KUALA LUMPUR, 20 Februari- Pelbagai inisiatif dirangka Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) menerusi Lembaga Penduduk dan Pembangunan Keluarga Negara (LPPKN) untuk meningkatkan kadar kelahiran negara.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri berkata LPPKN telah mengadakan program galakan perkahwinan seperti Majlis Resepsi Mahligai Cinta untuk pasangan terpilih.

"Kita juga menawarkan perkhidmatan persekitaran yang boleh membantu pasangan membuat keputusan seperti perkhidmatan perancangan keluarga dan pelaksanaan program pembangunan keluarga menerusi modul Smart Start praperkawhinan," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika menjawab soalan daripada Ahli Parlimen Permatang Pauh Muhammad Fawwaz Mohamad Jan berkenaan langkah untuk meningkatkan kadar kelahiran negara dan inisiatif dalam menggalakkan rakyat agar menambah bilangan anak.

Nancy juga memaklumkan bahawa modul berkenaan berperanan memberi kemahiran dan pengetahuan kepada pasangan yang bercadang mendirikan rumah tangga.

Total fertility rate in Malaysia has declined since 2013 — Nancy

KUALA LUMPUR: The total fertility rate (TFR) in Malaysia has been on a downward trend since 2013, the Dewan Rakyat was told yesterday.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri highlighted that according to the 2024 ESCAP Population Data Insights, most Asia-Pacific countries now have a TFR below the replacement fertility level of 2.1.

"Over the past 15 years, Malaysia's highest TFR was 2.2 in 2011 and 2012. Since then, we've observed a declining trend.

"However, for the first time during this period, the TFR increased by 0.1 to 1.7 in 2023, up from 1.6 the previous year," she said during the oral question-and-answer session.

She was responding to Muhammad Fawwaz Mohamad Jan (PN-Permatang Pauh) who asked about the ministry's strategies to address the declining birth rate and initiatives to encourage larger families.

Nancy said various factors contribute to Malaysia's declining TFR, including economic challenges, lifestyle choices, delayed marriages, and infertility issues.

She added that the ministry, through the National Population and Family Development Board (LPPKN), is actively implementing initiatives to address this decline.

Among the initiatives are the marriage encouragement programme, family planning services, and fertility-related services. — Bernama

Child labour still rife in M'sia

NGO calls for establishment of multi-stakeholder working committee involving government agencies, child protection advocates, and industry leaders committed to country's future to tackle problem.

Child labour persists despite high-income ambitions

PETALING JAYA: While Malaysia aims to become a high-income nation as early as 2028, its labour laws still permit child exploitation, said Child Rights Innovation and Betterment Foundation co-chairperson Srividhya Ganapathy. "The Children and Young Persons (Employment) Act 1966 allows certain forms of child labour, contradicting Malaysia's commitments to international human rights conventions and socioeconomic progress," she said. "We ratified the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) in 1995, obliging the government to align national laws with the convention's standards. The UNCRC, alongside Malaysia's Child Act 2001, defines a child as anyone under 18 and guarantees their rights

to protection, education and healthcare. Yet outdated labour laws still allow children to work, particularly in agriculture and informal sectors." Srividhya noted that while the 12th Malaysia Plan focuses on inclusive socioeconomic development, digital economy growth and sustainability, child labour remains legal. "How can we speak of these goals when our laws still permit child labour?" She referred to government data from 2018, which estimated that 33,600 children aged five to 17 worked in Malaysia's oil palm sector,

with Sabah accounting for 58.8%. No recent data has been released, raising concerns about transparency and policy effectiveness. "We have embraced Industry 4.0, yet some of our children, especially those from marginalised communities, are being left behind," she said. She added that the 1966 Act was introduced when Malaysia was still recovering from colonial rule and war, making it ill-suited for today's digital age. The law does not apply to Sabah and Sarawak, where separate labour ordinances govern child labour,

further complicating nationwide enforcement. Srividhya also highlighted data from Unesco's Institute of Statistics, which put Malaysia's literacy rate at 94.64%. However, the 2022 Programme for International Student Assessment report showed one of the world's sharpest declines in reading, mathematics, and science scores. "Children forced into work lose their right to education, play and protection. They take on adult roles and are exposed to abuse, neglect and pressures no child should endure," she said. She acknowledged that for many families, child labour is a matter of survival. She urged the government to enact the Social Work Profession Bill to improve welfare services and protect vulnerable children. She also called for a multi-stakeholder working committee to tackle child labour. "We need collaboration between government agencies, child protection advocates and industry leaders committed to Malaysia's future," she said. Lim Wei Jun knows the reality of child labour firsthand. At age 12, he spent his mornings wiping tables and washing dishes at a kopitiam in Kuala Lumpur while his parents ran a small hawker stall nearby. "They struggled to make ends meet, so I was expected to help," he said. Lim always longed to study and escape poverty, but his parents prioritised his four younger siblings' education. Now 30, he works as a kitchen helper in another restaurant in Kuala Lumpur, stuck in the same cycle of low-paying jobs. "If I had a good education, I could have achieved something better. Maybe I could have become a teacher or worked in an office, but I never had that chance," he said.

Mangsa banjir di Pahang naik, Negeri Sembilan menurun

Kuala Lumpur: Jumlah mangsa banjir di Pahang meningkat, manakala di Negeri Sembilan menurun, pagi ini.

Di **PAHANG**, mangsa banjir terus meningkat kepada 178 orang daripada 54 keluarga berbanding 121 orang daripada 33 keluarga, malam tadi.

Menurut portal InfoBencana Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM), sebanyak 150 orang ditempatkan di Pusat Pemindahan Sementara (PPS) Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Karak Setia, Bentong manakala 28 lagi di PPS Sekolah Kebangsaan Lanchang, Temerloh.

Di **NEGERI SEMBILAN**, mangsa banjir di Jelebu merekodkan 101 orang daripada 27 keluarga berlindung di PPS Dewan D'Sury, pagi ini berbanding 110 orang, malam tadi.

Pegawai Pertahanan Awam Daerah Jelebu Leftenan (PA) Mohd Najib Abdul Karim berkata, kesemua mangsa adalah penduduk Ladang Jelebu, Taman Pekan Baru, Taman Bandar Tinggi dan Kampung Sepri, Chennai yang terdiri daripada sembilan individu warga emas, 53 dewasa, 35 kanak-kanak serta empat bayi lelaki.

"Keadaan cuaca pada masa ini baik. Paras air di kawasan sungai berdekatan juga semakin surut. Kerja-kerja pascapembersihan akan dilakukan oleh pasukan Skuad Madani," katanya dalam kenyataan, hari ini.

Katanya, operasi menyelamatkan mangsa banjir membabitkan 17 anggota Angkatan Pertahanan Awam, bomba (10), polis (13), Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (lima) dan Rejimen Askar Melayu Diraja (lapan).

“Mohon doakan kesejahteraan anak sulung saya, dia sedang tenat. Semoga ada keajaiban untuknya.”

Begitu rayuan Mohamad Fakhruddin Mohamad Fikri, 35, bapa kepada kanak-kanak lelaki Mohamad Fahmi, 10, yang kritikal sejak Selasa lalu dipercayai tercekik gula-gula *gummy* mata.

Mohamad Fakhruddin berkata, kali terakhir dia dan isteri dapat melihat anaknya di Unit Rawatan Rapi Pediatrik (PICU) Hospital Pulau Pinang (HPP) pada 8.30 pagi tadi dan sudah berjumpa dengan doktor.

Menurutnya, Muhamad Fahmi masih tidak menunjukkan perkembangan dan doktor sedang berusaha merawatnya.

“Doktor beritahu pasukannya sedang berusaha merawat dan jika tiada perkembangan, mereka akan hentikan pemberian ubat bagi melihat perkembangan seterusnya.”

“Luluh hati saya, seorang anak yang ceria tiba-tiba dalam keadaan begini. Pada masa ini, kami sekeluarga hanya mampu berdoa dan berserah kepada kuasa Allah SWT.”

“Tragedi yang menimpa anak sulung kami amat mengejutkan, kami tiada daya menghalangnya,” katanya ketika ditemui di pekarangan HPP bersama isteri, Noraini Mohamad Isa, 37 dan adiknya, Siti Farhanah, 33, semalam.

‘Doakan anak saya, dia tenat’

berkata, sejak anaknya dipindahkan ke PICU HPP dari Hospital Seberang Jaya, dia tidak pulang ke rumah dan tidak berganjak dari ruang menunggu bagi menunggu khabar gembira.

Menurutnya, dia cuba lelap seketika, namun terjaga apabila terdengar seolah-olah Muhamad Fahmi memanggilnya.

“Betul dan jelas kedengaran Muhamad Fahmi panggil saya, ‘baba’, seketika kemudian baru terседar ia hanya mimpi atau perasaan saya.”

“Kelmarin (Selasa lalu), Muhamad Fahmi beritahu tidak mahu ke Kelas al-Quran dan Fardu Ain (KAFA) kerana keletihan. Saya sangka itu hanya perkara

biasa tambahan sesi persekolahan baharu sahaja bermula.

“Sebelum ini, ibunya menghantar ke kelas dan tidak sangka semalam pertemuan akhir kami. Sebelum masuk ke kelas, dia paling muka melihat saya dan pandangan matanya buat saya teringat sampai sekarang,” katanya.

Wanita mengaku salah bantu suami noda sepupu

Kuala Terengganu: Seorang suri rumah mengaku bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen, di sini, semalam atas pertuduhan bersubahat dengan suaminya dalam kejadian rogol memabitkan sepupunya, awal bulan ini.

Wanita berusia 29 tahun membuat pengakuan selepas pertuduhan dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Mohd Zul Zakiqudin Zulkifli.

Mengikut pertuduhan, tertuduh didakwa bersubahat dengan suaminya yang berusia 25 tahun merogol mangsa berusia 15 tahun enam bulan di rumah di Marang antara jam 7.30 malam hingga 1 pagi pada 8 hingga 9 Februari lalu.

Tertuduh yang didakwa mengikut Seksyen 109 Kanun Keseksaan dan dibaca bersama Seksyen 376 (2)(c) kanun sama, yang berdepan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan, jika sabit kesalahan.

Sementara itu, di mah-

kamah sama, suami tertuduh bekerja sebagai bu-ruh mengaku tidak bersalah atas pertuduhan merogol mangsa yang juga sepupu kepada isterinya.

Kesalahan itu dilakukan lelaki terbabit dalam kehadiran orang lain iaitu isterinya di alamat, masa dan hari yang sama.

Dia yang didakwa mengikut Seksyen 376 (2)(c) Kanun Keseksaan berdepan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan, jika sabit kesalahan.

Sejurus pengakuan bersalah, mahkamah menetapkan 25 Februari depan sebagai tarikh sebutan semula kes untuk fakta dan hukuman.

Mahkamah turut membenarkan ibu kepada tiga anak terbabit diikat jamin RM10,000 dengan seorang penjamin.

Bagi tertuduh lelaki, mahkamah menetapkan 23 Mac depan sebagai tarikh sebutan semula kes dan tiada sebarang jaminan ditawarkan.

FACES 20 YEARS' JAIL

Woman admits to helping husband rape underage cousin

KUALA TERENGGANU: A 29-year-old woman pleaded guilty at the Sessions Court here to abetting her husband in the rape of her underage cousin.

The woman allegedly assisted her 25-year-old husband in raping the 15-year-old at a house in Marang between 7.30pm on Feb 8 and 1am the next day.

The charge was read out before judge Mohd Zul Zakiquidin Zulkifli.

The woman faces a prison sentence of up to 20 years.

The court set Feb 25 for sentencing.

The woman was allowed RM10,000 bail with one surety.

In the same court, the woman's husband, who works as a labourer, pleaded not guilty to the rape charge.

The offence was allegedly committed by the man in the presence of his wife.

If found guilty, the man faces a jail term of up to 20 years and whipping.

The court fixed March 23 for procedural issues to be settled. No bail was offered.
