya: Sebanyak RM1.4 juta bantuan awal oleh kerajaan dan Petronas diserahkan kepada 219 mangsa tragedi kebakaran saluran paip gas di Jalan Putra Harmoni, Putra Heights di sini, semalam.

Setiasaha Politik Perdana Menteri Datuk Azman Abidin berkata, ia membabitkan jumlah RM5,000 kepada pemilik kediaman yang musnah sepenuhnya serta RM2,500 kepada mereka yang sedikit terjejas.

"Sumbangan ini sedikit-sebanyak dapat membantu mengurangkan beban mangsa dan keluarga mereka yang terjejas akibat tragedi itu, terutama umat Islam yang sedang menyambut hari raya Aidilfitri.

"Walaupun tiada kehilangan nyawa namun kemusnahan harta benda sangat besar. Kerajaan Madani, kerajaan negeri dan agensi berkaitan berusaha untuk membantu menyelesaikan masalah ini," katanya.

Beliau sebelum itu mewakili Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim menyerahkan sumbangan kepada 191 mangsa yang hadir pada majlis penyampaian sumbangan di Dewan Masyarakat, Putra Heights di sini.

Turut hadir Pegawai Daerah Petaling, Huzunul Khaidil Mohammed dan Datuk Bandar Subang Jaya Datuk Amirul Azizan Abd Rahim. Mengulas lanjut, Azman berkata, kerajaan amat mengalu-alukan

sumbangan pihak swasta dan syarikat korporat menerusi tanggungjawab sosial korporat (CSR) untuk membantu kesemua mangsa tragedi.

Beliau berharap lebih ramai pihak yang akan tam-

pil membantu mangsa.

Seorang penerima, Ahmad Baharudin Hamid, 56, bersyukur dengan bantuan yang diberikan kerajaan dan Petronas walaupun kerugian dialaminya mencecah RM2 juta.

Juruteria syarikat minyak dan gas itu berkata, ia dapat meringankan beban keluarganya bagi membaik pulih rumah serta kenderaan yang rosak teruk.

"Ketika ini, saya bersa-

ma isteri dan empat anak masih tinggal di PPS (pusat pemindahan sementara) kerana rumah kami sudah musnah sepenuhnya.

"Apabila ada bantuan ini dapatlah menampung kos pembaikan sedikit. Saya pun tidak tahu sampai bila akan tinggal di situ. Saya menantikan tindakan seterusnya daripada kerajaan dan pihak berkaitan mungkin ada bantuan melantik kontraktor atau bantuan kewangan lain," katanya.

Sementara itu, Ong Yaw Kern, 51, juga mengharapkan bantuan seterusnya daripada pihak bertanggungjawab dalam membaik pulih kediamannya yang musnah sepenuhnya.

Jangan pinggirkan OKU semasa meraikan lebaran

HARI Raya Aidilfitri adalah simbol kesyukuran, kemurahan, dan kekeluargaan. Namun, bagi Orang Kurang Upaya (OKU) dan keluarga mereka, perayaan ini seringkali dikelilingi cabaran yang mungkin mengasingkan mereka.

Menurut Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM), seramai 664,063 OKU berdaftar di Malaysia sehingga 2023.

Manakala Pertubuhan Kesihatan Sedunia (WHO) menganggarkan secara purata 12-15% jumlah penduduk sebuah negara tergolong dalam kategori OKU disebabkan pelbagai faktor dan risiko.

Ini menunjukkan kepentingan inklusiviti OKU semasa Hari Raya mahupun semasa semua musim perayaan utama dan peranan masyarakat dalam menyantuni mereka.

Juga, strategi ibu bapa untuk mendidik serta memperkasakan anak serta ahli keluarga mereka yang berstatus OKU melalui advokasi.

Hari Raya dan musim perayaan sering melibatkan suasana bising, rumah terbuka yang sesak, dan interaksi sosial yang intensif. Bagi OKU, terutama mereka dengan autisme atau gangguan deria, keadaan ini boleh mencetuskan tekanan.

Kajian Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (2020) mendapati 65% keluarga OKU mengelak menghadiri majlis kerana risiko *sensory overload*.

Selain itu, halangan fizikal seperti tangga di rumah tradisional dan sikap masyarakat yang kurang memahami turut menyukarkan penyertaan OKU.

Peranan Masyarakat: Langkah Praktikal Menyantuni OKU

1. Persekitaran Deria Mesra OKU

Masyarakat boleh mencipta ruang "zon tenang" di rumah terbuka untuk OKU yang memerlukan rehat.

Contohnya, komuniti di Singapura mengadakan rumah terbuka "senyap" semasa perayaan, dibantu oleh pertubuhan seperti Autism Resource Centre.

Di Malaysia, inisiatif seperti Program Hari Raya Inklusif oleh OKU Sentral menyarankan penggunaan lampu redup dan mengurangkan bunyi kuat.

2. Aksesibiliti Fizikal

Menurut Konvensyen mengenai Hak OKU (CRPD) yang diratifikasi Malaysia pada 2010, aksesibiliti adalah hak asasi.

Masyarakat boleh menyediakan laluan tanpa bertalangan di pintu masuk rumah dan lauan ke ruang tamu, atau menggunakan kerusi tambahan sebagai alternatif.

Perkara ini termasuklah kesediaan semua pihak untuk peka dan menyediakan penyediaan munasabah bagi membolehkan semua yang ada dapat meraikan musim perayaan dengan gembira dan harmoni denagn turut mengambil kira kemudahan ahli keluarga juga tetamu yang berstatus OKU.

Data JKM (2022) menunjukkan hanya 30% rumah OKU di Malaysia diubahsuai untuk aksesibiliti, menekankan perlunya kesedaran awam.

3. Pendidikan Sosial

Menggalakkan interaksi inklusif seperti melibatkan OKU dalam aktiviti sesuai, dengan suasana hari raya dan tahap keupayaan OKU yang terlibat sama ada sebagai sebahagian tuam rumah atau rombongan yang berzarah.

Program kesedaran yang dimulakan di sekolah dan tempat kerja ibu bapa atau individu OKU turut menampakkan kesan positif. Kajian UNESCO (2021) menunjukkan program kesedaran di sekolah mampu mengurangkan stigma terhadap OKU sebanyak 40%.

Ibu Bapa sebagai Agen Advokasi

Ibu bapa anak OKU memikul tanggungjawab besar untuk mendidik masyarakat. Antara strategi yang boleh diusahakan adalah dengan memberitahu ahli keluarga tentang keperluan anak dan ahli keluarga yang terlibat seperti meminta mereka mengurangkan bunyi kuat jika terdapat ciri sensitif deria.

Komunikasi berhemah dan berkesan diharapkan dapat membina pengalaman berharga ahli keluarga bersama dalam menyantuni OKU. Para ibu bapa juga boleh berkongsi infografik atau video tentang cara berinteraksi dengan OKU.

Para Ibubapa juga digalakkan menyertai komuniti dan persatuan yang berkaitan dengan kategori OKU anak dan ahli keluarga untuk sama-sama memberi dan mendapatkan sokongan dan sumber untuk advokasi.

Kajian melalui *Journal of Disability Studies* (2022) membuktikan ibu bapa yang aktif dalam NGO lebih berjaya membina empati komuniti.

Persatuan-persatuan ini lazim menyediakan sumber dan informasi dalam pelbagai format untuk menyokong aktiviti advokasi dan pemerkasaan komuniti OKU.

Hari Raya dan Musim Perayaan sebagai Platform Perubahan

Perayaan adalah masa ideal untuk mempromosikan inklusiviti kerana ia melibatkan semua lapisan masyarakat.

Di Jepun, festival tempatan menyediakan penterjemah bahasa isyarat, manakala di India, perayaan Deepavali diadaptasi dengan permainan inklusif.

Di Malaysia, kempen "Raya Untuk Semua" oleh Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita pada 2023 berjaya menarik 10,000 peserta, termasuk 2,000 OKU, menunjukkan potensi besar perayaan sebagai medium advokasi.

Hari Raya dan musim perayaan bukan sekadar meraikan tradisi, tetapi peluang emas untuk membina masyarakat yang lebih inklusif dan berempati.

Dalam konteks ini, suasana kemurahan yang merentasi agama, budaya, dan generasi menjadi medan efektif untuk mendidik masyarakat tentang kepelbagaian keupayaan.

Contohnya, di Jepun, Obon Festival (festival menyambut roh nenek moyang) menyediakan penterjemah bahasa isyarat dan papan maklumat bertulis Braille, membolehkan OKU pendengaran dan penglihatan turut serta dalam ritual penting ini.

Langkah ini bukan sahaja memudahkan akses, tetapi menunjukkan bahawa penglibatan OKU dalam masyarakat adalah hak, bukan keistimewaan.

Di India, semasa Deepavali, komuniti setempat memperkenalkan permainan inklusif seperti rangoli (seni corak berwarna) yang diadaptasi untuk kanak-kanak dengan paksi serebrum menggunakan alat bantu khas.

Aktiviti ini menggalakkan interaksi antara OKU dan bukan OKU, lantas menghindari stigma. Kajian oleh *Indian Journal of Community Psychology* (2022) mendapati 78% peserta bukan OKU melaporkan peningkatan pemahaman tentang cabaran harian OKU selepas menyertai program seumpama ini.

Di Malaysia, kempen "Raya Untuk Semua" wajar dilaksanakan bukan sekadar mengadakan rumah terbuka, tetapi merangka aktiviti berstruktur seperti:

1. Sesi Bercerita Inklusif: OKU dan keluarga mereka berkongsi pengalaman melalui platform interaktif, membantu masyarakat memahami keperluan unik mereka.
2. Bazaar Mesra OKU: Gerai jualan dikendalikan oleh usahawan OKU dengan bantuan relawan, mempromosikan kemandirian ekonomi sambil membina keyakinan masyarakat terhadap keupayaan OKU.
3. Simulasi Gangguan Deria: Pengunjung diajak mengalami simulasi *sensory overload* (seperti memakai fon telinga dengan bunyi bising) untuk merasai cabaran OKU autistik.

Kempen seperti ini mampu mewujudkan ruang interaksi dengan menggunakan pendekatan "belajar melalui pengalaman" (*experiential learning*) lebih berkesan dalam menanam empati berbanding ceramah konvensional.

Gabungan teknologi dan seni boleh dimanfaatkan untuk memperluas impak dan meningkatkan empati. Contohnya, penggunaan *augmented reality* (AR) untuk mensimulasikan pengalaman OKU dalam aktiviti tradisi seperti menyediakan hidangan Raya.

Di Sweden, projek *Empathy Mirror* menggunakan AR untuk menunjukkan bagaimana individu dengan disleksia melihat tulisan, menarik perhatian 500,000 pengguna dalam tempoh sebulan.

Di Malaysia, inisiatif seperti "Raya Tanpa Sempadan" oleh Persatuan OKU Johor menggunakan aplikasi mudah alih untuk mengajar bahasa isyarat asas semasa kunjungan rumah, merapatkan komunikasi dan meningkatkan empati melambangkan inklusiviti.

Selain itu, kerjasama strategik dengan influencer media sosial mampu menyemarakkan mesej inklusiviti.

Sebagai contoh inisiatif kempen #RayaBersamaOKU menampilkan kisah kegembiraan OKU menyambut hari raya dengan kasih sayang keluarga dan masyarakat sekaling dengan penglibatan OKU dari pelbagai bidang termasuk dalam seni dan keusahawanan.

Pendekatan ini bukan sahaja meningkatkan kesedaran, tetapi turut mengubah naratif masyarakat daripada melihat OKU sebagai "penerima bantuan" kepada "agen perubahan".

Perkara ini boleh dijayakan dengan penglibatan dan sokongan pelbagai pihak yang sedar OKU juga boleh menjadi ahli masyarakat yang menyumbang kepada pembangunan Malaysia yang kita cintai jika ruang yang dan peluang yang tepat dan beresuaian diberikan.

Peluang ini harus dimanfaatkan semua pihak dan lapisan masyarakat. Musim perayaan adalah detik di mana nilai kemanusiaan dan keiktian berada di puncaknya.

Dengan merangka aktiviti yang menggabungkan pendidikan, pengalaman langsung dengan penglibatan OKU dalam aktiviti berzarah dan teknologi, masyarakat bukan sahaja dapat "meraikan" OKU, tetapi secara proaktif membina dunia yang mengiktiraf kepelbagaian sebagai kekuatan.

Inklusiviti OKU adalah kewajiban moral masyarakat yang harus di lihat sebagai pelaburan untuk masyarakat harmoni. Dengan langkah praktikal, kesedaran melalui pendidikan dan sokongan kepada ibu bapa, Hari Raya boleh menjadi pemangkin perubahan kerana semua insan layak untuk bergembira dan merasa diraikan.

COMMENT | Don't sweep child marriage under the carpet

COMMENT | I must laud former MP Kasthuri Patto for reminding Malaysians that child marriage still persists in our country despite being a hot topic of discussion during the first Pakatan Harapan administration.

As a young female lawyer from Sabah I would like to echo her call for the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry to table a progress report on the National Strategy Plan in Handling the Causes of Child Marriage.

While the demand for transparency is commendable, the bigger issue remains—why are we still tolerating child marriage at all? The government's slow and fragmented approach to reform is failing to protect vulnerable children, and urgent, decisive action is needed before more lives are irreversibly affected.

Yes, we have made incremental progress in reducing child marriage numbers but that does not change the fact that it remains legal in many states. Reports and strategies may give the illusion of action, but they mean little if children continue to be married off due to legal loopholes, economic hardships, and societal pressures.

The time for gradual reform is over—it is time for Malaysia to impose an outright ban on child marriage with no exceptions.

Incremental progress not enough

The plan, introduced in 2020, was supposed to tackle the root causes of child marriage. While it outlines education programmes, poverty alleviation measures, and awareness campaigns, its effectiveness remains highly questionable.

The plan was mooted when Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail was helming the women's ministry and Hannah Yeoh was her deputy. Since then the government has changed hands on three occasions and I wonder if a lack of continuity is to blame for a lack of linear progress.

Statistics showing declines in child marriage applications in certain states do not reflect a nationwide success as many states continue to permit it under existing religious and customary laws.

The reality is that other countries, including several Muslim-majority nations, have successfully enacted outright bans on child marriage. Neighbours Indonesia raised the minimum marriage age for girls to 19 in 2019, despite facing similar cultural and religious considerations.

If Indonesia can do it, why is Malaysia dragging its feet?

Under existing laws, Muslim girls can marry as young as 16 with a judge's permission, and non-Muslims can do so with the approval of the chief minister or menteri besar. This patchwork legal framework allows child marriage to persist despite growing awareness of its harms.

Yet, many Muslim-majority nations, including Saudi Arabia, Egypt, and Bangladesh, have taken steps to curb or eliminate child marriage by raising the legal age of marriage to 18 or higher. This proves that religious and cultural considerations do not have to be barriers to legal reform.

Children become vulnerable

The consequences of child marriage are well-documented, yet the government continues to treat the issue as a policy debate rather than an ongoing human rights violation.

Child brides are at significantly higher risk of domestic violence, early pregnancy complications, and mental health struggles. Many are pulled out of school, trapping them in cycles of poverty and dependency.

Instead of prioritising protection and enforcement, I am sorry to say that the government's approach remains reactive—monitoring numbers rather than implementing a clear legal ban.

How many more child brides must endure abuse and lost opportunities before Malaysia enforces the change it claims to support?

Education and community engagement are necessary to shift mindsets, but legal change must come first. It is only when child marriage is completely outlawed that societal attitudes will begin to align with modern human rights standards.

I implore our minister Nancy Shukri to take bold action on this matter.

Economic solutions

Poverty is one of the strongest drivers of child marriage. Many families marry off their daughters because they believe it provides financial security or reduces their economic burden. This is why tackling the root economic causes of child marriage is crucial in any effort to eradicate it.

However, existing financial aid programmes in Malaysia do not go far enough. Many vulnerable families still lack access to sustained economic support, education subsidies, and vocational training opportunities that could provide alternatives to early marriage.

The government must implement stronger financial support initiatives, particularly for rural and marginalised communities, ensuring that no child is married off due to economic desperation.

Most importantly, child protection should not be subject to debate or gradual reform. It is a fundamental human right. Malaysia must stop compromising on this issue and take an unequivocal stand against child marriage once and for all.

A country's commitment to human rights is measured by how it protects its most vulnerable members. Malaysia cannot claim to prioritise children's rights while still permitting child marriage in any form.

The time for discussions and reports is over—it is time for Malaysia to take decisive, irreversible action. The longer we wait, the more children will pay the price.

Mangsa banjir di Johor terus meningkat

KUALA LUMPUR: Situasi banjir di Johor terus menyaksikan peningkatan jumlah mangsa yang dipindahkan ke pusat pemindahan sementara (PPS) manakala di Sabah kekal seperti sebelumnya setakat pagi ini.

Di JOHOR, Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Negeri (JPBN) Tan Sri Dr Azmi Rohani memaklumkan daerah Batu Pahat mencatatkan peningkatan jumlah mangsa kepada 326 orang daripada 108 keluarga setakat 8 pagi berbanding 285 daripada 94 keluarga pada 4 petang semalam.

Beliau berkata kesemua mangsa yang terdiri penduduk Kampung Baharu Sri Gading itu ditempatkan di PPS Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Seri Gading.

"Paras air Sungai Senggarang di Batu Pahat kini berada pada tahap amaran iaitu 3.35 meter manakala Sungai Batu Pahat mencatatkan bacaan 2.30 meter iaitu pada paras waspada," katanya dalam satu kenyataan hari ini.

Beberapa daerah turut dilaporkan hujan pagi ini, termasuk Muar, Segamat, Kluang, Batu Pahat, Tangkak dan Kulai manakala cuaca mendung di Johor Bahru, Mersing, Pontian dan Kota Tinggi.

Sementara itu, di SABAH, jumlah mangsa banjir di daerah Kinabatangan yang berlindung di PPS Sekolah Kebangsaan (SK) Bukit Garam kekal 138 orang daripada 30 keluarga pagi ini sejak malam tadi.

Sekretariat JPBN Sabah dalam kenyataan memaklumkan empat kampung terjejas akibat bencana itu.

Pada 2 April, Kinabatangan yang terletak kira-kira 306 kilometer timur dari Kota Kinabalu diisytihar sebagai kawasan bencana banjir susulan hujan berterusan dan kenaikan paras air sungai pada tahap bahaya.

Soldier claims trial to punching female driver

SERANIBAN: A 35-year-old serviceman claimed trial in the Magistrates Court hereto a charge of punching a female driver following a minor traffic incident.

Abdul Hafiz Abu Bakar, who is with the army, pleaded not guilty after the charge was read to him before magistrate Syed Farid Syed Ali.

He was charged with committing the offence against the 28-year-old woman at 10.20pm on March 29 at Taman Satria Senawang.

Abdul Hafiz was charged with voluntarily causing hurt under Section 323 of the Penal Code, which carries a jail term of up to one year, a maximum fine of 0 to 000 both upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Nadia Ezzati Mohd Zainal asked the court to set bail at RM2,000 pending a remission.

However, the accused, represented by Chrysandy Lai from the Legal Aid Department, requested a lower bail. She said the accused was not a flight risk as he held a permanent job.

she added the accused also had to provide for his two young children.

Syed Farid then set bail at RM2,000 in one surety and fixed May 19 for remission.

According to media reports, the victim suffered bruises on her right rib and swelling on the back of her head due to the alleged assault.

The incident occurred when the woman, who was driving a car, was punched by the soldier.

Soldier denies punching woman

SEREMBAN: A soldier pleaded not guilty in the Magistrate's Court here yesterday to voluntarily causing hurt to a woman driver by punching her head following a road collision.

Abdul Hafis Abu Bakar, 35, is charged with committing the offence against Syairah Md Sharom, 28, at Taman Satria in Senawang at 10.20pm on March 29.

The charge, framed under Section 323 of the Penal Code, provides up to one year's jail, a maximum fine of RM2,000, or both upon conviction.

Magistrate Syed Farid Syed Ali granted bail at RM2,000 with one surety and set May 19 for mention. —Bernama

SOLDIER CLAIMS TRIAL TO ASSAULTING FEMALE DRIVER

He is charged with voluntarily causing hurt, granted bail

A SOLDIER pleaded not guilty here yesterday to a charge of assaulting a woman driver.

Abdul Hafiz Abu Bakar, 35, claimed trial when the charge

was read to him before magistrate Syed Farid Syed Ali.

According to the charge, the accused had punched the 28-year-old woman in the head in Taman Satria, Senawang, about 10.20pm on March 29.

Hafiz faces a charge of voluntarily causing hurt, which carries a penalty of up to one year in prison or a maximum fine of RM2,000.

Deputy public prosecutor Nadia Ezzati Mohd Zainal proposed bail of RM2,000 with one surety and requested a mention date for further proceedings.

Chrysandy Lai, a lawyer from the National Legal Aid Foundation representing the accused, requested lower bail on the grounds that the accused is supporting two young children, his parents and his wife.

The court granted bail at RM2,000 with one surety.

May 19 was fixed for case mention for the submission of documents and a full medical report.

A video showing a female driver being punched by a man in

Senawang has gone viral.

The incident is believed to have occurred after the man became angry, claiming that his child was knocked over by the driver of a Perodua Axia car while crossing the street.

Man arrested on suspicion of abducting disabled girl

HELAKA: Police have arrested a man suspected of abducting a disabled girl with learning difficulties, who was reported missing in Taman Ramba Idaman here on April 5.

Melaka Tengah police chief ACP Christopher Patit said the 40-year-old suspect, who was driving a Perodua Kelisa, was detained at around 10am yesterday by the side of Jalan Jati in Sungai Petani, Kedah.

Initial investigations revealed

that the suspect admitted to taking the 17-year-old victim in the car to drive around areas including Seremban, Ipoh, Bukit Menajam, and then to his village in Baling.

"Further checks found no illegal items in the car of the suspect, who is a trader residing in Melaka," he said in a statement.

Christopher added that the victim did not know the suspect and an initial physical

examination revealed that the girl did not suffer any injury.

According to him, the suspect has a criminal record under Section 13(i) of the Dangerous Drugs Act.

The case is being investigated under Section B3 of the Penal Code for kidnapping.

On Sunday, media reports stated that the disabled teenager had gone missing after leaving her house to play at a nearby playground — and her name
