## Jangan kongsi, sebar video kanak-kanak mangsa cabul: Nancy

**IPOH:** Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri meminta orang ramai dan pengguna media sosial tidak sewenang-wenang berkongsi video mangsa cabul di sebuah masjid di Batang Kali, Hulu Selangor pada 21 Februari lepas.

Nancy berkata, kanak-kanak perempuan yang menjadi mangsa itu dilindungi di bawah Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 dan perbuatan menyebarkan serta berkongsi video berkenaan adalah tidak wajar.

“Hari-hari kita bercakap tentang hal ini, masih juga terjadi. Kita harap sesiapa yang terima video atau berada di situ (tempat kejadian) tidak semudahnya berkongsi keadaan mangsa cabul yang tentunya masih trauma dengan kejadian berkenaan,” katanya pada sidang media

selepas merasmikan Sambutan Hari Wanita Antarabangsa peringkat zon utara di sini, semalam.

Nancy berkata, pihaknya sedia bekerjasama dengan Polis Diraja Malaysia (PDRM) bagi membantu kes itu, termasuk memberi pandangan terutama isu berkaitan kebajikan mangsa serta keluarganya.

Dalam pada itu, beliau turut memohon pihak masjid memperketat aspek keselamatan supaya kejadian sama tidak berulang terutama menjelang Ramadan dan umat Islam akan menunaikan solat tarawih.

“CCTV (kamera litar tertutup) dan fasiliti keselamatan lain boleh digunakan supaya tidak ada pihak yang boleh mengambil kesempatan dengan mudah di dalam kawasan masjid,” katanya. — Bernama

## Nancy: Stop sharing video of mosque molestation victim

**IPOH:** Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri has urged the public and social media users to refrain from sharing videos of the young girl who was allegedly molested at a mosque in Batang Kali, Hulu Selangor on Feb 21.

She said the victim is protected under the Child Act 2001, and sharing footage of her condition is highly inappropriate.

"We talk about this issue every day, yet it still happens. We urge those who receive the video or were at the scene not to share it, as the victim is already traumatised by the incident," she told a press conference after

the northern zone International Women's Day celebration yesterday.

The girl was allegedly molested by a man at Masjid Jamek Sungai Masin at 6.41am last Friday.

A viral video showed the visibly shaken girl recounting how she was molested while performing her Subuh prayers.

Nancy said the ministry is ready to assist the police in their investigation, particularly on matters concerning the welfare of the victim and her family.

She also urged mosques to tighten security measures to prevent similar incidents, especially with Ramadan approaching, when Muslims gather for Terawih prayers.

"CCTV and other security measures should be in place to prevent anyone from exploiting the mosque's premises," she said. —Bernama

## Stop circulating video of minor molested in mosque

**IPOH:** The Women, Family and Community Development Ministry has called for a stop to the circulation of a video that showed a young girl allegedly molested at a mosque in Batang Kali, Hulu Selangor.

"Please stop sharing the video, as it involves a minor," said minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri.

She said that it would be highly inappropriate to circulate video footage of the girl, who is protected under the Child Act.

The video, which has gone viral, showed a visibly shaken girl recounting what she went through while she was performing her prayers.

Selangor police chief Comm Datuk Hussein Omar Khan has said in a statement that a 19-year-old youth, who was detained over the case, will be charged today.

Yesterday, Nancy said that mosques need to beef up their security systems to protect worshippers.

She said stricter measures are required to protect children and stop others from exploiting them.

"It is also hoped that those with close circuit camera (CCTV) facilities will utilise them effectively to ensure the safety of children inside the mosque," she told reporters after opening the International Women's Day 2025 celebration for the Northern Zone here yesterday.

On the International Women's Day celebration, Nancy said the ministry is hosting the event across five zones this year, namely Borneo, East, South, Central and the North.

"The celebrations are being held in different zones to encourage greater participation from women across the states and communities while raising public awareness on women-related issues," she said.

She said the main celebration would take place in Kuala Lumpur on March 8.

Nancy also said that the Women's Leadership Apprenticeship Programme (Perantis) is targeting 100 Malaysian women leaders this year, with each of them receiving up to RM50,000 to support their programmes.

"Last year, 25 women's leadership development programmes were held nationwide, benefiting 1,247 participants with an allocation of RM1.2mil," she added.

IPOH: Tahap keselamatan di masjid dan surau menjadi tumpuan pada Ramadan ini ekoran kes seorang lelaki disyaki mencabul kanak-kanak perempuan di sebuah masjid di Batang Kali, Selangor.

Menteri Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat, Datuk Nancy Shukri melihat soal keselamatan sebagai kepentingan bagi memantau dan mengelakkan kejadian yang tidak diingini.

"Saya setuju. Pihak masjid seharusnya perketatkan lagi urusan (keselamatan) di masjid, supaya tidak ada orang dengan mudah mengambil peluang.

"Diharapkan mereka (masjid dan surau) yang mempunyai kamera litar tertutup (CCTV), menggunakan fasiliti itu untuk menjaga keselamatan terutama kanak-kanak," katanya kepada pemberita selepas perasmian Sambutan Hari Wanita Antarabangsa peringkat zon utara di Ipoh di sini hari ini.

Beliau berkata demikian apabila ditanya mengenai kes tersebut yang dilaporkan berlaku ketika solat Subuh di masjid tersebut pada 21 Februari lalu.

Rakaman kamera litar tertutup (CCTV) masjid menunjukkan suspek yang berpakaian putih menyelilap masuk ke ruang solat wanita sebelum memeluk mangsa dari arah belakang dan membawa kanak-kanak itu keluar.

Berkenaan kes yang sama, Nancy mahu orang ramai tidak menyebarkan video dan gambar kes menerusi laman sosial memandangkan mangsa adalah kanak-kanak yang diliindungi di bawah undang-undang.

Sementara itu, beliau berkata masih belum ada keputusan akhir berkenaan pelaksanaan waktu bekerja selama 45 jam seminggu membabitkan golongan jururawat di bawah Kementerian Kesihatan yang telah ditangguhkan.

Ketika diajukan soalan mengenai kebjakan jururawat yang kebanyakkan merupakan wanita dan bergelar ibu, Menteri itu menyatakan perkara tersebut akan dibawa untuk pengetahuan pihak yang berkaitan.

Delegasi Jururawat Malaysia (DJM) mahu tempoh penangguhan pelaksanaan waktu kerja 45 jam itu selama tiga bulan lagi akan digunakan sebaiknya oleh pihak kerajaan untuk membatalkan penambahan jam bekerja itu sepenuhnya.

Beliau sebelum itu merasmikan sambutan Hari Wanita Antarabangsa Peringkat Zon Utara dengan fokus keterampilan dan keyakinan diri menjelang kemuncak sambutan pada 8 Mac depan yang dirasmikan oleh Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim. - UTUSAN

## Seek fertility treatment, help boost birth rate, Nancy tells married couples

**KEPALA BATAS:** The government is urging married couples to overcome any feelings of embarrassment about seeking fertility treatment, as such hesitation could hinder their chances of conceiving.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said fertility issues are often associated with women, but men can also face challenges which contribute to difficulties in conceiving.

"Often, the inability to conceive is attributed solely to women, but the reality is that men can also experience fertility problems.

"Therefore, I encourage our community to seek treatment to improve fertility levels, ultimately helping to boost the

nation's birth rate," she told reporters after launching the Fertility Treatment Assistance and Infertility Advocacy (BuAI) initiative at the National Population and Family Development Board (LPPKN) Family Centre, here yesterday.

She added that under Budget 2025, the government has allocated RM6 million to fund two cycles of Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) fertility treatment for 1,300 eligible couples free of charge, along with an infertility advocacy campaign.

Nancy said the government hopes that the fertility treatment facilities, and subsidies provided under BuAI, will help more couples fulfil their dream of starting a family. — Bernama

## Ministry targets 13,000 counsellors

**SERDANG:** The Women, Family and Community Development Ministry is targeting 13,000 counsellors to be registered with the Board of Counsellors Malaysia by the end of this year.

Its minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said 11,700 counsellors are now registered with the board.

"Counselling is not a new field, but demand for it is extremely high, given the various issues affecting the country. With the increased exposure to social media, the need (for counselling services) has grown significantly," she said after officiating at the World Counselling Conference 2025, here on Tuesday.

Nancy said on average, the ministry's *Talian Kasih* 15999 helpline receives 500 calls daily, with complaints ranging from abuse to depression.

At the three-day conference, which began on Monday, local counsellors have the opportunity to exchange views with their international counterparts on various aspects of counselling, she said.

Jointly organised by the ministry, the Board of Counsellors Malaysia, Universiti Putra Malaysia and Open University Malaysia, the conference brought together counselling professionals, educators, researchers, and students to discuss pressing issues, advancements, and the latest research in the field.

## Call for **child protection** measures at public spaces

**PETALING JAYA:** Public spaces frequented by children must have comprehensive child protection measures to ensure their safety, said Child Rights and Innovation Betterment Foundation co-chairman Srividhya Ganapathy.

Her comments came following a 19-year-old man's arrest for allegedly attempting to molest a young girl at a mosque in Batang Kali. The alleged assailant was later confirmed to be holding a person with disabilities (PwD) card for having a learning dysfunction.

Srividhya also called on the authorities to implement child protection measures in schools and places of worship, provide adequate security, have specially trained child safety personnel, and institute protection policies and mechanisms to enable children to raise the alarm in the event they face impending danger.

"Malaysians tend to take videos but not get involved in situations where physical violence and abuse occur in public.

"We must change this mindset and do the right thing, while the

government raises awareness and educates the public that child protection comes first."

She said awareness of 24-hour hotlines should be increased and manned by trained personnel to provide an immediate response, especially since the government is obligated to protect all children under the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child which Malaysia ratified in 1995.

"Also, the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017 applies to every child and is enforceable in Malaysia against anyone regardless of social status.

"Every child suffering from trauma should be supported and assisted by qualified and trained healthcare professionals and psychologists."

Srividhya also said current reporting of the mosque incident seeks to emphasise the

perpetrator's PwD status.

"This is harmful, serves little purpose, and will only worsen bias and prejudice in the minds of the public that PwD are not to be trusted and are sexual perpetrators."

She said it will also hinder efforts to fully integrate the PwD community into society, as the ability or disability of any offender has no bearing when it comes to protecting children.

Srividhya said the absence of SOPs and laws to protect PwD cardholders' confidentiality and prevent public bias also hinders efforts to address child protection issues.

"Everyone has equal rights to justice regardless of their disability. Shifting the focus to the alleged perpetrator's disability rather than concentrating on the offence is dangerous and unwarranted."

Clinical child psychologist

Dr Noor Aishah Rosli supported Srividhya's call for increased supervision in public spaces and stricter safeguarding measures, especially in religious institutions where people should feel safe even though individuals with behavioural challenges are present.

"Individuals with certain disabilities can still be held accountable for their actions, but it is crucial to involve forensic psychologists and psychiatrists when assessing the accountability of those with PwD status to determine cognitive capacity and intent, as the legal system often evaluates accountability based on it."

Noor Aishah said when a child witnesses or experiences a crime committed by someone with PwD status, he may develop negative stereotypes or fears leading to misconceptions that individuals with disabilities are dangerous or have unpredictable behaviour.

She said public education campaigns play a vital role in raising awareness about disabilities, including the behaviours and challenges faced by individuals with PwD status to help set appropriate expectations about their actions.

## New childcare centre registration guidelines in July

**SHAH ALAM:** Guidelines to standardise and simplify the registration process for childcare centres in Selangor will be introduced in July, said State Women Development and Social Welfare Committee chairman Anfaal Saari.

She said the guidelines, developed in collaboration with the Department of Occupational Safety and Health, aim to increase the number of registered childcare centres in the state.

As of January 2024, 959 childcare centres were registered with the Social Welfare Department, while 164 had not.

To assist operators in meeting technical agency requirements, the state government is offering grants of up to RM5,000 to help cover registration costs.

"In addition, one-stop centres at the state and district levels have been activated to facilitate the registration process until operators meet the necessary requirements. As of December 2024, 201 childcare centres have been assisted and successfully registered," she said at the Selangor State Legislative Assembly sitting on Tuesday.

To ensure all centres comply with regulations, reminder notices are being issued, and enforcement actions are taken against non-compliant operators under the Child Care Centre Act 1984.

Additionally, a Special Committee for the Improvement of Care Services has been established, comprising representatives from local authorities, the Social Welfare Department, PlanMalaysia Selangor, Selangor Health Department, Fire and Rescue Department and the Selangor Economic Planning Unit. – Bernama

## Almost 14,000 children reported missing since 2014,

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Over 20,000 people, a majority of those below 18, have gone missing in Malaysia over the past decade, according to police statistics.  
And nearly 60% of the total missing persons are female, raising serious concerns about the safety of the nation's youth.  
"A total of 21,722 individuals were reported missing nationwide from 2014 to 2024.  
"Of this, 13,969, or 64.3%, were

under the age of 18. The majority of those who went missing were females (12,882)," Bukit Aman deputy Criminal Investigation Department (CID) director Deputy Comm Datuk Fadil Marsus (pic) told *The Star*.  
More worryingly, among those under 18, the largest group of missing individuals during this period was in the 13-to-15-year-old category, totalling 7,426 children.



"The second highest is the 16 to 17 age group (3,561); followed by 7-12 (785); and those below seven years of age (197)," DCP Fadil noted.  
In the 18 and above category, the highest number of missing persons were in the 21-25 age group (1,219); followed by 18-20 (1,195); and those aged 61 and above (1,015).  
According to police, the state

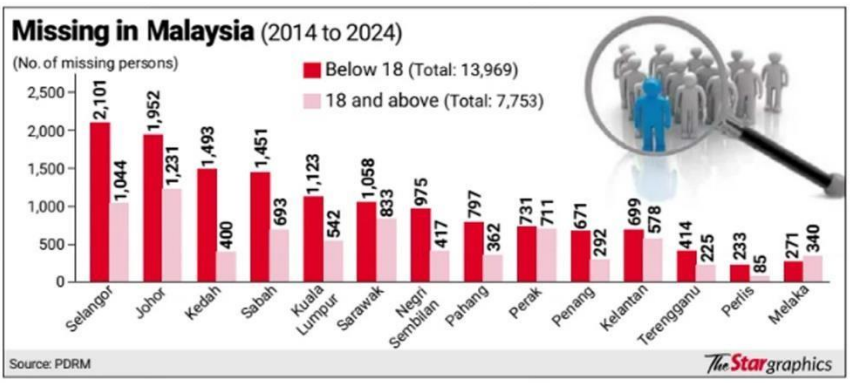
with the most cases of children reported missing in the past 10 years was Selangor (2,101); followed by Johor (1,952); and Kedah (1,493).  
However, there is some good news: DCP Fadil said that 98% of cases involving individuals under 18 have been resolved.  
"Out of 13,779 cases, 13,726 were found alive, with the remaining deceased.  
"For those aged 18 and above, 6,653 cases, or 85.8%, have been resolved, with 6,025 individuals (90.6%) found alive," he added.

DCP Fadil said the number of missing person cases involving those under 18 showed a 36% increase last year compared to the previous year, mostly among those aged 13 to 15.  
He said the reasons for children going missing include running away from home in search of freedom, family problems, accidents, or falling victim to crime.  
Meanwhile, for those aged 18 and above, there was a 22% increase in missing cases in 2024 compared to 2023.  
"Misunderstandings between

## statistics show

family members have been identified as one of the main factors leading to individuals running away.  
"Other factors include escaping from money lenders, mental health issues, and accidents," said DCP Fadil.  
He emphasised that collaboration between law enforcement agencies, community organisations, and the public is vital to reducing the number of missing person cases.  
"Through cooperation, we are able to share resources and exper-

tise. There needs to be greater awareness of personal safety in schools to teach individuals about potential risks and how to stay safe," he said.  
DCP Fadil also pointed out that technological solutions, such as social media awareness campaigns, tracking applications, and emergency alert systems, are among the ways to address missing person cases in the country.  
"Providing counselling, rehabilitation, and reintegration programmes for at-risk individuals is also important," he added.

## '15% of childcare centres in S'gor unregistered'

ABOUT 14.6% or 164 childcare centres in Selangor are not registered, says state women, family empowerment, welfare and care economy committee chairman Anfaal Shaari.

As of January, she said there were 1,123 childcare centres in the state with 959 registered.

Selangor, she added, was committed to ensuring all childcare centres were registered and had implemented various strategies to reach this goal.

"For unregistered childcare centres, the state is offering grants of up to RM5,000 to help operators fund the cost of registration and compliance.

"Additionally, we have formed the Special Committee for Improvement of Care Services, which includes local authorities, state Social Welfare Department, PLANMalaysia, Health Department, Fire and Rescue Department and Economic Planning Unit.

"This committee oversees current regulations and standards, and works to identify areas for improvement," Anfaal said, adding that the state has also issued reminders while enforcing the Child Care Centre Act 1984 (Act 308).

"To streamline the registration process, we have activated one-stop centres at state and district levels, allowing operators to easily meet the requirements set by technical agencies," said Anfaal in reply to a question by Pang Sock Tao (PH-Kuala Kubu Bharu) during the Selangor State Assembly sitting at Bangunan Dewan Negeri Selangor in Shah Alam.

Anfaal said by the end of last year, 201 childcare centres received assistance and gained approval for registration.

Separately, in reply to a question by Mariam Abdul Rashid (PH-Meru) on domestic violence matters, Anfaal said 1,300 police reports were lodged last year.

"Out of the total, 871 involved women, 286 involved men and 143 involved children.

"To improve awareness, the state will launch a campaign against gender-based violence that will kick off in April and run until the end of the year.

"The campaign will be held in five districts with the participation of stakeholders including local authorities, police, One-Stop Crisis Centre, Health Ministry, Selangor Islamic Religious Department (JAIS) and community leaders.

"It will comprise awareness talks and mobile legal services," she said, adding that an online campaign would also be intensified for wider reach.

Anfaal said the Selangor Gender-Based Violence Case Reference Document, which was currently in progress, was also expected to raise awareness on the issue.

Since 2022, she said the state, through the Wanita Berdaya Selangor organisation, has been holding a 16-day campaign against gender-based violence, which is observed internationally from Nov 25 to Dec 10.

**PETALING JAYA:** Seven deaths in unregistered childcare centres were recorded from 2021 to 2024, says women, family and community development minister Nancy Shukri.

In a written parliamentary reply, she said the figure, which includes deaths due to neglect and negligence, is based on the social welfare department's (JKM) enforcement records.

"There was one case per year from 2021 to 2023, and four cases in 2024," she said.

Nancy was responding to Rodiyah Sapiee (GPS-Batang Sadong), who had asked about the number of deaths in childcare centres since 2021.

Rodiyah had also asked what the ministry had done about the reported death of a four-month-old infant at an unregistered childcare centre on Jan 3.

Nancy said JKM had shuttered the centre located in Bandar Saujana Putra for operating without proof of registration.

"The registration of childcare centres is dependent on compliance with the law and regulations, as well as the conditions set to ensure quality service is offered.

"Its purpose is also to reduce the risk of unwanted incidents for the sake of the children's safety and well-being.

"Parents are encouraged to send their children to registered centres. They can check a centre's registration status via JKM's official website," she said.

It was reported earlier that Selangor JKM ordered the closure of the centre in Bandar Saujana Putra, Kuala Langat, after police received a report on Jan 3 about an infant who was brought to a clinic unconscious by a nursery caregiver.

Menurut Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Kebajikan Masyarakat, Pembangunan Wanita dan Keluarga Negeri Pahang, YB. Dato' Hajah Sabariah Saidan, bantuan sebanyak RM250 seorang ini melibatkan 400 orang anak yatim yang merupakan penghuni di rumah anak yatim.

"Kerajaan Negeri telah mengeluarkan sebanyak RM100,000 kepada tujuh buah pusat penjagaan anak-anak yatim. Anak yatim ini, seorang, akan menerima bantuan sebanyak RM250.

"Dan memang kita memilih tarikh hari ini (bagi penyerahan bantuan) sebab berdekatan dengan bulan puasa dan kita akan sampaikan sumbangan kepada anak-anak yatim.

"Penerima kita ikut kepada bilangan rumah anak yatim berdaftar. Kita ada banyak rumah anak yatim, ada 18 buah tapi yang benar-benar kita bagi adalah kepada yang betul-betul lengkap dengan pendaftaran, renew semula, ada tujuh," katanya.

Beliau berkata demikian ketika ditemui pada penyerahan cek cura Inisiatif Makmur Pahang 2025 Bantuan Kepada Anak Yatim Berdaftar Di Bawah Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Negeri Pahang yang disampaikan oleh YAB Menteri Besar Pahang, Dato' Sri Diraja Haji Wan Rosdy Wan Ismail.

Tambah beliau, bantuan ini juga akan disampaikan kepada baki 11 rumah anak yatim lagi sekiranya kelulusan pendaftaran baharu telah diperolehi.

"Walau bagaimana pun kita ada standby kepada rumah anak yatim yang dalam proses mendapatkan kelulusan pendaftaran baru, dalam 11 lagi," katanya.

Beliau ketika ditemui turut mengingatkan pengusaha rumah anak yatim di negeri ini supaya mempercepatkan proses memperbaharui pendaftaran.

"Apa-apa kita kena ada kelulusan kerajaan. Kita minta rumah anak yatim ini segera renew, jangan tunggu expired betul, bila hampir (tarikh tamat) tu kita kena usaha untuk memperbaharui.

"InsyaAllah (diperudahcara). Dari segi bahagian teknikal, majlis perbandaran, bomba, itu memang tak ada kompromi untuk keselamatan anak-anak yatim di tempat tersebut," katanya. -

Hanya tangisan dan raungan bersama di keklaman keluarga Hud Aryan Mohd Nur Hafifi di Kampung Aira Kuala Tiga, di sini, semalam sebuah dimaklumkan penemuan bayi 19 bulan itu.

Selapas 45 jam hilang, penemuannya dalam keadaan tidak bernyawa mengandungi duka keluarga terutama ibu bapanya, Azean Nur Atikah Ramley dan Mohd Nur Hafifi Sidiq masing-masing berusia 34 tahun.

Hud Aryan yang juga satu-satunya jantung hati pasangan itu ditemui pada jam 4.15 petang semalam, dengan mayatnya tersangkut di pokok di tebing sungai di Kampung Kerit, kira-kira tiga kilometer (km) dari kediaman keluarga.

Sebaik dikhabarkan penemuan itu, Azean Nur Atikah meraung hingga terpeka ditengking suaminya dan ahli keluarga, sekali gas mengandungi pilu mereka yang berada di kediaman berkenaan termasuk wartawan.

Pihak berkuasa turut mengawal keklaman bagi memberi ruang kepada keluarga untuk berduka.

Ketua Bahal Bomba dan Penyelamat Tanah Merah, Mohd Zulfitri Osman berkata, bayi malang itu ditemui anggota penyelamat yang melaksanakan pencarian dengan alat di sungai.

Katanya, kawasan penemuan itu juga sudah dibaharui beberapa kali sejak operasi mencari dan menyelamatkan (SAR) diiktirafkan selepas Hud Aryan dilaporkan hilang pada jam 7.30 malam, Isnin lalu.

Menurutnya, kehilangan Hud Aryan berusia 19 bulan adalah ujian berat untuk mereka sekeluarga, terutama ibu ayahnya, Azean

"Kejadian ini menyedihkan kami semua dan berharap Hud Aryan segera ditemui," katanya.

Nur Atikah, 34, yang sudah lama menantikan kelahiran cahaya mata.

## MISSING TODDLER'S BODY FOUND

Search team finds Hud Aryan, the only child of a couple, at river estuary about 3km from his village

**T**HE body of 19-month-old Hud Aryan Mohd Nor Hafifi, who went missing on Monday night, was found yesterday among tree branches at a river estuary in Kampung Kerila.

Firefighters, police and villagers found the body about 3km from where he was last seen in Kampung Aira Kuala Tiga.

Tanah Merah police chief Superintendent Mohd Haki Hasbullah said the toddler's body was found at 4.20pm.

"The body has been sent to Tanah Merah Hospital for a post-mortem examination. The cause of death will be known after that."

Hud Aryan's parents, Mohd Nor Hafifi Saidee and Azean Nur Atikah Ramley, both 34, have accepted his death as fate.

Hud Aryan's uncle, Nor Rahimi Muaz, 30, said he received the news from his brother-in-law Hafifi at 4.30pm.

"My brother-in-law told me

that he and my sister Azean were on their way to the hospital with other family members.

"They are in shock, but they have both accepted the tragedy as

a test from Allah."

Hud Aryan went missing from his home in Kampung Aira Kuala Tiga about 7.20 pm on Monday.

A search-and-rescue operation

was launched to find the boy. The K9 unit was also deployed.

Hud Aryan was the couple's only child after eight years of marriage.

## Ustaz didakwa amang seksual fizikal menangis tidak dibenarkan jamin

ALOR SETAR: Seorang tenaga pengajar sebuah madrasah yang didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, hari ini bagi pertuduhan melakukan amang seksual fizikal terhadap kanak-kanak lelaki menangis apabila mahkamah tidak membenarkan jaminan terhadapnya.

Tertuduh yang berusia 31 tahun itu mengaku tidak bersalah dan minta dibicarakan selepas pertuduhan dibacakan terhadapnya di hadapan Hakim N. Priscilla Hemamalini.

Mengikut pertuduhan, dia didakwa melakukan amang seksual fizikal dengan meraba kemaluan seorang remaja lelaki berusia 16 tahun di sebuah bilik hotel di Jalan Tandop Utama, Kota Setar pada 2.35 pagi, 22 Februari lalu.

Pendakwaan dikemukakan mengikut Seksyen 14 (a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 yang boleh dihukum di bawah seksyen sama yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun dan sebatan, jika sabit kesalahan.

Kes dikendalikan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Nurfatin Mastura Asri manakala tertuduh diwakili peguam Mohd. Imran Farouk.

Pihak pendakwaan memohon mahkamah tidak menawarkan jaminan terhadap tertuduh yang turut berhadapan tujuh lagi pertuduhan di bawah seksyen sama di Mahkamah Sesyen Butterworth, Pulau Pinang.

Mohd. Imran meminta jaminan minima dibenarkan atas alasan tertuduh perlu menyara keluarga selain tidak melanggar syarat ditetapkan Mahkamah Sesyen Butterworth yang memberikan jaminan terhadapnya.

Bagaimanapun, Nurfatin Mastura memohon mahkamah mengambil kira faktor kepentingan awam yang mana tertuduh dianggap berbahaya kepada mangsa lain, walaupun tidak mengganggu mangsa-mangsanya dalam kes dihadapinya.

Pihak pendakwaan memaklumkan, kes yang dihadapi tertuduh hari ini berlaku selepas dia diberi jamin setelah pertuduhan terdahulu, selain faktor mangsa-mangsanya yang berlainan.

Hakim kemudian menetapkan jaminan tidak dibenarkan terhadap tertuduh dan tarikh 23 Mac untuk sebutan semula kes.
