Couples urged to seek fertility treatment to boost birth rate

KEPALA BATAS: The government is encouraging married couples to overcome any feelings of embarrassment about seeking fertility treatment, as hesitation could reduce their chances of conceiving.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said fertility issues are often linked to women, but men can also face challenges that contribute to difficulties in conceiving.

"Often, the inability to conceive is attributed solely to women, but the reality is that men can also experience fertility problems.

"Therefore, I encourage our community to seek treatment to improve fertility levels, ultimately helping to boost the nation's birth rate," she said after launching the Fertility Treatment Assistance and Infertility Advocacy initiative at the National Population and Family Development Board Family Centre on Wednesday.

She added that, under Budget 2025, the government has allocated RM6 million to fund two cycles of Intrauterine Insemination fertility treatment for 1,300 eligible couples, free of charge, along with an infertility advocacy campaign.

Nancy said the government hopes the fertility treatment facilities and subsidies provided under the initiative will help more couples fulfil their dream of starting a family.

The initiative aims to improve accessibility for couples with a household income of less than RM10,000, who have never received financial assistance for fertility treatment from any agency.

At the event, Nancy also announced the first recorded pregnancy under the initiative on Feb 18, underscoring its effectiveness in helping couples struggling with infertility.

In a separate matter, Nancy urged parents to remain vigilant and advise their children against buying or consuming certain snacks, particularly chewy or gummy candies.

"Apart from parents, teachers also play a crucial role in ensuring children avoid foods that could pose a danger to them," she said.

Her warning follows the death of Mohammad Fahmi Hafiz Mohammad Fakhruddin, who was in critical condition after allegedly choking on gummy candies and passed away while receiving treatment last Thursday. – Bernama

Nancy: Seven died at unlicensed childcare centres since 2021



SEVEN children have died at unregistered childcare centres over the past four years, the Dewan Rakyat was informed.

According to Social Welfare Department statistics, four cases were recorded last year and one each in 2021, 2022 and 2023, said Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri (*pic*).

“All cases happened at unregistered childcare centres,” she said in a written parliamentary reply yesterday.

Nancy stressed that the ministry continuously works to reduce the risk of neglect, carelessness and abuse at childcare facilities.

She explained that the registration of such centres is strictly governed by relevant laws, regu-

lations and conditions to ensure quality care and safety.

“Parents are advised to send their children to registered childcare centres,” she said, adding that the list can be accessed on the department’s website.

Beginning Jan 10 this year, Nancy said all registered childcare centres are required to display their registration certificates.

“It also aids the ministry in tackling any potential cases of abuse or neglect,” she added.

Regarding a recent case involving the death of a four-month-old baby at an unlicensed childcare centre in Bandar Saujana Putra, Selangor, Nancy confirmed that the Social Welfare Department had sealed the premises for operating without registration.

PUTRAJAYA, 27 Feb (Bernama) -- Permohonan Program Perantisan Kepimpinan Wanita (PERANTIS) dibuka mulai hari ini hingga 26 Mac, dengan peruntukan sebanyak RM5 juta dan menyasarkan 100 tokoh wanita serta bakal memanfaatkan lebih 5,000 peserta bimbingan.

Menurut Jabatan Pembangunan Wanita (JPW), permohonan lengkap bersama kertas cadangan pelaksanaan program boleh dibuat secara dalam talian di pautan <https://iwanita.my>.

JPW memaklumkan peruntukan itu diumumkan Perdana Menteri Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim dalam sambutan Hari Wanita Antarabangsa pada 8 Mac 2024 sebagai usaha memartabatkan wanita di persada dunia dan memperkasakan kepimpinan wanita melalui bimbingan tokoh wanita berjaya.

PERANTIS menyediakan geran kepada tokoh wanita untuk melatih dan membimbing lebih ramai kaum hawa, terutamanya golongan muda bagi mengasah bakat kepimpinan mereka.

"Ia adalah langkah penting untuk melahirkan lebih ramai kumpulan bakat pemimpin wanita, terutamanya di peringkat pembuat keputusan. PERANTIS juga dijadikan platform bagi perkongsian ilmu dan kepakaran," menurut kenyataan itu.

Di samping itu, melalui program berkenaan peserta akan dapat mengukuhkan jaringan kerjasama dalam kalangan pemimpin wanita daripada pelbagai sektor.

Untuk rekod, pelaksanaan PERANTIS pada tahun lepas telah menarik penyertaan seramai 1,247 peserta dengan bimbingan 25 tokoh wanita.

Macsa: Strengthen disability rights protection

THE Malaysian Alliance of Civil Society Organisations (Macsa), a coalition of 60 non-governmental and civil society groups, expresses concern over the recent tragic death of a blind man who was run over by a Light Rail Transit train after falling onto the tracks at the Titiwangsa station.

It appears the train operator was unaware of the fall, and there were no staff present to assist people with disabilities (PWD).

Through a report from one of our PwD members of the "Persatuan Orang-Orang Cacat Penglihatan Islam Malaysia" (Pertis), it was noted that since the gazetting of the Persons with Disabilities Act 2008 (Act 685), at least seven incidents involving blind individuals in public areas have been reported.

All of these incidents resulted from public facility providers' failure to comply with the procedures and guidelines outlined in Part IV of Act 685.

Macsa urges the government, through relevant ministries – namely the Women, Family and Community Development Ministry as well as the Transport Ministry – to thoroughly address the concerns faced by PwD in public areas and ensure strict compliance with the provisions of the CRPD (Convention on the Rights of PwD) and Act 685.

Legal provisions to protect the PwD's basic rights will remain toothless and ineffective without the government's intervention in ensuring that all providers of public facilities uphold their shared responsibilities towards people with disabilities.

Macsa also calls for urgent amendments to the Act to include enforcement and penalty provisions, ensuring that any violation of the Act can be legally dealt with.

These demands are in line with the recommendations Macsa submitted to the office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights during the Universal Periodic Review processes in Geneva last year and in 2018.

Macsa would like to take this opportunity to thank all activists who have tirelessly fought for the rights of people with disabilities.

A special thanks goes to the activists in Pertis. Their commitment, creativity and dedication to improving the well-being and welfare of blind individuals will continue to inspire all Macsa members.

Urgent action needed to address rising cases of missing children — Lee Lam Thye

KUALA LUMPUR: Stronger laws, stricter enforcement, and coordinated efforts are needed to tackle the increasing number of missing children, said Alliance for a Safe Community Chairman Tan Sri Lee Lam Thye.

He emphasised that the disappearance of a child is not just a personal tragedy but also a serious national concern requiring urgent intervention.

"Every missing child represents a potential tragedy, not only for the child but also for their family and the wider community.

"While some cases involve runaways, others may be linked to abduction, trafficking, exploitation, or criminal activities.

Addressing this issue effectively demands a multifaceted approach involving parents, schools, law enforcement, and society as a whole," he said in a statement yesterday.

Lee outlined several urgent steps that should be taken to enhance child safety and prevent cases of missing minors, including proposing a comprehensive data on missing children cases be collected to analyse patterns and identify high-risk factors.

"Research on the root causes of children going missing, such as family issues, abuse, or exploitation, must guide policy changes," he said.

He emphasised that parents and guardians must also be

vigilant in monitoring their children's activities, both online and offline.

Open communication between parents and children is vital, and schools should conduct awareness programmes to educate students about personal safety and the dangers of following strangers, he added.

"The public must be encouraged to report suspicious activities or individuals who may pose a risk to children, while collaboration between authorities, non-governmental organisations and the media is equally essential to create greater awareness and to disseminate information quickly in missing child cases," he said.

Dia didakwa mengikut Seksyen 14(a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 yang boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 14 akta yang sama, jika sabit kesalahan boleh dipenjara maksimum 20 tahun dan

sebat.

Terdahulu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nurfadzlin Mahamad Zulhasnan memohon mahkamah menetapkan tarikh baharu bagi menunggu laporan sosial daripada JKJ memandangkan tertuduh adalah pesalah muda yang berusia

antara 18 sehingga 21 tahun.

"Pihak pendakwaan menawarkan jaminan RM15,000 terhadap tertuduh selain mencadangkan dia melaporkan diri di balai polis berdekatan setiap bulan serta tidak mengacau ganggu mangsa dan saksi pendakwaan.

"Tempat kejadian juga berdekatan dengan kawasan perumahan di mana mangsa tinggal," katanya.

Sebelum menetapkan tarikh sebutan, Norshila menyoal tertuduh sama ada ahli keluarganya hadir ke mahkamah pada semalam bagi membayar jaminan, bagaimanapun tertuduh menjawab tiada.

Susulan itu, Norshila tidak membenarkan sebarang jaminan terhadap tertuduh yang tidak diwakili peguam.

Dia didakwa mengikut Seksyen 14(a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 yang boleh dihukum mengikut Seksyen 14 akta sama yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara maksimum 20 tahun dan sebat, jika

sabit kesalahan.

Terdahulu, Timbalan Pendakwa Raya Nurfadzlin Muhamad Zulhasnan, memohon mahkamah menetapkan tarikh baharu bagi menunggu laporan sosial daripada JKM memandangkan tertuduh adalah pesalah muda berusia antara 18 sehingga 21 tahun.

Pihak pendakwaan menawarkan jaminan RM15,000 ke atas tertuduh, selain mencadangkan dia melaporkan diri di balai polis berdekatan setiap bulan serta tidak mengacau ganggu mangsa dan saksi pendakwaan.

“Tempat kejadian juga berdekatan kawasan perumahan di mana mangsa tinggal,” katanya.

Sebelum menetapkan tarikh sebutan, Norshila menyoal tertuduh sama ada ahli keluarganya hadir ke mahkamah bagi membayar jaminan dan tertuduh menjawab tiada.

Susulan itu, Norshila tidak membenarkan sebarang jaminan ke atas tertuduh yang tidak diwakili peguam.

VIRAL CASE

Youth admits to sexual assault of girl in Batang Kali mosque

KUALA LUMPUR: A youth with learning disabilities pleaded guilty at the Ampang Sessions Court yesterday to sexually assaulting a 10-year-old girl in a mosque last week.

The incident caused a national uproar after closed-circuit television (CCTV) camera footage of the incident was circulated on social media.

Muhamad Adam Haiqal Abdullah, 19, made his plea after the charge was read out to him before judge Norshila Kamarudin.

He was charged with sexually assaulting the girl at Masjid Sungai Masin in Kampung Sungai Masin, Batang Kali about 6.20am on Feb 21.

The offence under Section 14(a) of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act carries a maximum 20-year jail term and whipping.

Deputy public prosecutor Nur-fadzlin Mahmad Zulhasnan asked the court to set a date for

the submission of a social report.

"Pending the report, if the court wishes to offer bail, I suggest it be set at RM15,000.

"He must also report to the police station and be barred from harassing the victim and prosecution witnesses as the location of the offence is near the residence of the victim. This is to prevent recurrence of the incident," she said.

The judge asked Adam Haiqal, a disabled-card holder, if there was anyone who would post bail for him.

"I do not have a bailor," he said.

The court set March 27 for facts and sentencing.

Adam Haiqal was caught on a mosque CCTV approaching a child from behind and carrying her away, without being noticed by other congregants.

He was also seen attempting to assault the victim but fled after she resisted.

Teen OKU pleads guilty to sexual assault

"Yes, I understand, I plead guilty," he said.

According to the charge, Muhamad Adam Haiqal was accused of committing physical sexual assault on a 10-year-old girl at the mosque at 6.20am on Feb 21.

He was charged under Section 14(a) of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017, which carries a penalty of up to 20 years' jail and whipping, if convicted.

Deputy public prosecutor Nurfadzlin Mahmad Zulhasnan appeared for the prosecution, while the accused was unrepresented.

Nurfadzlin proposed that the accused be granted bail of RM15,000 with one surety.

"This includes reporting to the police station and not disturbing the witness and victim, to prevent a recurrence of the incident," she said.

Teen pleads guilty to sexually assaulting girl at mosque

KUALA LUMPUR: A teenager was charged in the Ampang Sessions Court yesterday with committing sexual assault on a girl at a mosque in Batang Kali, Hulu Selangor.

Muhamad Adam Haiqal Abdullah, 19, pleaded guilty before Judge Norshila Kamaruddin.

The court set March 27 for sentencing following the prosecution's request to obtain a social report on the accused from the Social Welfare Department.

Muhamad Adam Haiqal was charged with

committing the offence on the girl, aged 10 years and eight months, at the mosque at 6.20am on Feb 21.

DPP Nurfadzlin Mahmad Zulhasnan appeared for the prosecution while the accused was unrepresented.

A video footage from closed-circuit television that was widely circulated on social media platforms showed a man wearing a white skullcap sneaking into the women's prayer area.

The man approached a girl from behind while she was prostrating and hugged her

before carrying her away without being noticed by others who were praying at the time.

The man was also seen struggling as he attempted to assault the victim. He fled after the victim fought back.

The suspect who lives about a kilometre from the mosque was arrested soon after the incident.

It is learnt that the victim's mother, who is also the complainant, said she brought her two children to the mosque to perform the *Subuh* prayers, but only the victim performed the prayers at the back of the mosque. – Bernama

Nabbed doc allegedly harassed up to 15 other female patients

GEORGE TOWN: A 43-year-old doctor arrested for allegedly outraging the modesty of a female patient at a public hospital may have done it more than a dozen times before.

A medical fraternity source says there could be up to 15 victims who had been sexually harassed by the same doctor.

The doctor, the source said, had apparently fabricated documents and medical records to ask female

patients to come and see him.

"After telling them to undress, he would film them using his phone, on the pretext of checking their heart readings, or conducting other routine check-ups.

"Sometimes, the sessions were done outside regular consultation hours.

"In most cases, the female patients did not suspect anything," the source claimed.

This is also not the first time the doctor had been investigated for such offences, said the source who claimed the man had been questioned by police in 2019 and 2023.

However, due to insufficient evidence, no action was taken.

"He was finally caught in the act now," the source said.

On Wednesday, the doctor had allegedly convinced a 21-year-old female patient to undress under the pretence of performing heart checks, without a female nurse present.

He reportedly recorded her using his mobile phone before hospital management staff barged into the room and found video recordings of her on his phone.

The victim then filed a police report.

George Town OCPD ACP Abdul Rozak Muhammad said the medical officer was picked up at about 9.30pm on Wednesday and remanded for four days until Sunday.

He will be investigated under Section 509 of the Penal Code for insulting modesty, which carries a sentence of up to five years in jail, a fine, or both upon conviction.

ACP Abdul Rozak said the case was also being investigated under Section 14 of the Minor Offences Act 1955 for behaving in an insulting manner with the purpose of

stirring anger, which would likely cause a disturbance.

The offence carries a fine of not more than RM100, upon conviction.

Senator Dr RA Lingeshwaran, a former director of Hospital Sungai Bakap in Penang, called for a thorough investigation into the case.

"It is crucial to emphasise that doctors must conduct physical examinations in the presence of a chaperone.

"Medical professionals must uphold ethical standards," he said.

Kematian Hud Aryan disiasat secara teliti, dikhuatiri ada kecuaiian: Polis

KOTA BHARU: Kematian kanak-kanak lelaki berusia 19 bulan Hud Aryan Mohd Nor Hafifiakan disiasat secara teliti kerana dikhuatiri ada unsur kecuaiian, kata Ketua Polis Kelantan Datuk Mohd Yusoff Mamat.

Mohd Yusoff berkata, beliau telah mengarahkan Ketua Polis Daerah Tanah Merah Supt Mohd Haki Hasbullah untuk menjalankan siasatan lanjut terhadap keluarga kanak-kanak berkenaan.

“Saya memantau TikTok orang ramai dan mereka mengatakan cara kanak-kanak itu hilang tidak logik kerana dalam tempoh beberapa minit sahaja dia (Hud Aryan) telah terjatuh ke dalam sungai.

“Pihak polis bimbang sekiranya ada unsur kecuaiian dan kes ini masih diklasifikasikan sebagai kematian mengejut,” katanya dalam sidang media khas di Ibu Pejabat Polis Kontinjen Kelantan di sini hari ini.

Mohd Yusoff berkata, hasil bedah siasat terhadap kanak-kanak berkenaan tidak menemukan sebarang kecederaan pada anggota badan serta tiada unsur jenayah.

Beliau berkata, polis akan mengambil keterangan keluarga termasuk ibu dan bapa kanak-kanak itu serta jiran-jiran yang berdekatan di kawasan Kampung Aira Kuala Tiga, Tanah Merah.

Pada Isnin lepas, kanak-

kanak itu dilaporkan hilang di Kampung Aira Kuala Tiga dan memasuki hari ketiga pencarian kelmarin, anggota mencari dan menyelamat (SAR) menjumpai mayat Hud Aryan di tebing sungai kira-kira tiga kilometer dari rumahnya.
