## Growing challenges faced by the young

Minister: Mental health issues among kids and teens a serious concern, no longer an adult thing

**KUCHING:** Mental health issues are no longer confined to adults but are increasingly affecting children and teenagers, raising serious concerns about their well-being, said Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

Speaking at the Program Jelajah Kasih Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) and back-to-school donation event by the National Welfare Foundation (YKN) here yesterday, the Women, Family, and Community Development Minister highlighted the growing challenges faced by the younger generation.

"The world today presents many challenges. Mental health issues are not just affecting adults but are also worrying trends among children and teenagers," she said.

"This can be attributed to factors such as family problems, academic pressure, and environmental influences," she said, adding that if left unaddressed, these stressors could have long-term effects on children's well-being.

She emphasised the role of the PSSS initiative in providing crucial support for those in need. "Sometimes when we are stressed, we don't know where to turn for help. That is why the PSSS initiative exists—to ensure our communities have a safe space to seek assistance and support without stigma."

The PSSS programme, which offers professional and registered counselling services,

advocacy sessions, and mental health awareness initiatives, has both static and mobile units to reach wider communities across Sarawak and the country.

Yesterday's event at Mydin Vista Tunku witnessed 460 schoolchildren receive school supplies through the back-to-school donation programme, aimed at easing the financial burden on families while motivating students to start the new academic year with confidence.

In this regard, Nancy called on corporate and private organisations to support such social initiatives, adding that YKN provides tax exemption receipts for contributions to encourage participation.

"As we prepare the younger generation for the future, we must ensure they have access to not only education but also mental health support.

"Education is the key to a brighter future, and we must equip our children with the right resources and emotional resilience to succeed," she said.

In December year, Deputy Health Minister Datuk Lukanisman Awang Sauni told the Dewan Rakyat that the ministry will introduce the Child

and Adolescent Mental Health Action Plan this year to tackle growing mental health issues among the youth.

He said based on statistics from the National Health and Morbidity Survey, mental health problems among school and tertiary education students had doubled from 7.9 per cent (424,000) in 2019 to 16.5 per cent (922,318) in 2023.

He added that the ministry was also working to increase the number of child and adolescent psychiatrists to 30 by 2027, up from the current 18.

## Khidmat kaunseling, sokongan mental penting

**KUCHING:** Lebih 3,000 individu di seluruh Malaysia telah mendapatkan khidmat kaunseling menerusi Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) setakat ini.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat Dato Sri Nancy Shukri berkata, daripada jumlah itu, lebih 1,000 individu dari Sarawak dengan kebanyakan mereka terdiri daripada golongan wanita berusia lingkungan 20 hingga 45 tahun.

Menurutnya, angka ini membuktikan bahawa perkhidmatan kaunseling dan sokongan mental seperti yang disediakan oleh PSSS amat diperlukan dalam masyarakat.

"Malah, kita juga sudah mula bawa program PSSS ini ke hospital dan dalam masa sejam kita buka, sudah ada 96 pegawai dan kakitangan hospital yang datang untuk mengadu masalah tekanan mental yang mereka hadapi.

"Mungkin mereka lebih selesa untuk berjumpa dengan kaunselor kita, jadi ini menunjukkan khidmat ini juga diperlukan di situ," katanya pada sidang media selepas menyempurnakan program Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) 'Kamek Nengar Kamek Nulung' dan Sumbangan Back To School Sesi Persekolahan 2025 di sini, semalam.

Nancy turut menyuarakan kebimbangan terhadap trend tekanan mental dalam kalangan remaja, termasuk pelajar sekolah yang mula mencederakan diri sendiri.

Beliau berkata, lebih membimbangkan apabila terdapat remaja yang mula mencederakan diri sendiri sebagai cara untuk melepaskan tekanan.

"Kita tidak mahu perbuatan menyalur pergelangan tangan

menjadi satu trend normal dalam masyarakat.

"Oleh itu, campur tangan segera diperlukan bagi membantu mereka mengatasi masalah ini sebelum menjadi lebih serius," ujarnya.

Jelasnya, ketika program PSSS diadakan di Santubong baru-baru ini, ramai pelajar sekolah hadir sendiri untuk mendapatkan kaunseling.

"Ini membuktikan bahawa tekanan mental bukan hanya dialami oleh

golongan dewasa tetapi juga kanak-kanak dan remaja dan oleh itu, ia perlu ditangani dengan segera.

"Kita sudah mendengar laporan kes bunuh diri di Semenanjung sebelum ini. Kita tidak mahu perkara ini menjadi kebiasaan di mana-mana sahaja di Malaysia," kata Ahli Parlimen Santubong itu.

Sehubungan itu, Nancy berkata Yayasan Kebajikan Negara (YKN) akan terus memperluaskan khidmat ini dengan memperkenalkan perkhidmatan PSSS bergerak untuk menjangkau lebih ramai individu di seluruh negara.

## 'Over 3,000 sought counselling through PSSS in first year'

**KUCHING:** More than 3,000 individuals across Malaysia have sought counselling services through the Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) since its inception a year ago, according to Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

The Women, Family, and Community Development Minister highlighted the growing demand for mental health support, particularly among frontline workers and students.

"In Sarawak alone, over 1,000 individuals have reached out for help. We have expanded our services to hospitals, where healthcare personnel, including doctors and nurses, often feel more comfortable speaking with our professional counsellors rather than their in-house counterparts," she said.

Speaking at a press conference after officiating the 'Program Jelajah Kasih PSSS' and back-to-school donation event by the National Welfare Foundation (YKN) here yesterday, she noted a significant response when PSSS services were introduced at

a hospital recently.

"Within just one hour, 96 individuals sought counselling, including medical professionals. This proves the urgent need for such support," she added.

Nancy also pointed out that the initiative now includes mobile PSSS units, allowing teams to reach underserved areas.

"For instance in Lundu yesterday (Feb 8), 20 out of 96 attendees came forward seeking help. Even school students were engaging with our counsellors, revealing a wide range of issues they were facing."

The minister stressed that mental health concerns, especially among teenagers, should not be ignored.

"We must intervene early to prevent cases that could lead to self-harm. While we've heard of such incidents reported in Peninsular Malaysia, we do not want them to become common anywhere in the country," she said.

With the increasing demand for mental health support,

Nancy reaffirmed the ministry's commitment to expanding PSSS services nationwide.

"We are doing our best to help as many people as possible because mental health is just as important as physical well-being," she added.

On another note, she acknowledged that cases of sexual harassment involving male victims have been reported to the Anti-Sexual Harassment Tribunal.

However, she said some victims hesitate to proceed due to concerns over privacy.

"We urge men to come forward as their identities will be protected," she assured.

Meanwhile, the back-to-school initiative conducted in collaboration with YKN has benefited 680 students in Sarawak, with additional reserves set aside for further distribution.

The programme, which has been expanded this year, aims to provide essential school supplies while integrating PSSS outreach efforts.

## Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat diperluas ke setiap negeri

**Kuching:** Seramai 3,000 individu menerima manfaat menerusi program Pusat Sokongan Sosial Setempat (PSSS) tahun lalu.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, berkata kementeriaannya menerusi Yayasan Kebajikan Negara (YKN) akan terus memperluas usaha itu di setiap negeri tahun ini.

“Kita mula bawa program PSSS ini ke hospital dan dalam masa sejam selepas PSSS dibuka, seramai 96 pegawai dan kakitangan hospital datang.

“Mungkin mereka lebih selesa untuk berjumpa kaunselor kita

dan ini menunjukkan perkhidmatan sangat diperlukan di situ,” katanya pada sidang media selepas program PSSS dan sambutan Kembali Ke Sekolah 2025, di sini semalam.

Nancy turut menekankan masalah kesihatan mental kini tidak hanya membabitkan golongan dewasa, malah turut memberi kesan kepada pelajar yang mengalami tekanan akibat masalah keluarga, pembelajaran atau persekitaran.

“Kita tidak mahu masalah seperti menggelar tangan dan isu kesihatan mental menjadi sesuatu yang dianggap normal dalam

kalangan pelajar dan masyarakat.

“Kami akan terus bertindak dan membantu mereka dengan menganjurkan program bersama seperti ini,” katanya.

PSSS adalah program anjuran Yayasan Kebajikan Negara yang menawarkan perkhidmatan psikososial holistik kepada masyarakat seperti sesi bimbingan dan kaunseling.

Terdahulu, Nancy memberi sumbangan kepada 460 murid sekolah dari kawasan Parlimennya iaitu Batang Sadong, Santubong dan sekitar Kuching.

## 3,000 benefited from mobile counselling initiative

## FEDERAL AND MELAKA GOVERNMENTS CHANNEL RM135.413 MLN AID UNDER STATE JKM

MELAKA, Feb 6 (Bernama) -- The Federal and Melaka governments allocated a total of RM135.413 million last year to channel aid to recipients in the state under the Melaka Social Welfare Department (JKM).

State Women's Affairs, Family Development and Welfare Committee chairman Datuk Kalsom Nordin said the total covered 28,609 recipients eligible for monthly assistance throughout the year.

"This includes an allocation of RM16.18 million by the Melaka government, specifically for the people in this state, which includes monthly financial aid, festive contributions, milk aid for the bedridden and adult diapers, involving 5,210 recipients.

"The rest is from the Federal Government, such as allowances for workers with disabilities, care for the disabled and chronically ill, children and the elderly," she told reporters here today.

Earlier, she was a guest on the "Temu Bual Eksklusif Program Wakil Rakyat Untuk Rakyat (W.R.U.R)" segment on MELAKA fm, which was also attended by Melaka Broadcasting Department director Siti Norbaini Khairi.

Kalsom also said that 93 programmes are set to be held during the two-week W.R.U.R programme at the Pengkalan Batu State Legislative Assembly from Monday (Feb 10).

"The implementation of this programme, which ends on Feb 23, also has the cooperation of various departments and agencies, besides the Pengkalan Batu State Assembly Development and Coordination Committee (Japerun)," she said.

Di SARAWAK, Sekretariat Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Sarawak memaklumkan jumlah mangsa banjir berkurangan kepada 1,877 orang daripada 2,465 mangsa pagi tadi dengan ditempatkan di 14 PPS berbanding 16 PPS sebelum ini.

Menurut kenyataan itu, jumlah mangsa di Bintulu ialah 862 orang berbanding 1,099 pagi tadi manakala di Mukah pula menyaksikan sebanyak 602 mangsa berbanding 605 sebelumnya.

Situasi sama dicatatkan di Sibul apabila merekodkan 92 mangsa berbanding 423 pagi tadi manakala di Miri, sebanyak 321 mangsa berbanding 338 sebelumnya.

Dua PPS ditutup setakat petang ini iaitu PPS Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Cina Tong Ah Selangau dan Dewan Serbaguna Selangau, kedua-duanya di Sibul.

Di SABAH, Sekretariat Jawatankuasa Pengurusan Bencana Negeri Sabah memaklumkan jumlah mangsa banjir kekal kepada 989 orang daripada 308 keluarga setakat 4 petang ini berbanding 989 daripada 305 keluarga pagi tadi.

Menurut kenyataan, kemasukan baharu mangsa banjir ke PPS menyebabkan jumlah mangsa di Sabah kekal seperti di Beaufort terdapat 538 mangsa, Kinabatangan (275) dan Membakut (176) manakala di Tambunan, kesemua mangsa telah dibenarkan pulang ke rumah masing-masing selepas banjir di kawasan itu surut sepenuhnya.

## More flood evacuees in Sabah

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The number of flood evacuees in Sabah continues to rise, while Sarawak has recorded a decline in the number of people seeking shelter at temporary relief centres yesterday.

In Sabah, the state Disaster Management Committee Secretariat said as of 8am yesterday, the number of evacuees had increased to 989 from 305 families, up from 721 individuals from 212 families.

Membakut, which was hit by floods yesterday, has evacuated 160 people from 53 families to a relief centre.

Meanwhile, in Sarawak, the number of evacuees has dropped to 2,465 from 3,082, with 16 relief centres still in operation as of 8am.

According to the state Disaster Management Committee Secretariat, the Bintulu Division recorded a significant decrease, with the number of evacuees dropping to 1,099 from 1,775. – Bernama

Menteri Pendidikan, Fadhlina Sidek, berkata pihaknya kini masih mendapatkan dan mengumpul data terperinci berhubung kanak-kanak berkenaan.

"Jadi, sebaik sahaja selesai proses itu (kes mahkamah) semua, saya ingat mereka tak ada masalah untuk mereka ke sekolah dan teruskan sesi persekolahan," katanya.
